The ornamental design for a basking buoy for turtles
and amphibians, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a basking buoy for
turtles and amphibians showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being
the same as the front shown;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite
side being identical to the side shown; and
FIG. 6 is a reduced scale perspective thereof.
The broken line representation of an aquarium, water,
turtles, sand, anchor and connecting line in FIG. 6 is for
illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the
claimed design.

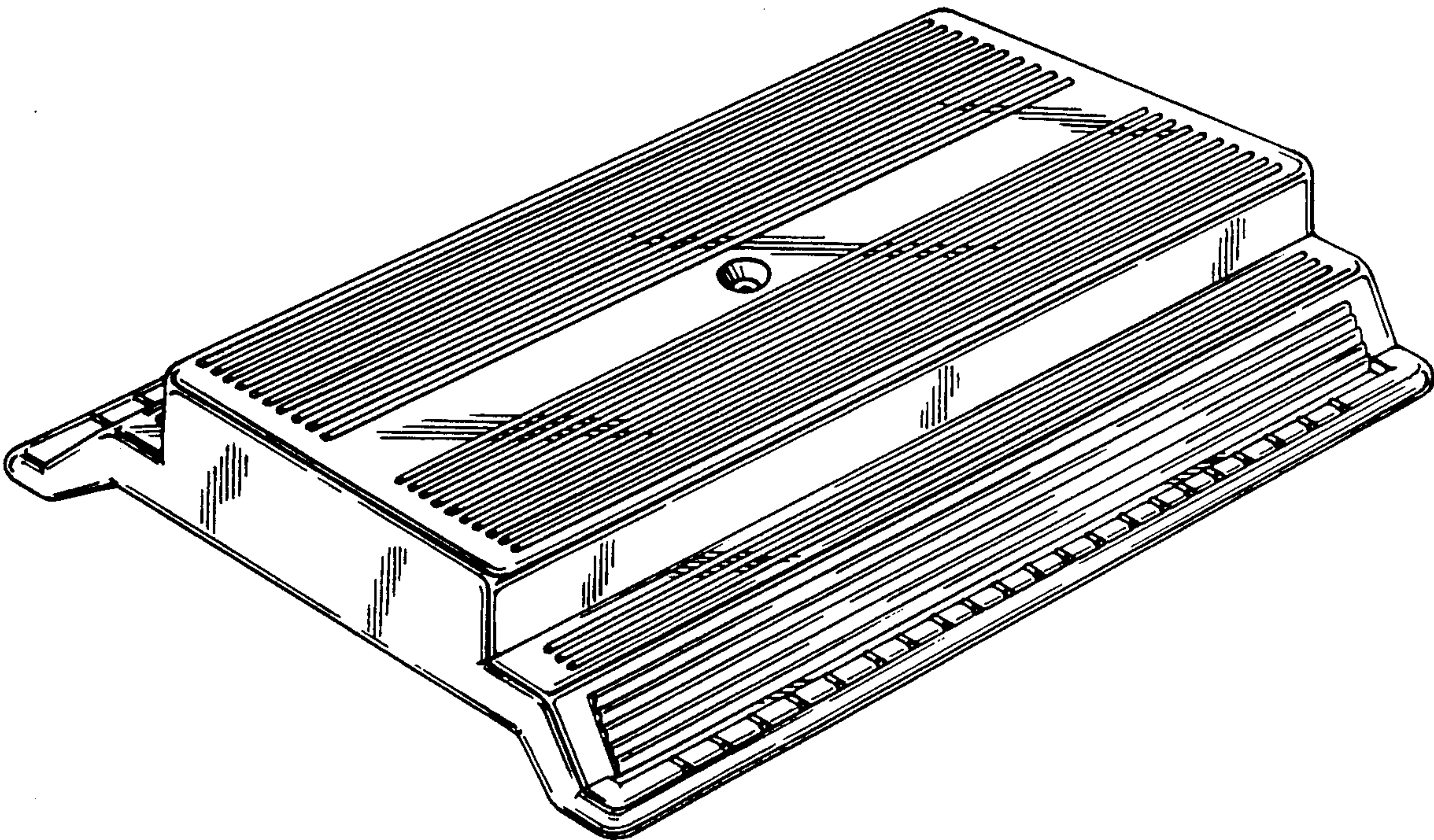

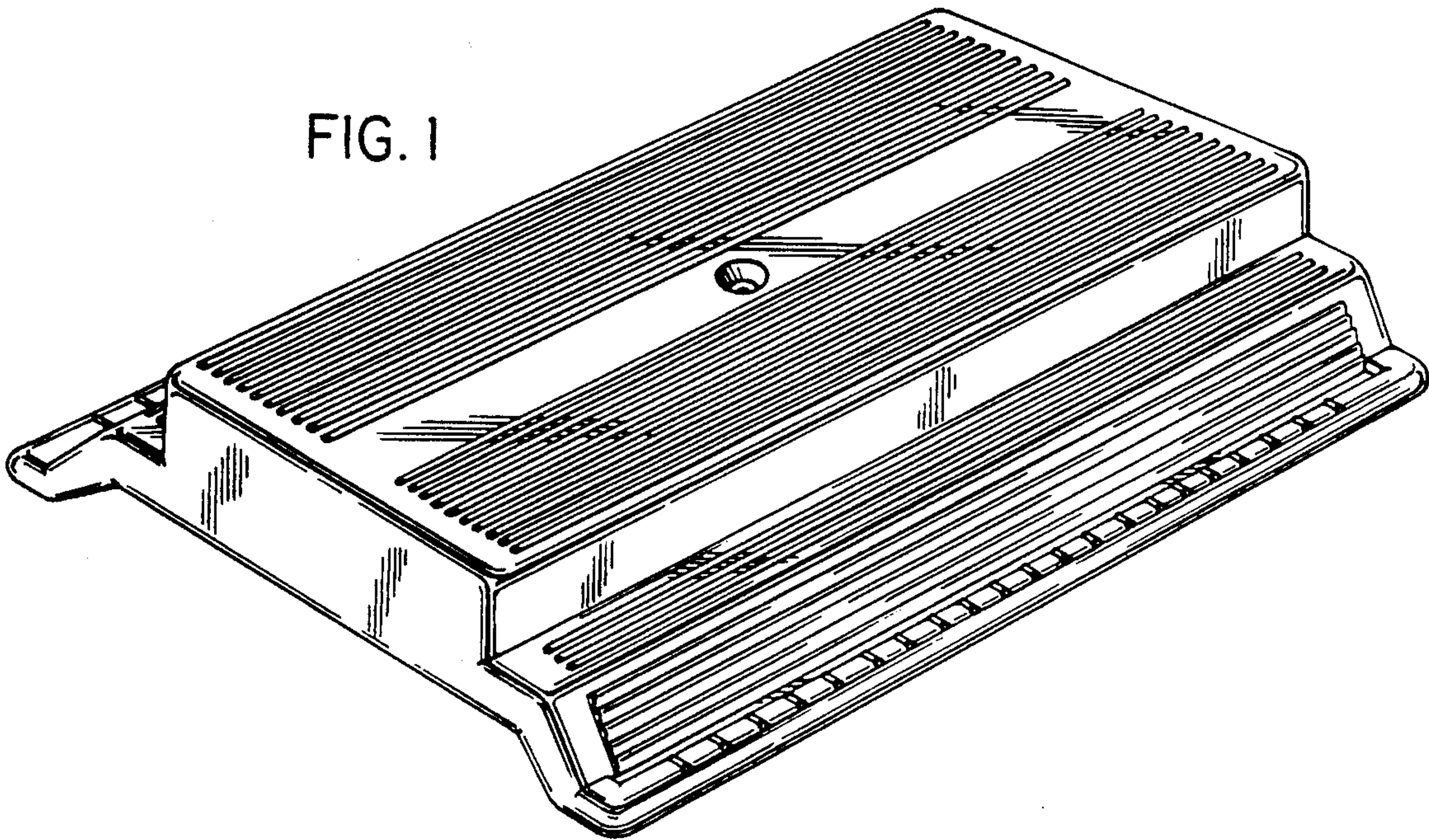

