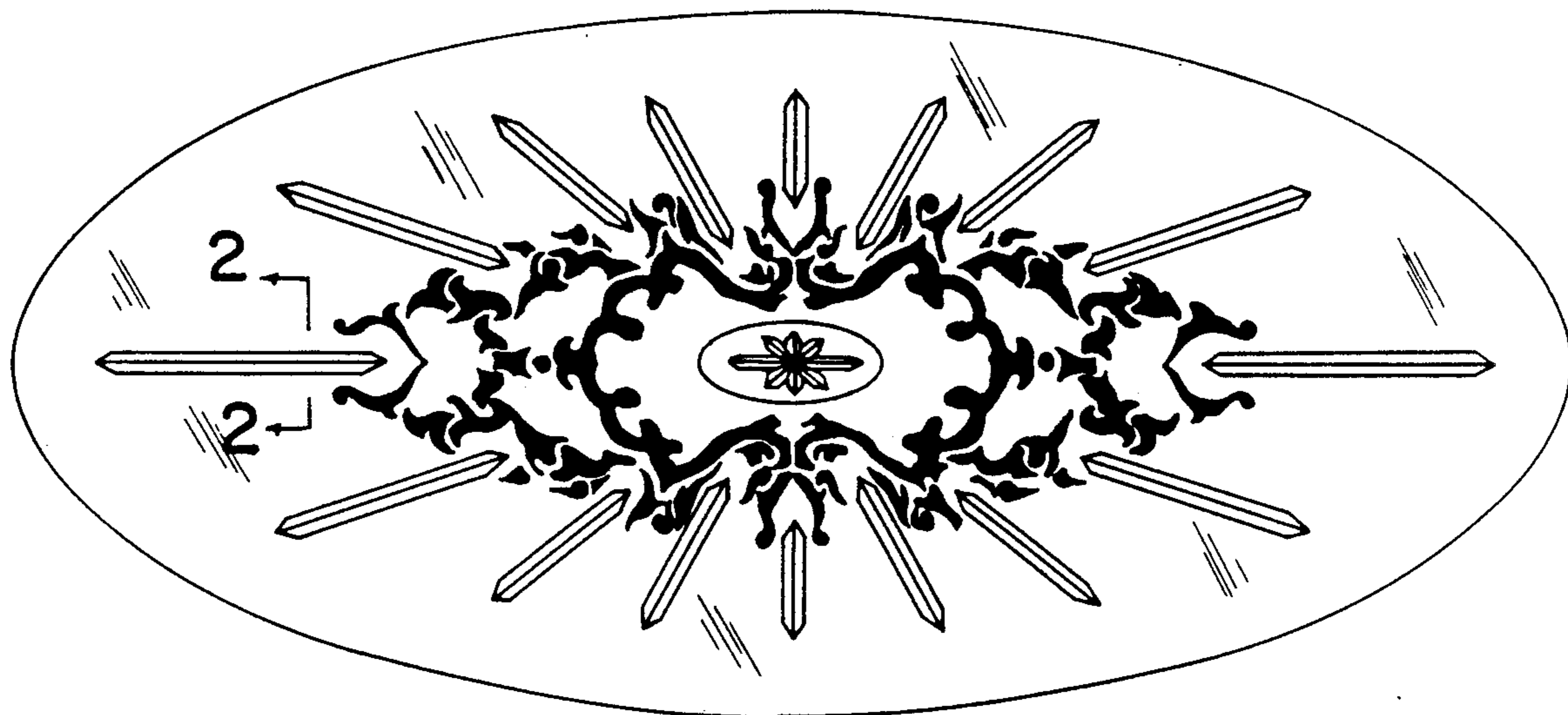
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a decorative glass panel, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a decorative glass panel showing our new design; and FIG. 2 is a cross sectional view taken along line 2—2 of FIG. 1.

The glass panel is transparent, and the appearance of the rear is essentially the same as the appearance of the front.



