**DESCRIPTION**

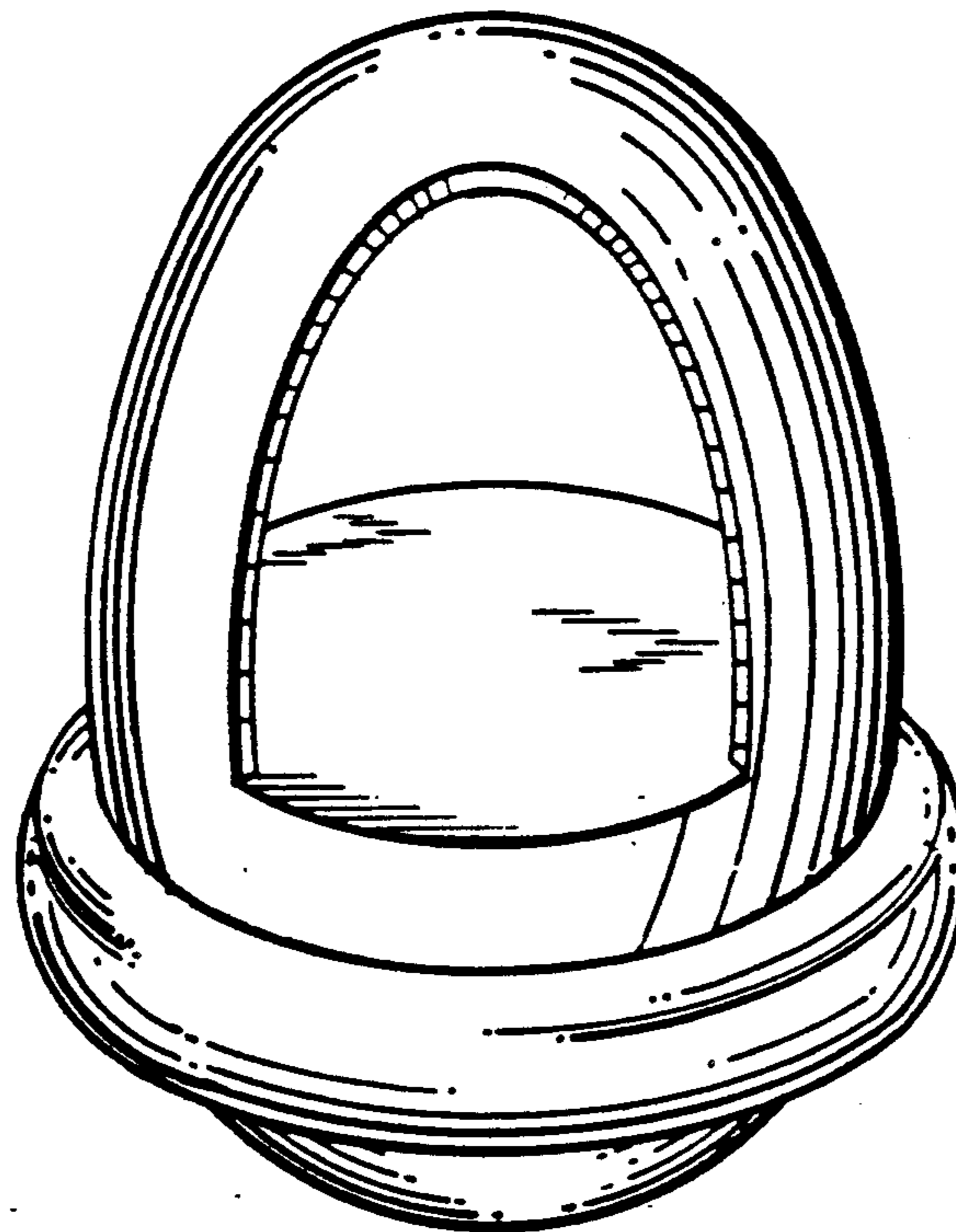

