DESCRIPTION

FIG. 12 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of a molded curb stone showing my new design;

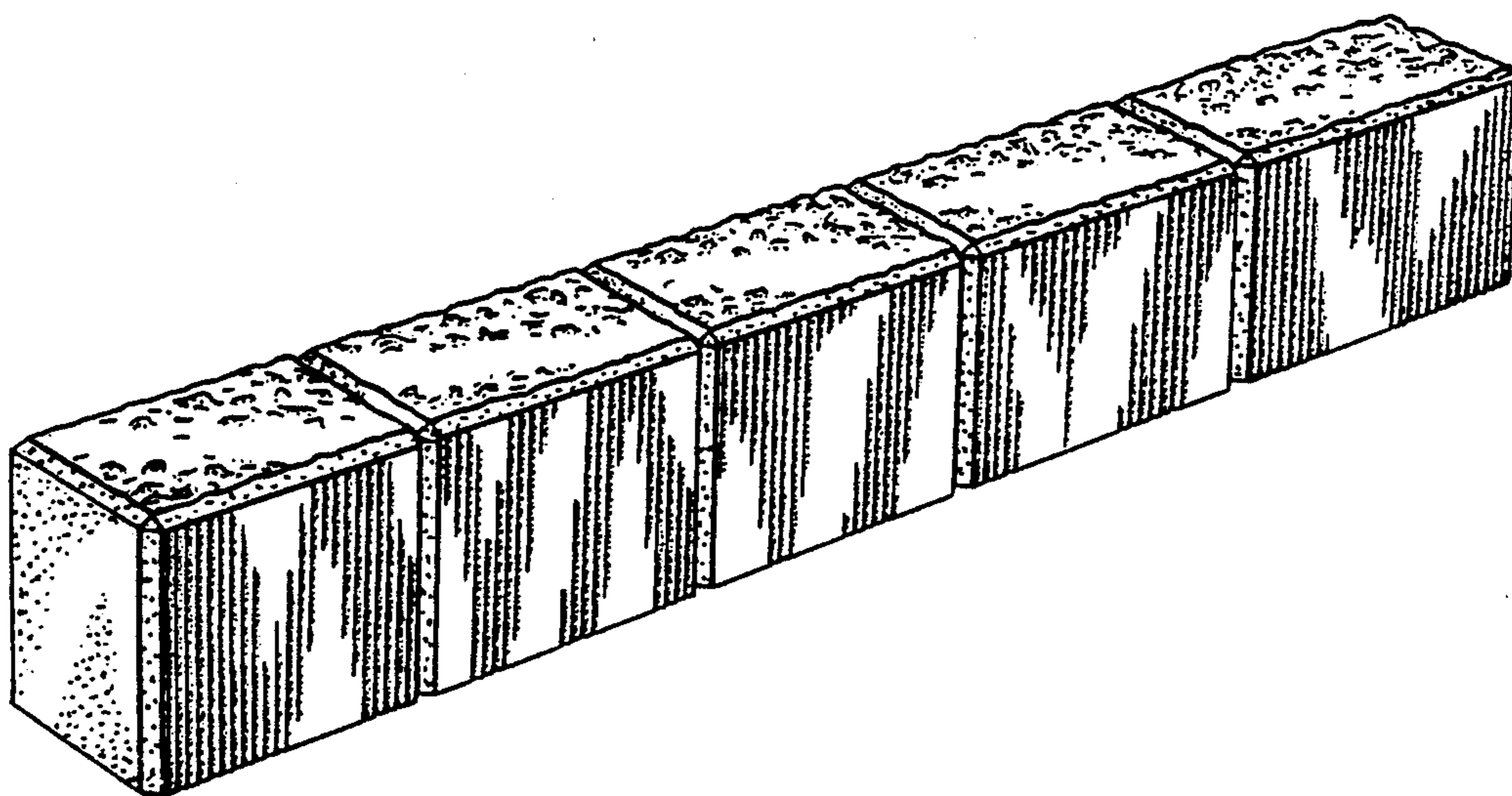
