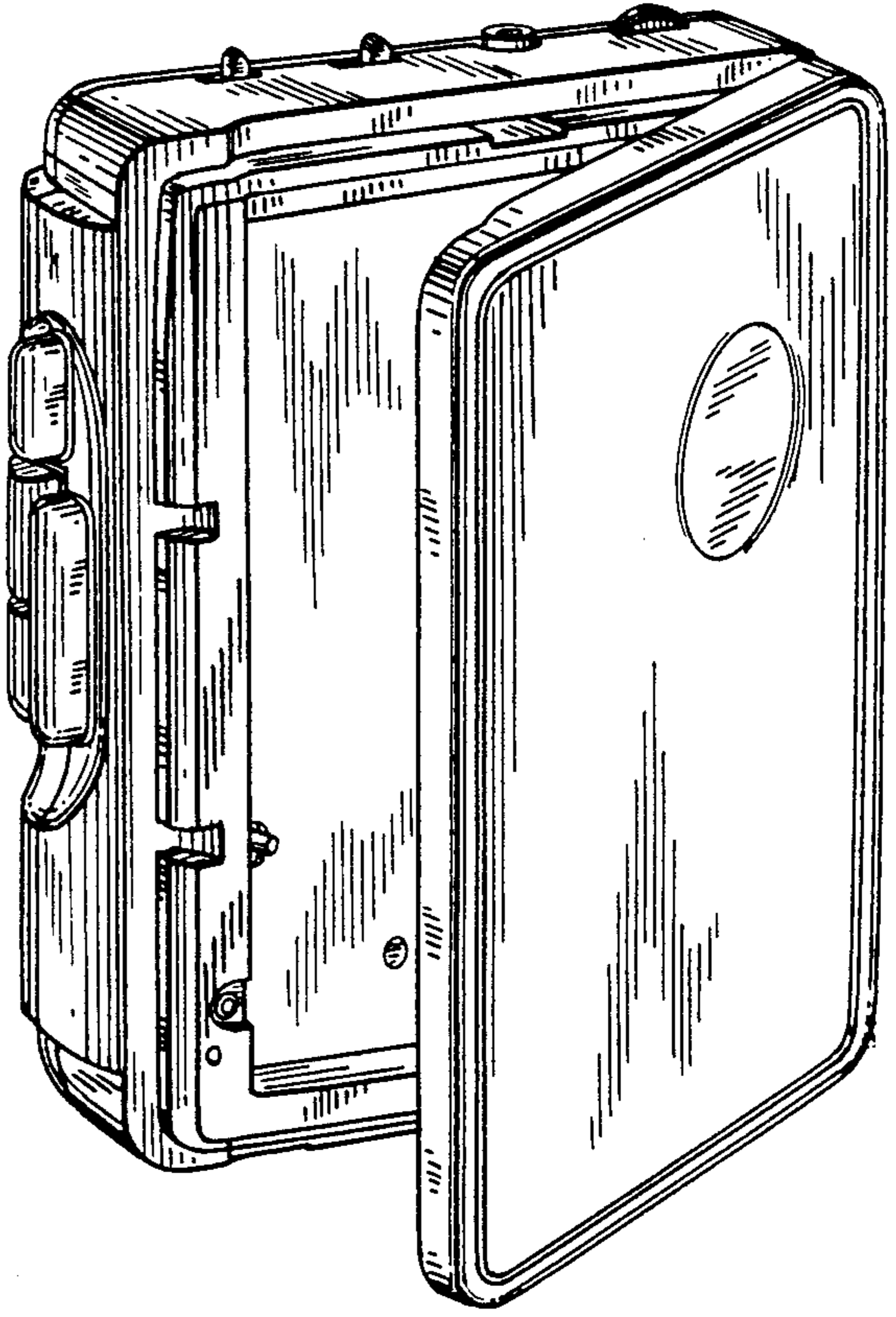
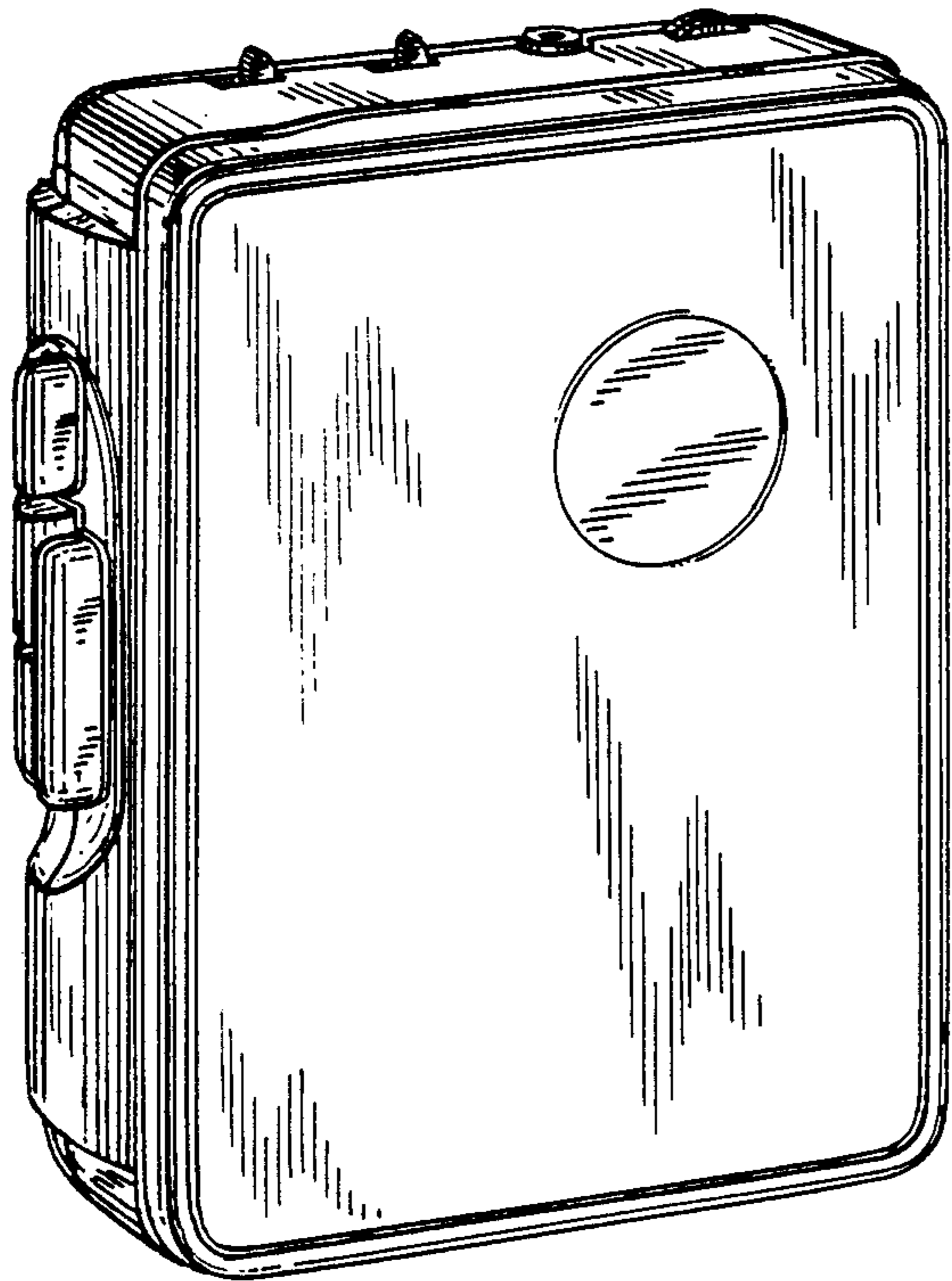

The ornamental design for a tape player, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left-side perspective view of a tape player, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top, front, and left-side perspective view thereof, shown with lid in the opened position; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left-side perspective view thereof; FIG. 6 is a right-side perspective view thereof; FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.