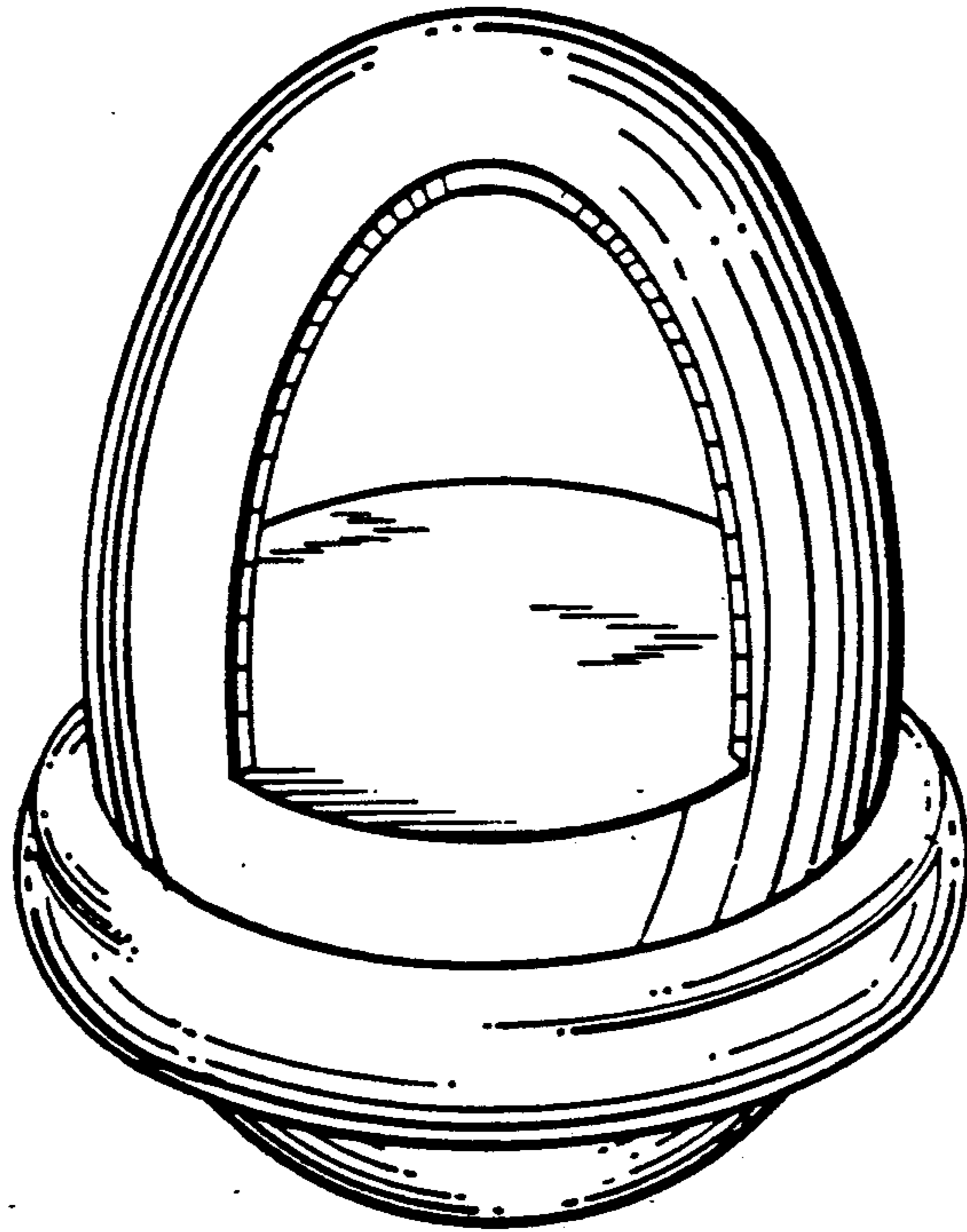

