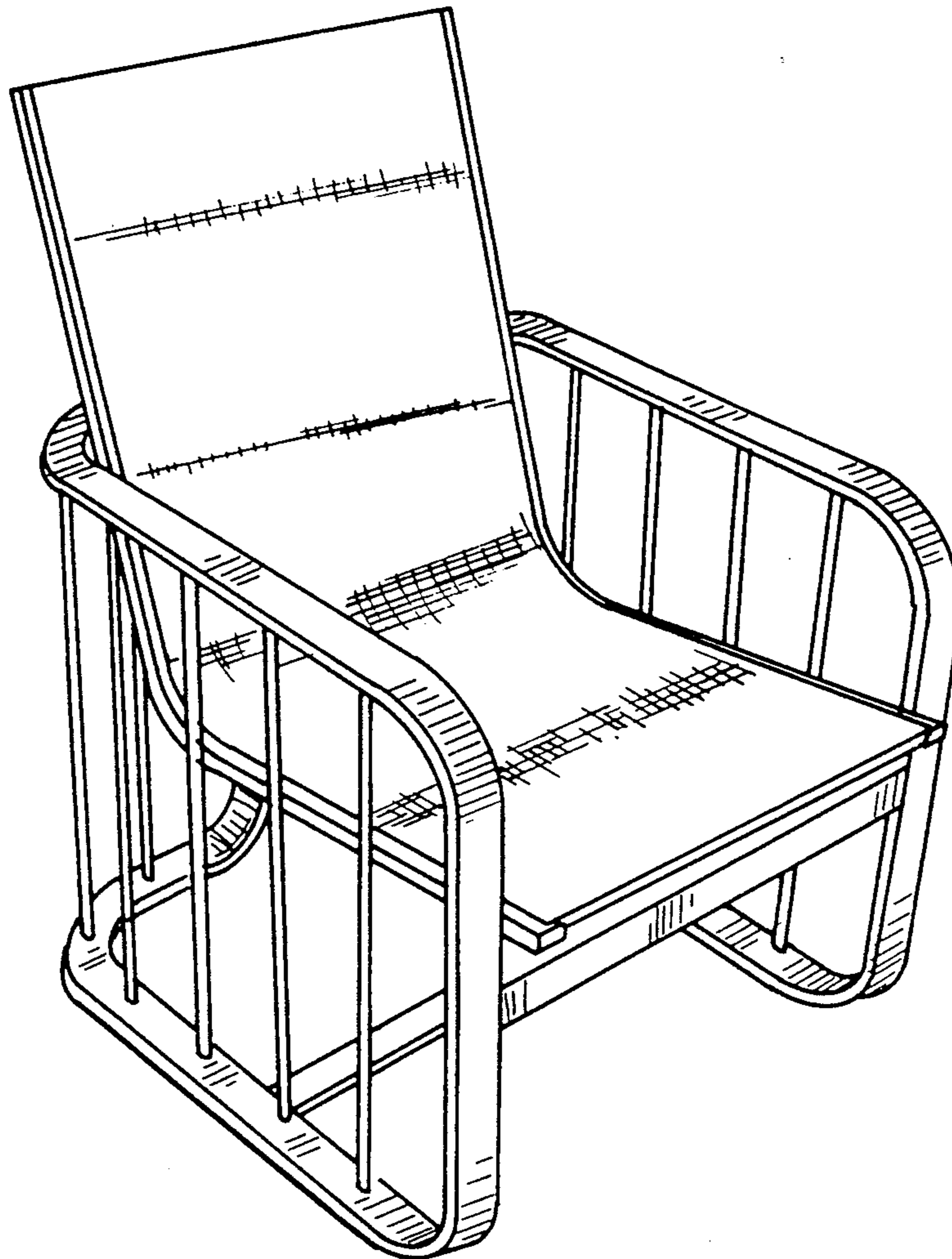

