FIG. 6 is a side elevation view thereof.

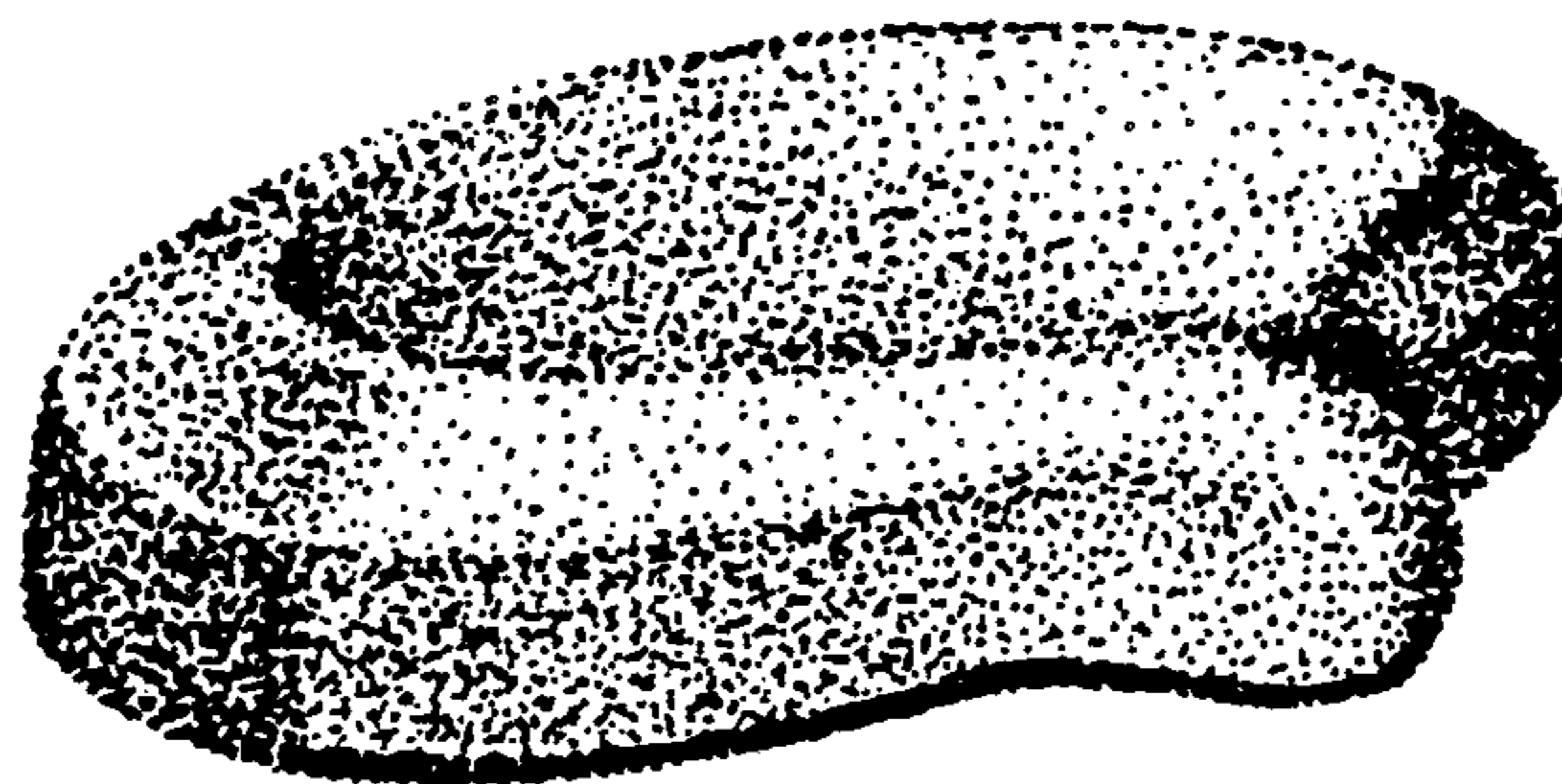

