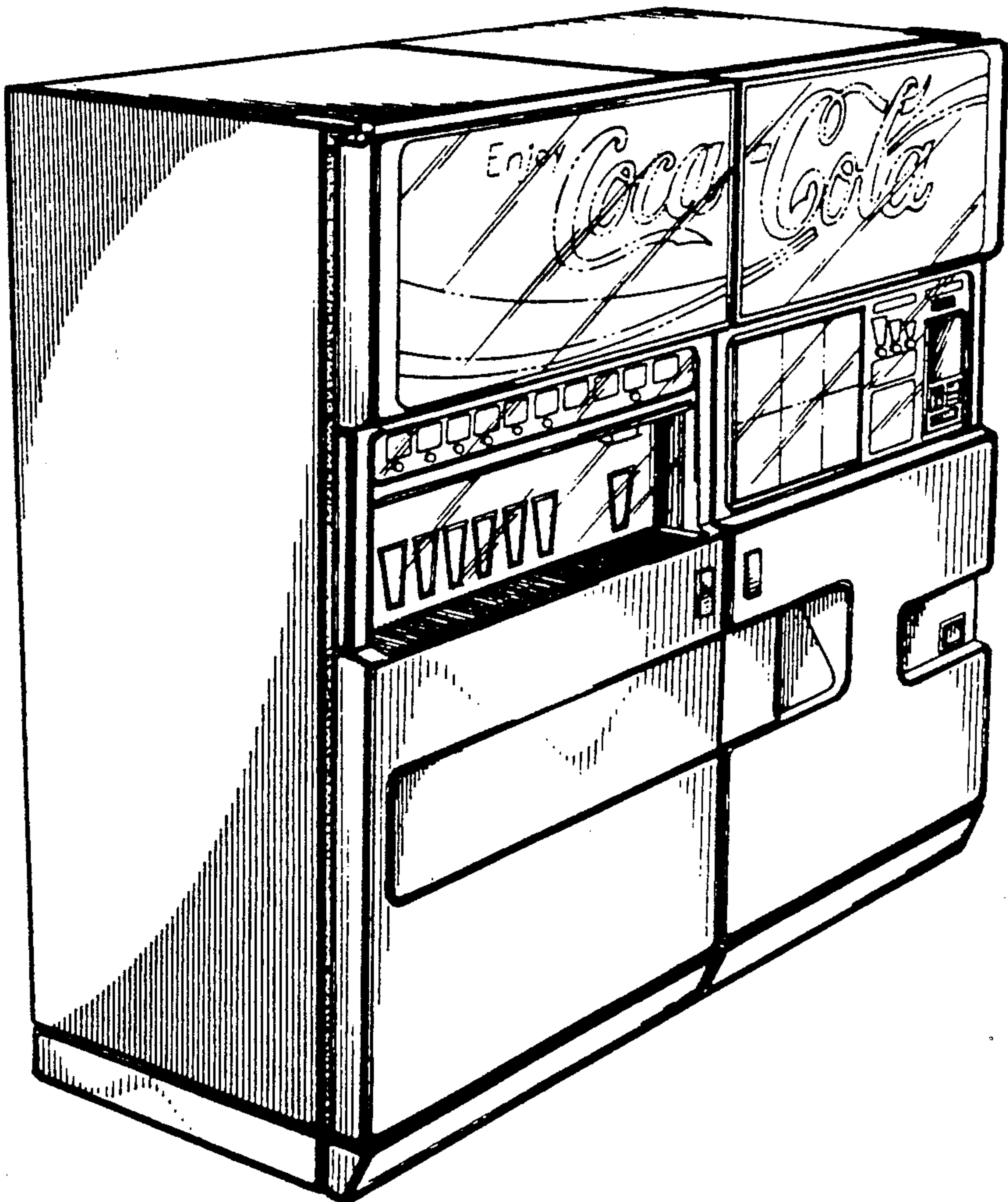

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front left side perspective view of a vending machine showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof. The portions shown in broken lines are disclosed for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.



