FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;

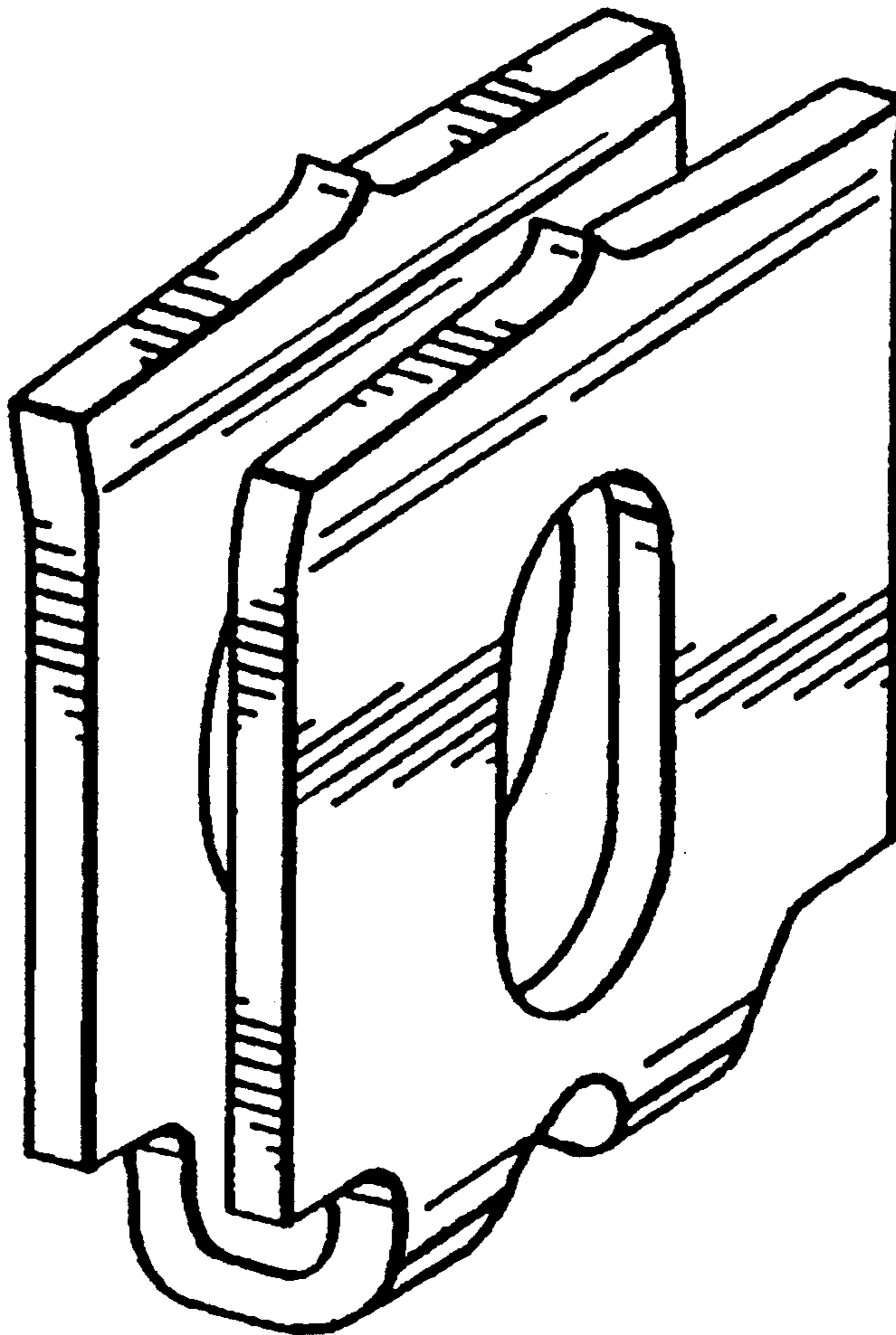

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof on an enlarged scale.