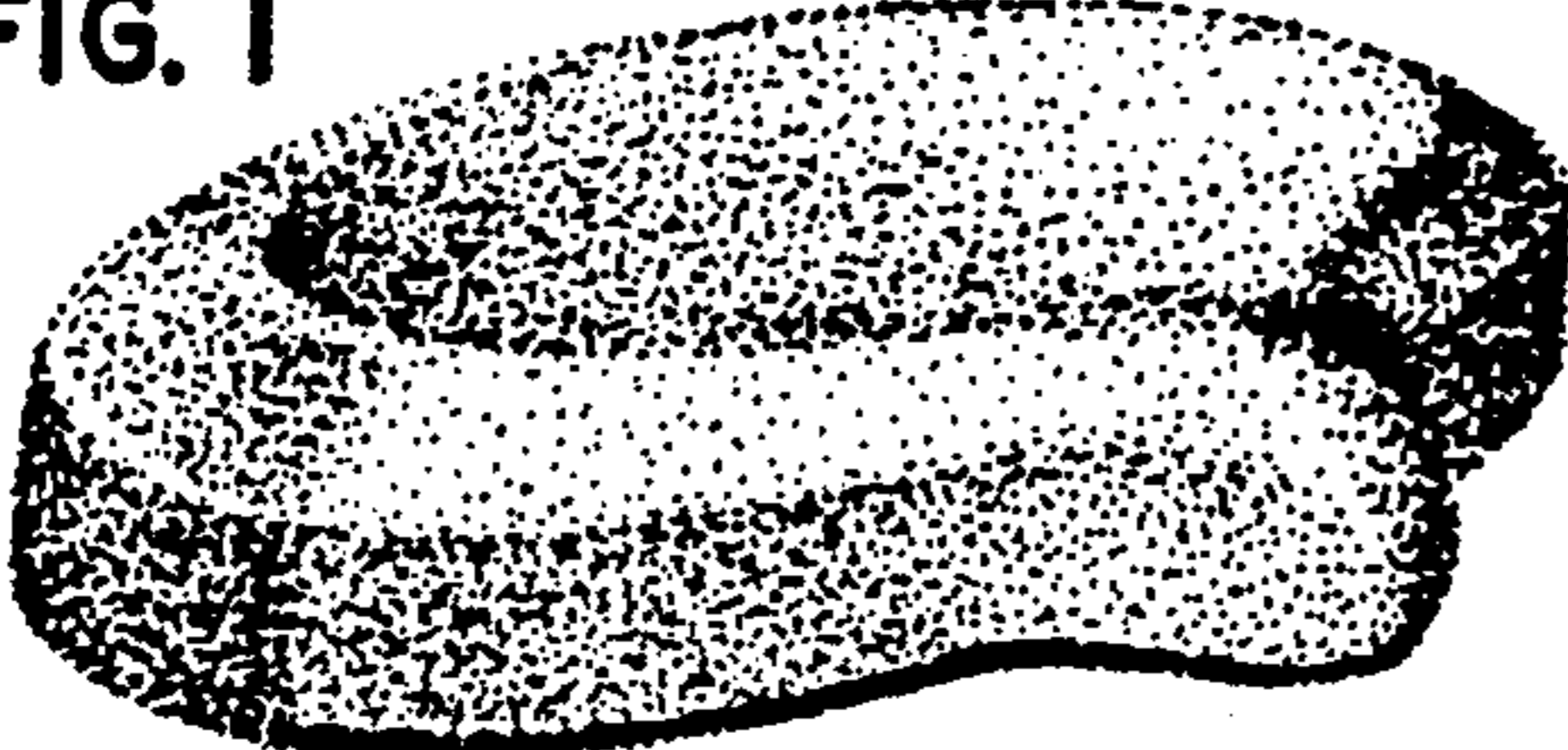

