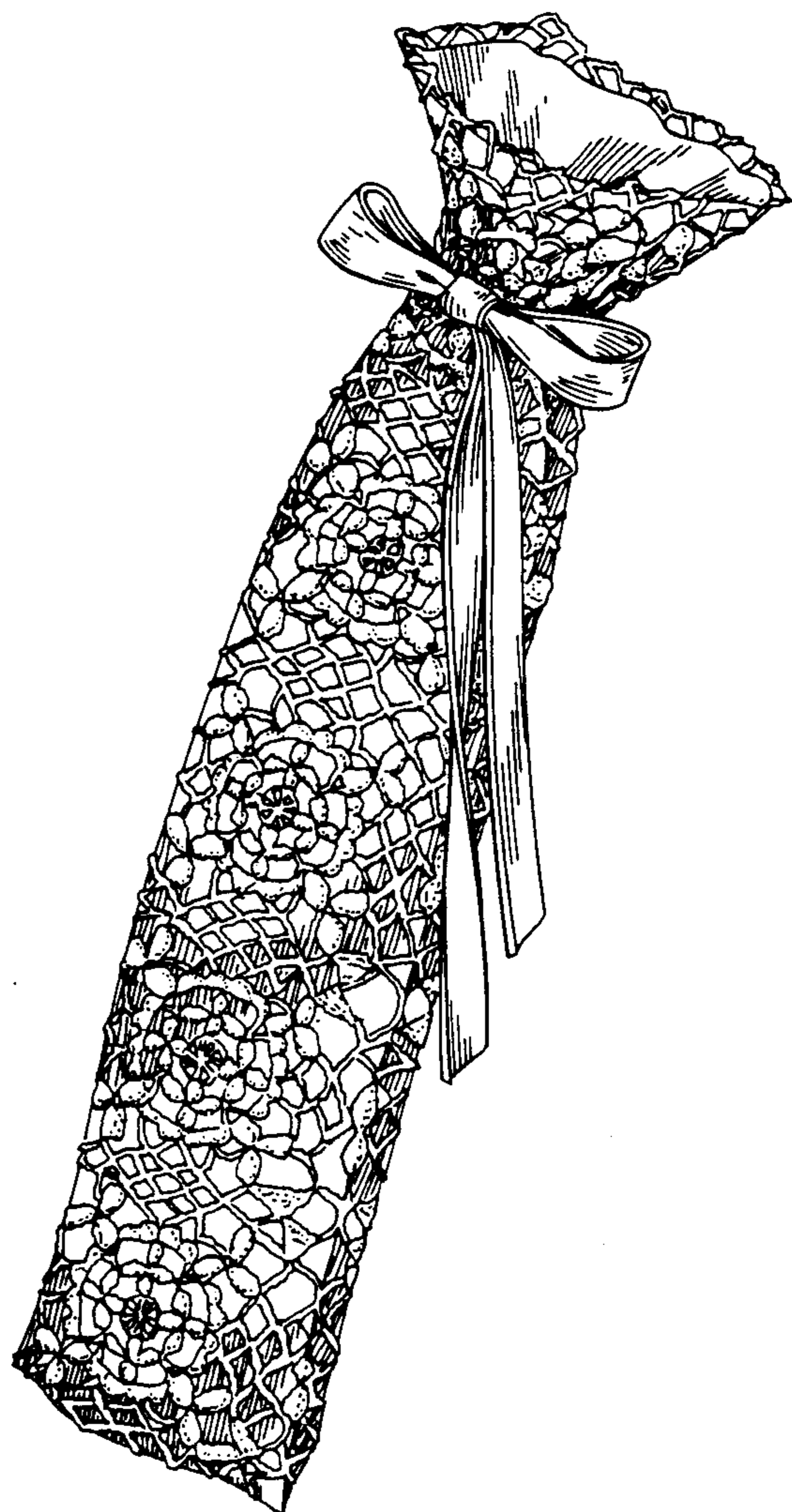
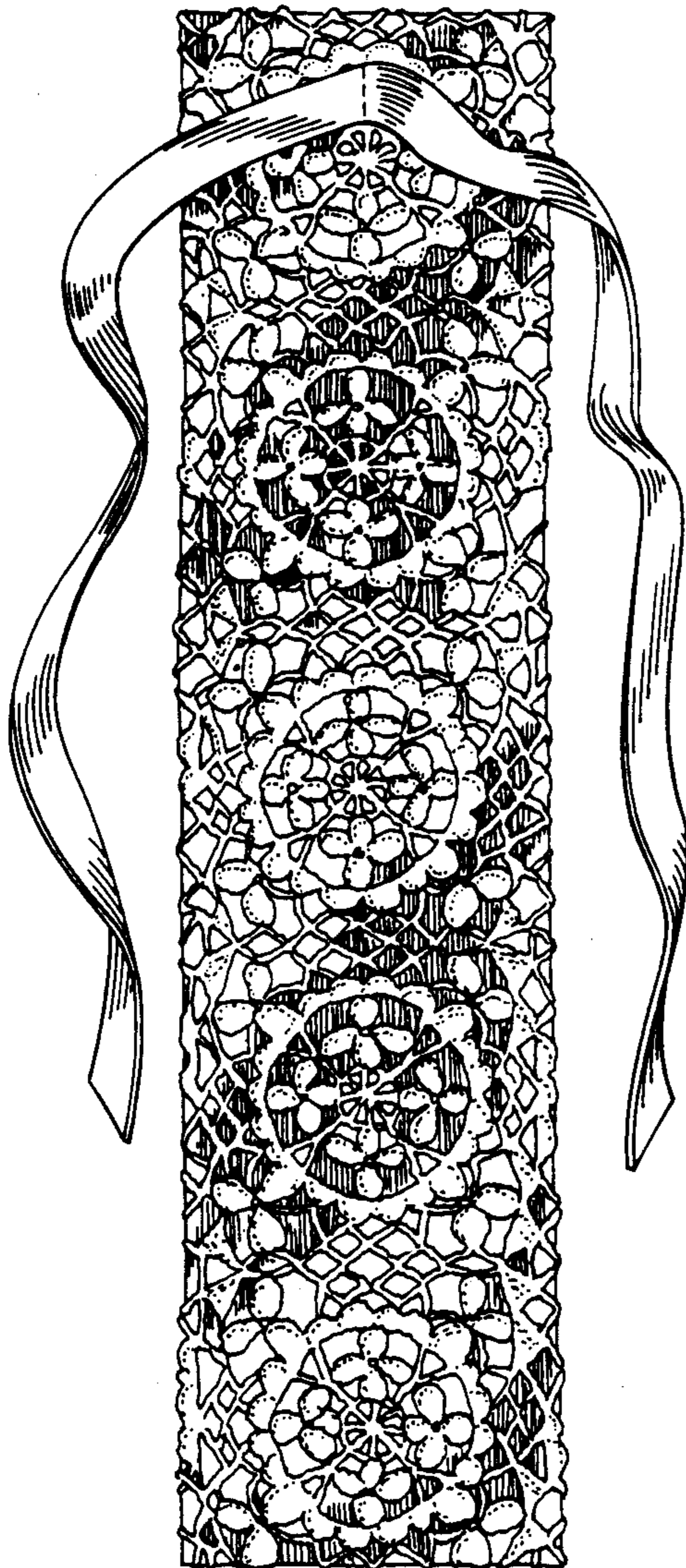

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a flower holder showing my new design, in its open position;
 FIG. 2 is a right side view thereof, the left side being substantially a mirror image;
 FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a perspective view in its closed position.