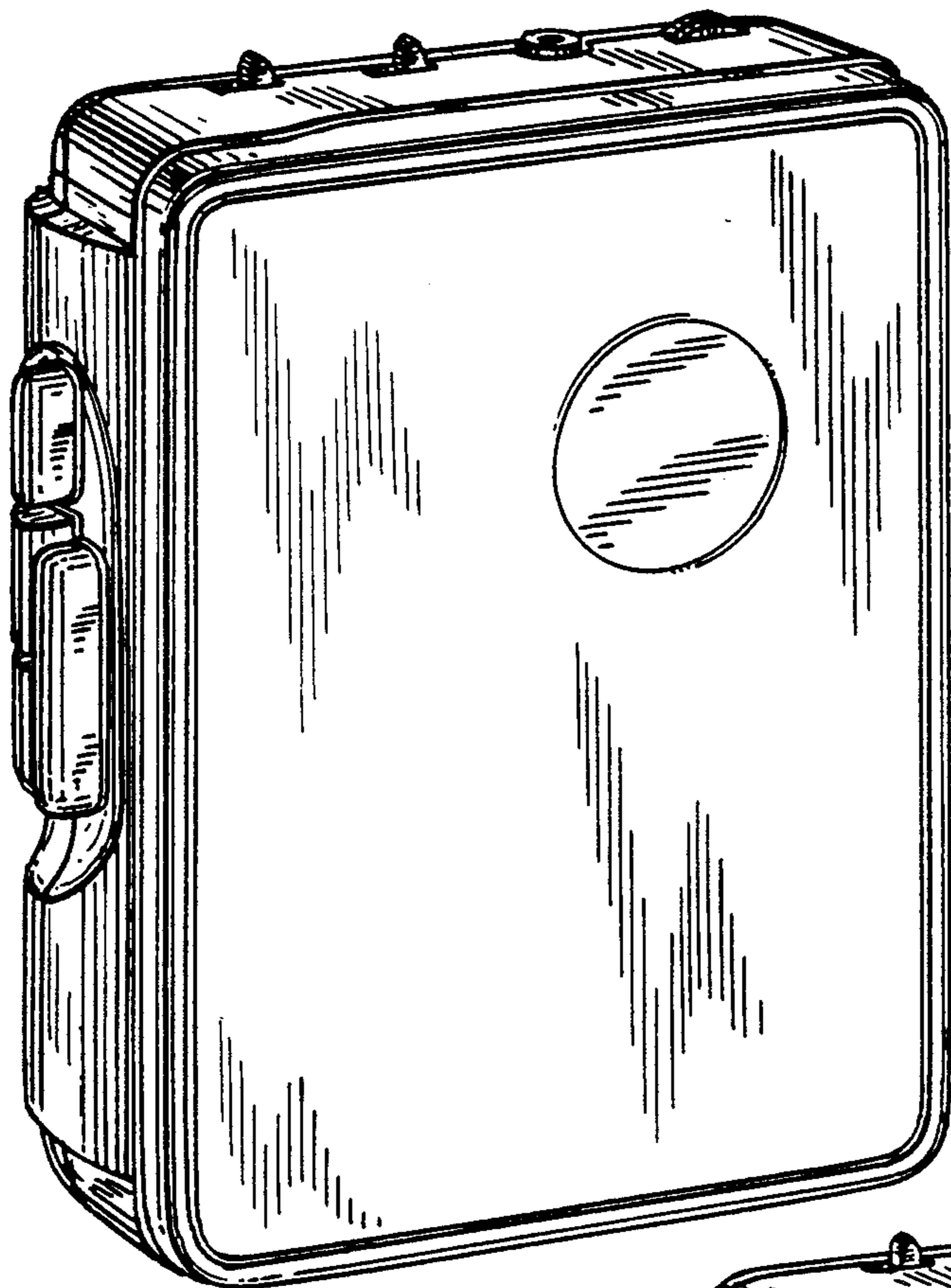

