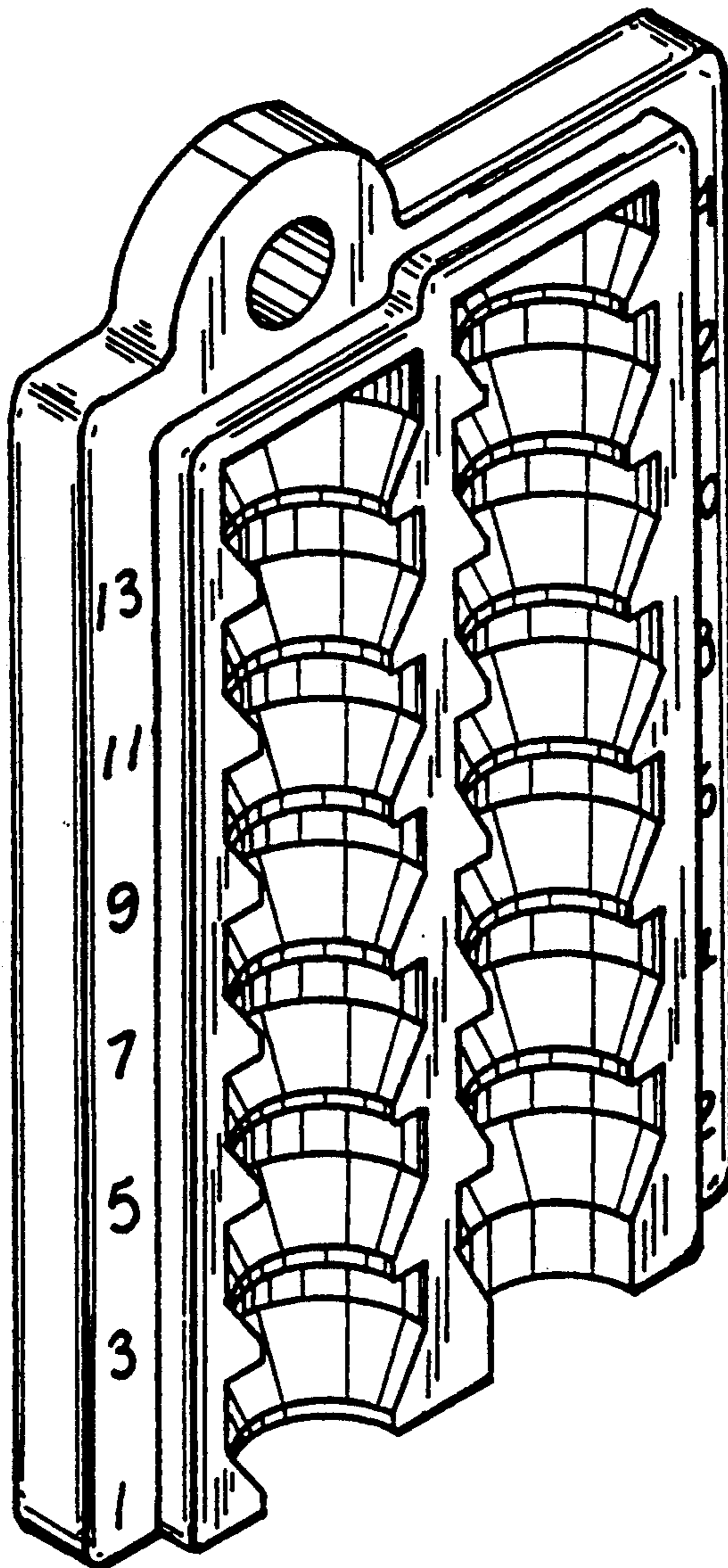
