FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a combined brush and scraper for boots and shoes showing my new design;

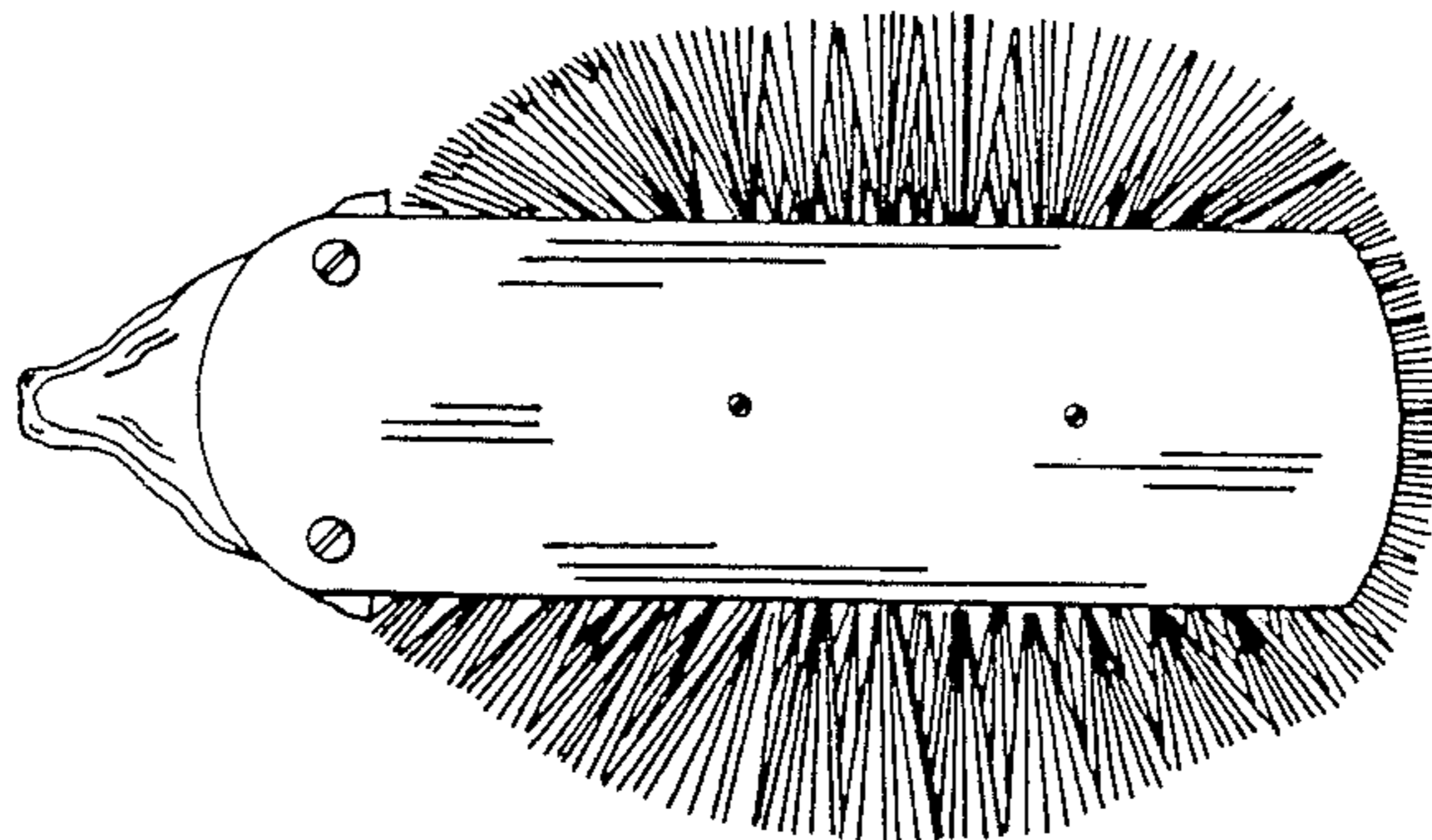
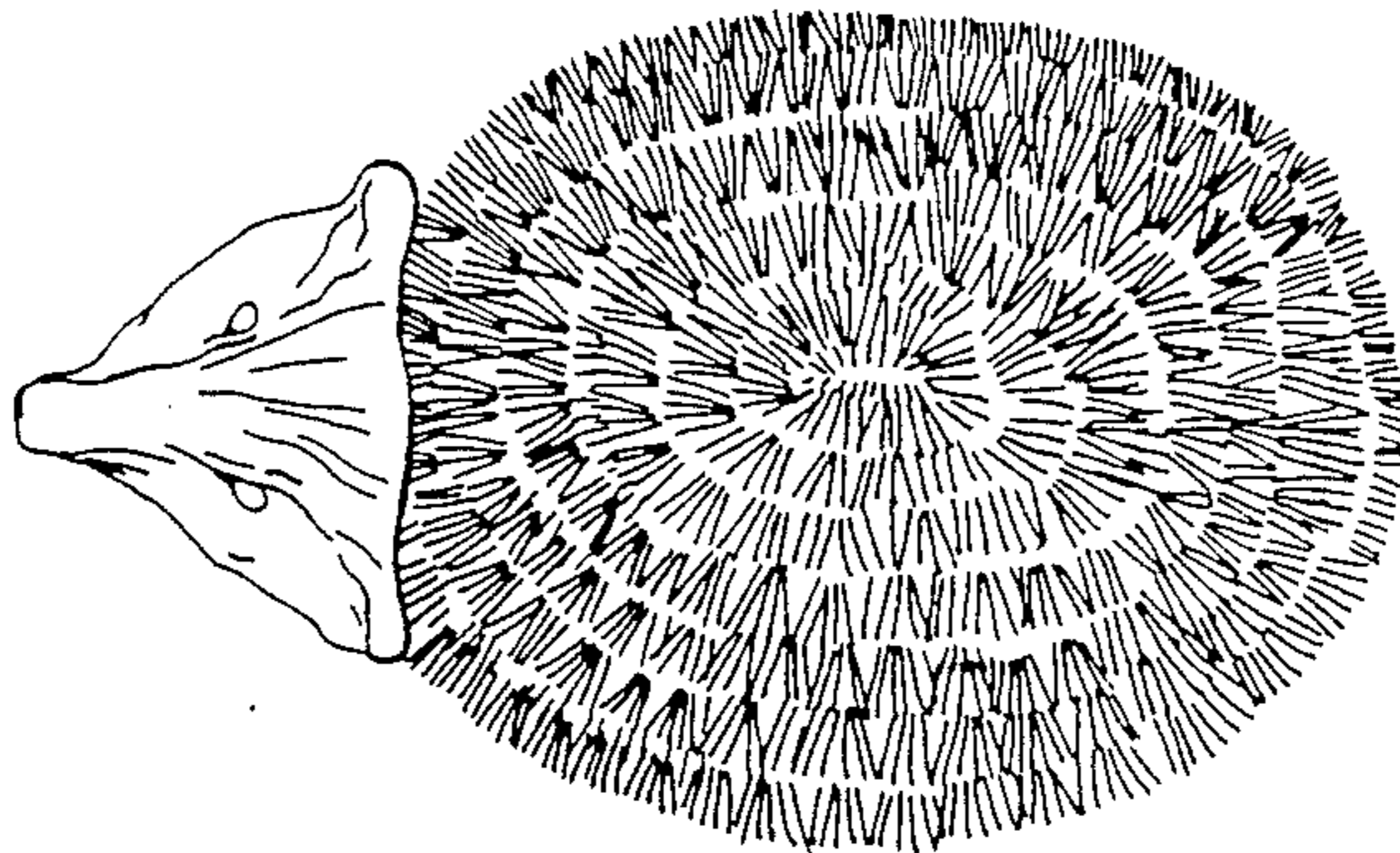
