DESCRIPTION

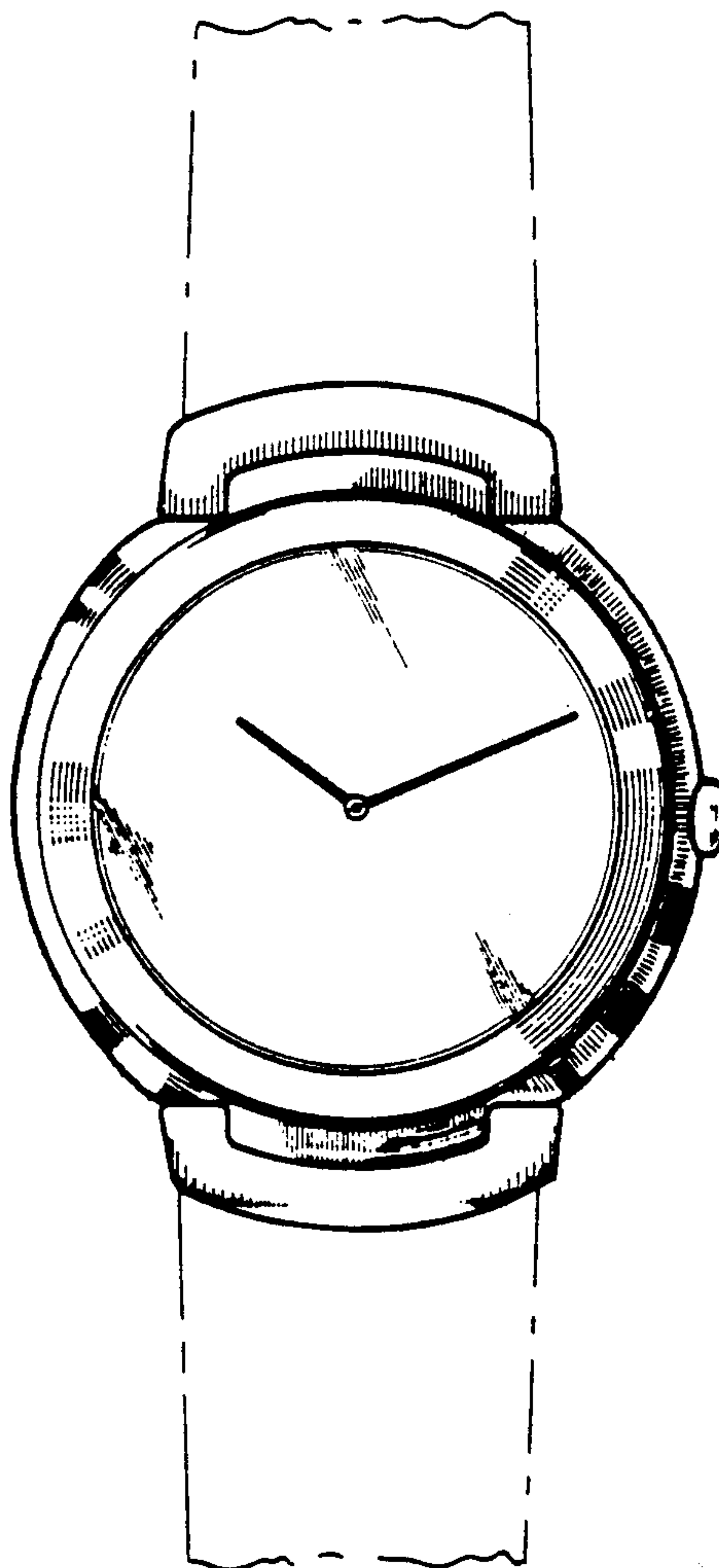
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a watch showing

not form part of the claimed design.



