The ornamental design for a fish hook, as shown and described.

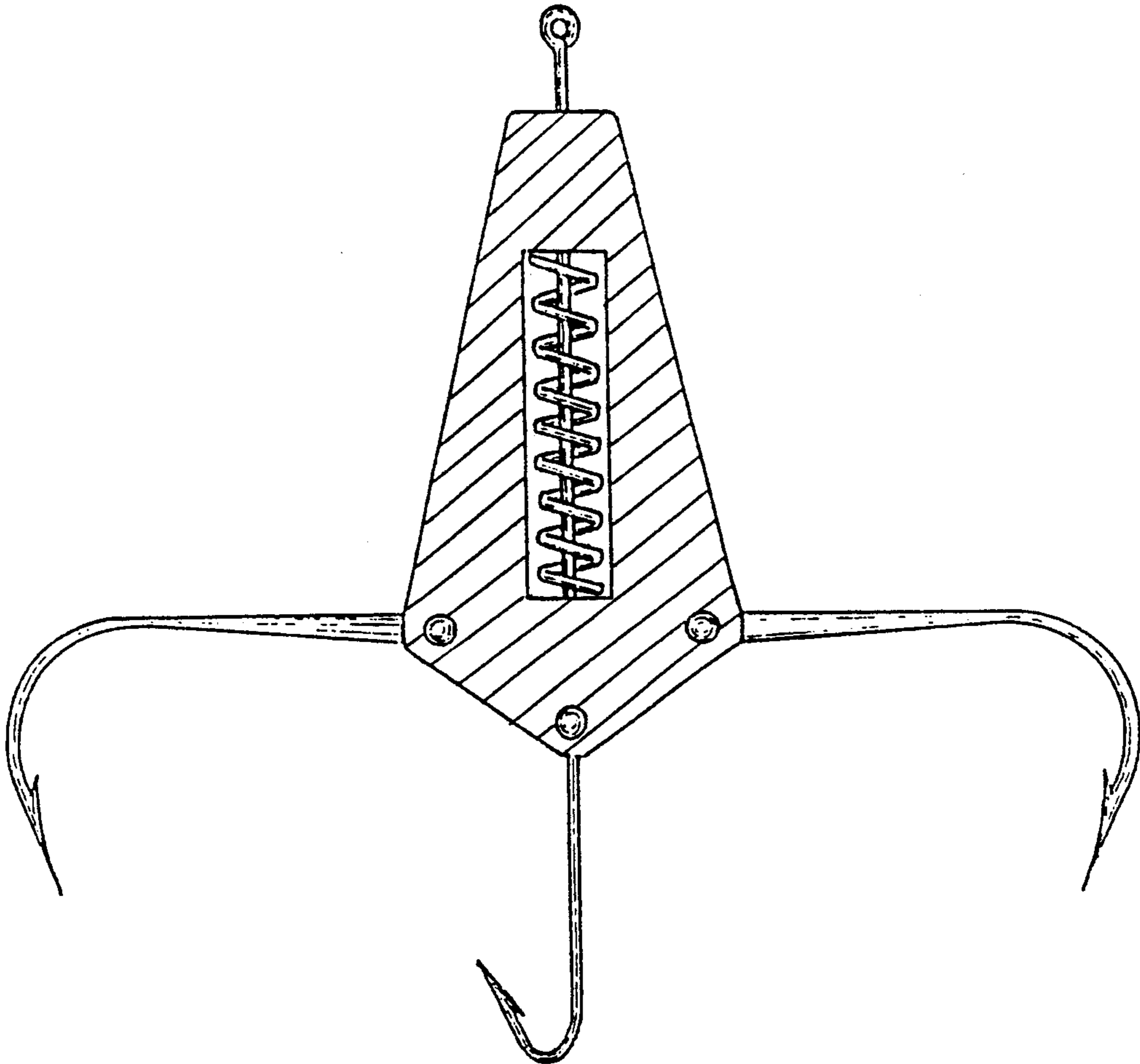

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a fish hook, showing my new design, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and
 FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof.



