[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lavatory or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a lavatory or similar article embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown;

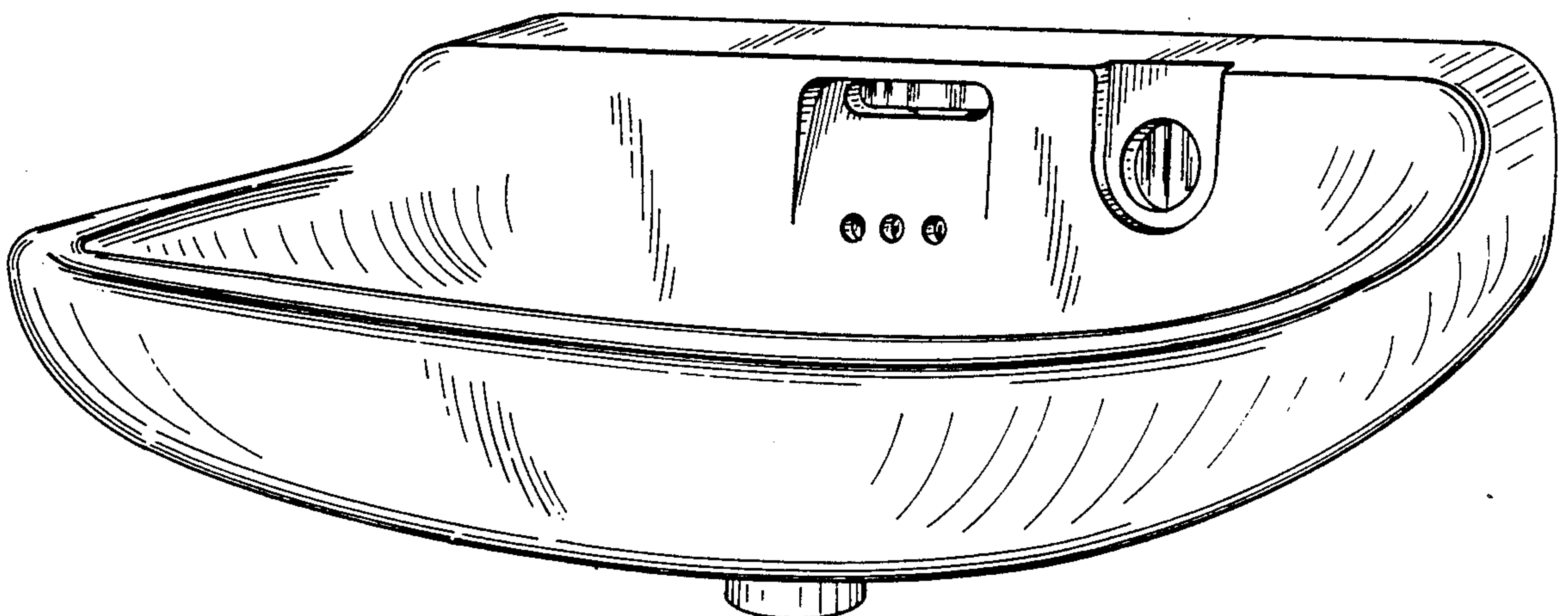
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a cross sectional view taken on line 8—8 of FIG. 1.



