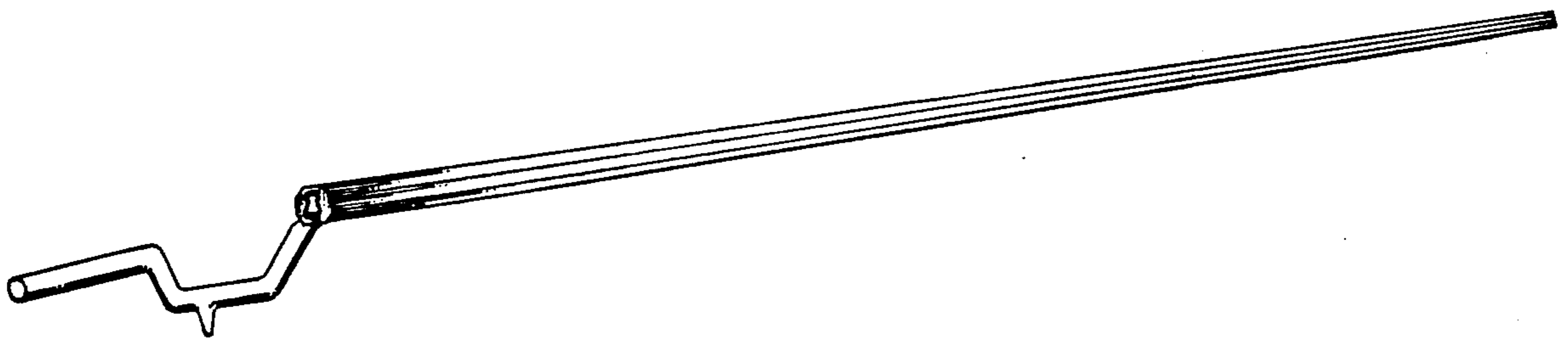

The ornamental design for a fishing rod, or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fishing rod, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.



