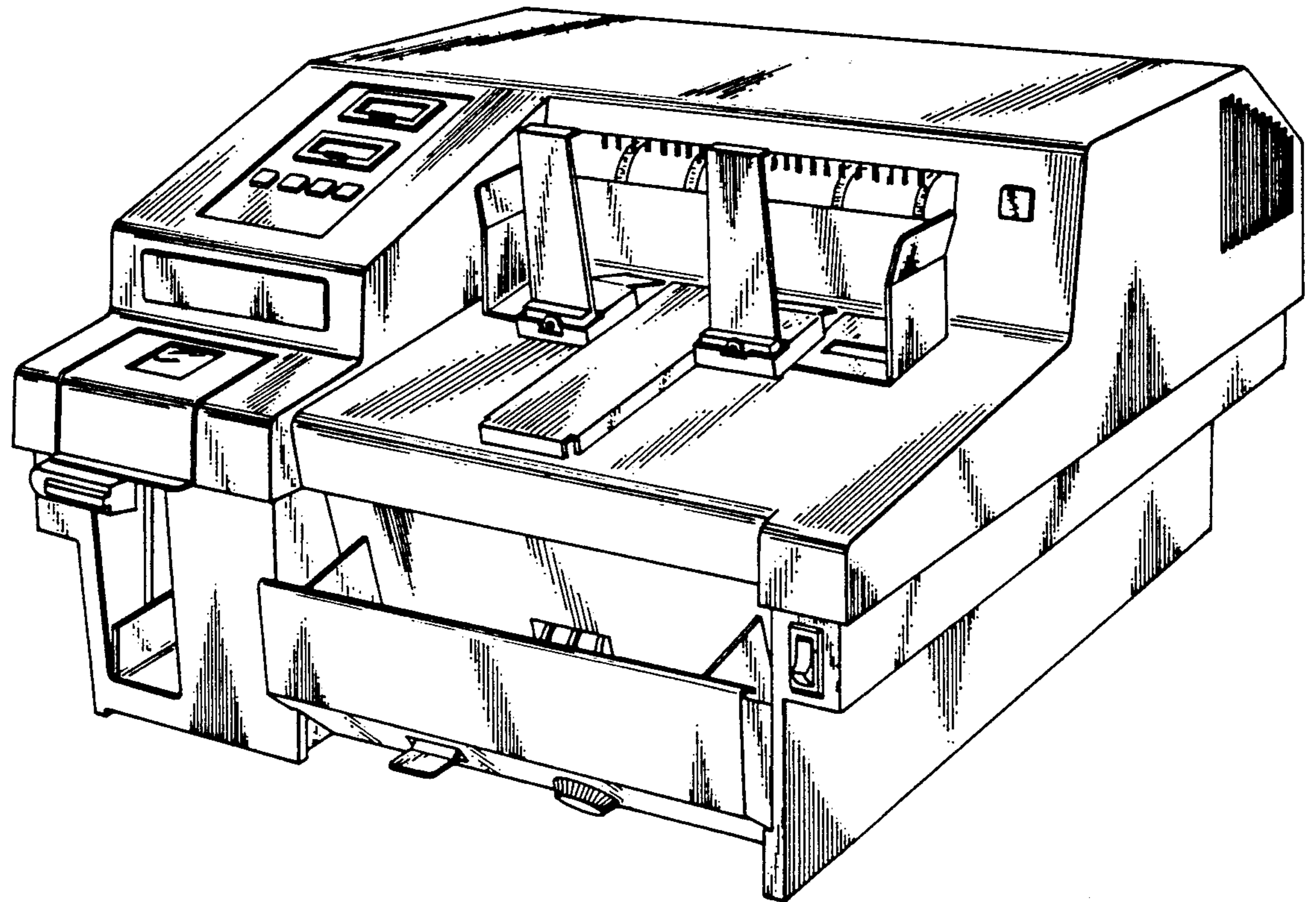

FIG. 2 is a rear, top and left side perspective view thereof.