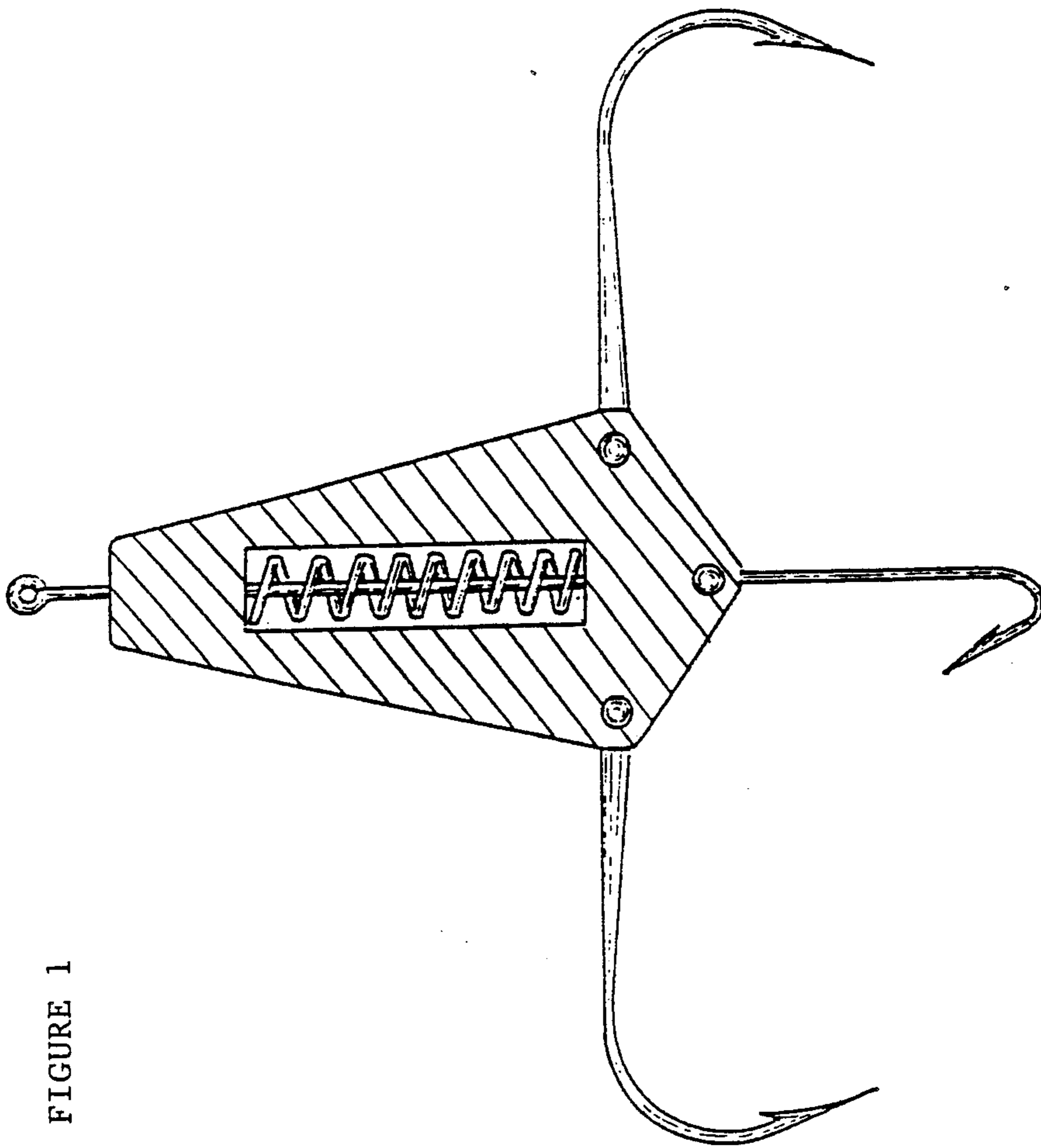

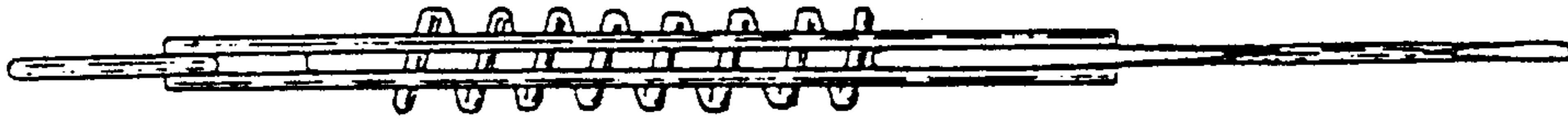