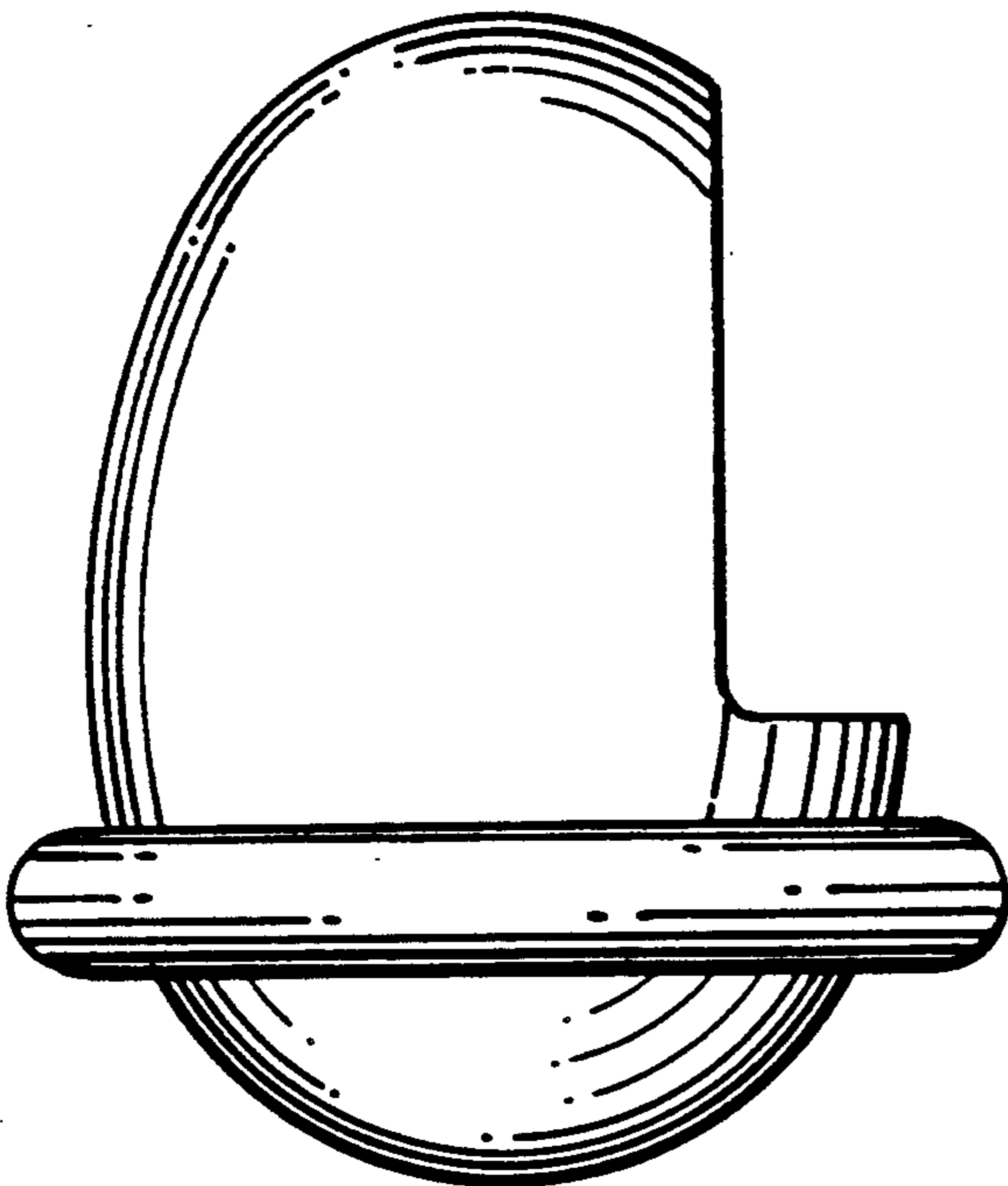