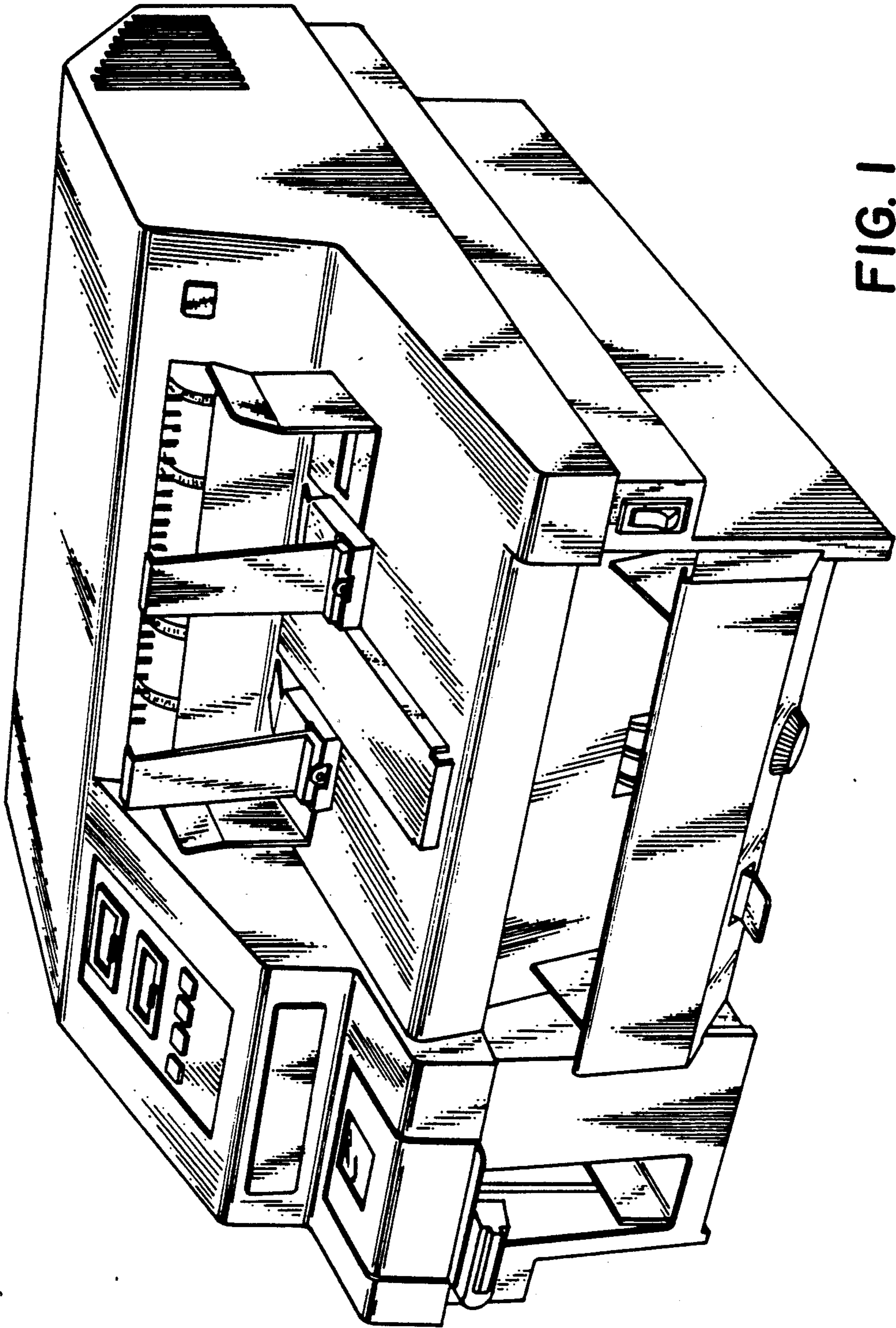

