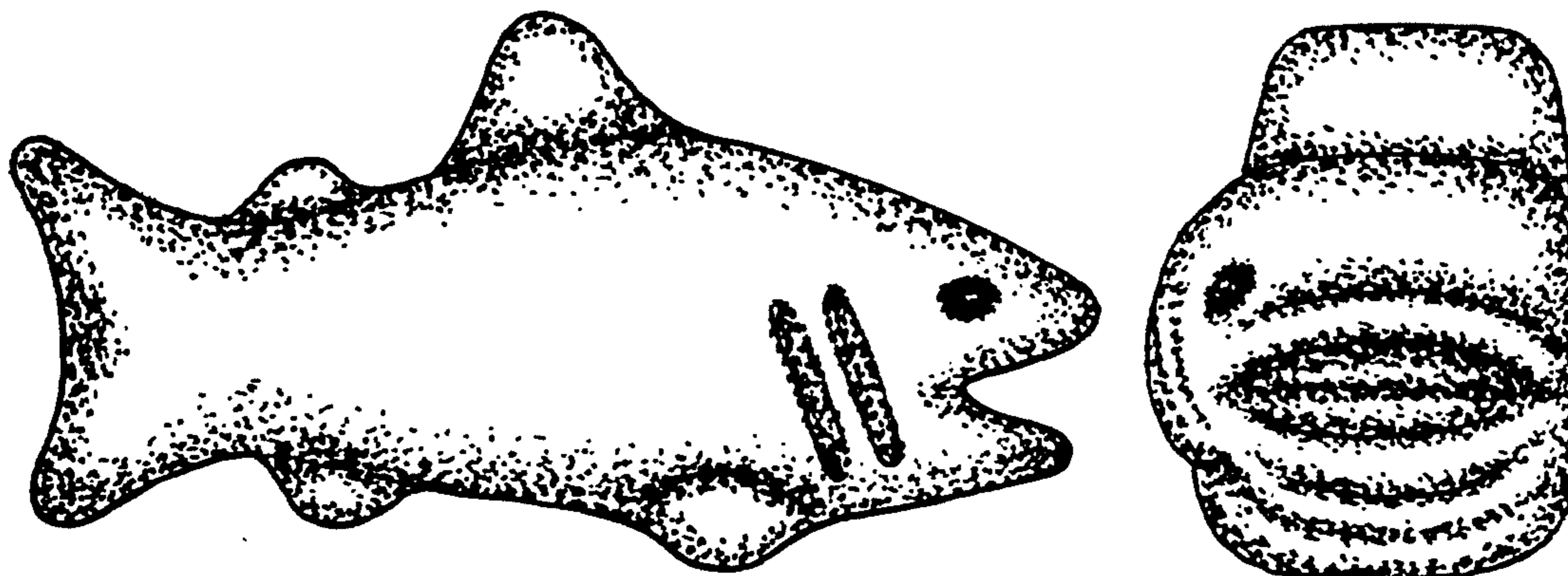

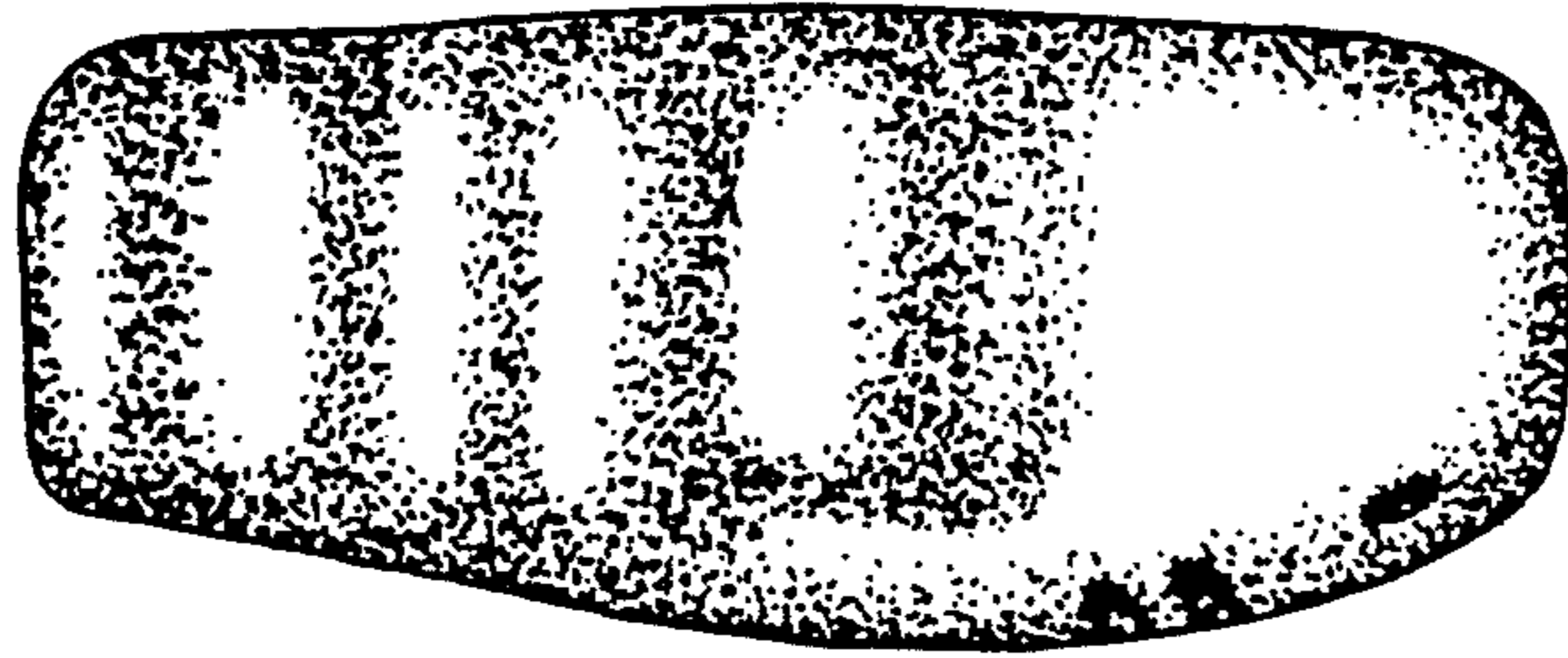
