FIG. 1 is a top right, front perspective view of a writing instrument stand showing my new design;

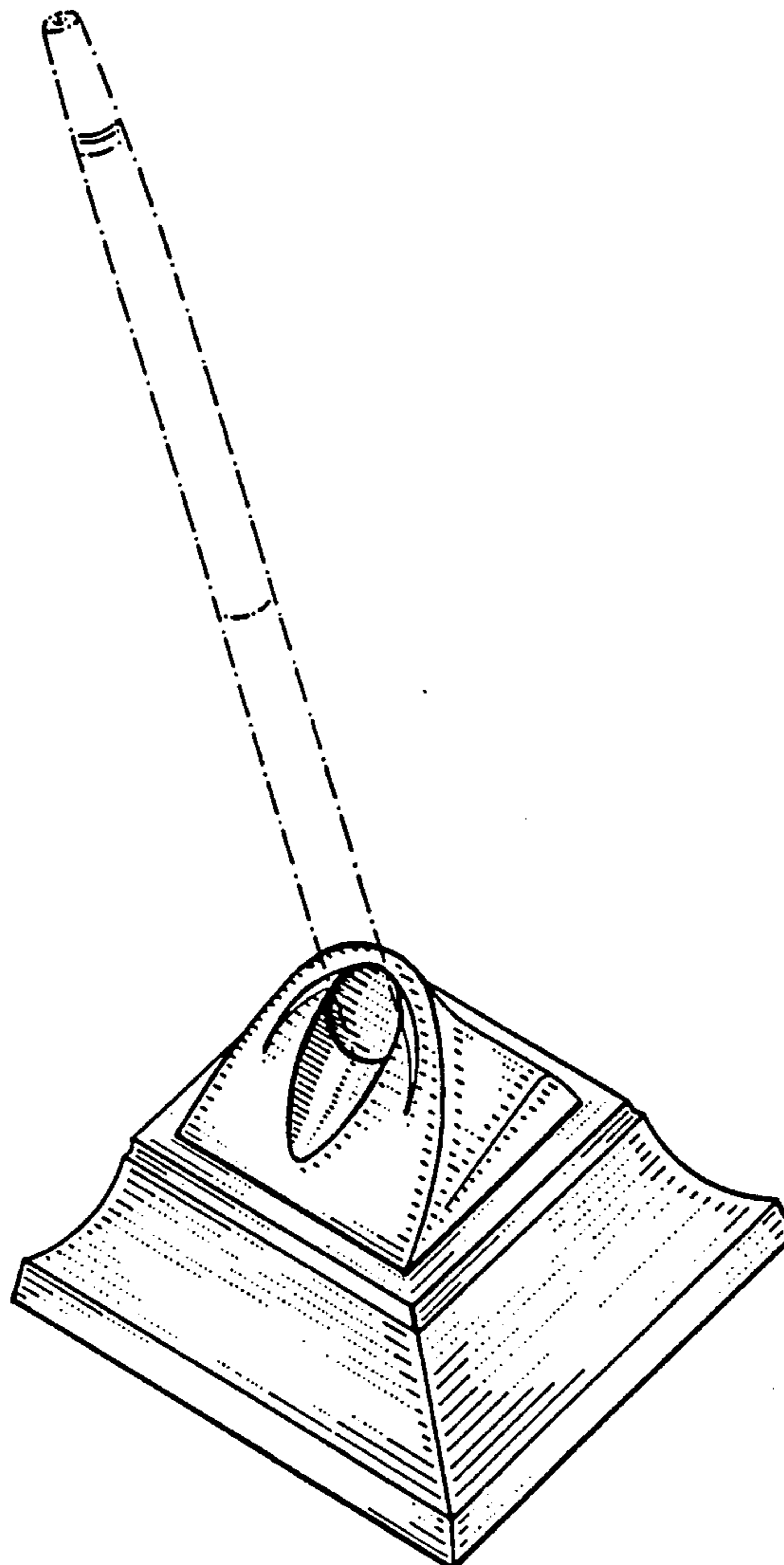