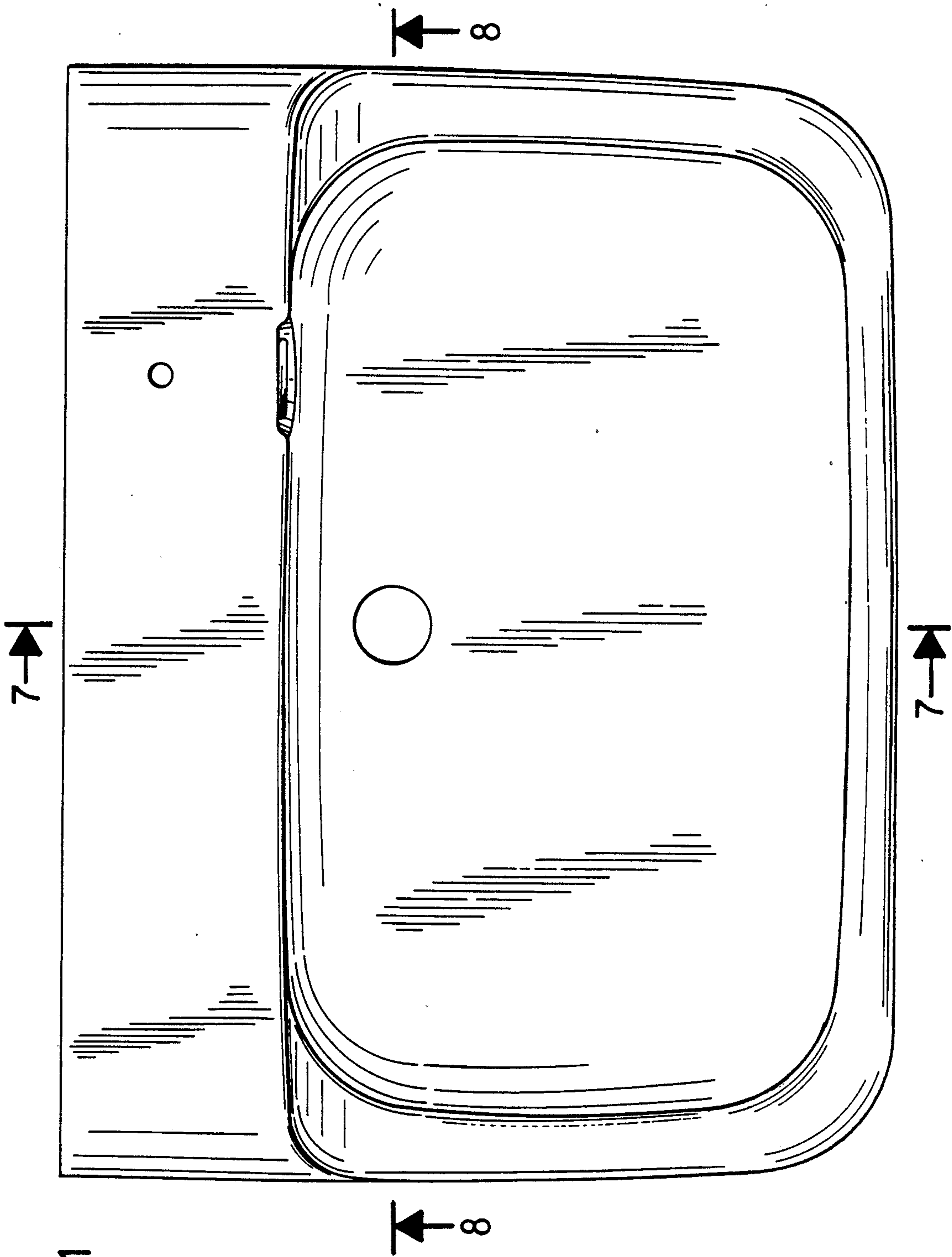