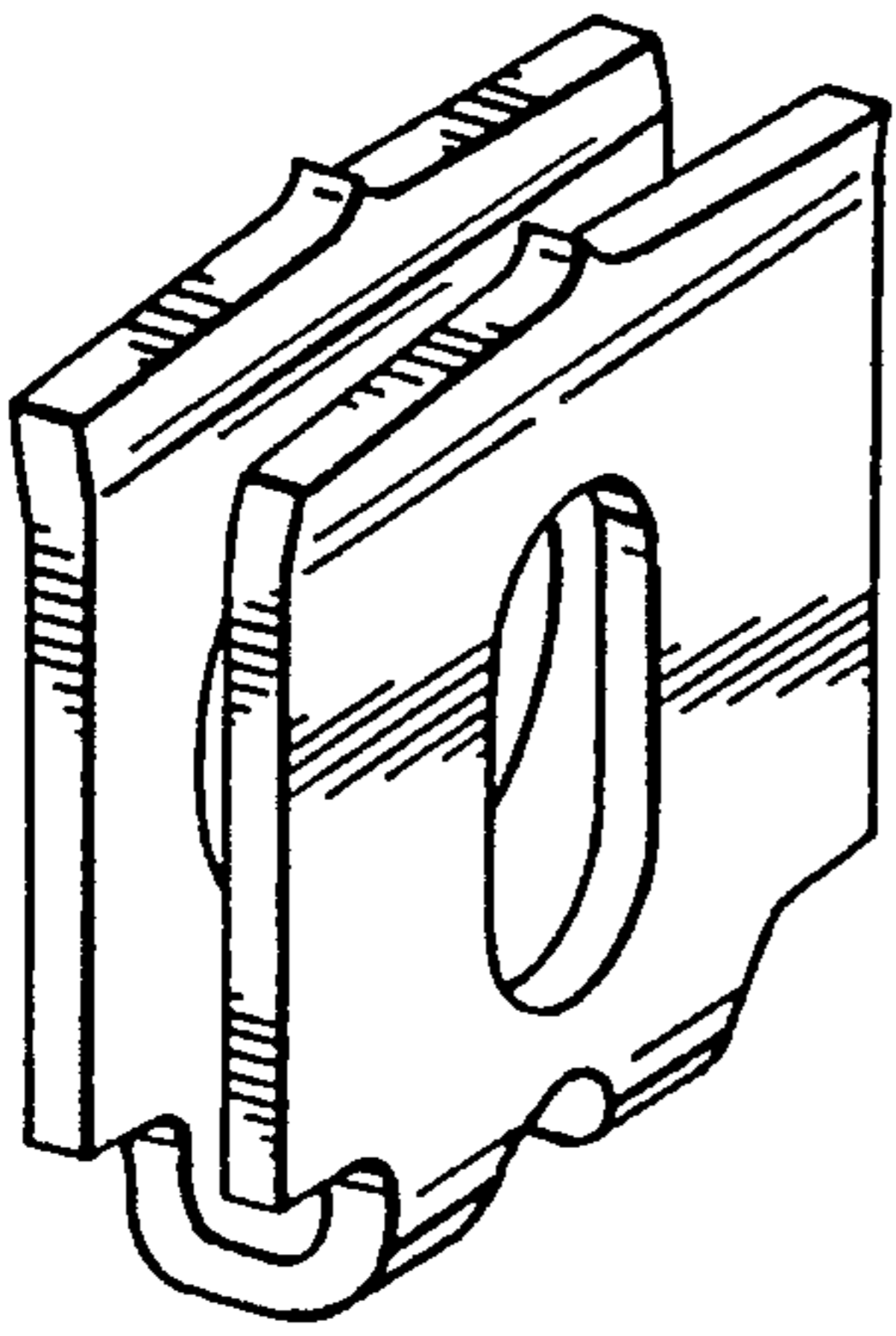

