DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a torchiere embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof taken from the right hand side of FIG. 2;

Since the side elevational views are identical, only a single view is illustrated.




