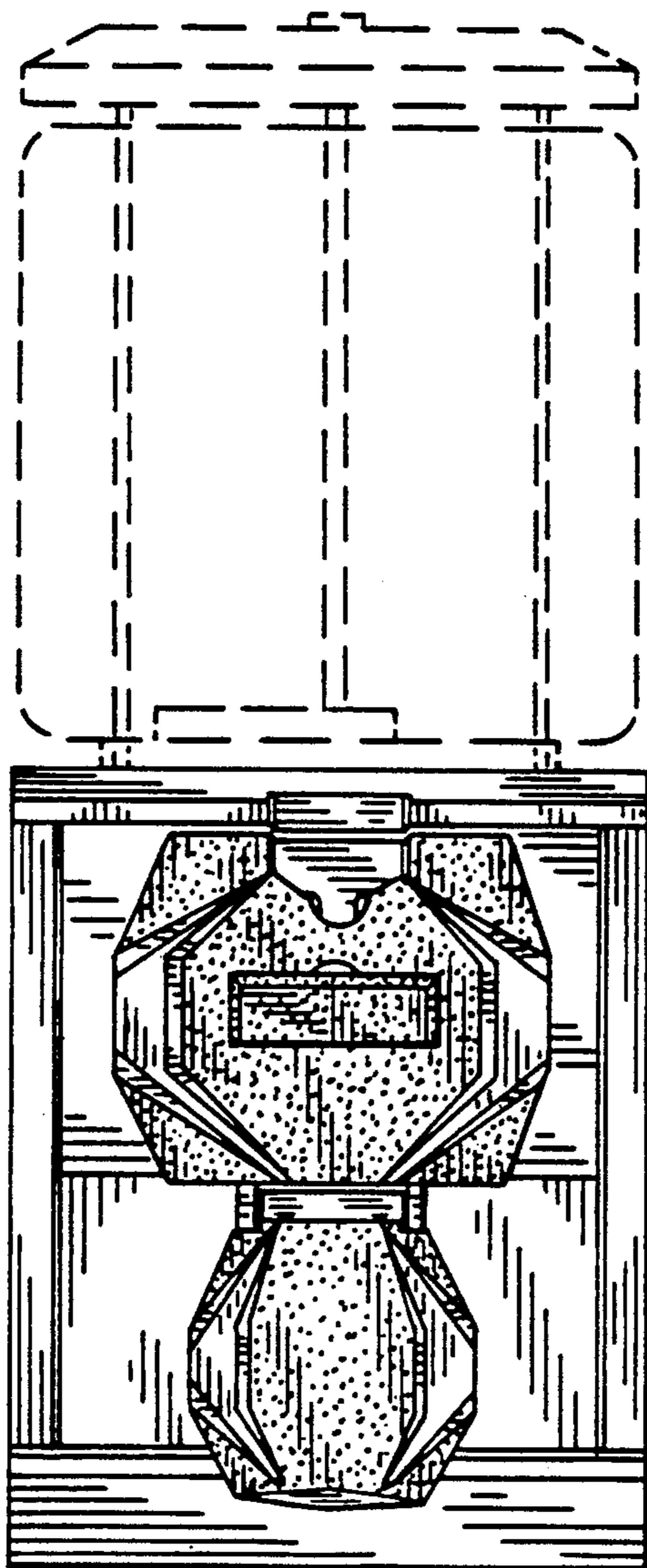

[57] **CLAIM**
 The ornamental design for a base for a coin operated bulk-vending machine, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a base for a coin operated bulk-vending machine showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof.
 The broken line showing of the merchandise reservoir is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design. The back and side of the machine, not illustrated, are substantially unornamented.