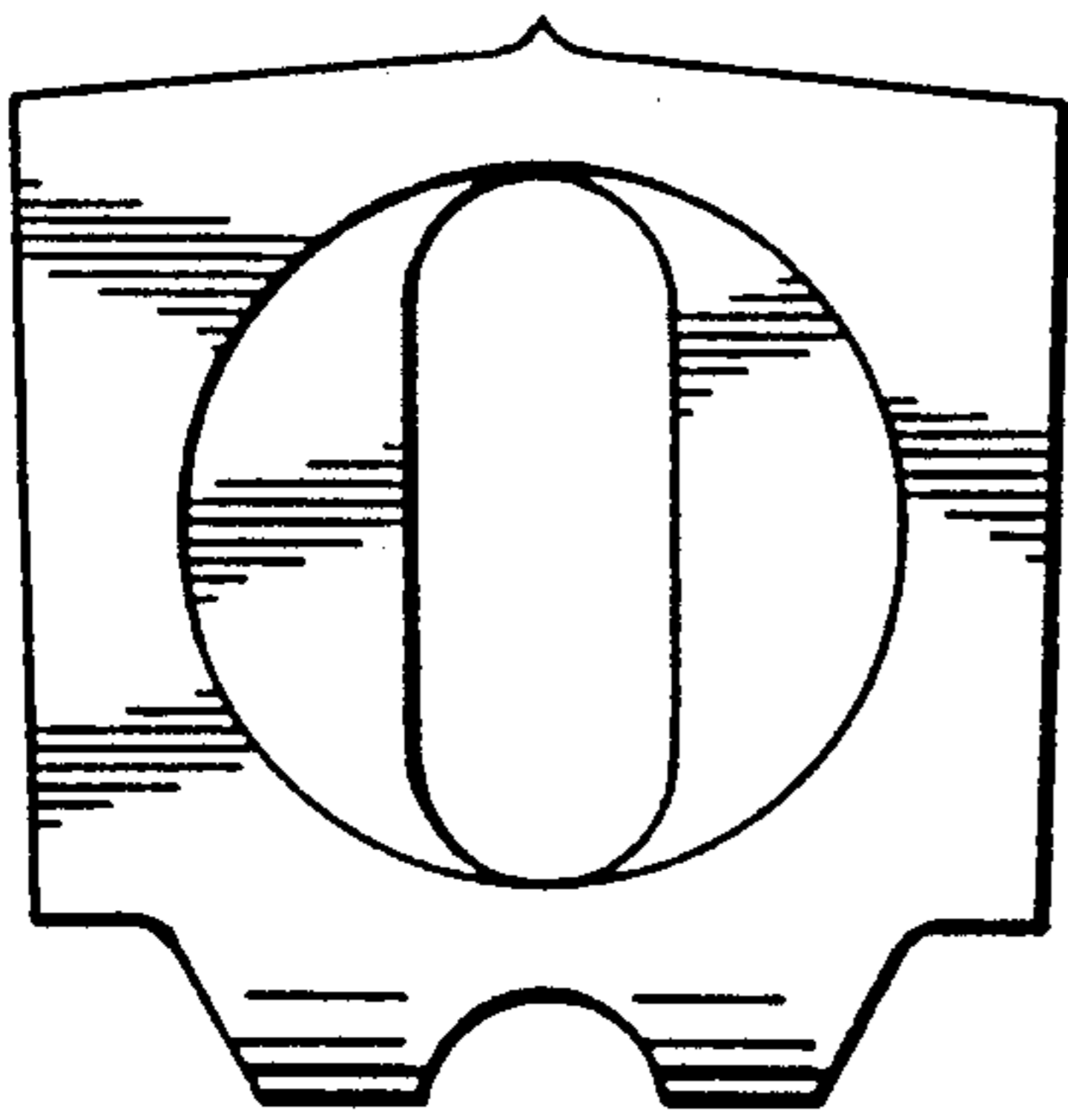

