

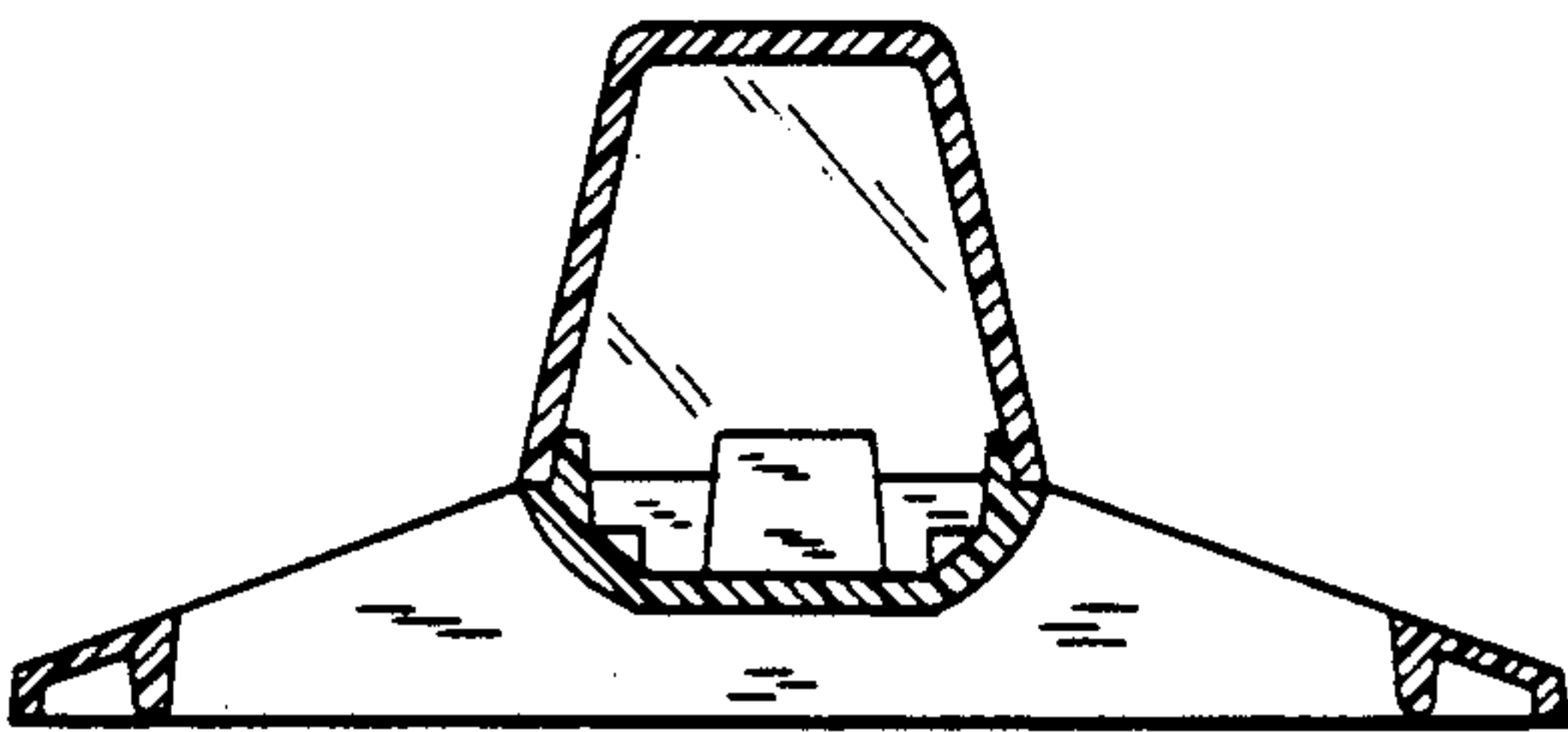
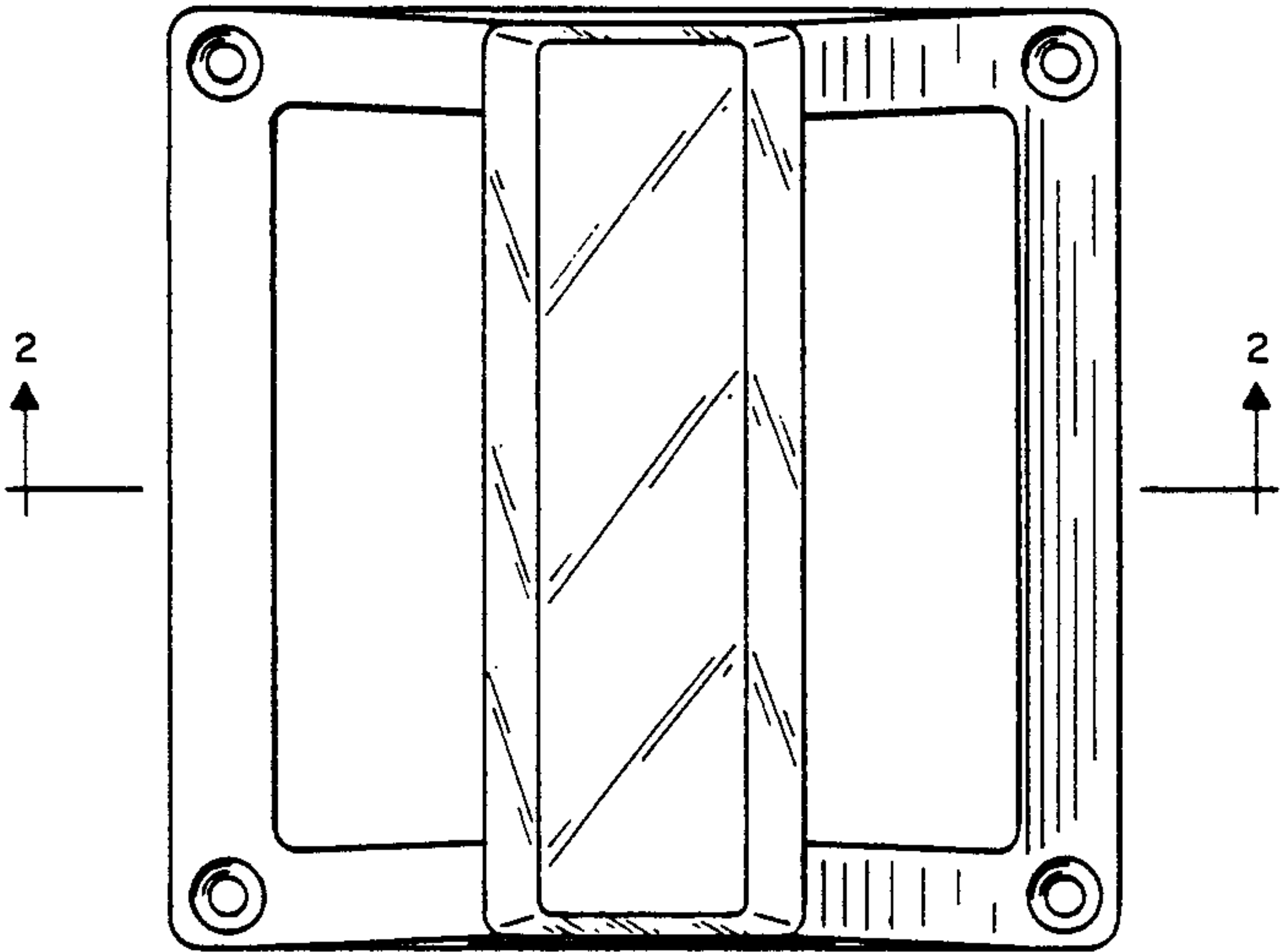

