The ornamental design for a food or beverage heating pot, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a food or beverage heating pot showing my new design; the opposite side being a mirror image;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

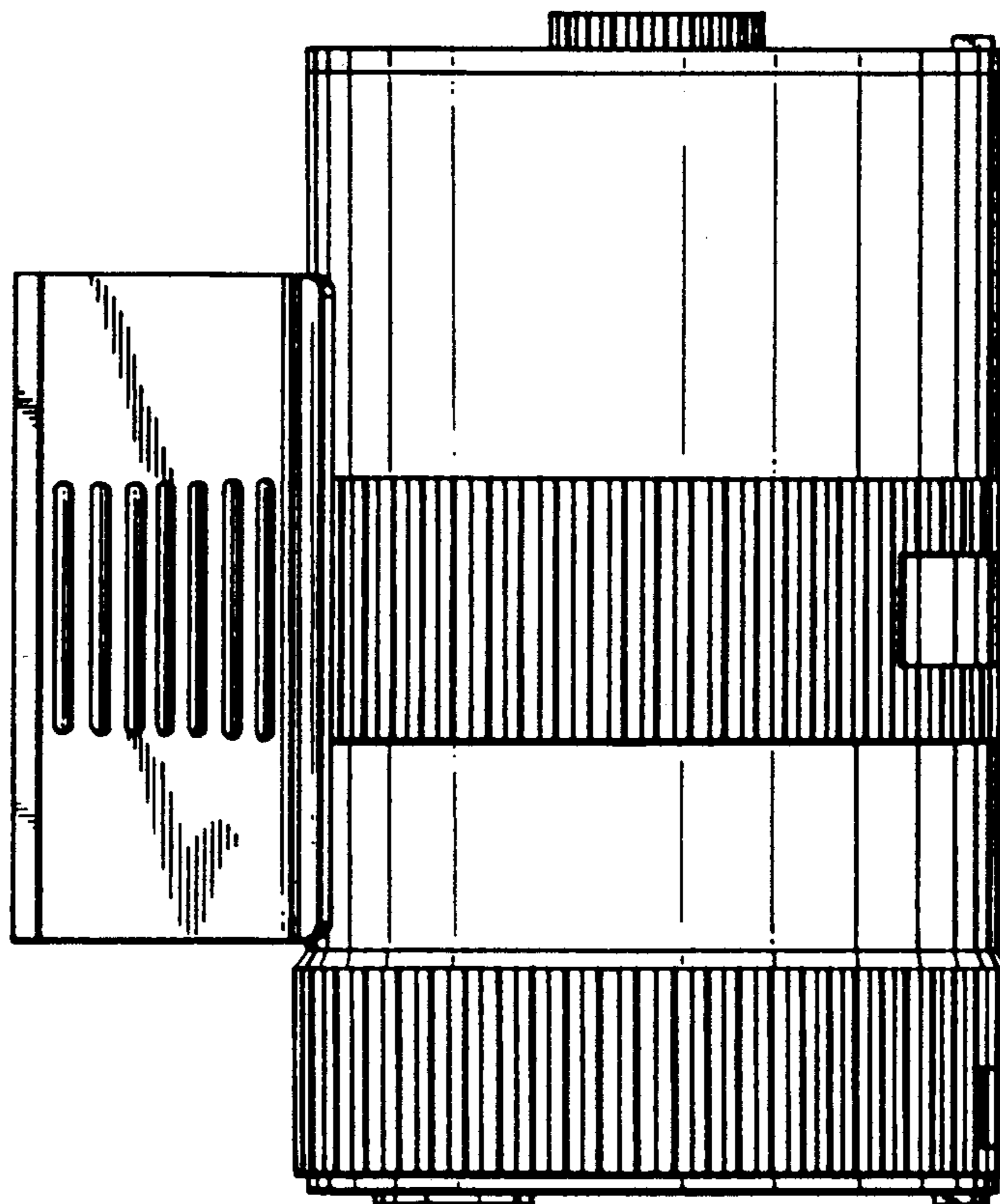

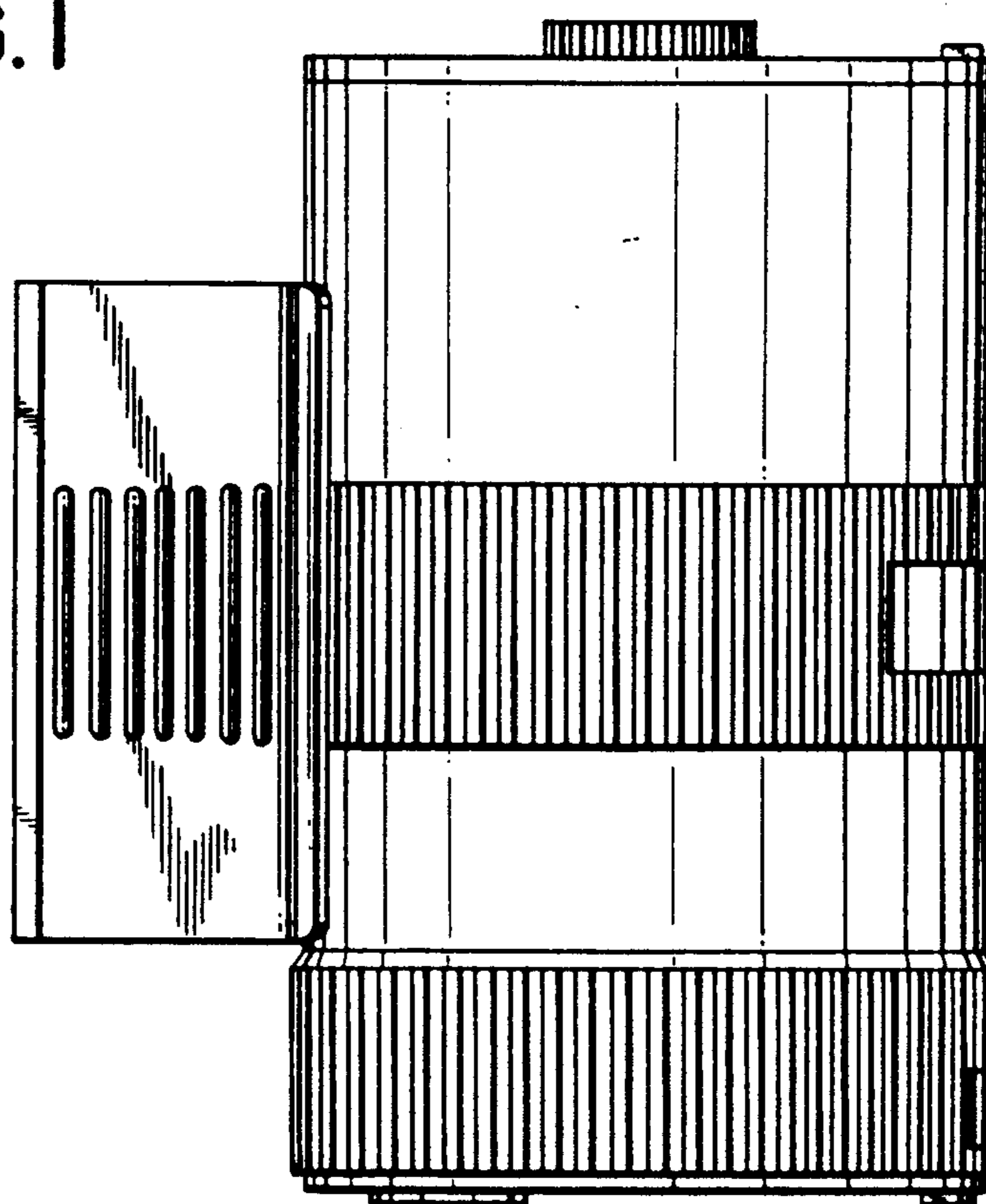

