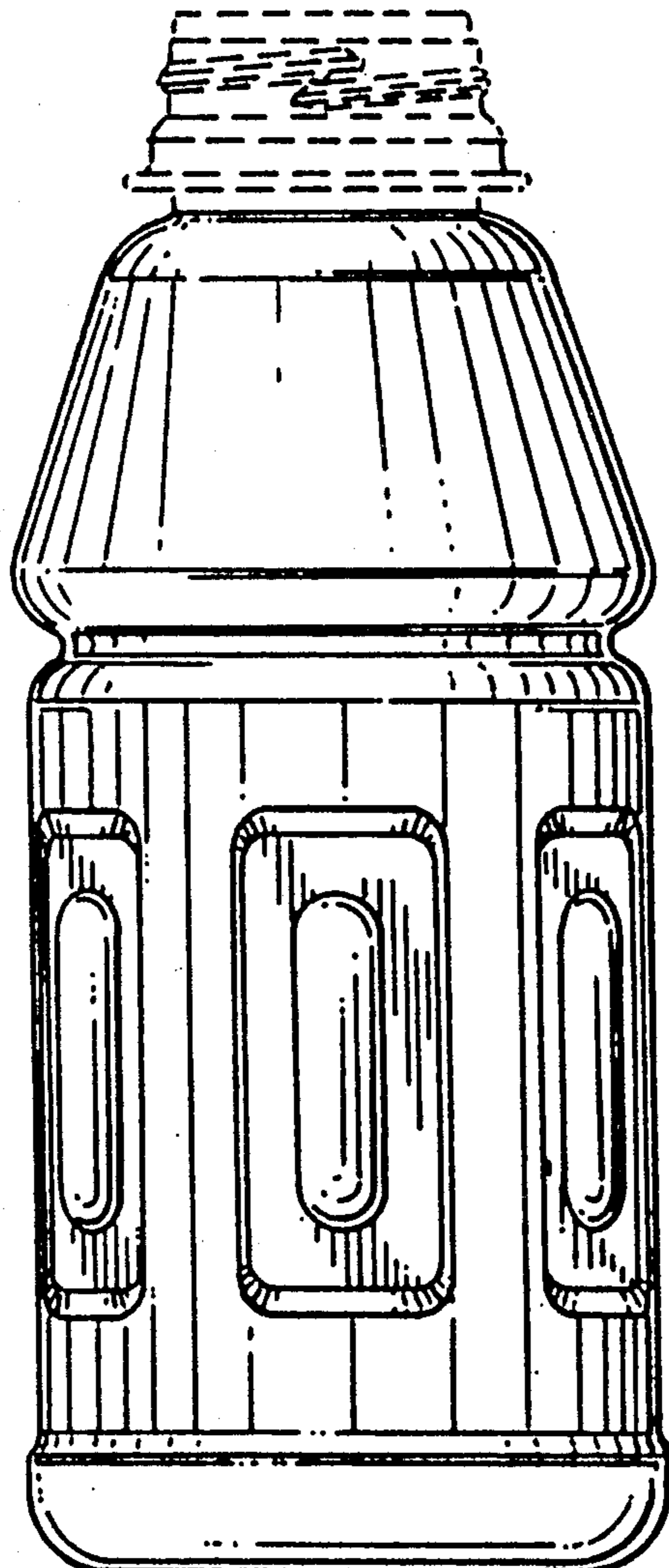
**DESCRIPTION**

