[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a wireform for an orthodontic appliance or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wireform for orthodontic appliances or similar article showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof, on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof, on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof, on an enlarged scale.