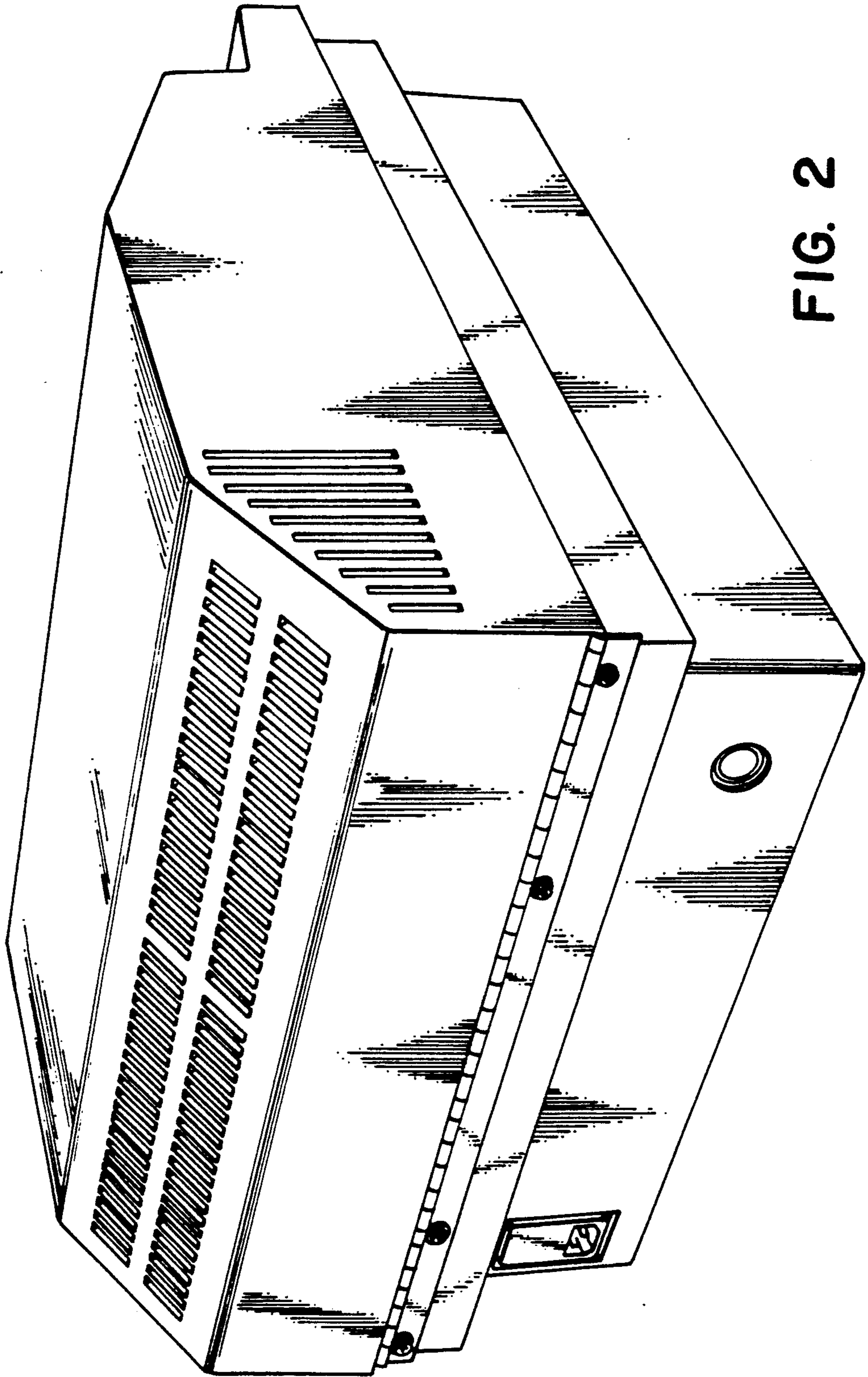