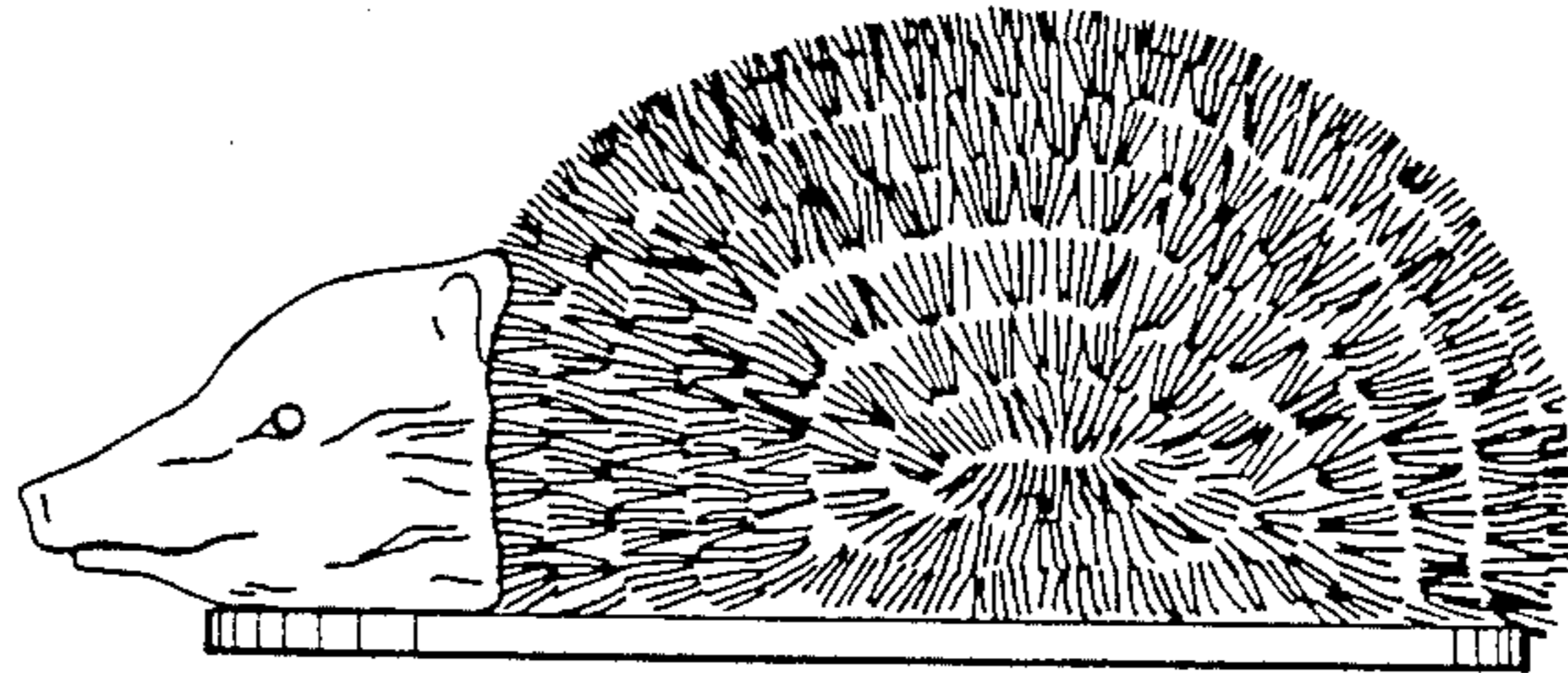
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