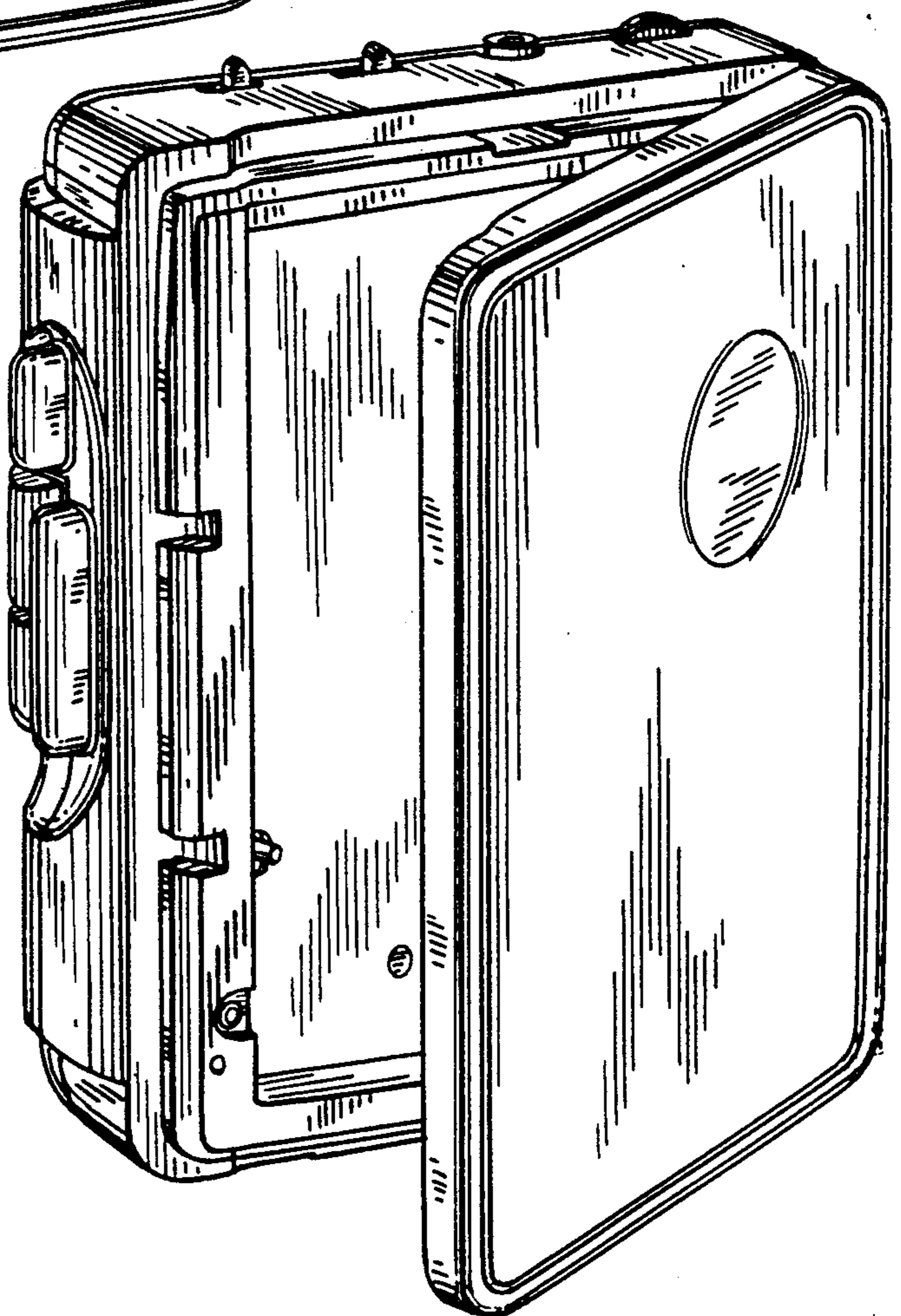

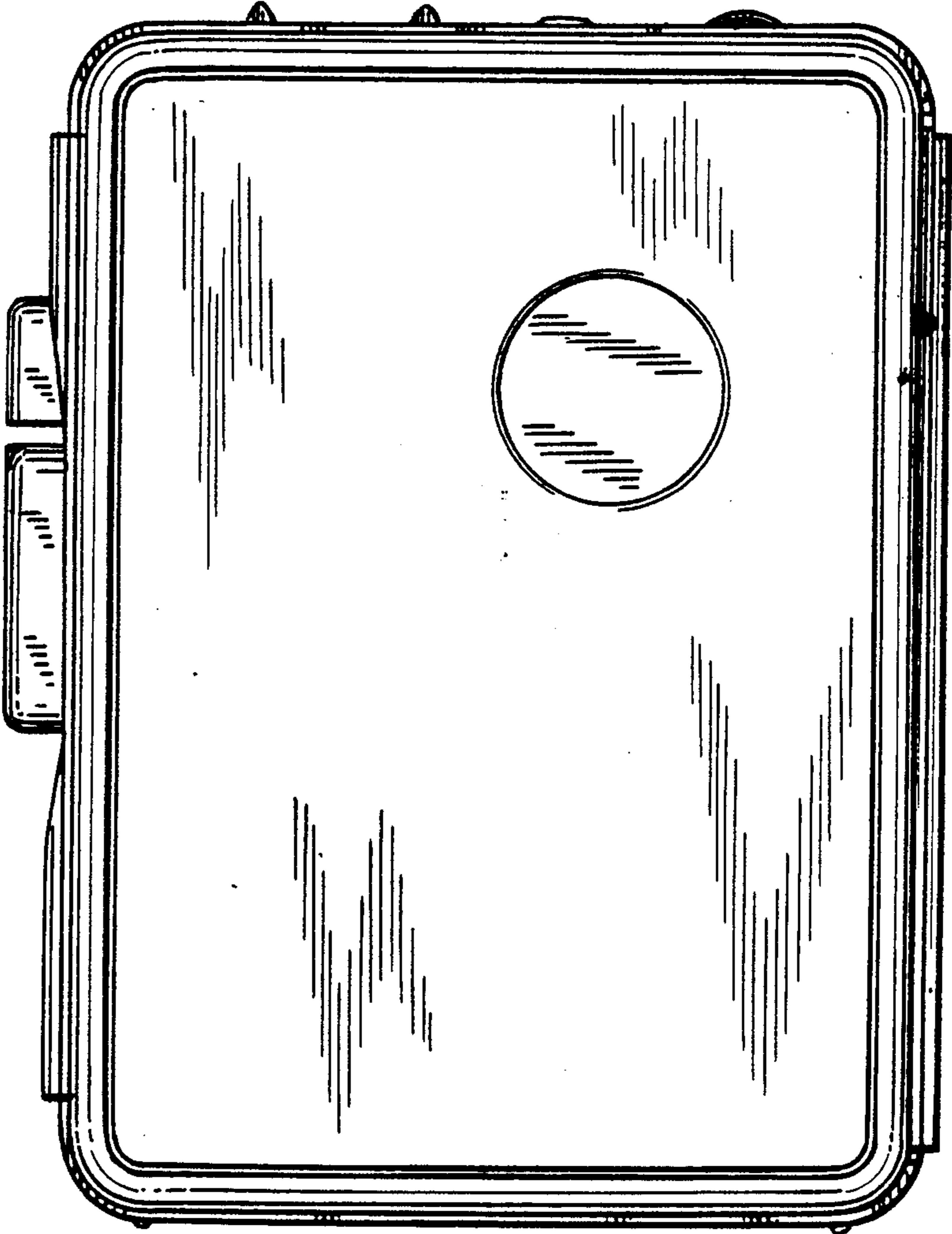

