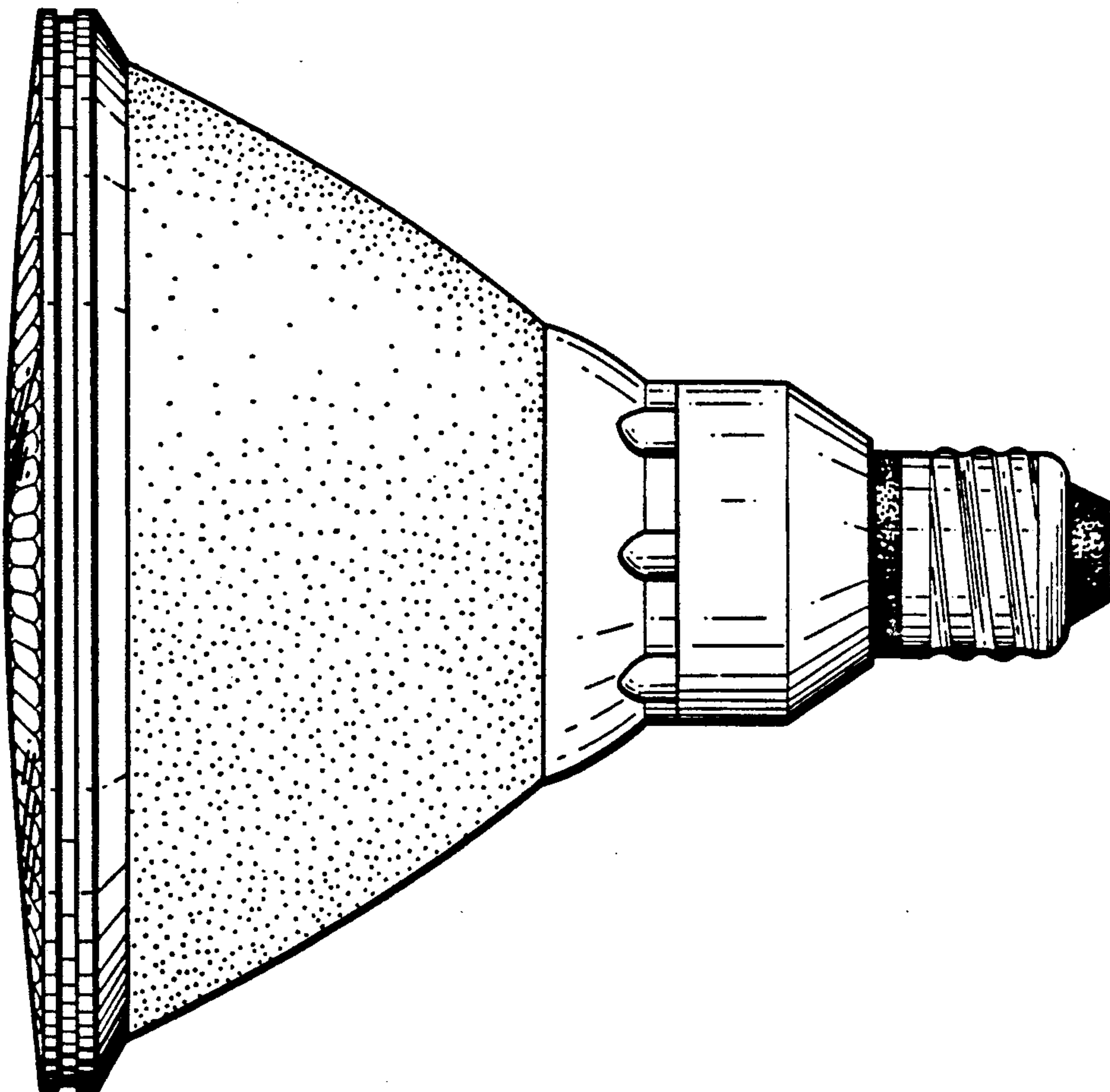

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof the opposite side being identical.



