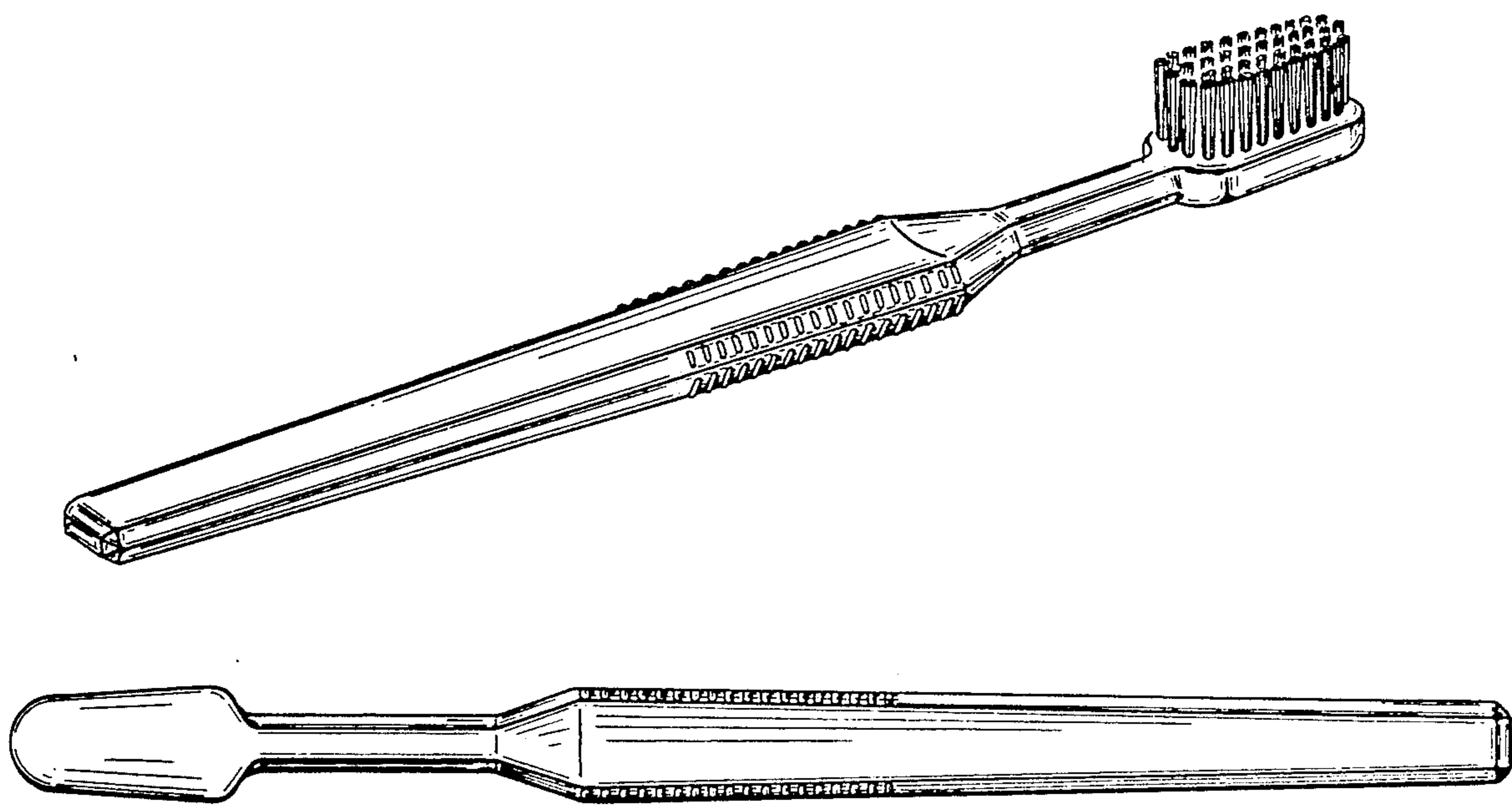

The ornamental design for a toothbrush, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a toothbrush, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the toothbrush shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being identical; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



