FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an auxiliary safety seat for use primarily in a high chair showing my new design;

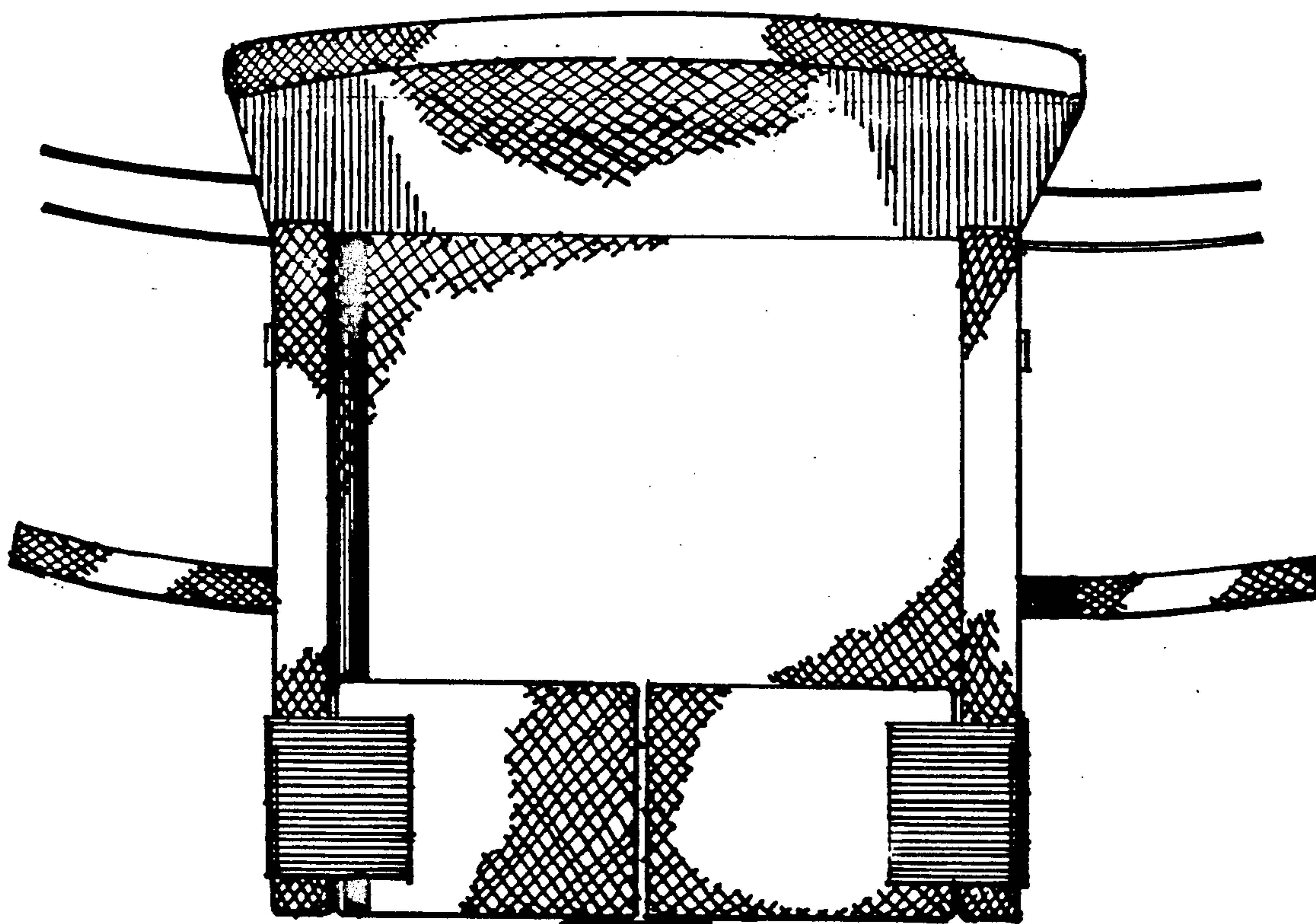
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



