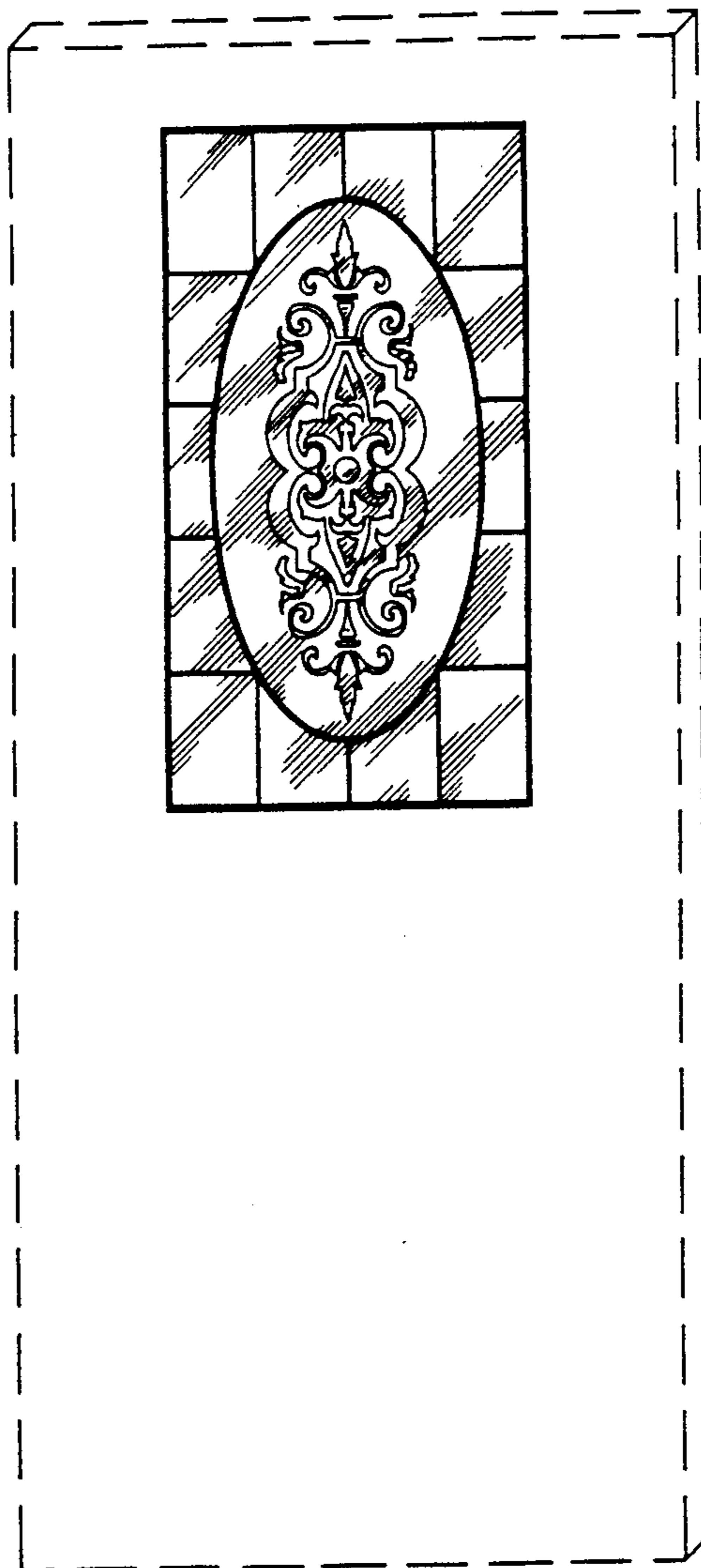
The ornamental design for a door light, as shown and

**DESCRIPTION**

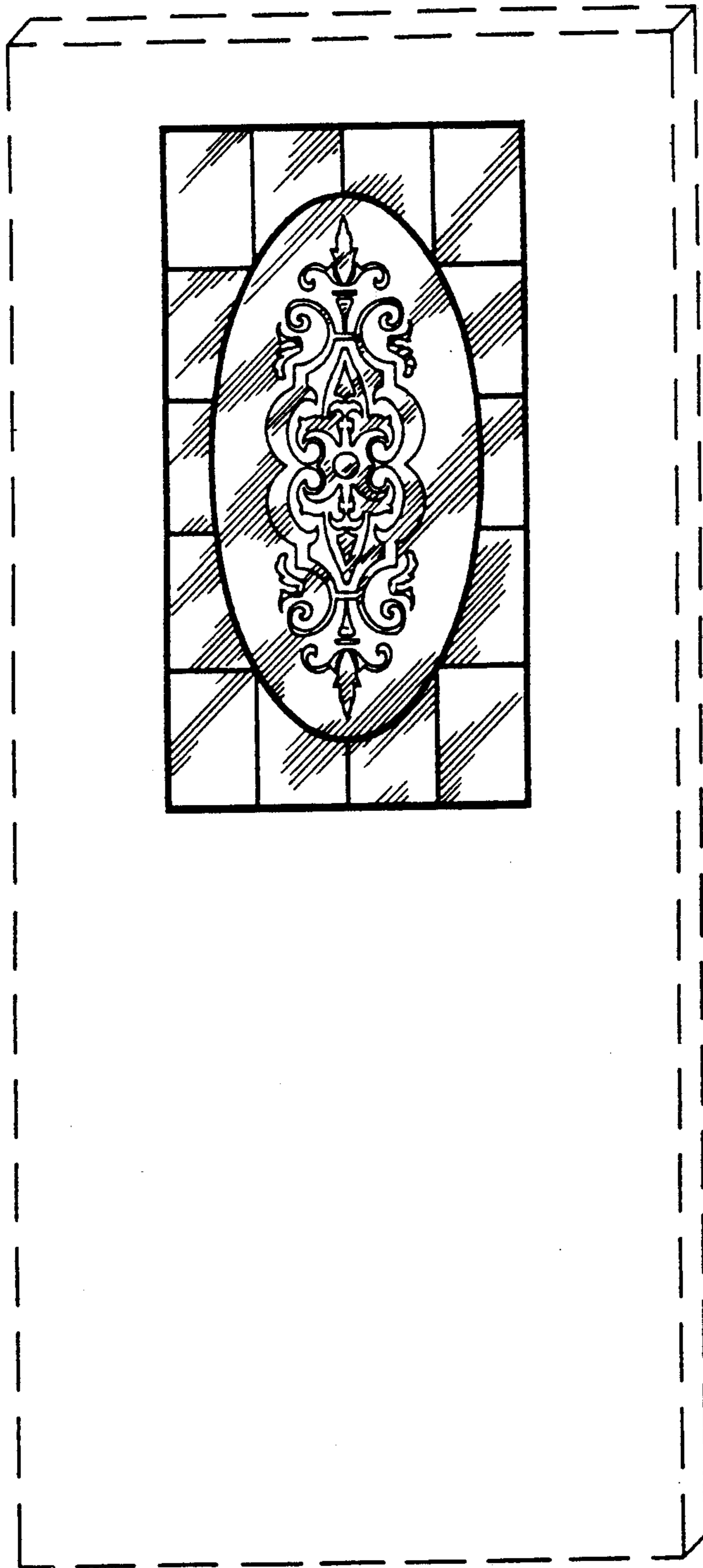
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a door light show-
