[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a collapsible multi-function lamp, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a collapsible multi-function lamp showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being identical;

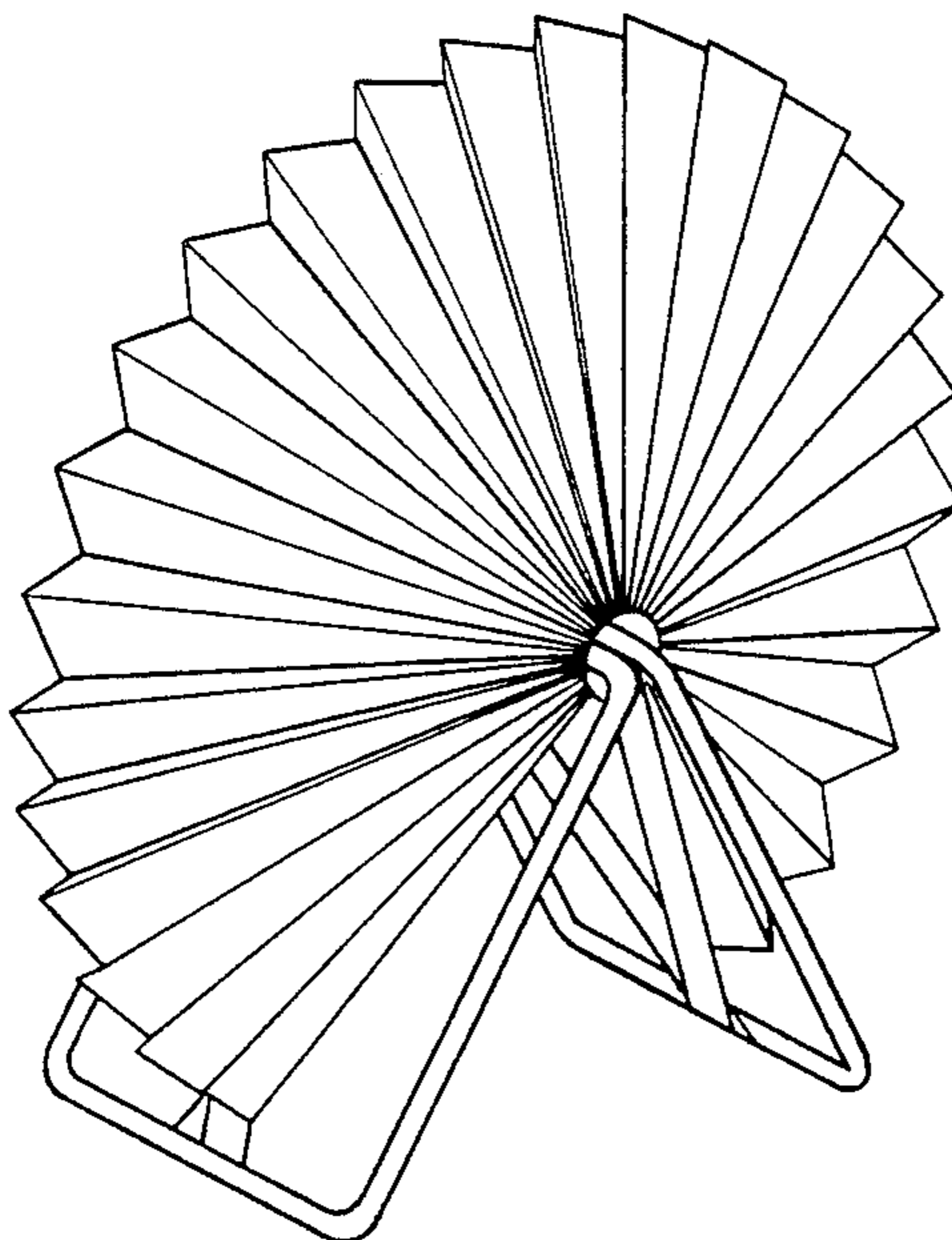
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being identical;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the lamp in a closed, folded position.



