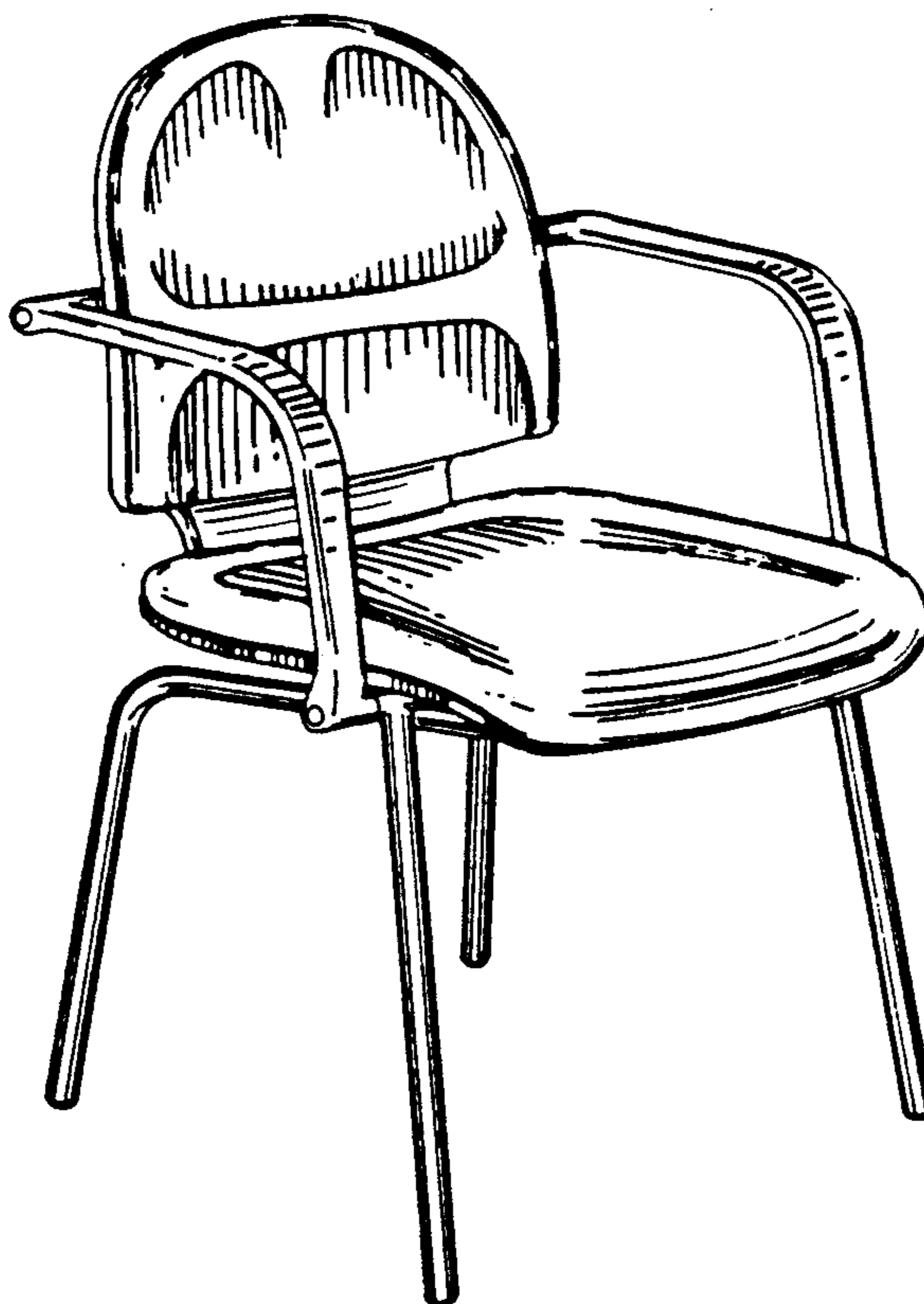

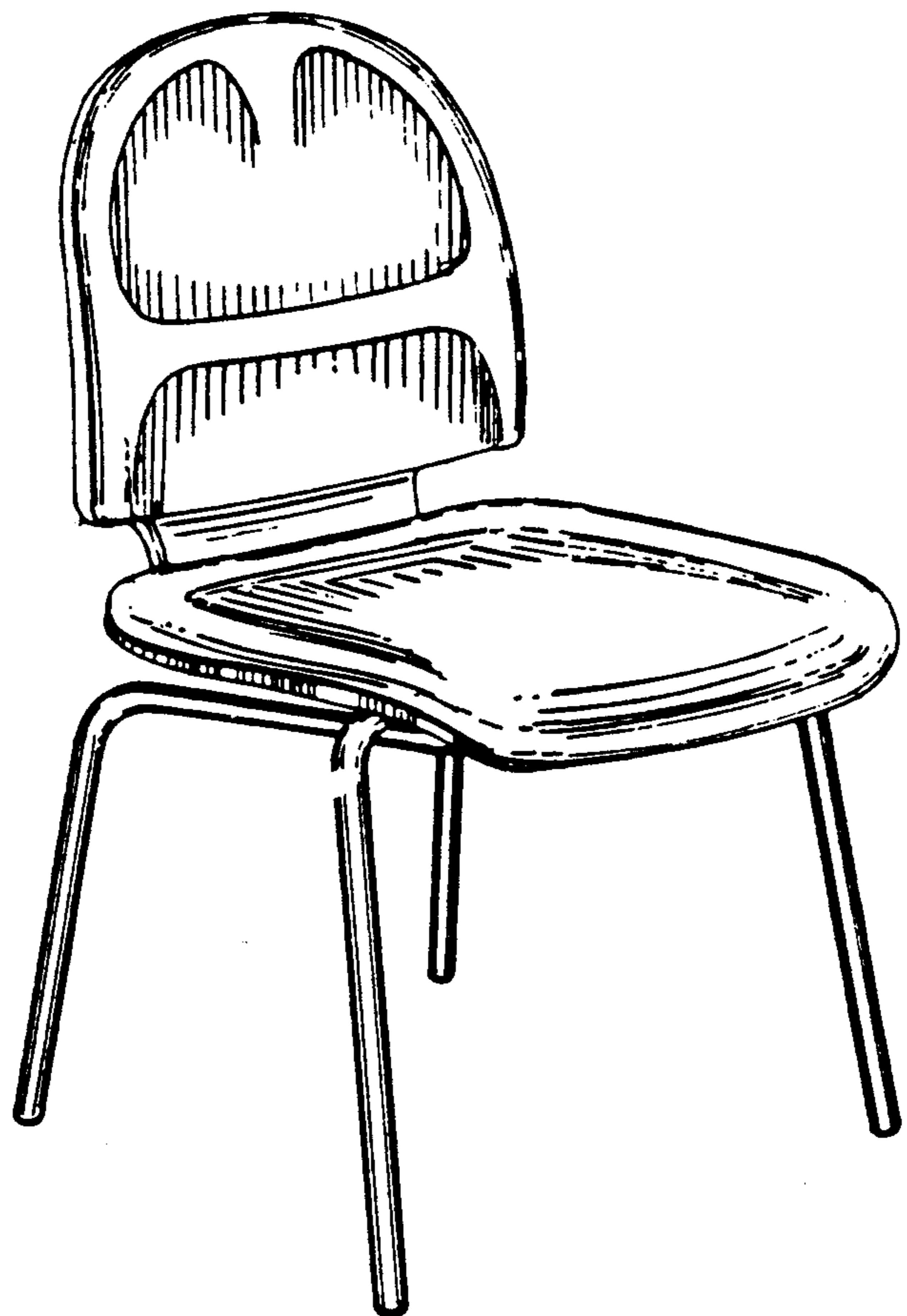
The ornamental design for the chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

