The ornamental design for an expansible carry-on case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an expansible carry-on case showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left end elevational view, the right end elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 7 is a left end elevational view in expanded position, the right end view being a mirror image thereof.

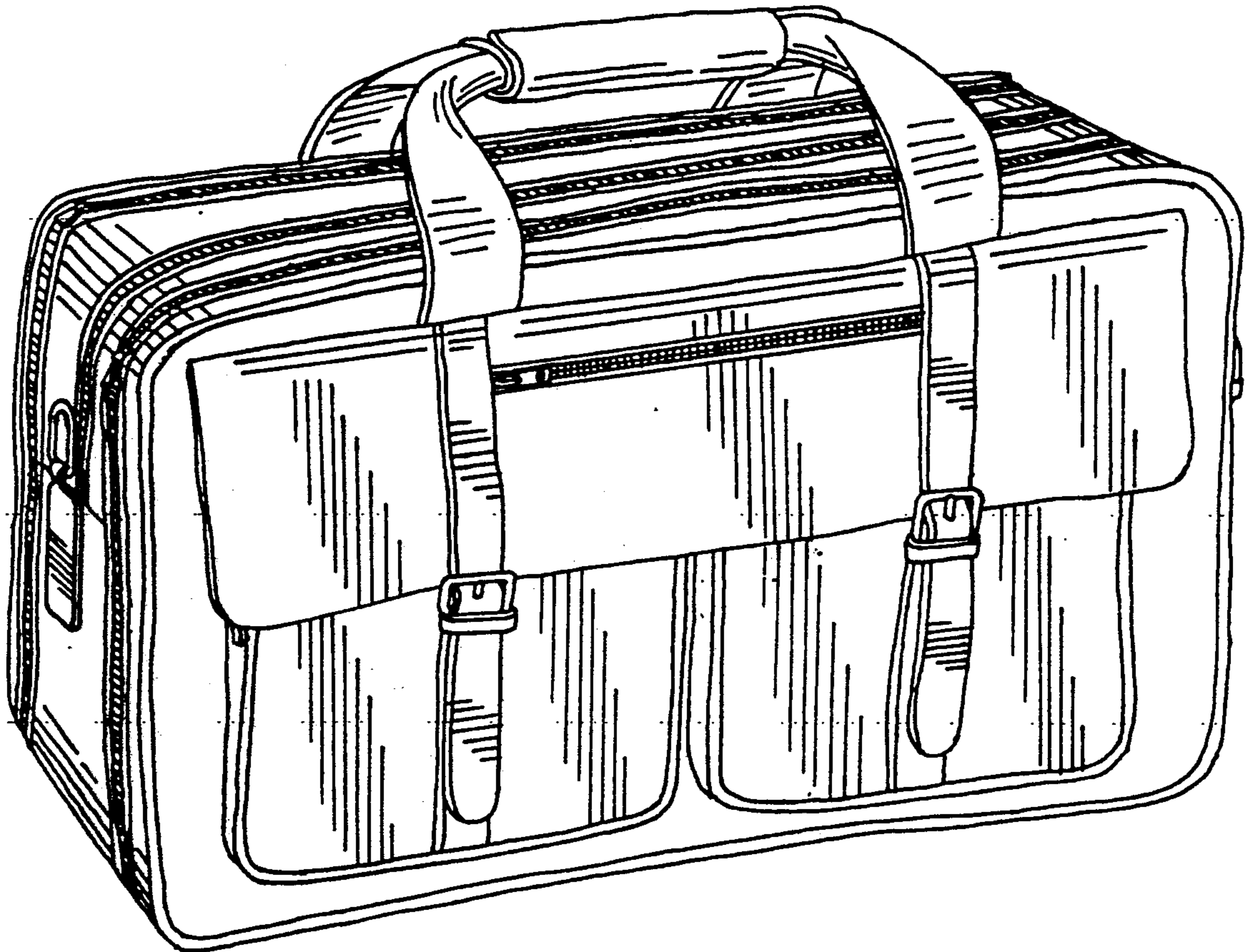

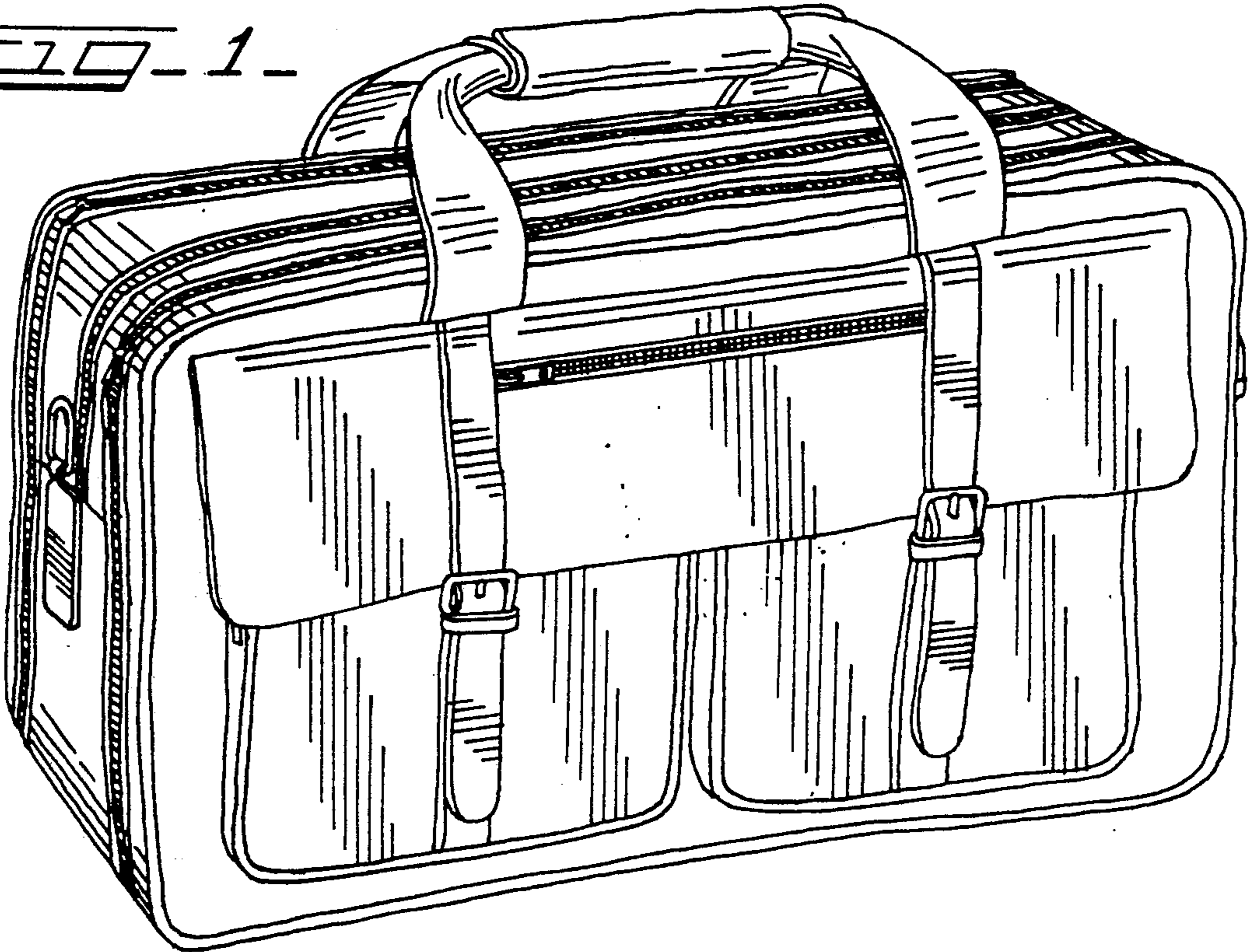