DESCRIPTION

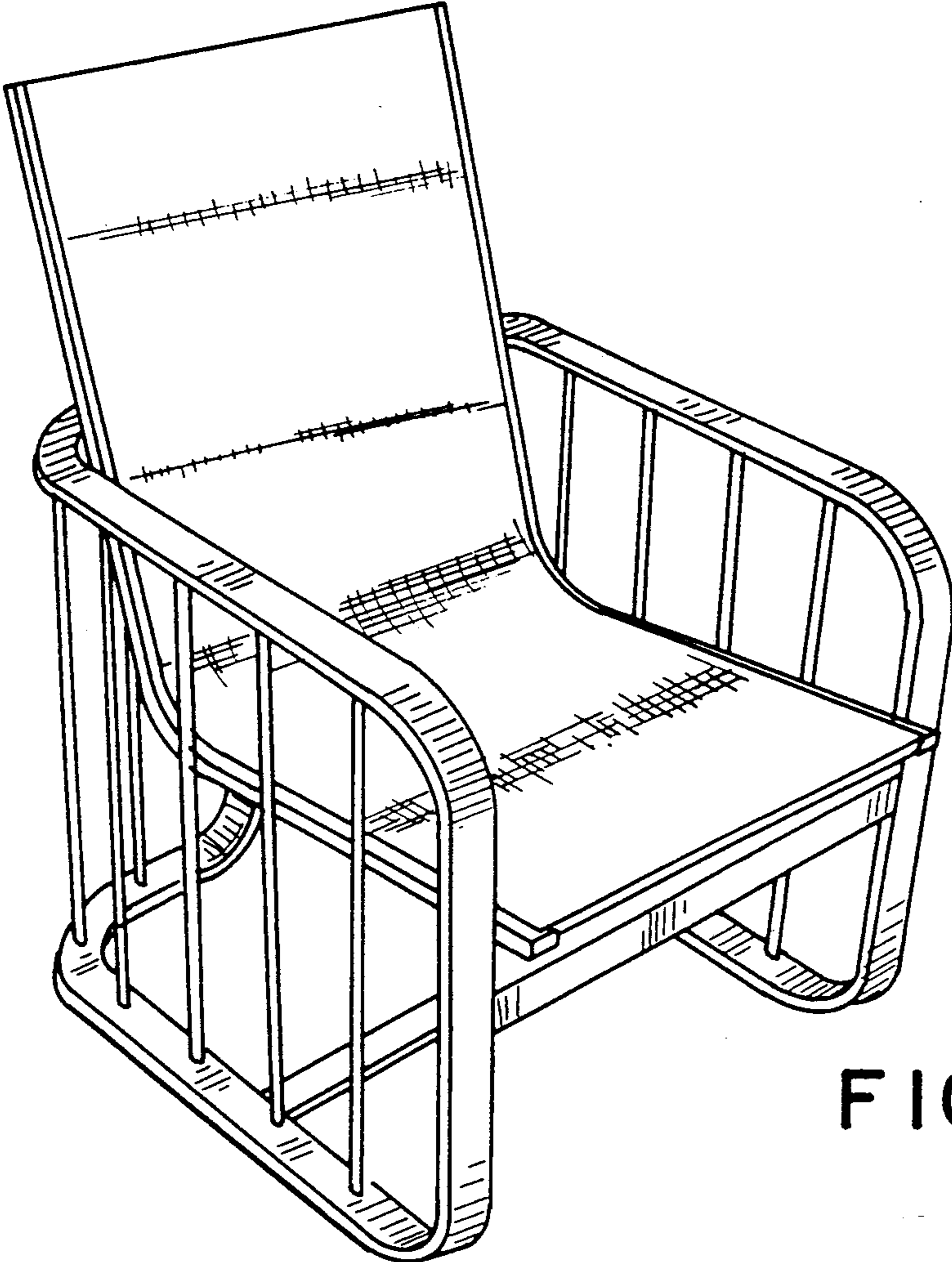