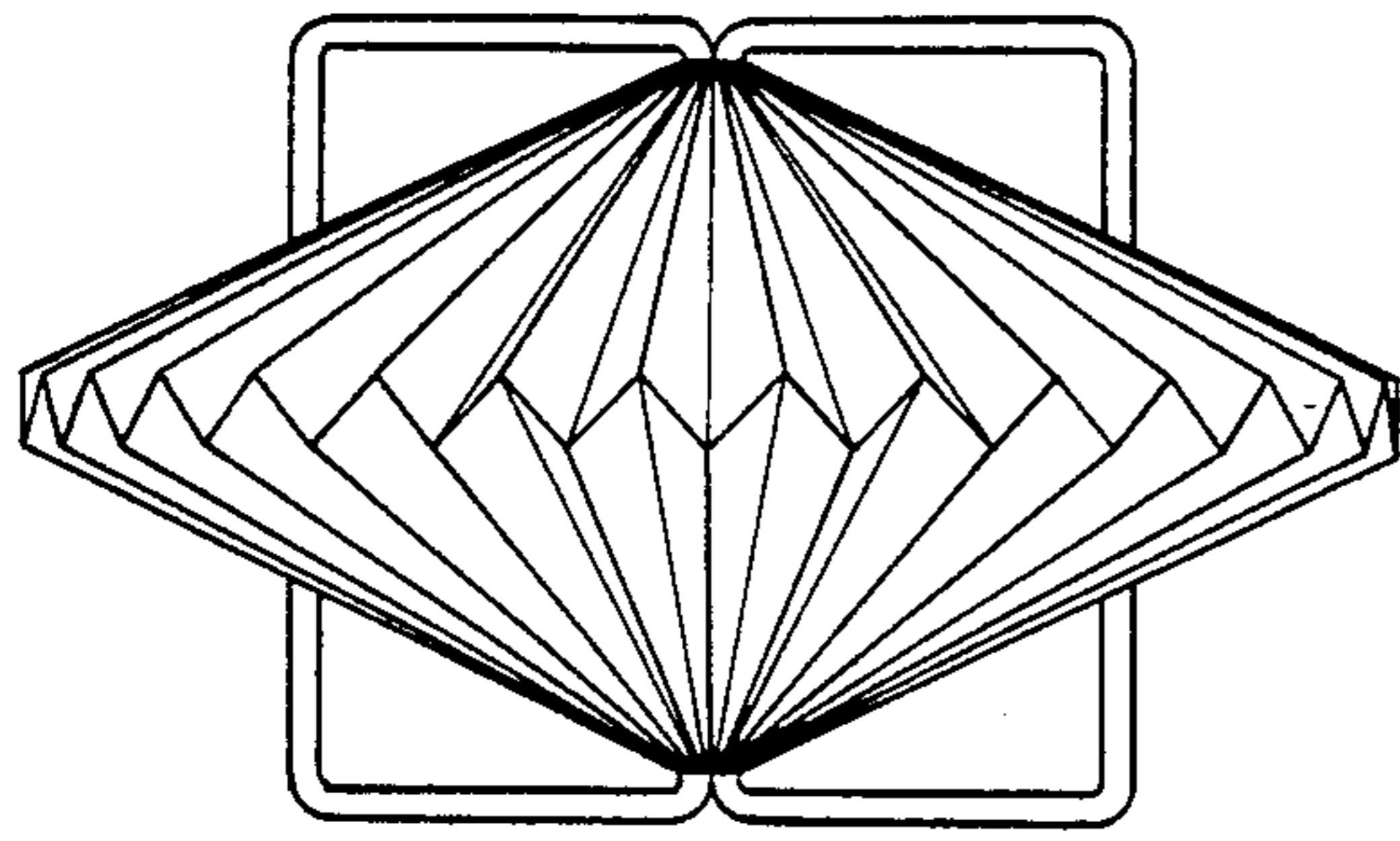