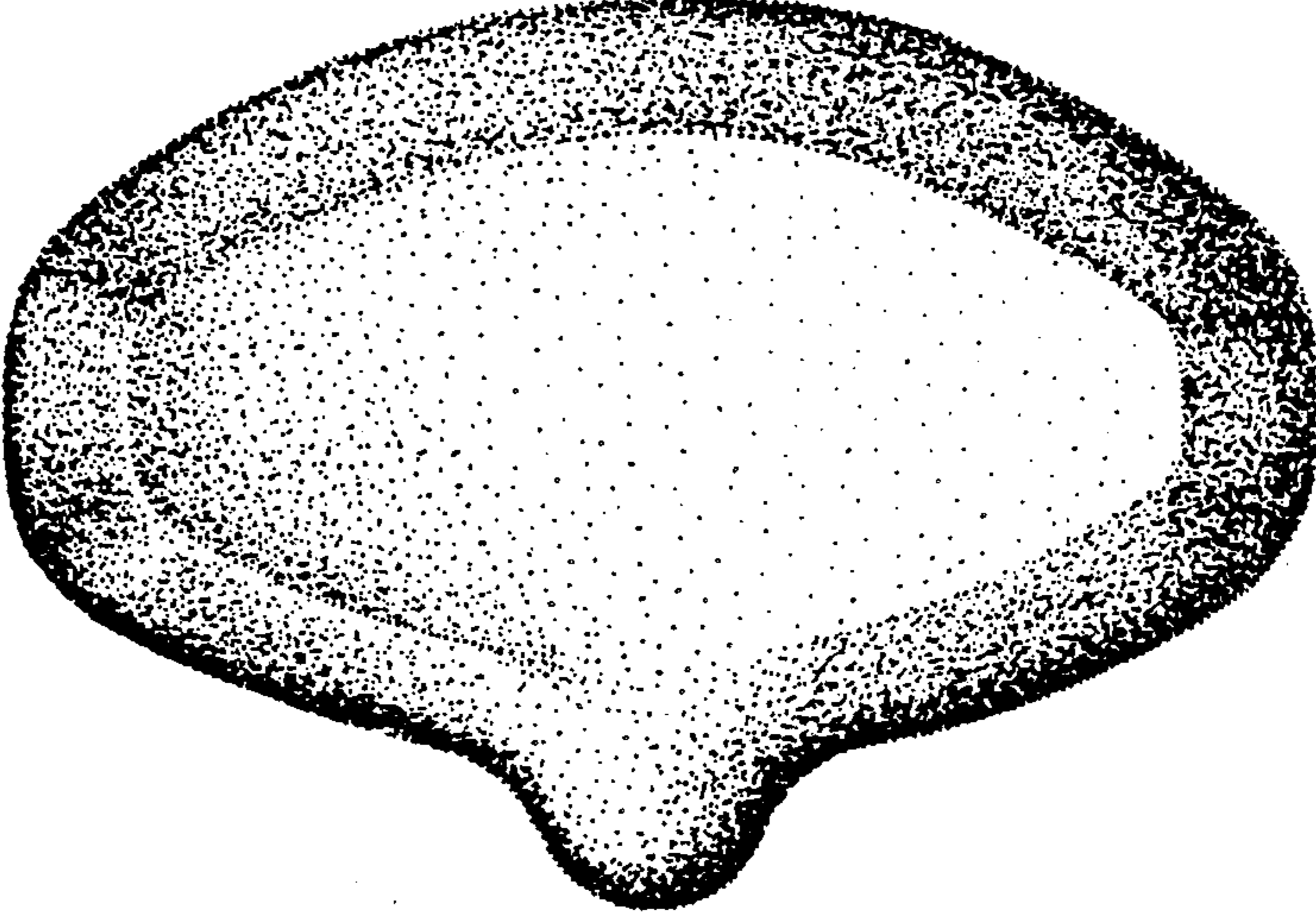

