DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a first embodiment of my new design for a golf club;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational view showing the putter head of the embodiments of FIGS. 2 and 3;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary top view of the putter head of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary left side elevational view of the putter head of FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmentary bottom view of the putter head of FIG. 3;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged fragmentary rear elevational view of the putter of FIG. 3;

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of a second embodiment of my new design for a golf club;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 10 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational view of the embodiment of FIGS. 8 and 9;

FIG. 11 is an enlarged fragmentary top view of the putter head depicted in FIG. 8;

FIG. 12 is an enlarged fragmentary left side elevation view of the putter head of FIG. 10;

FIG. 13 is an enlarged fragmentary bottom view of the putter head of FIG. 10; and

FIG. 14 is an enlarged fragmentary rear elevational view of the putter head of FIG. 10.