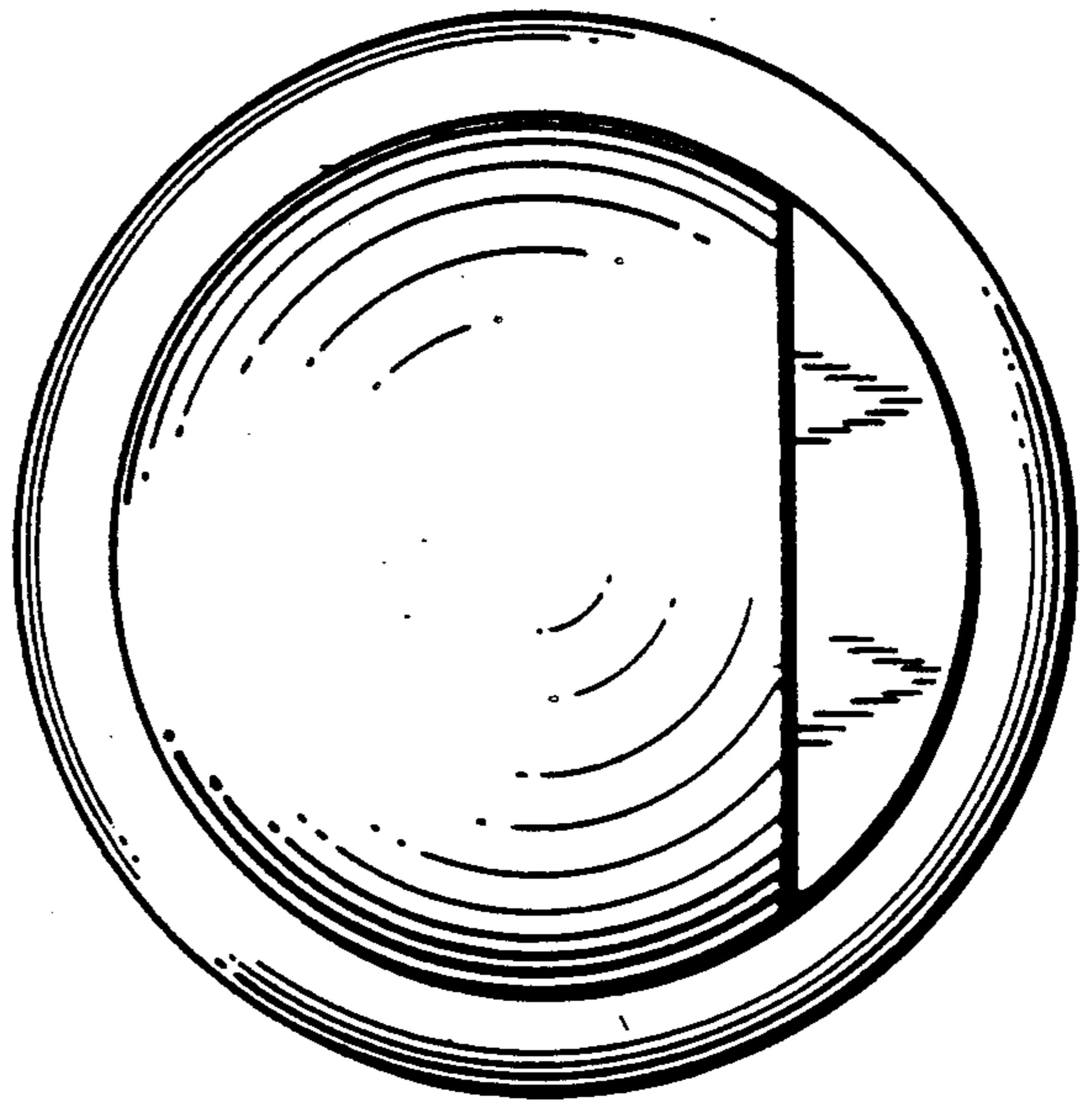