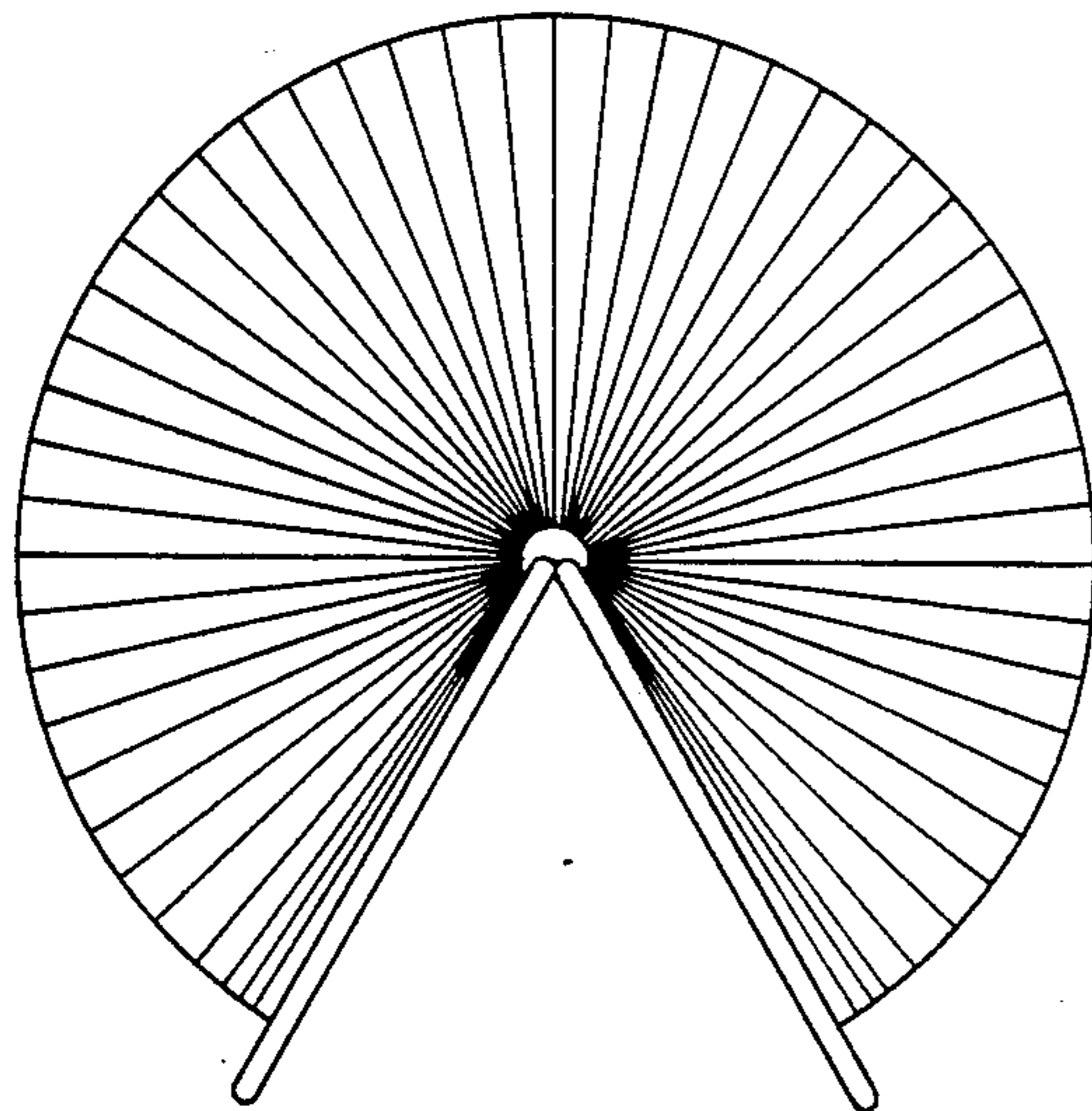