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a golf tee driving gauge showing my new design;

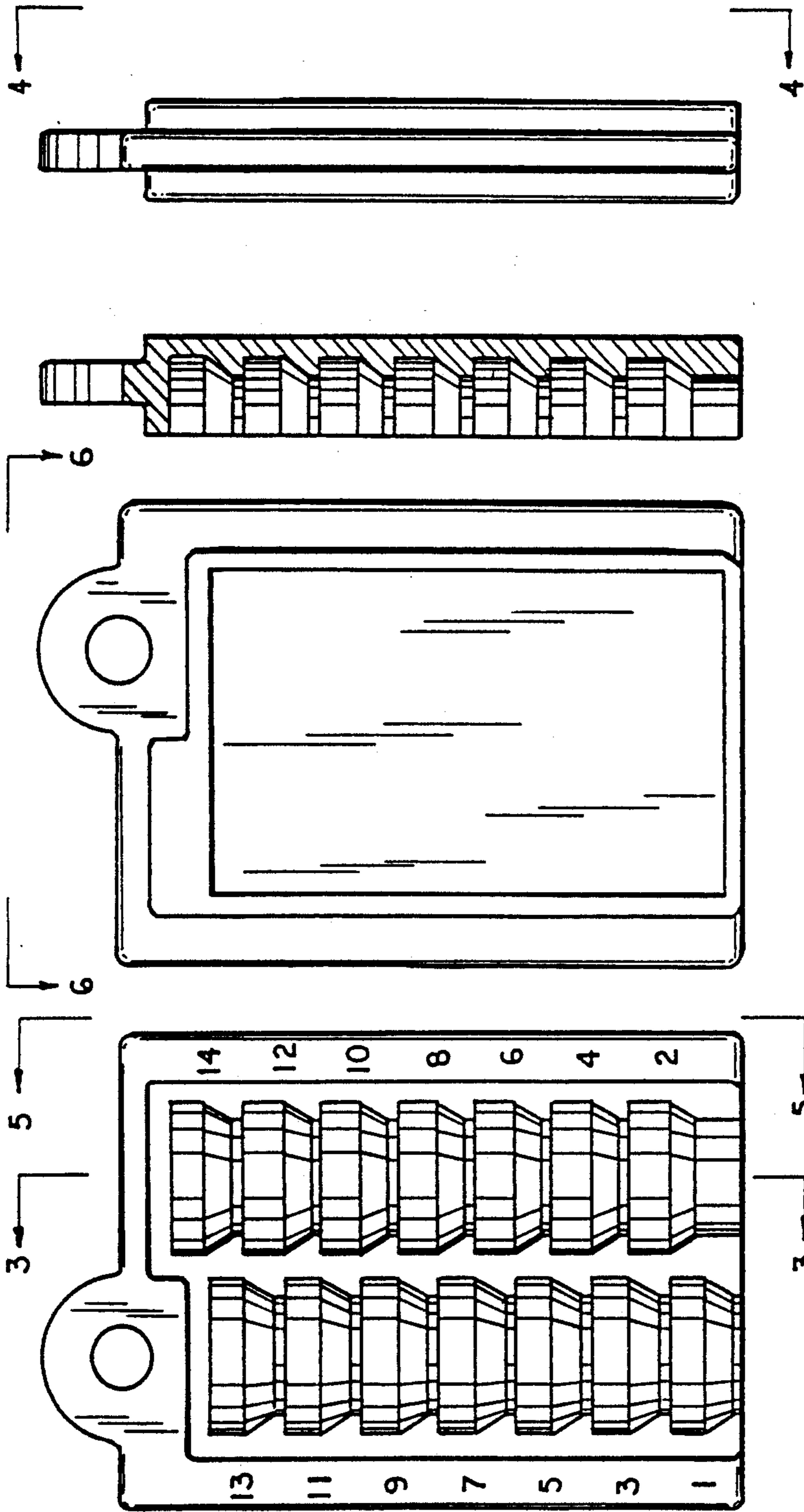