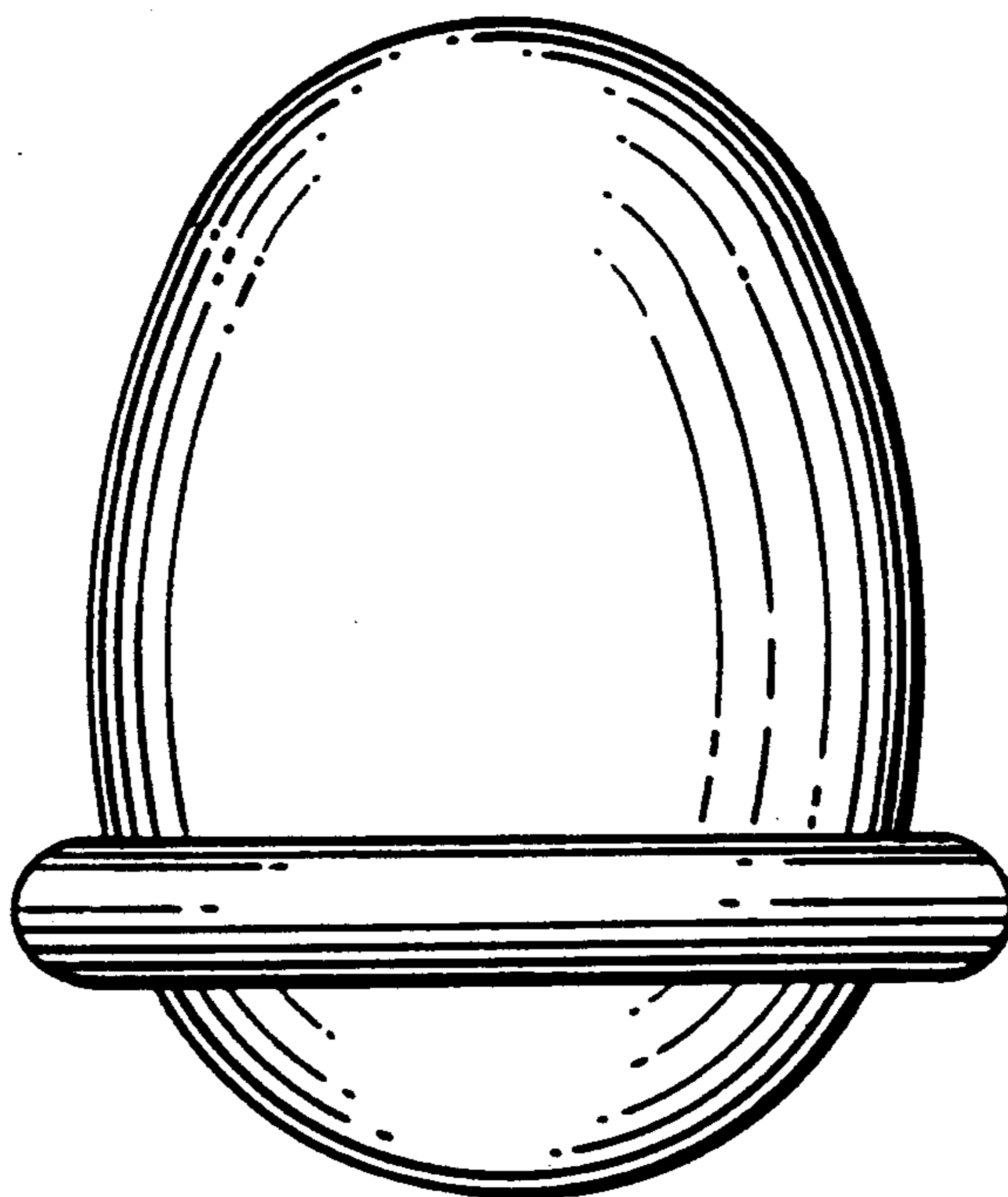