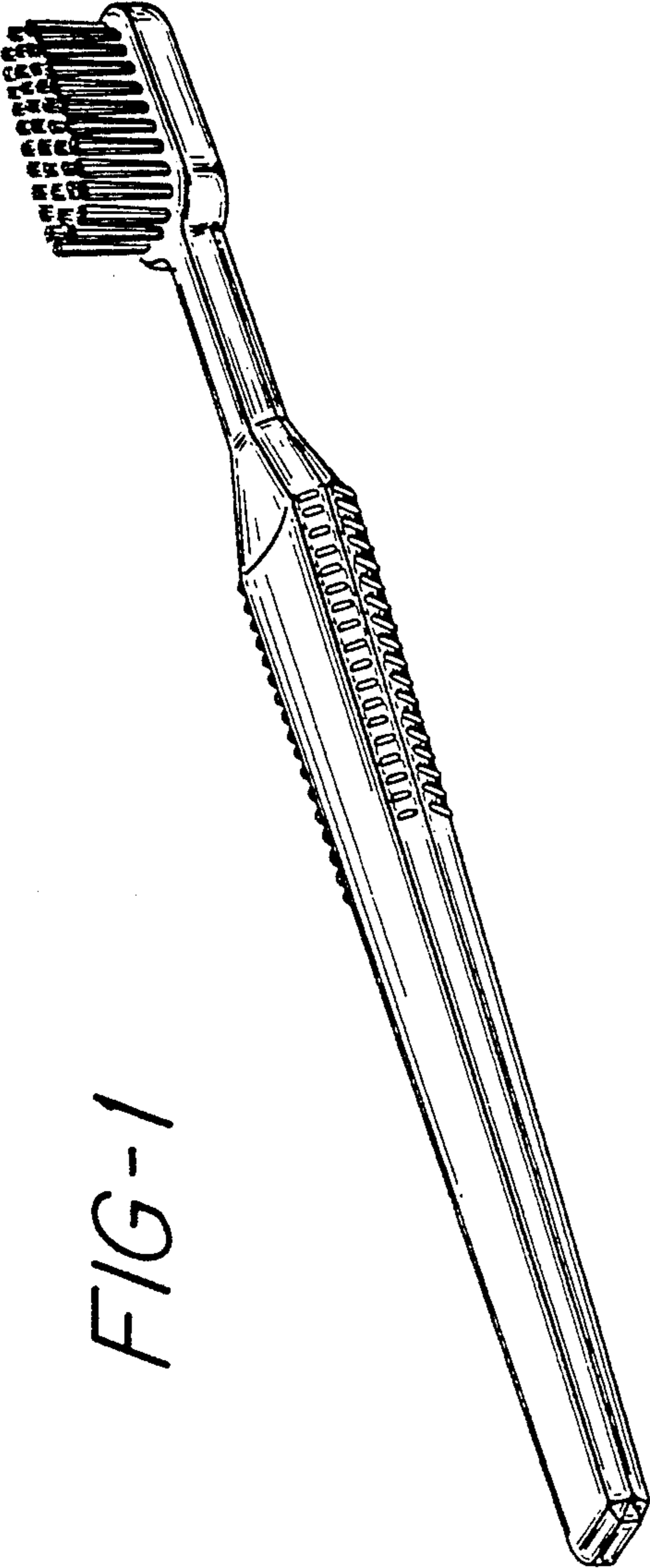

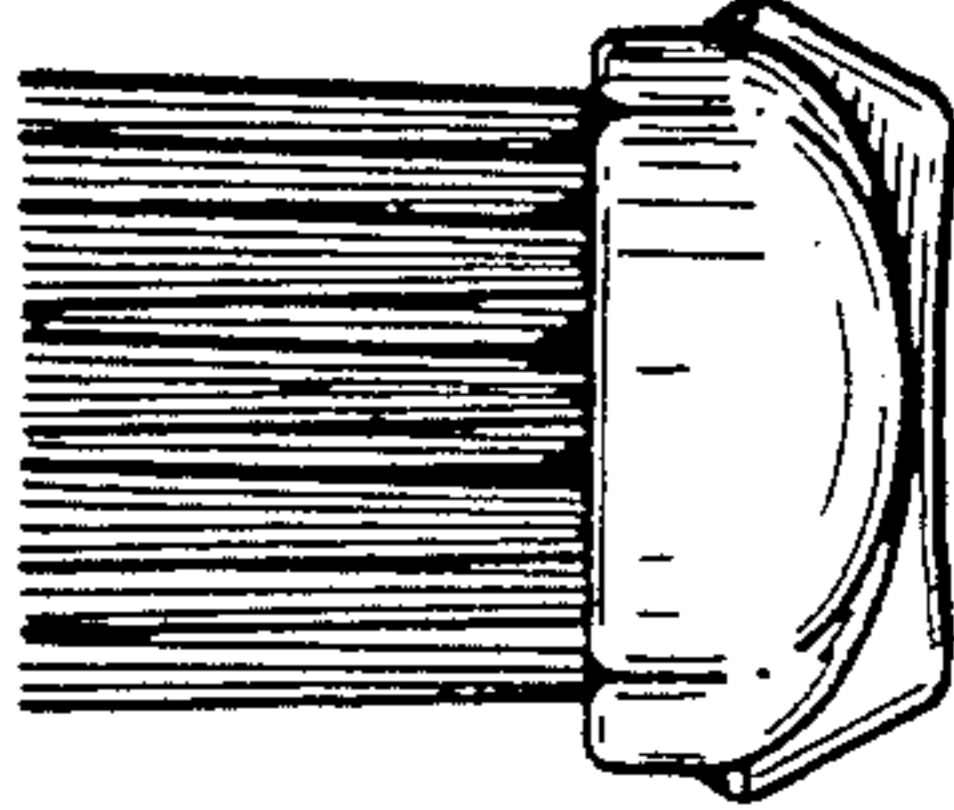

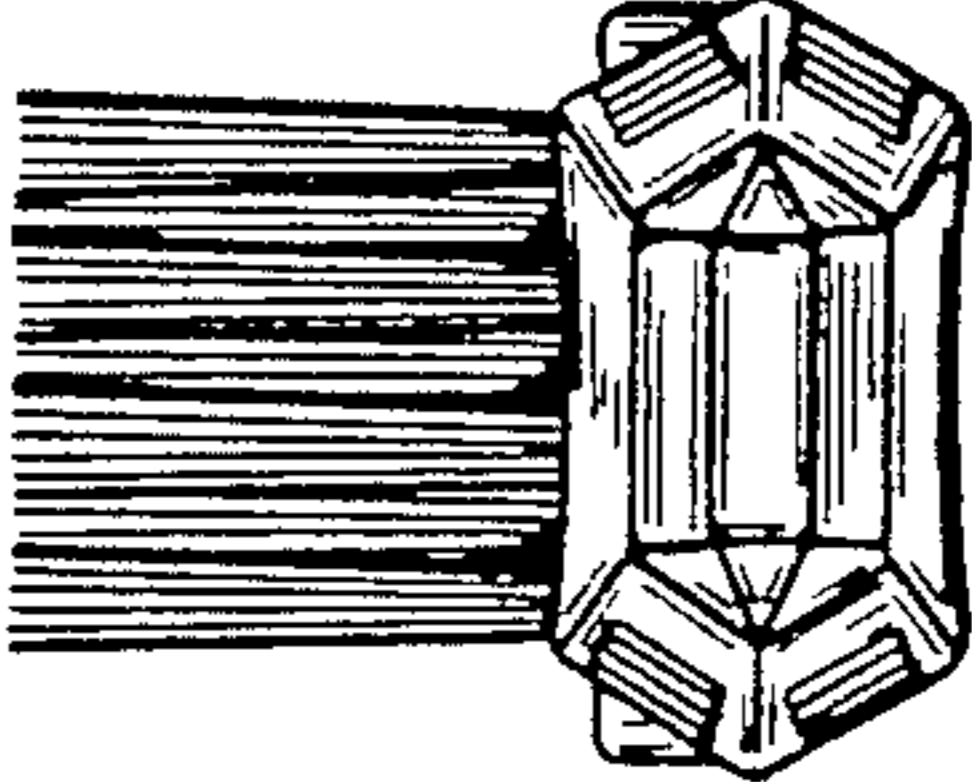

