## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an artificial flower showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a reduced front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a reduced rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a reduced top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a reduced bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a reduced left side elevational view thereof; and

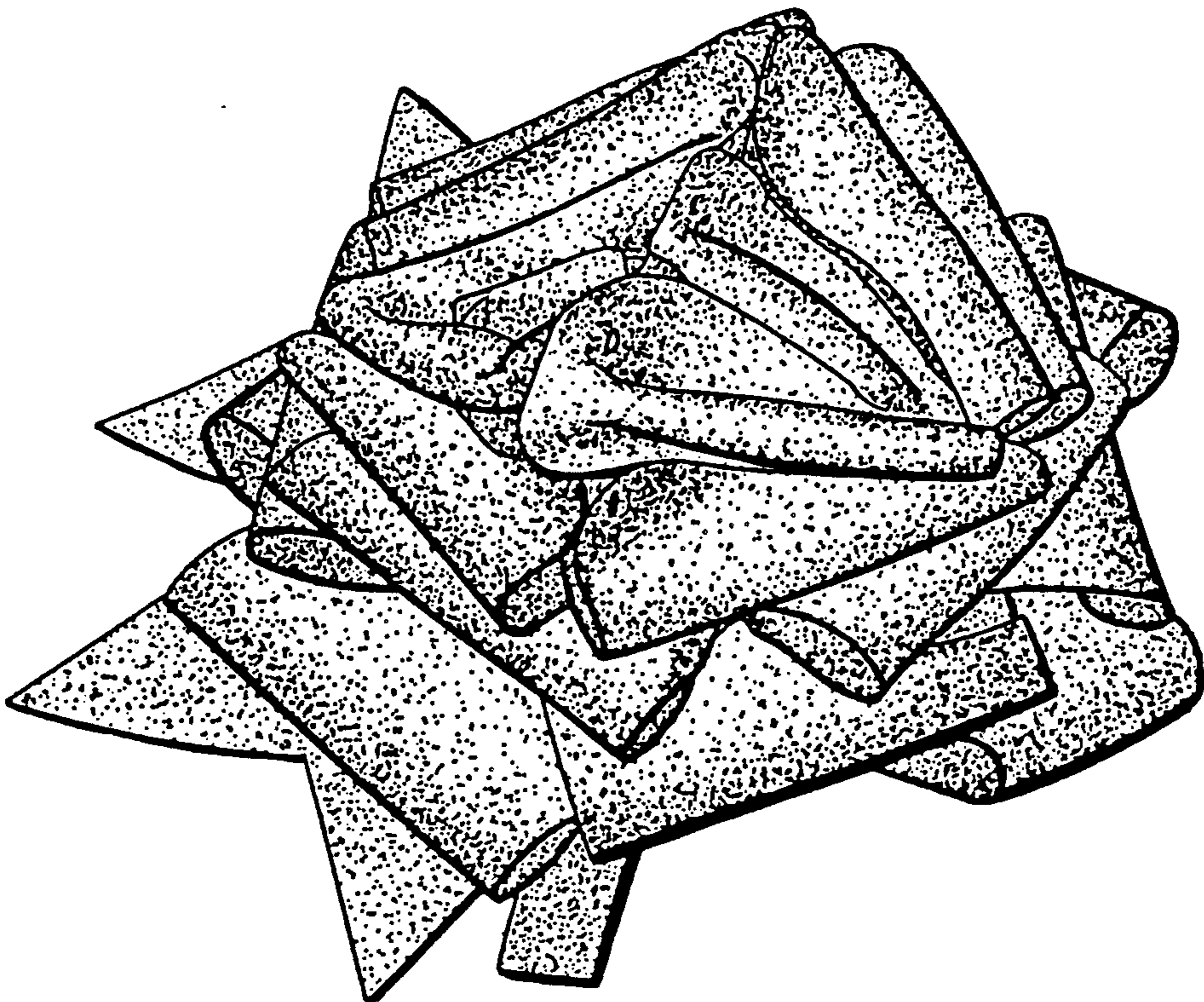

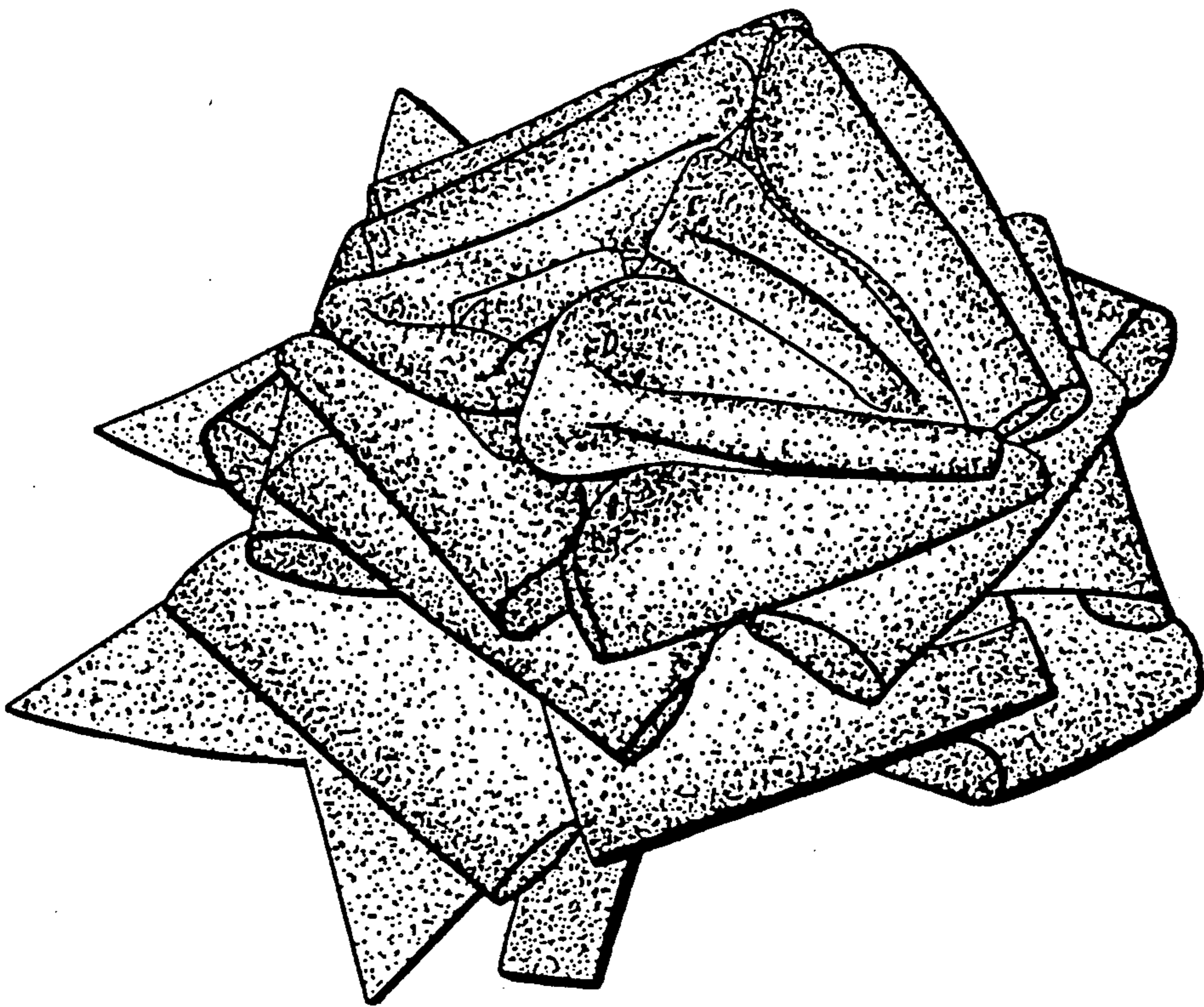