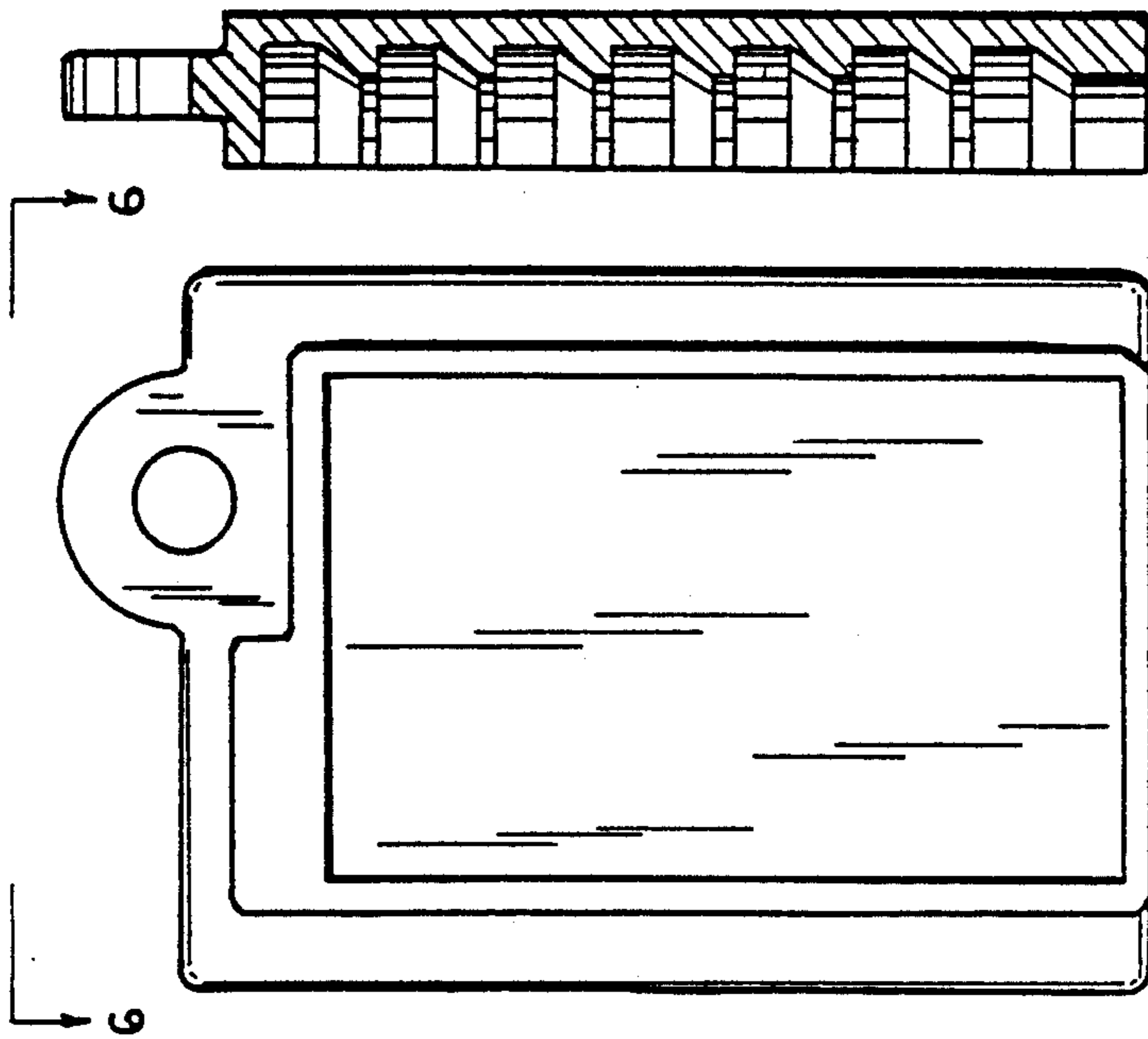

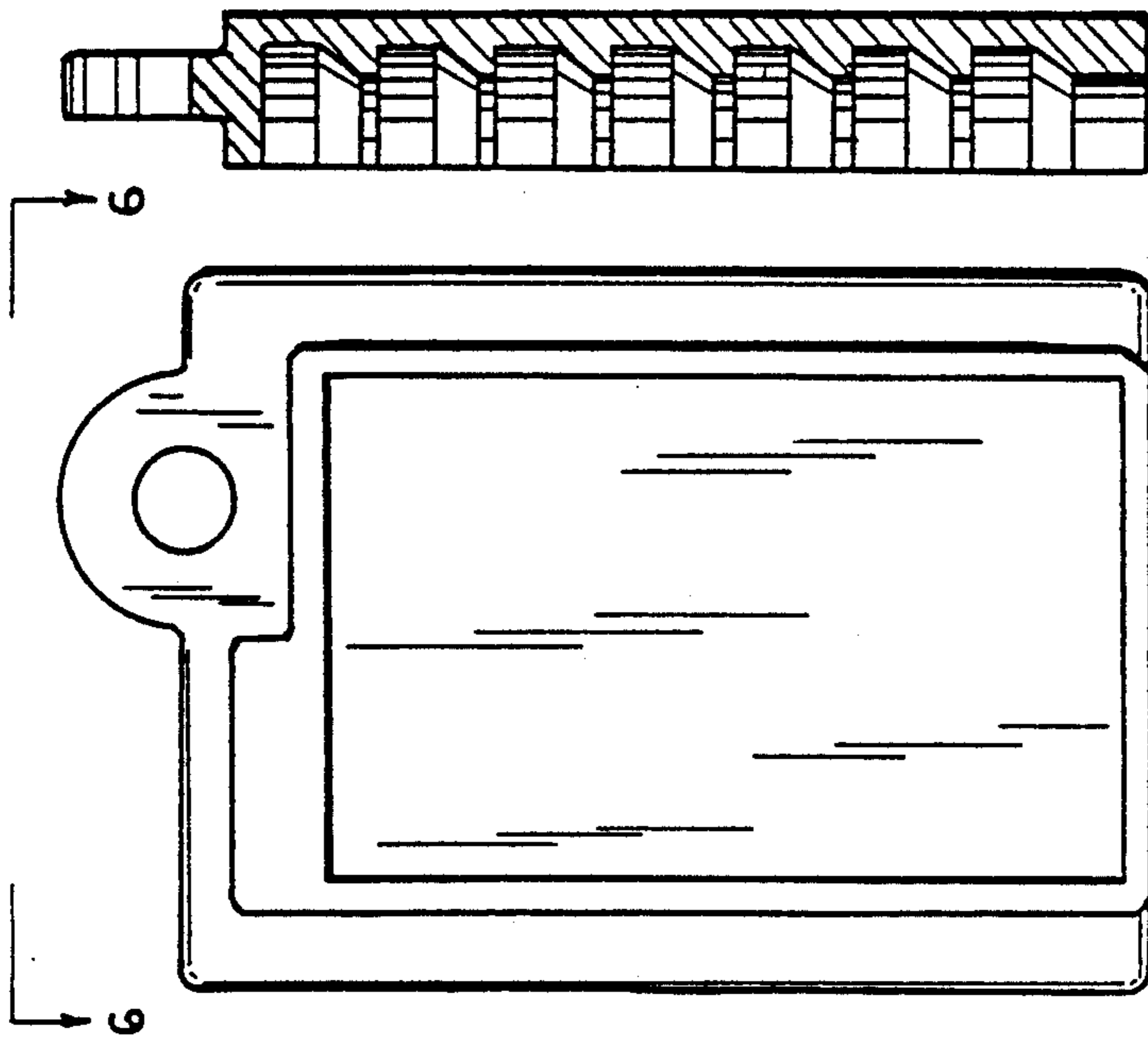