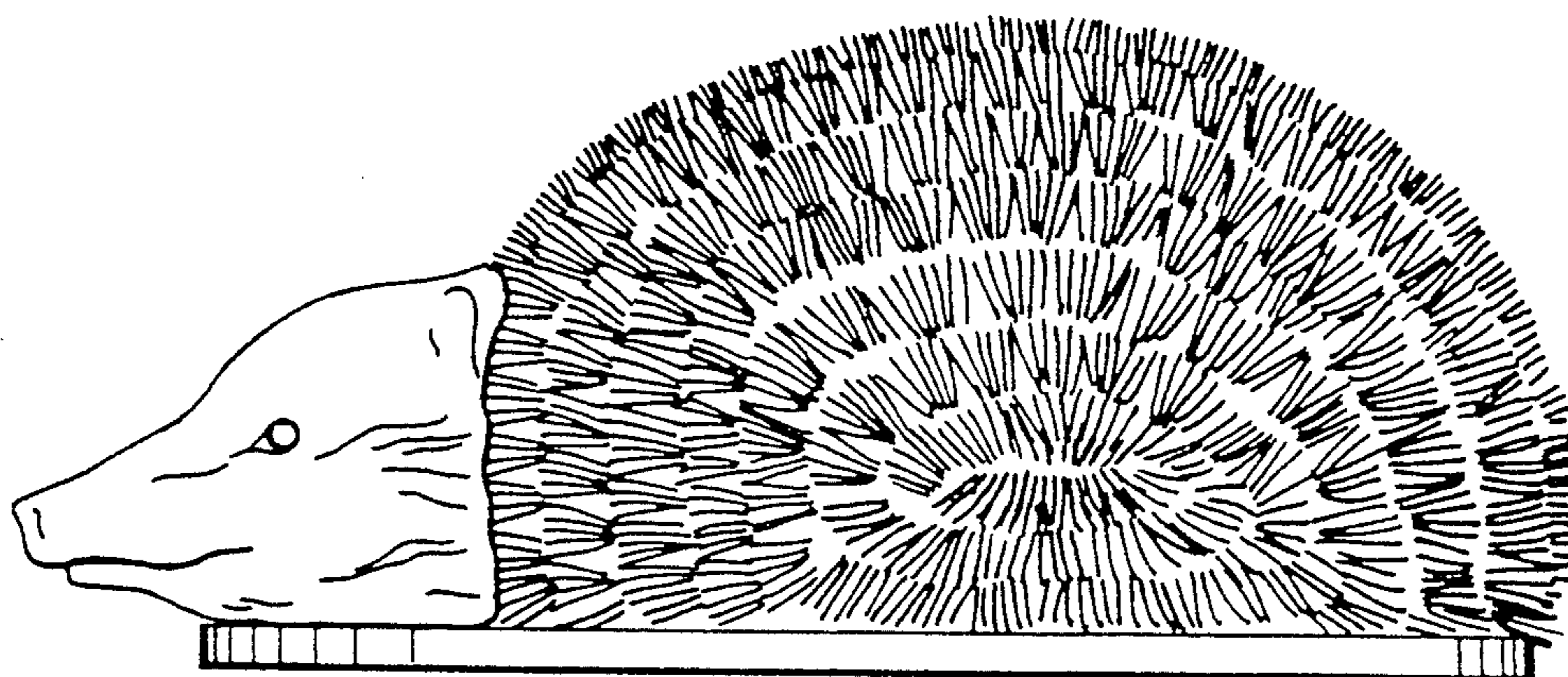