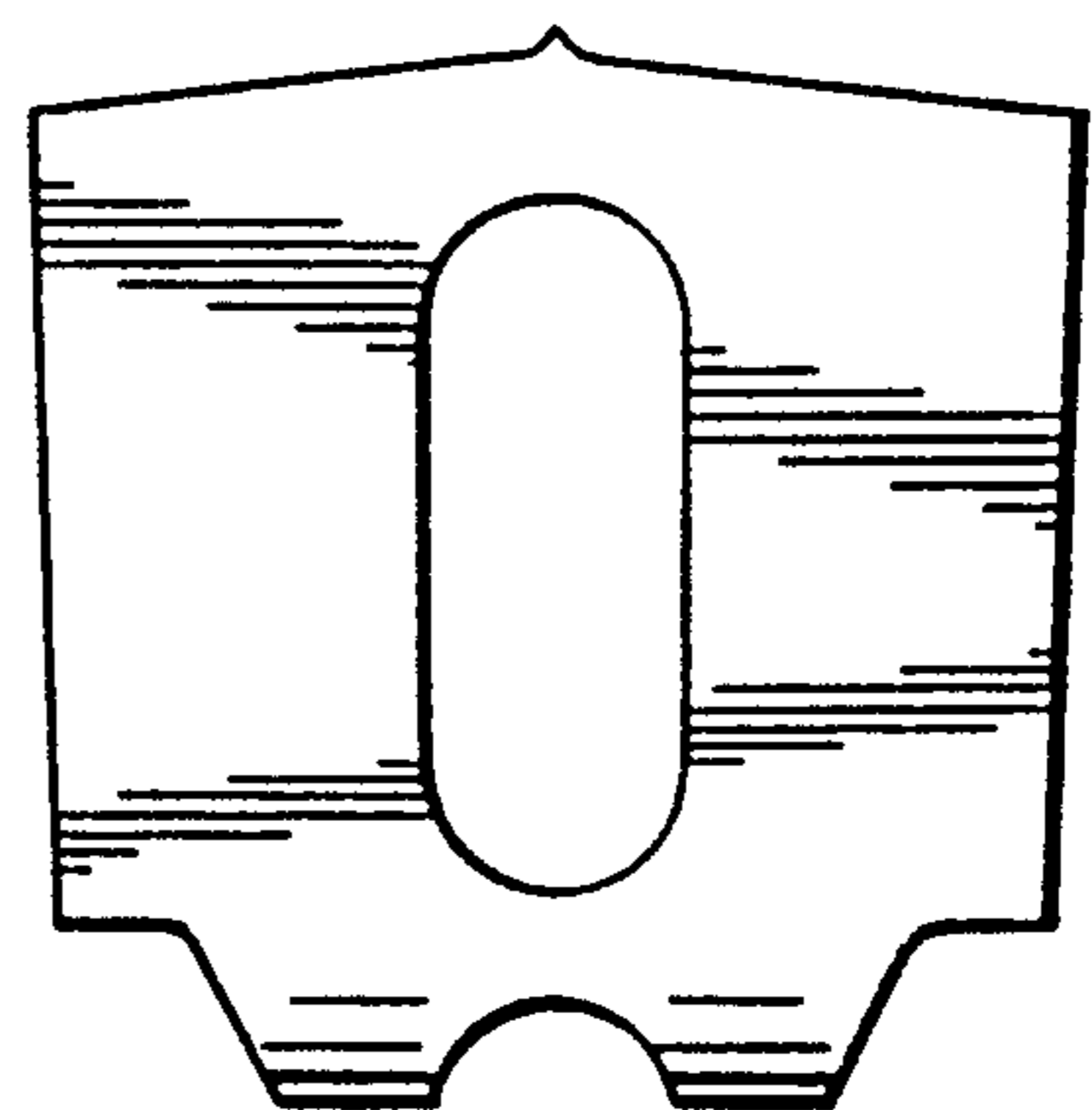

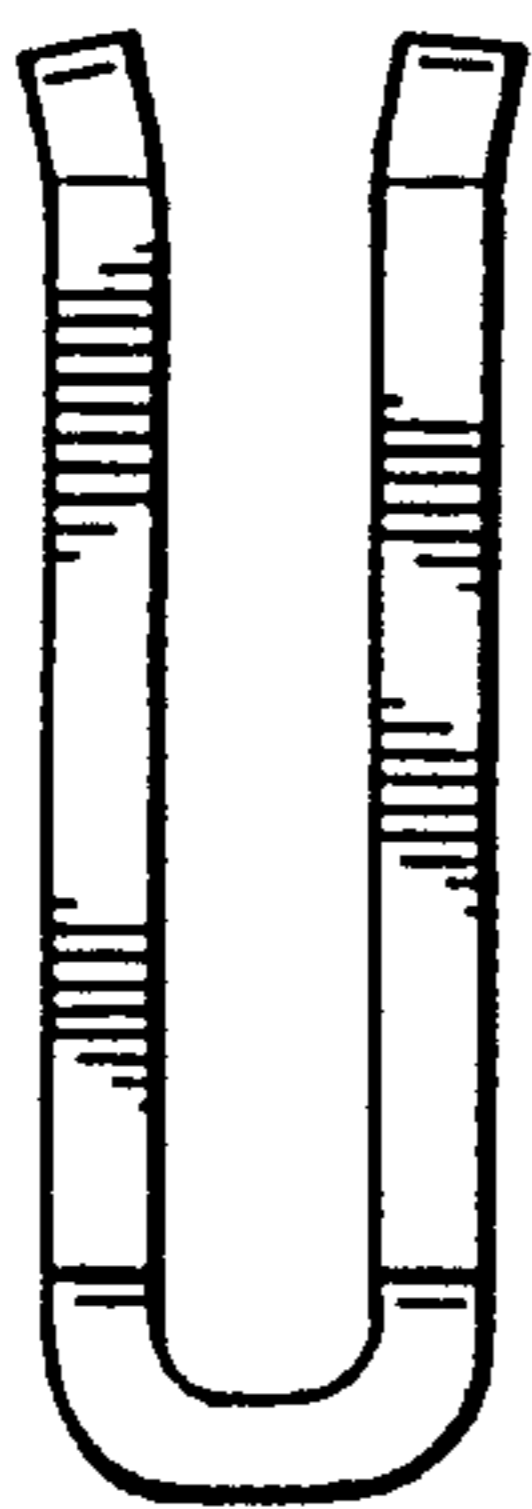

