[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a snack product, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a snack product showing our new design, the undisclosed rear being the same;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, taken along line 2—2 of FIG. 1, the undisclosed sides as seen perpendicular to the axis of any lobe being the same;

FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 3.

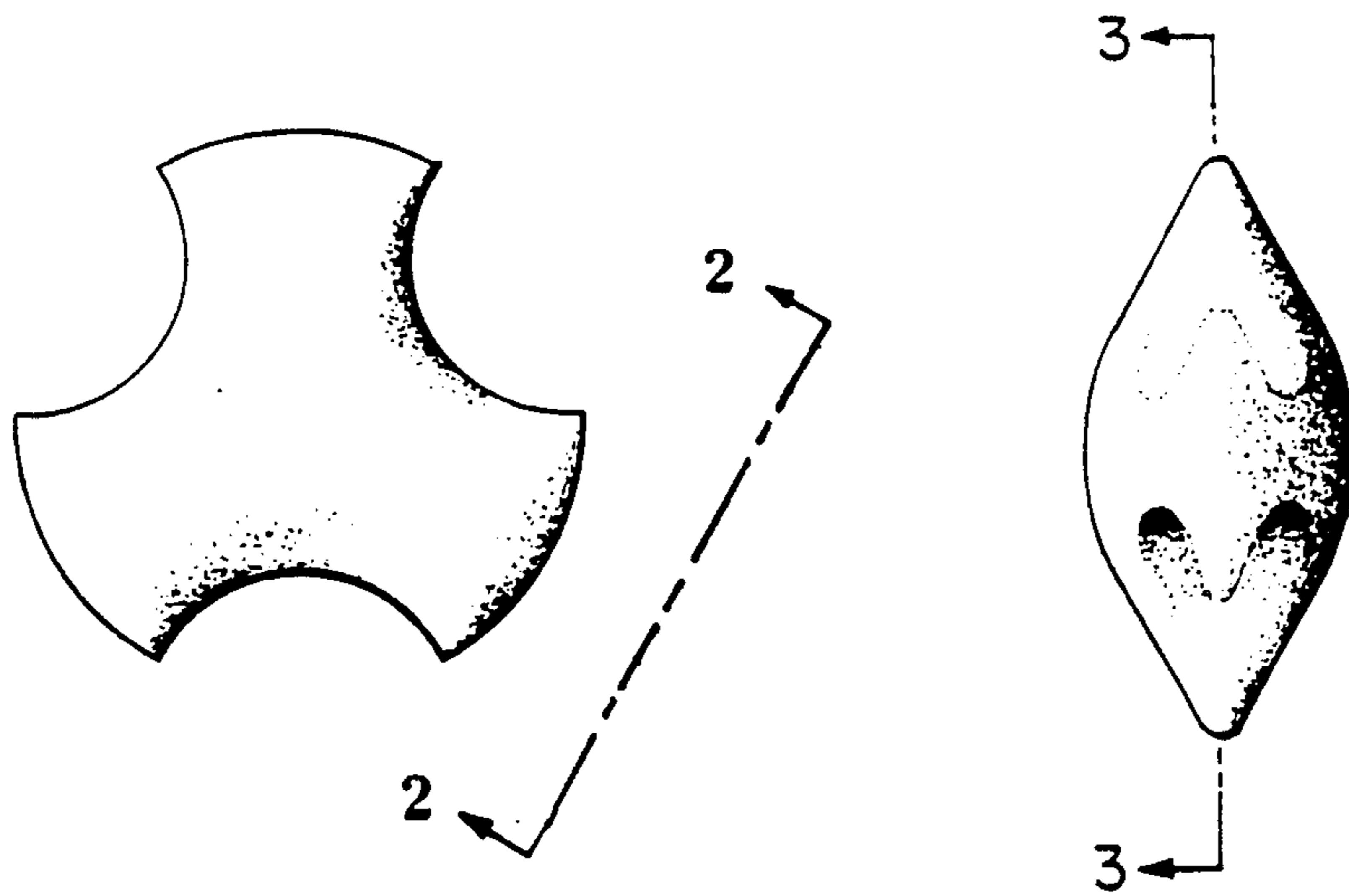

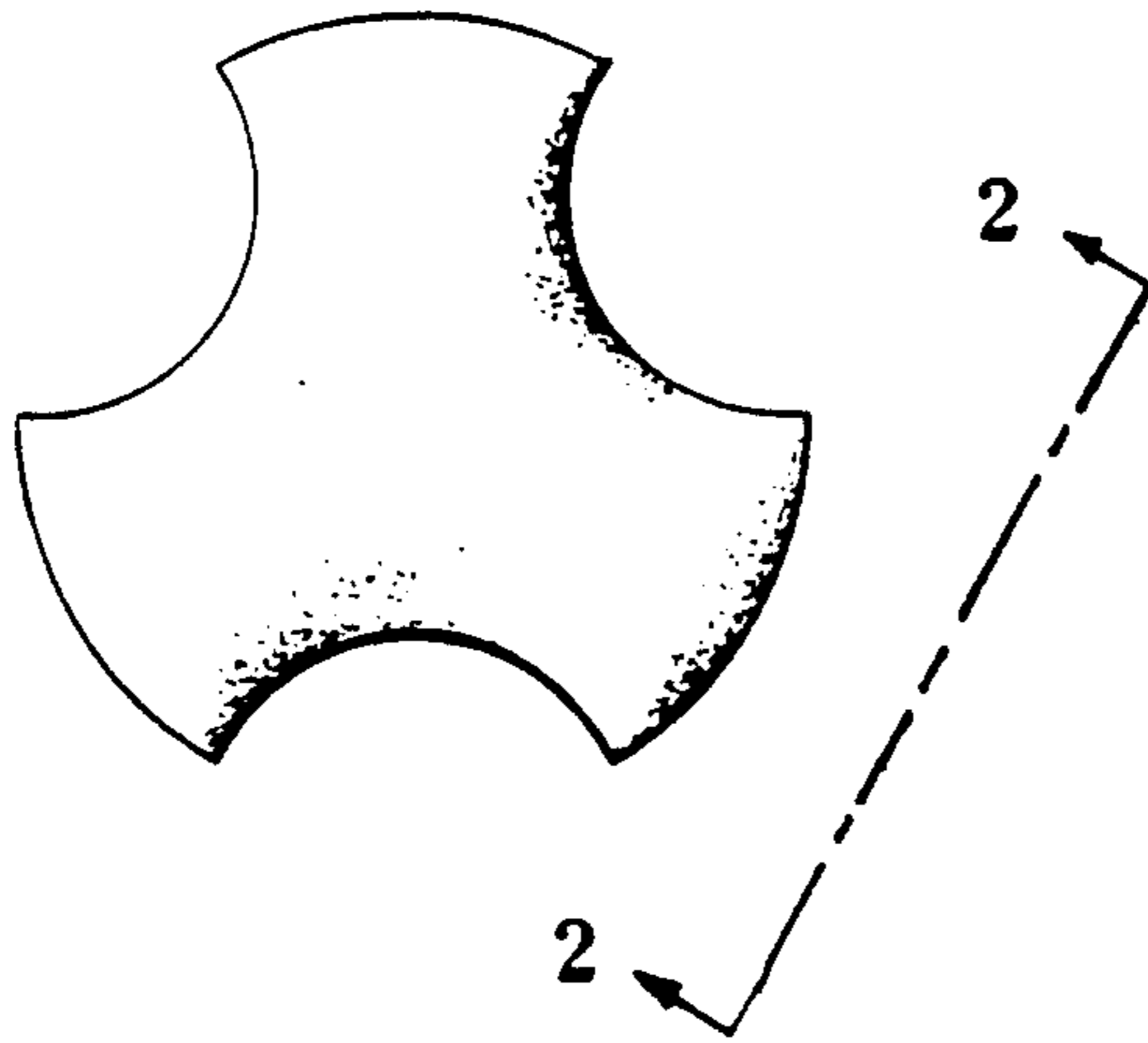

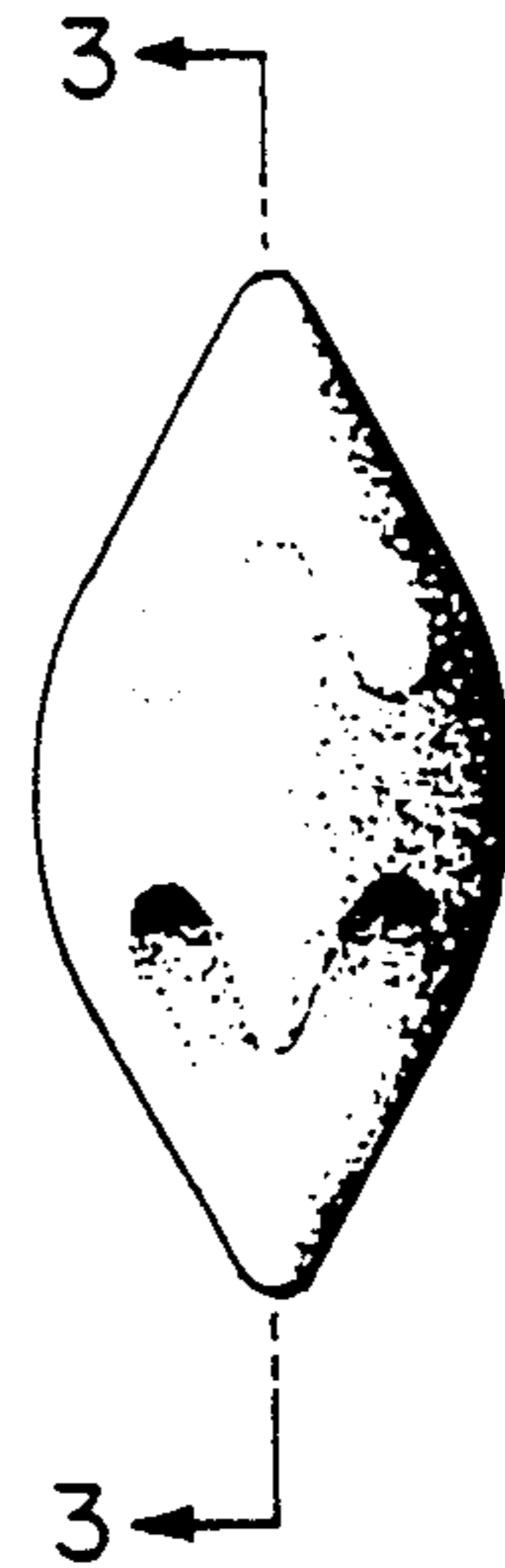