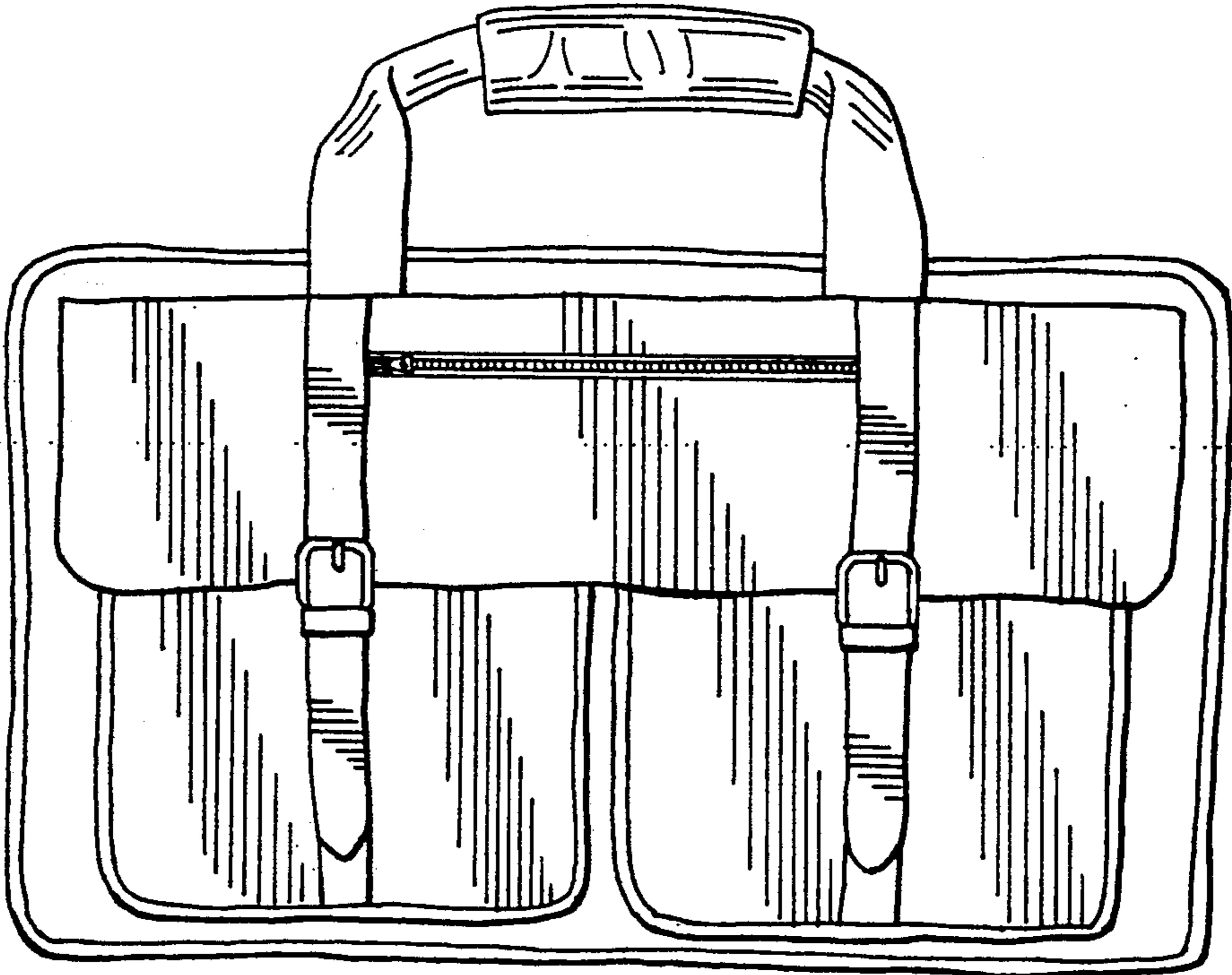

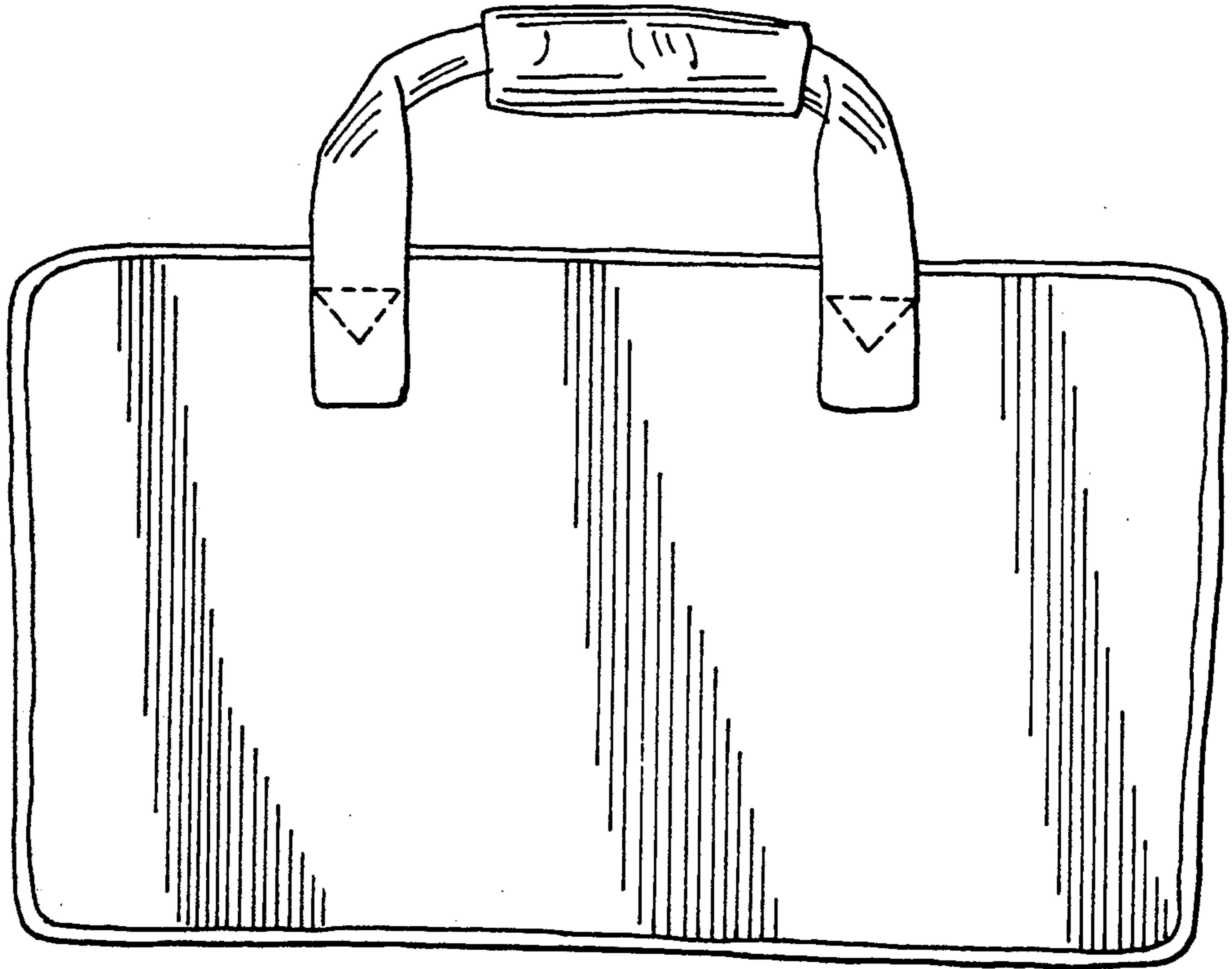

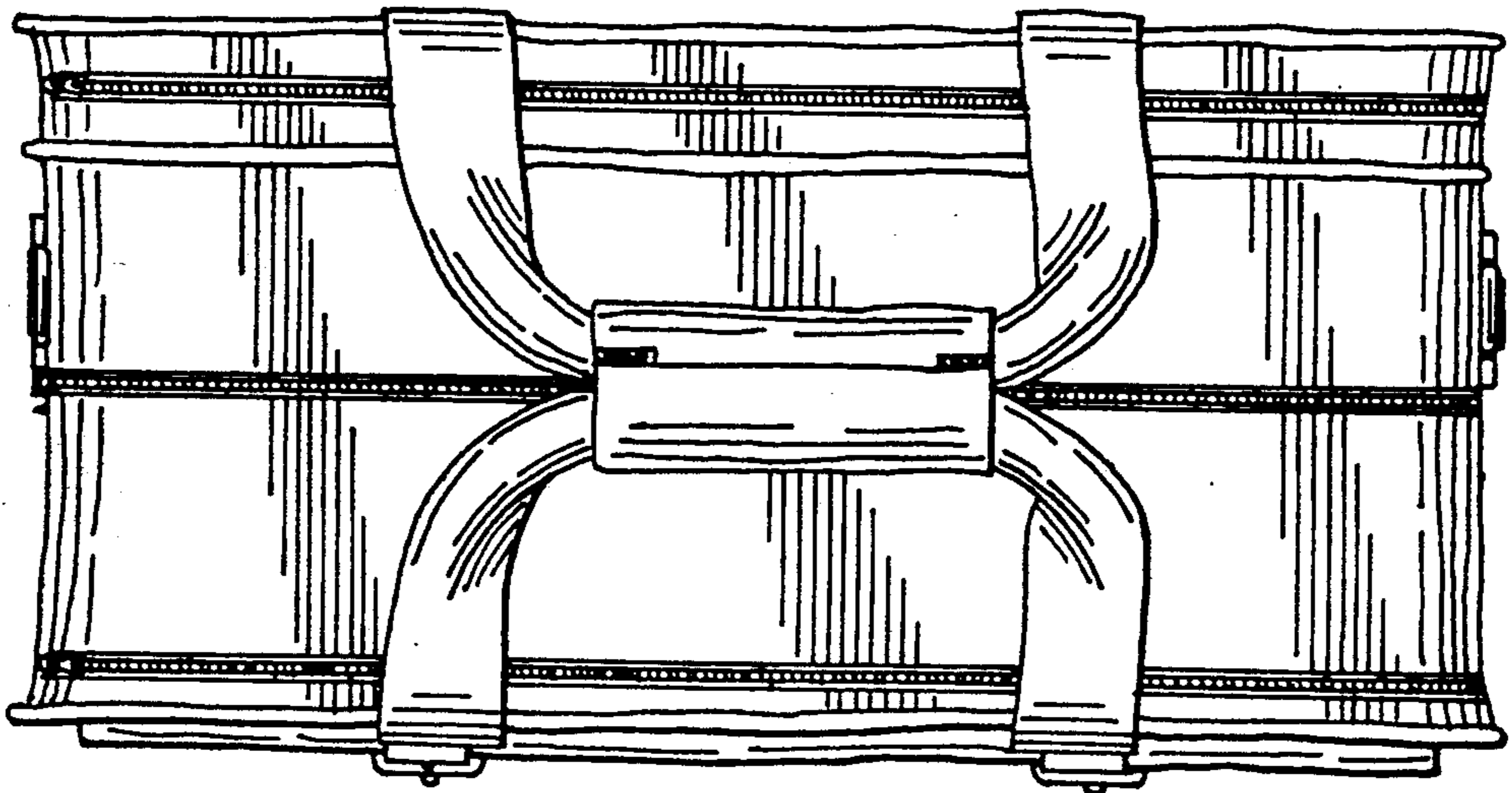