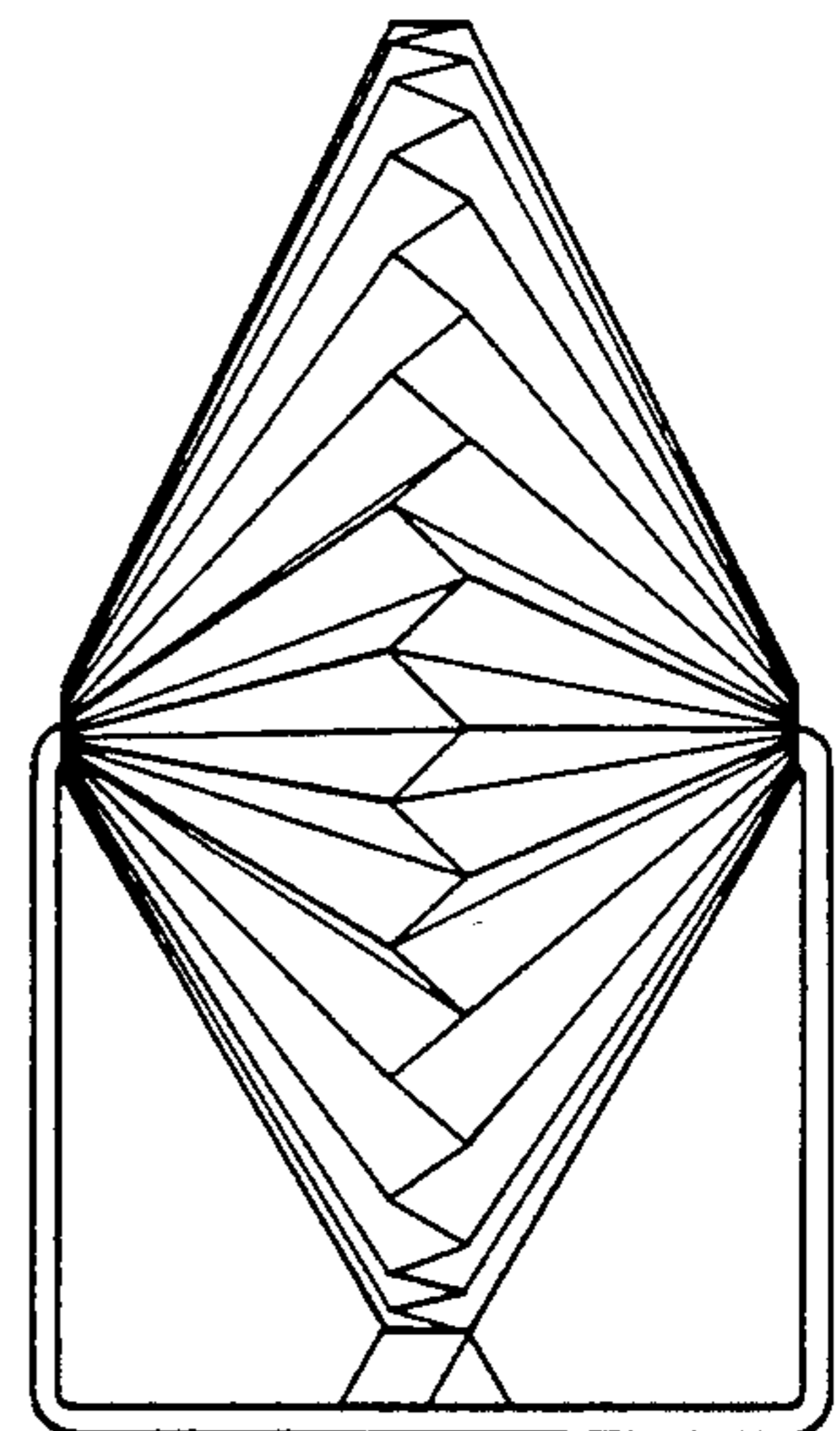