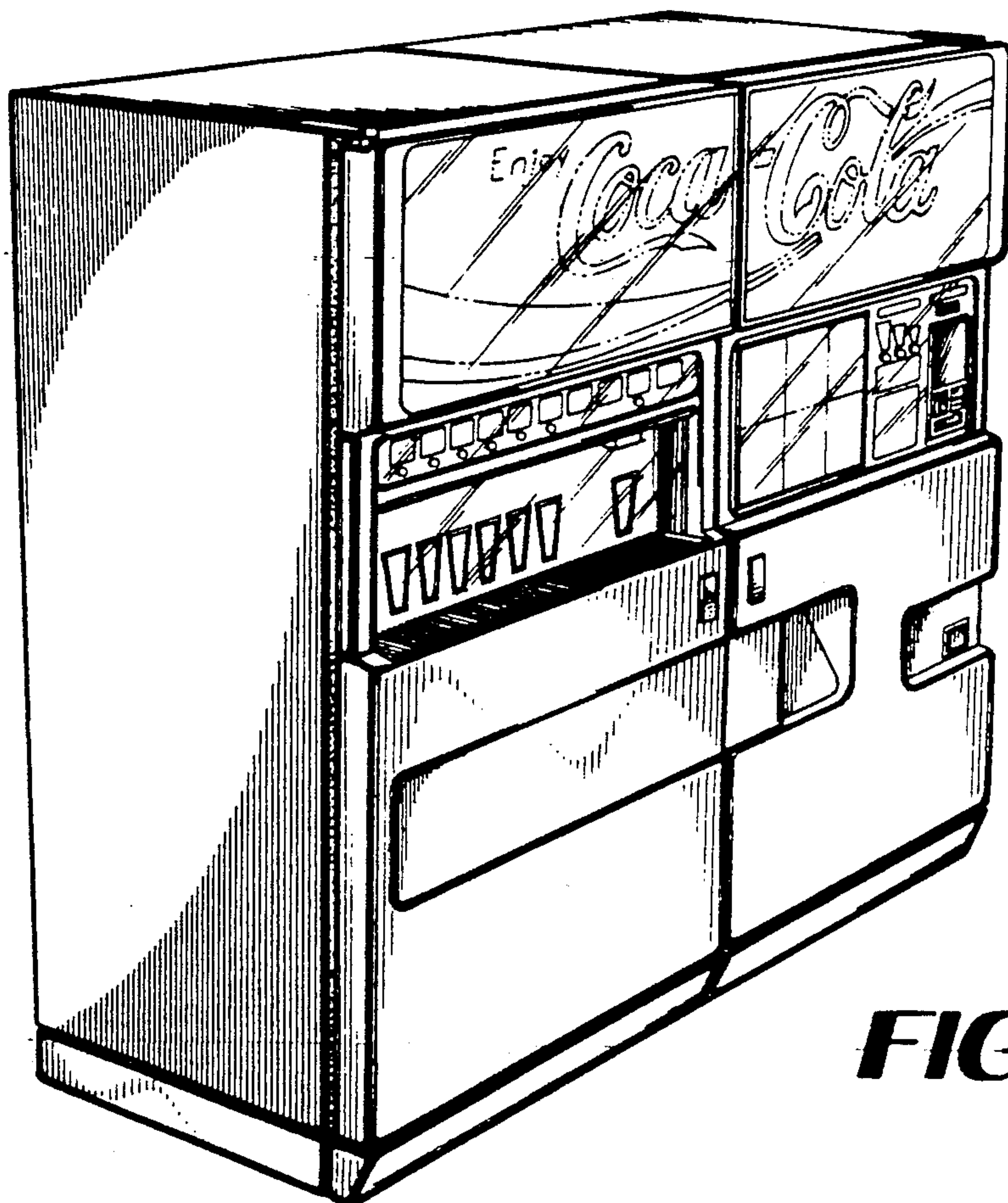