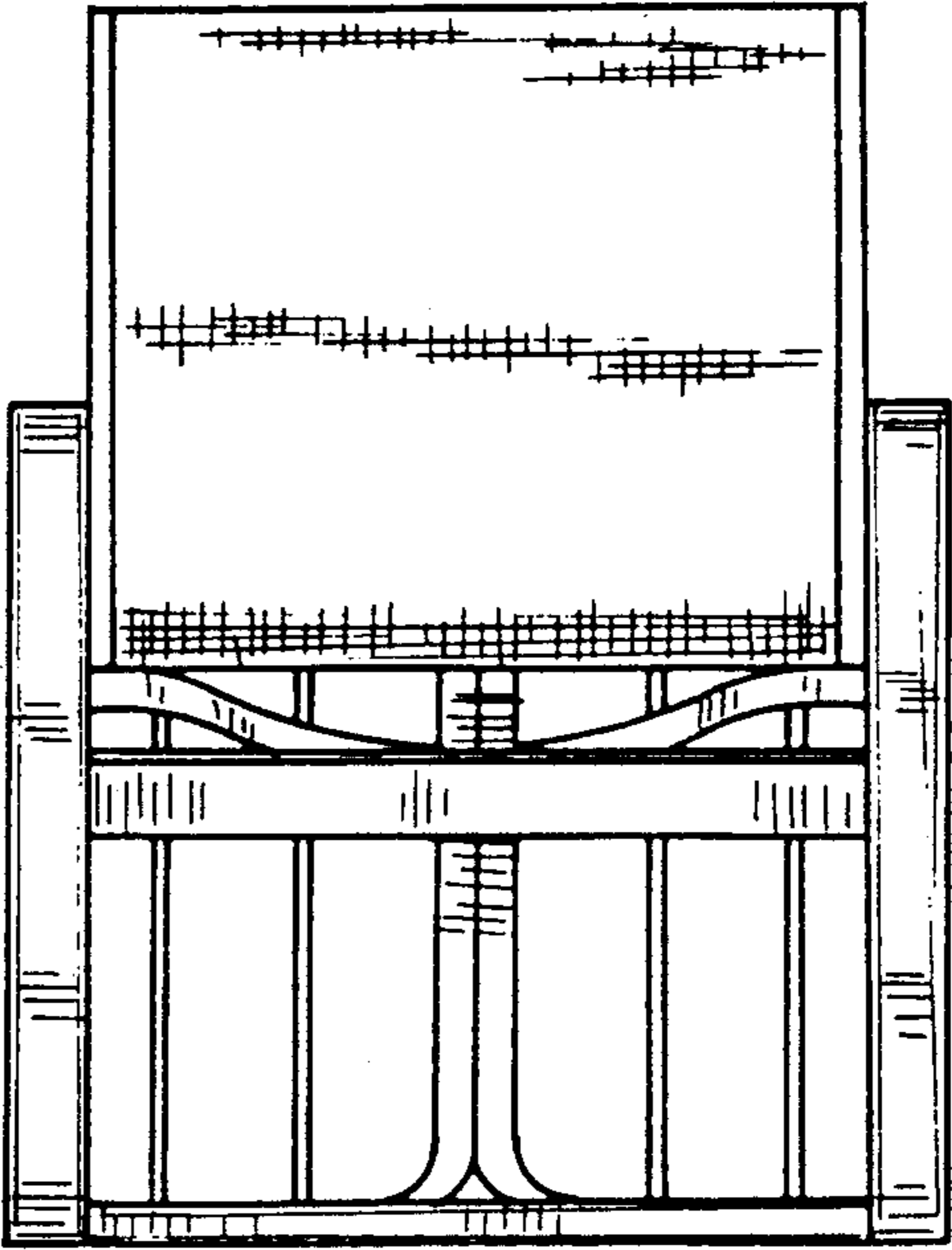