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a snack food product, as shown and described.

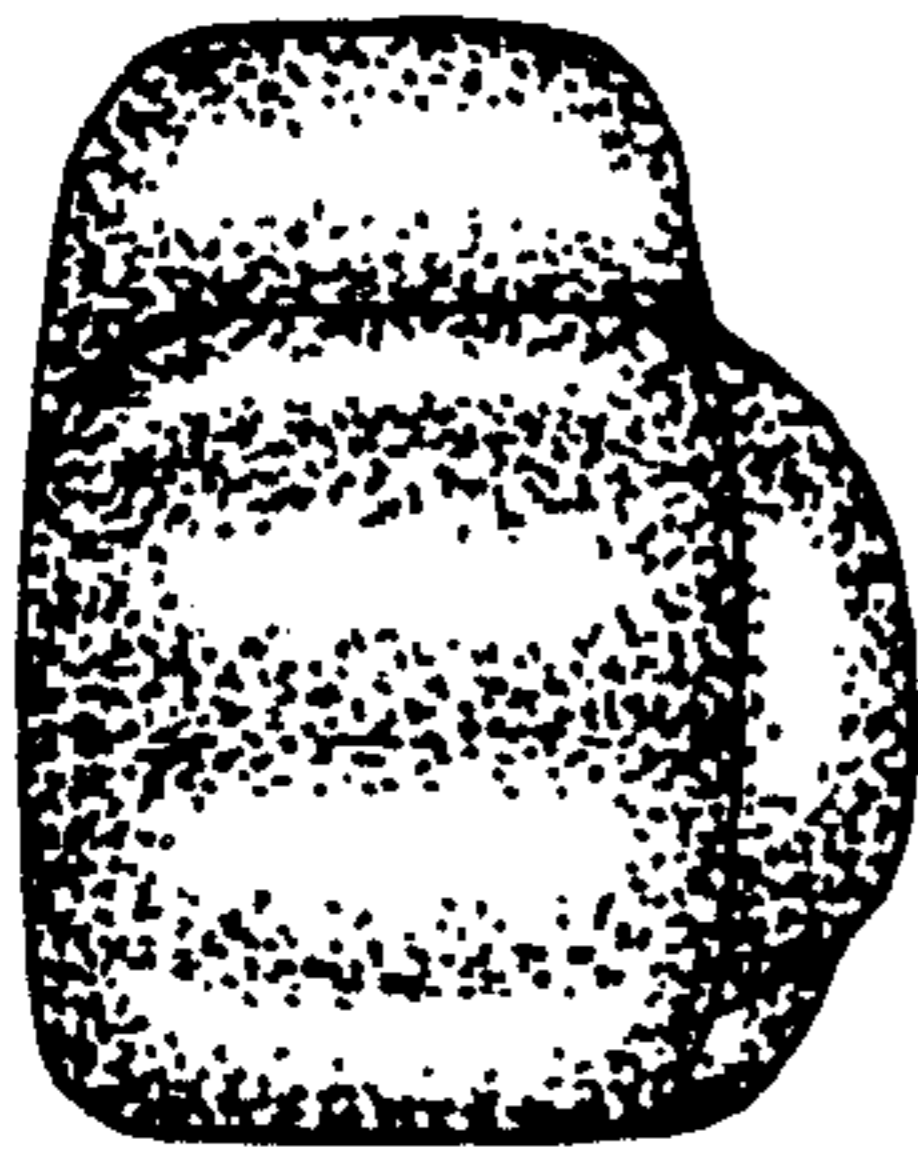
