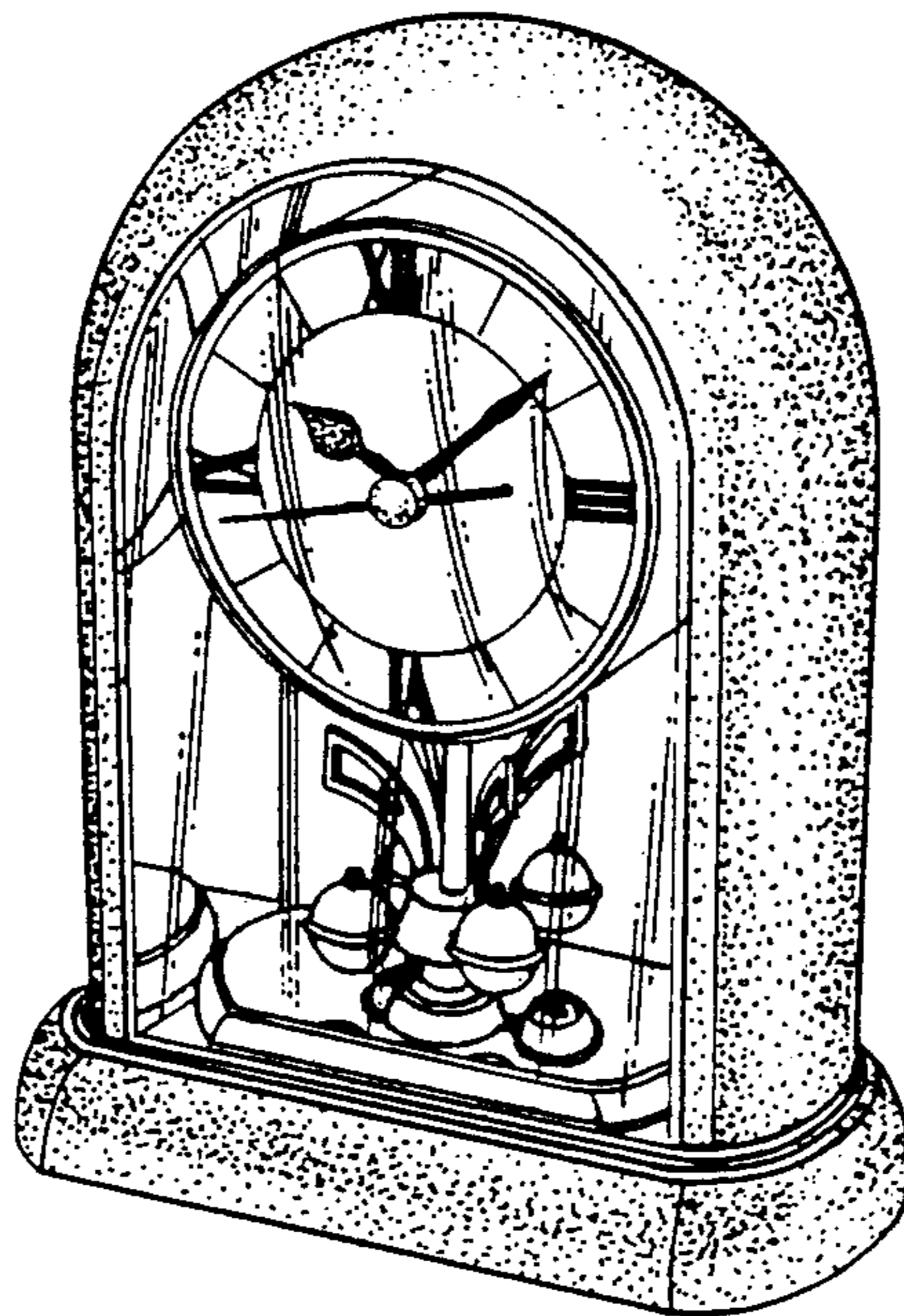

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a clock showing my new design;

 FIG. 7 is a front right perspective view thereof.