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a strobe showing
our new design;
FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken along
line 2—2 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being a
mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite
side being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



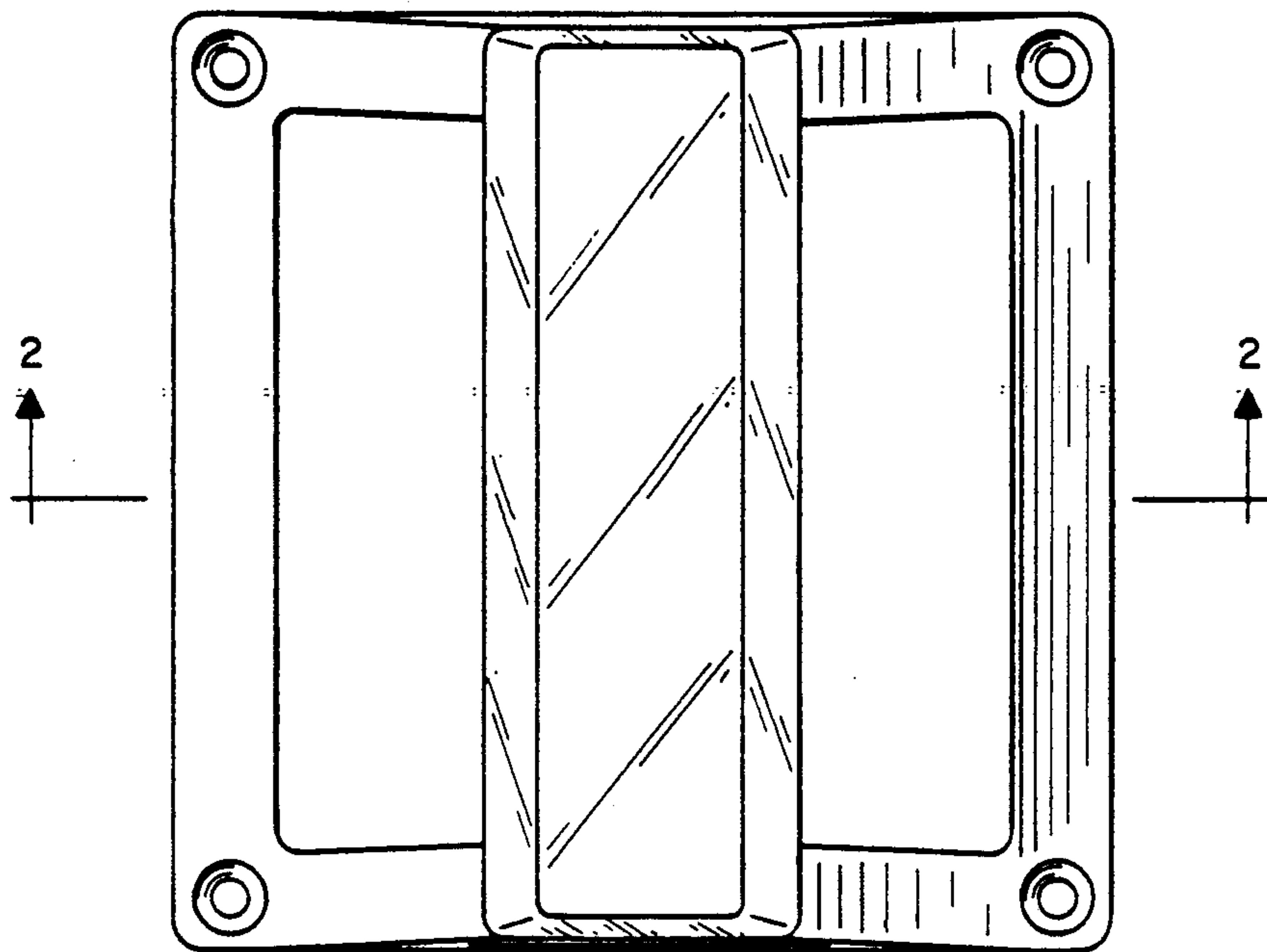

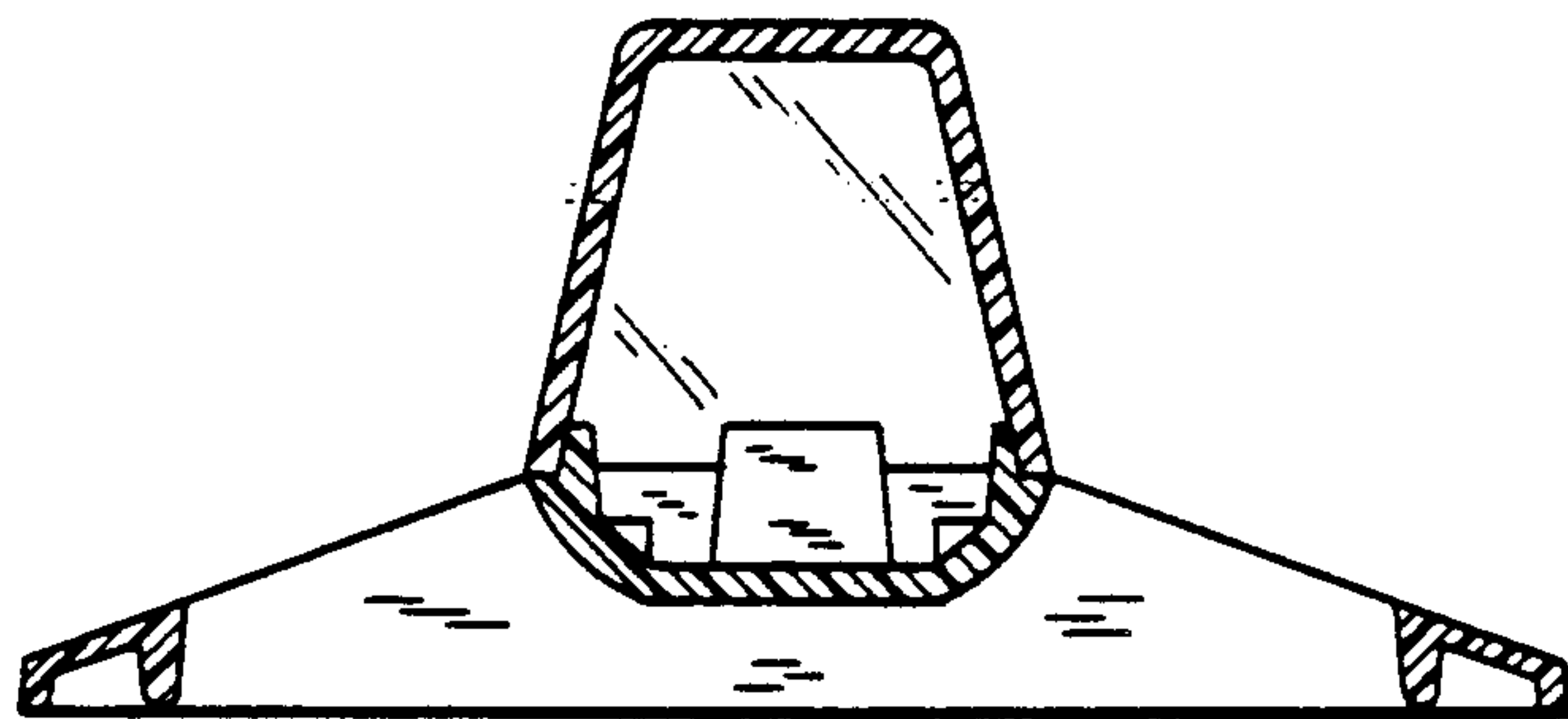