FIG. 13 is a top plan view thereof;

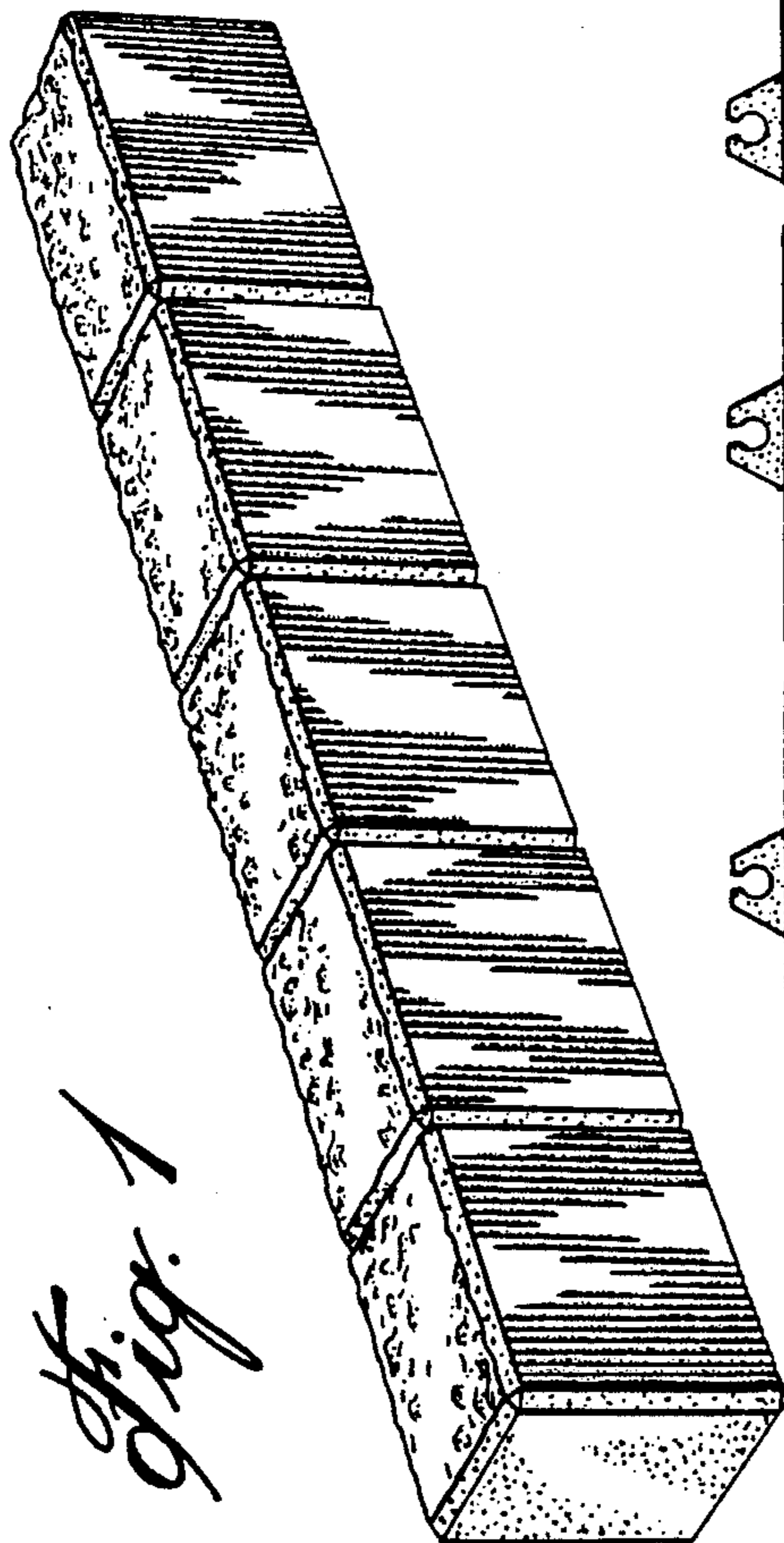
FIG. 14 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 