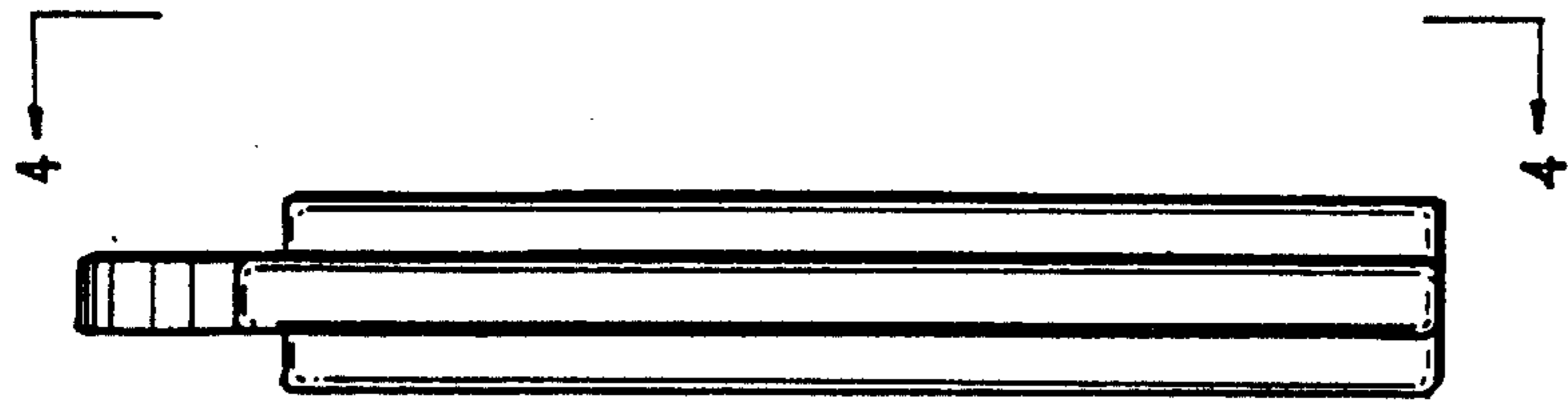