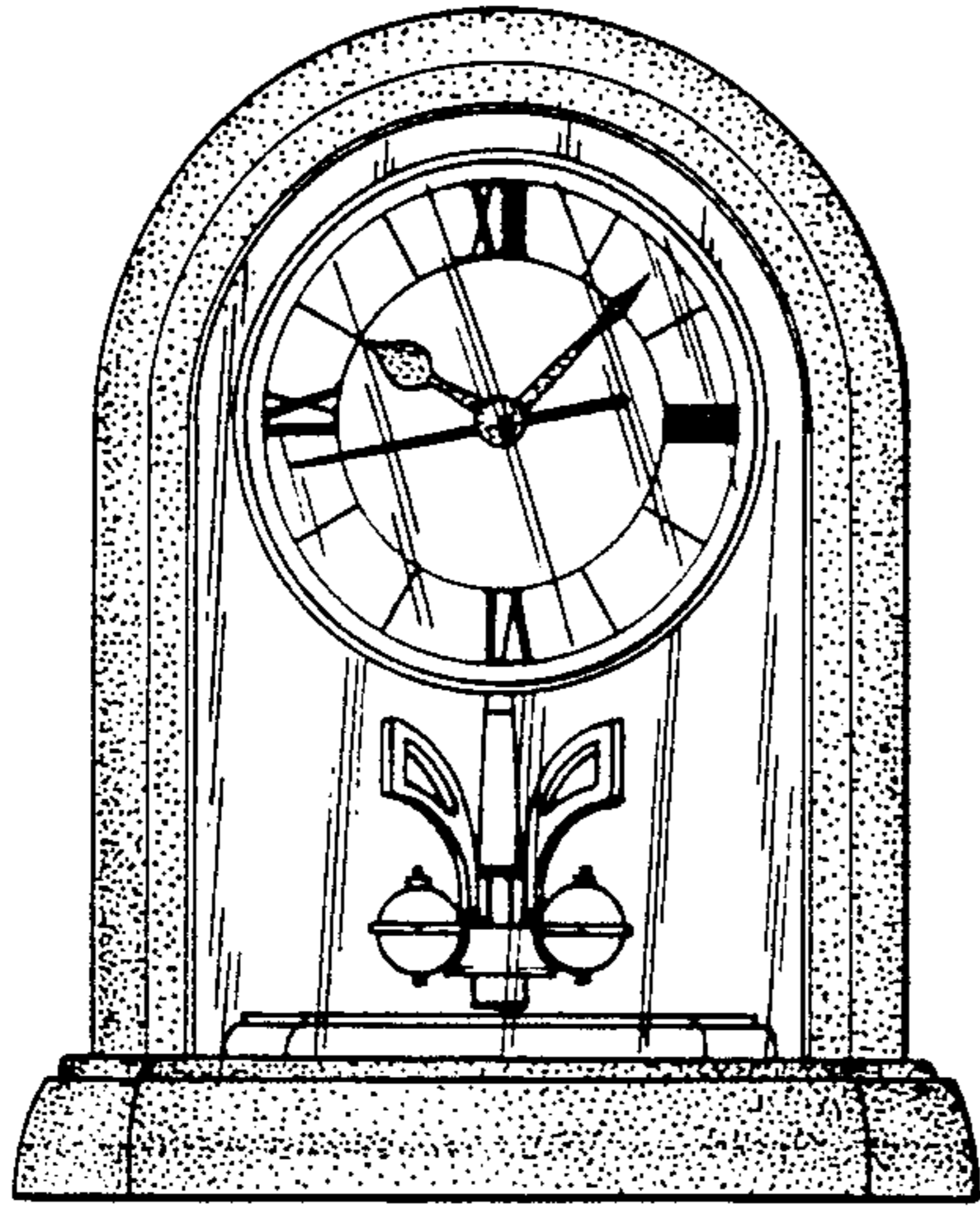

