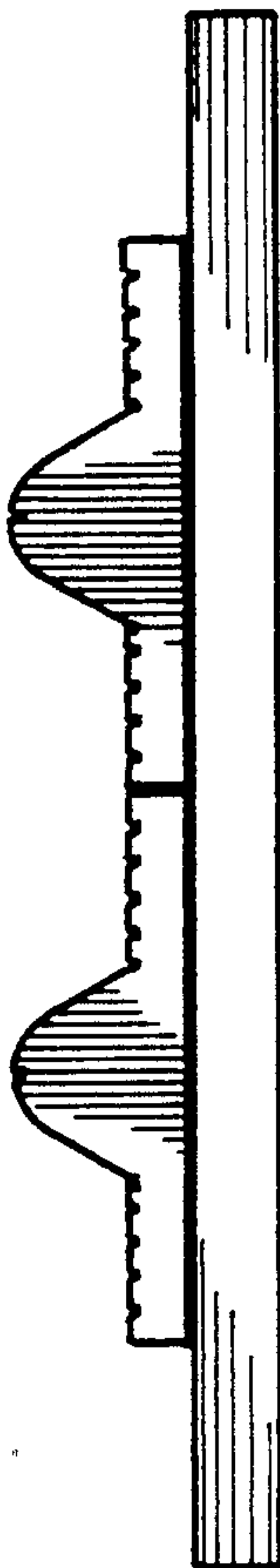
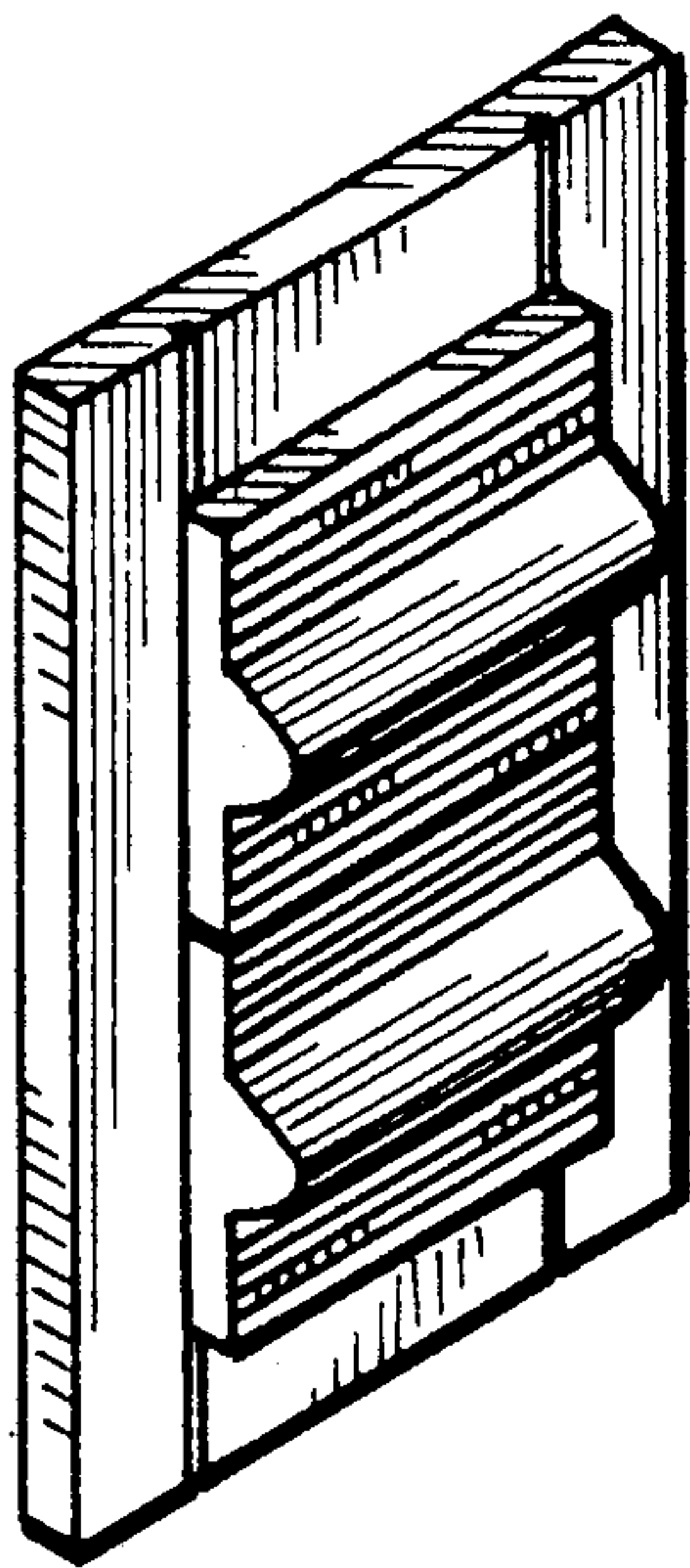
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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined wall plate and switches, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined wall plate and switches showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof, the rear being unornamented;
FIG. 3 is an enlarged right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof, the top being a mirror image.