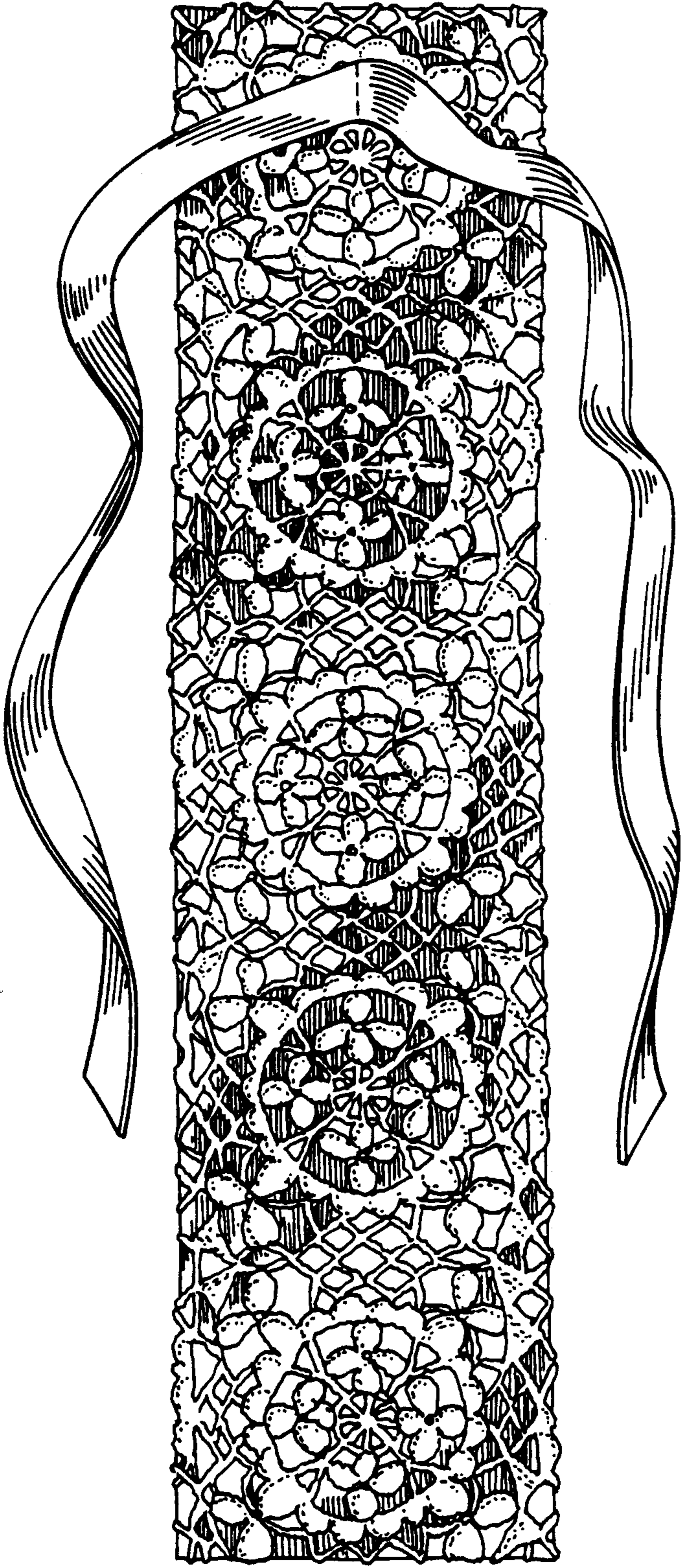

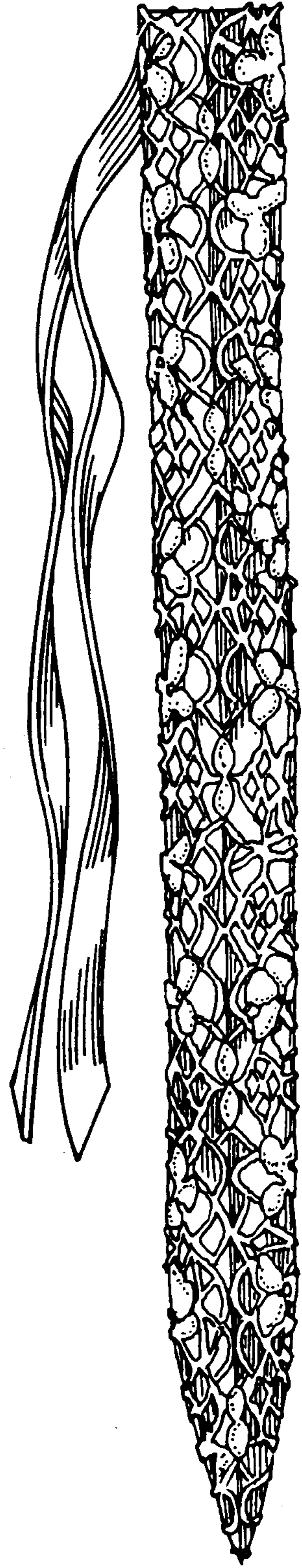