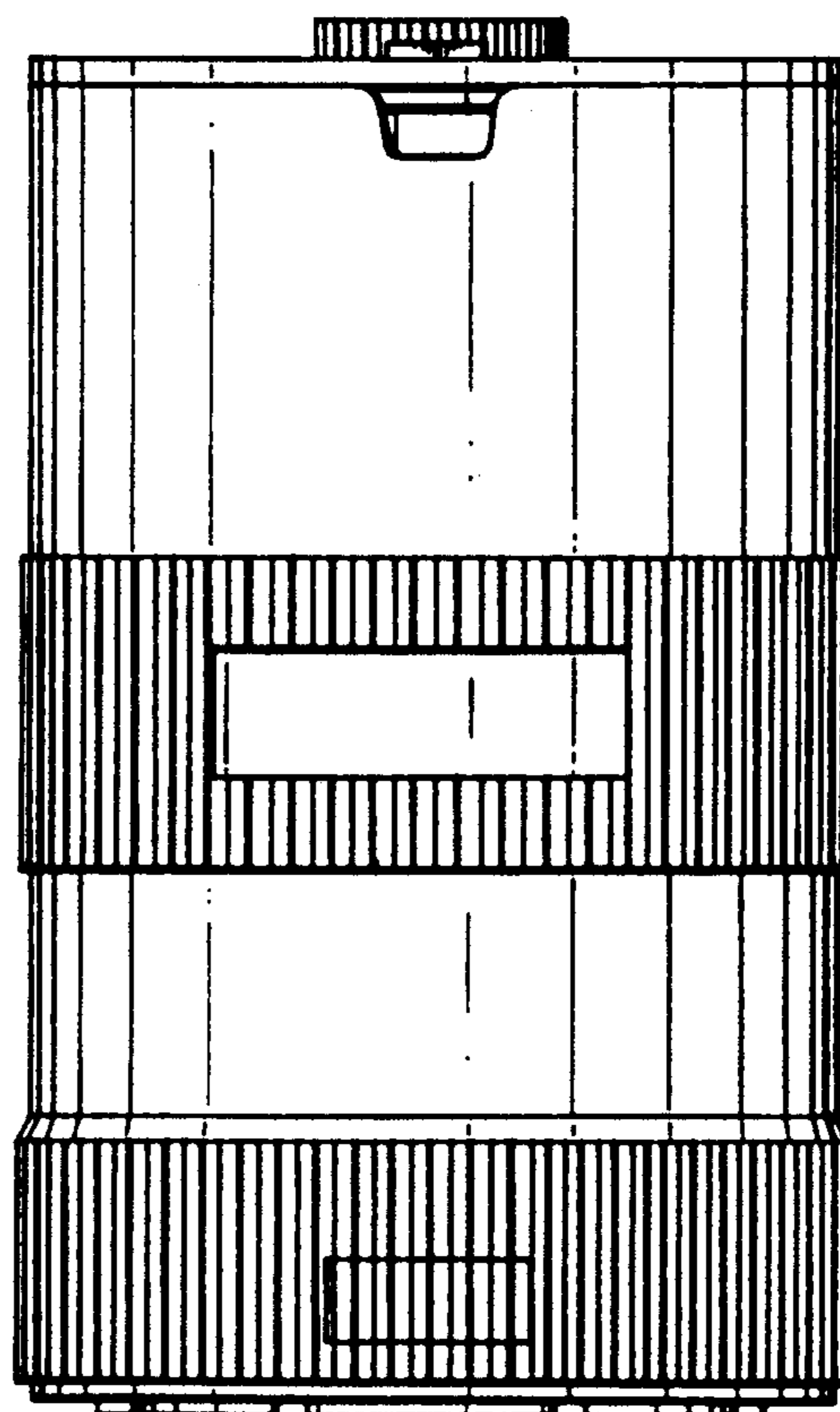

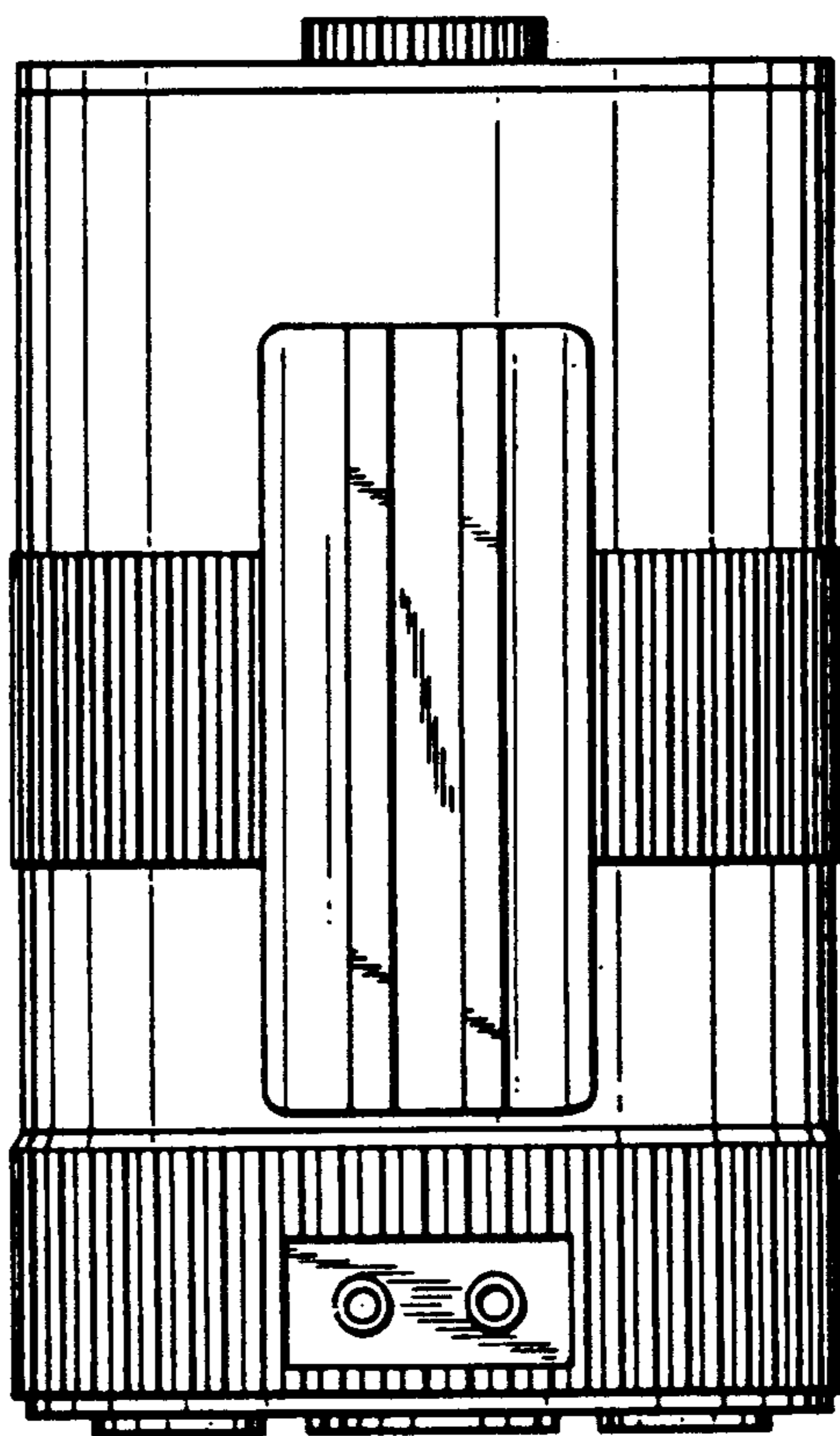