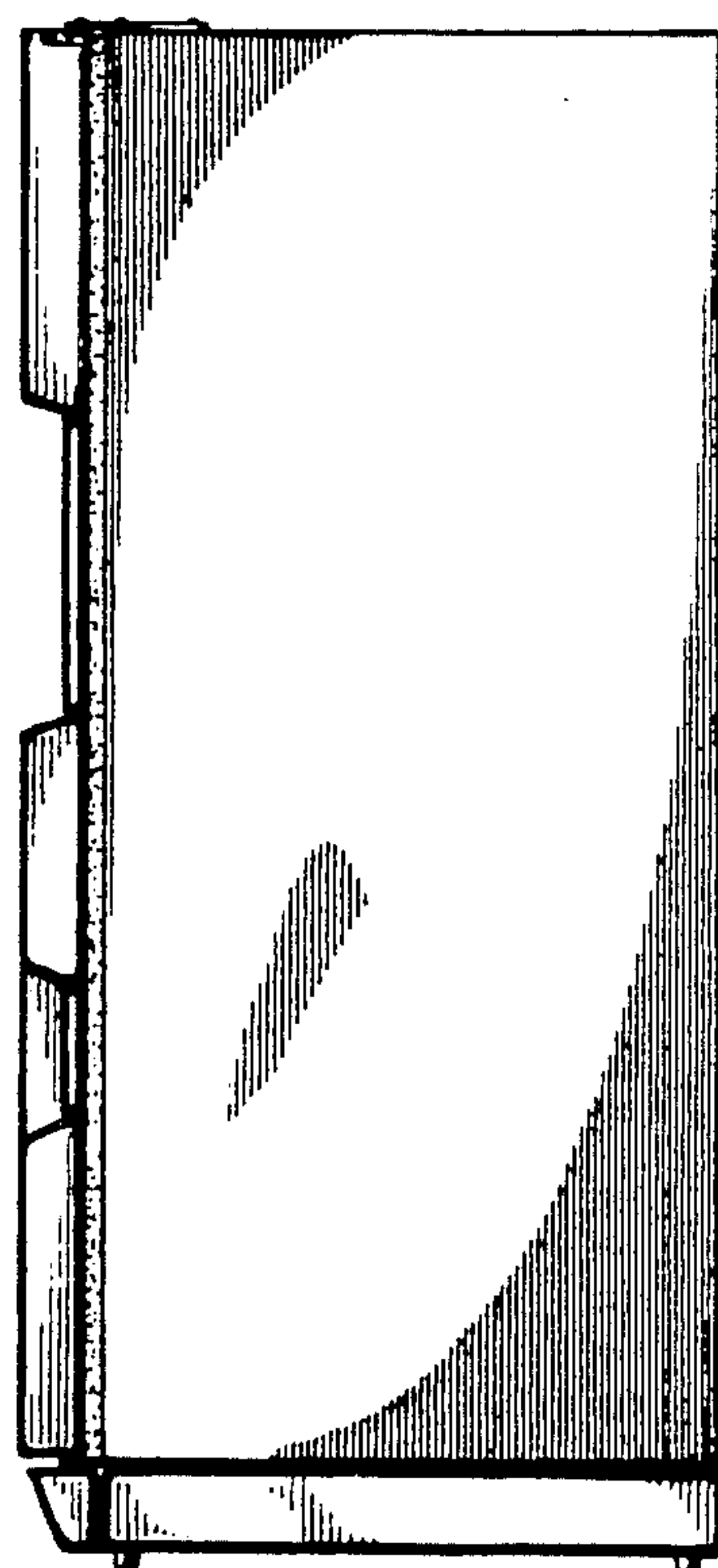