DESCRIPTION

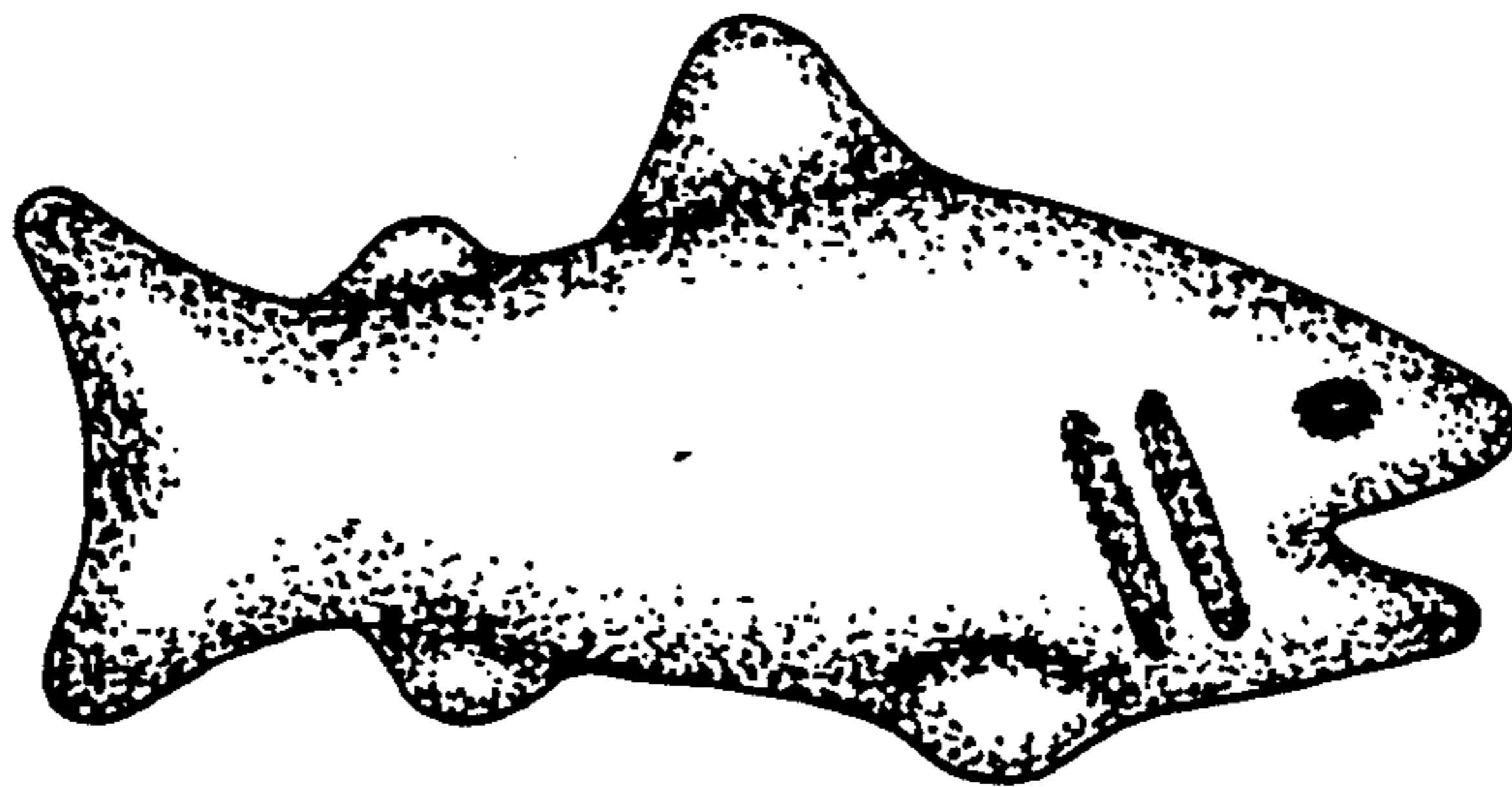




