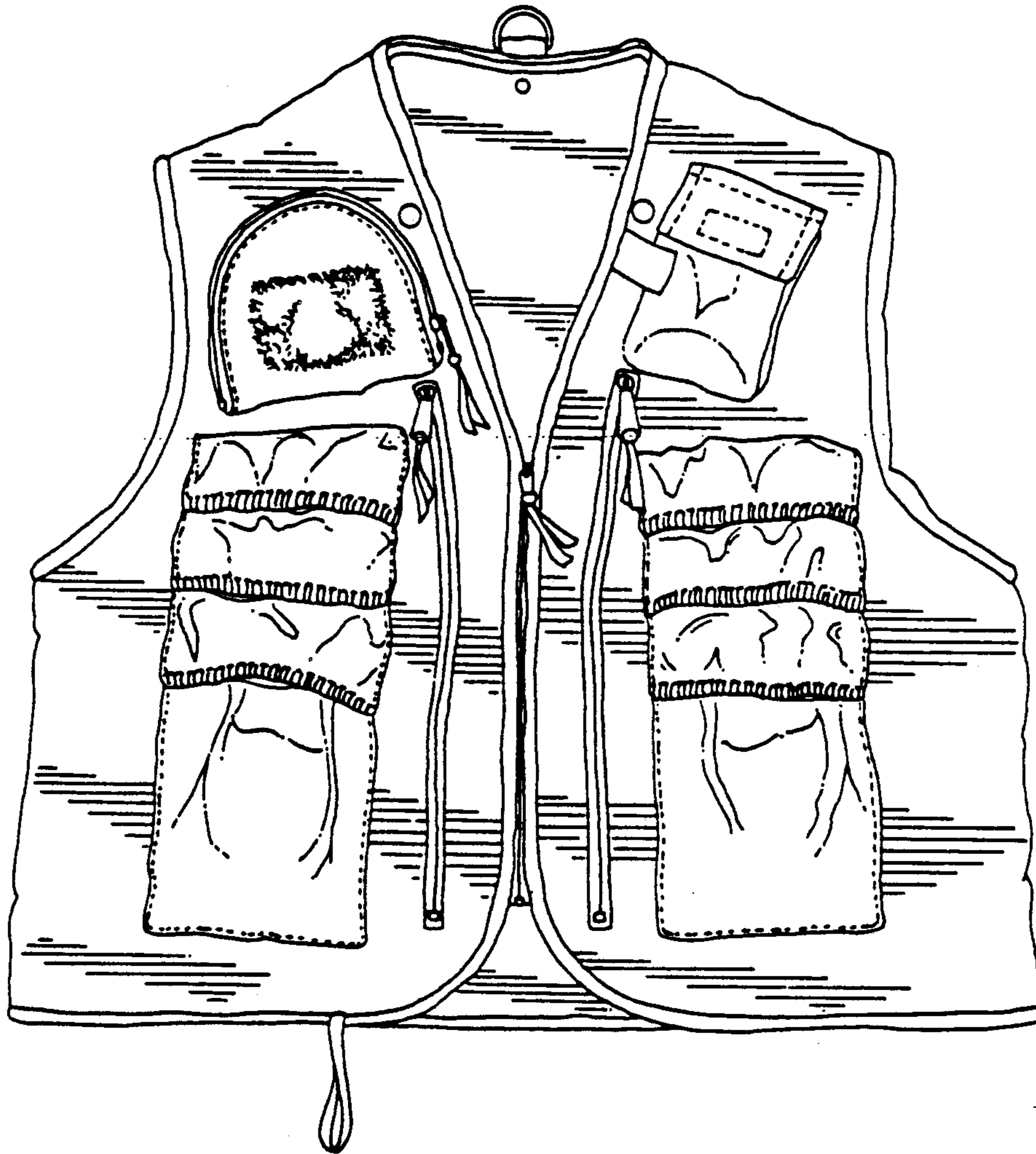
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined fishing vest and liner, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined fishing vest and liner showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the liner; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 3; and FIG. 5 is an inside elevational view of FIG. 1; the liner being removed.