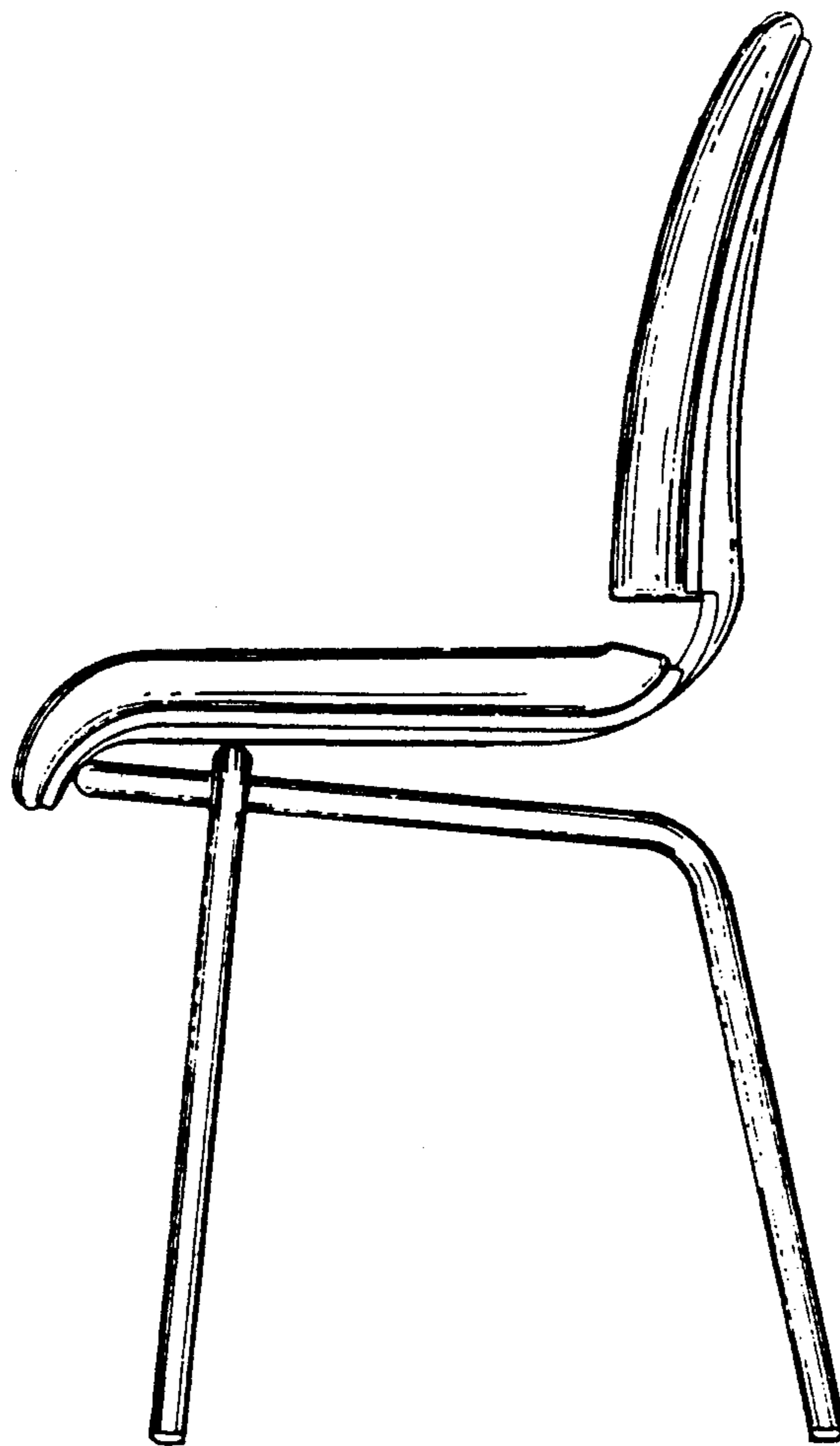
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the chair showing our new design;

FIG. 12 is a top plan view thereof.