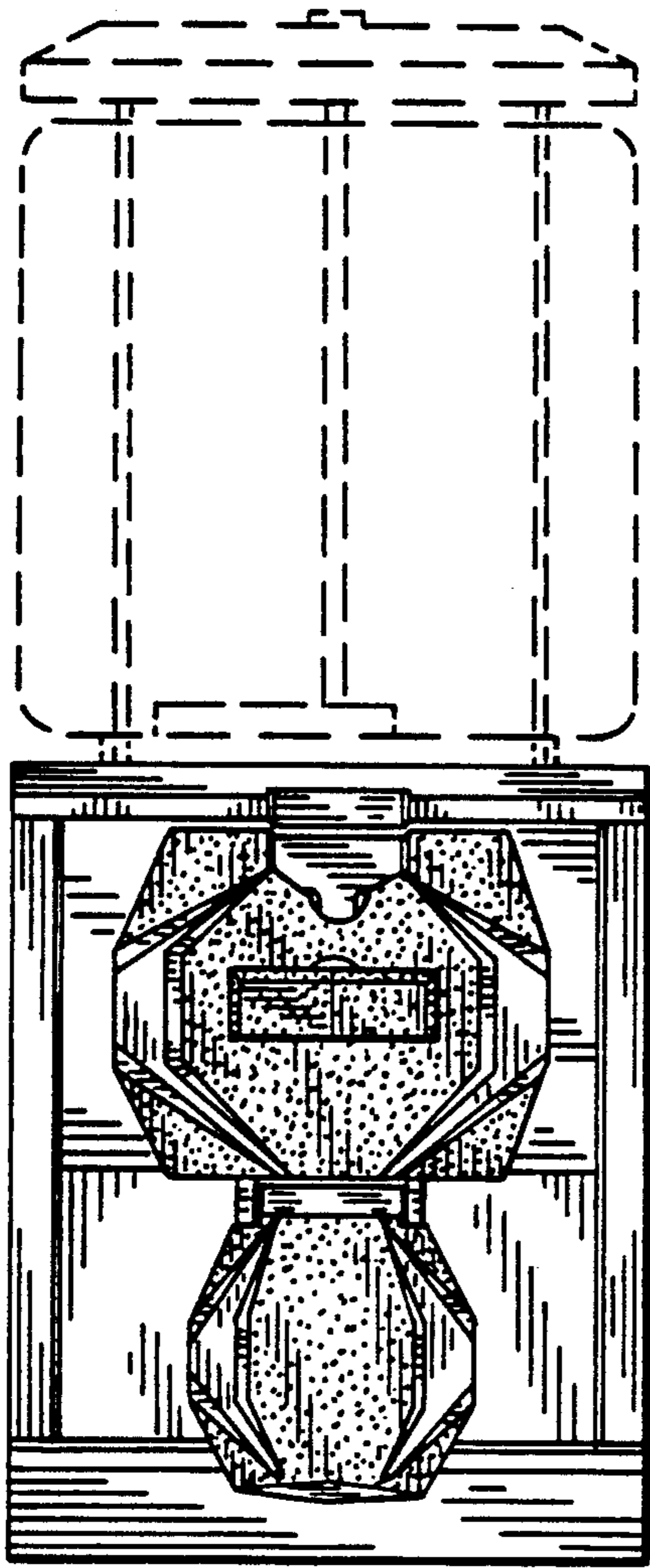

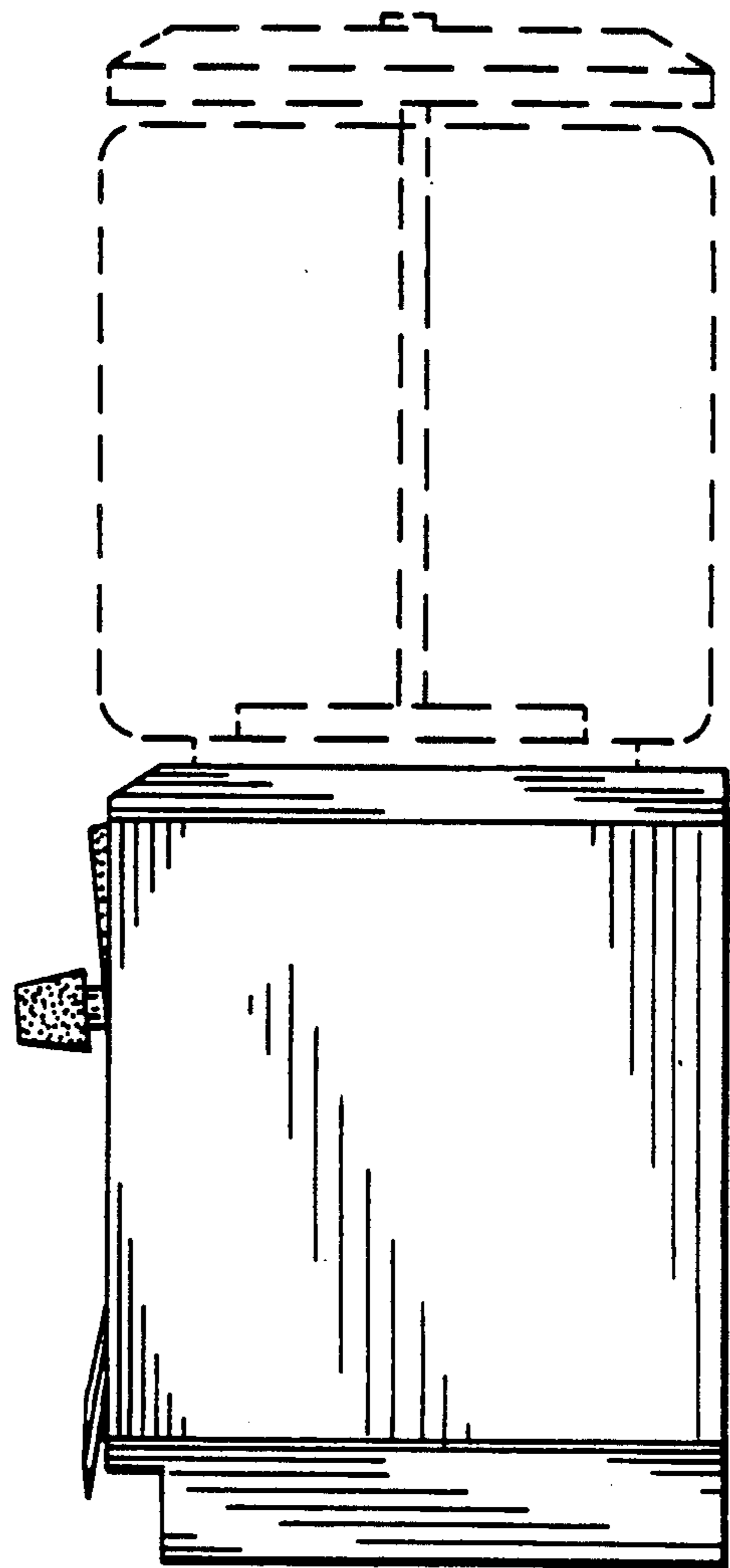