The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1, 3, and 5 represent conventional stitching.



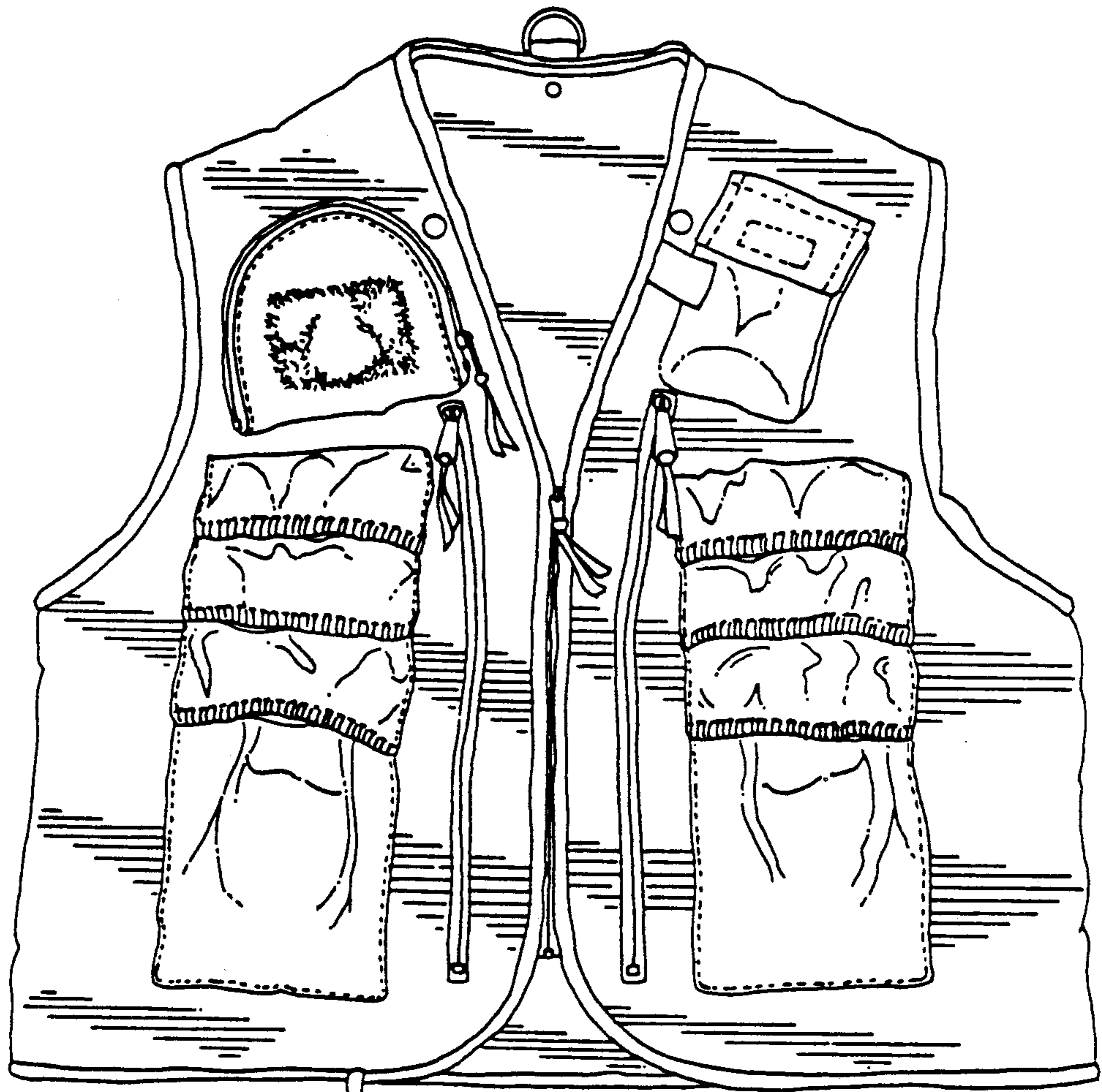

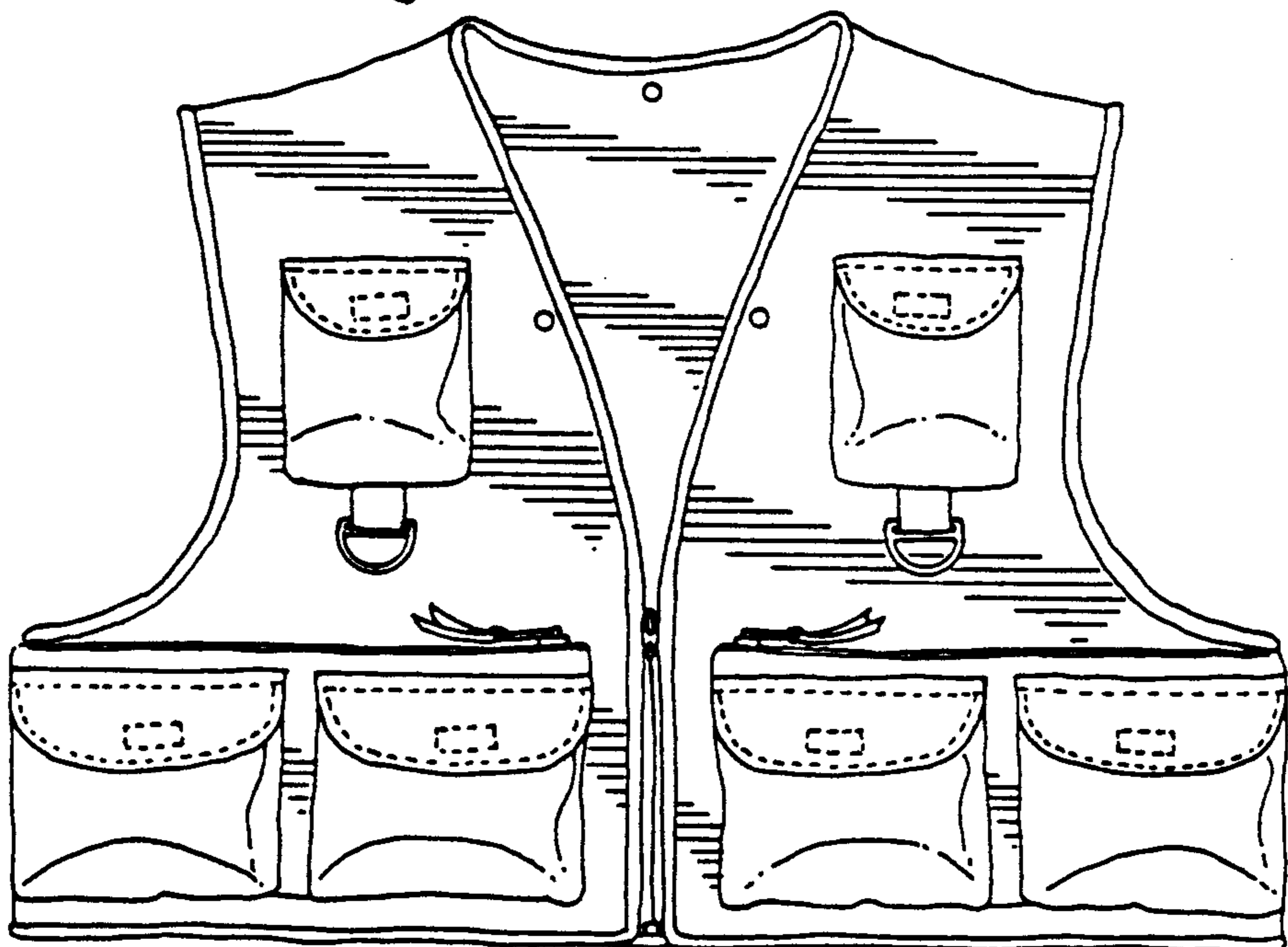