15 is a rear elevational view thereof;

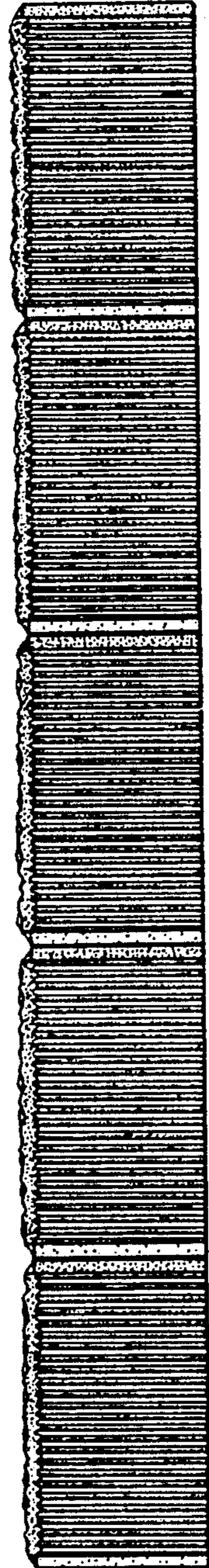
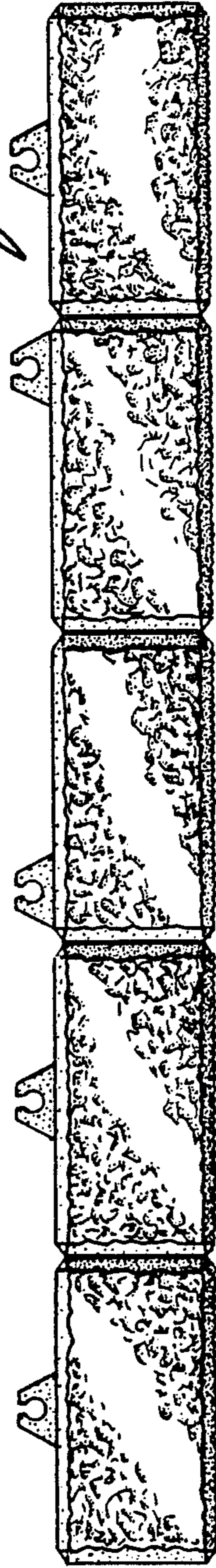