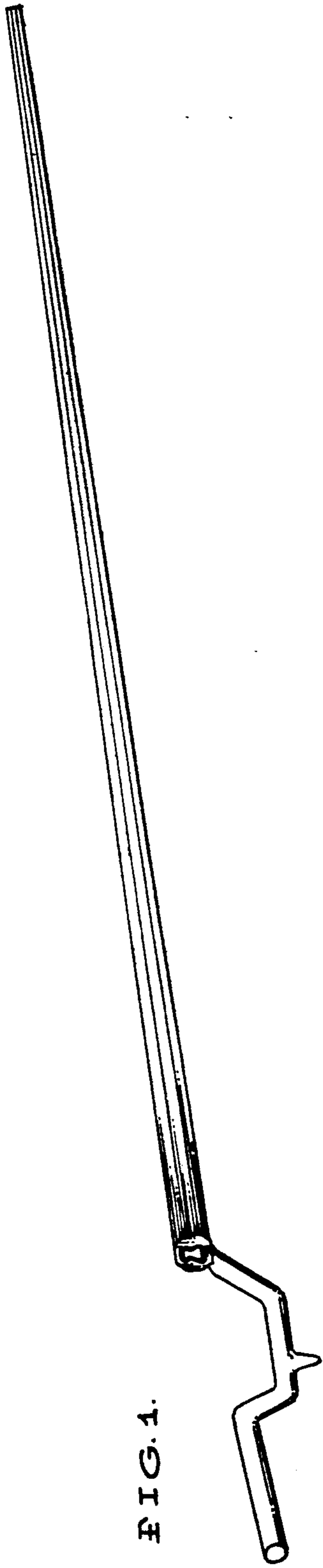

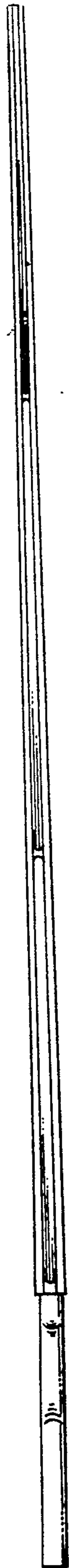

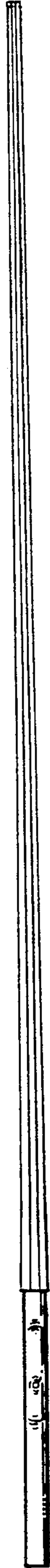

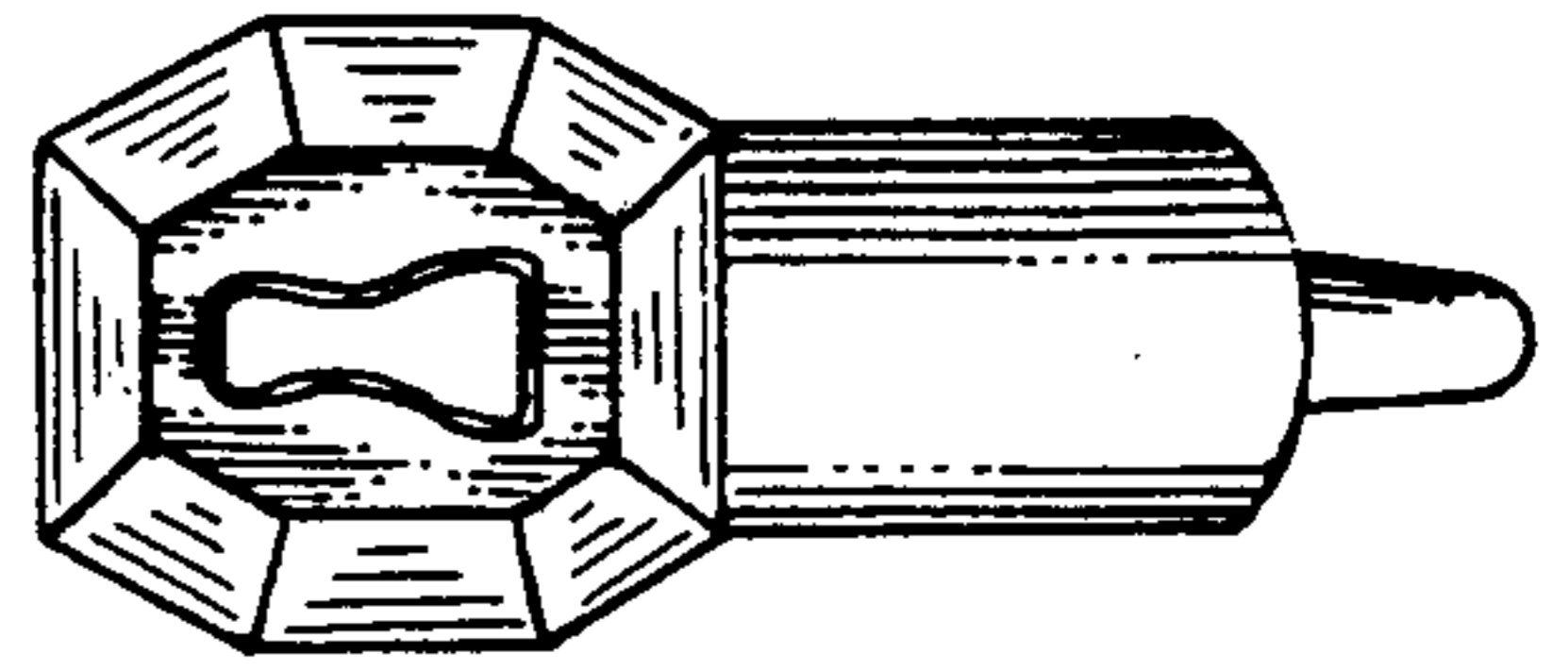

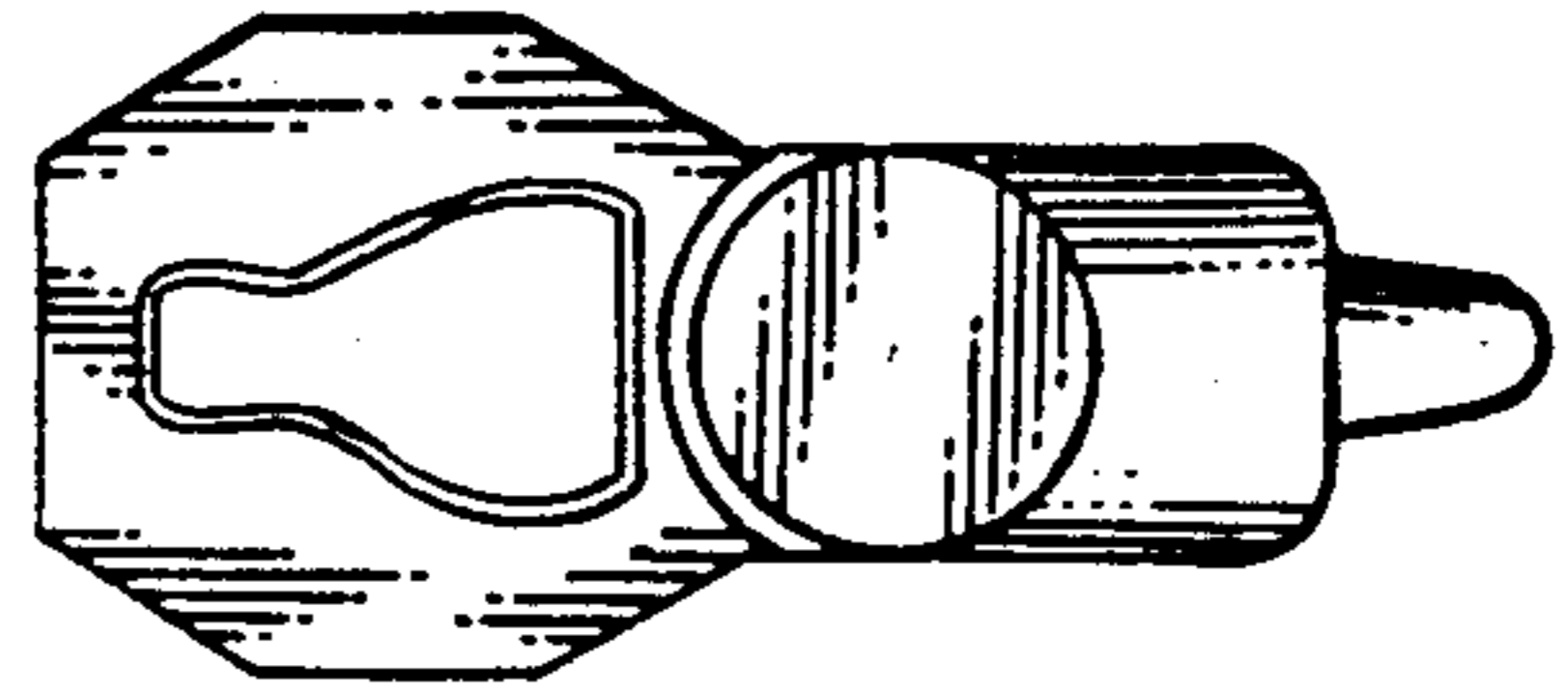