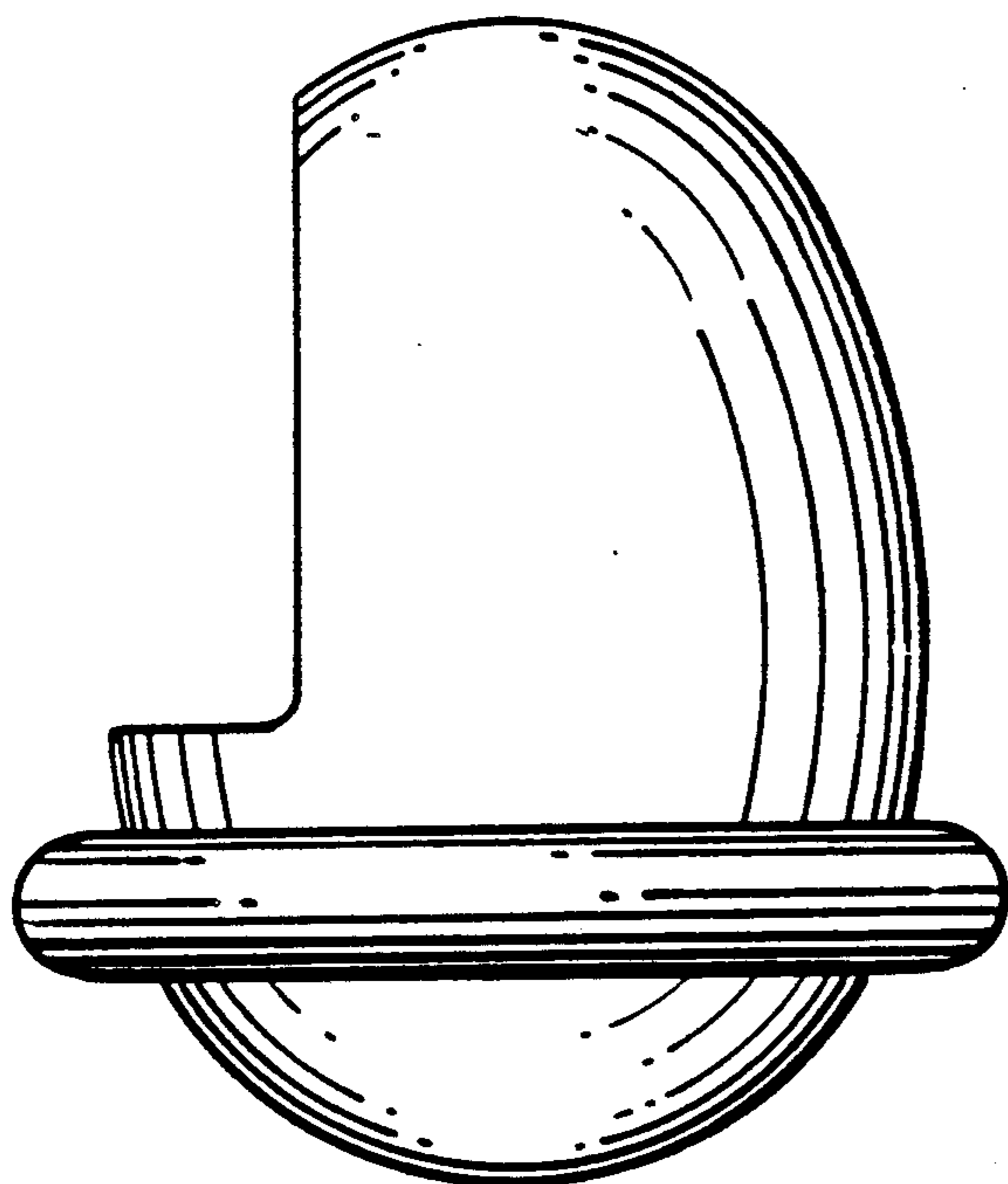