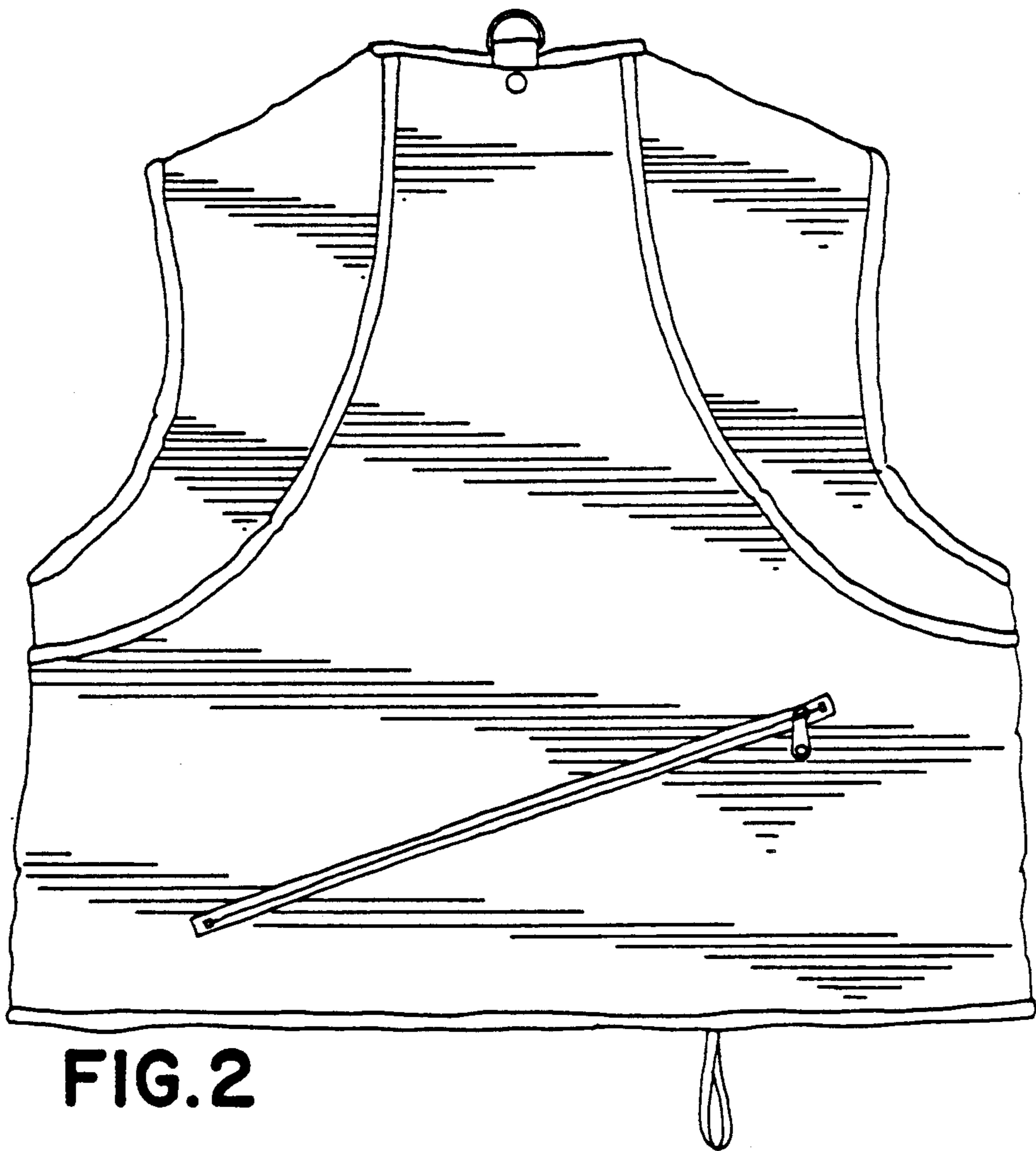