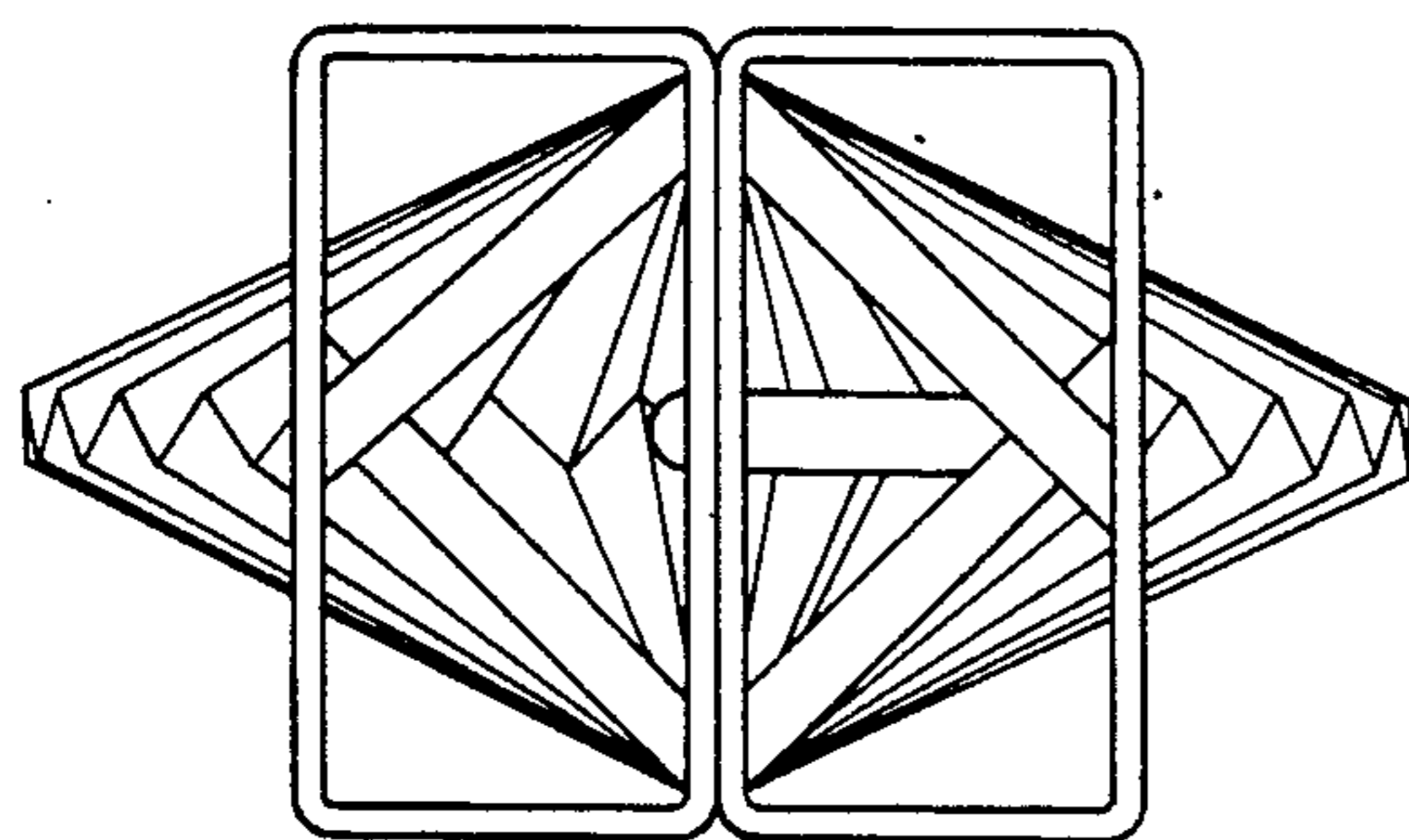

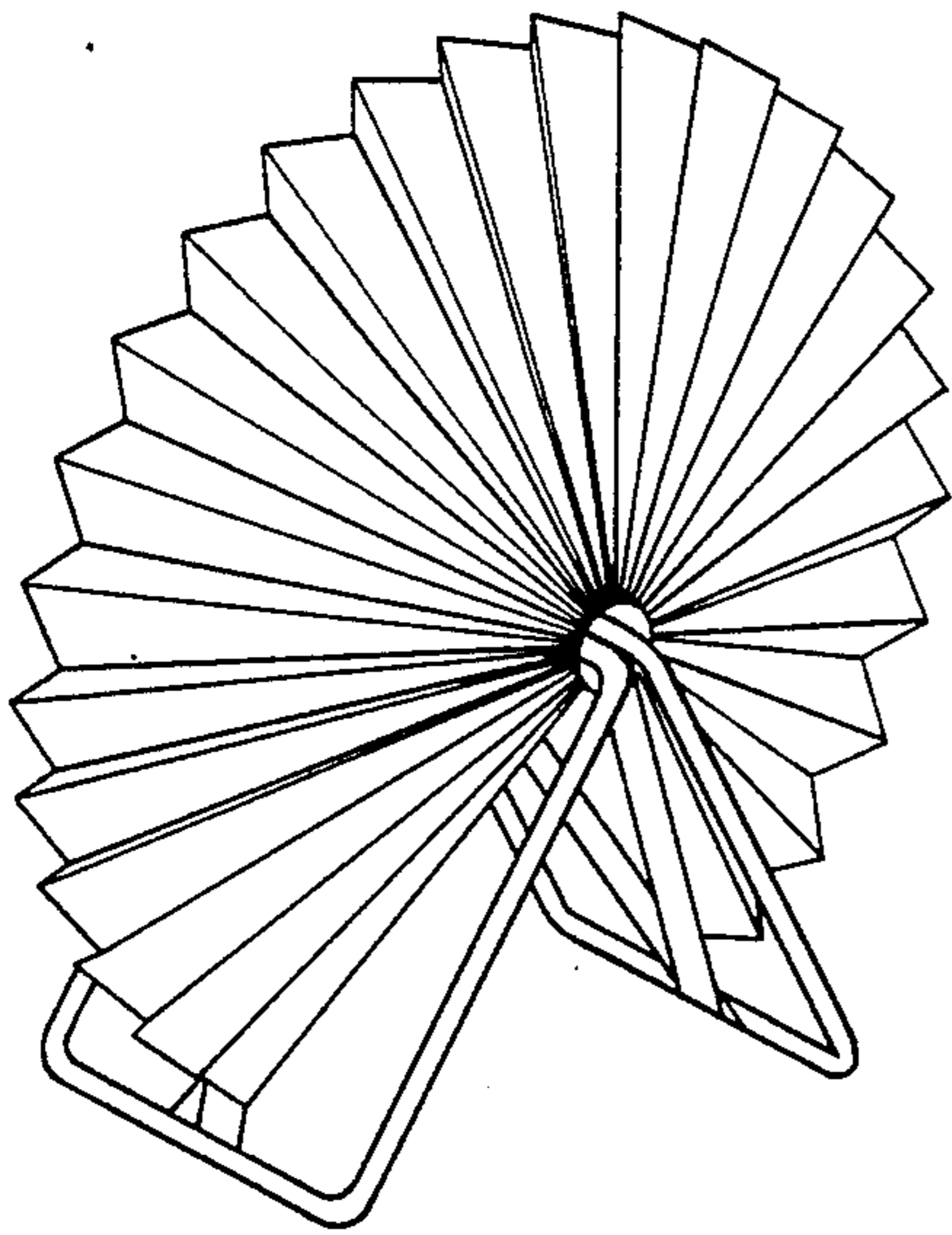