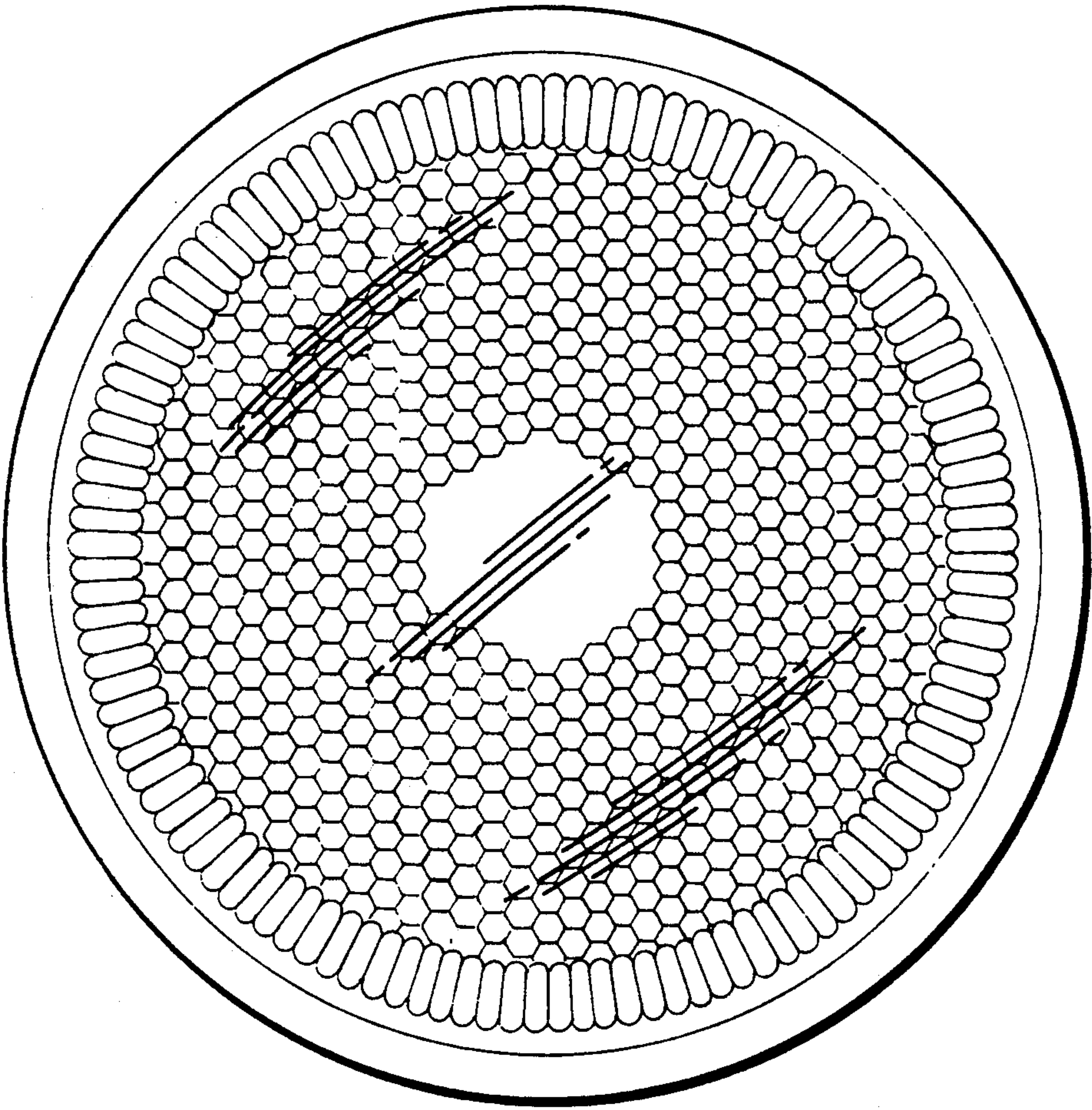