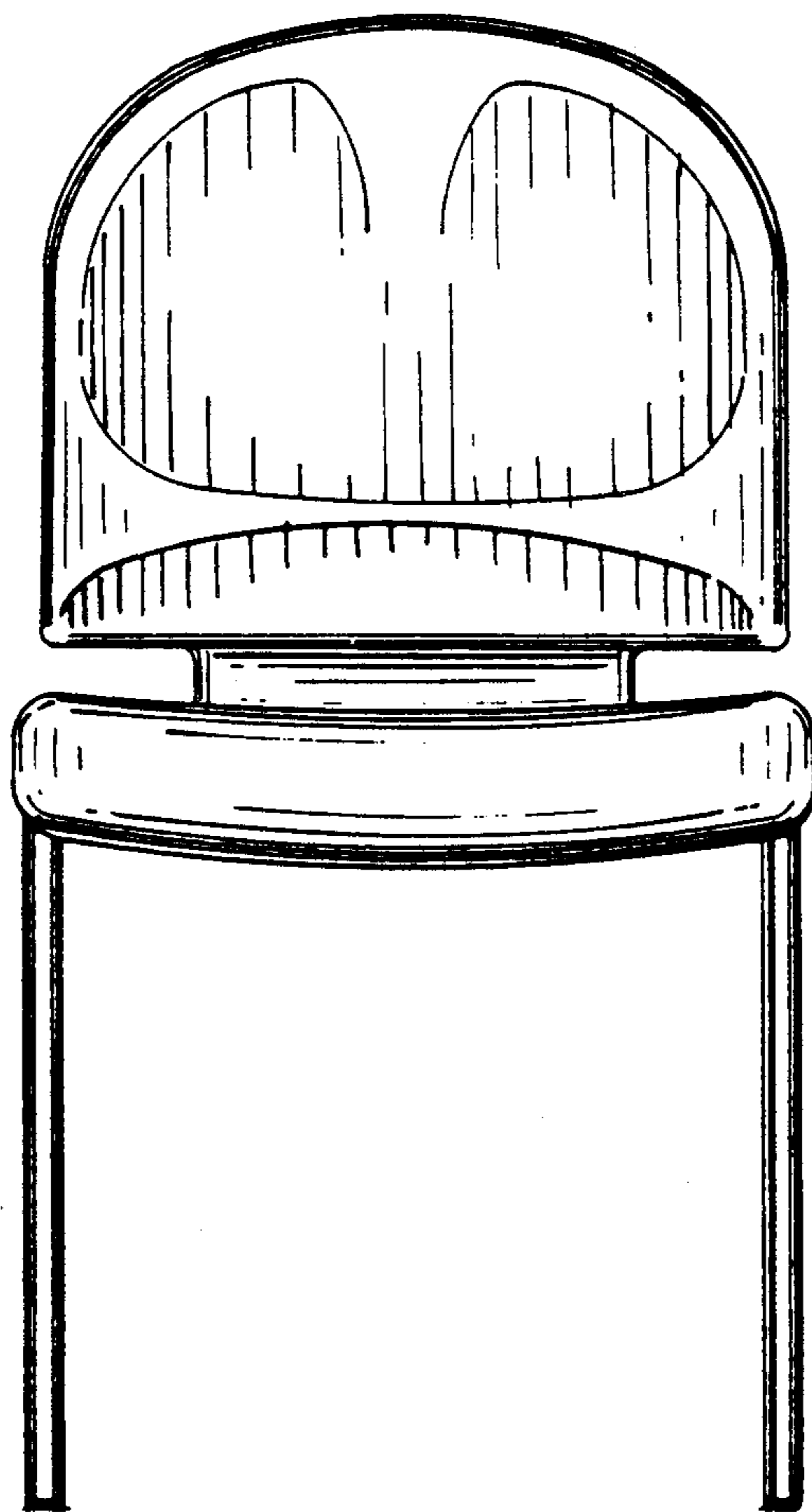