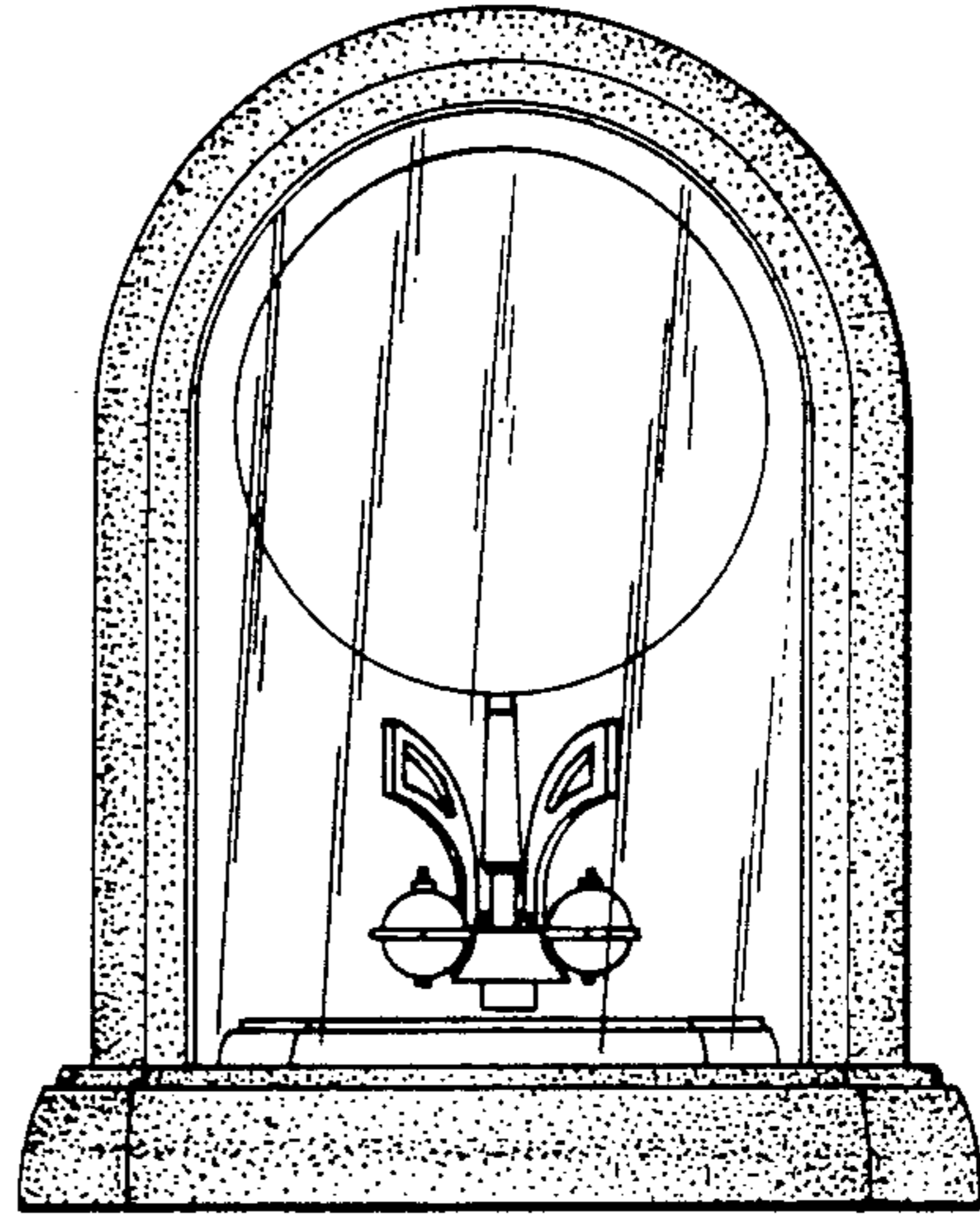

