The ornamental design for a hot dog bun for two hot dog, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of the hot dog bun for two hot dogs showing my new design, with the hot dogs depicted in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof, the front elevational view being a mirror image.

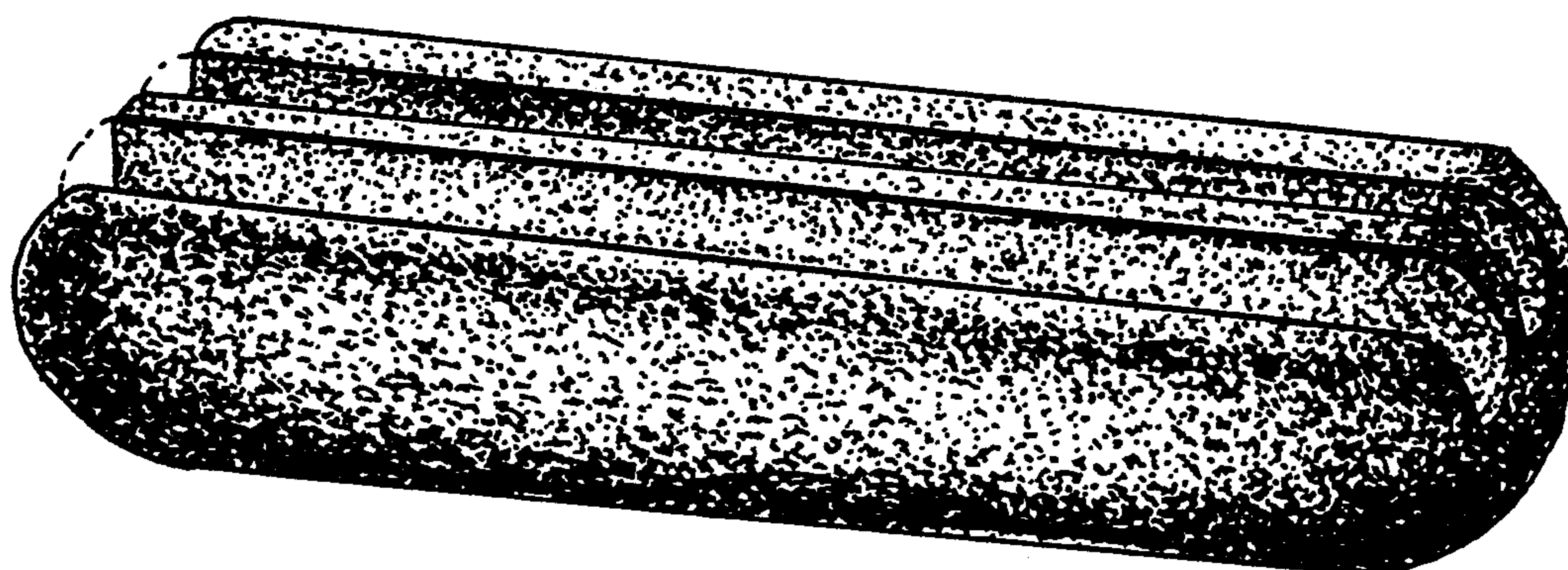

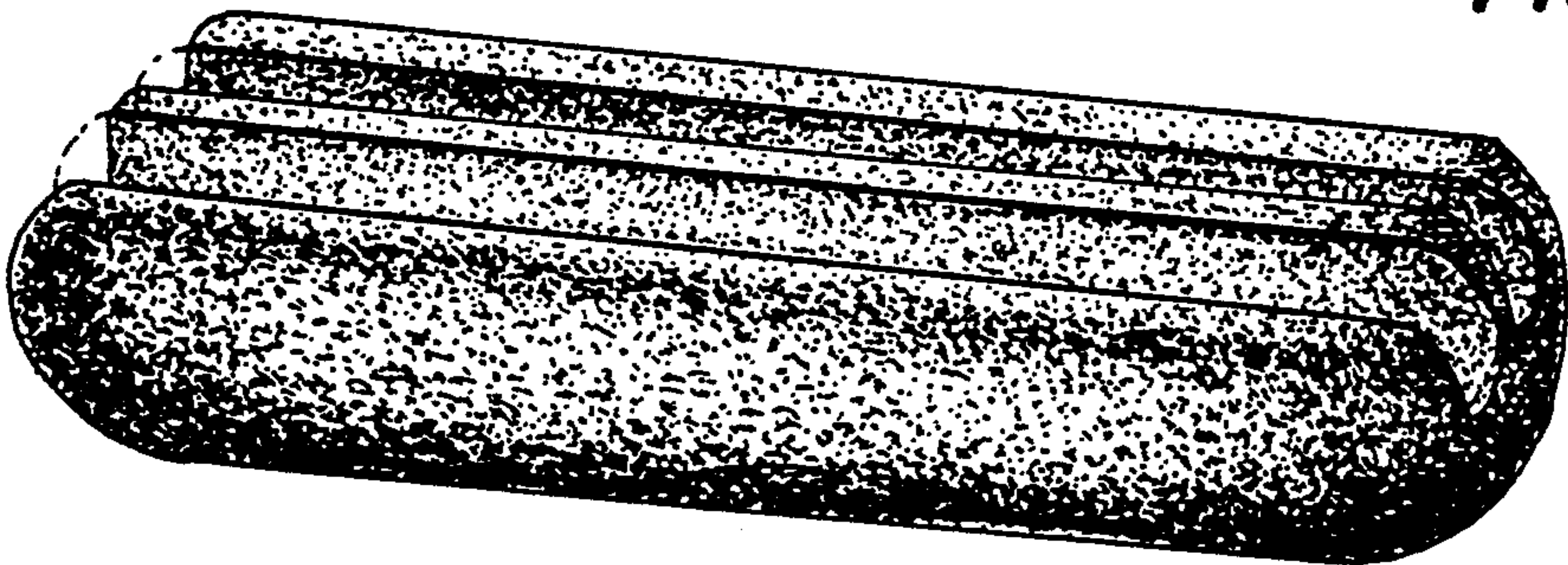

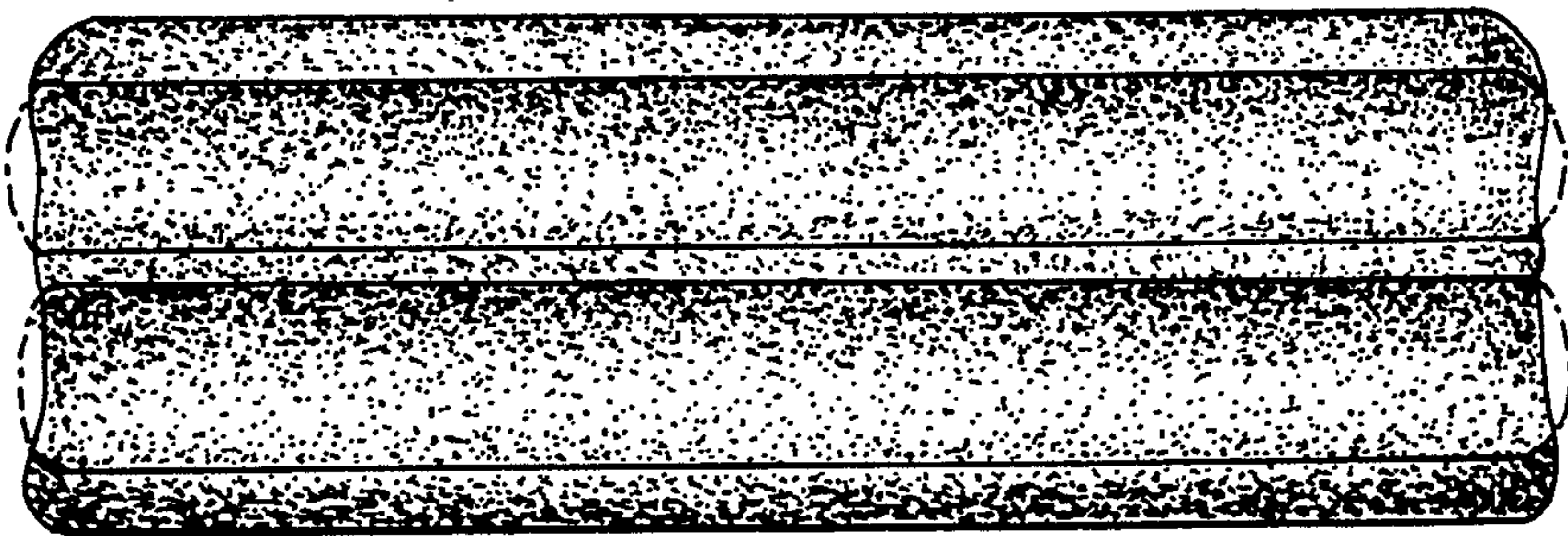

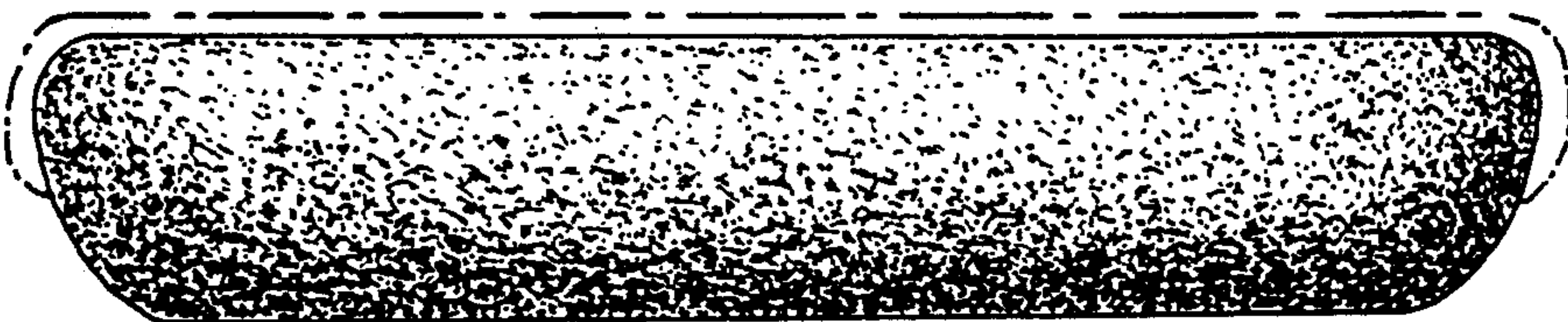