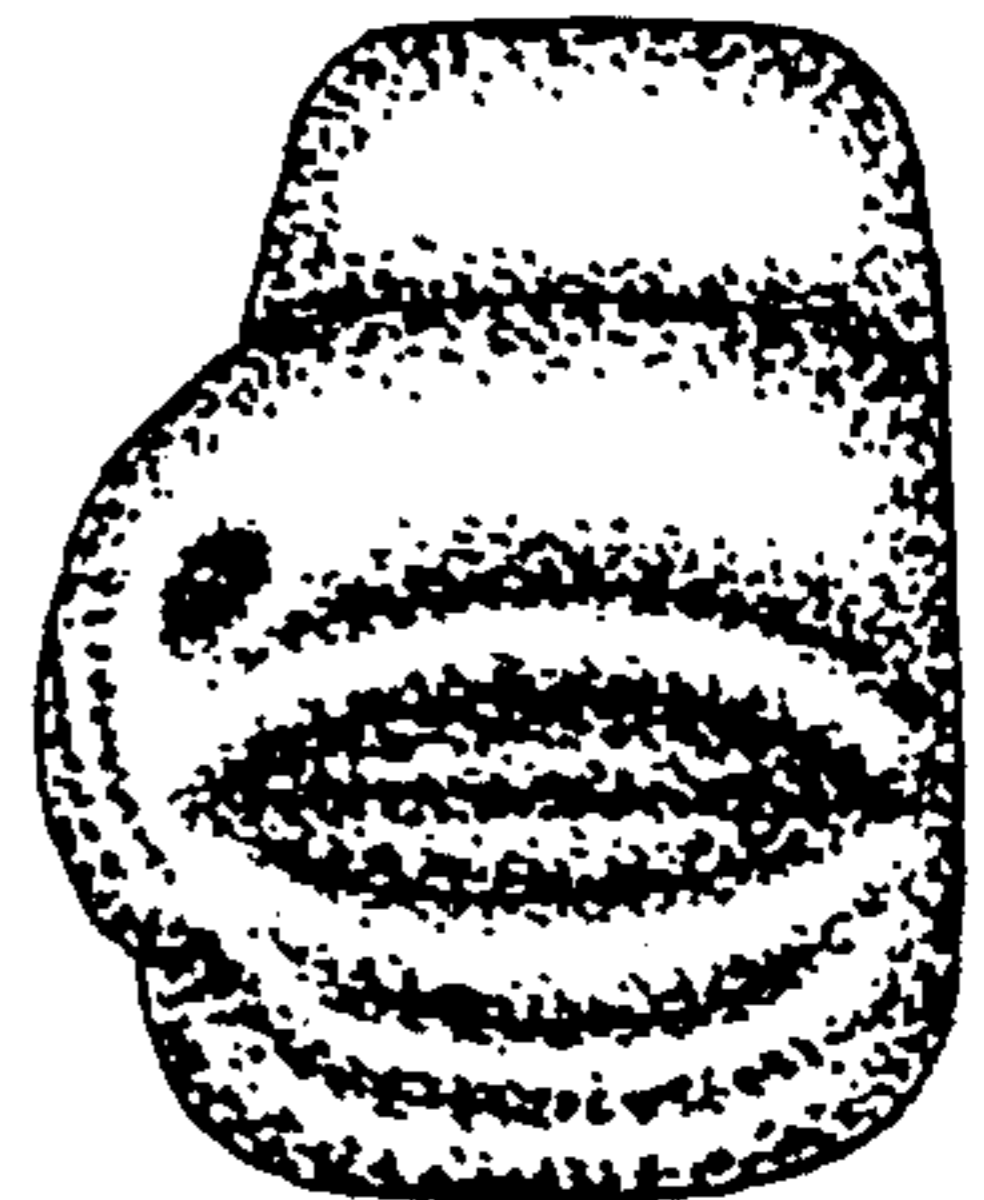

