DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a bracelet showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a front-elevational view thereof (the rear being a mirror image thereof).

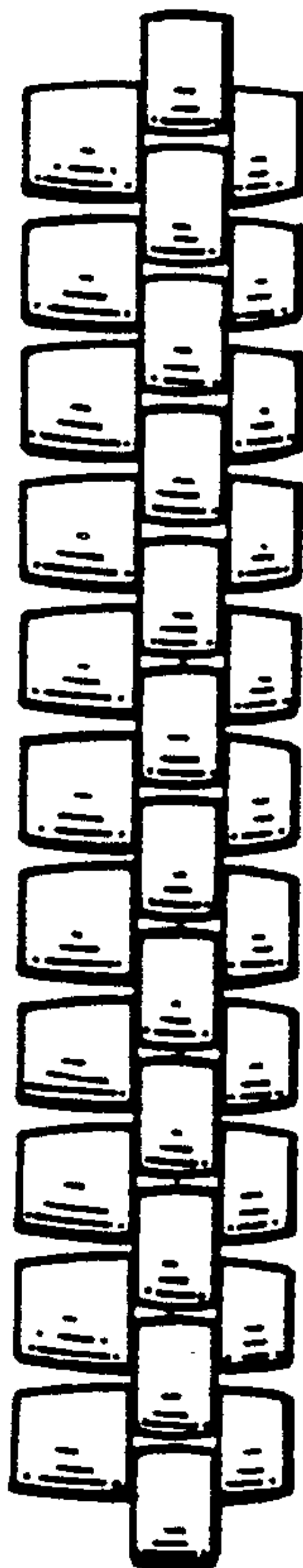

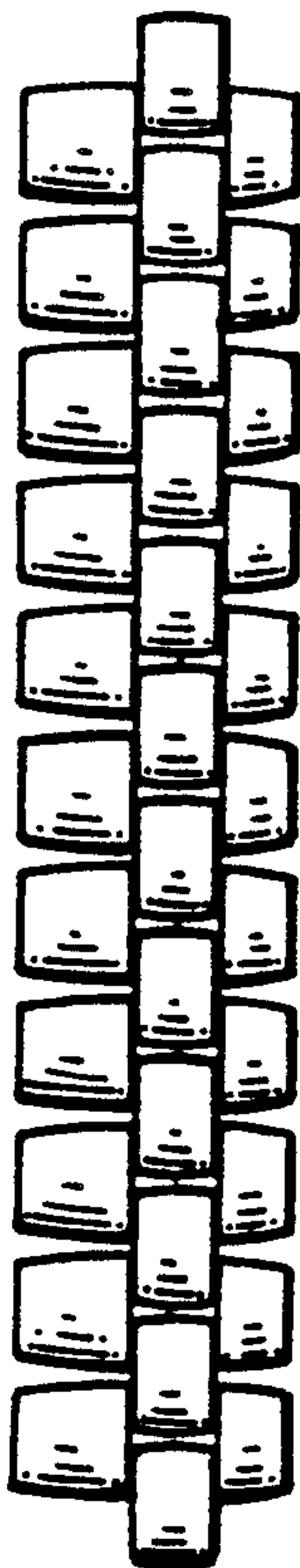

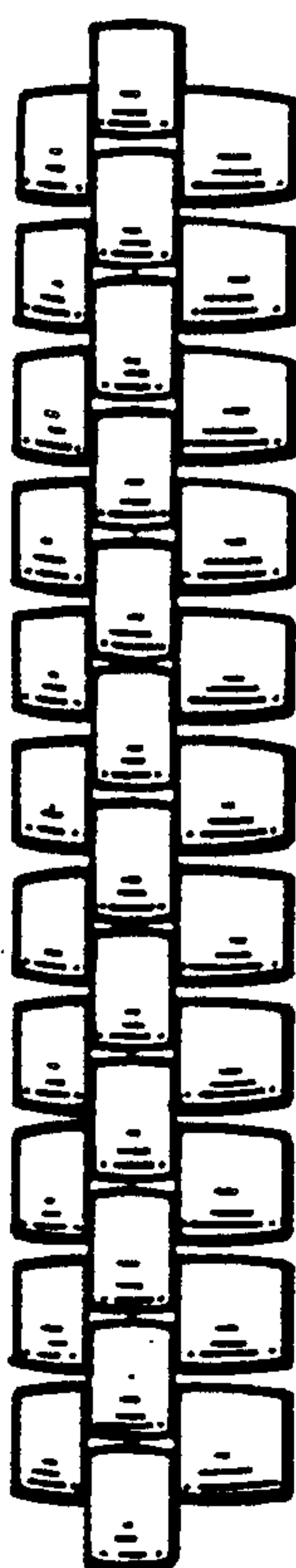