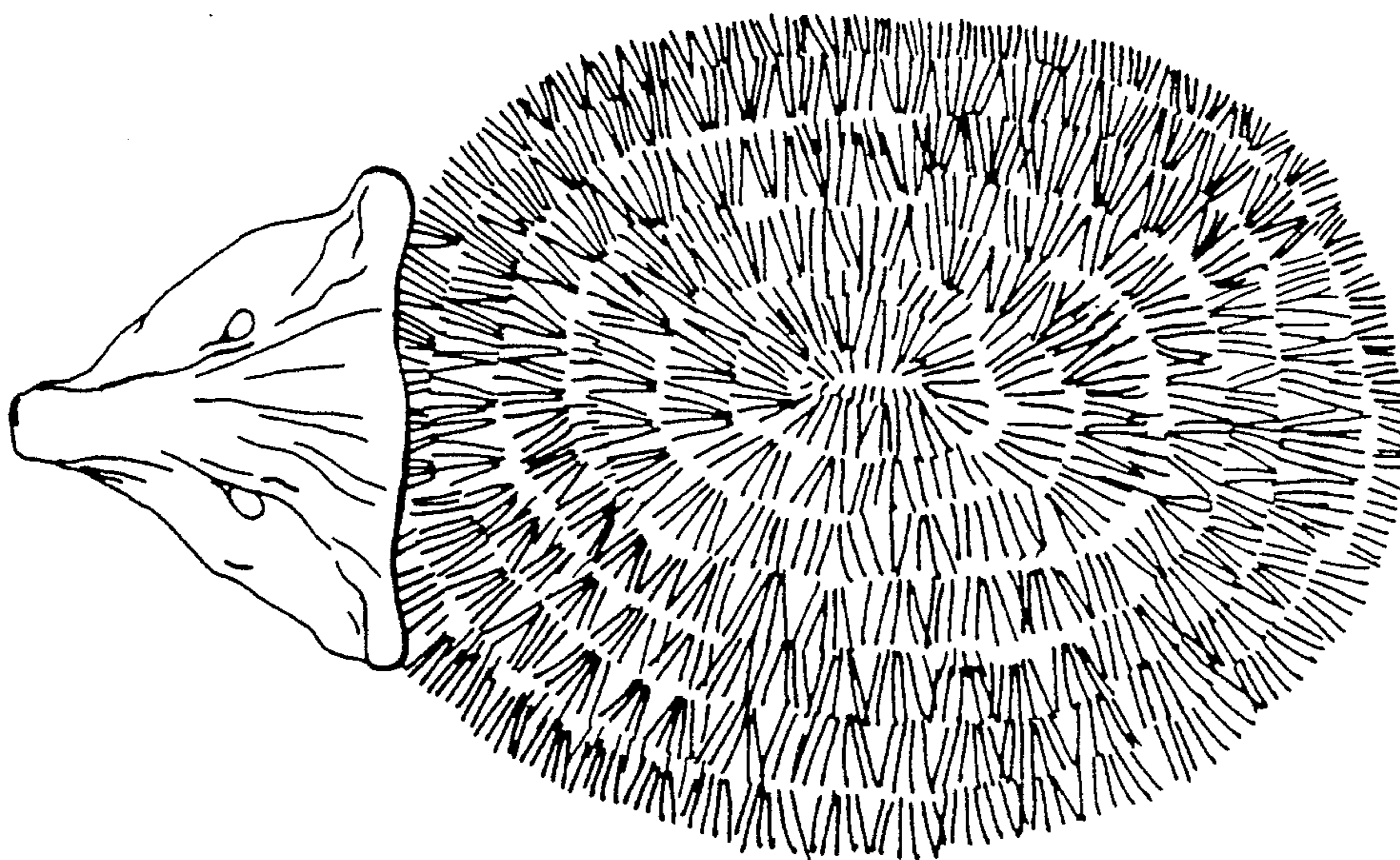

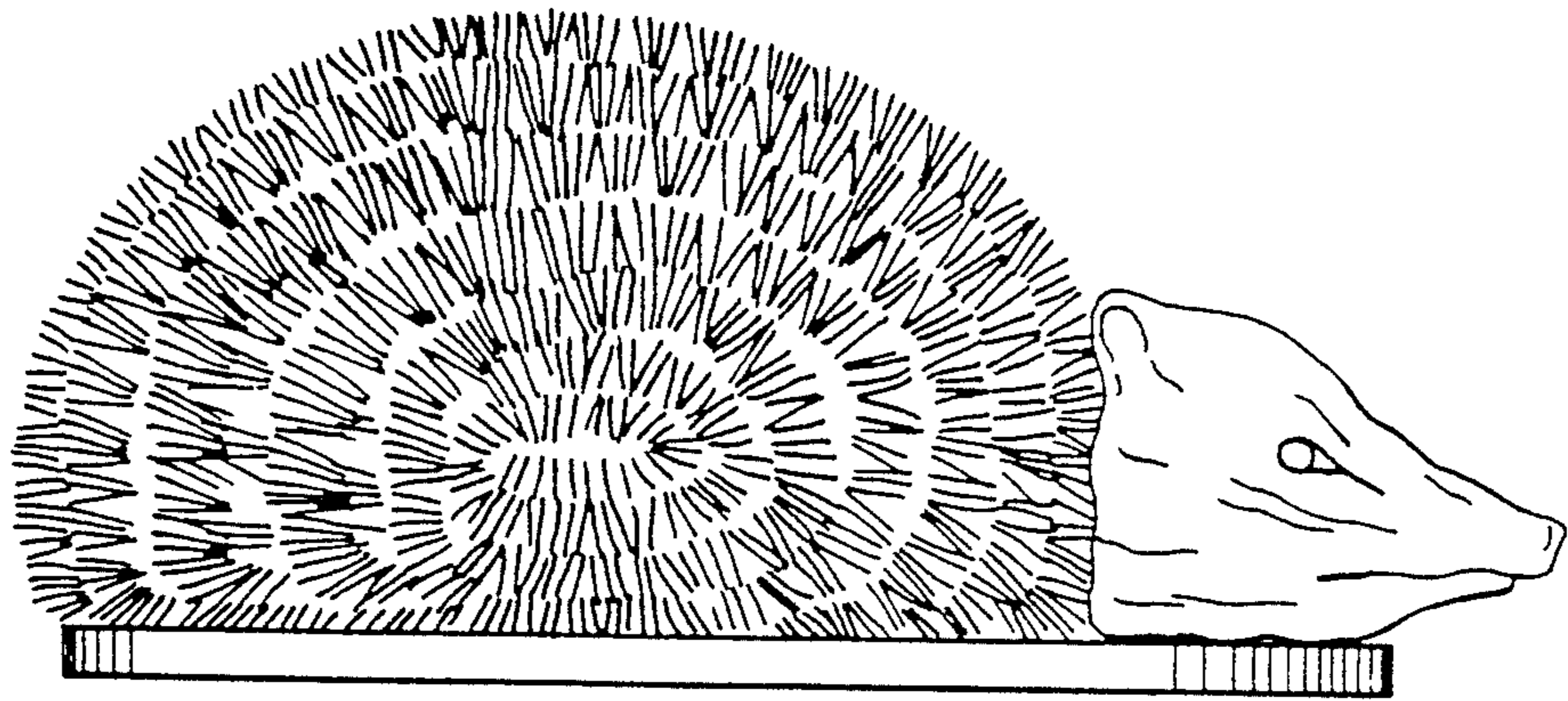