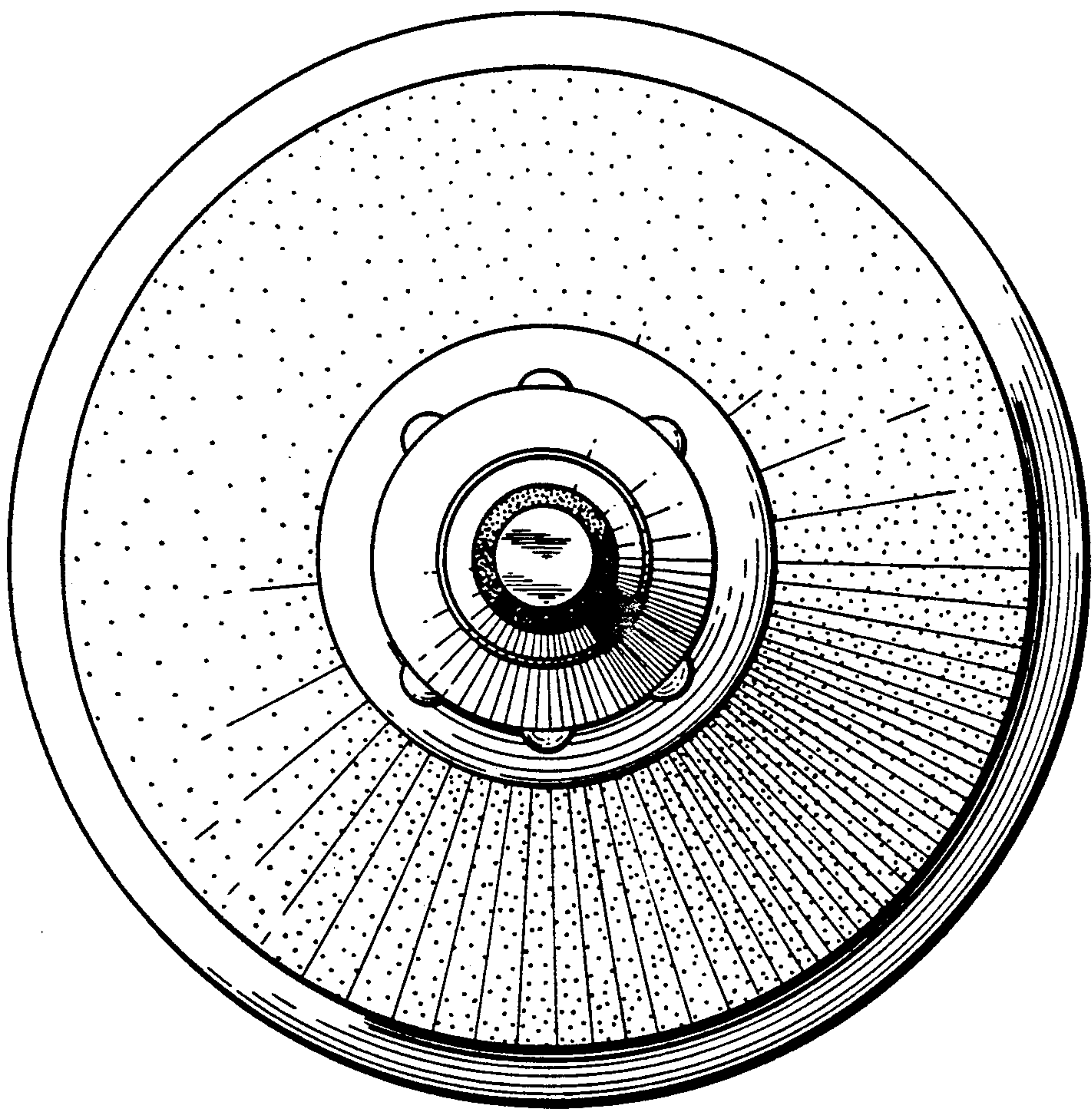

