[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a glove cover for attachment to a ski pole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a glove cover for attachment to a ski pole showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom elevational view thereof.
The broken line showing of a ski pole is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

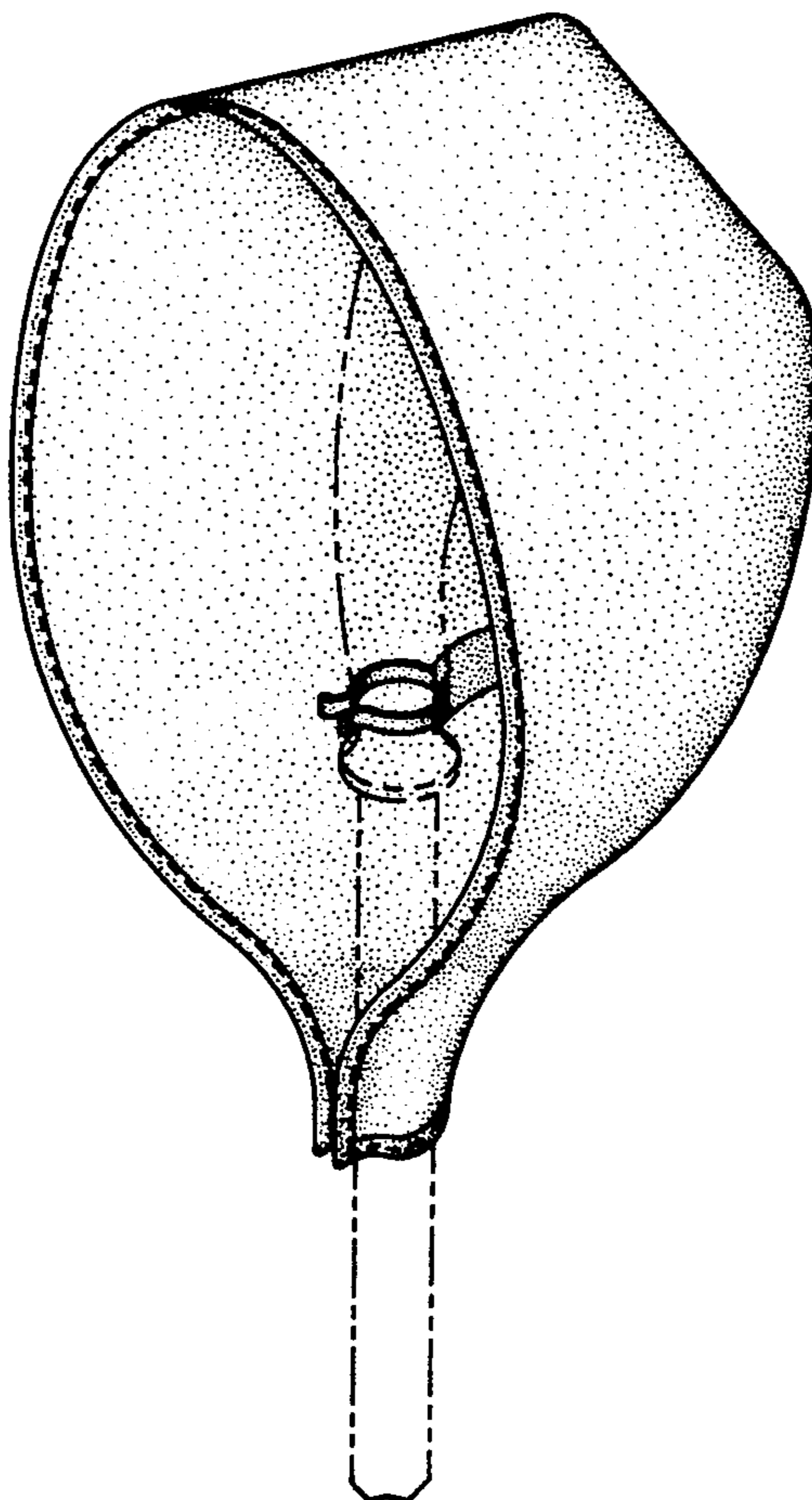

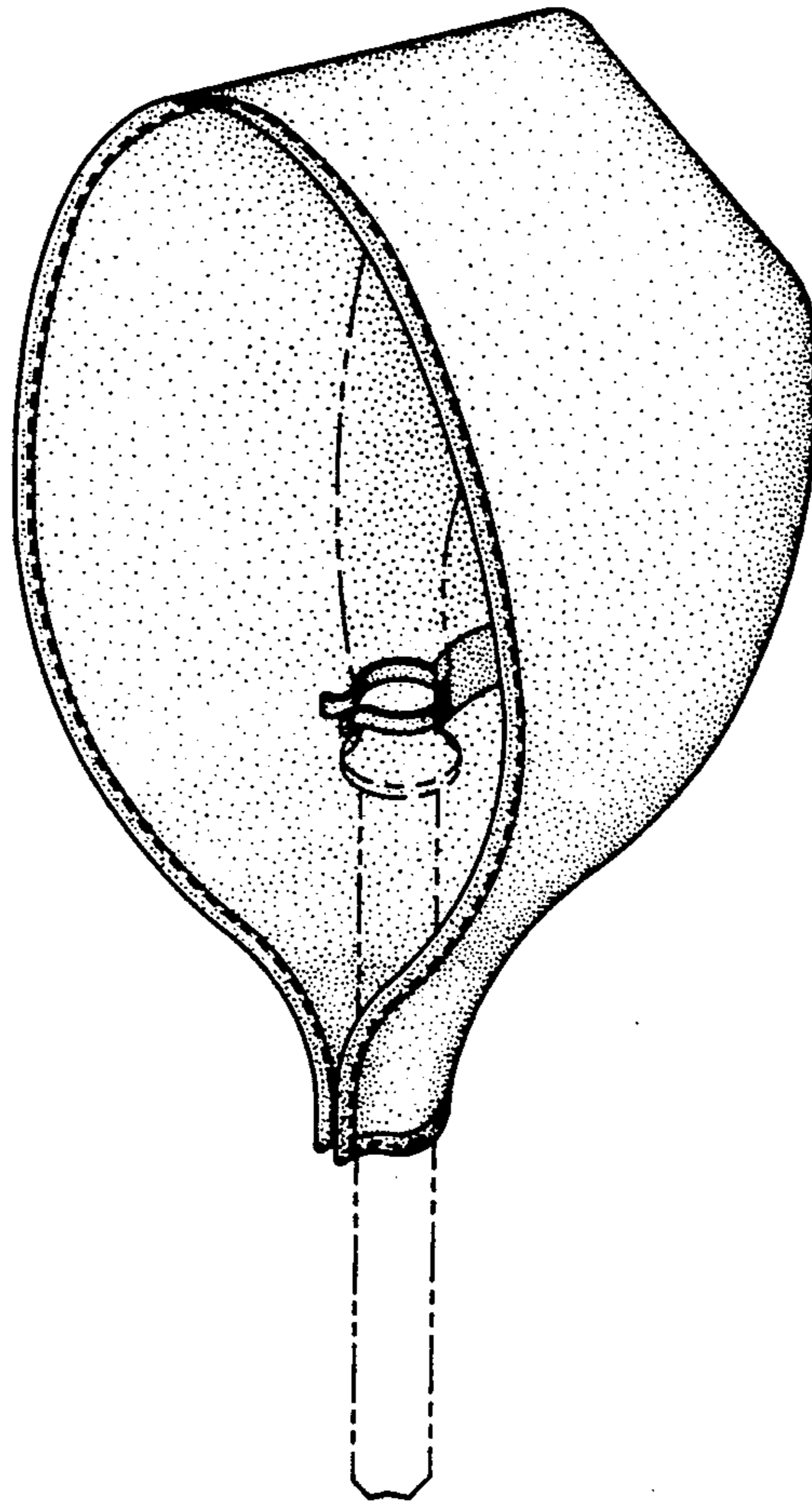