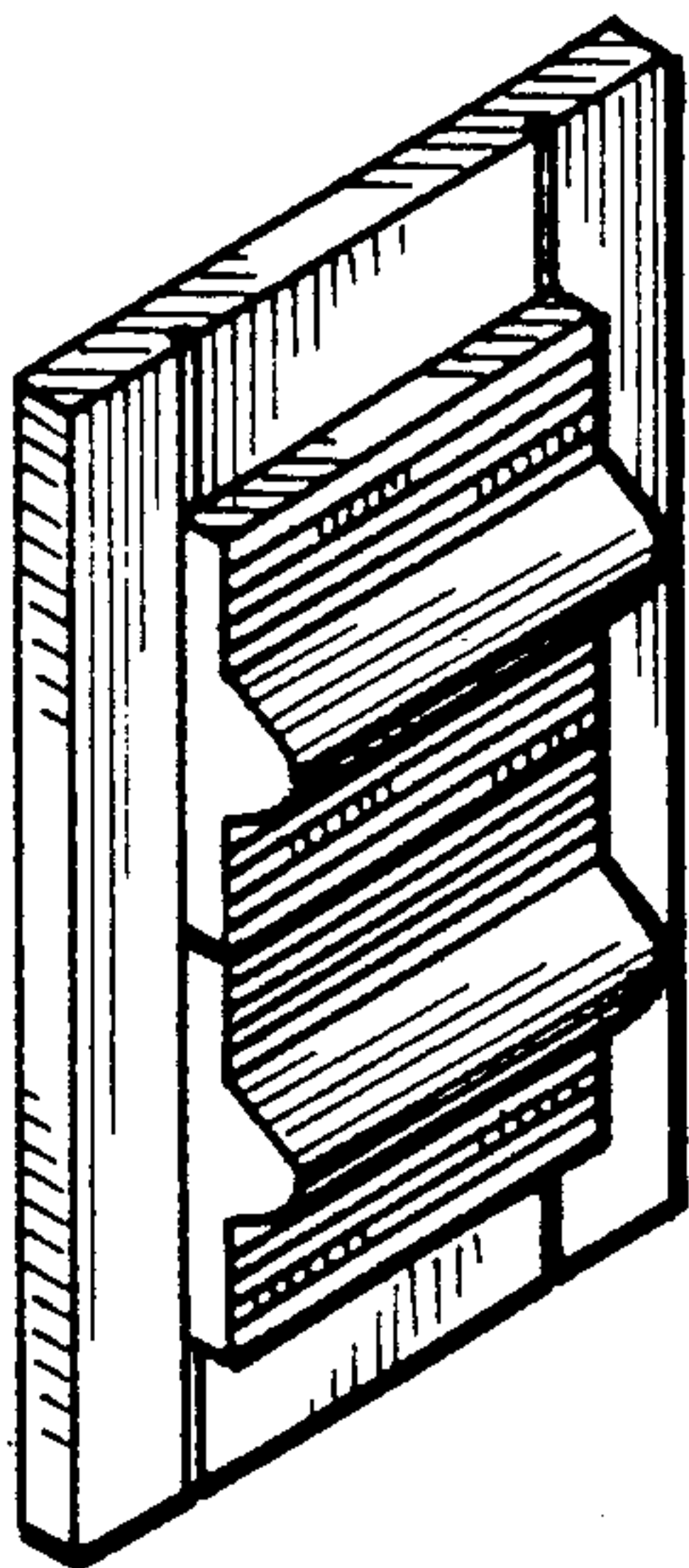