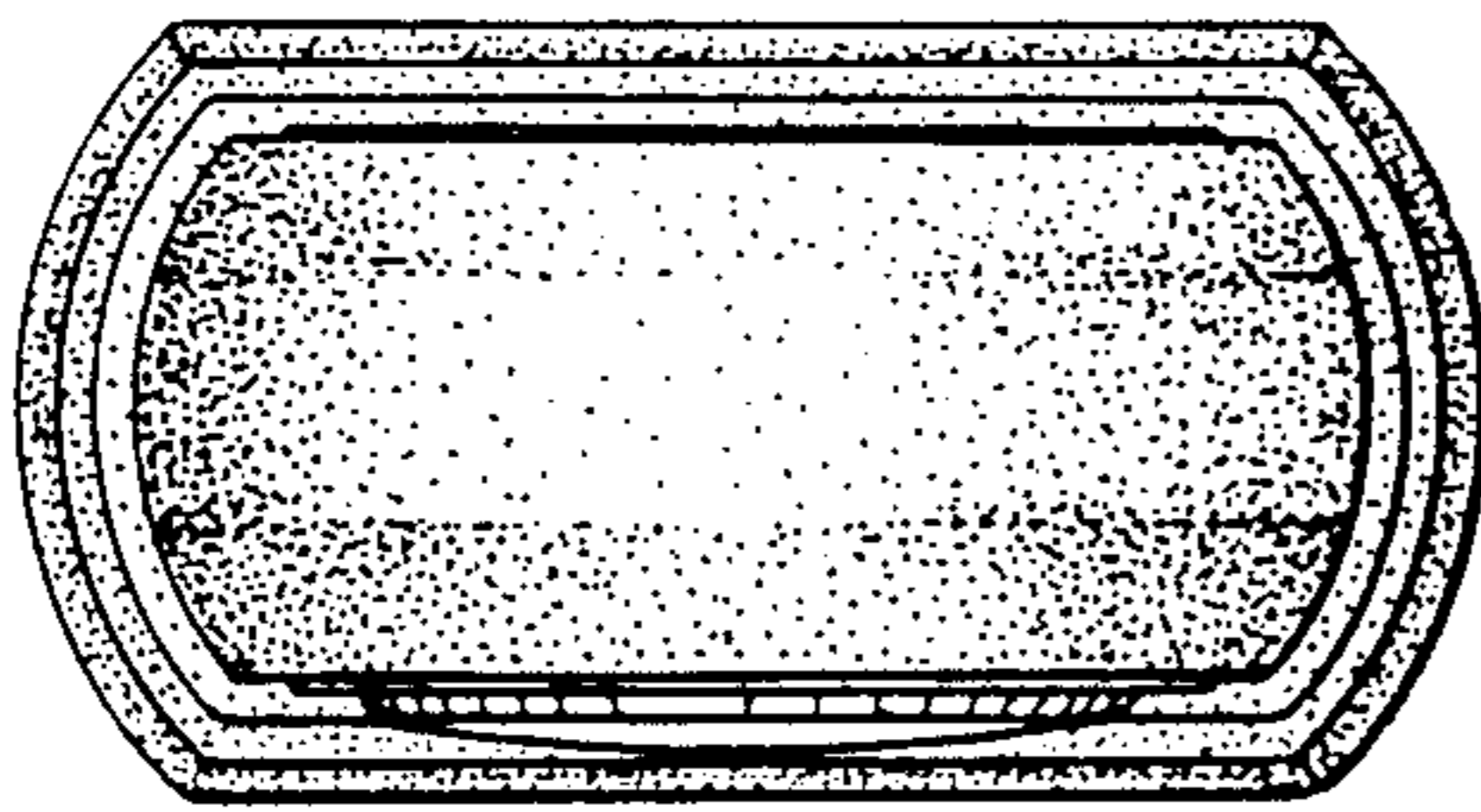