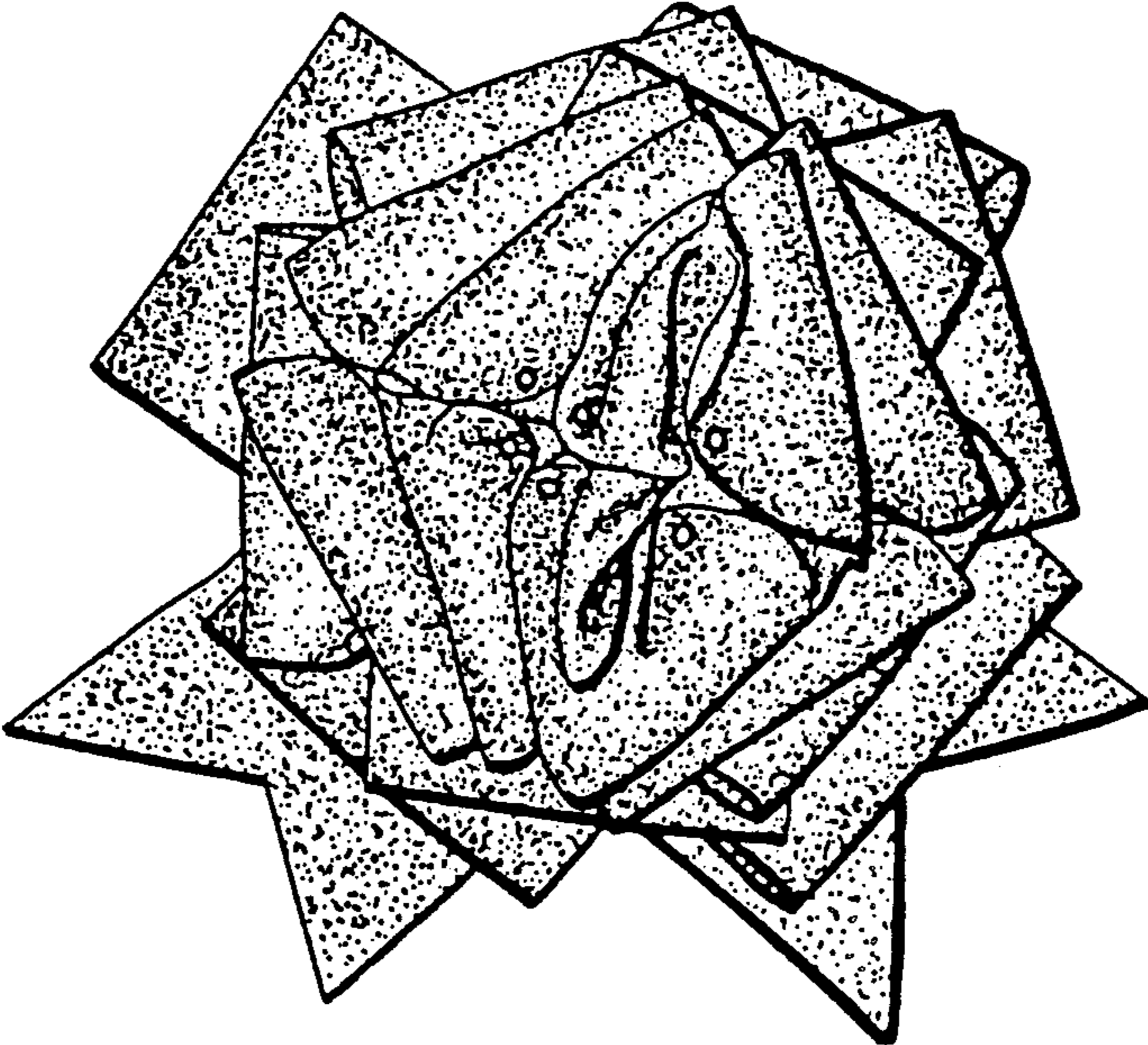

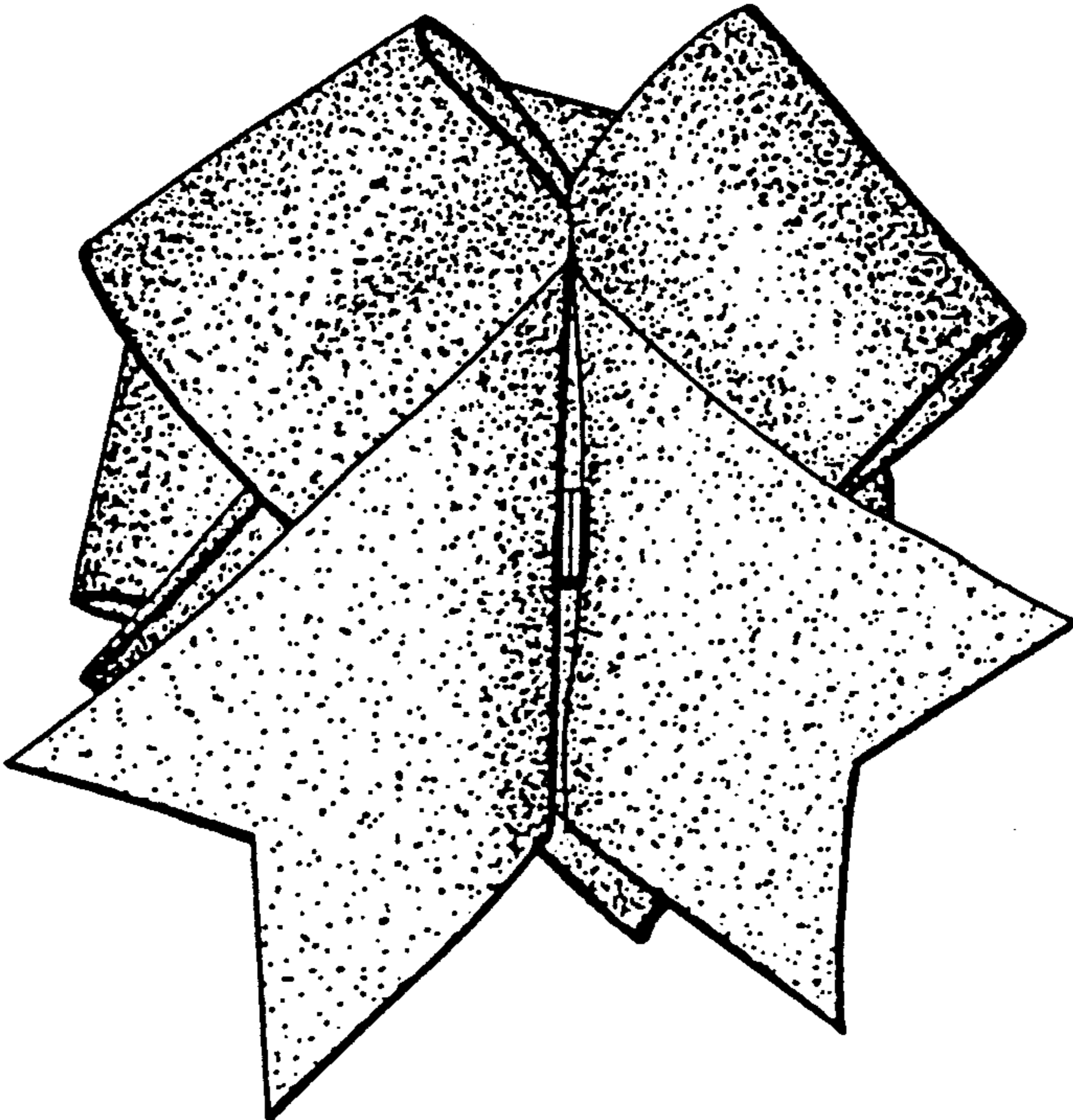