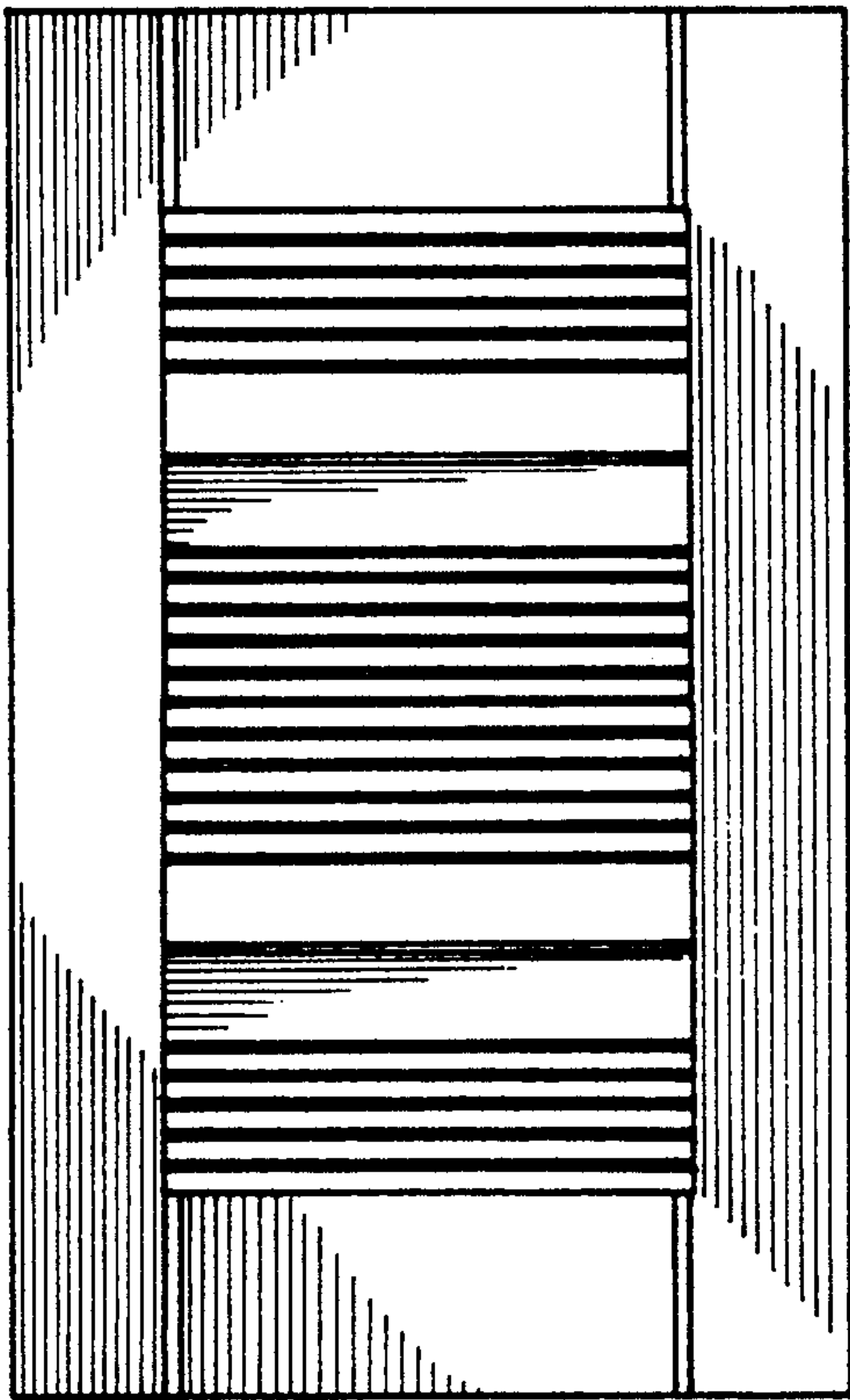

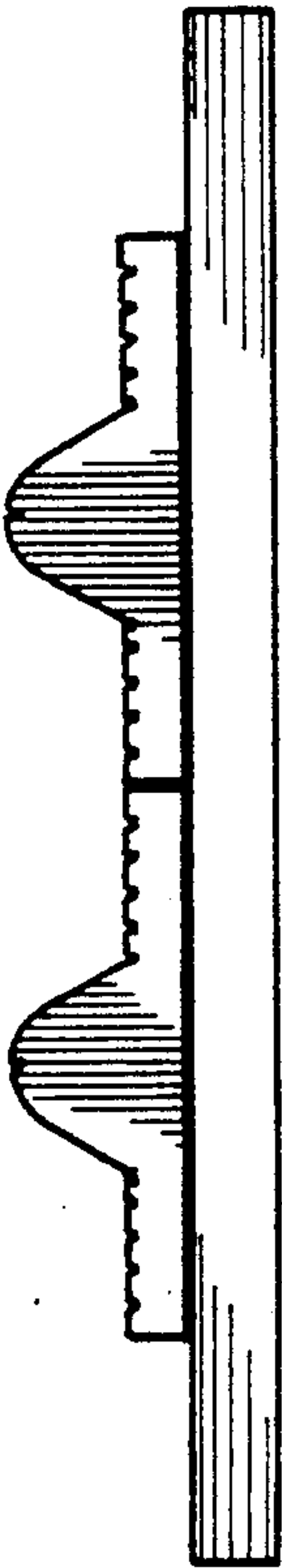