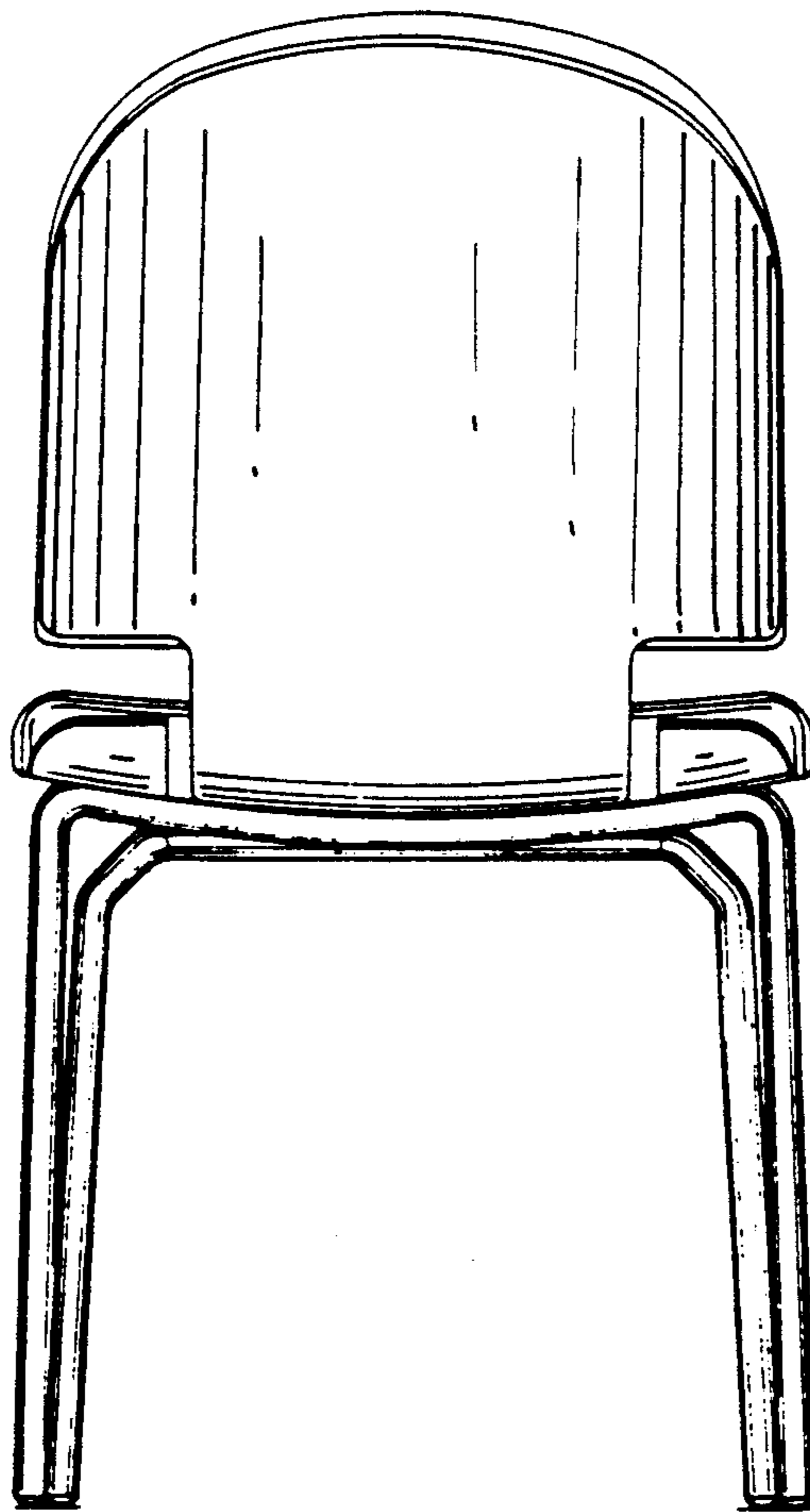

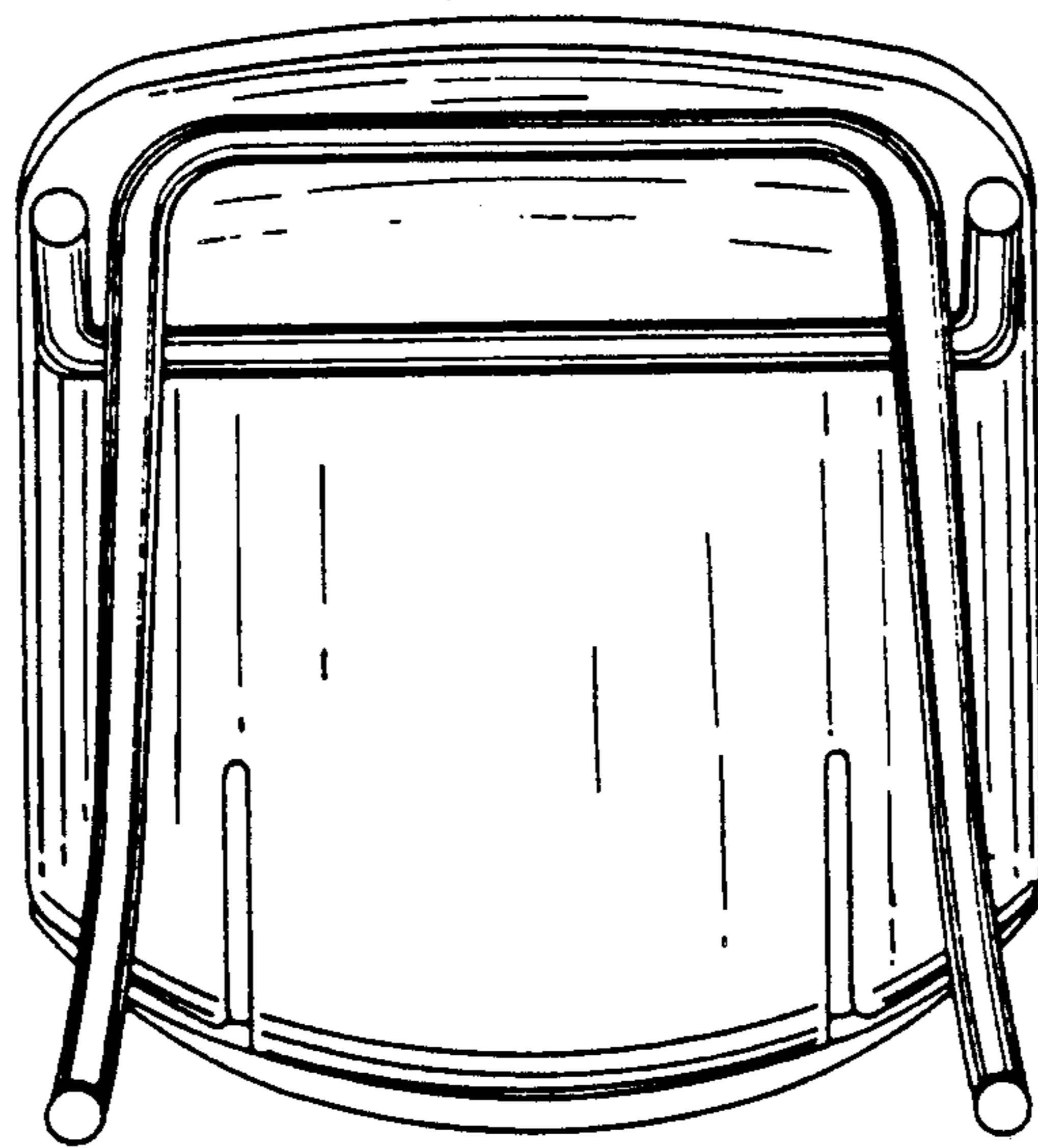