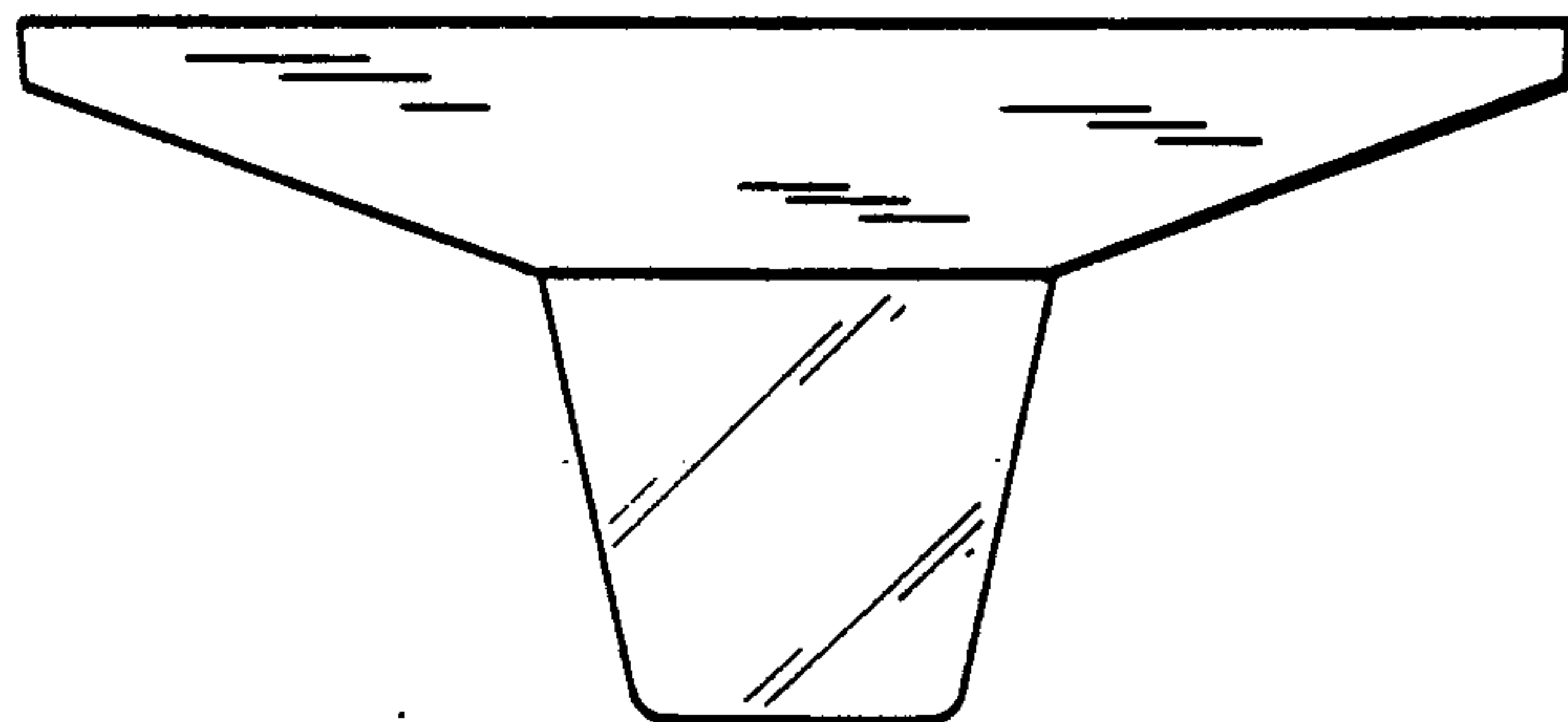

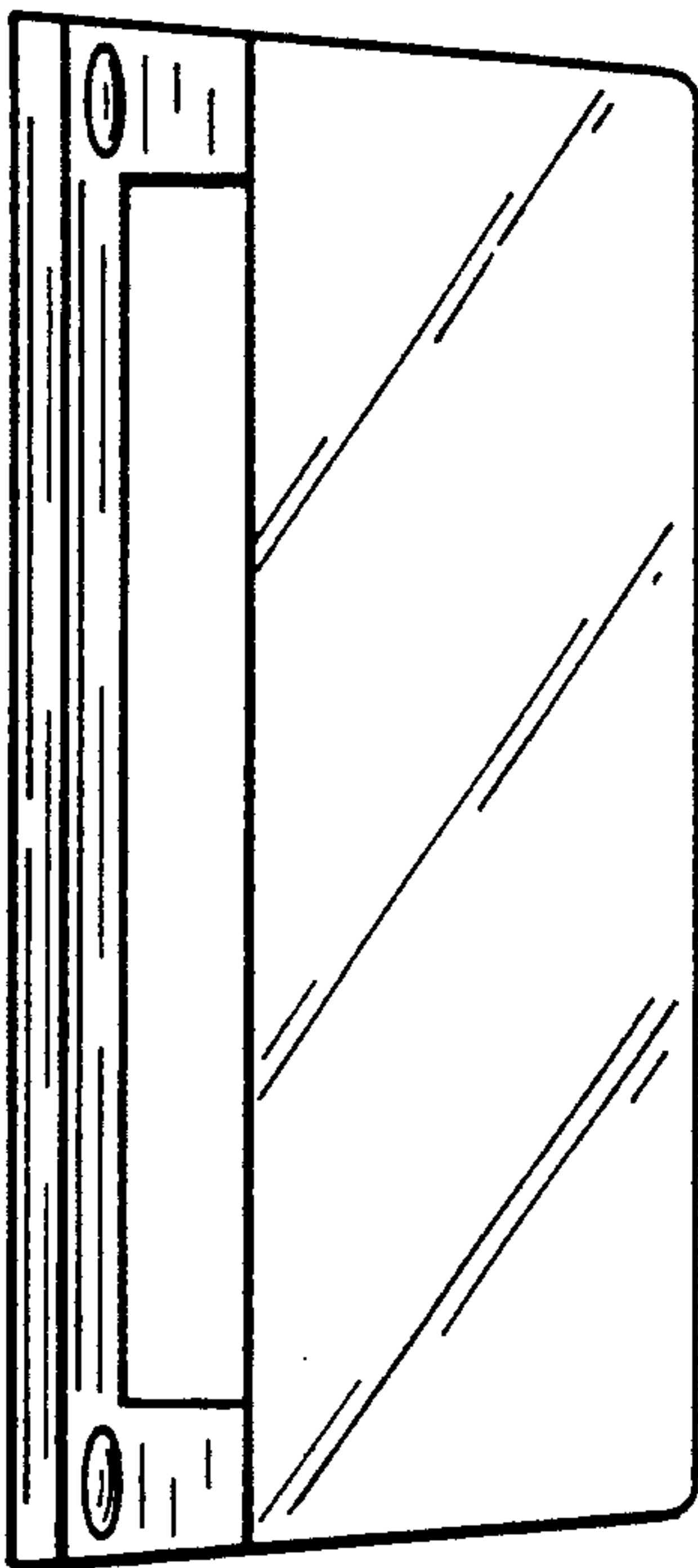

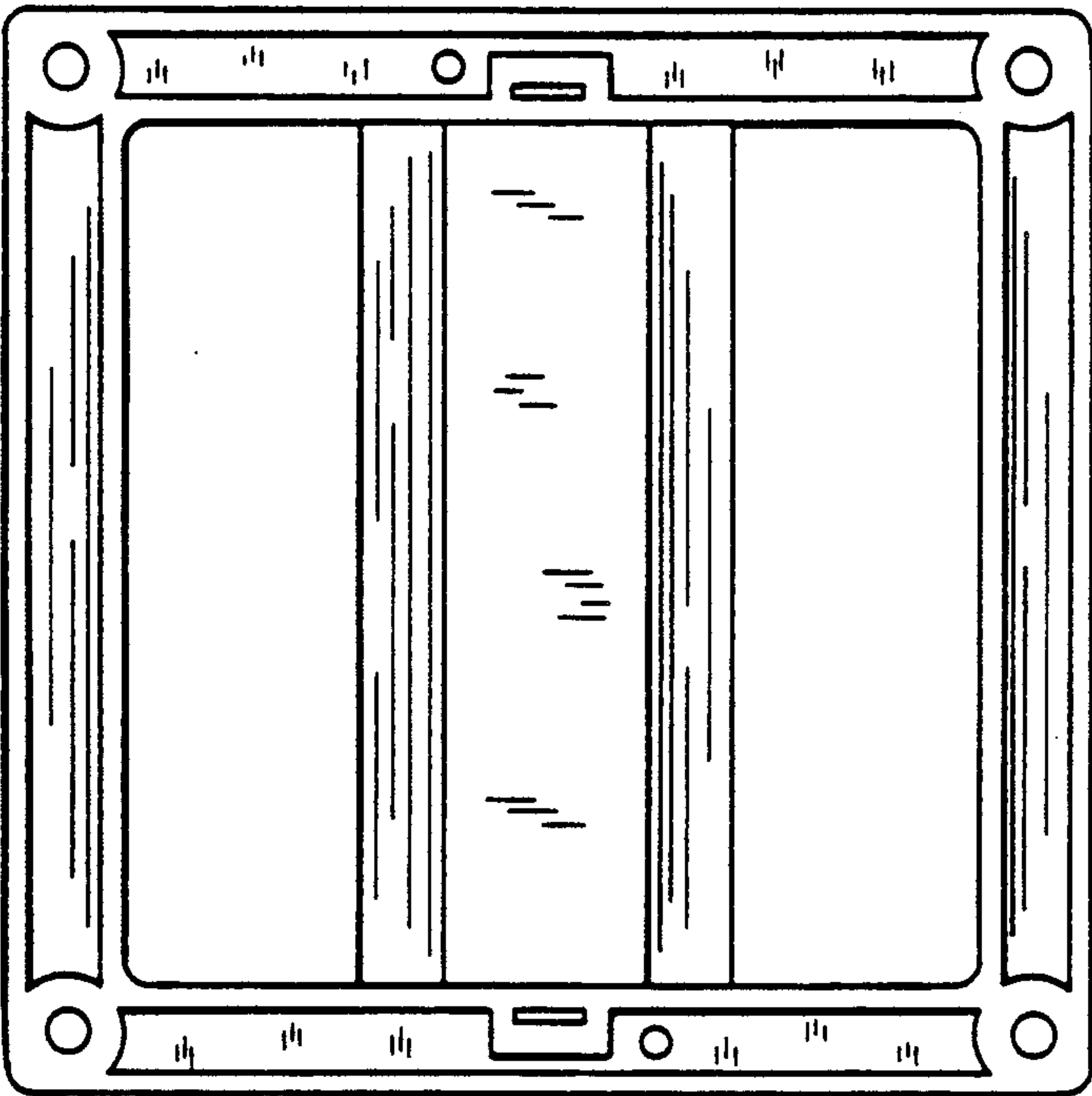