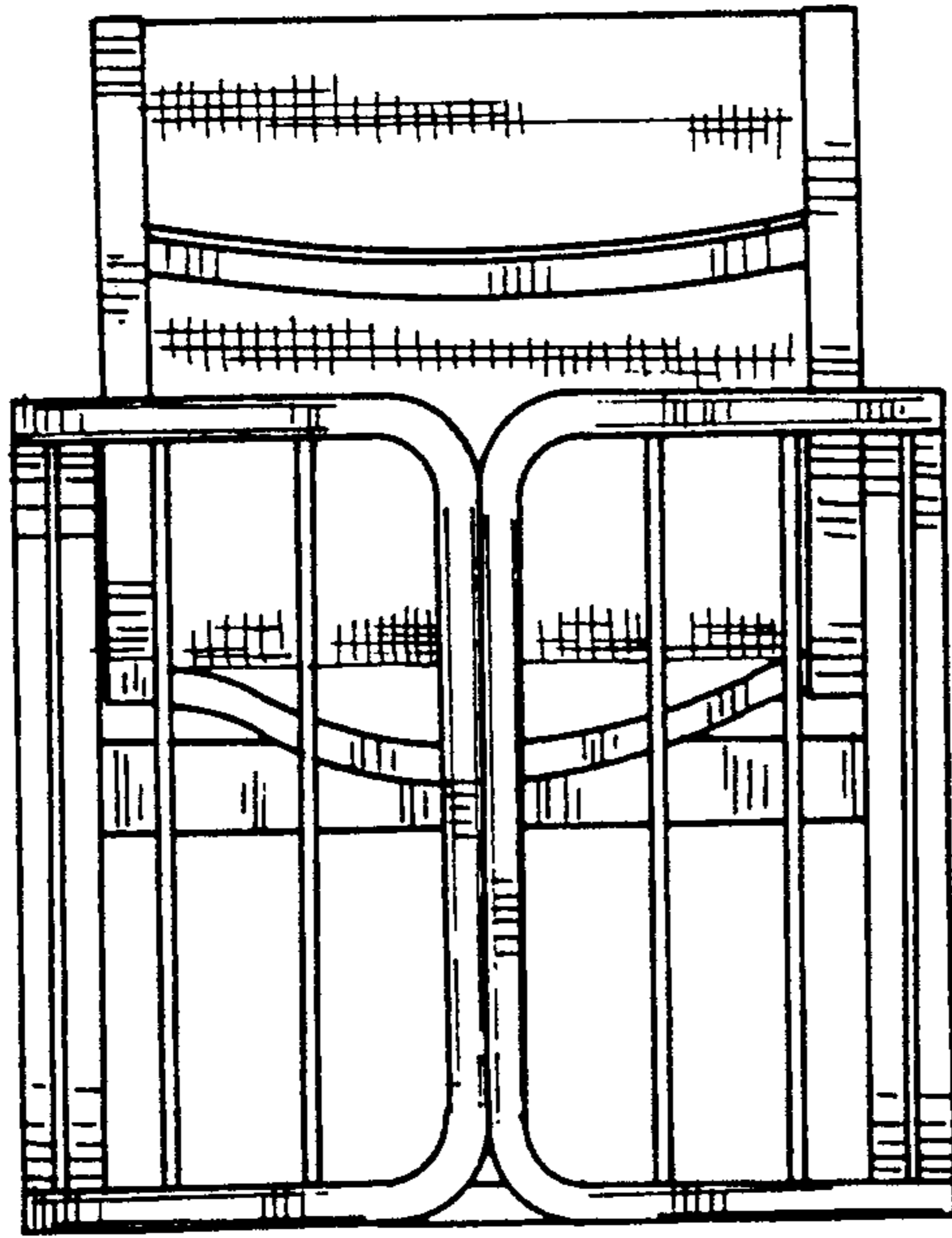