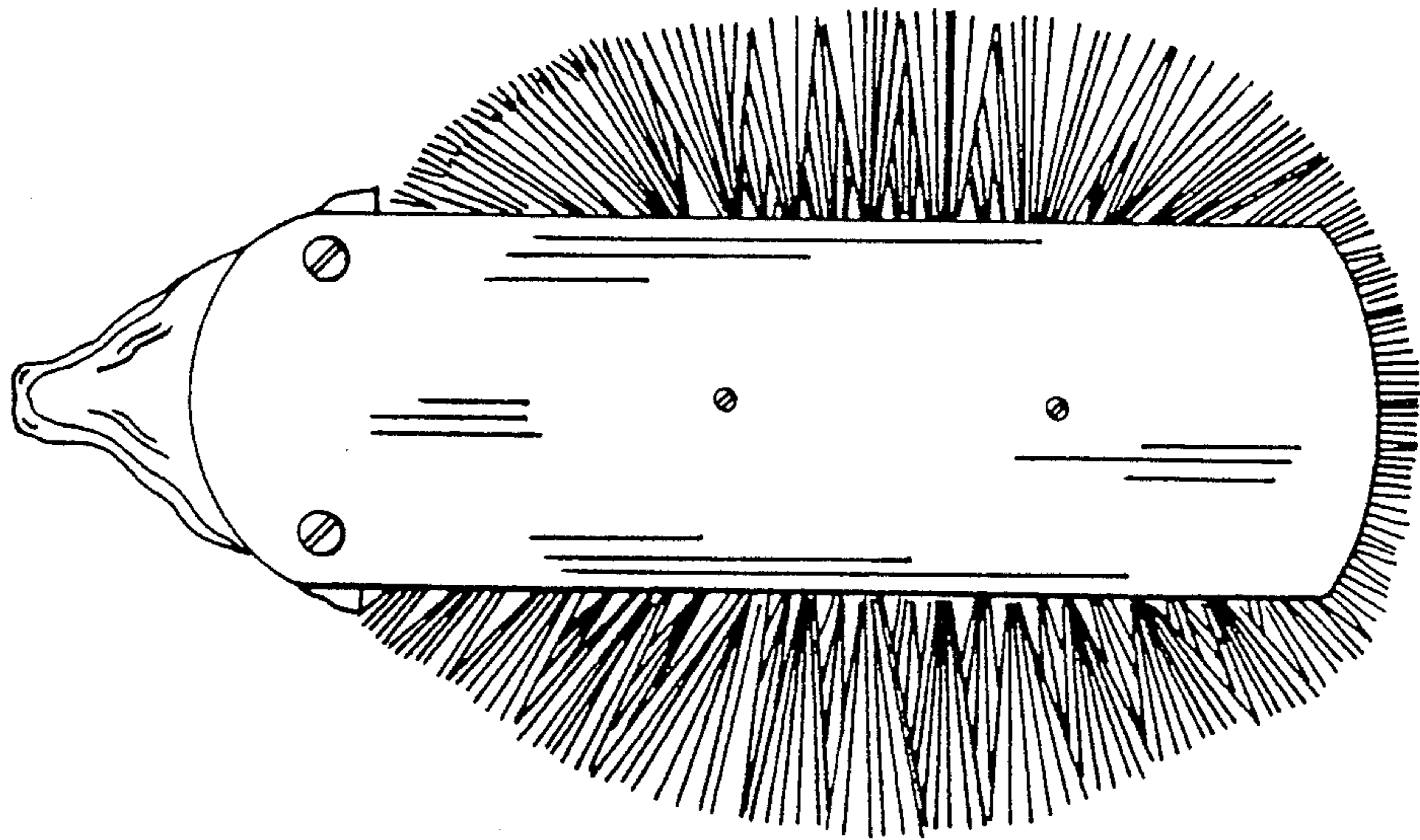

