The ornamental design for a glare reduction shield for attachment to a vehicle mirror or similar article, as shown.

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

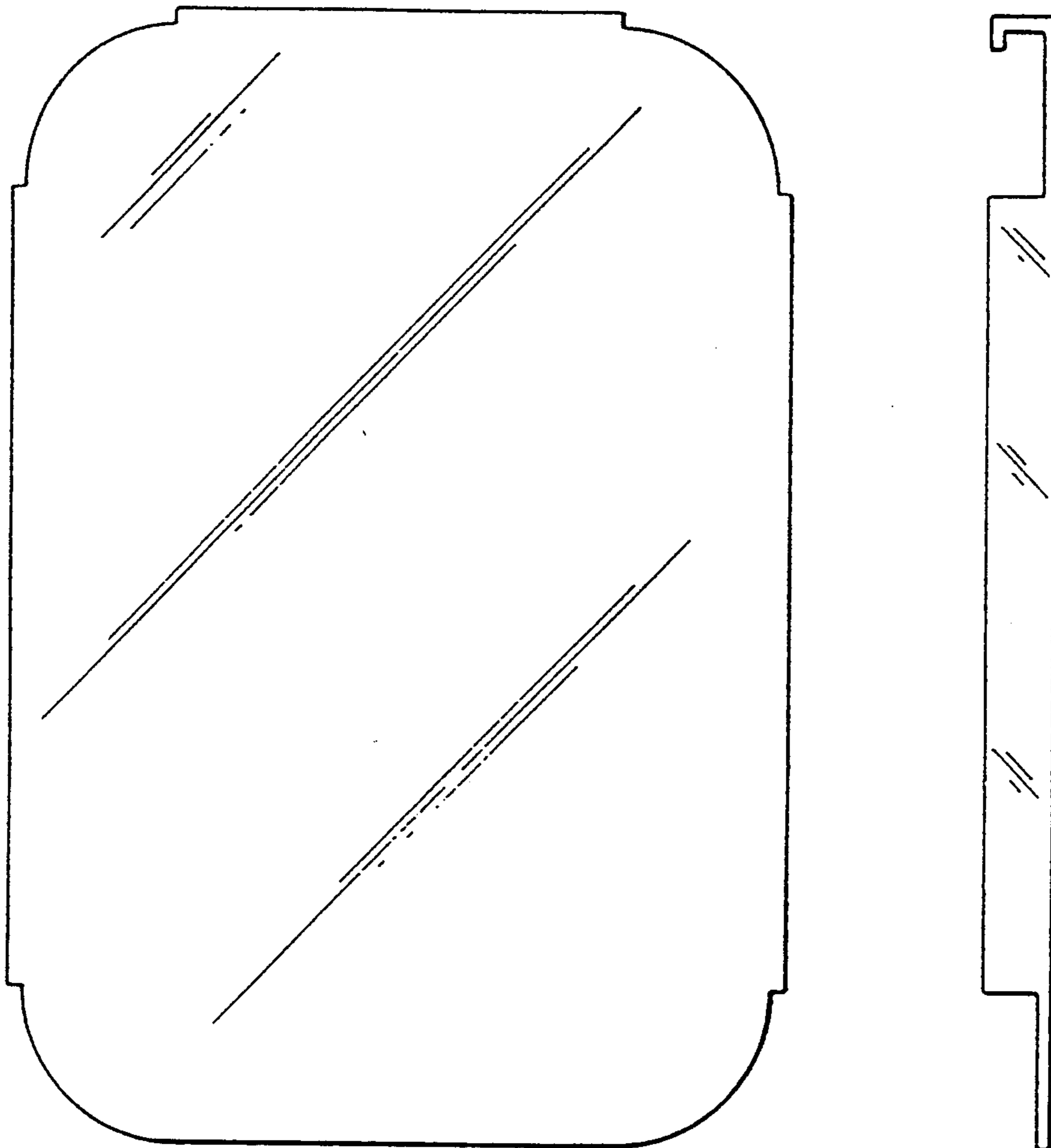