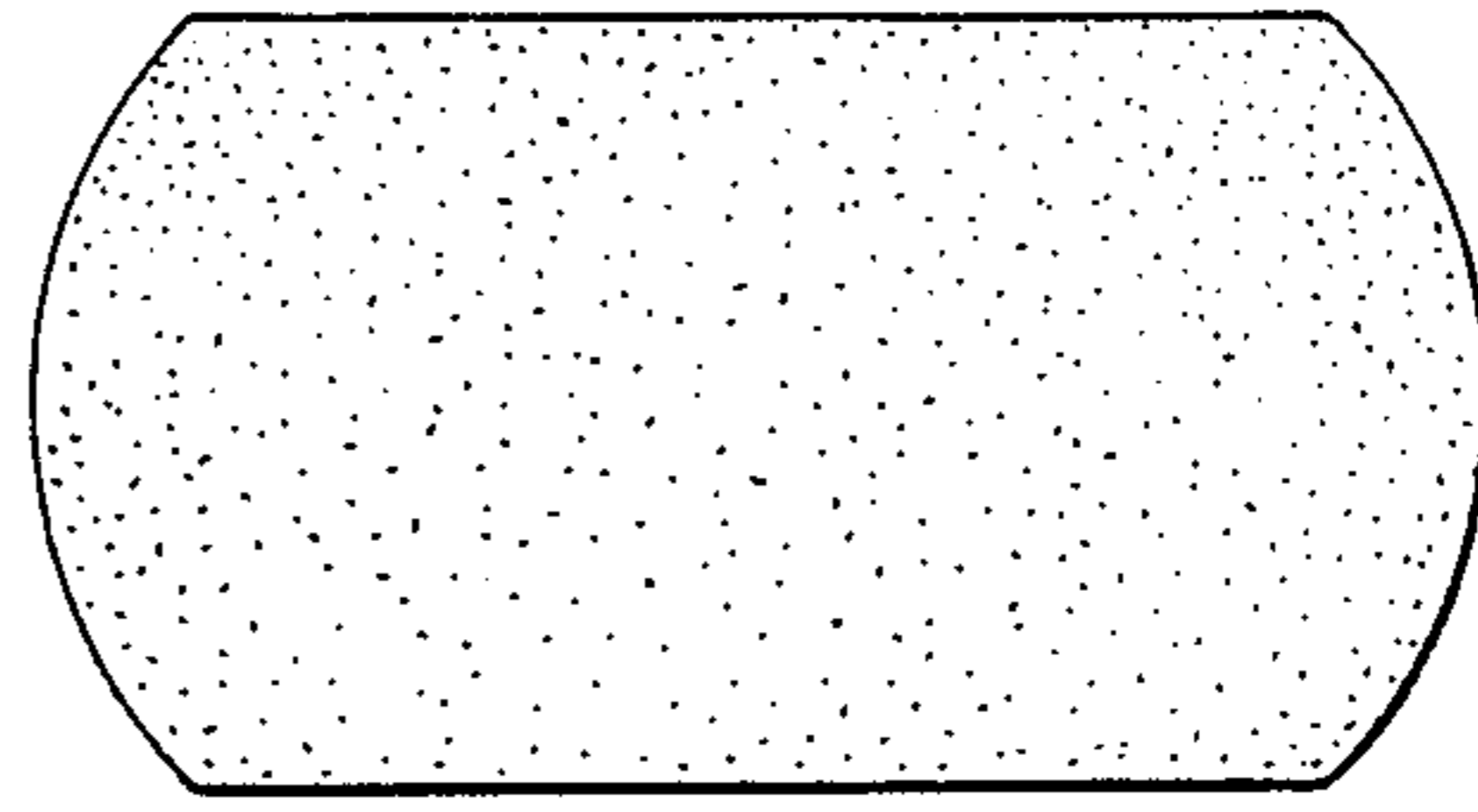

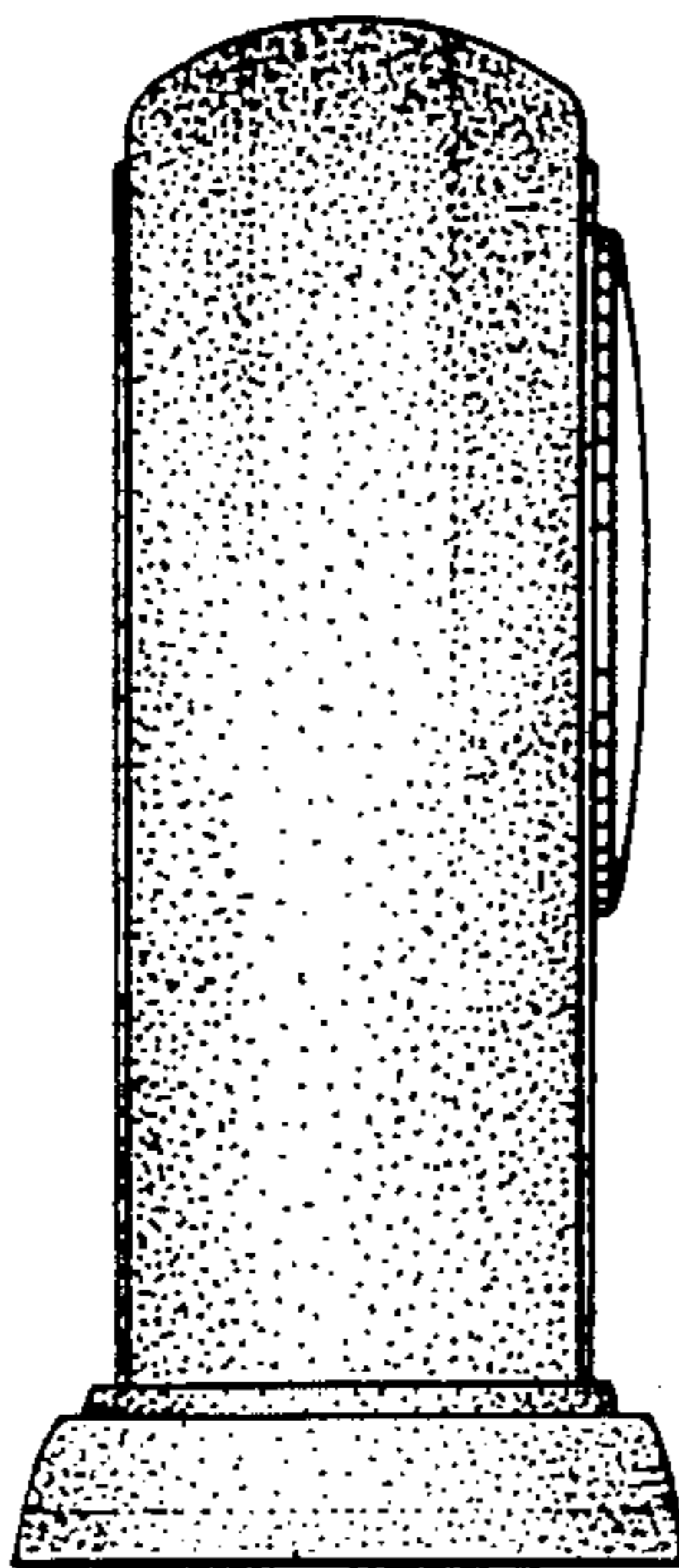