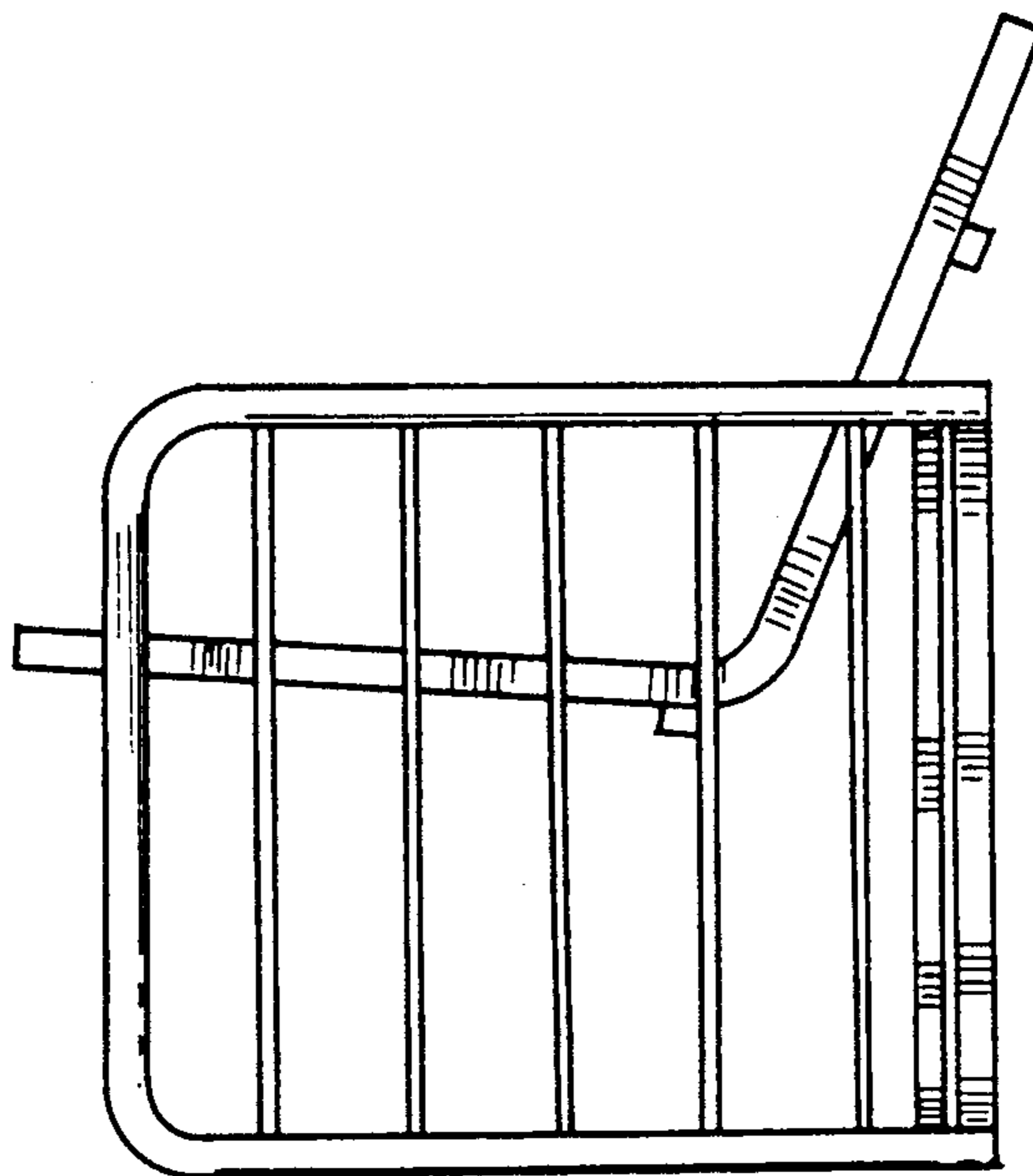