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

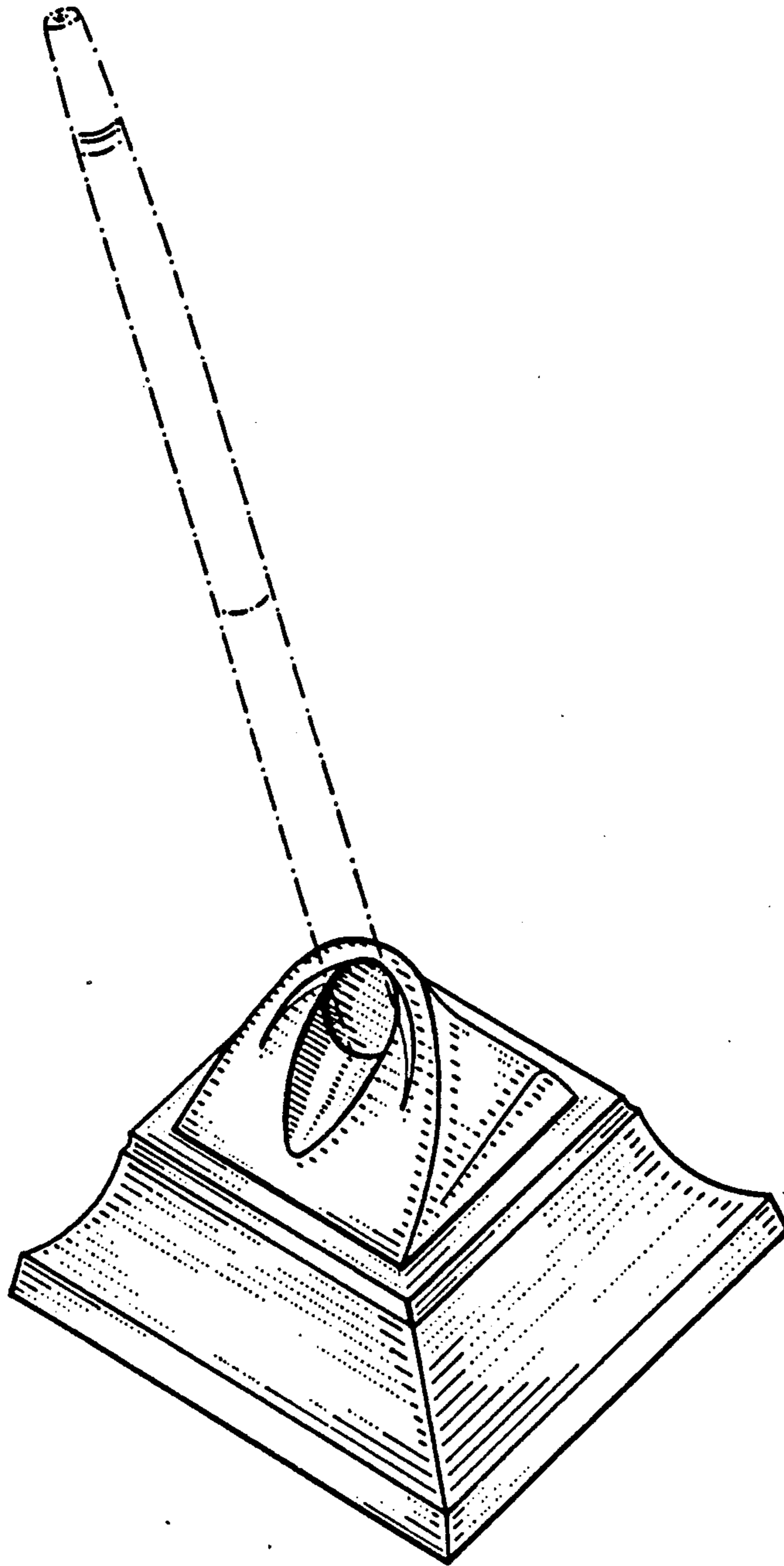

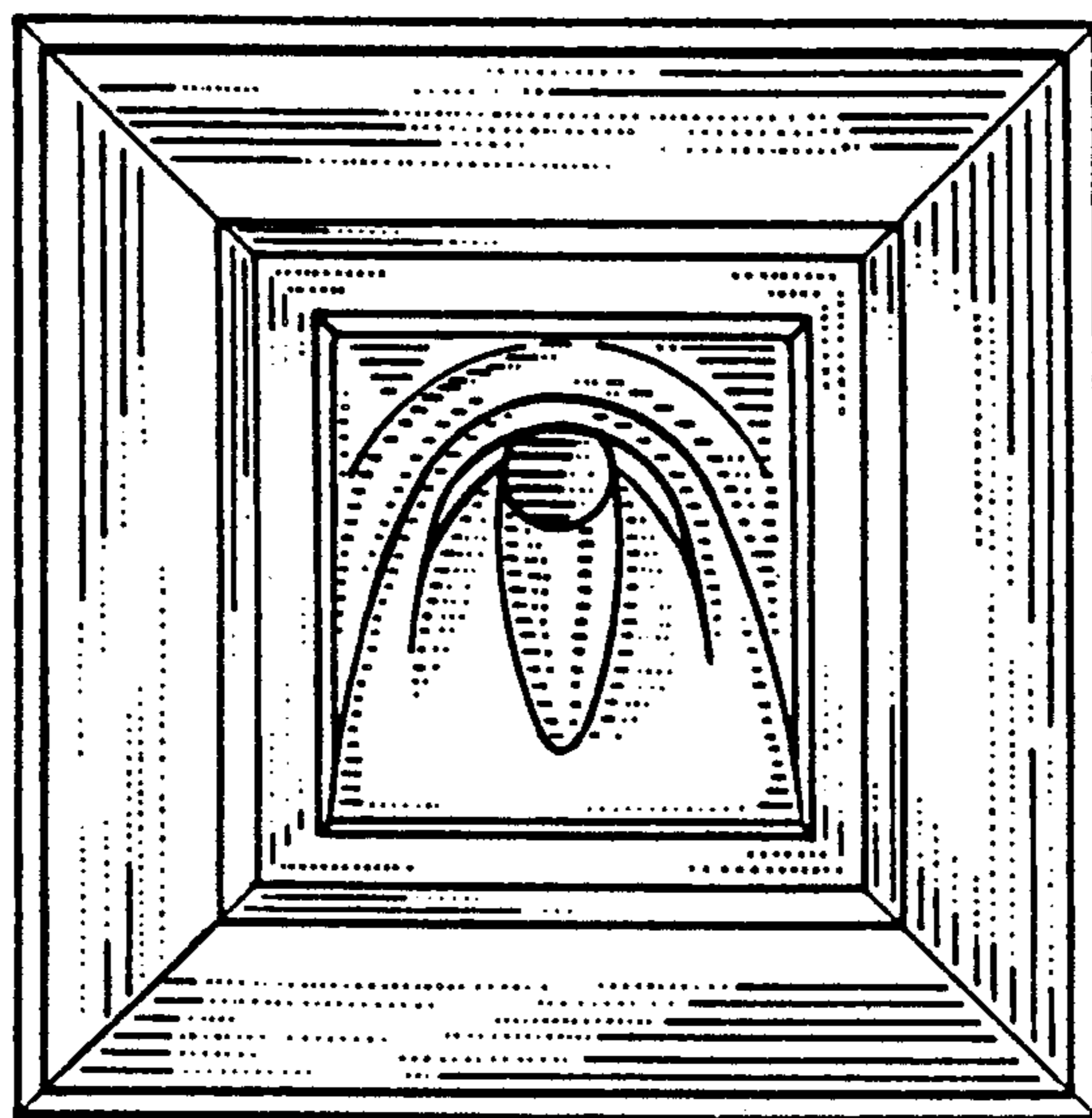