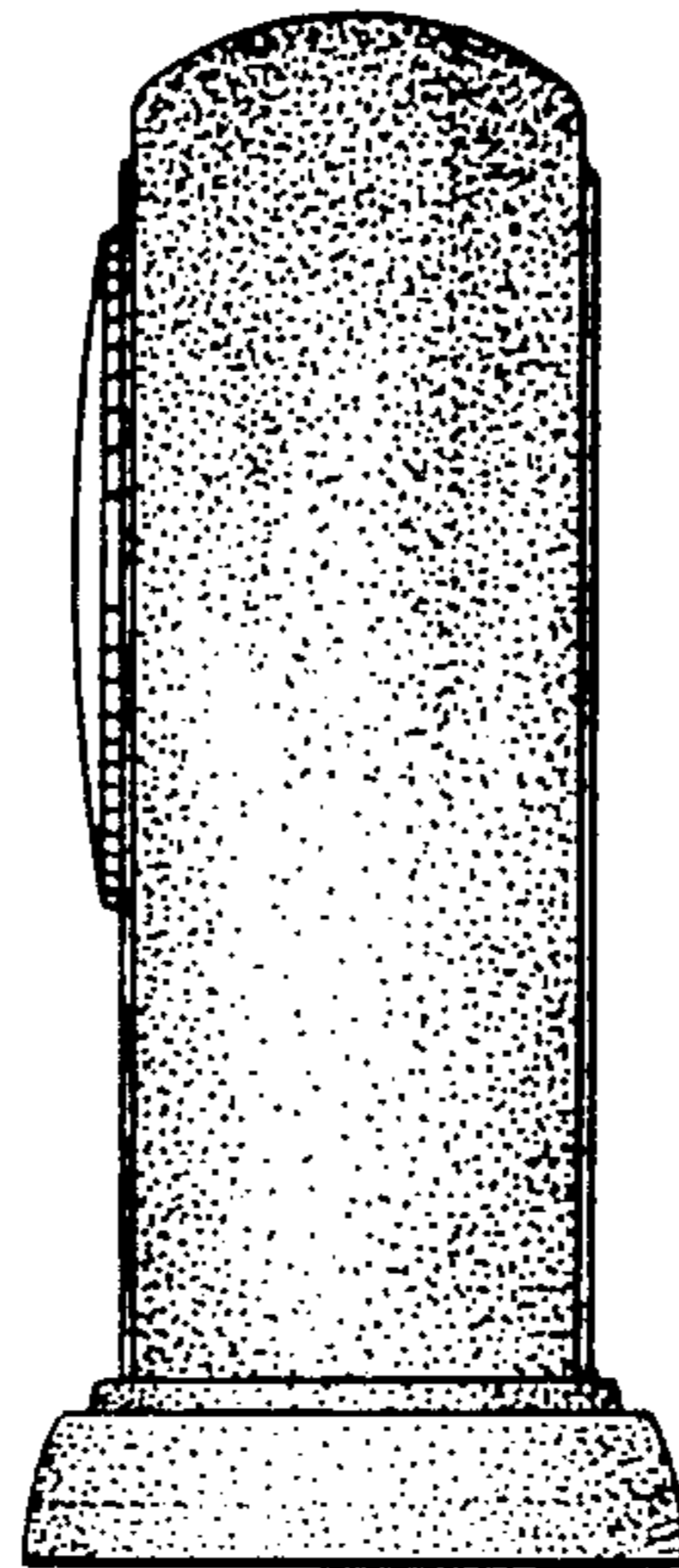