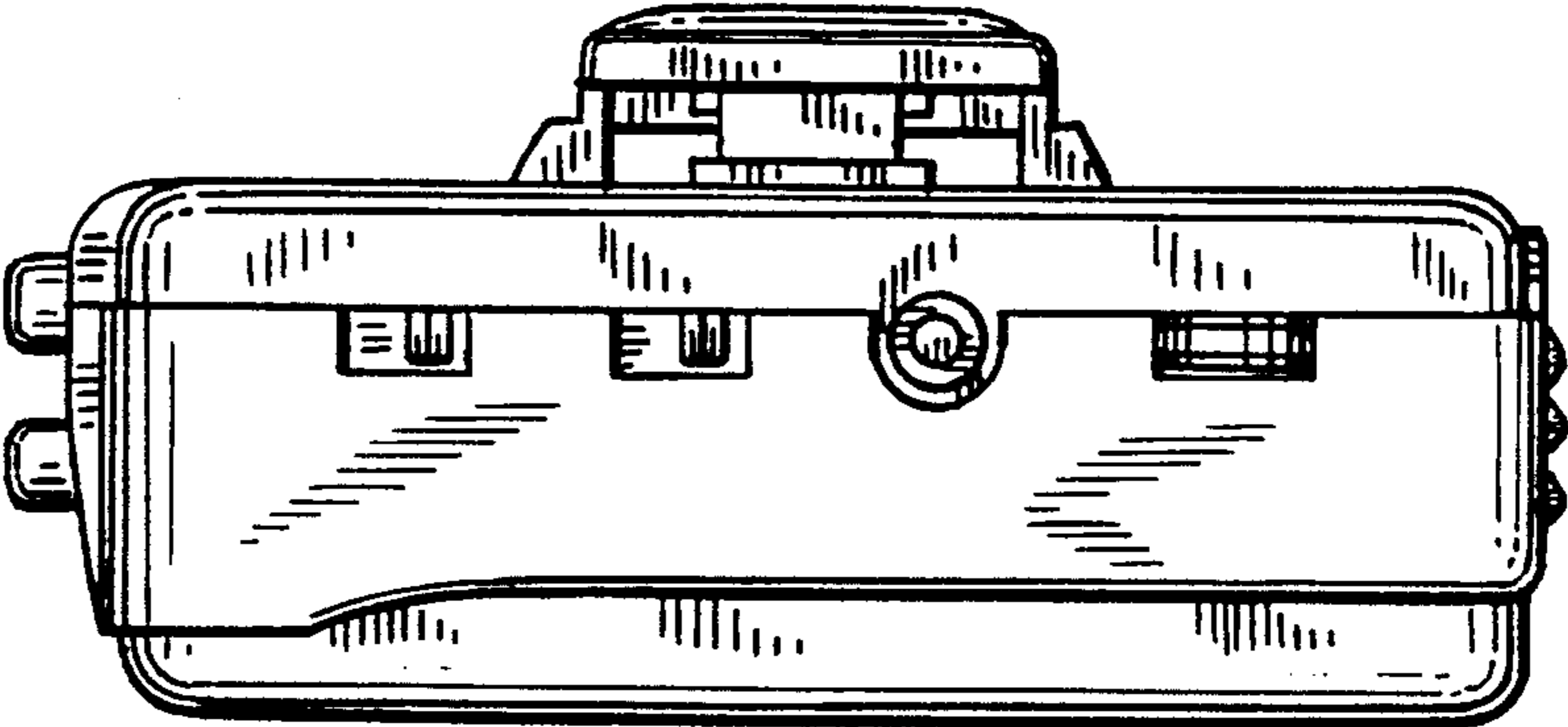