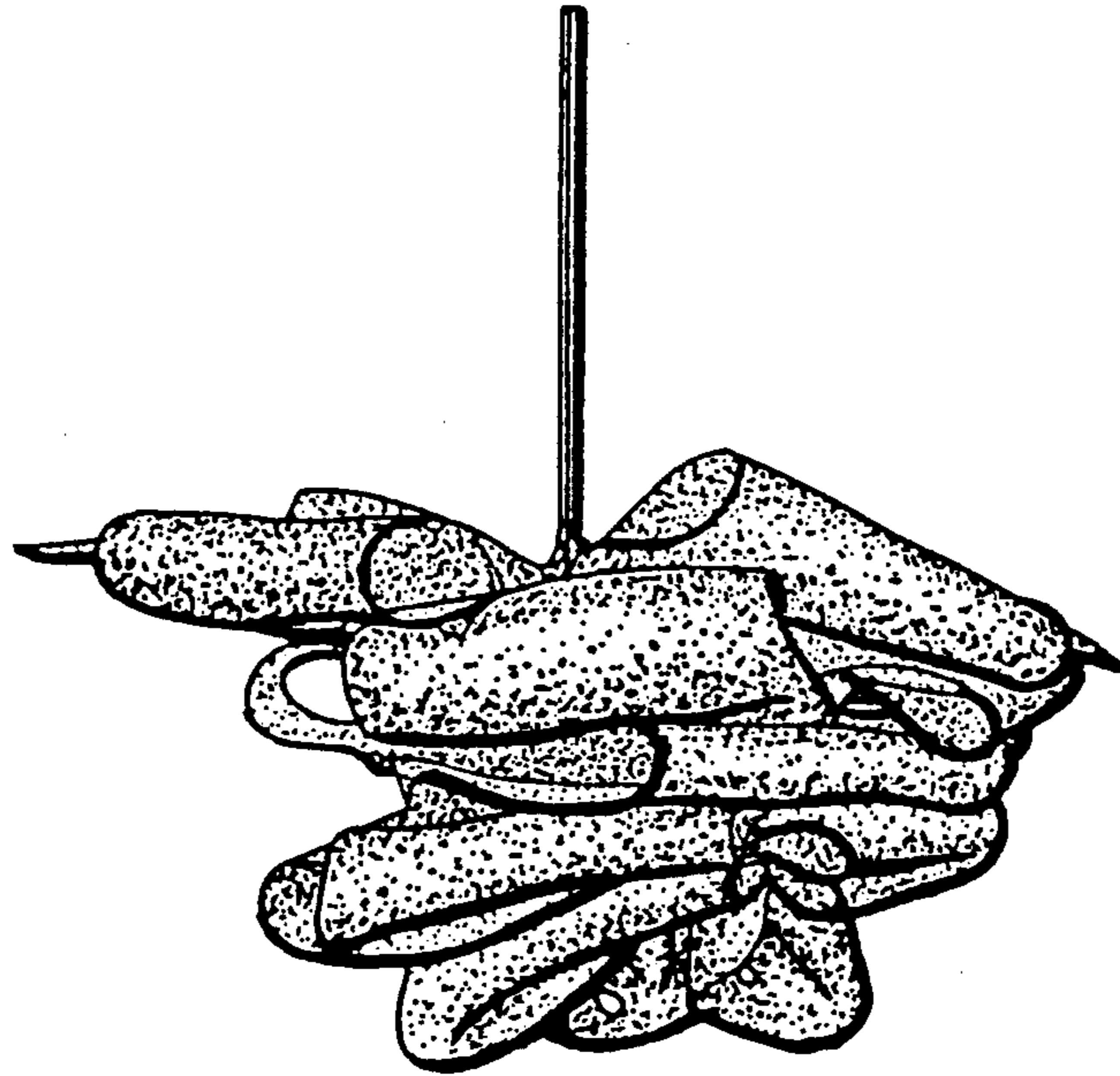

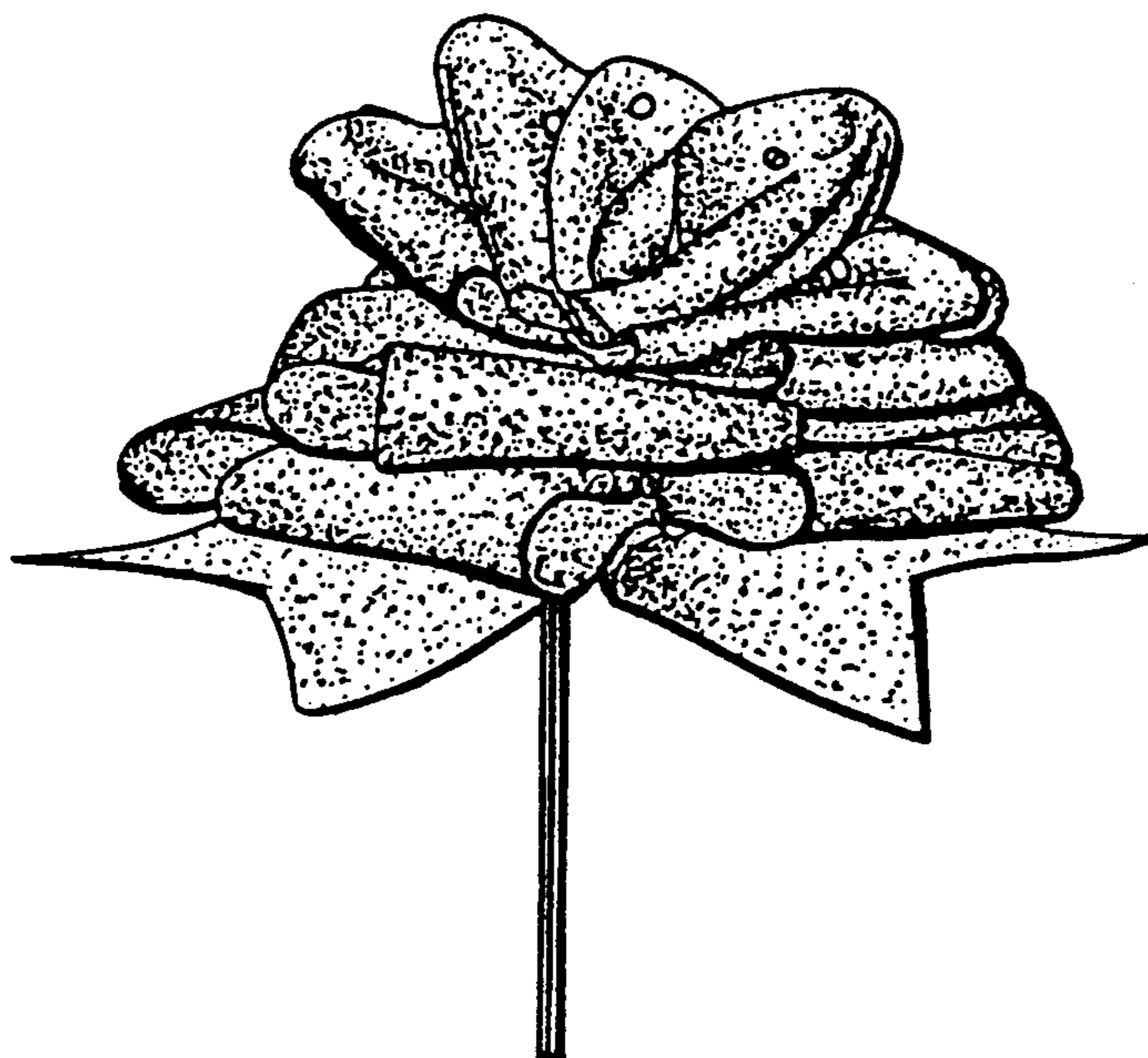

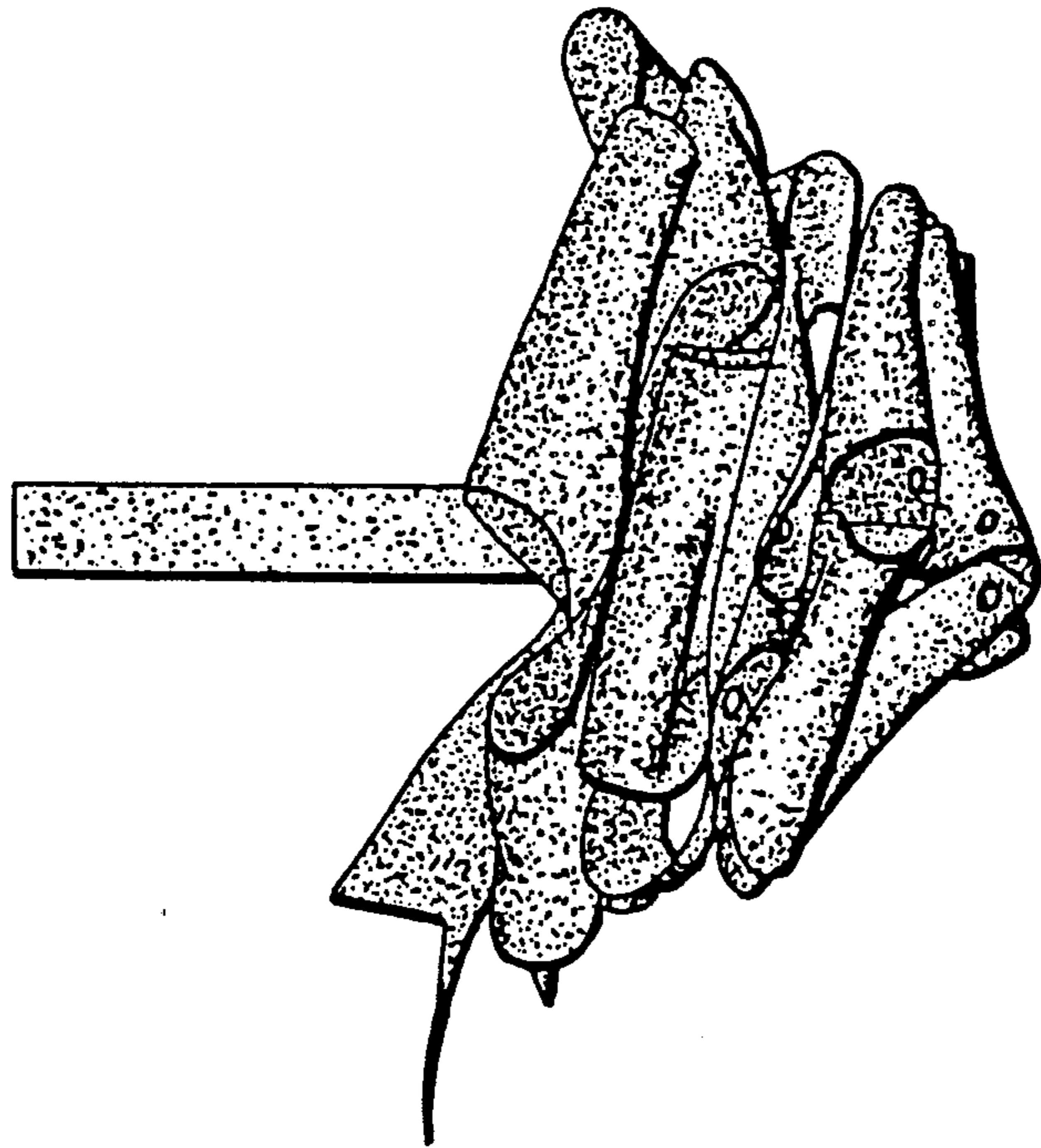