FIG. 16 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 17 is an end elevational view, the opposite end being a mirror image thereof.

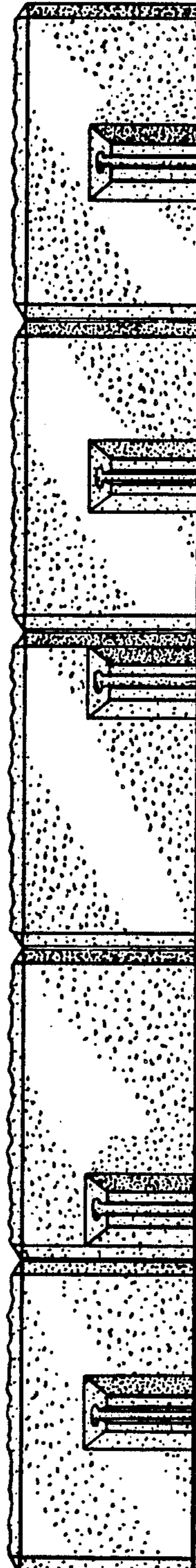
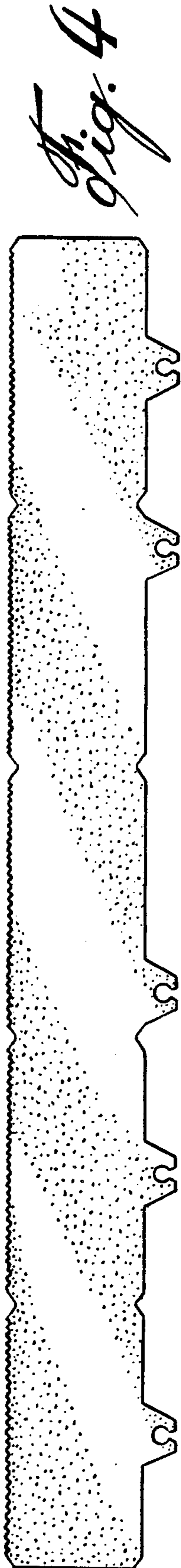

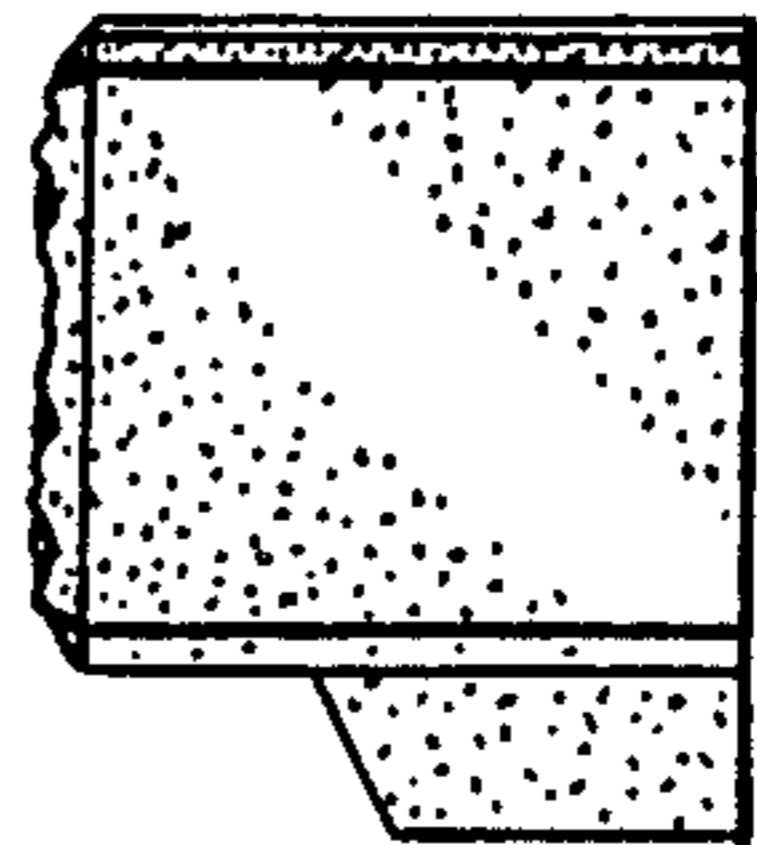

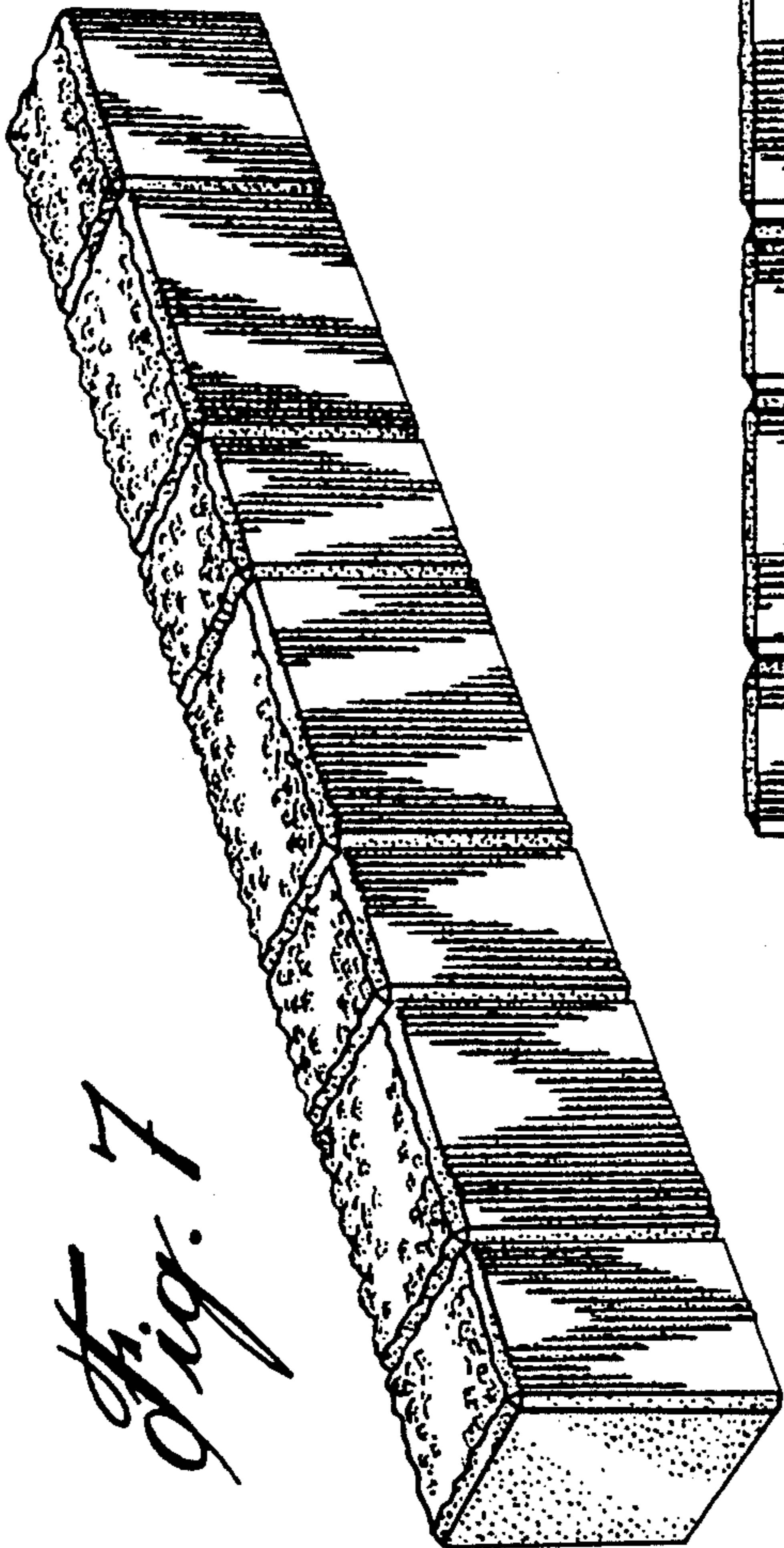