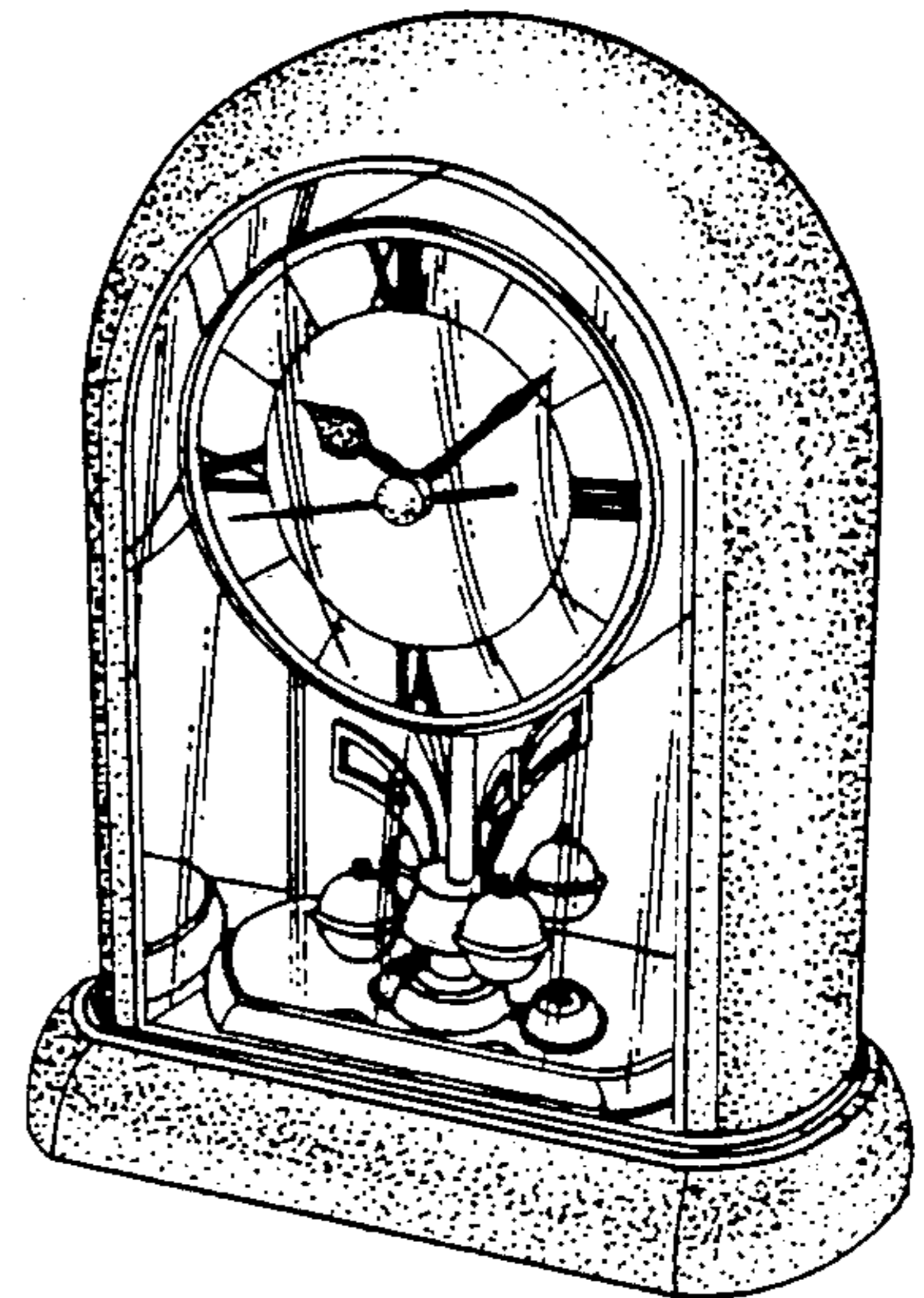