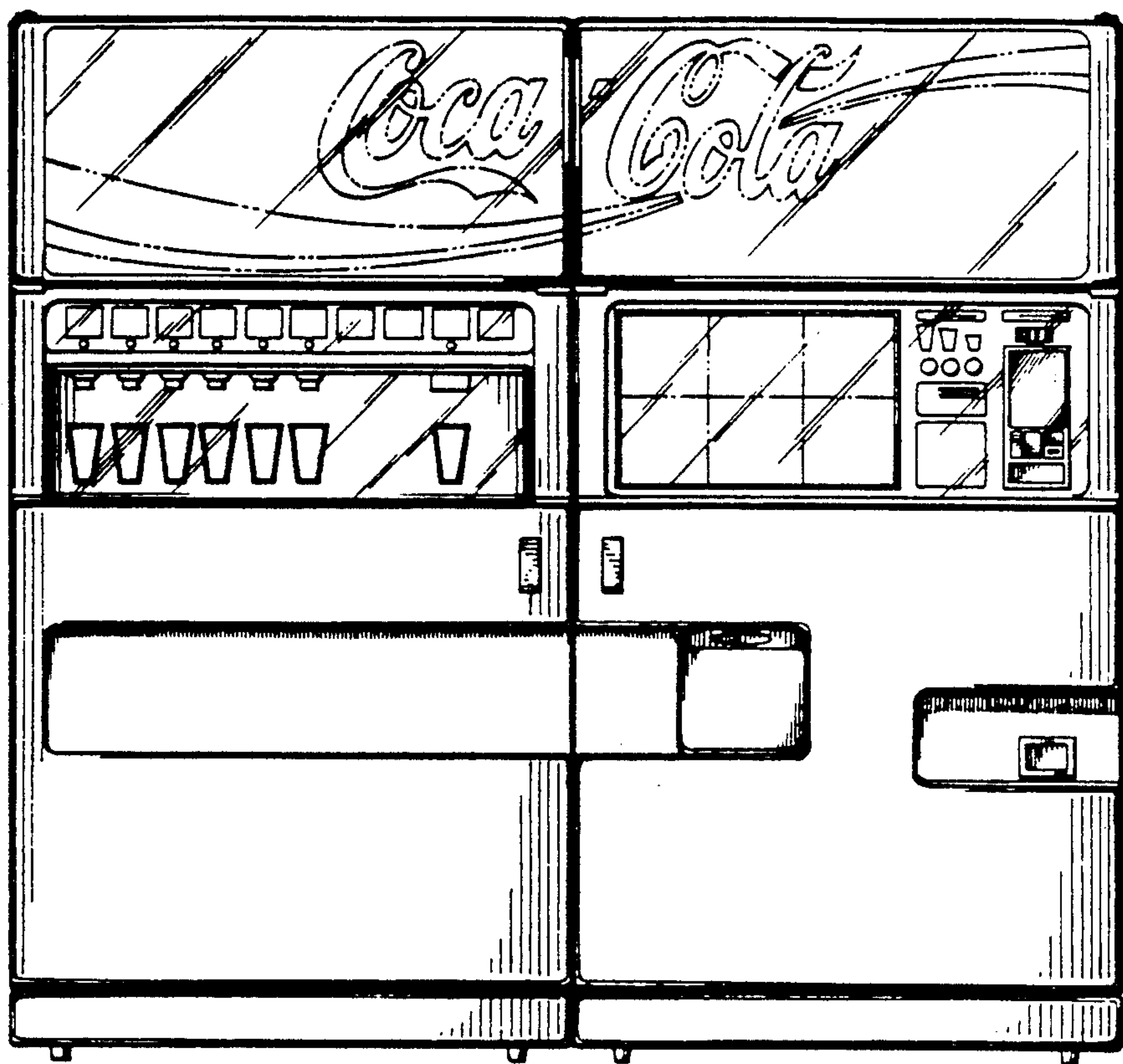

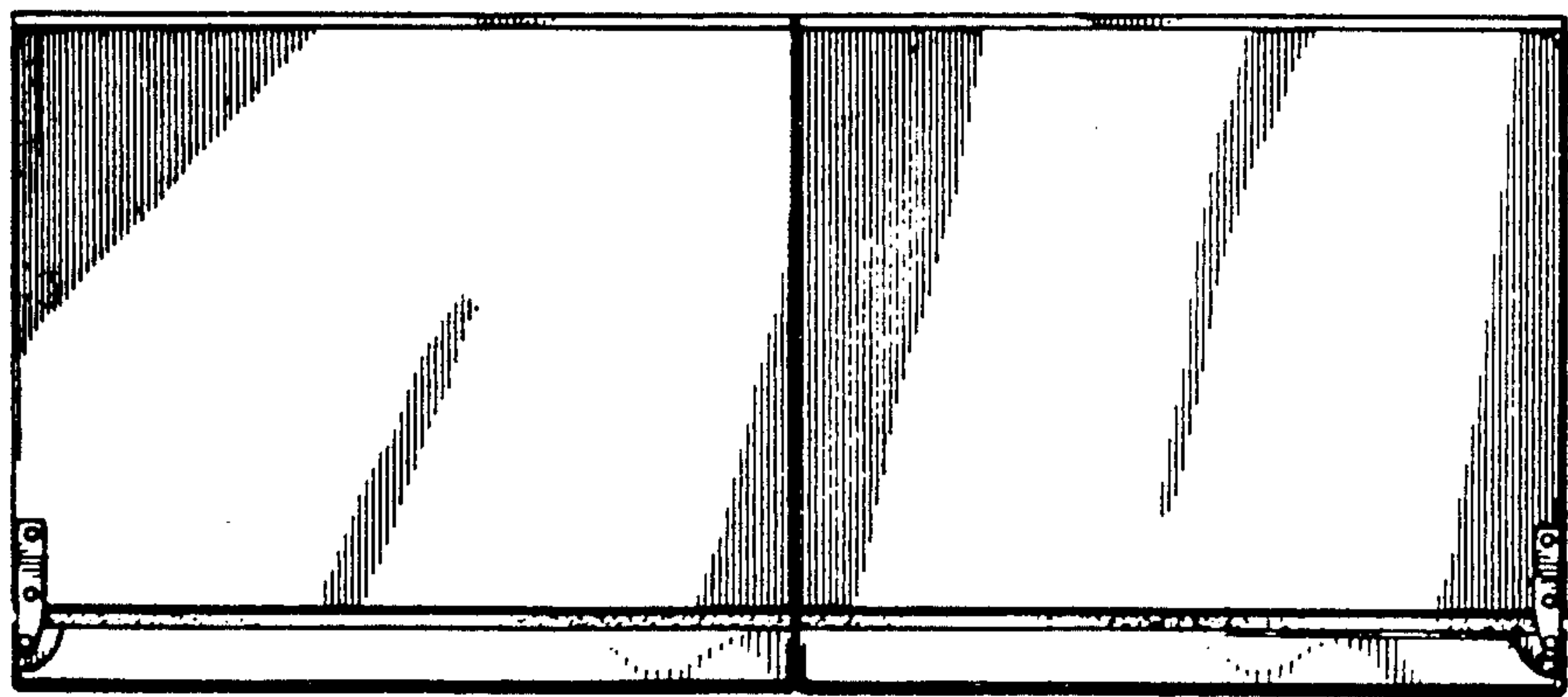

