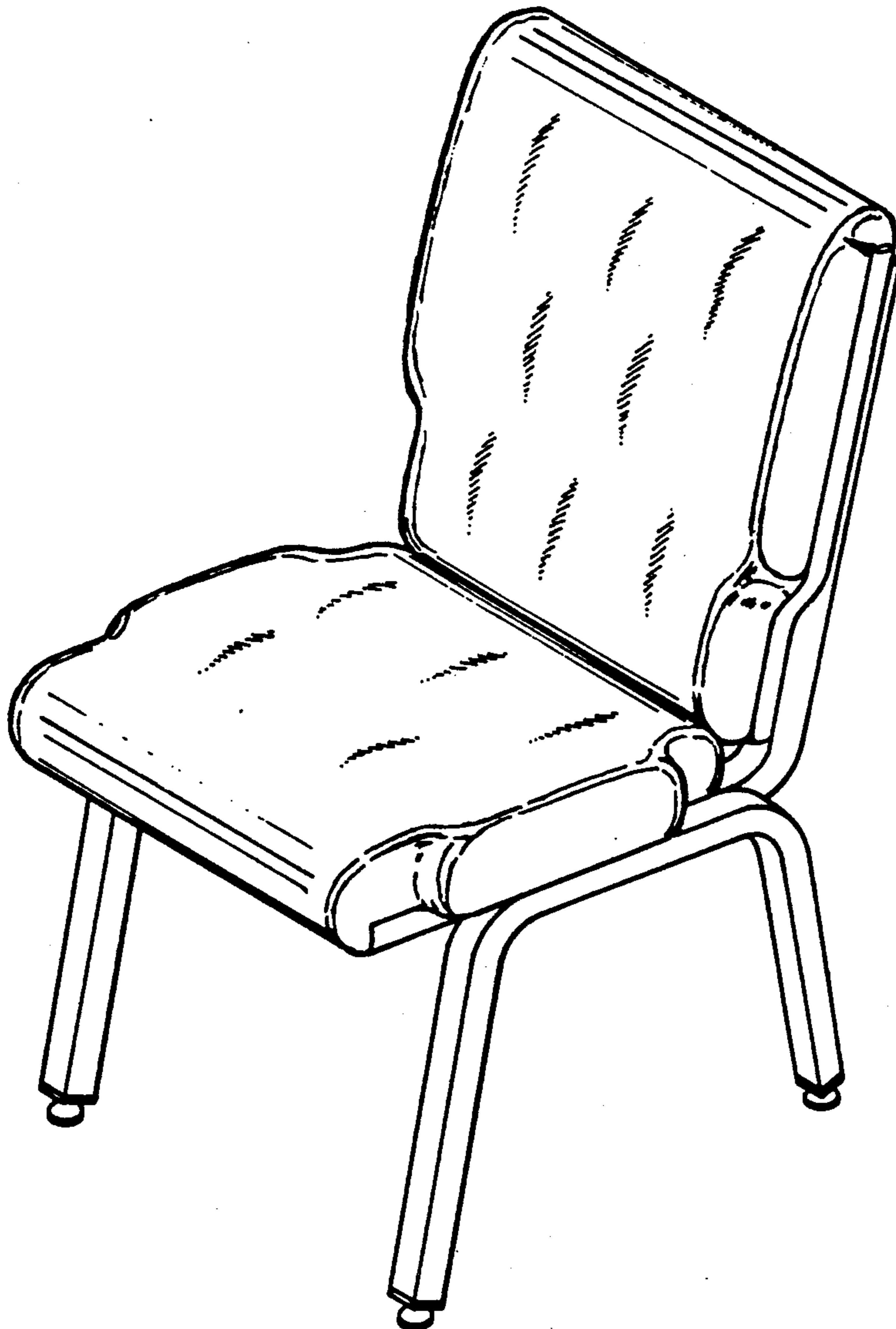

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of my new design for a chair;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of my new design for a chair, the opposite side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of my new design for a chair.