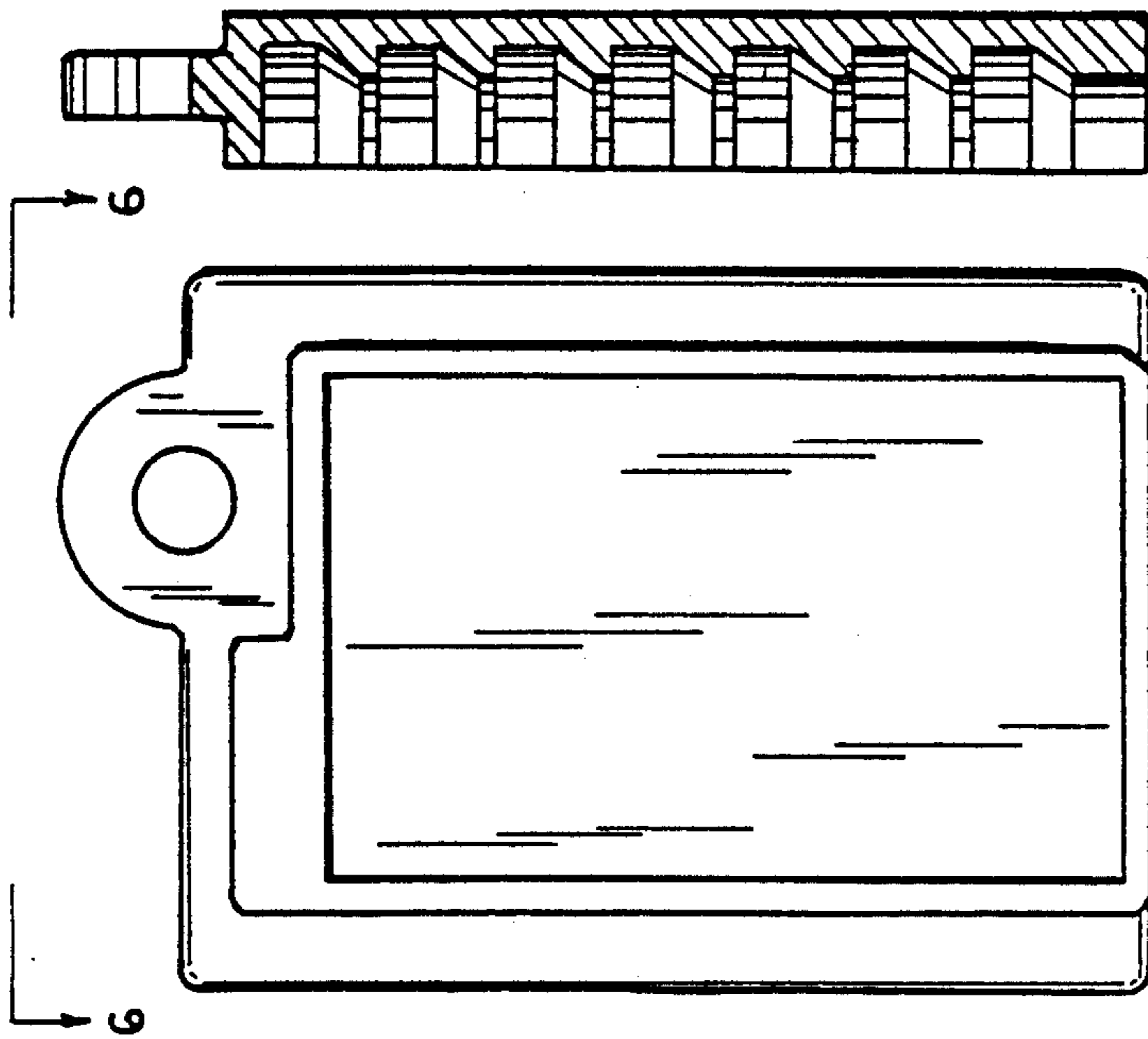

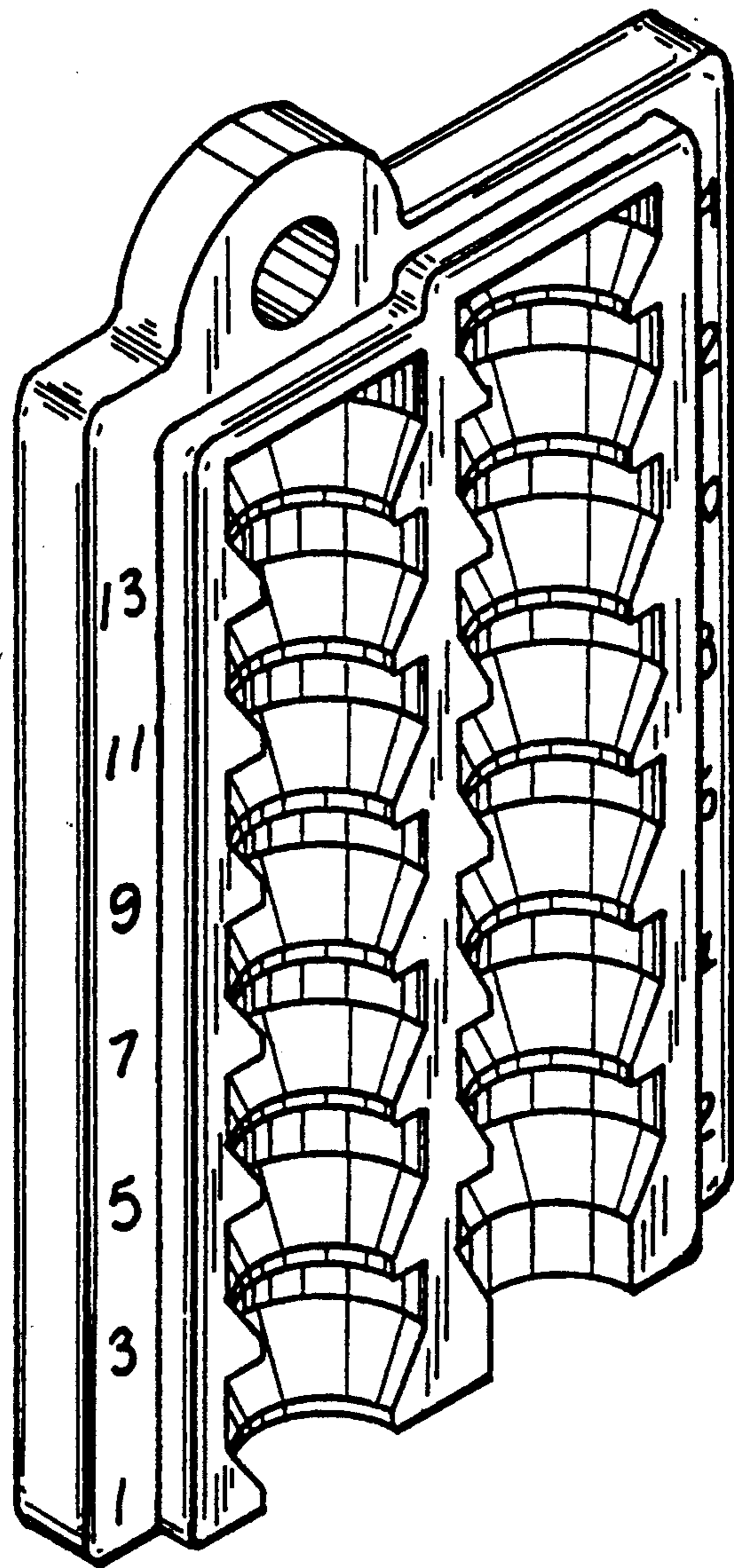