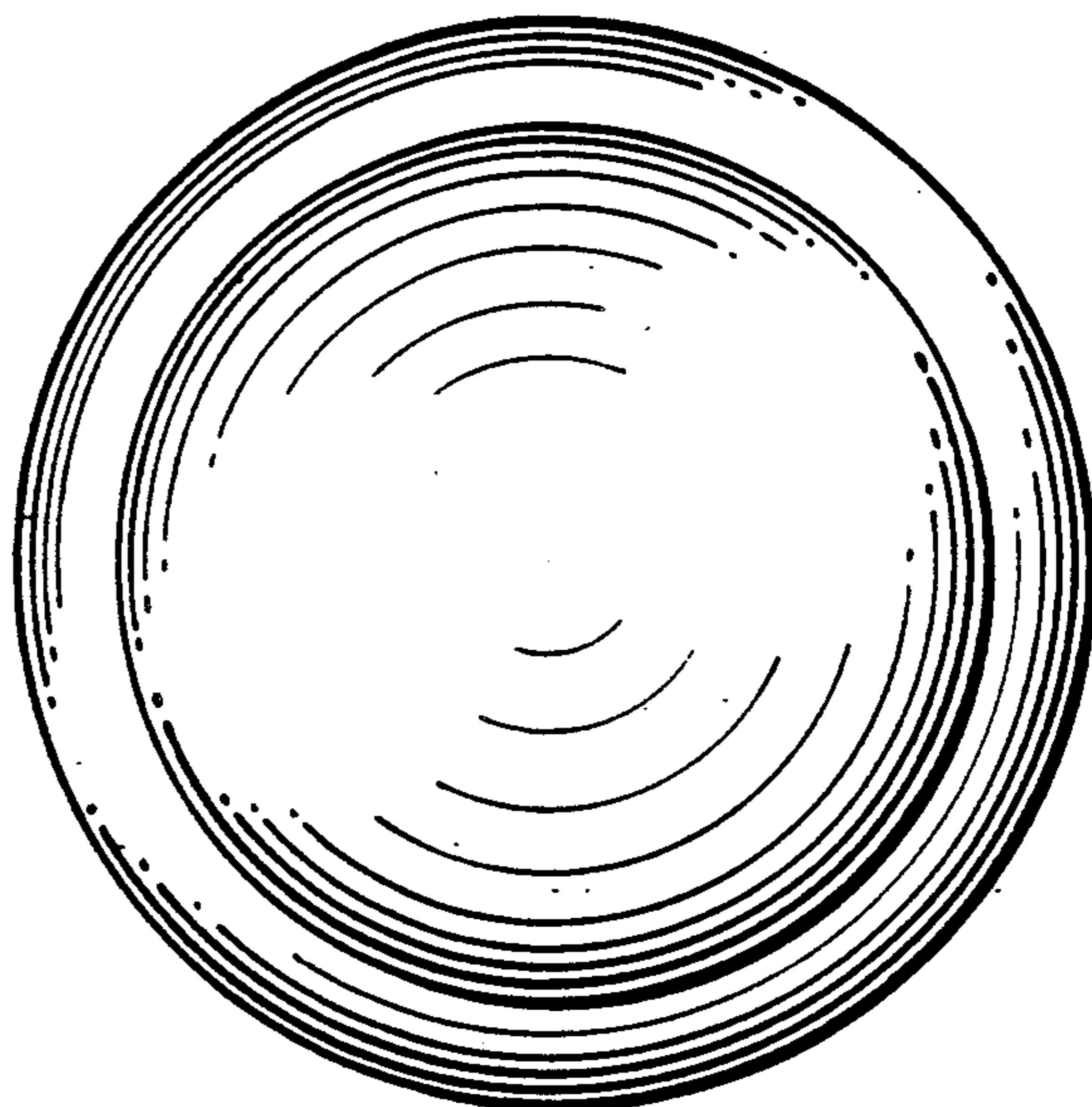