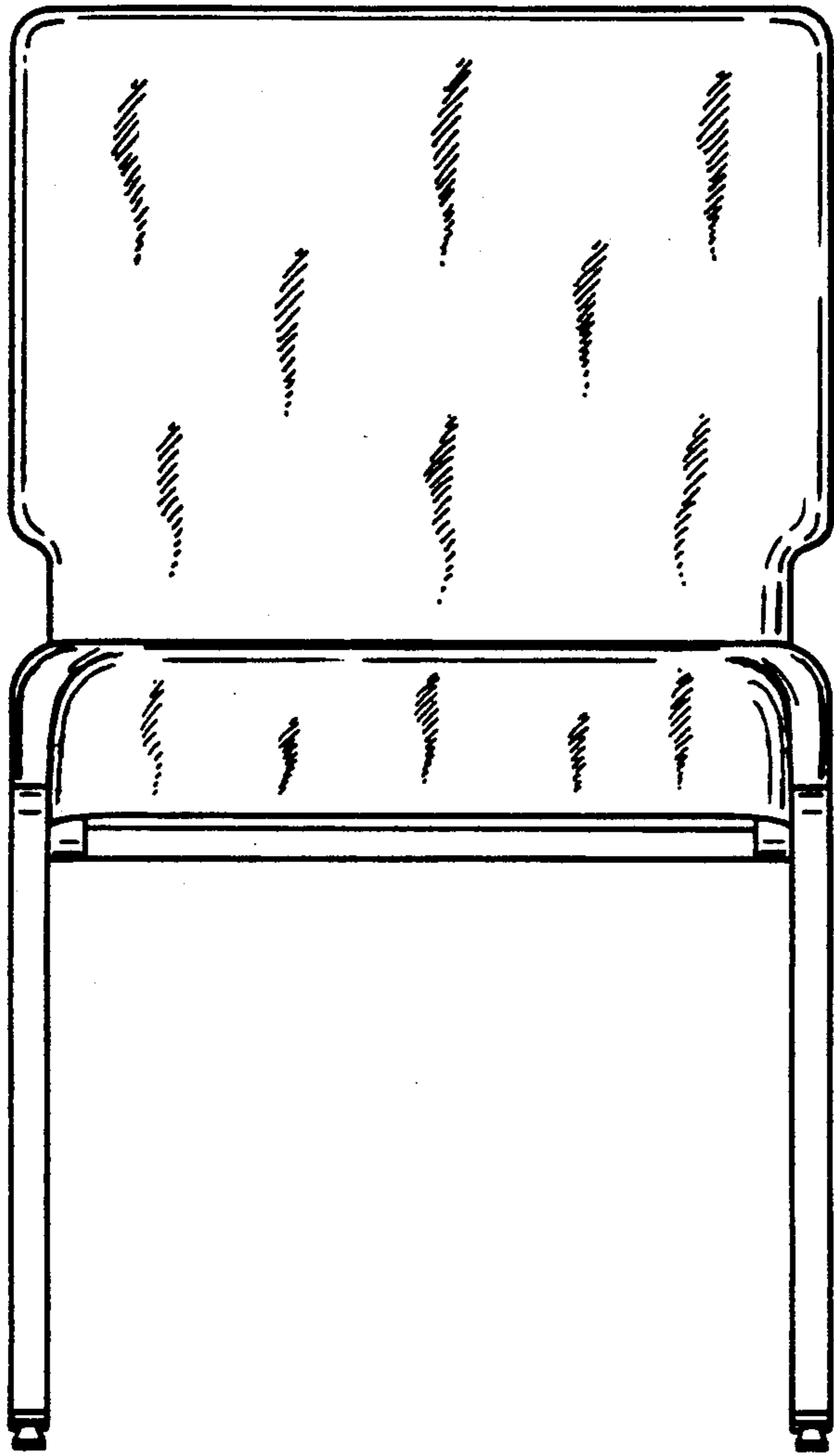