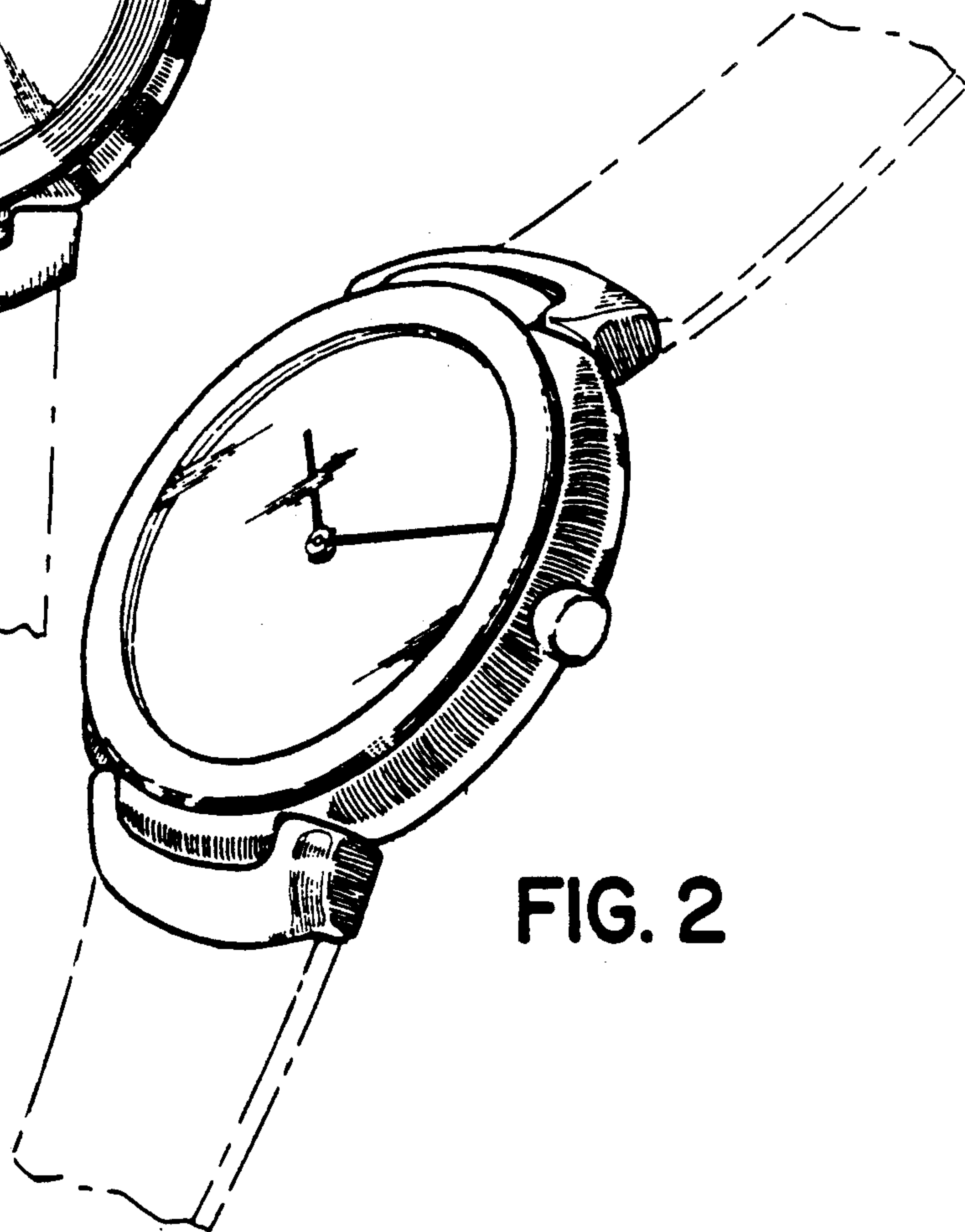