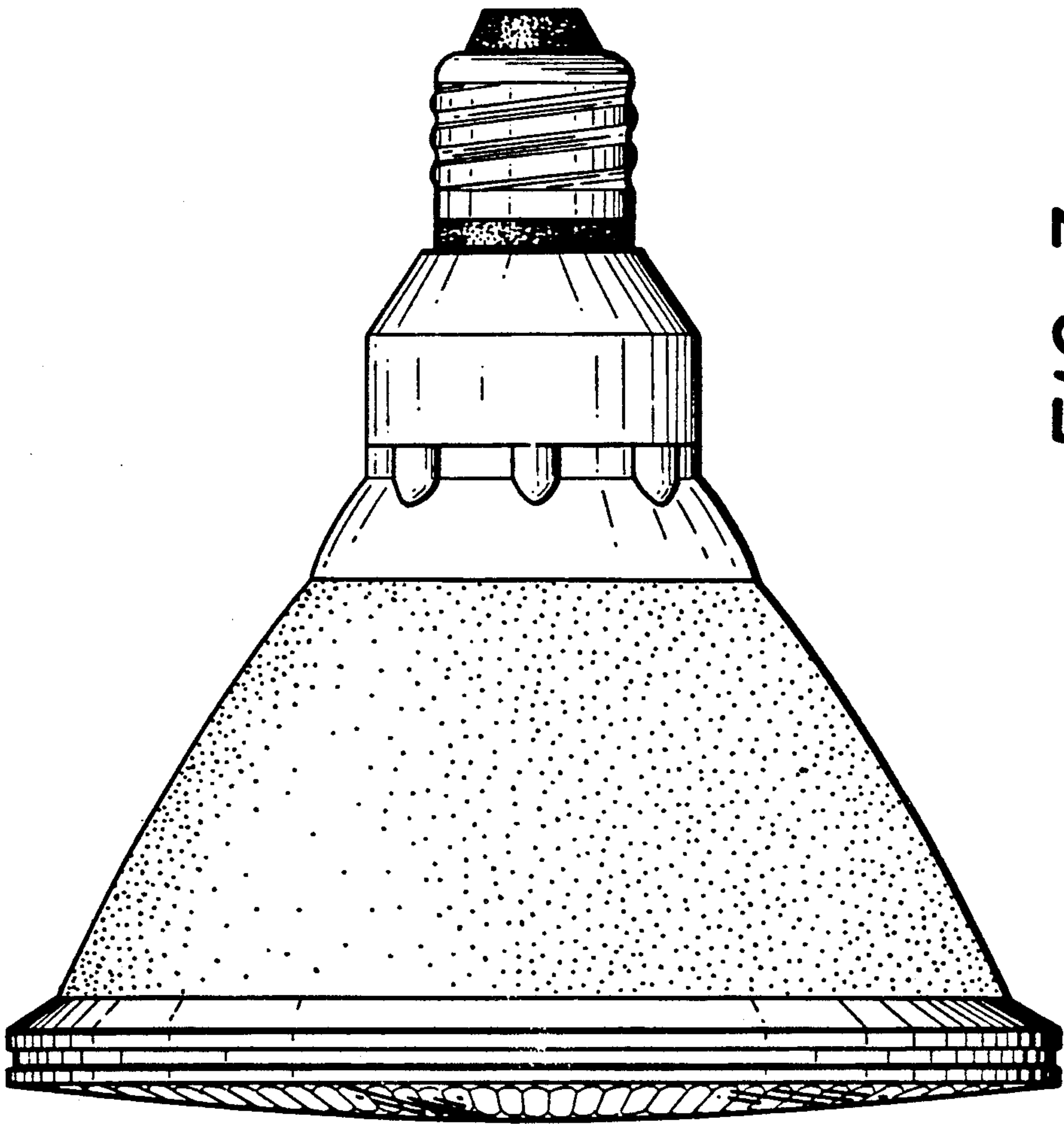