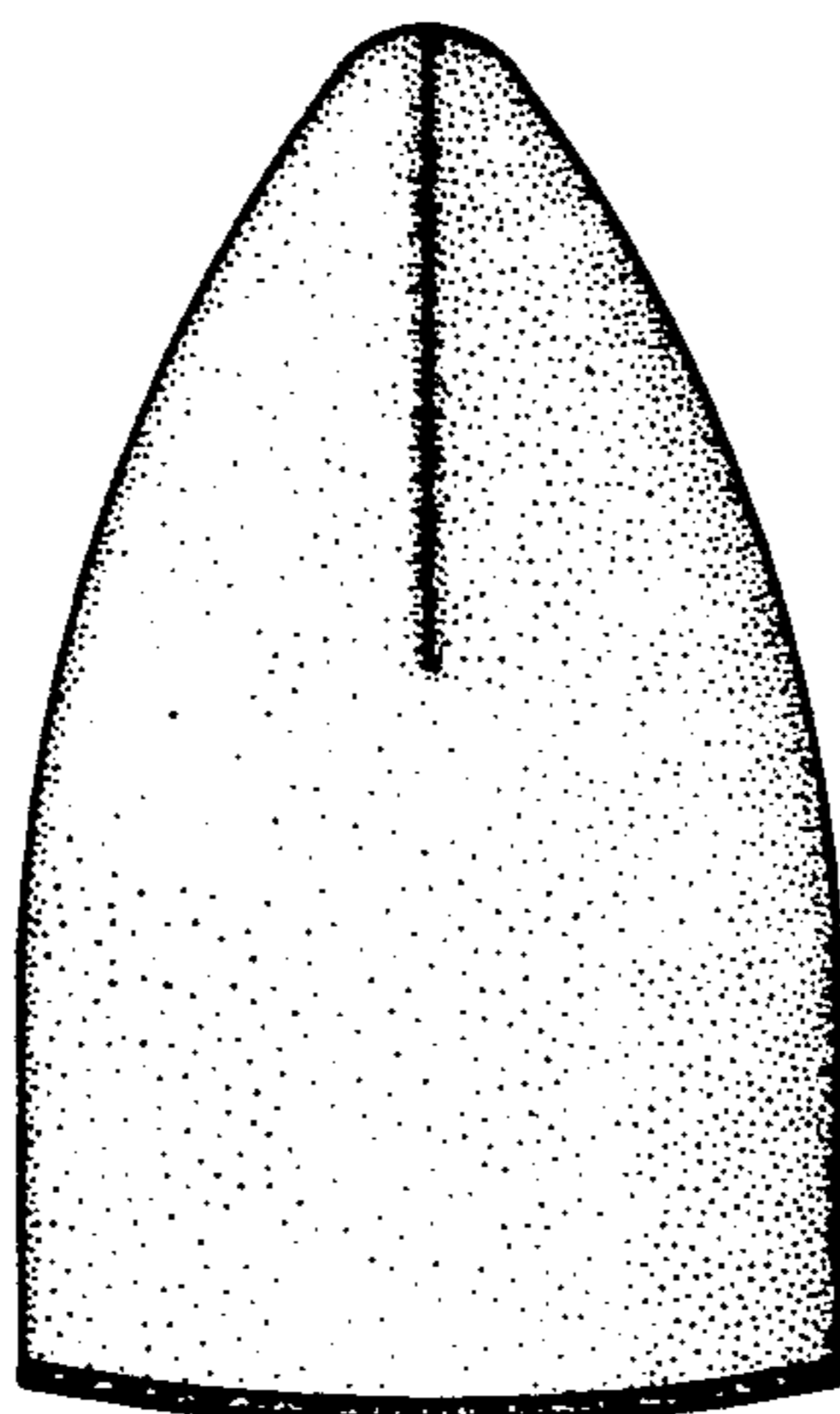

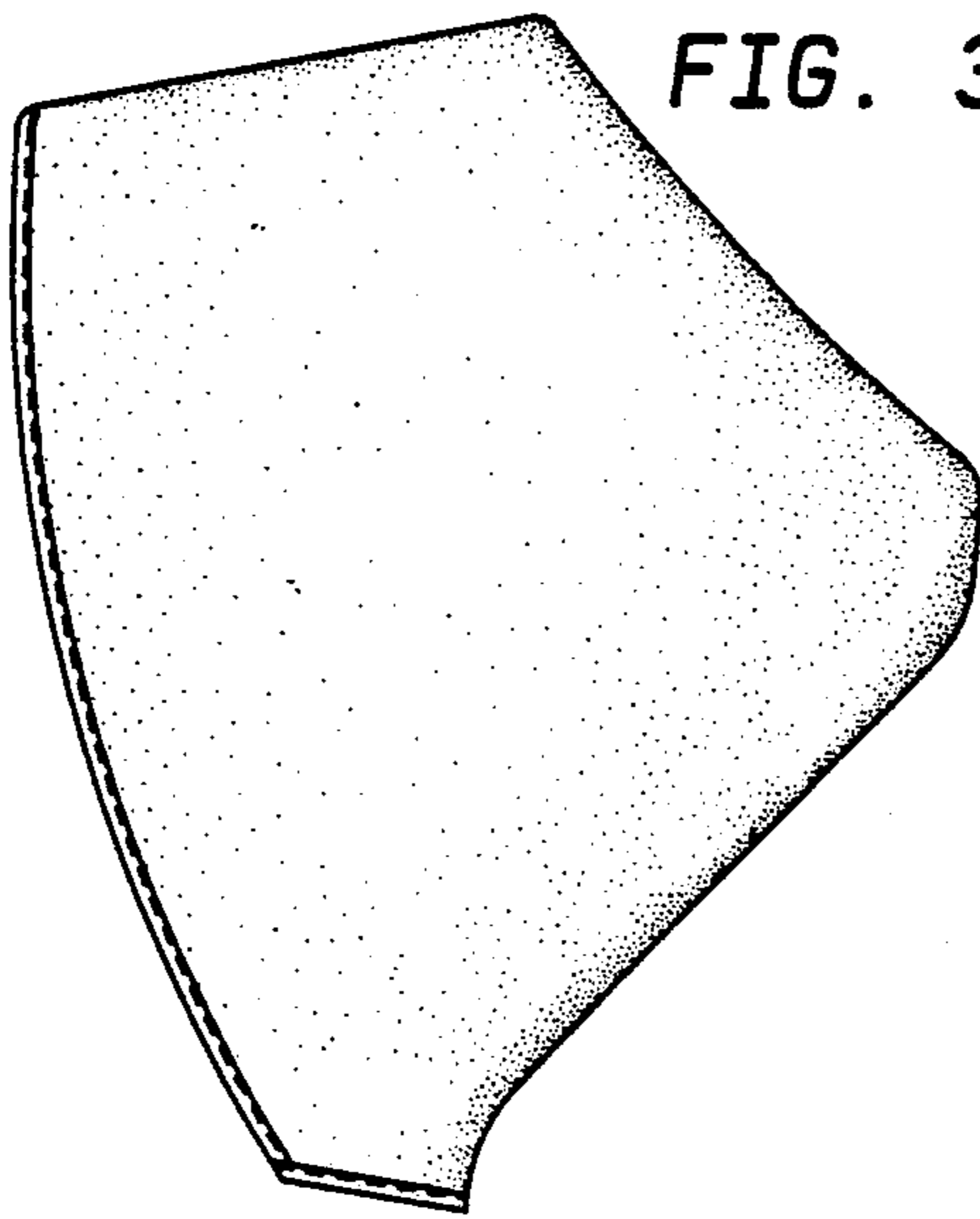

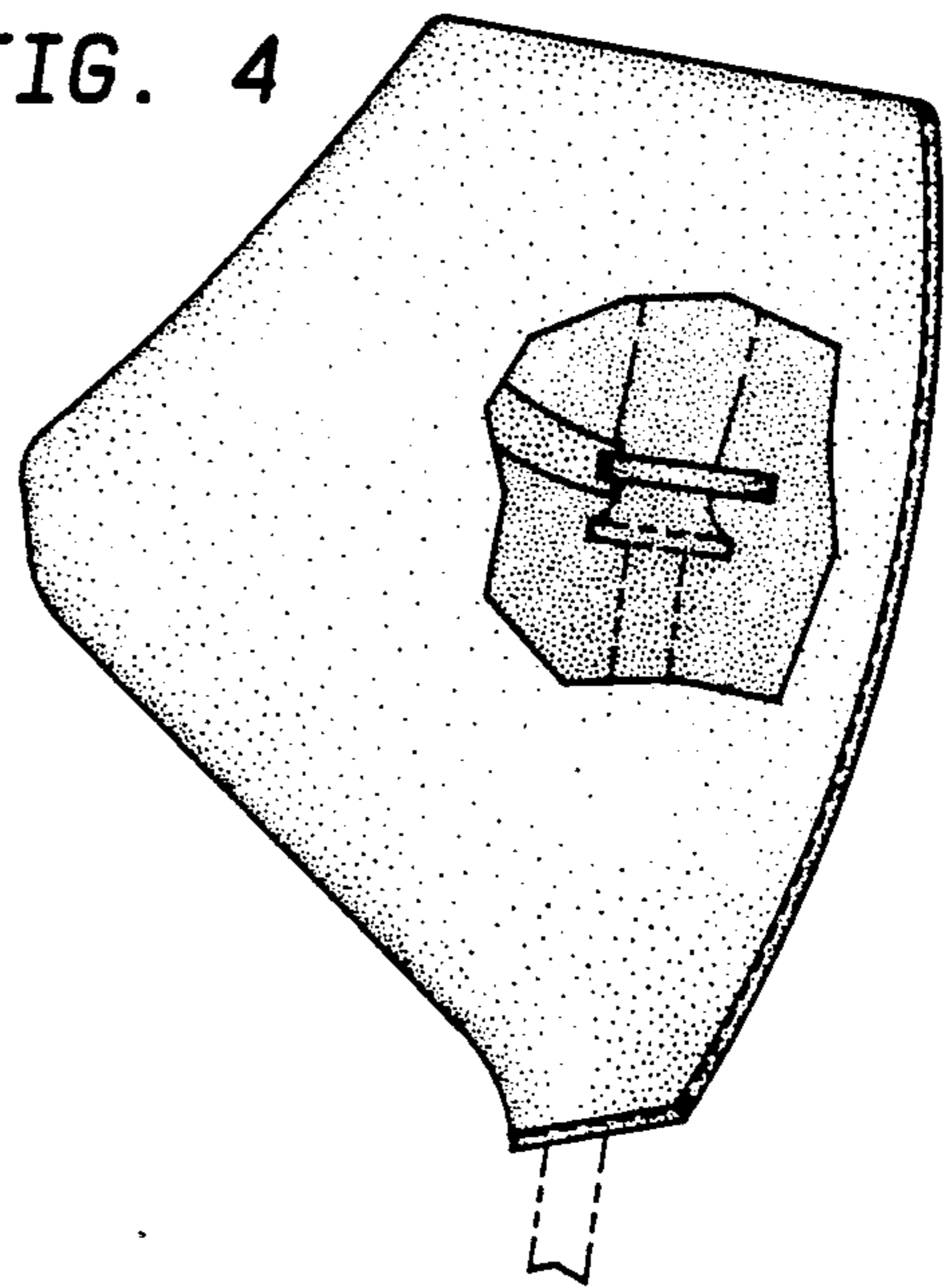