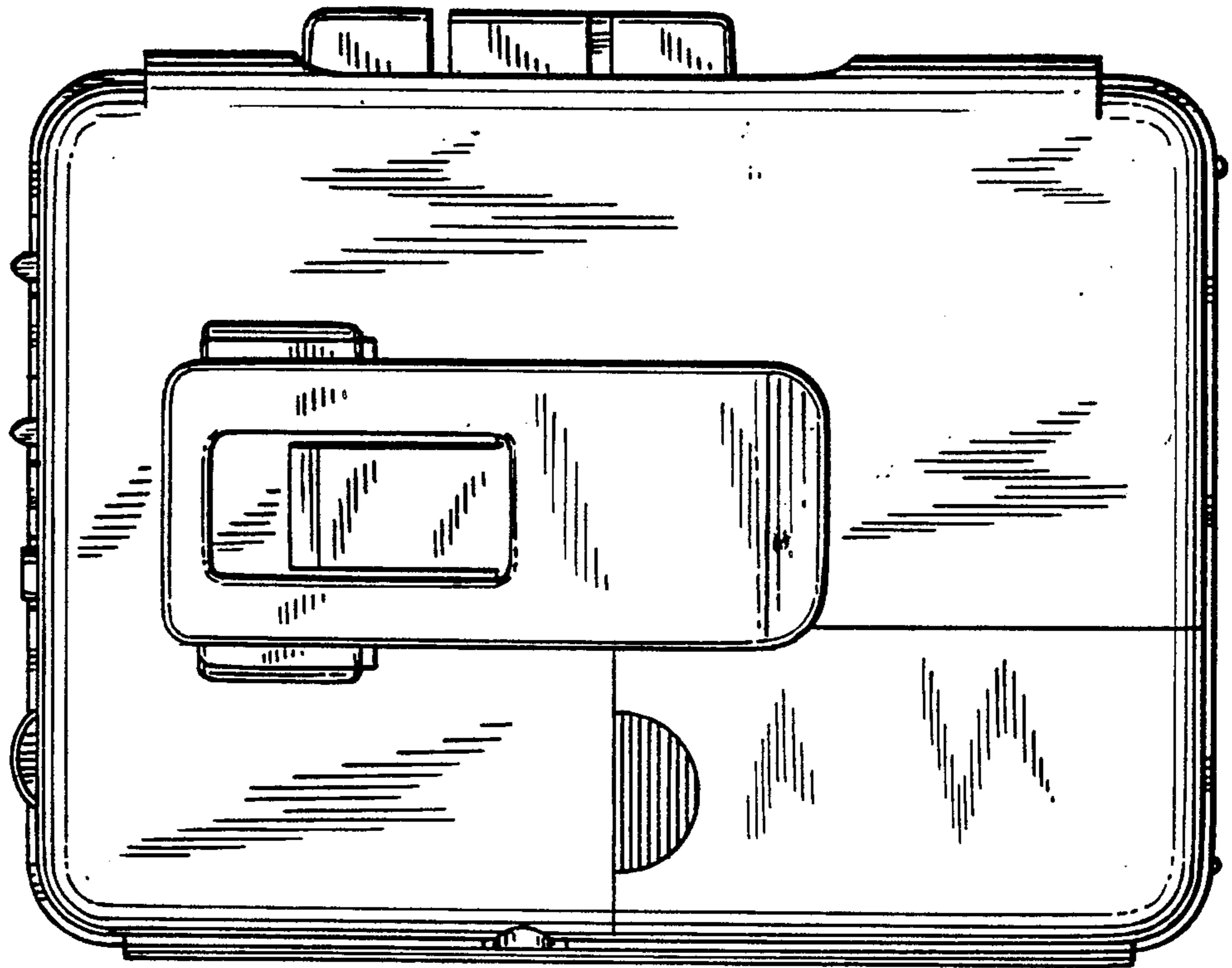