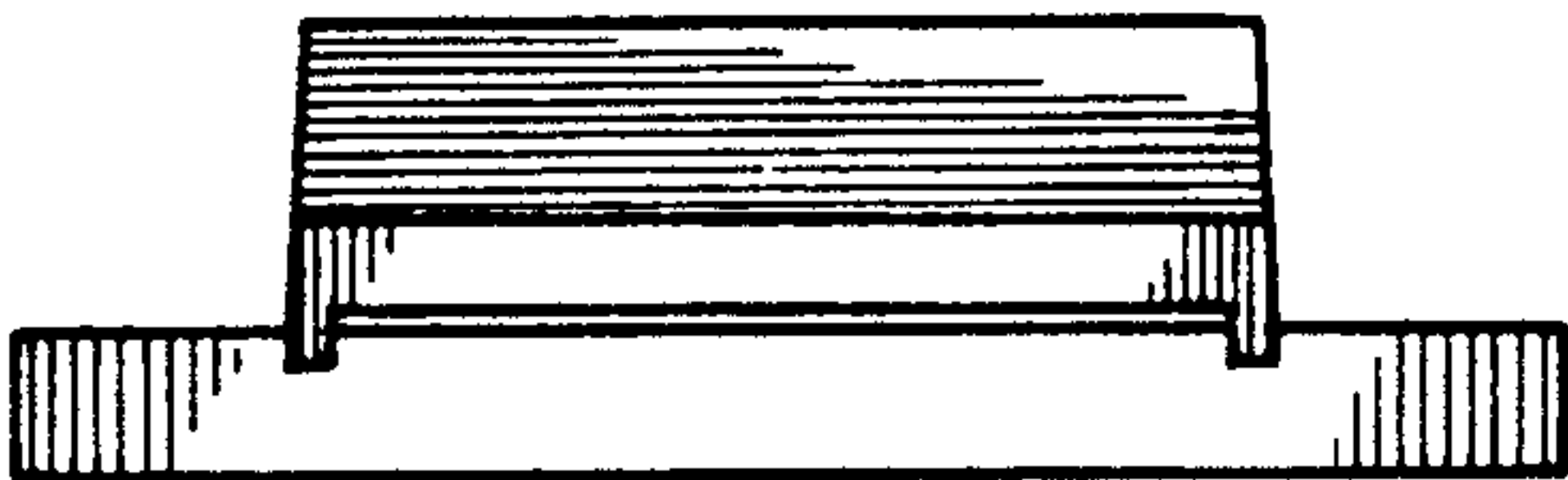