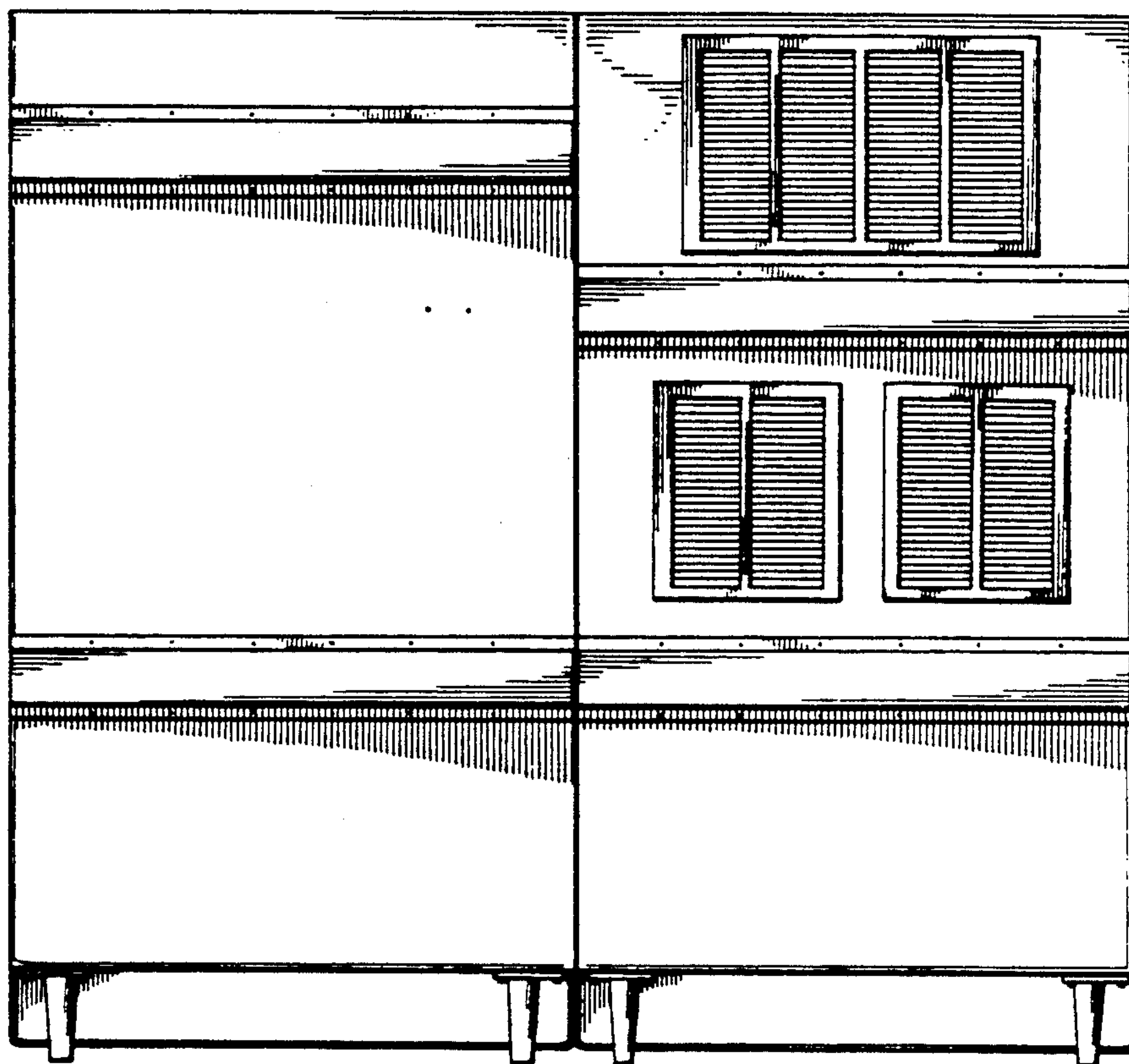