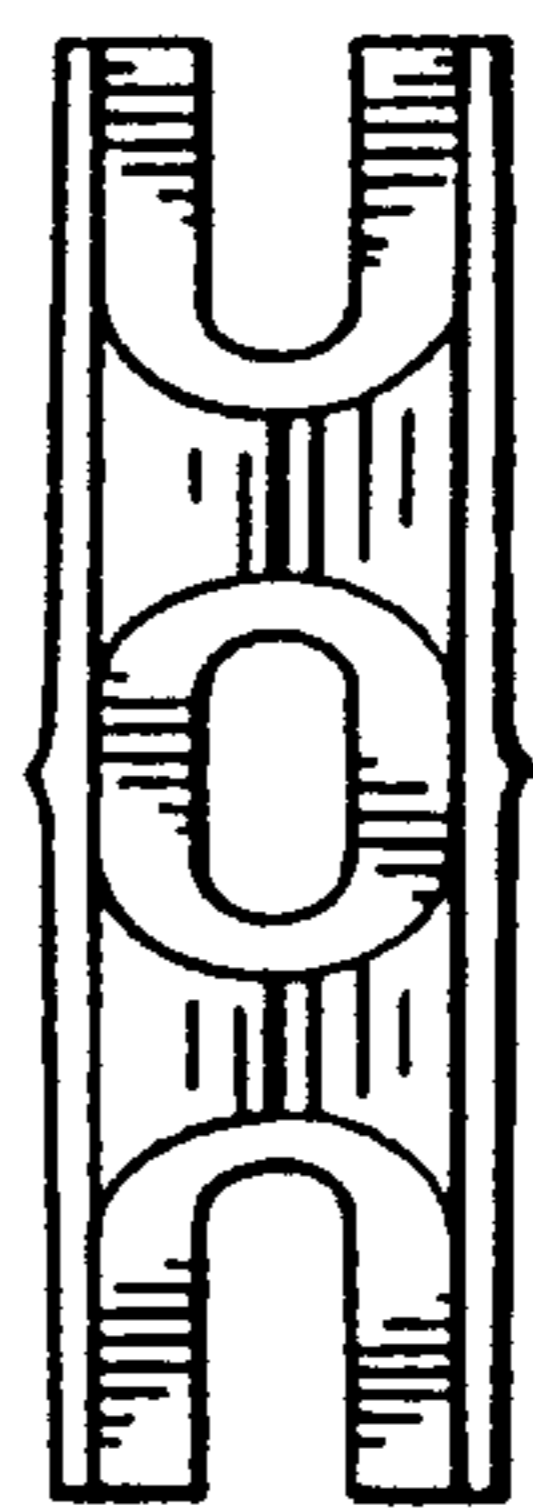