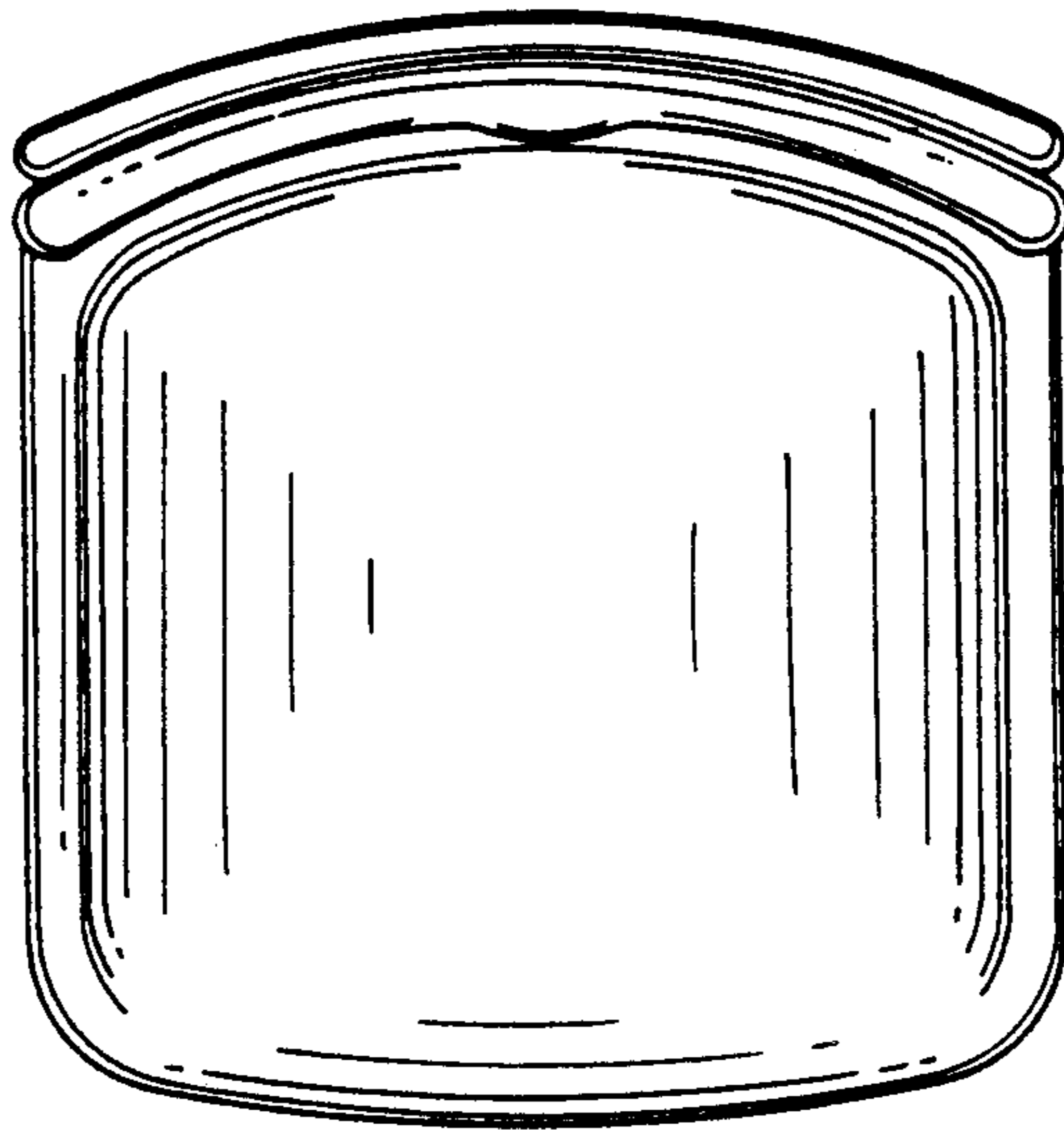

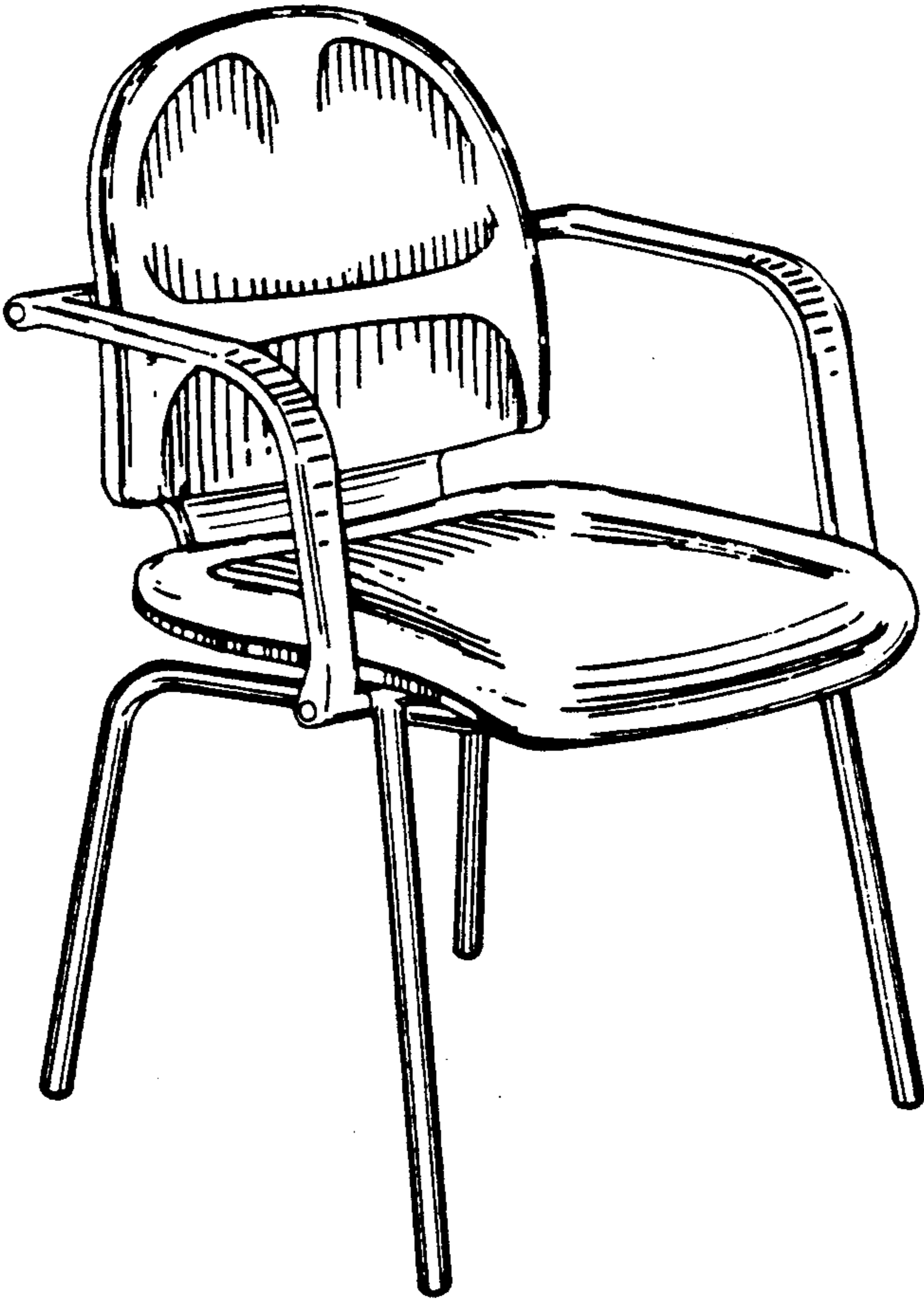