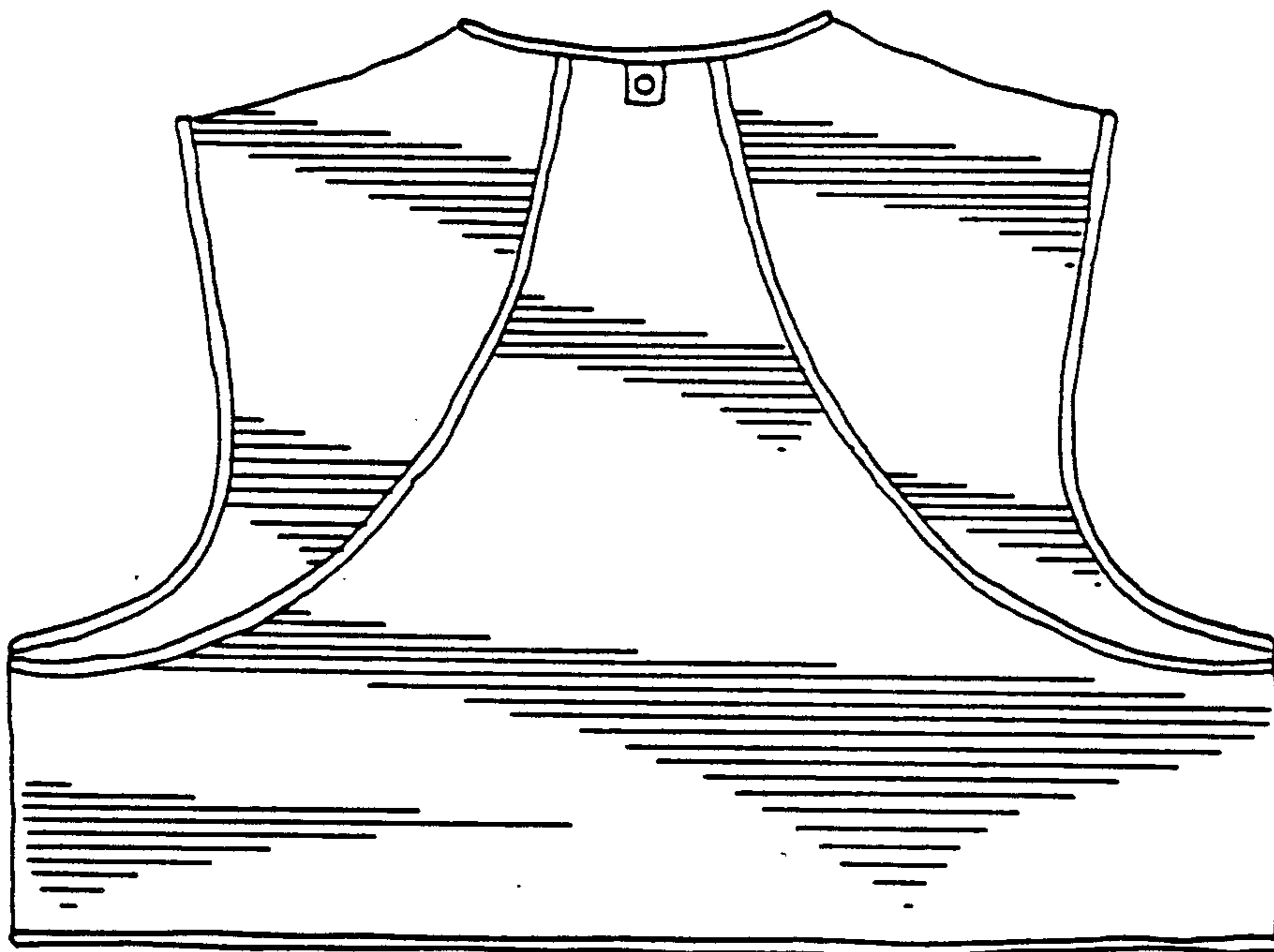

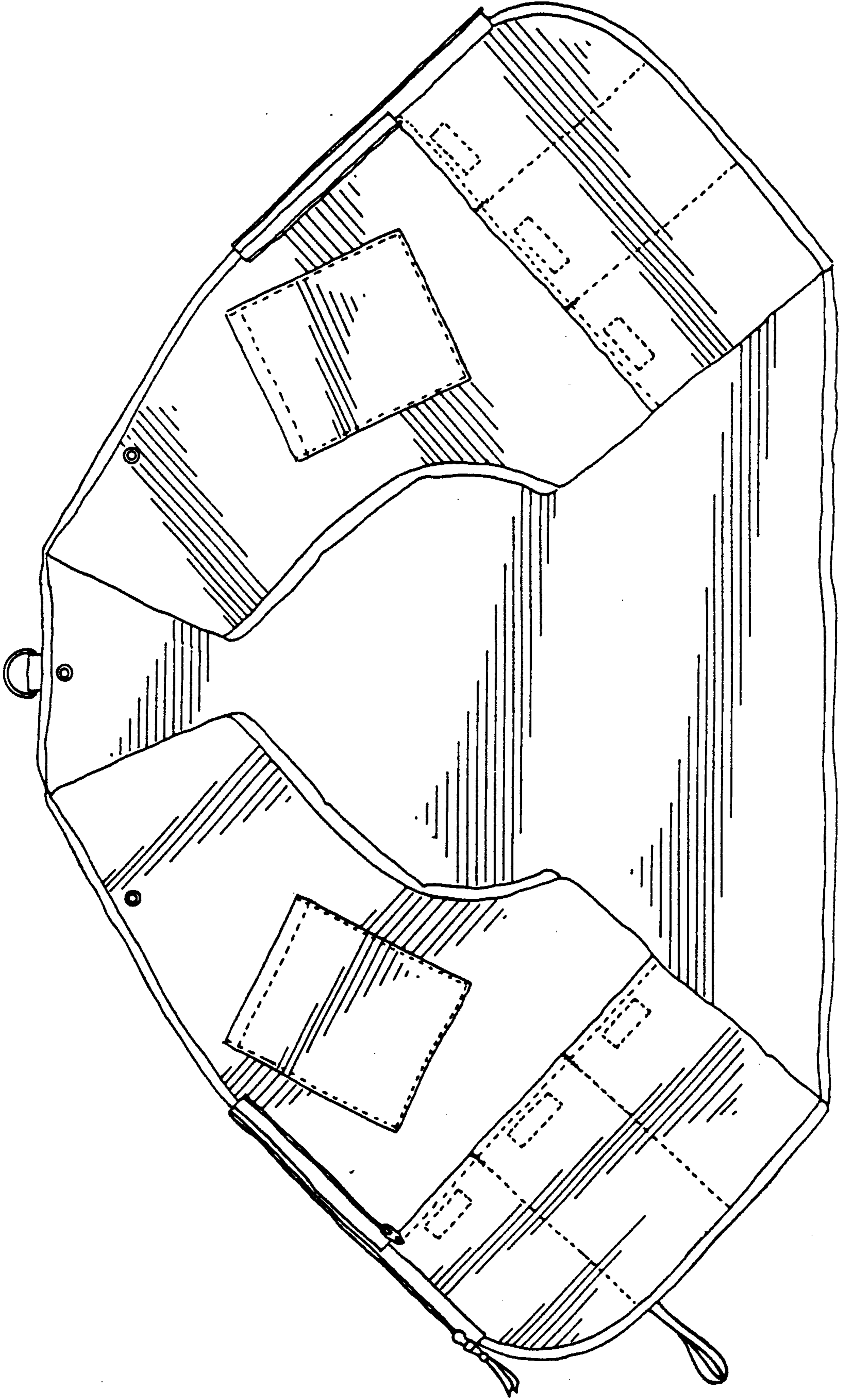