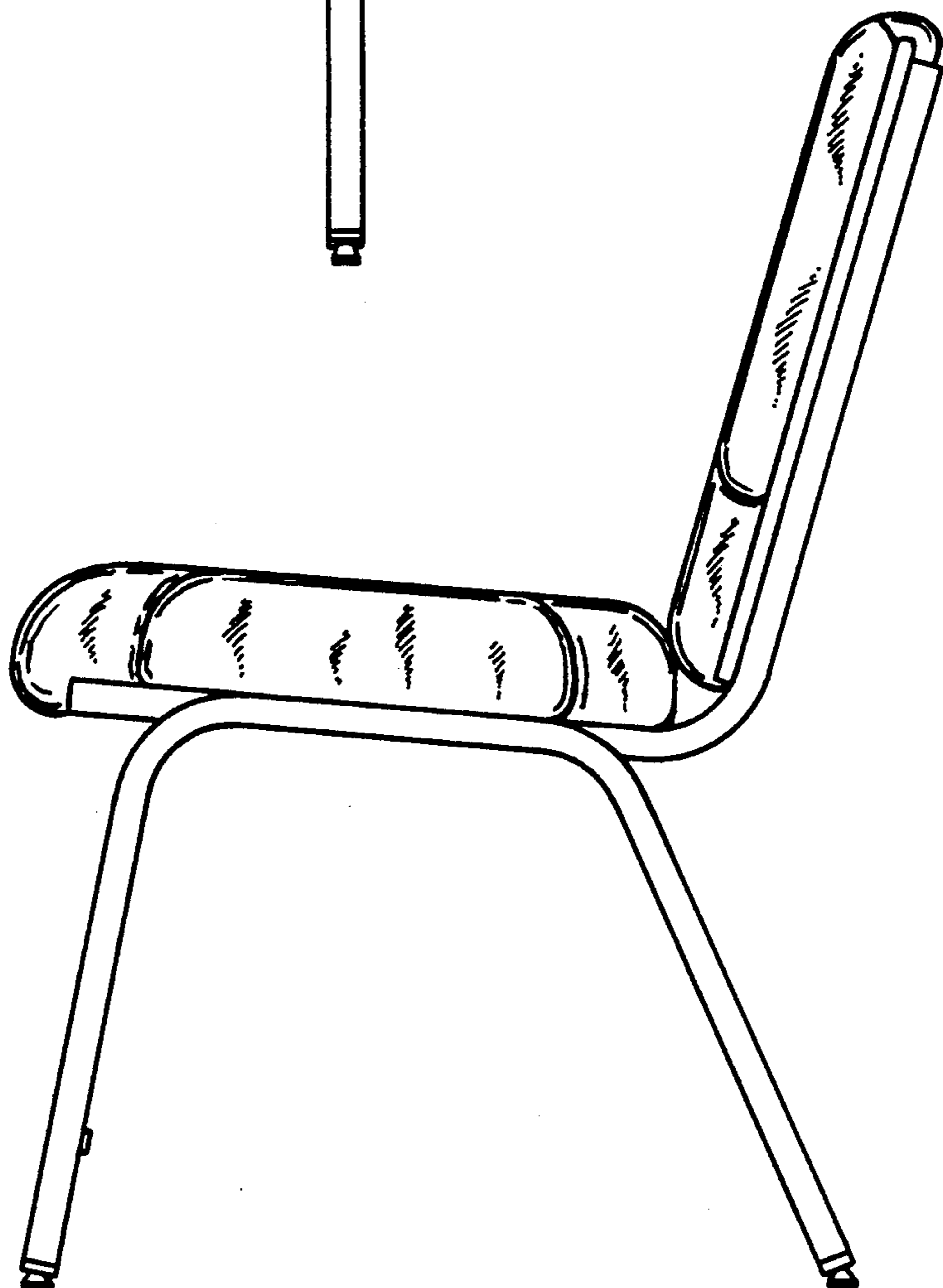