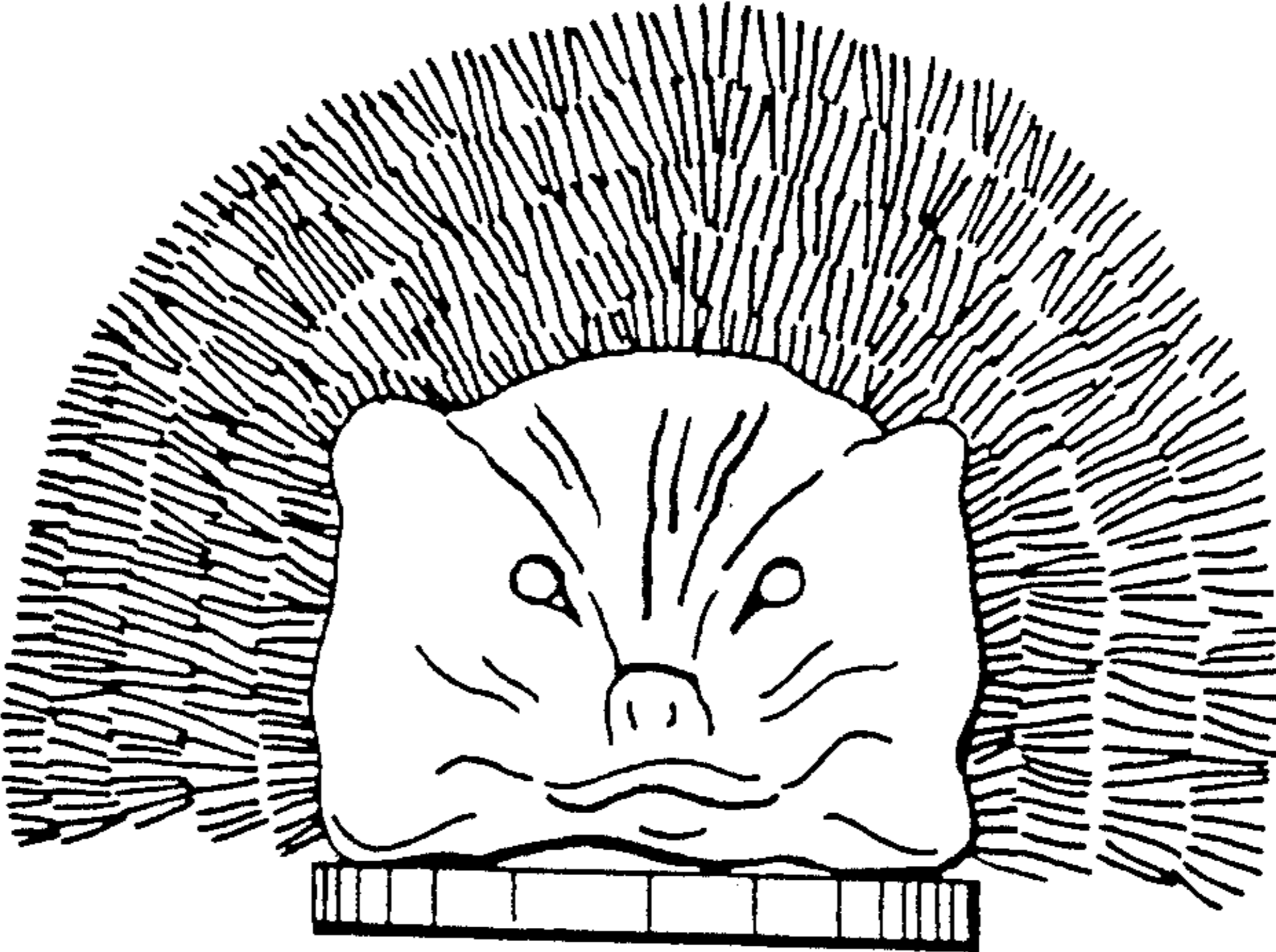

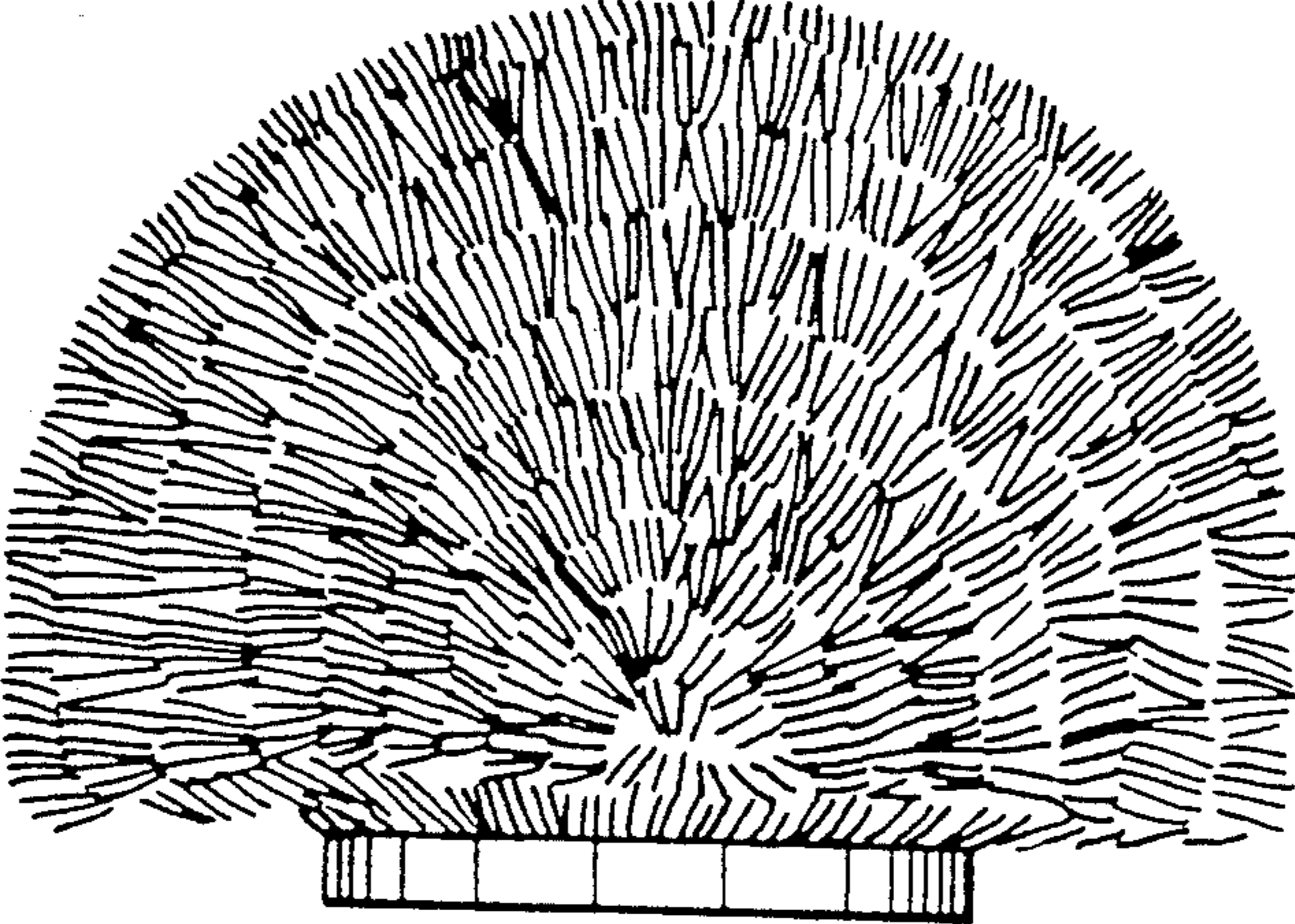