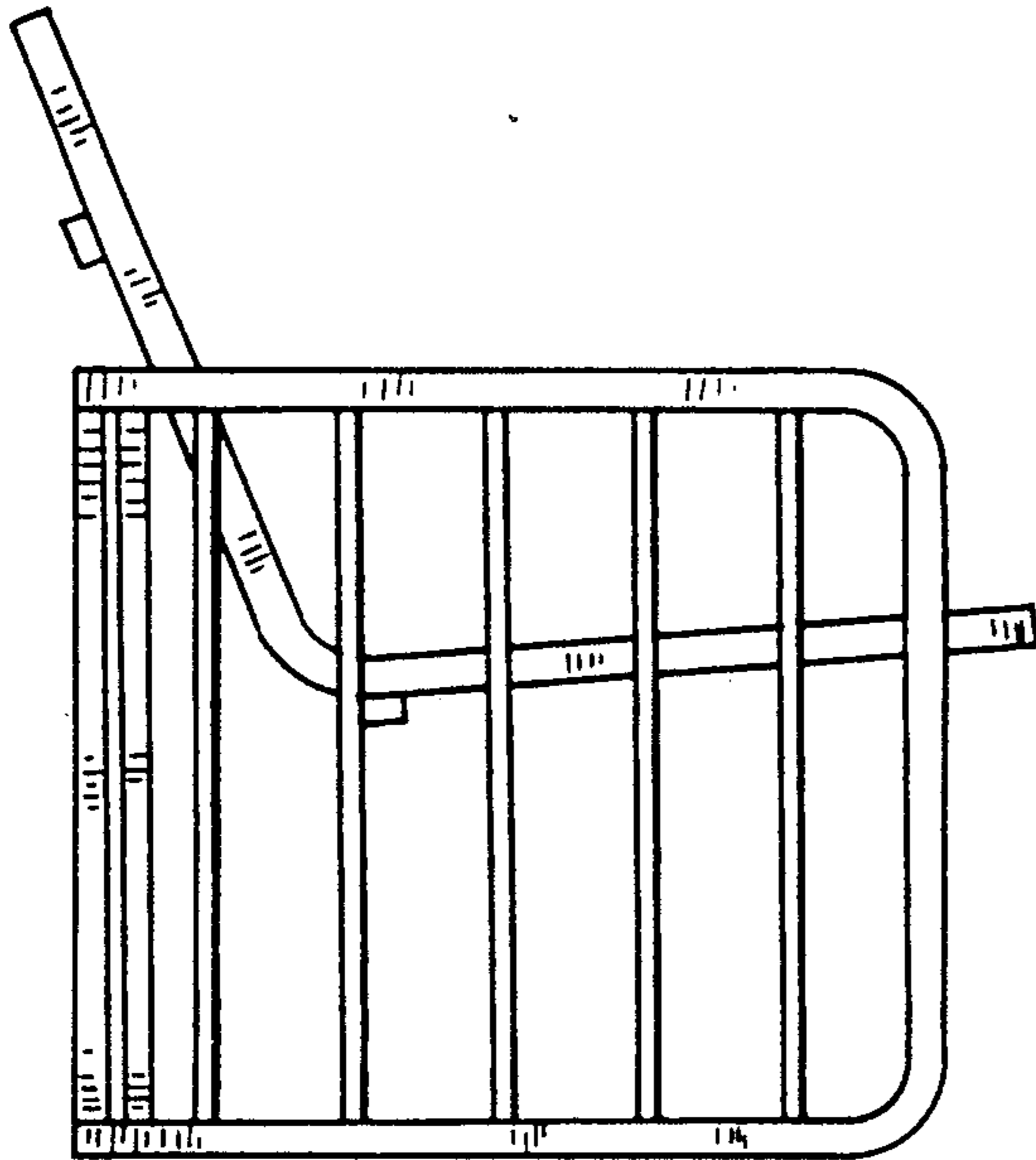