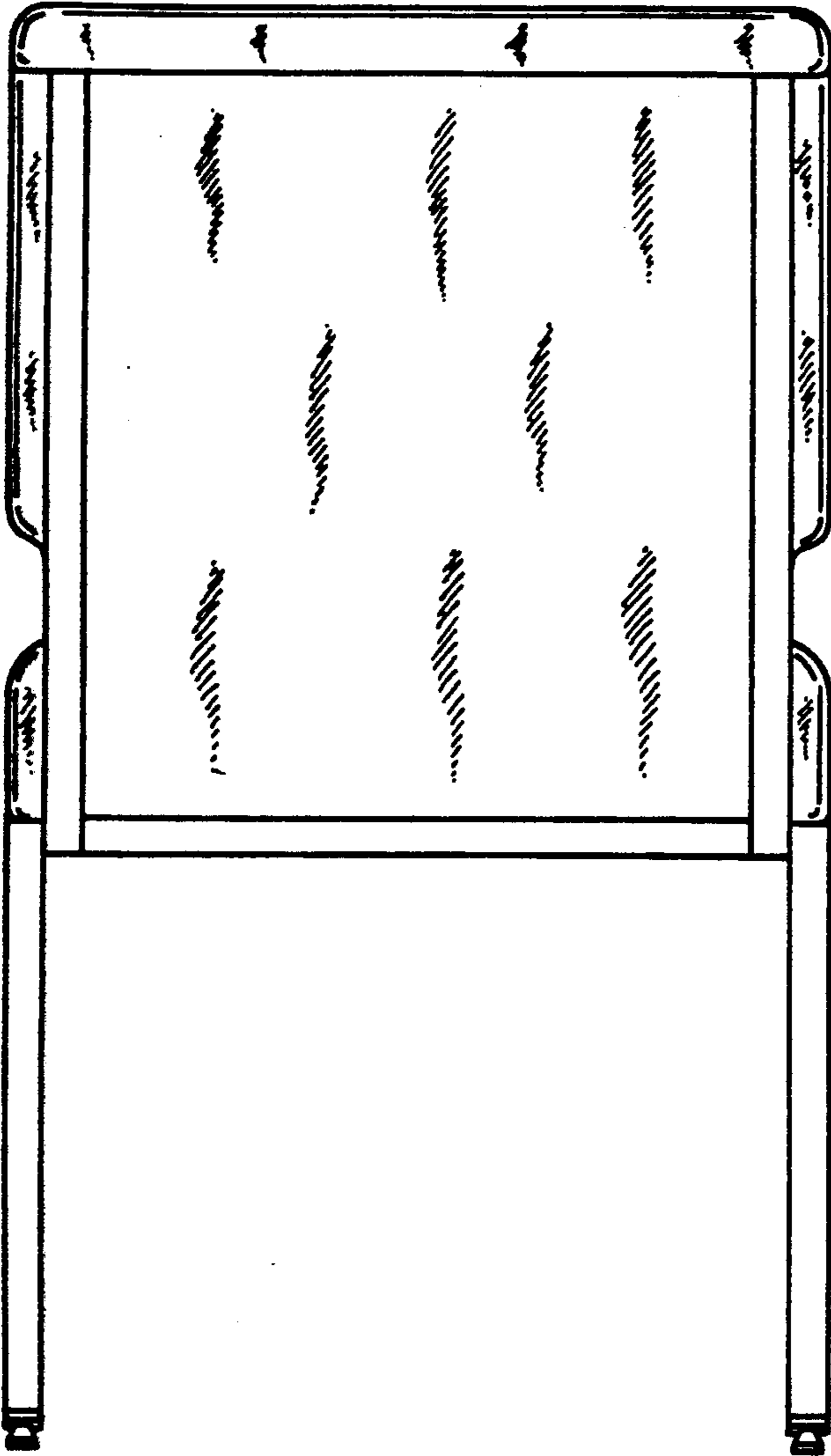