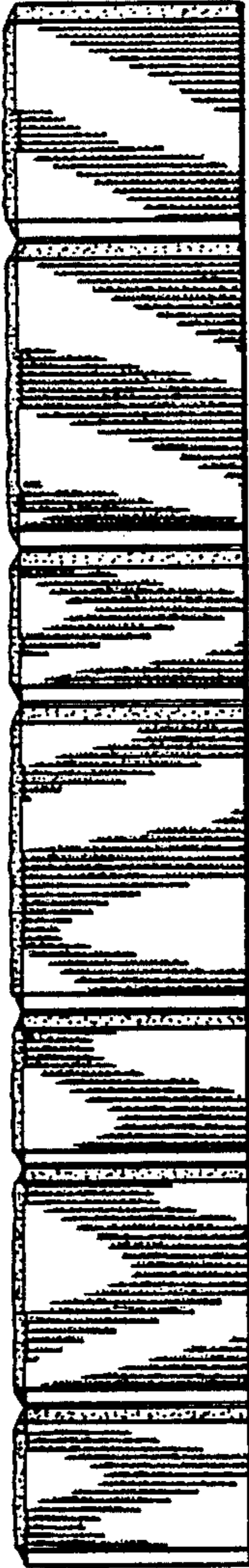

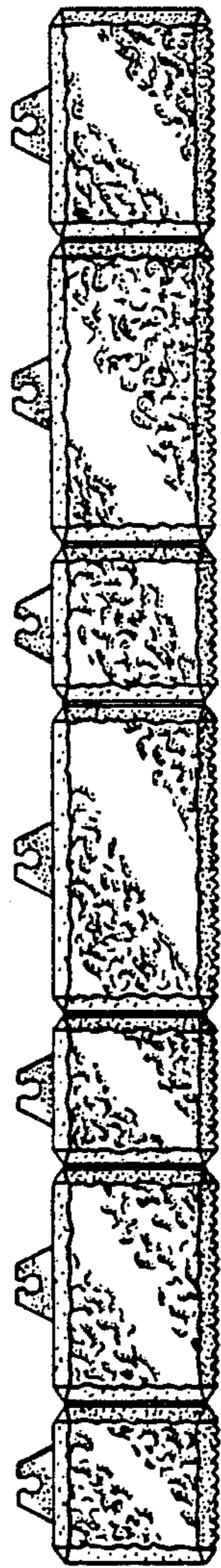

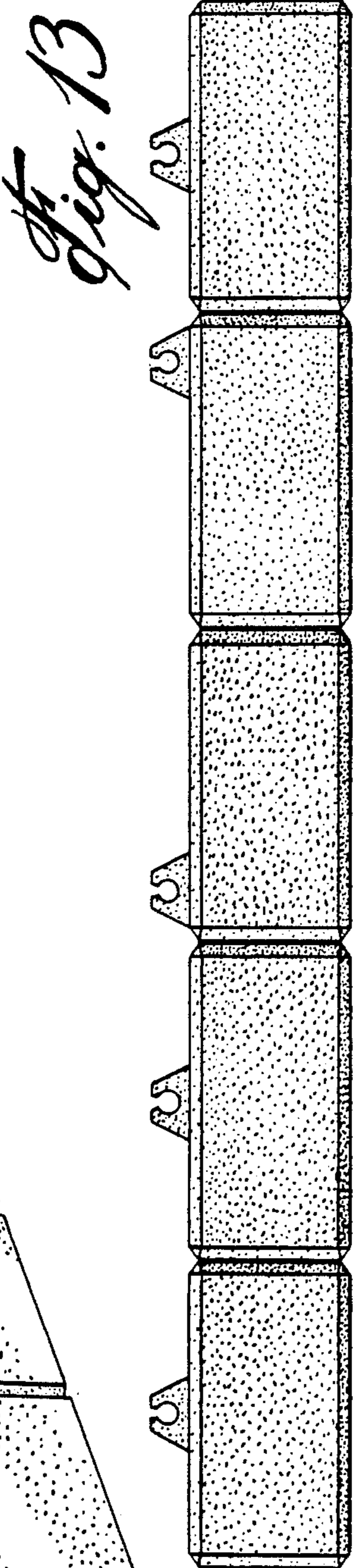