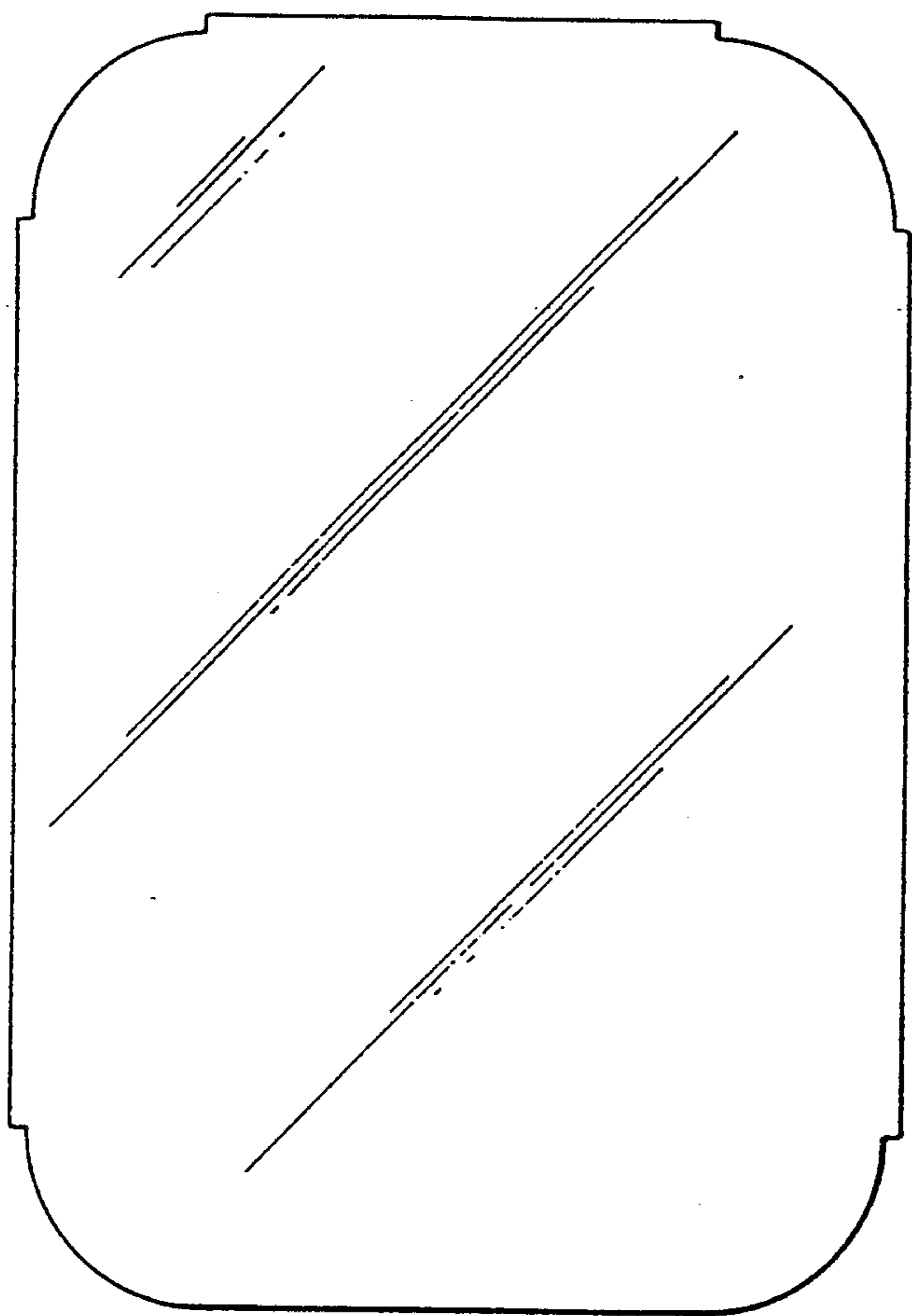

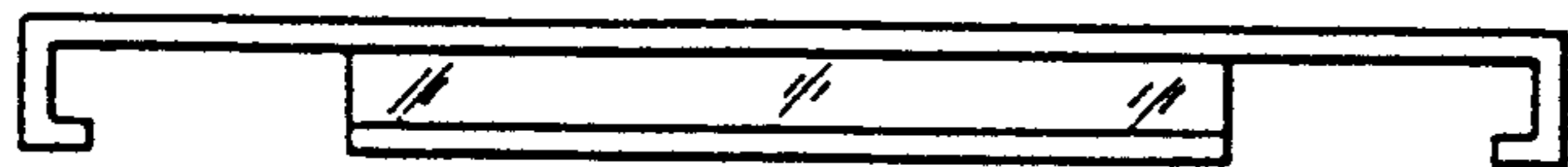

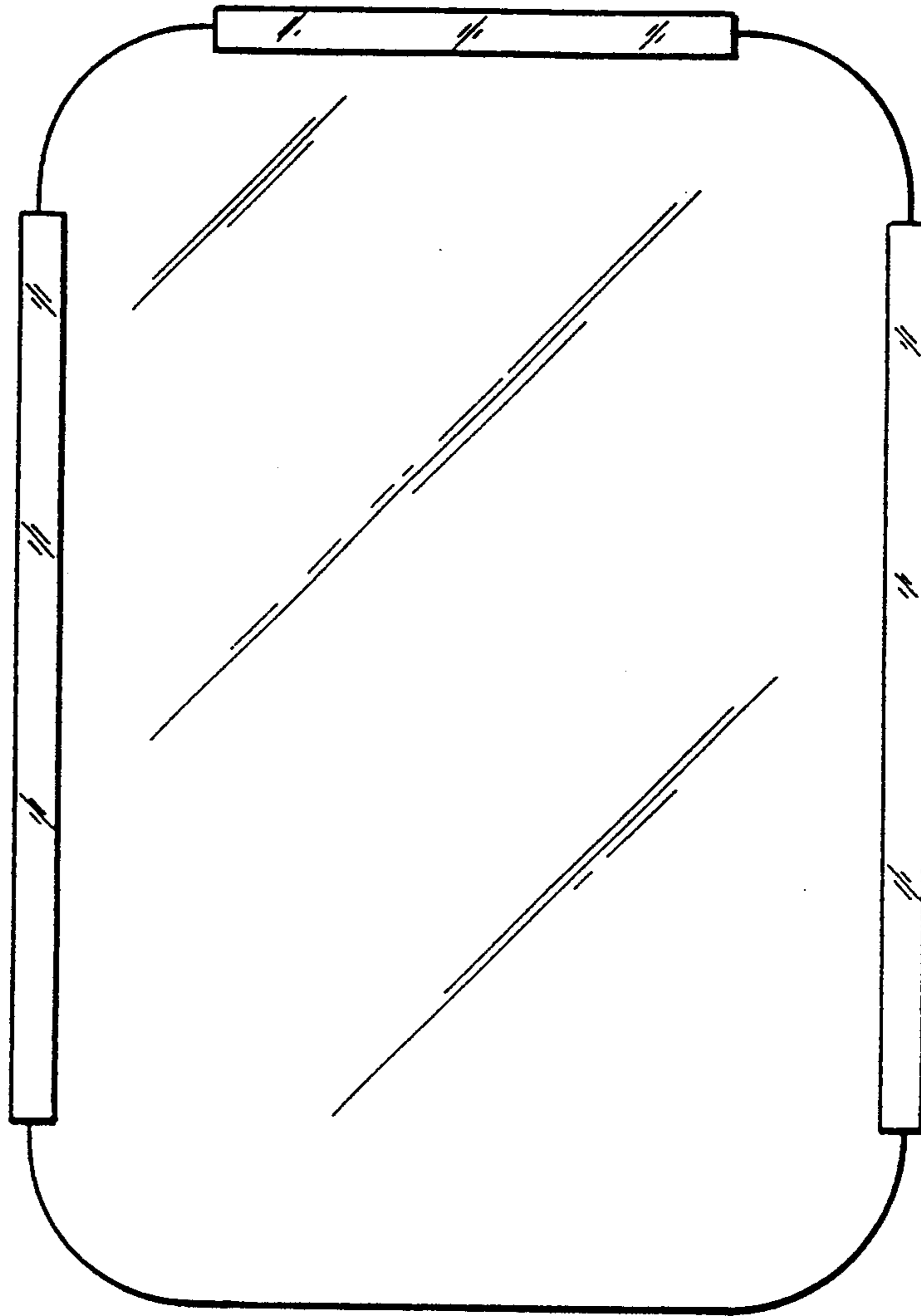