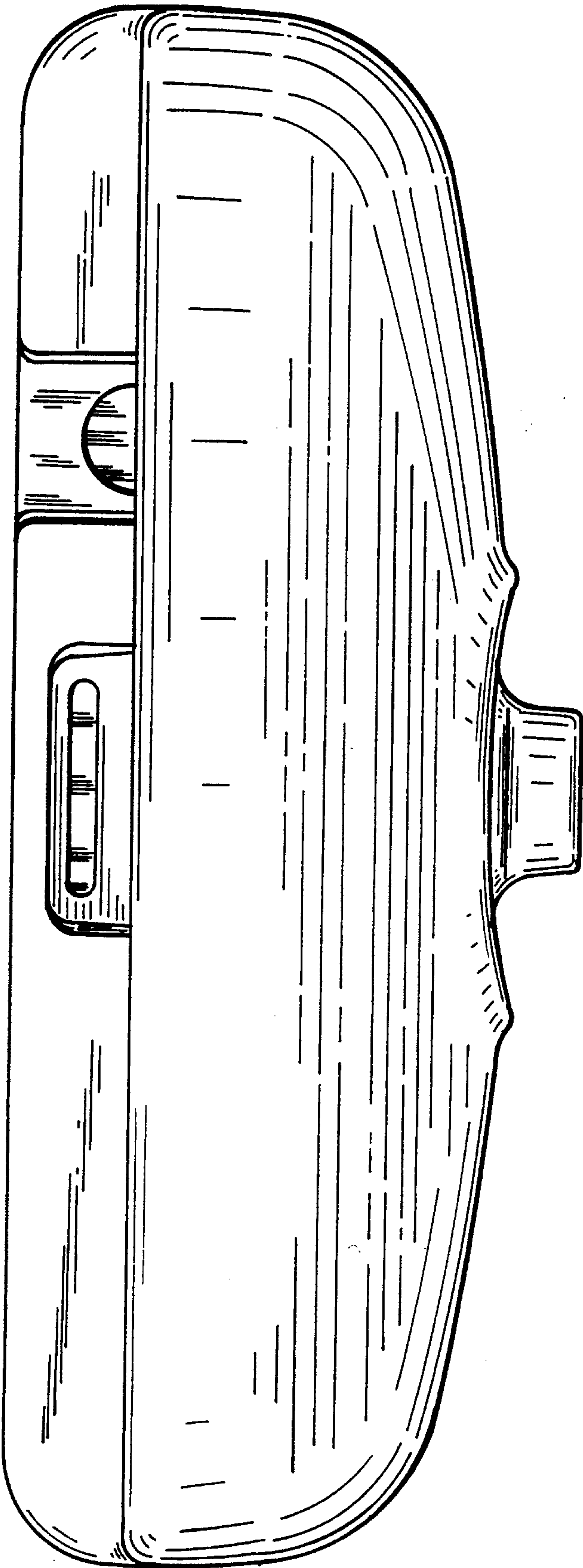