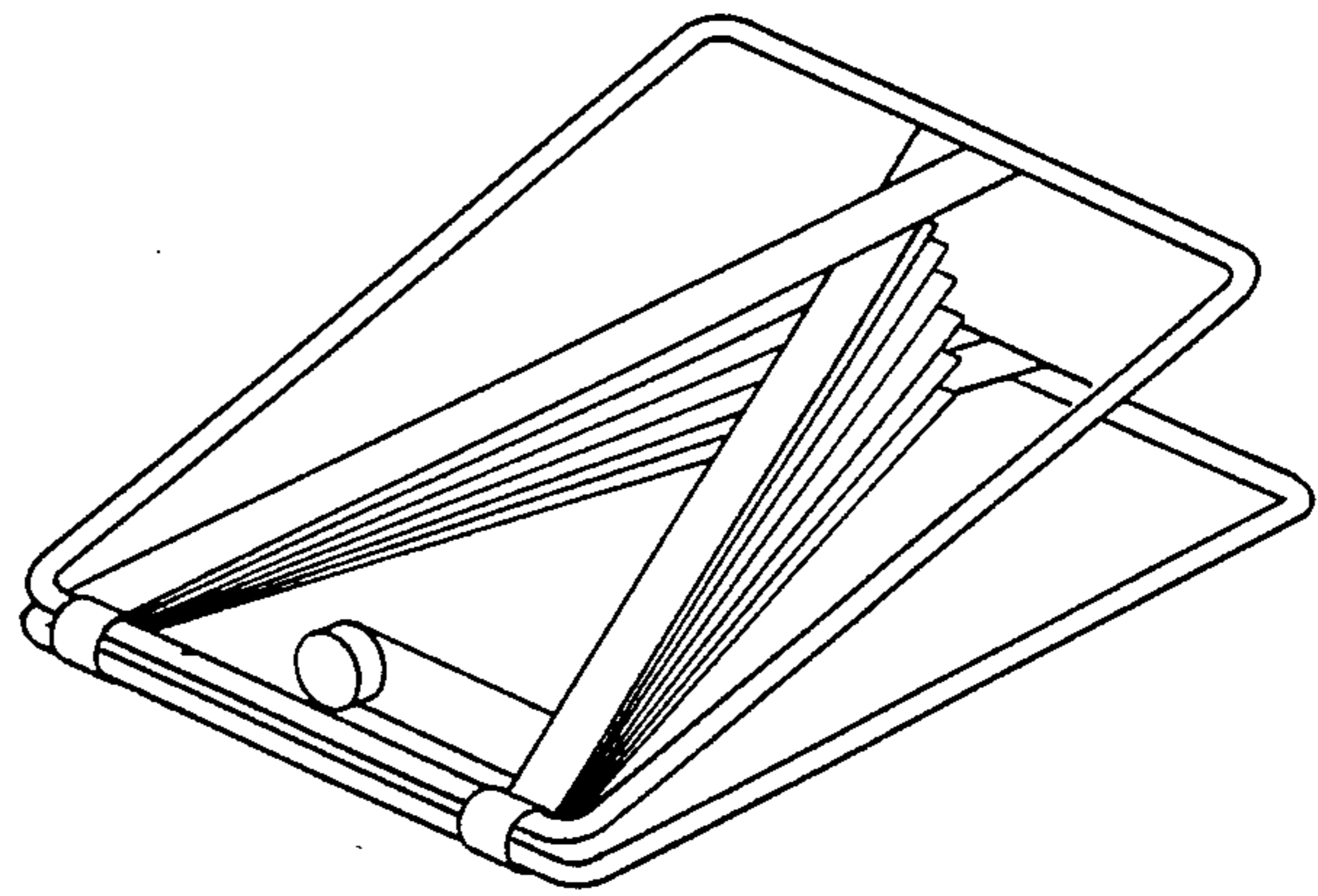