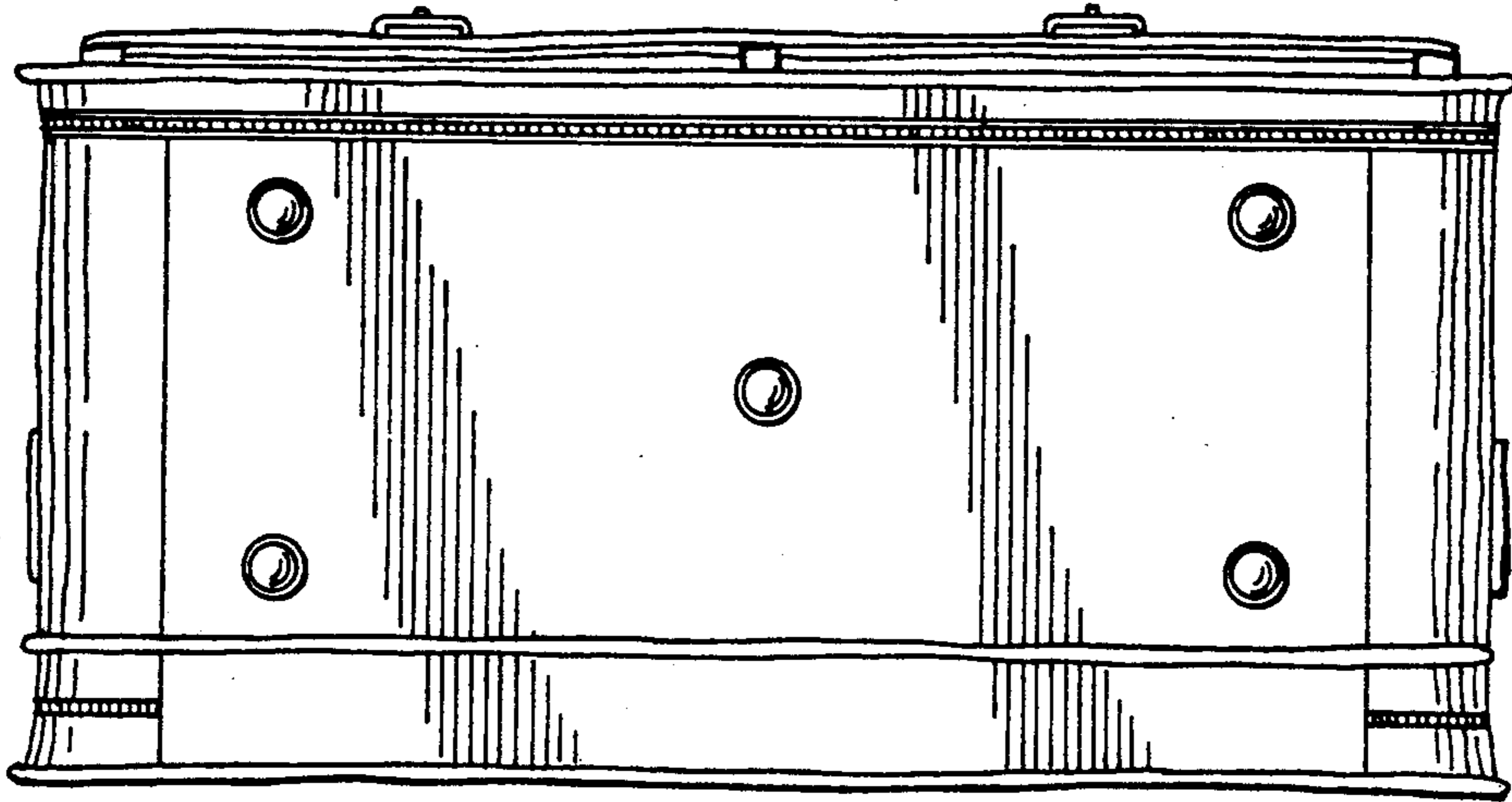

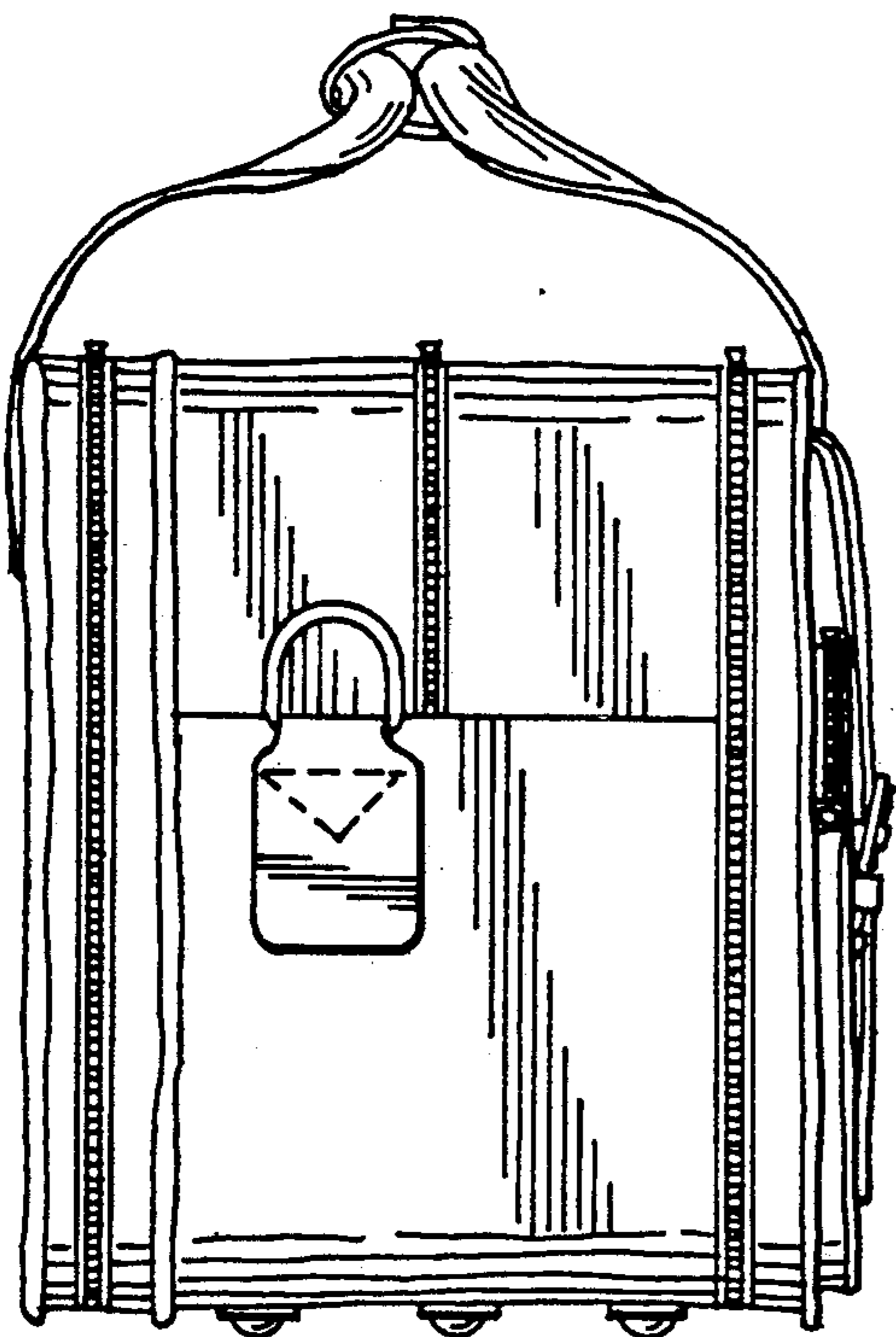