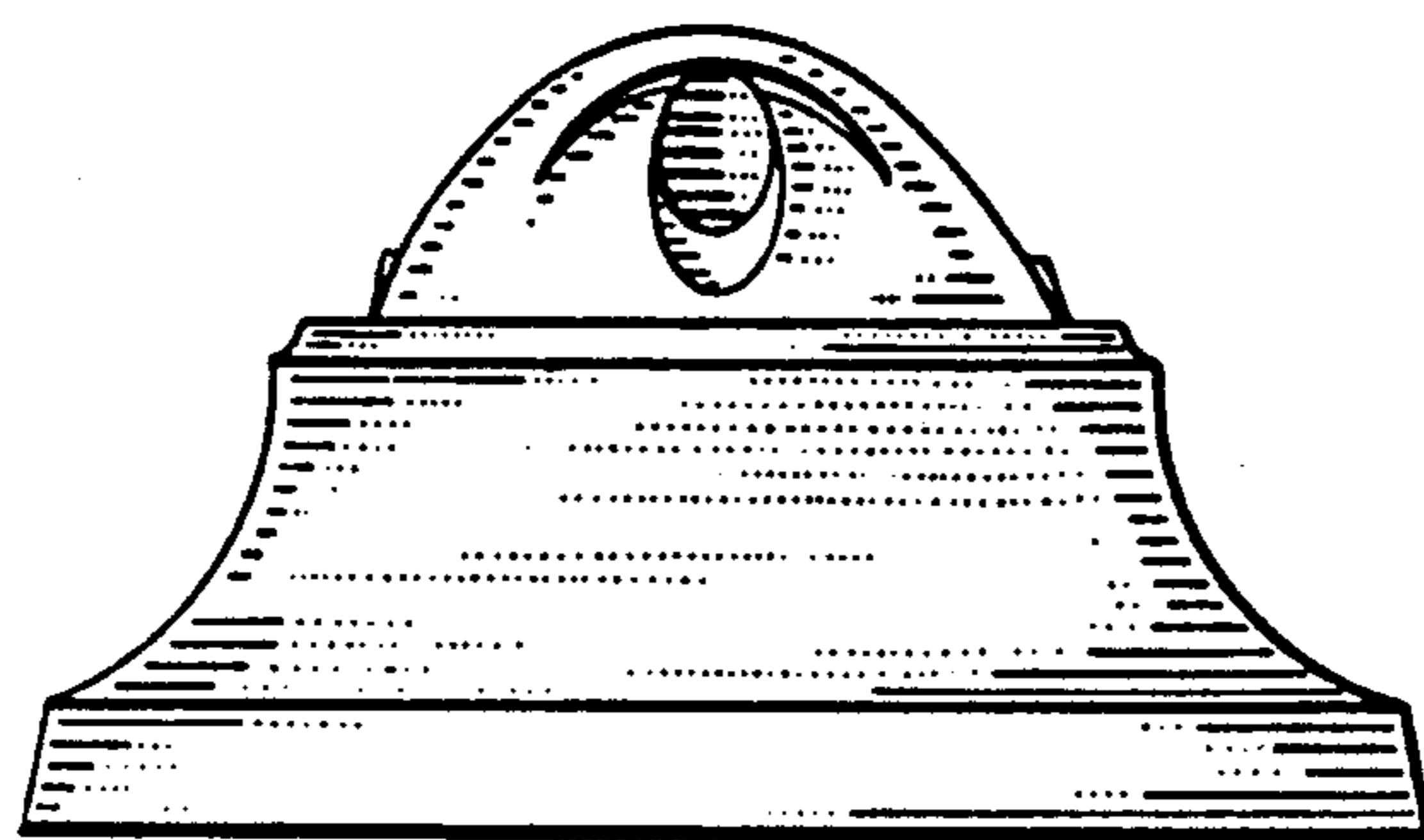