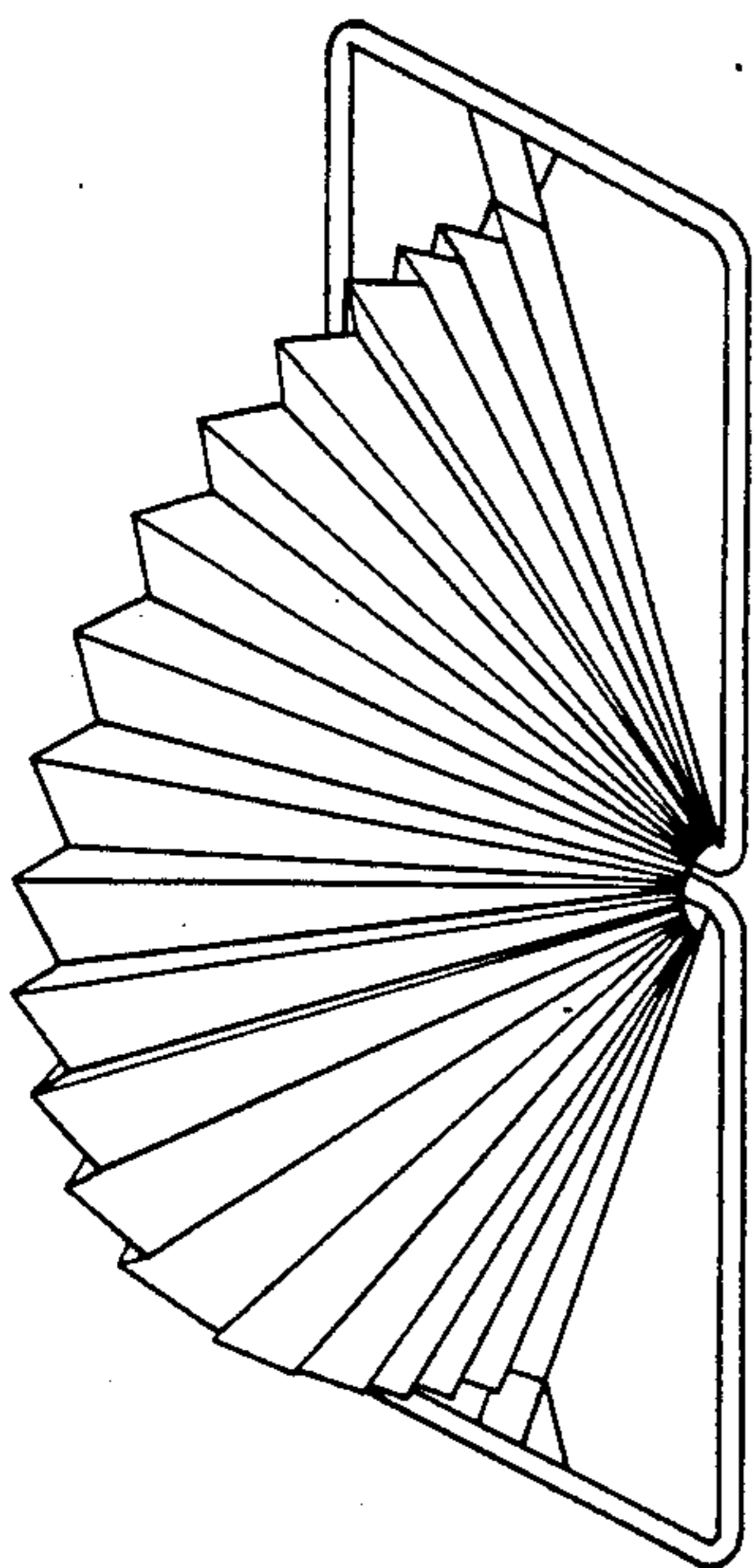