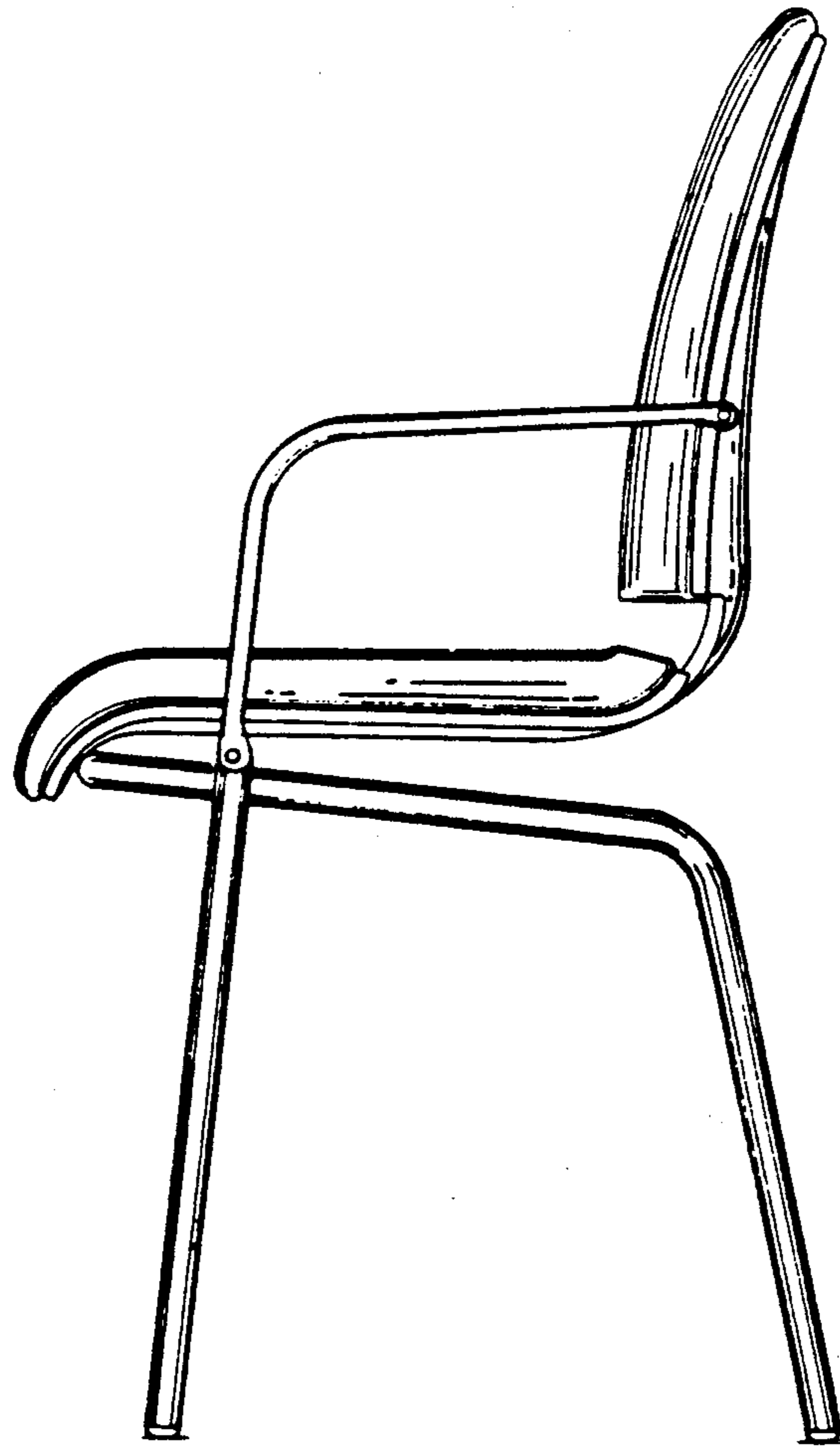