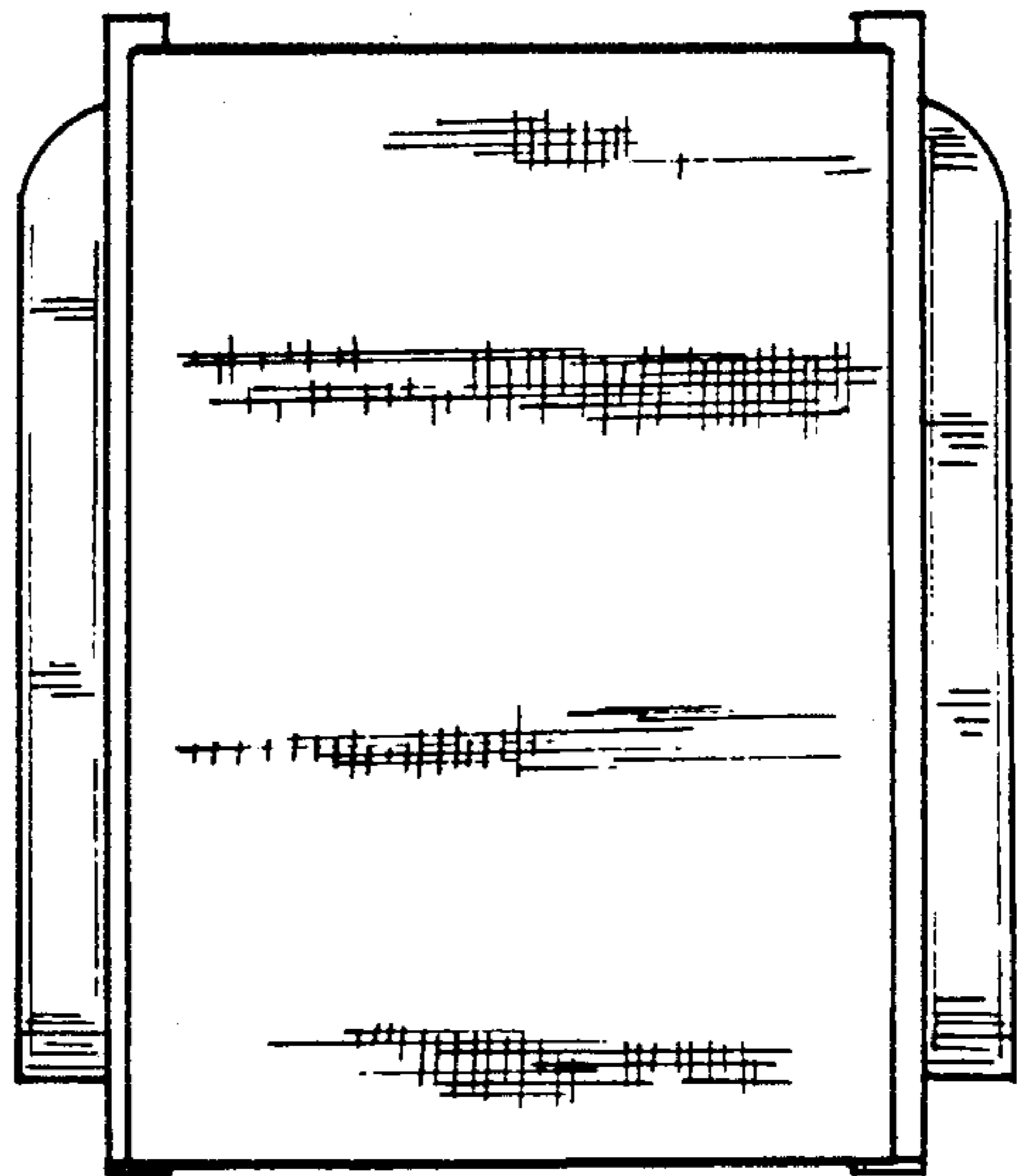