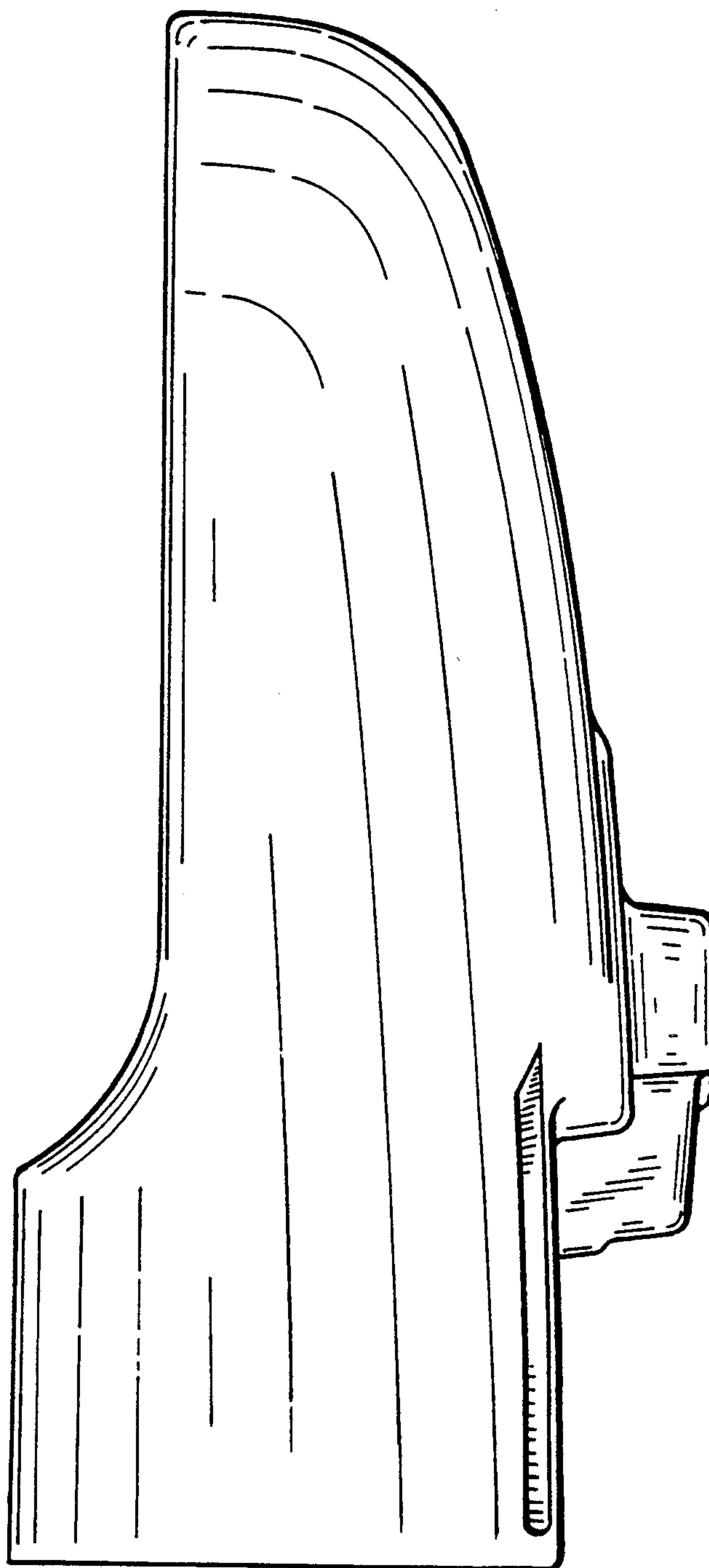