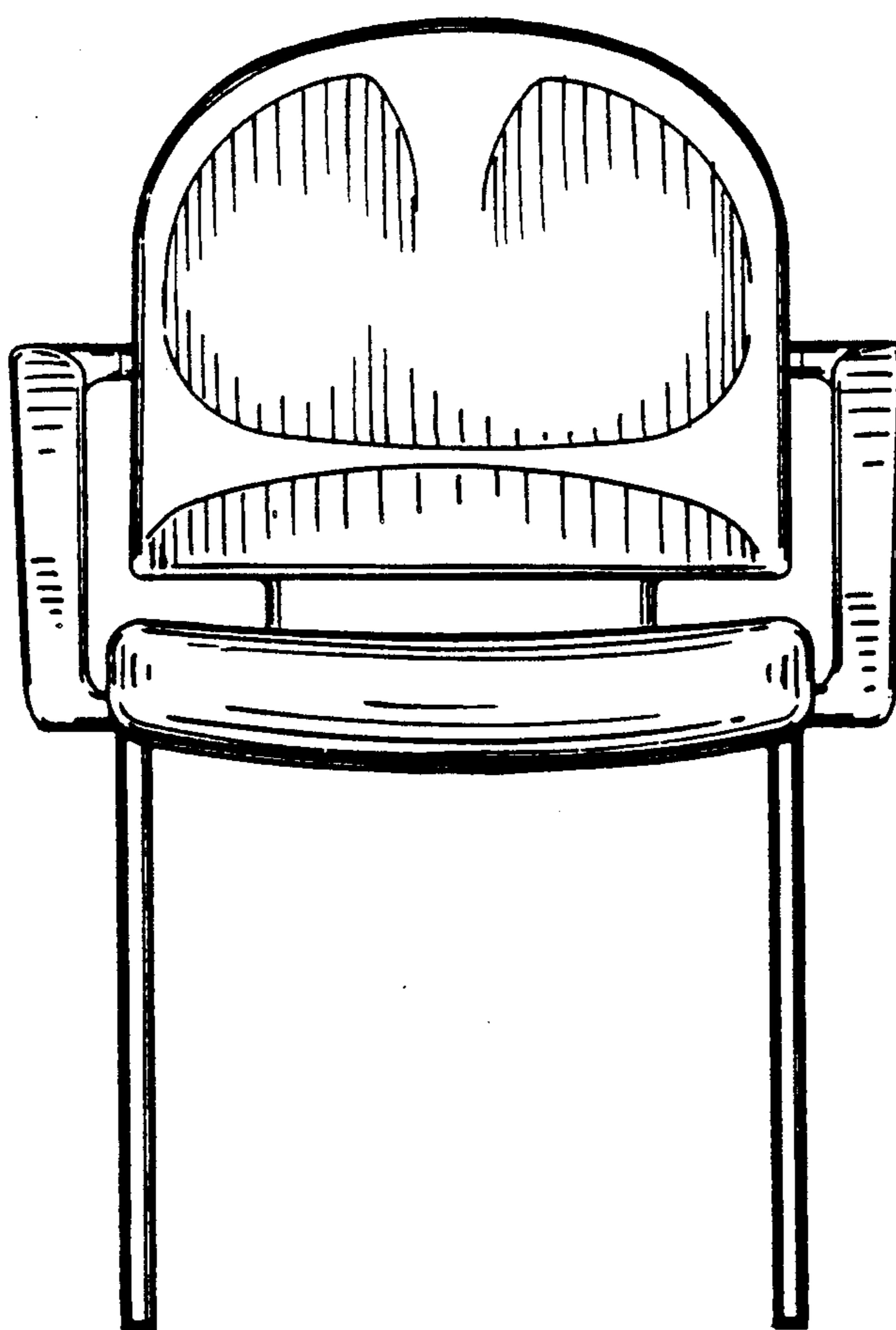