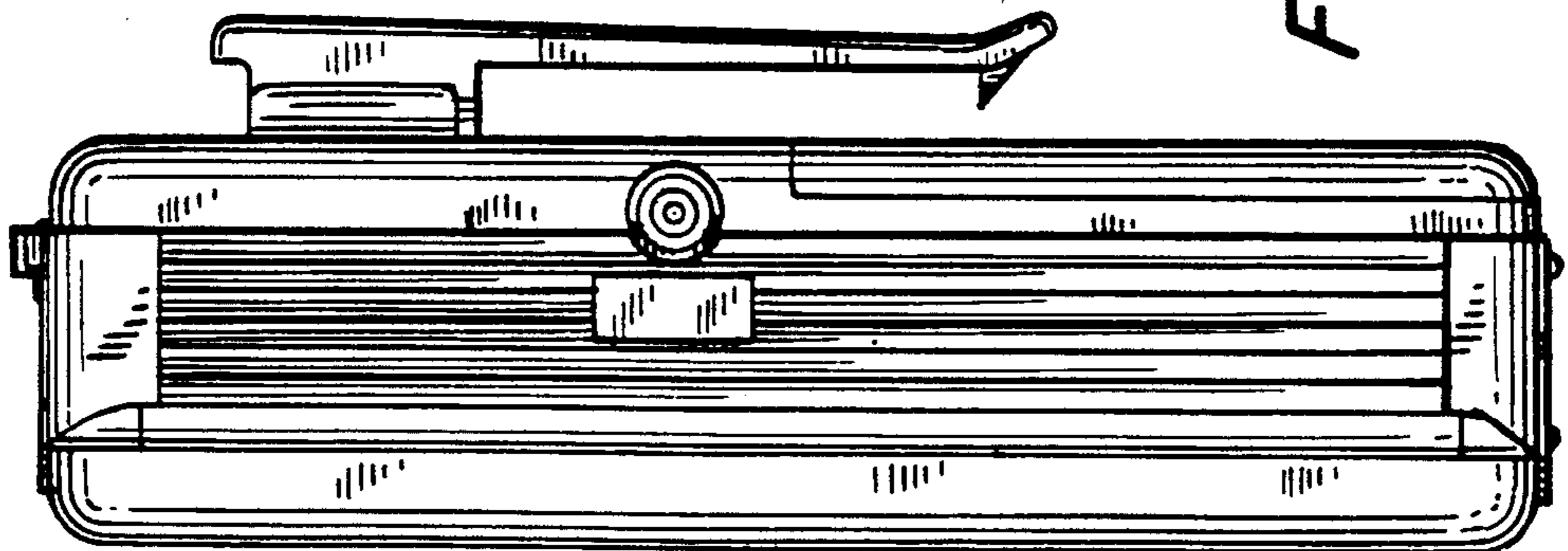

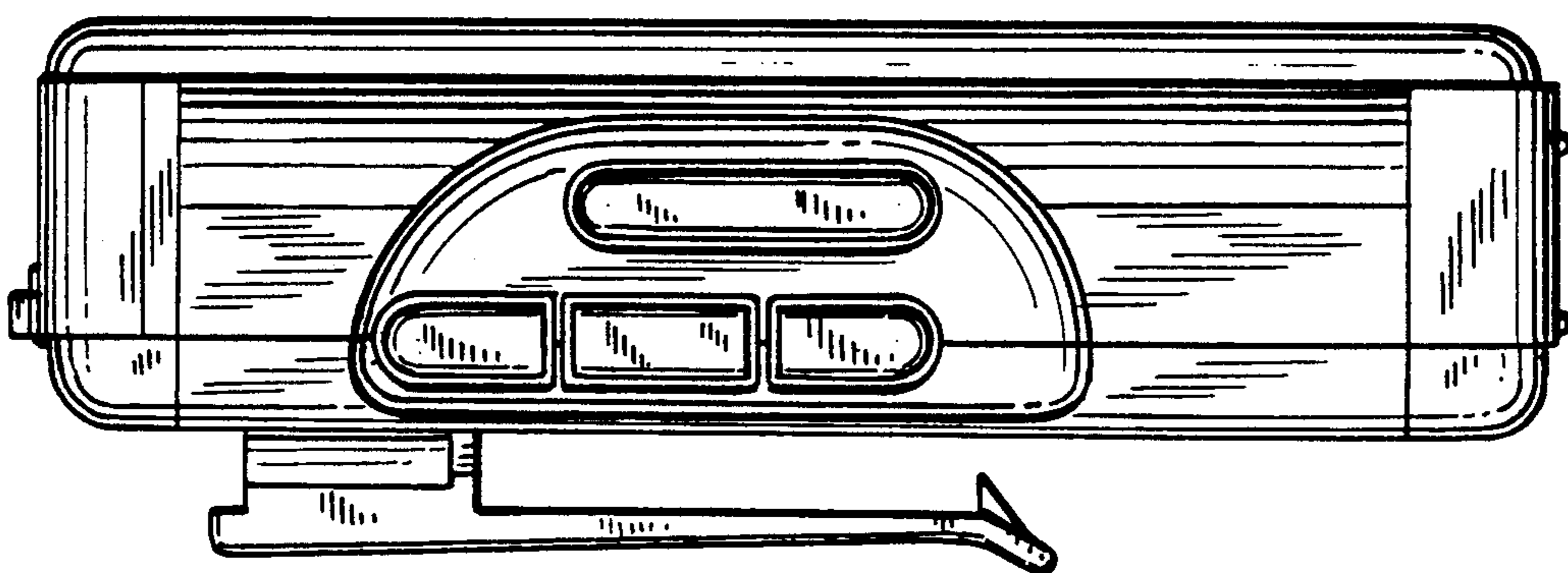