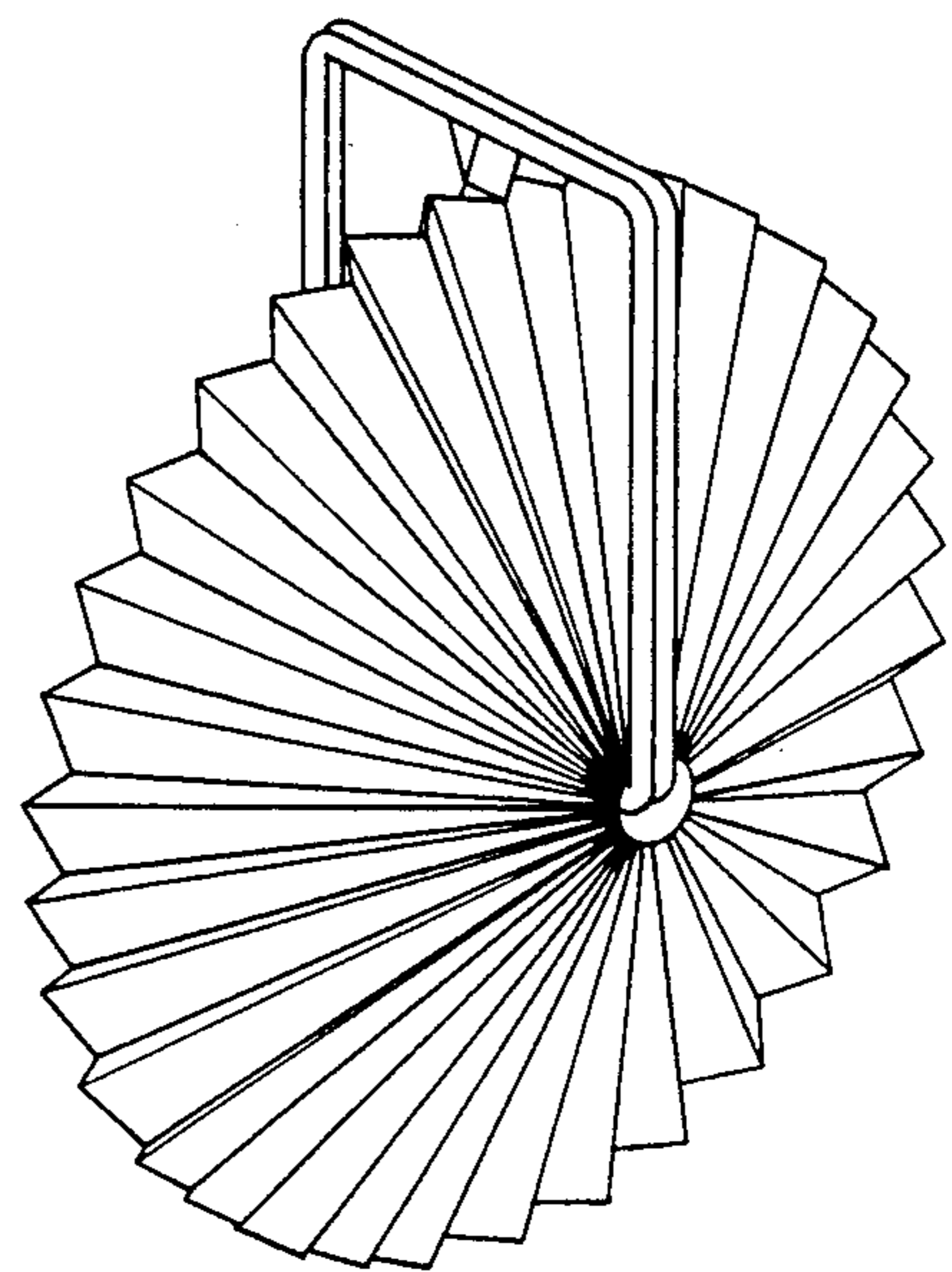