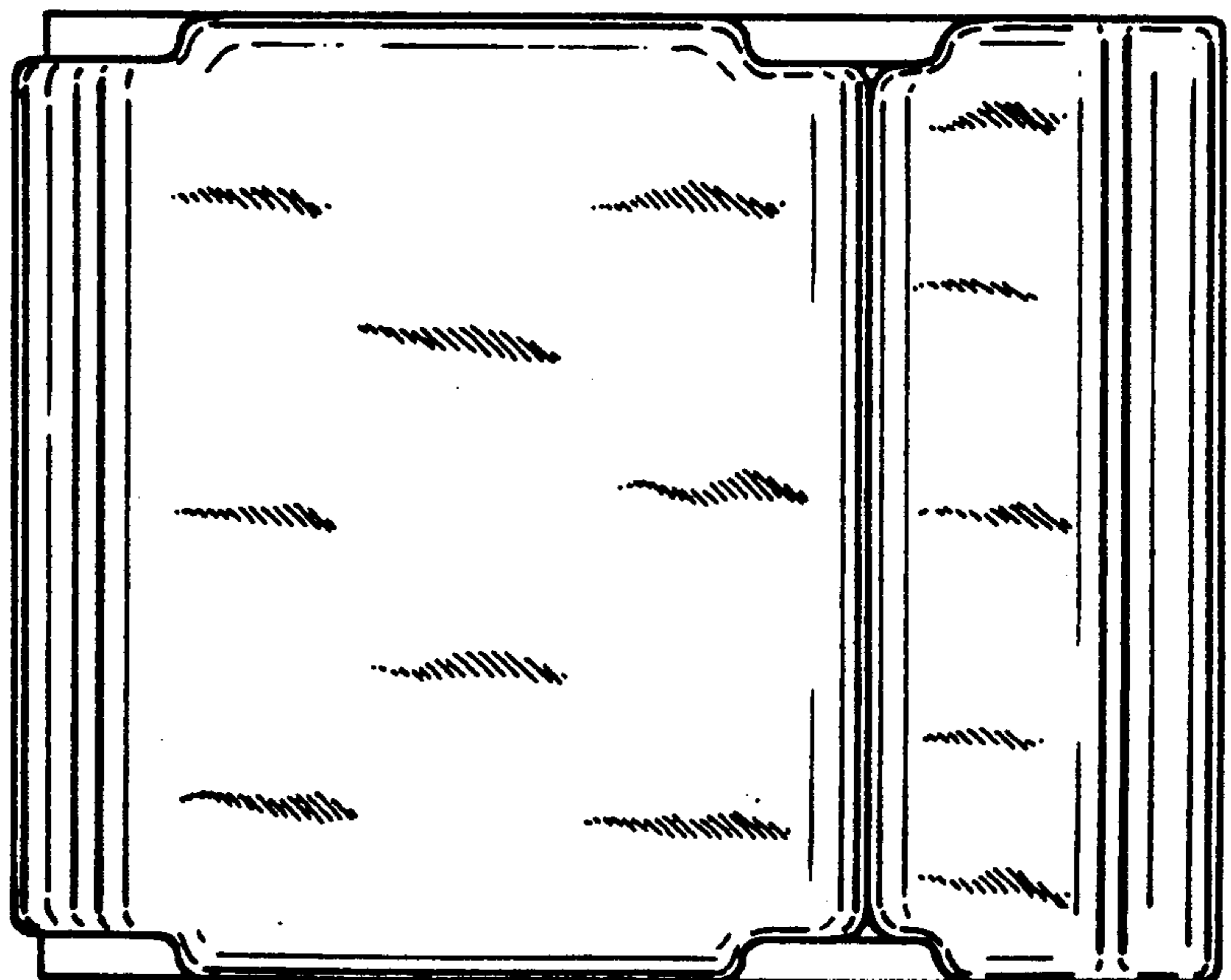