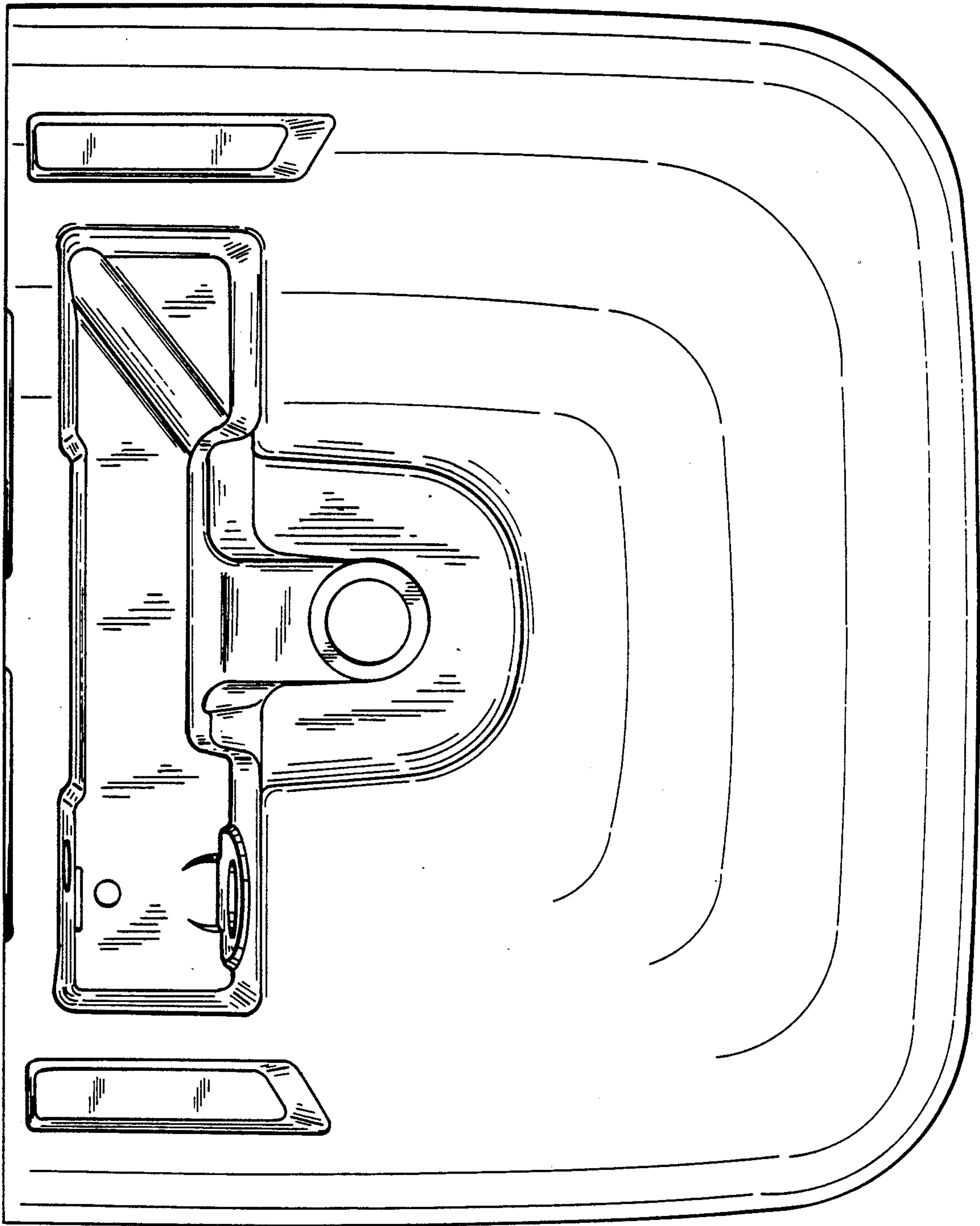

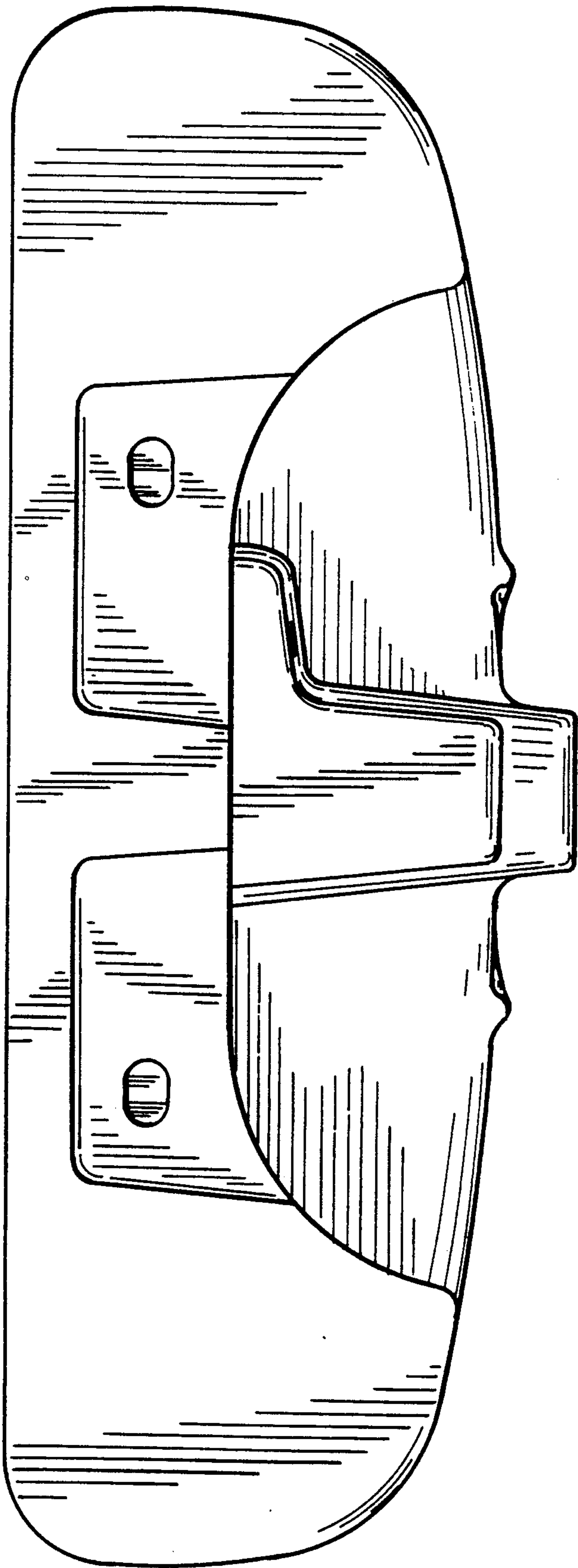