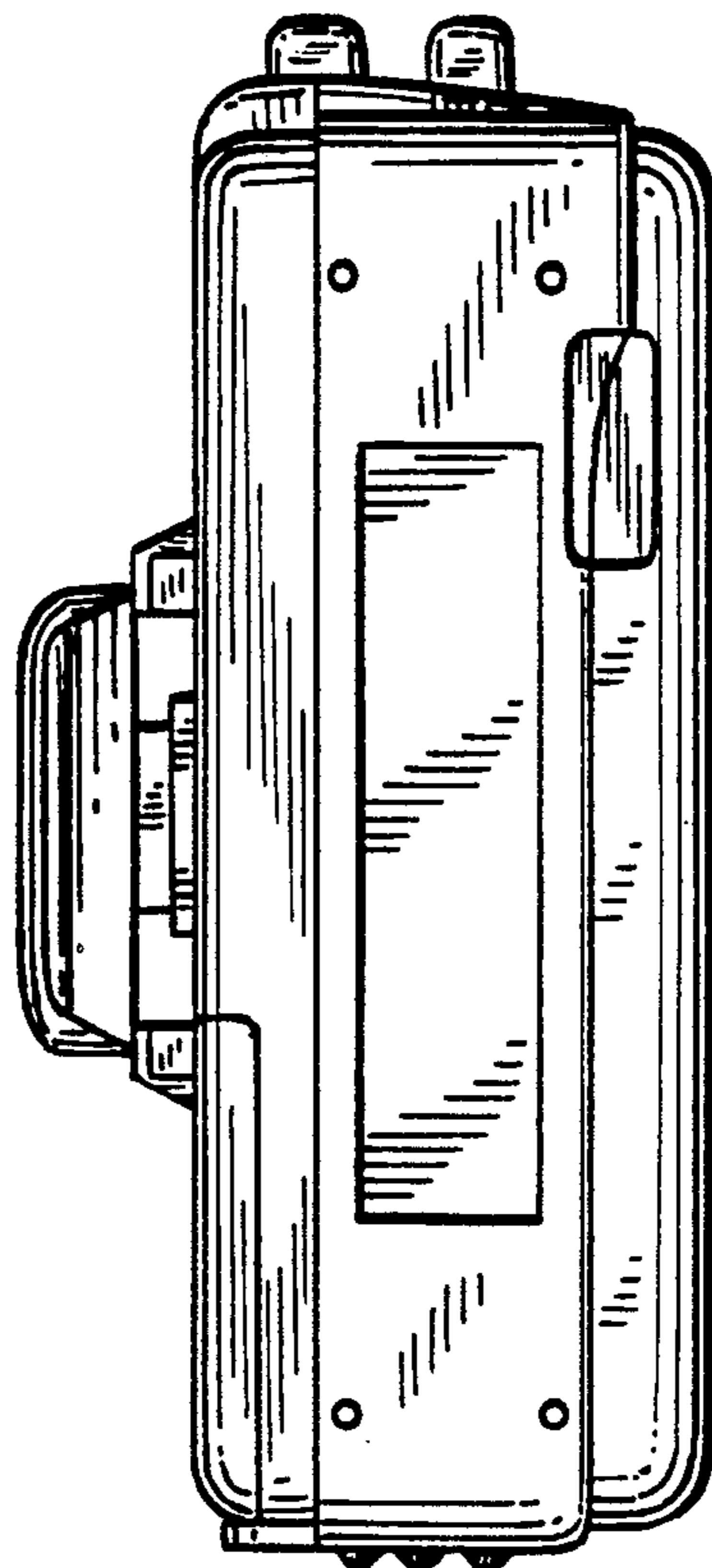