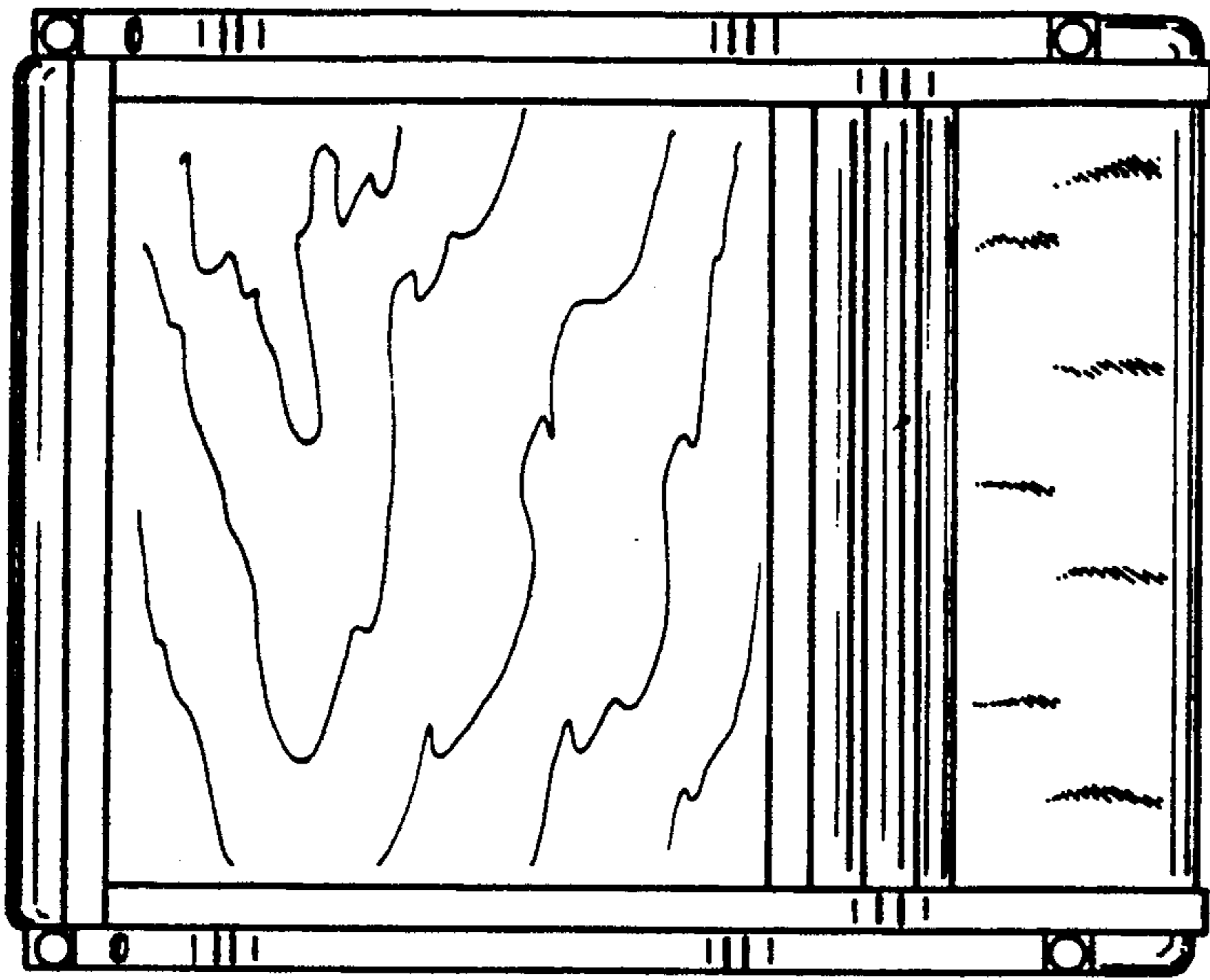