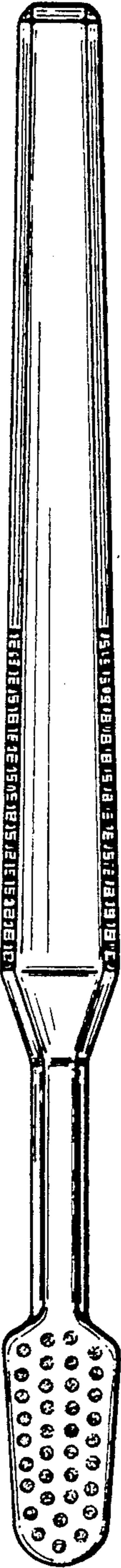

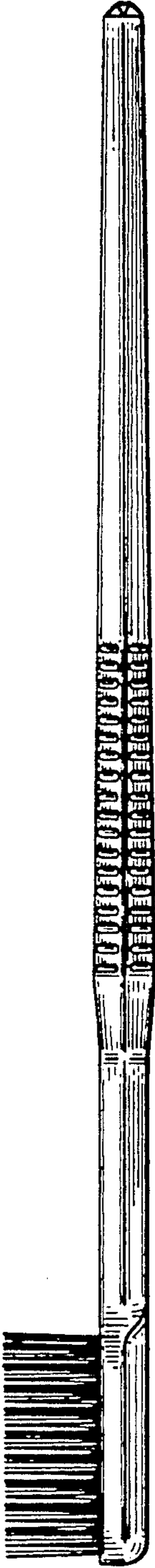

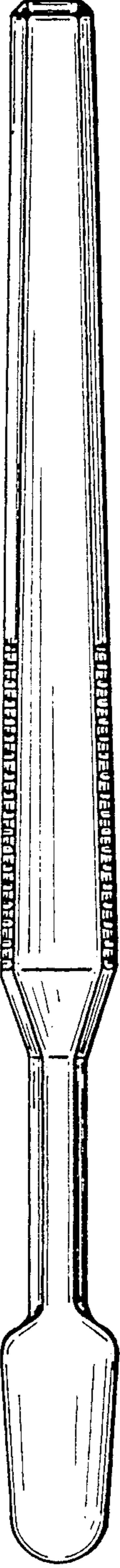