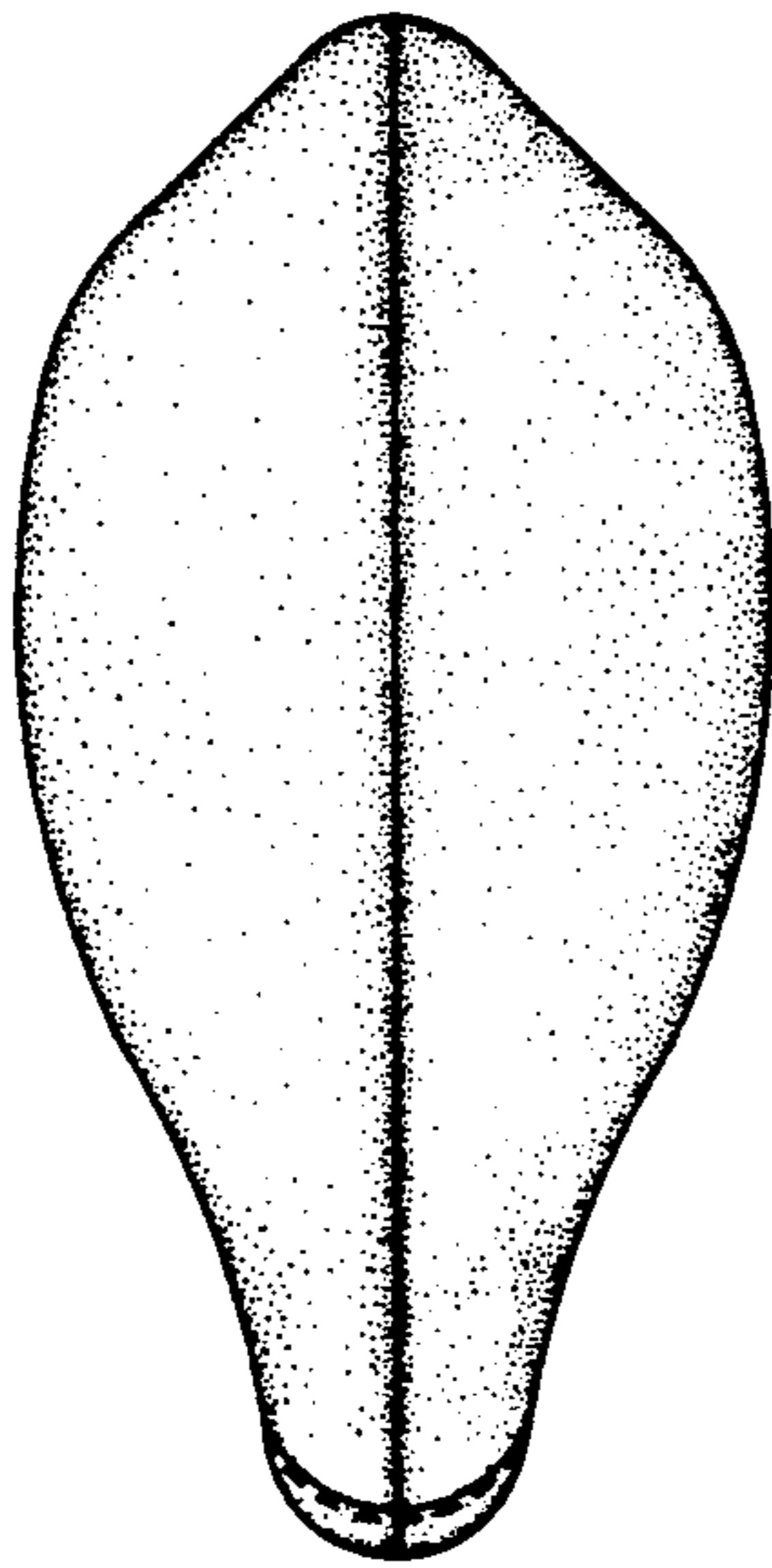

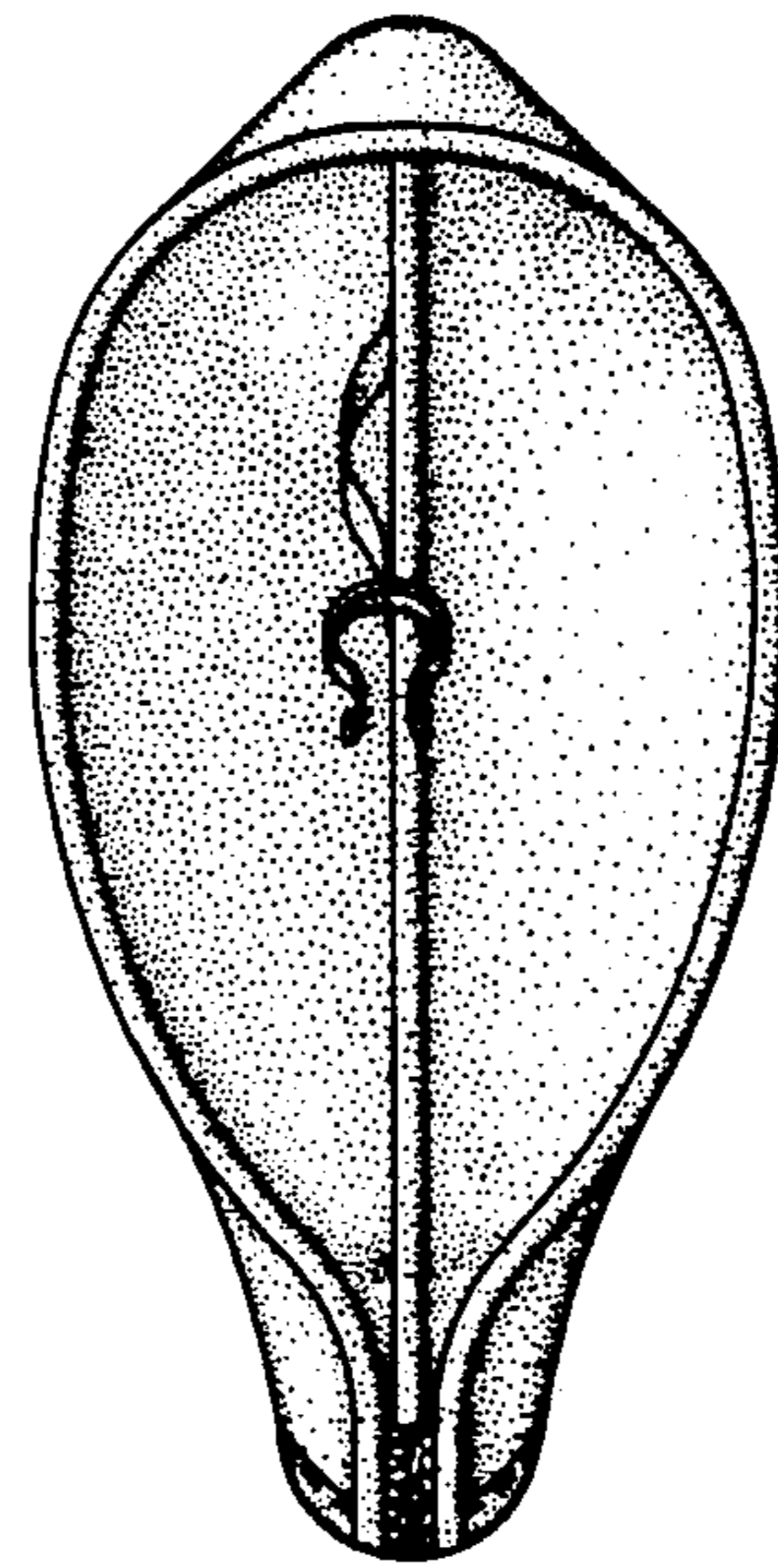