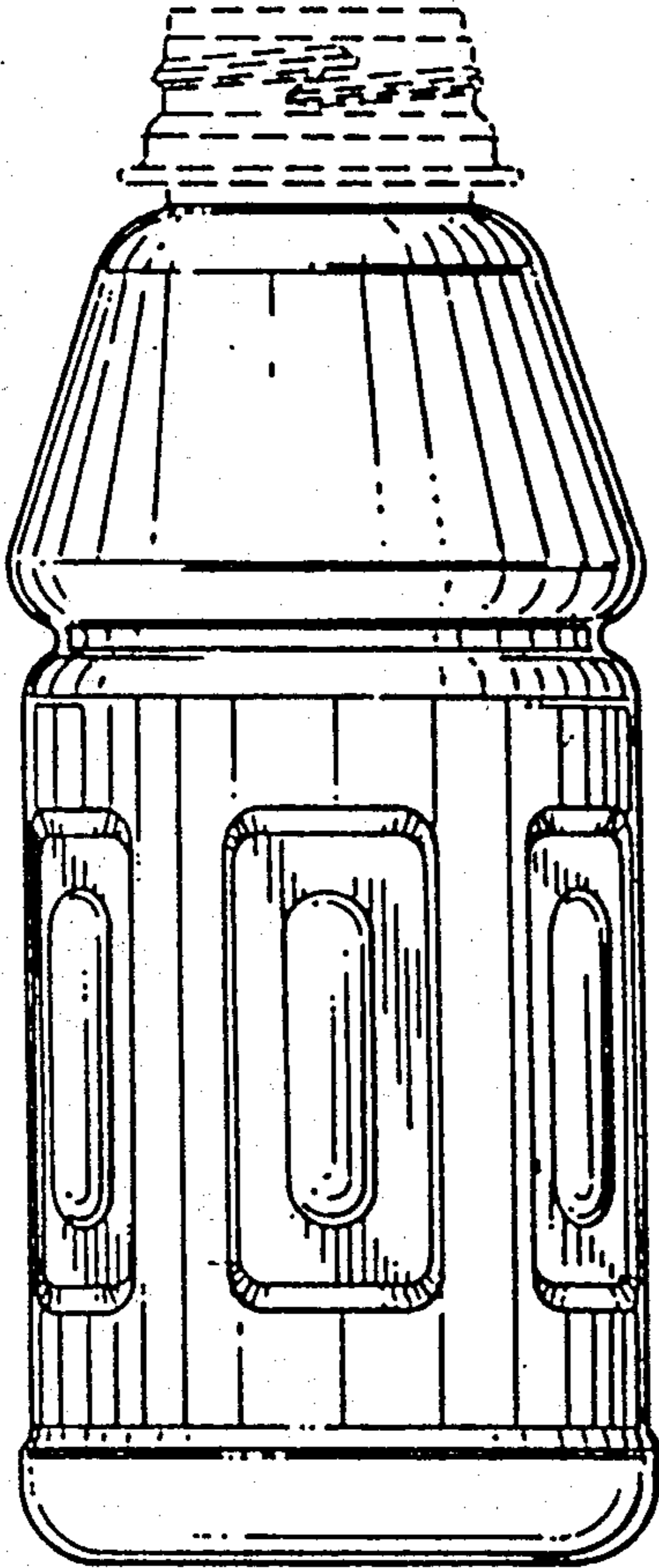

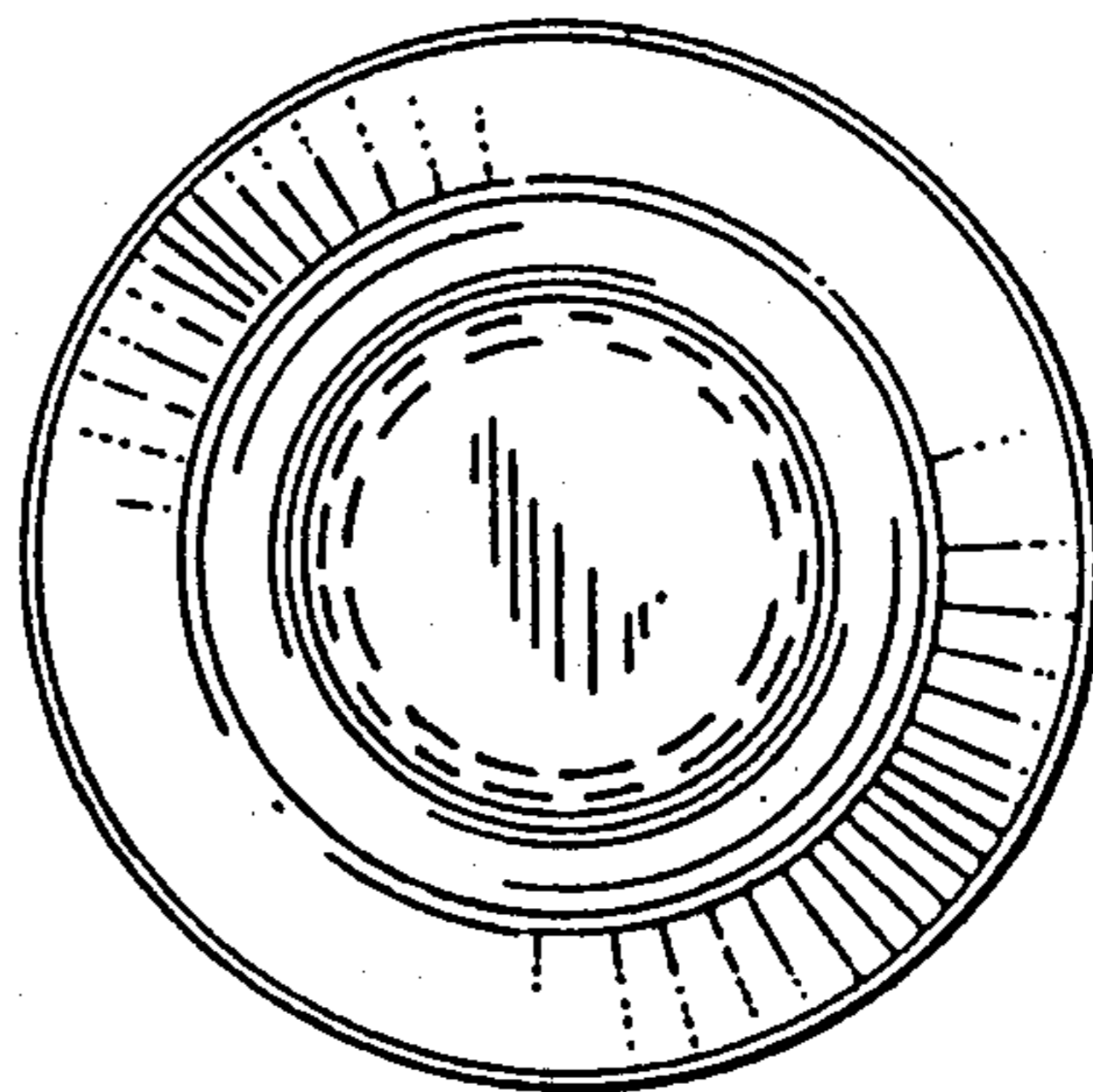