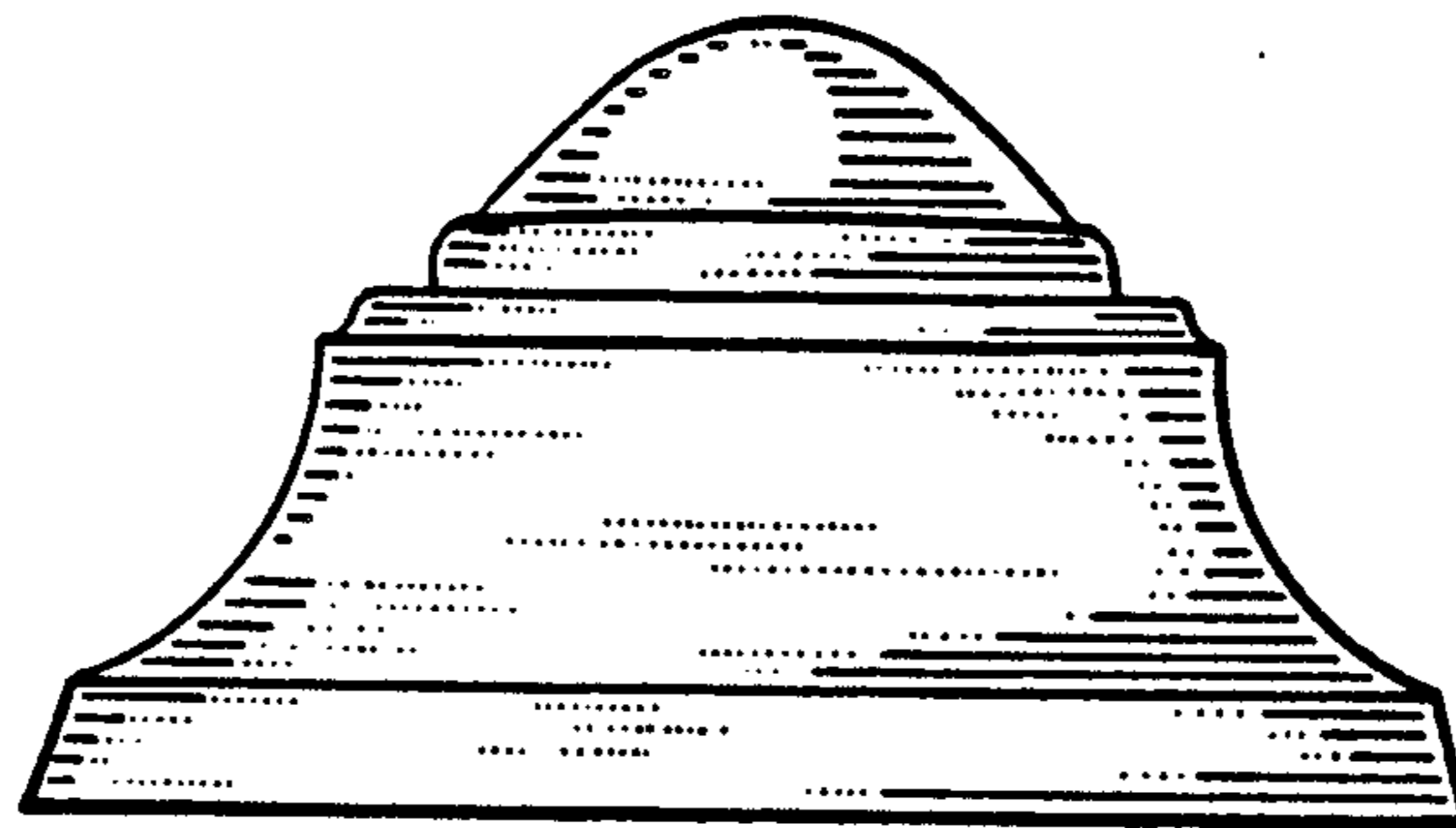

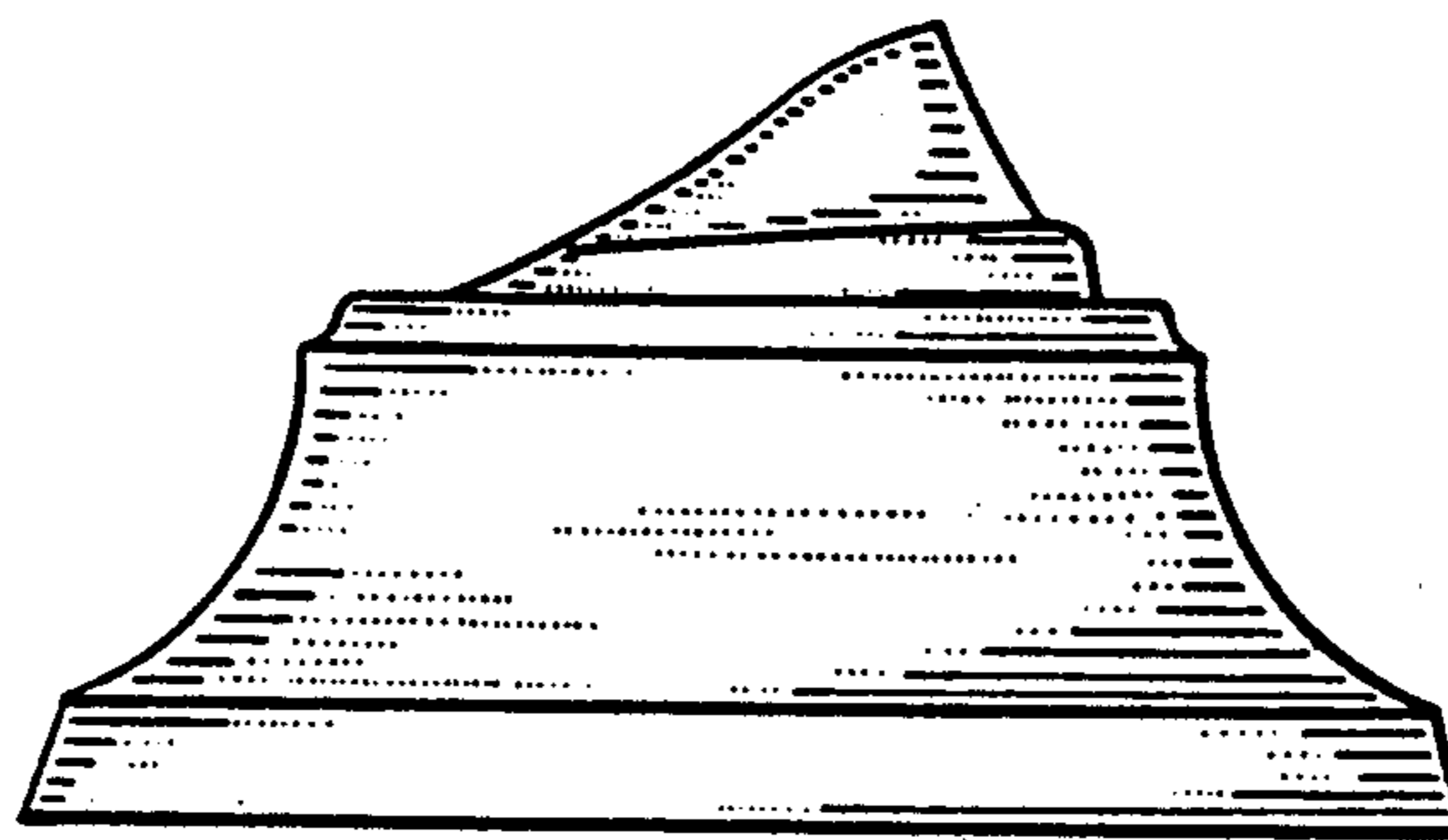