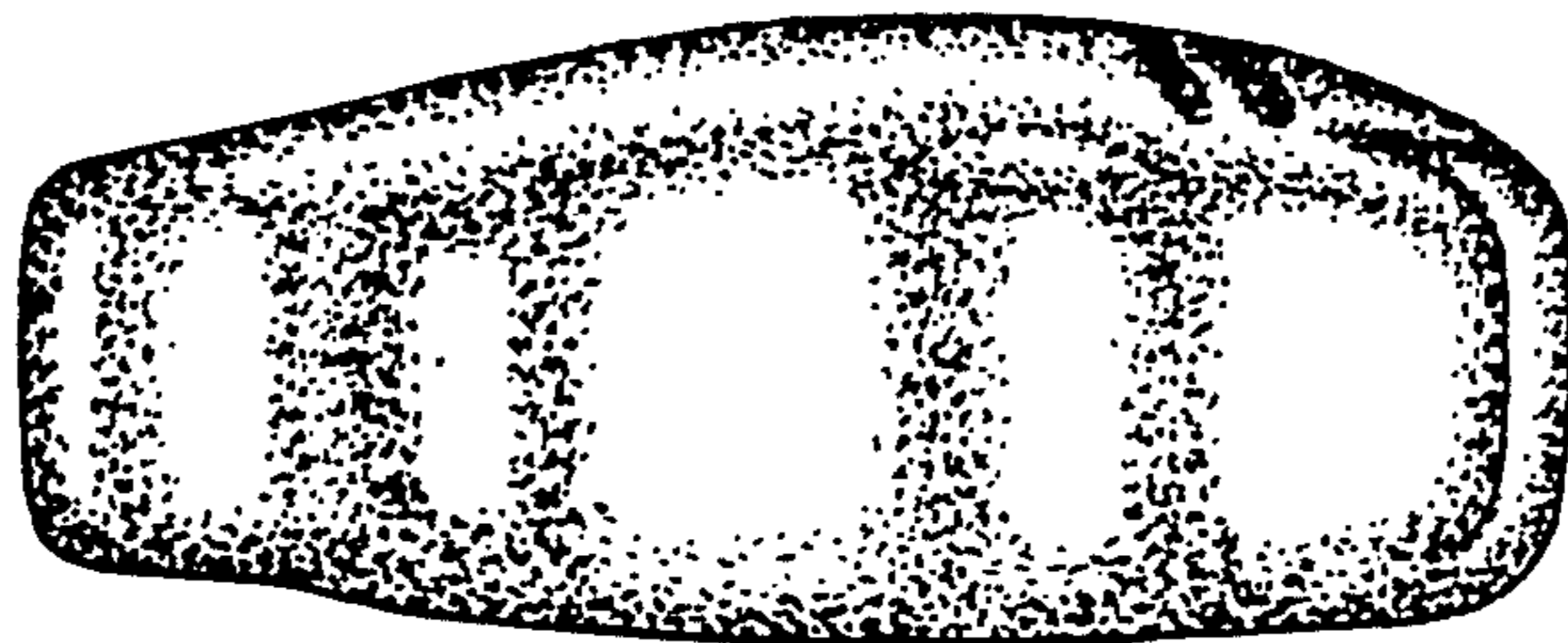

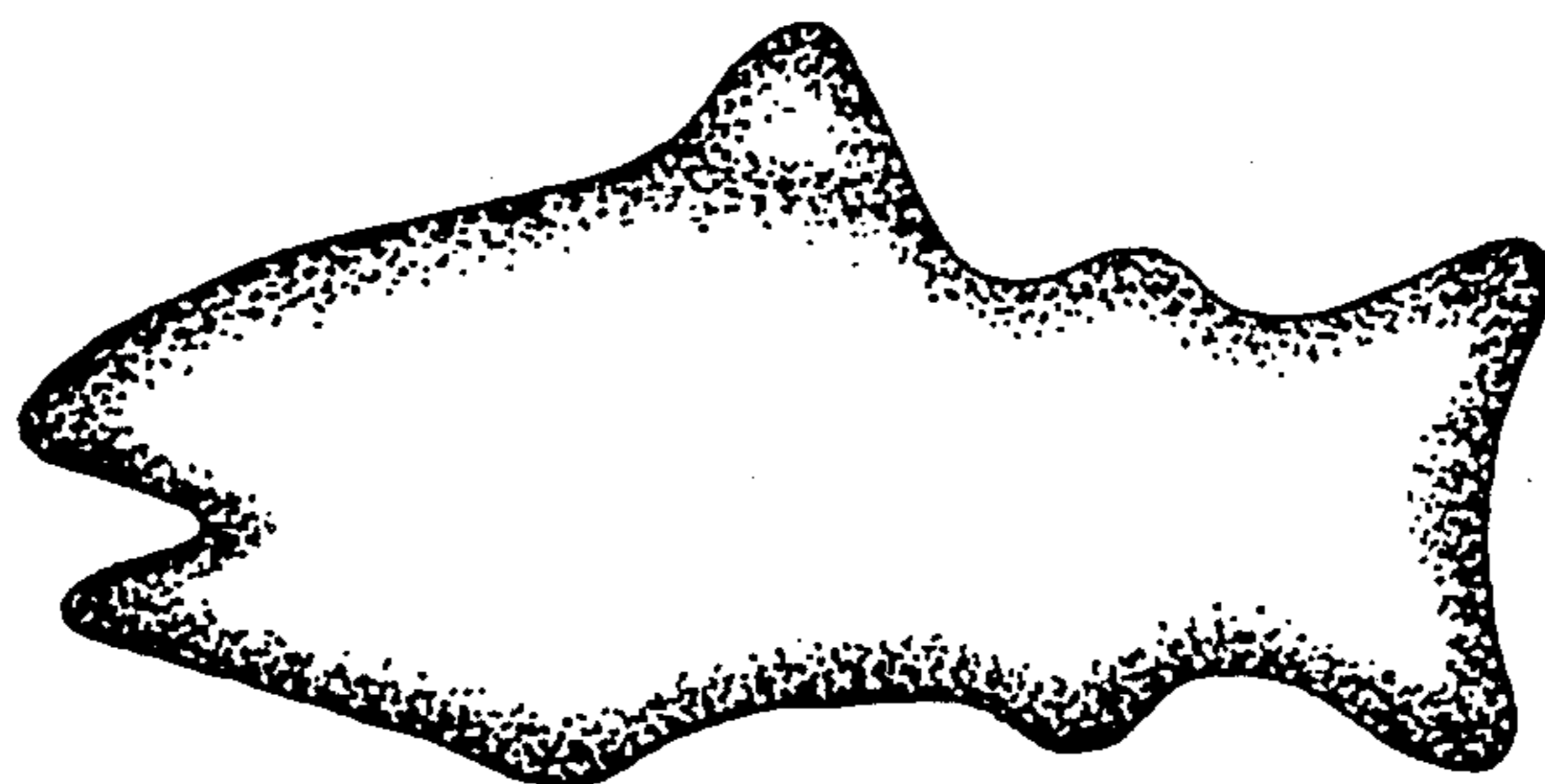