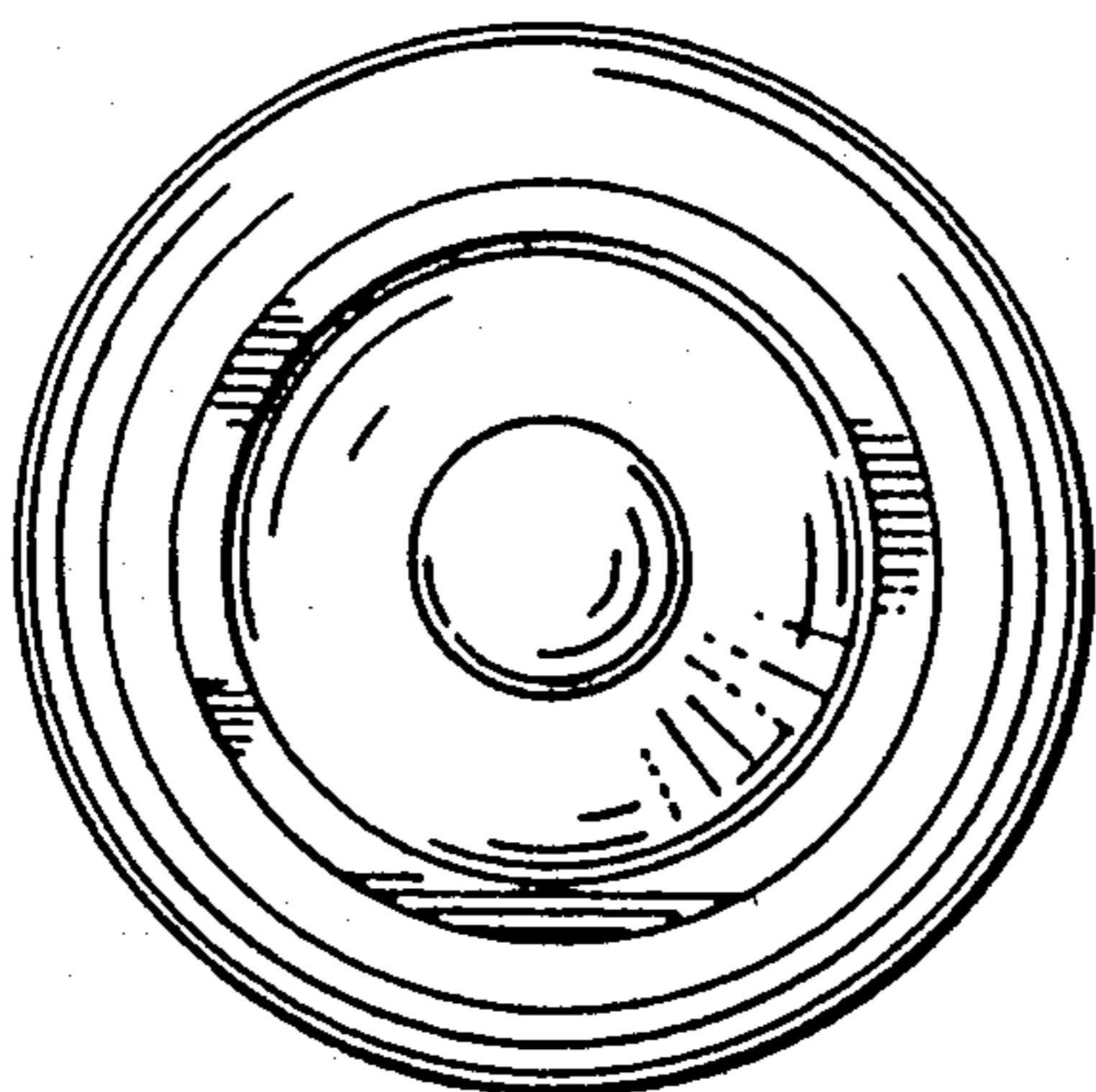