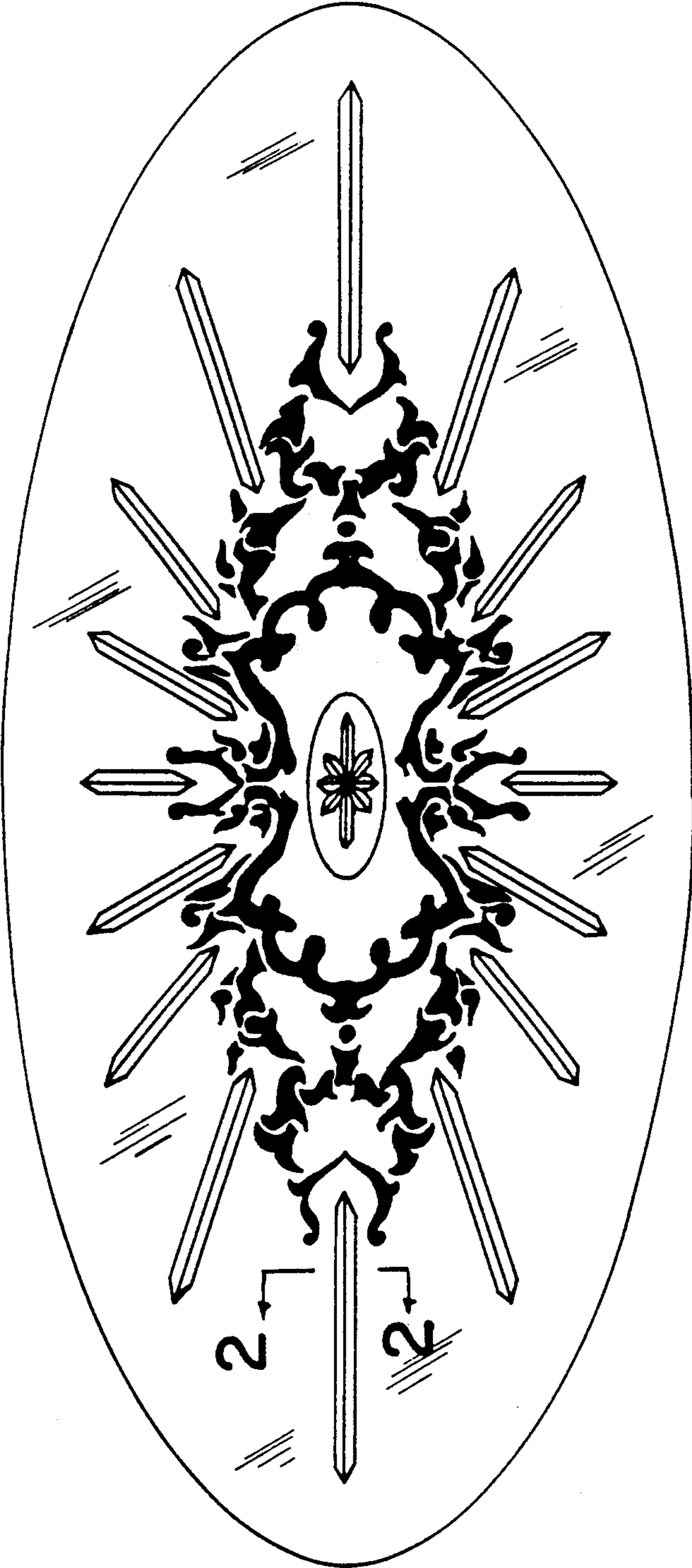

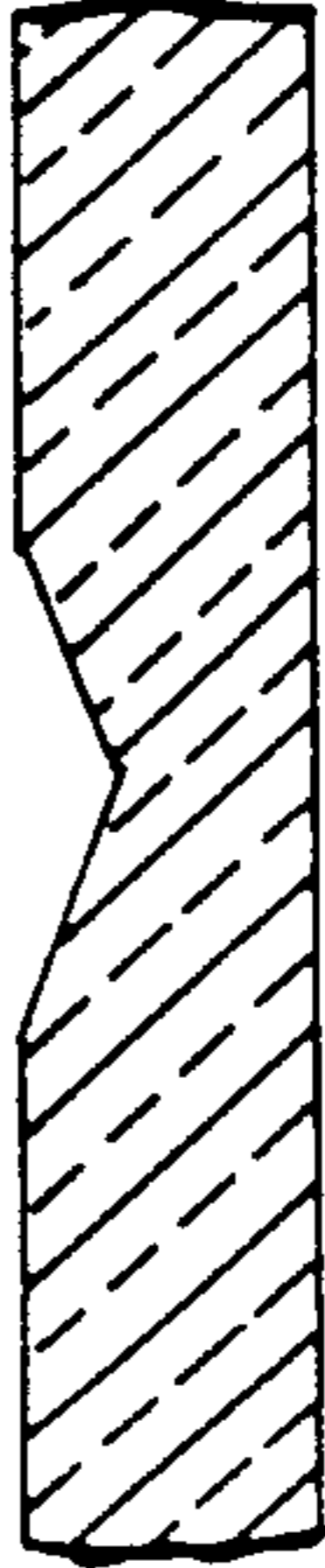