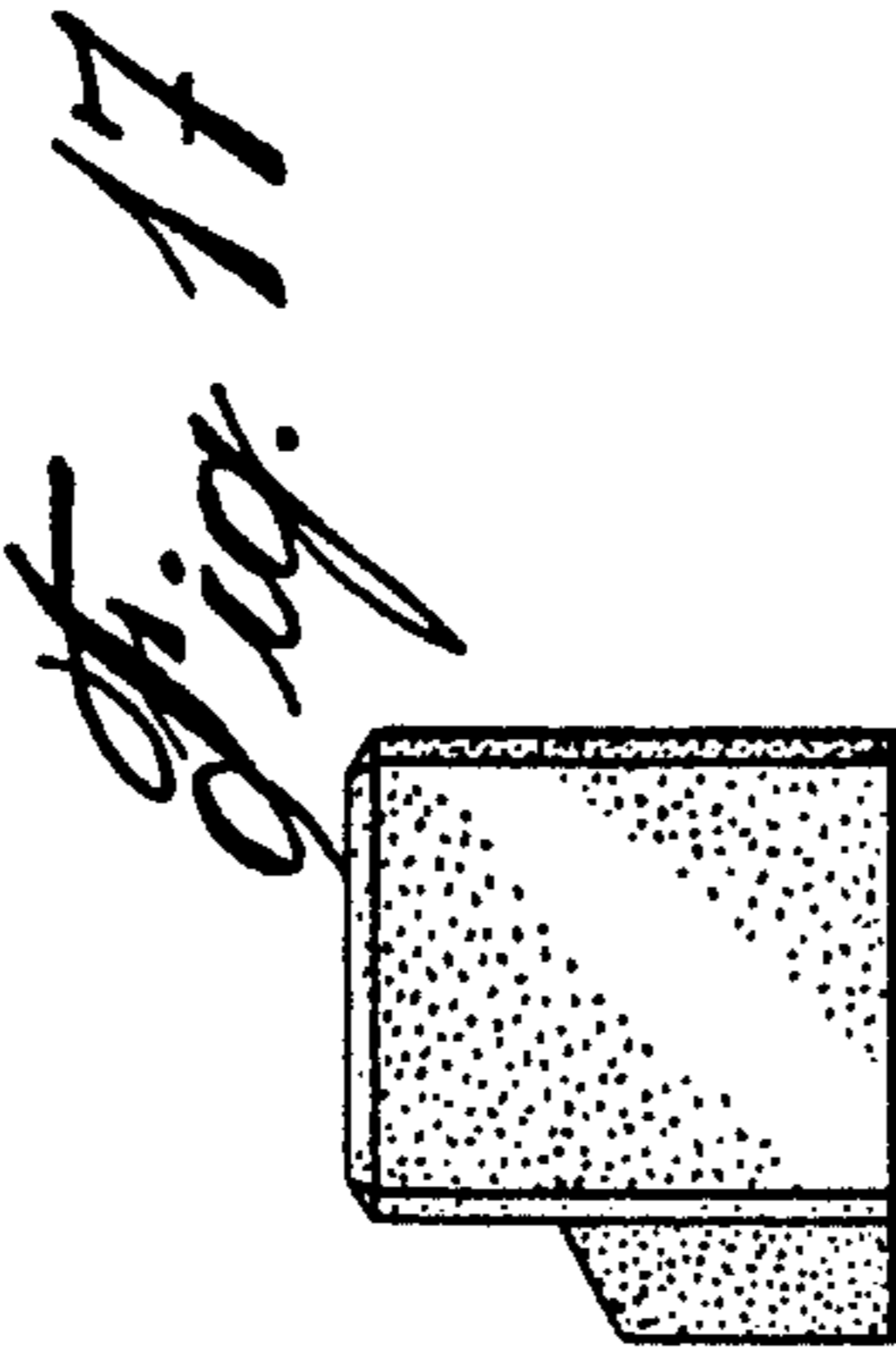
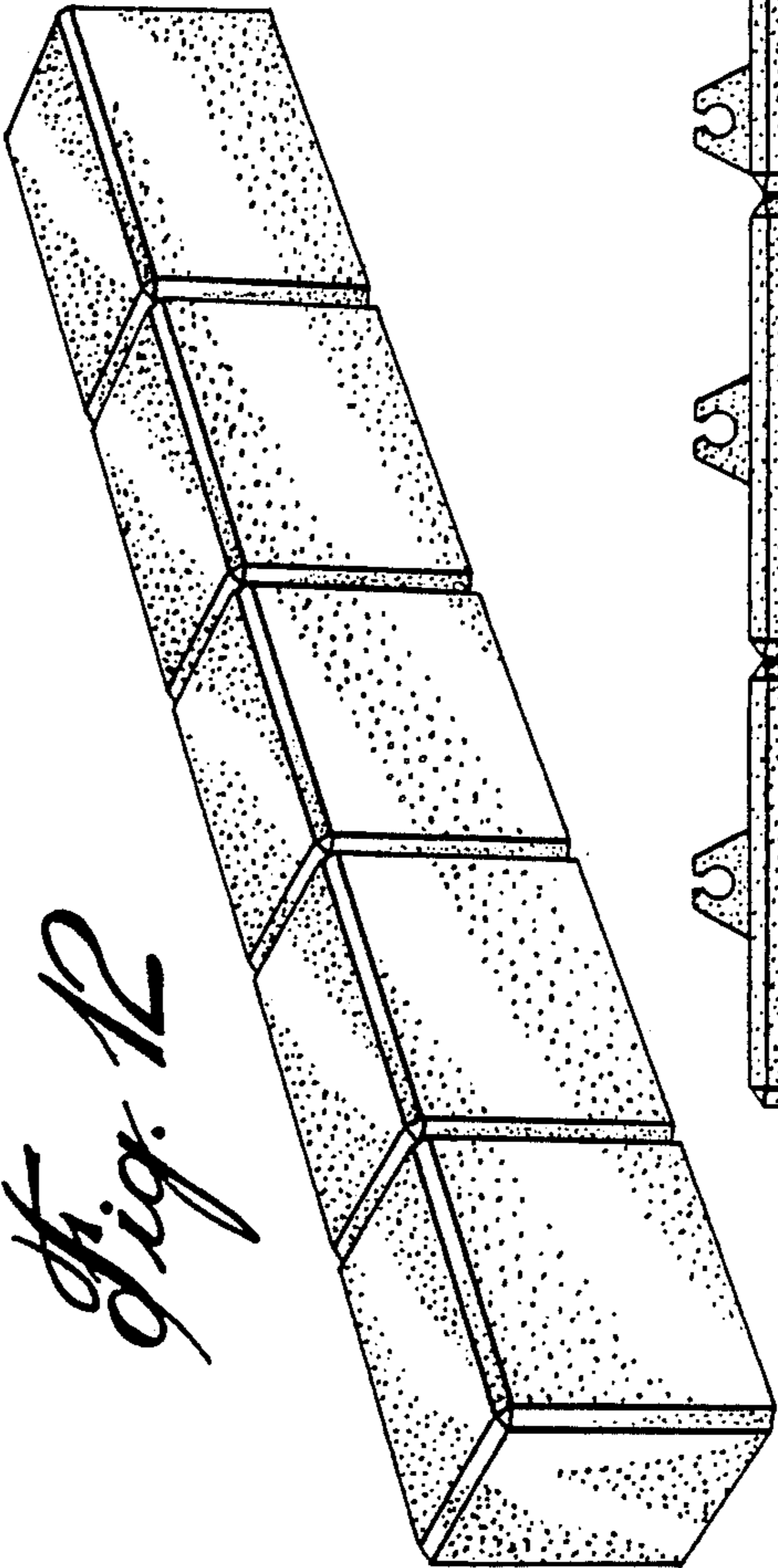
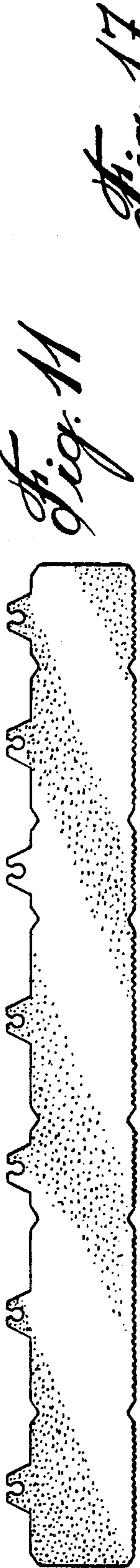
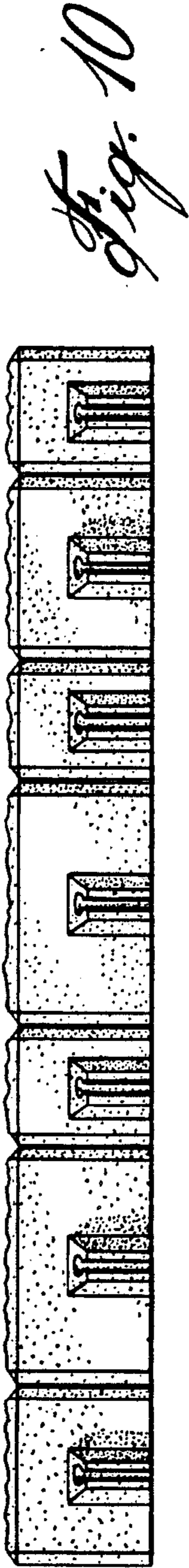