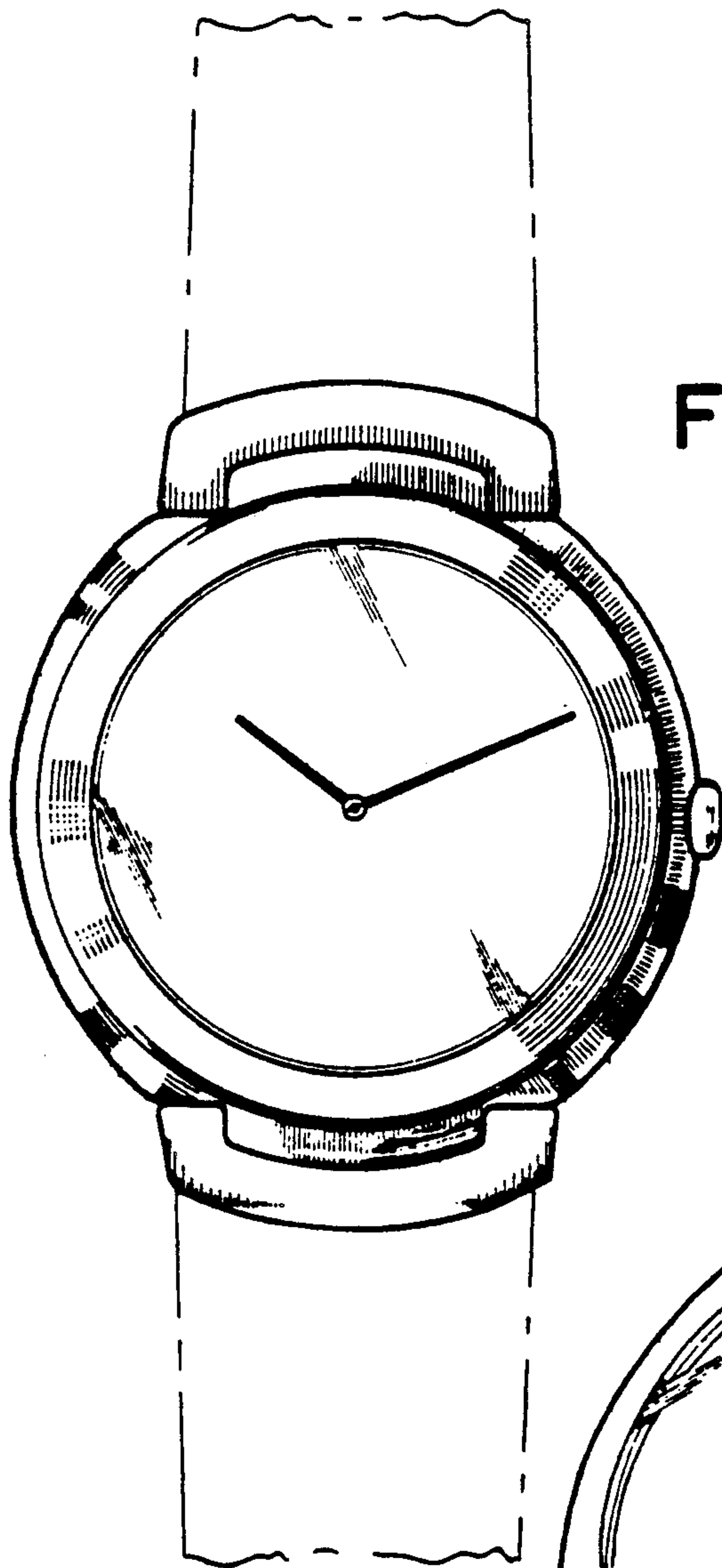

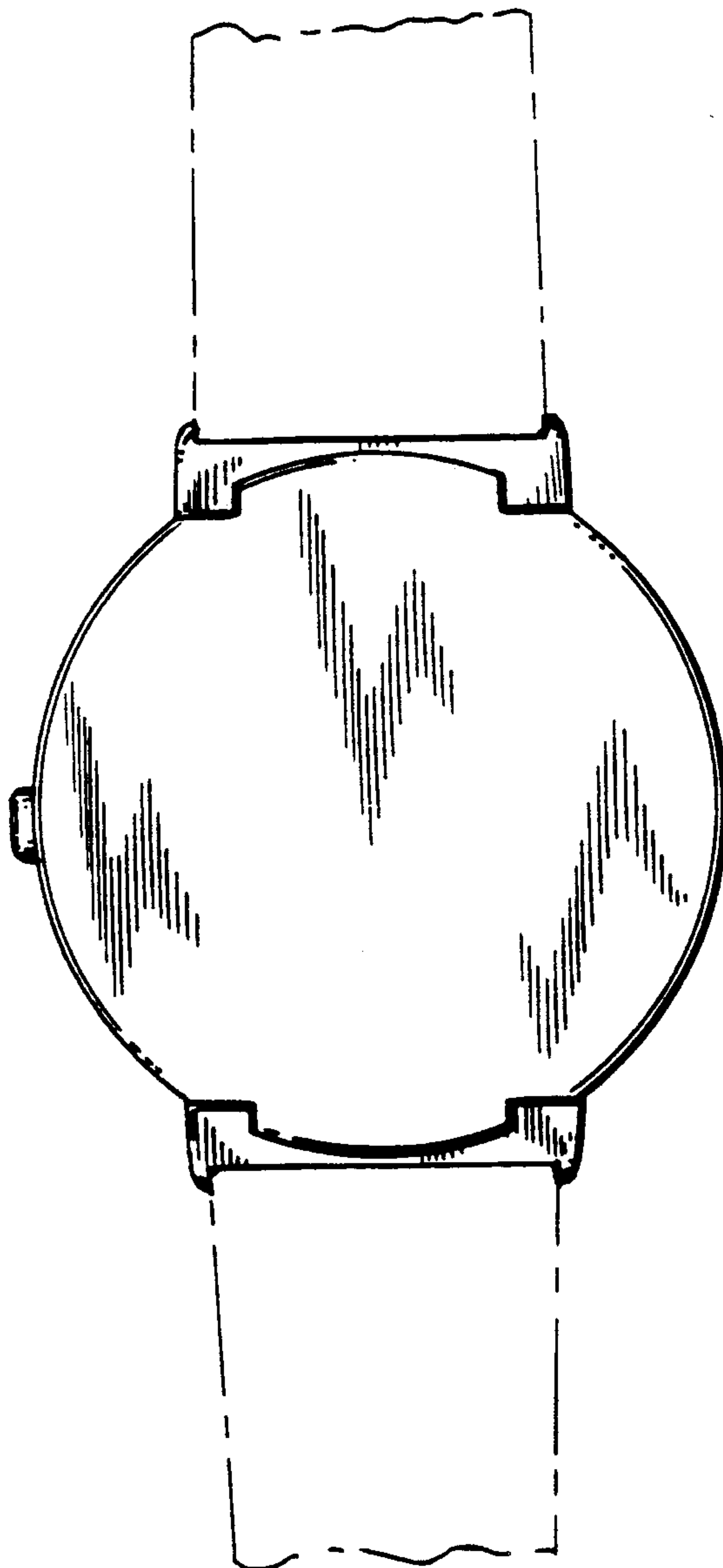