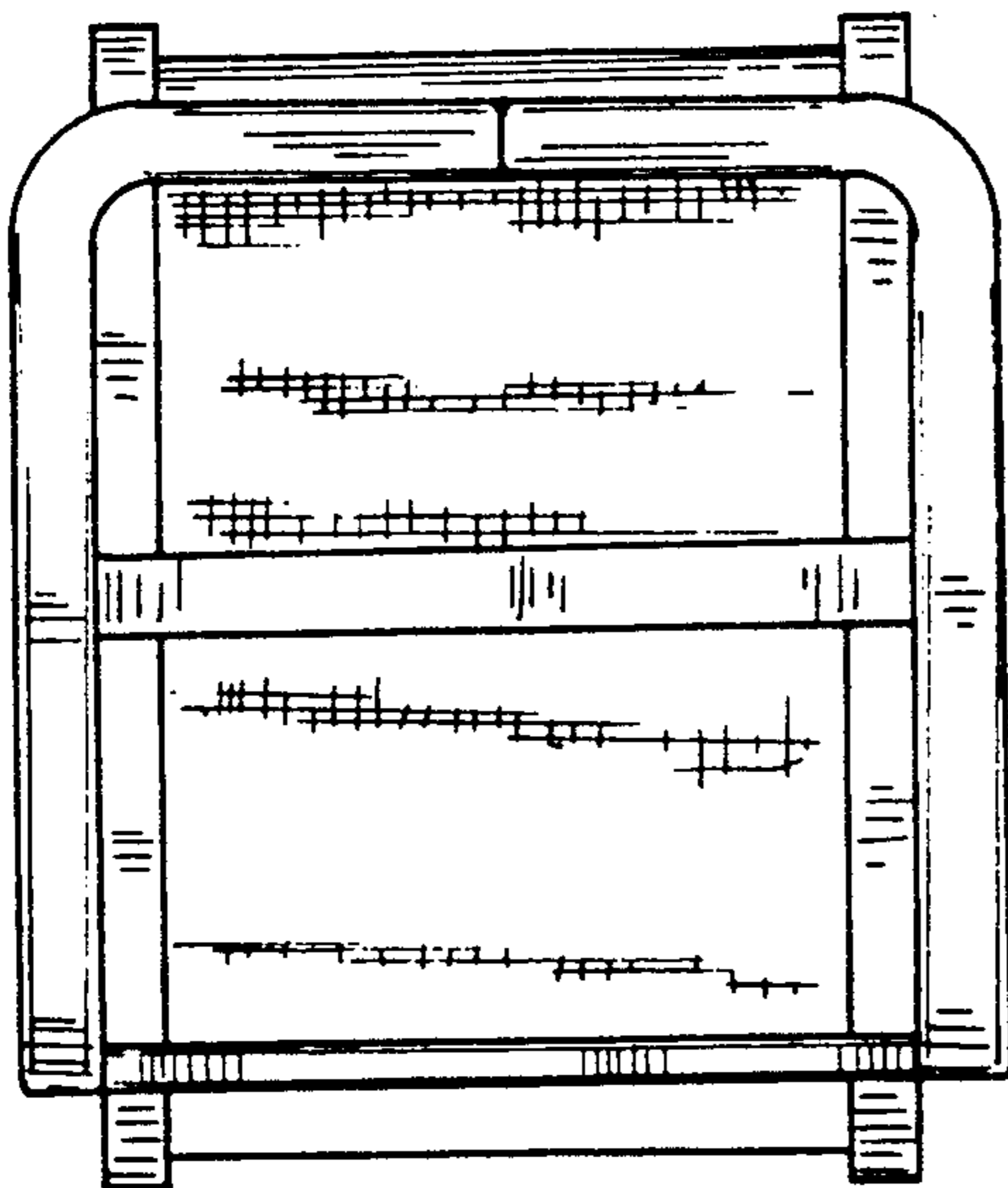