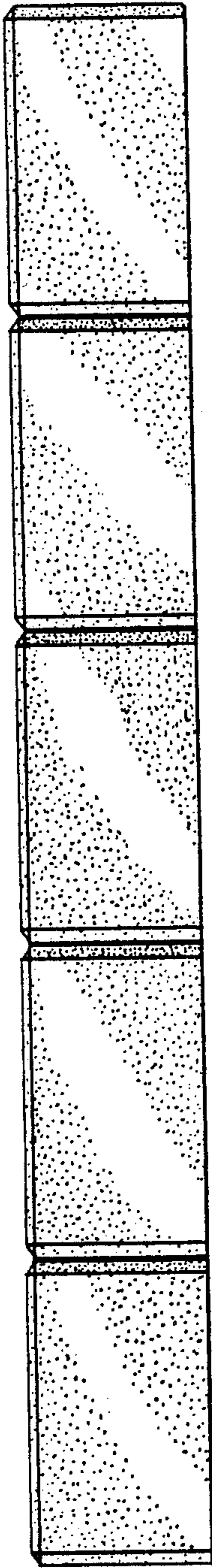

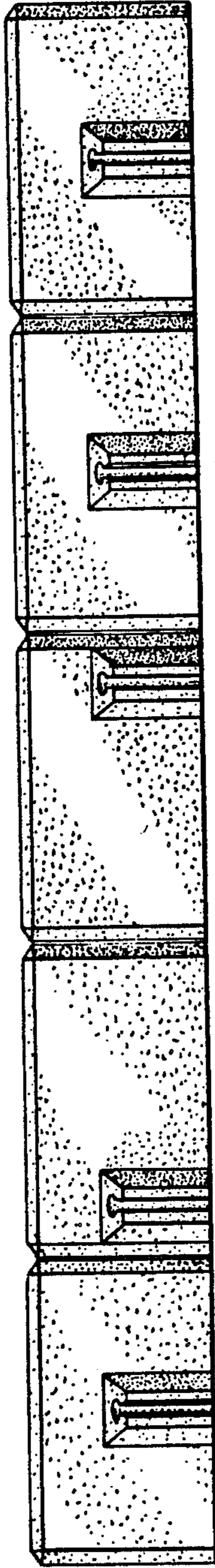

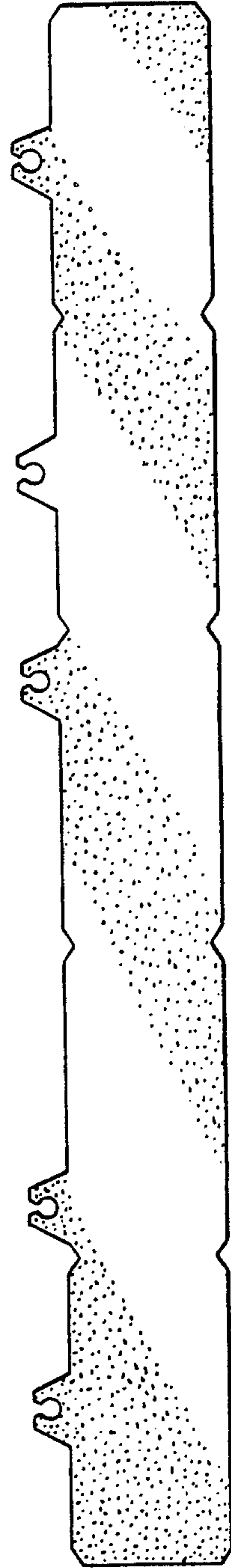