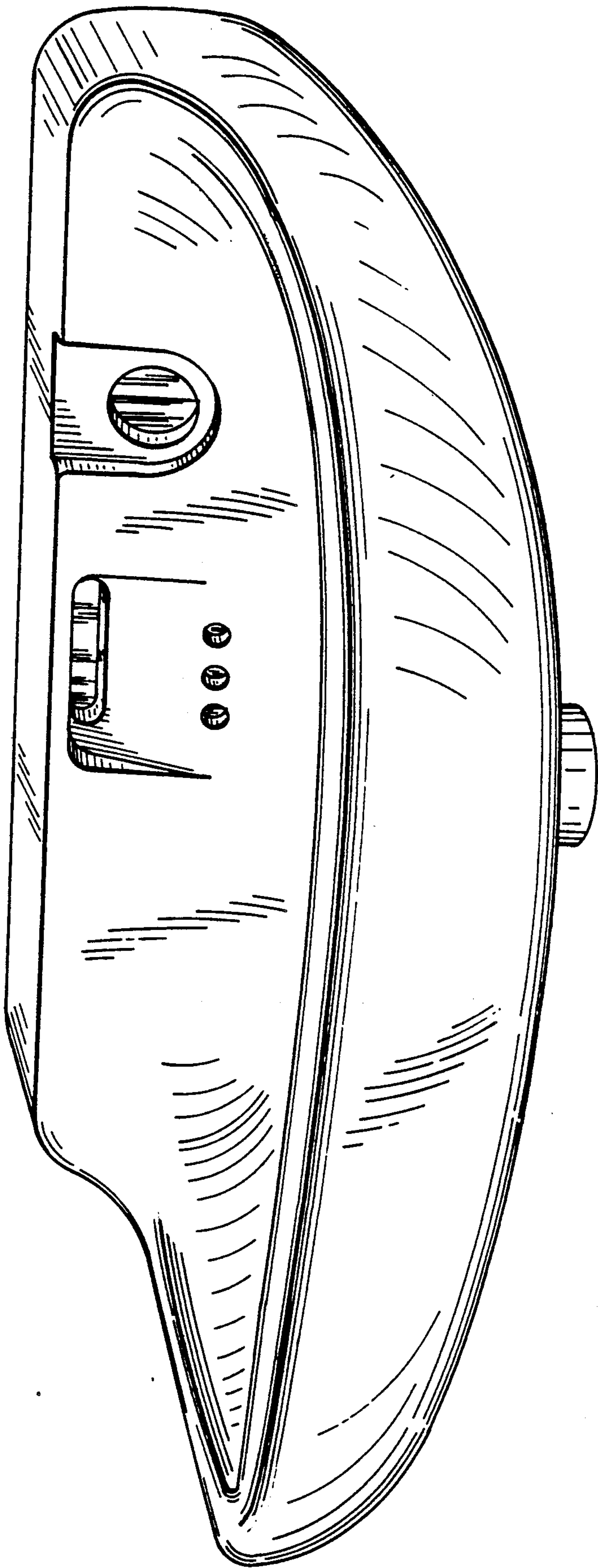