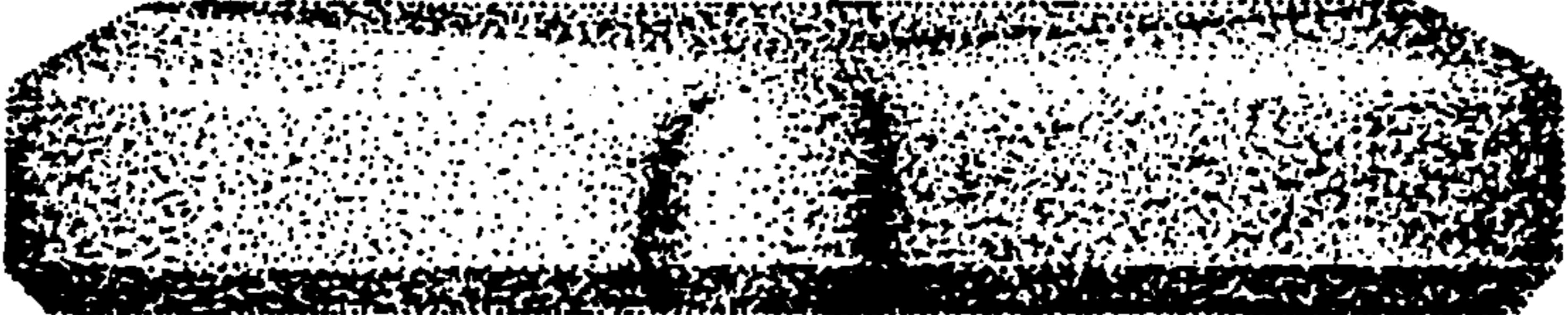

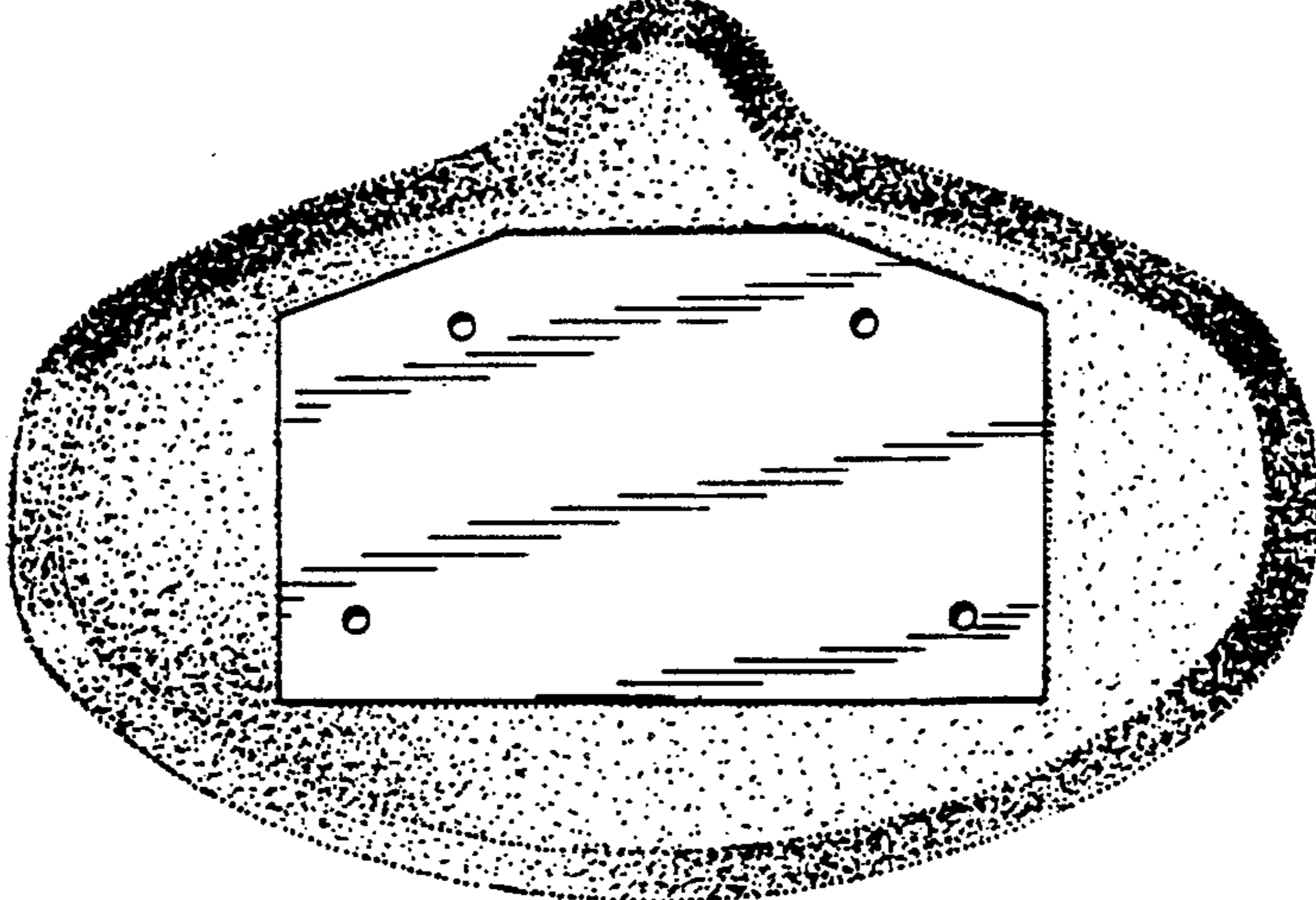