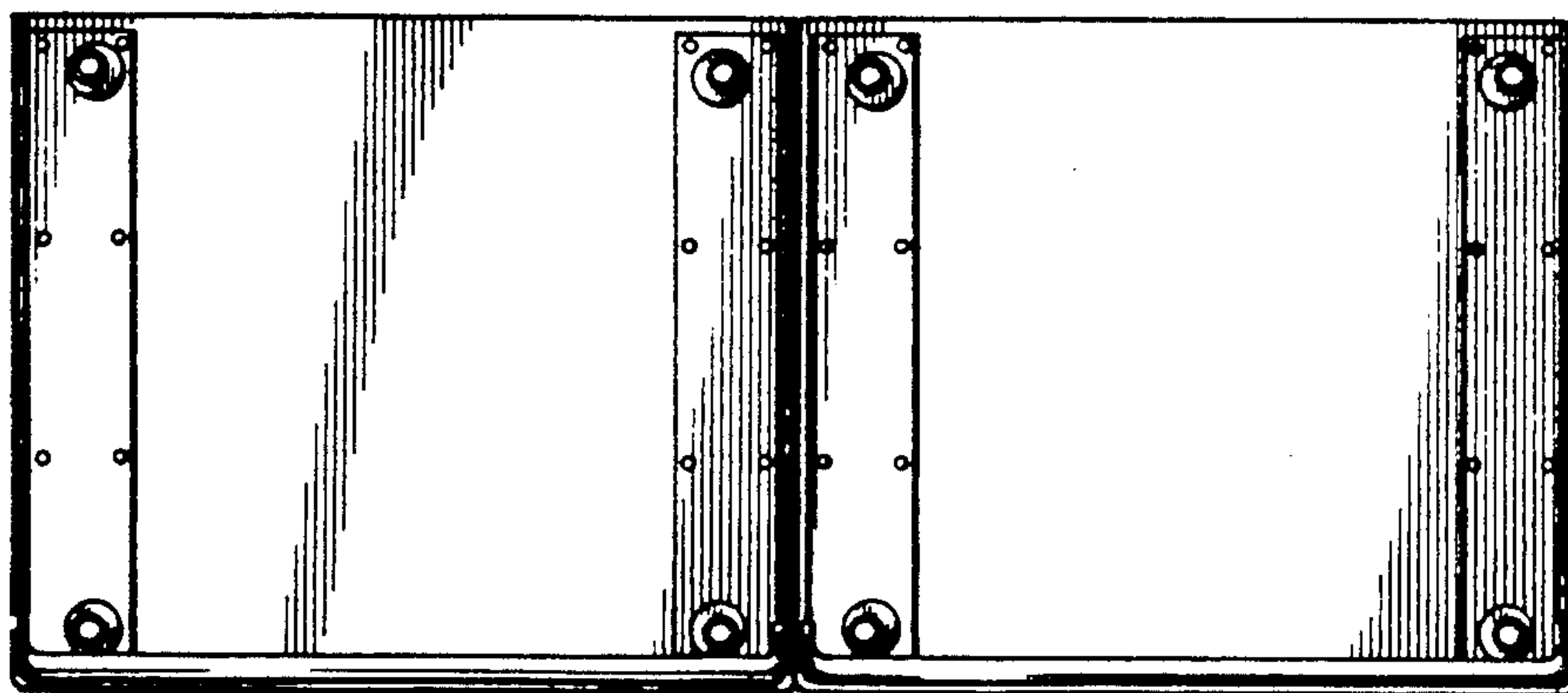