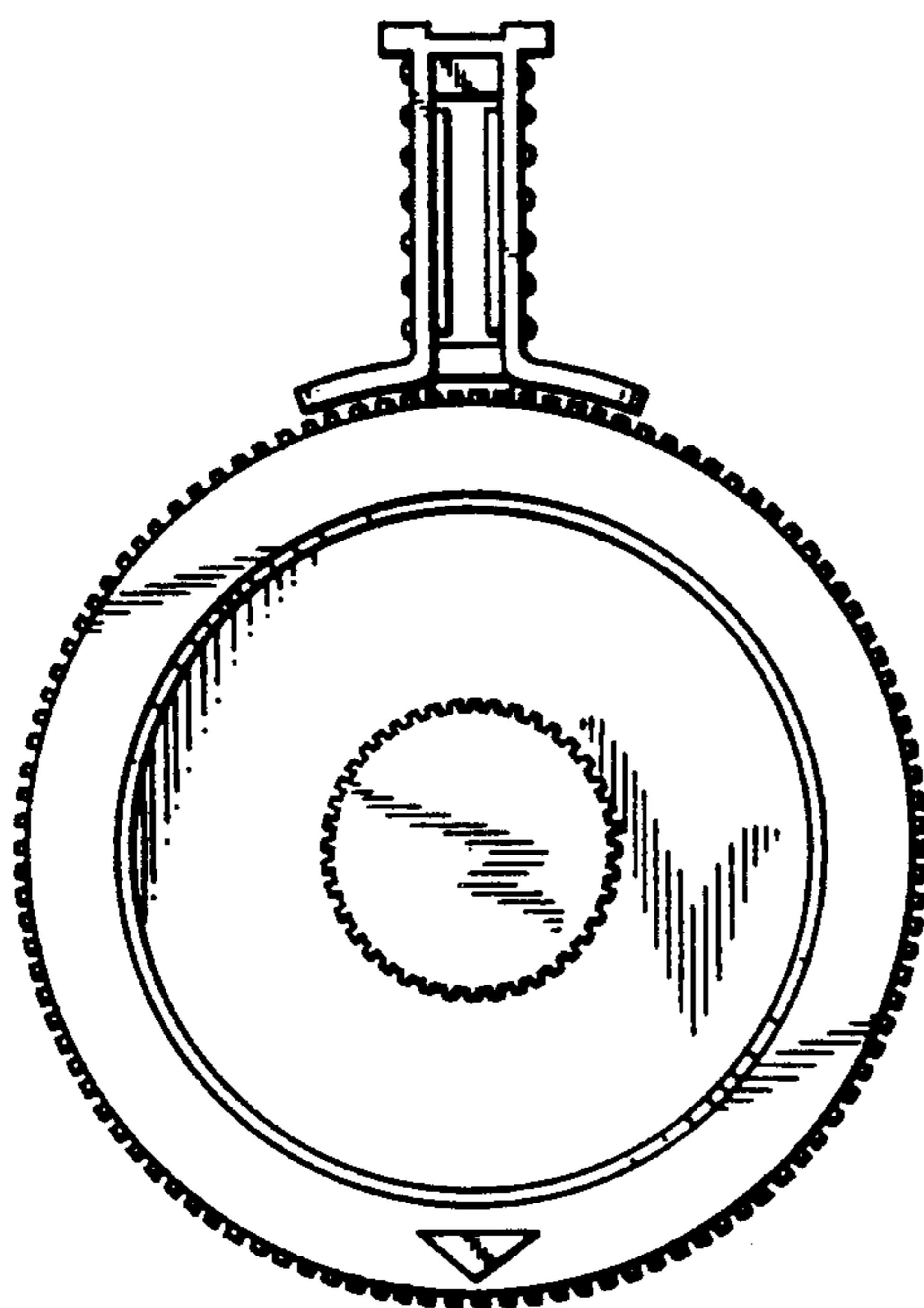
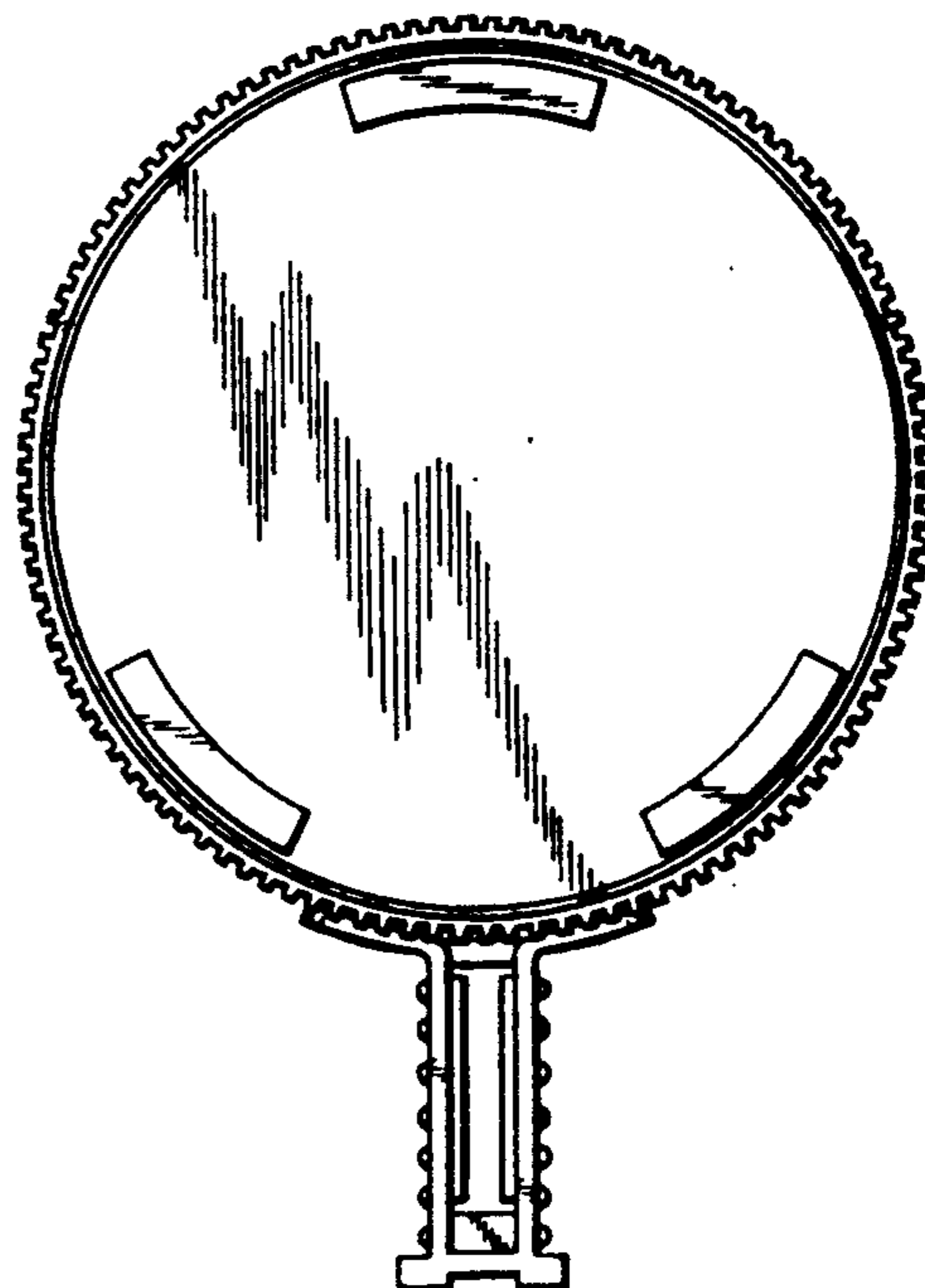