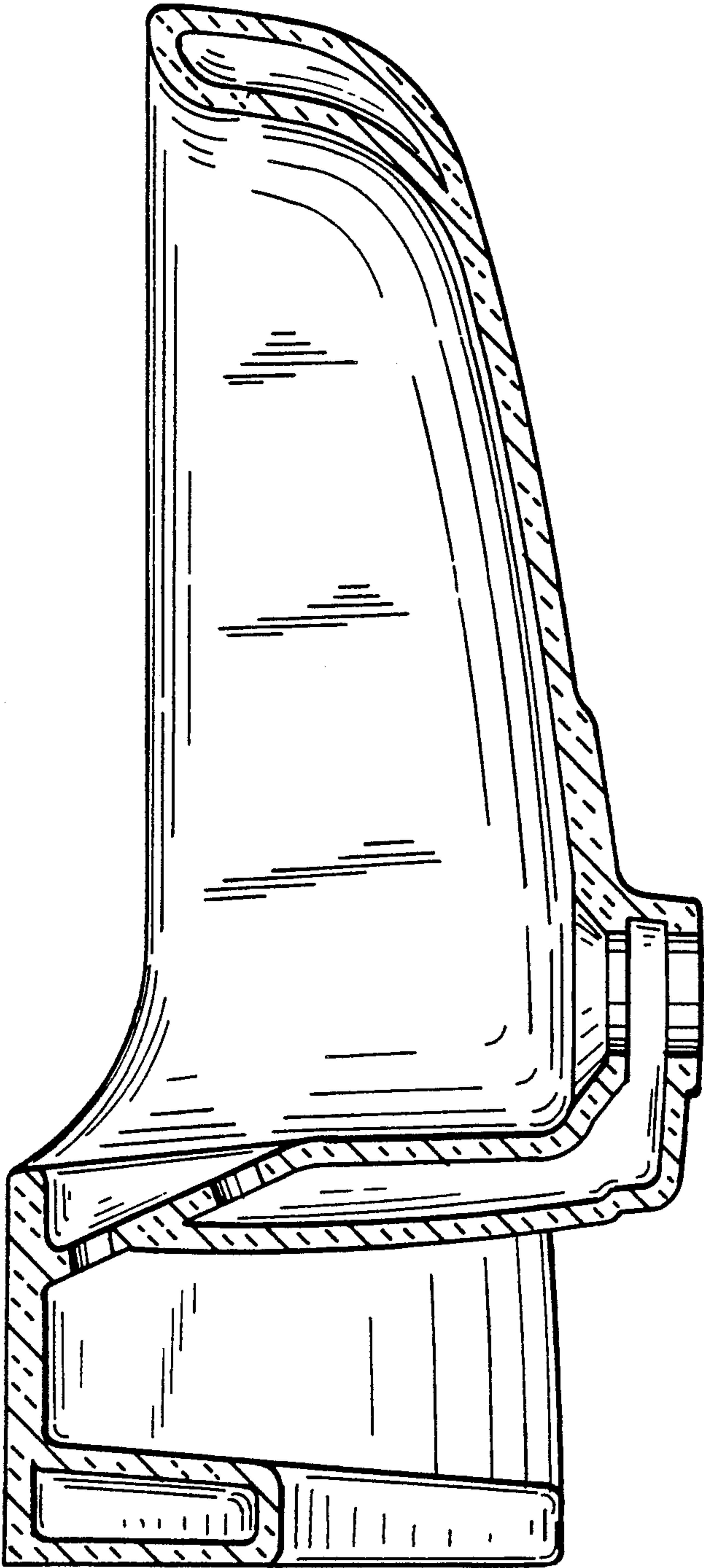