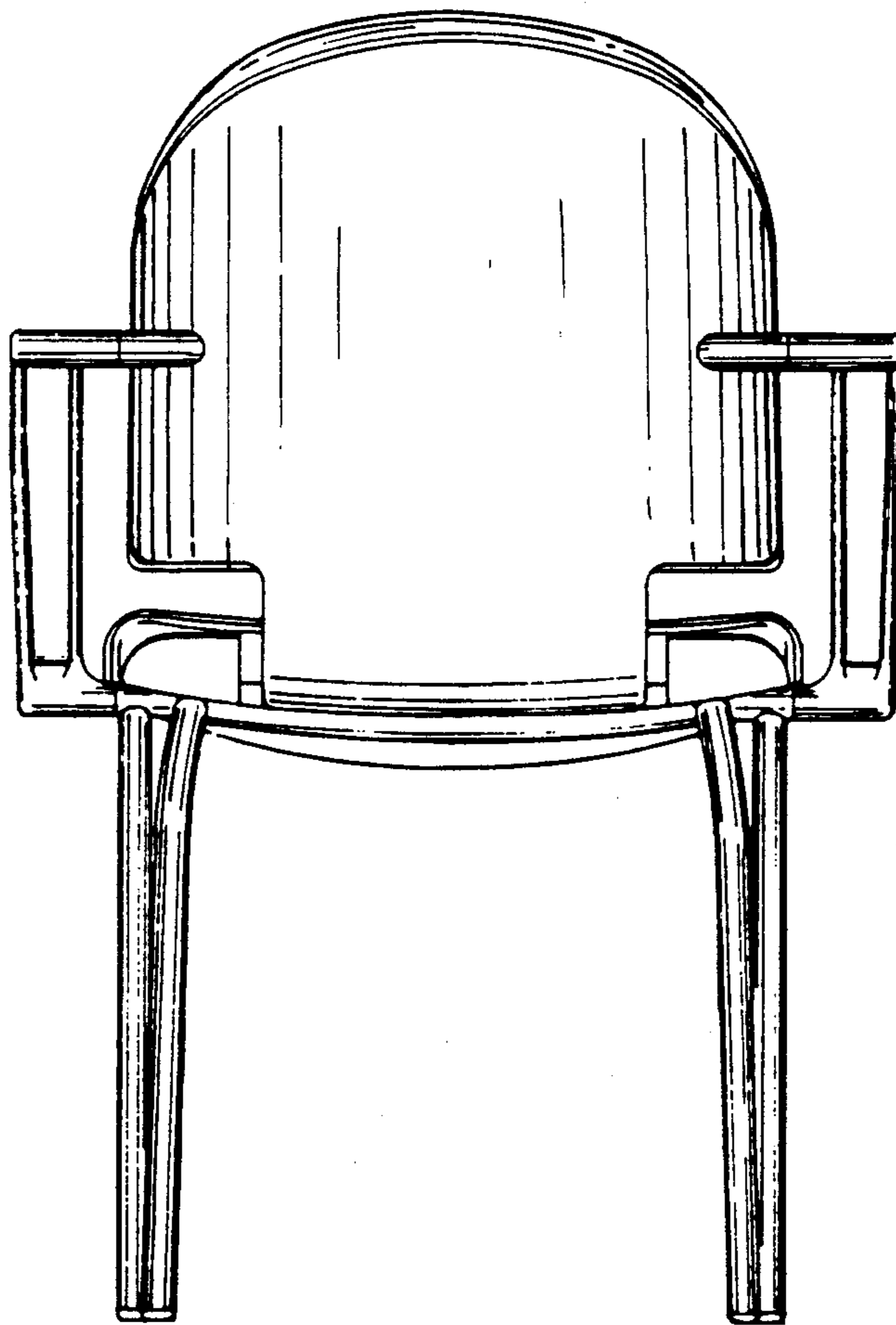

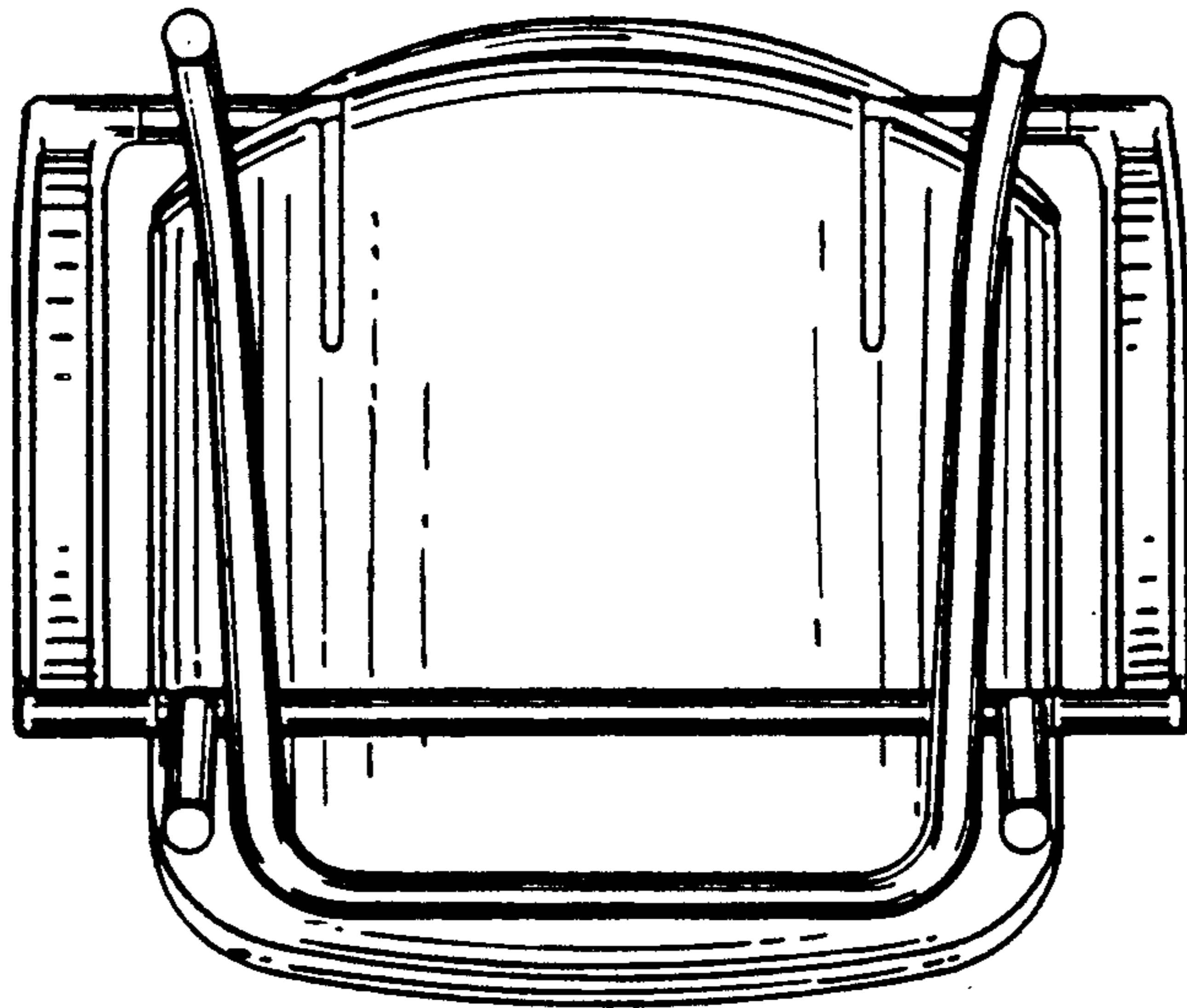