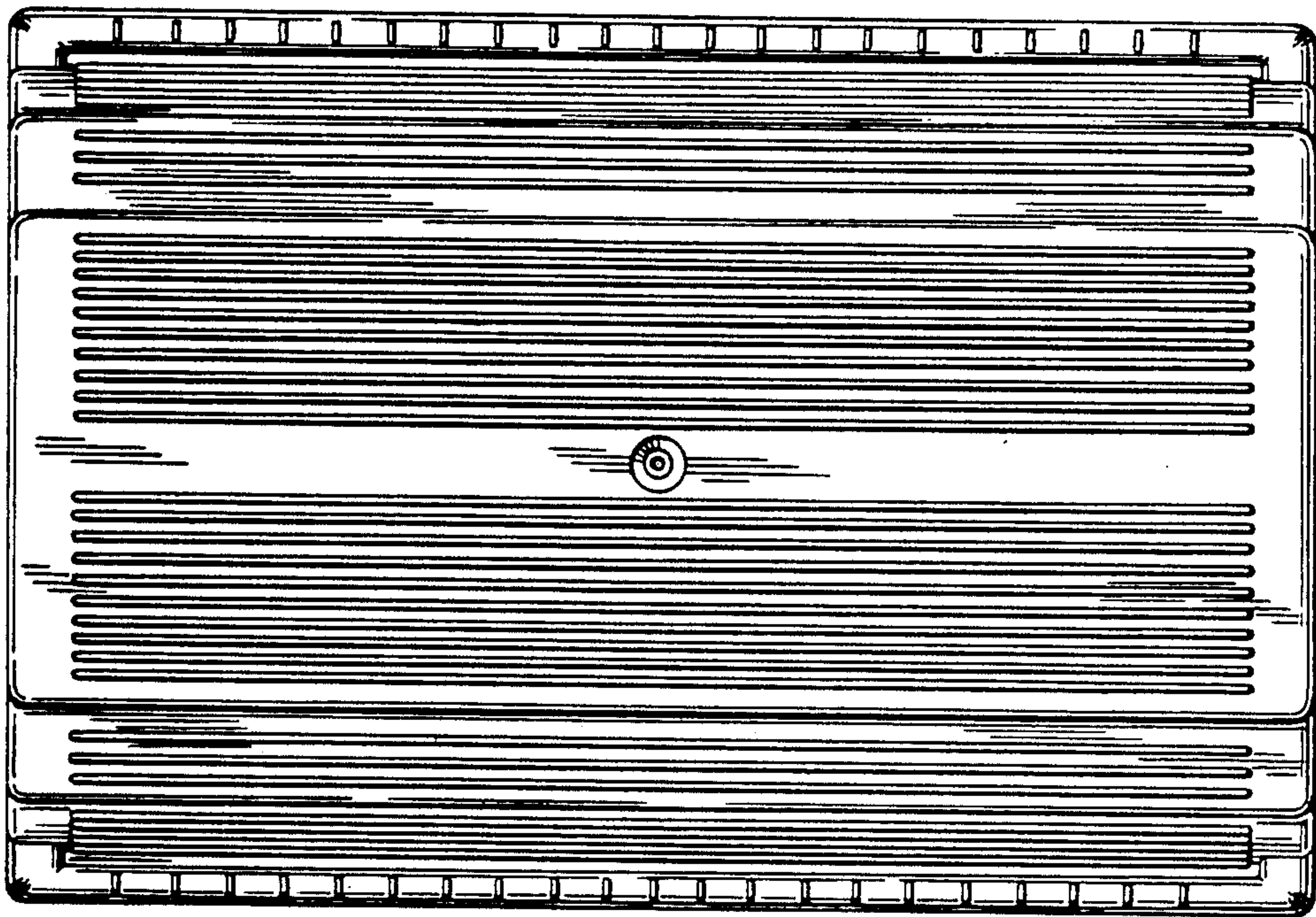

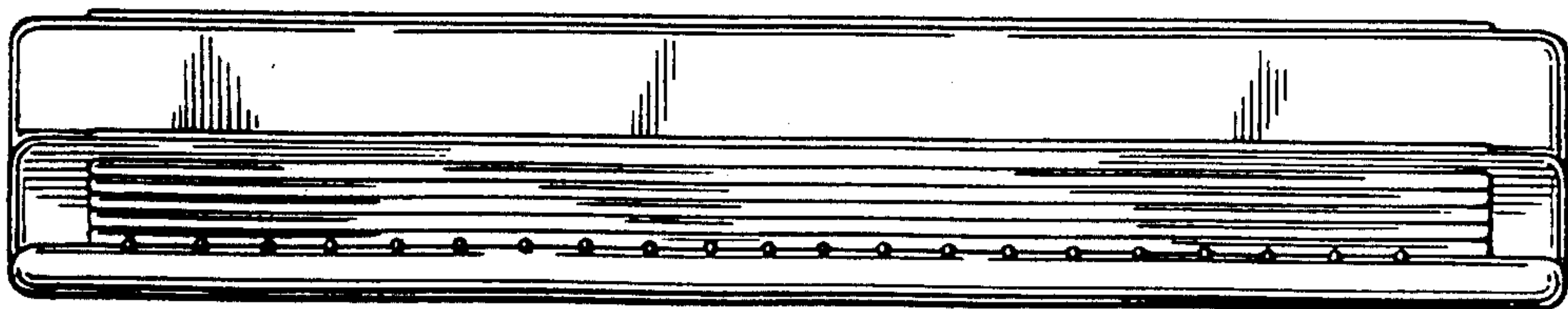

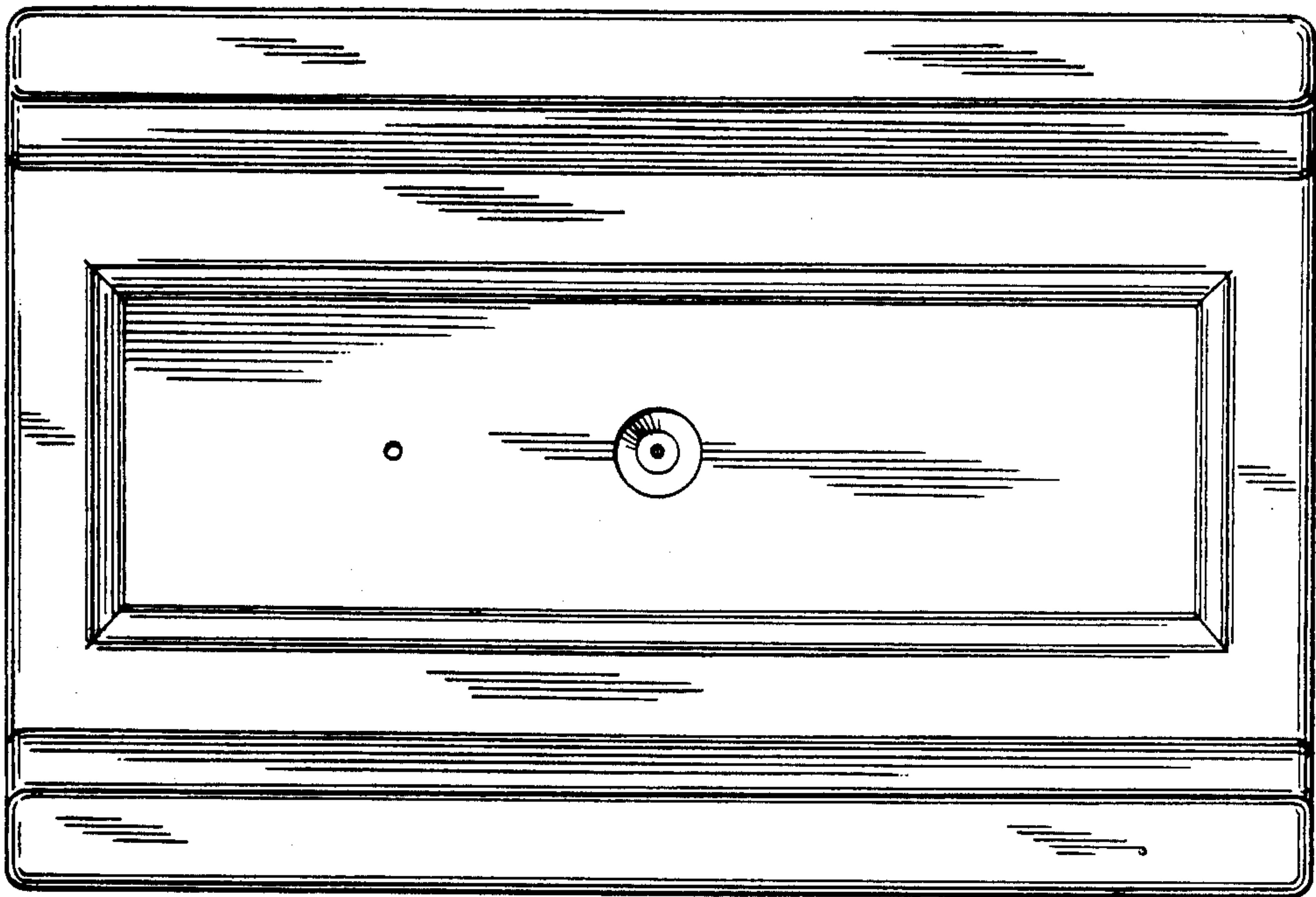

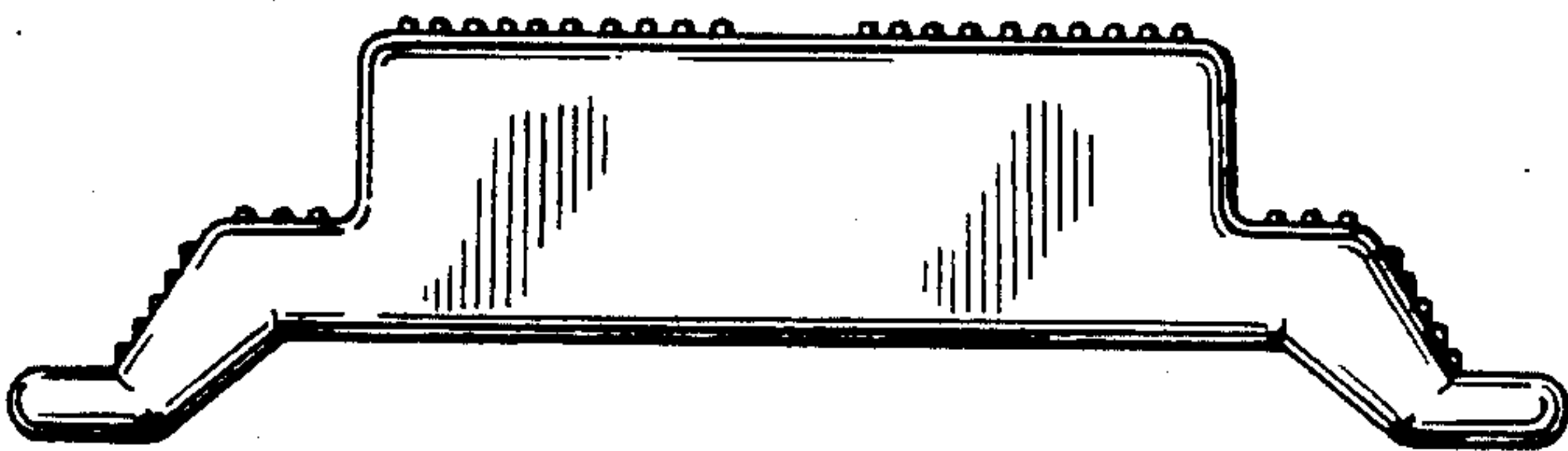