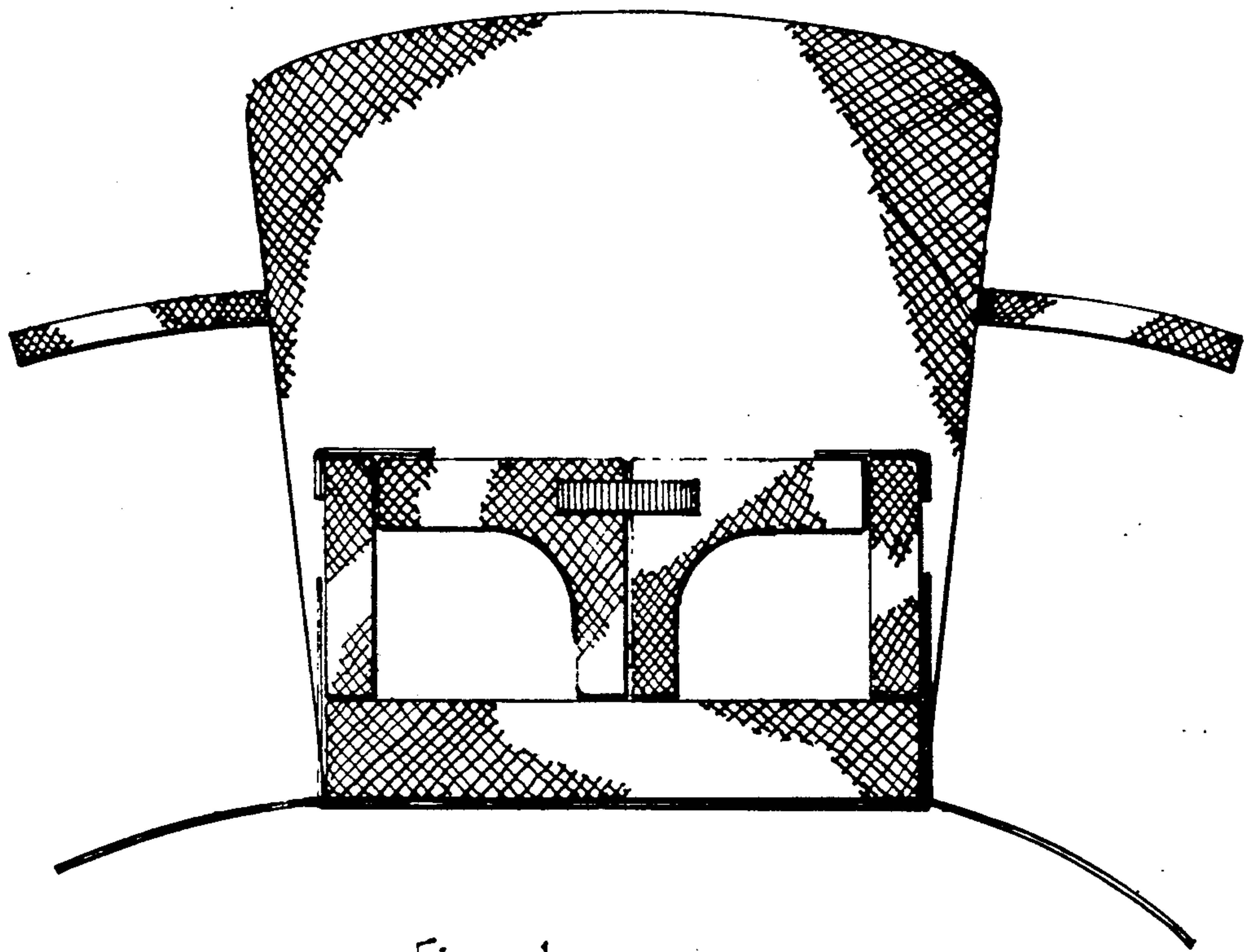

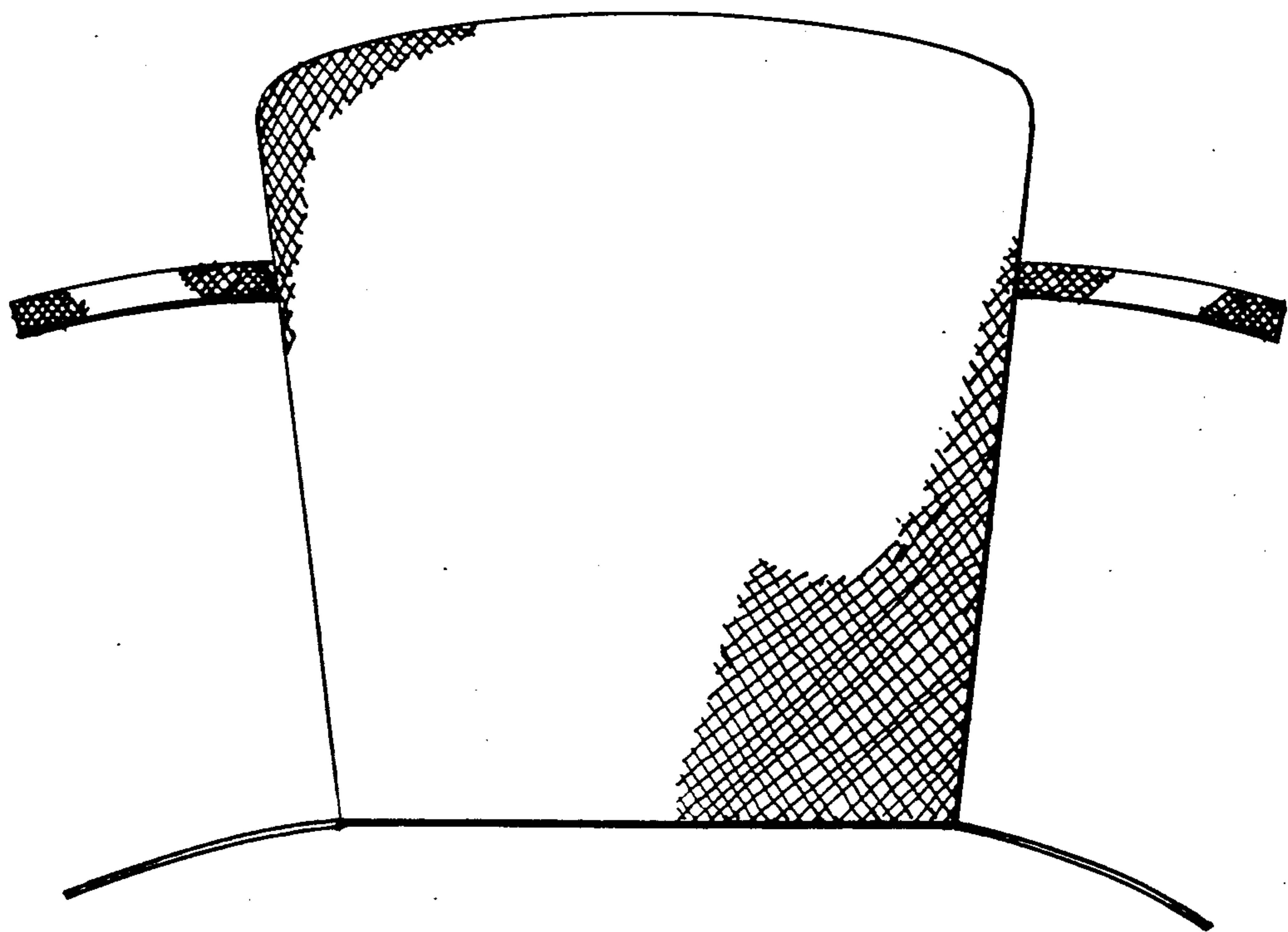

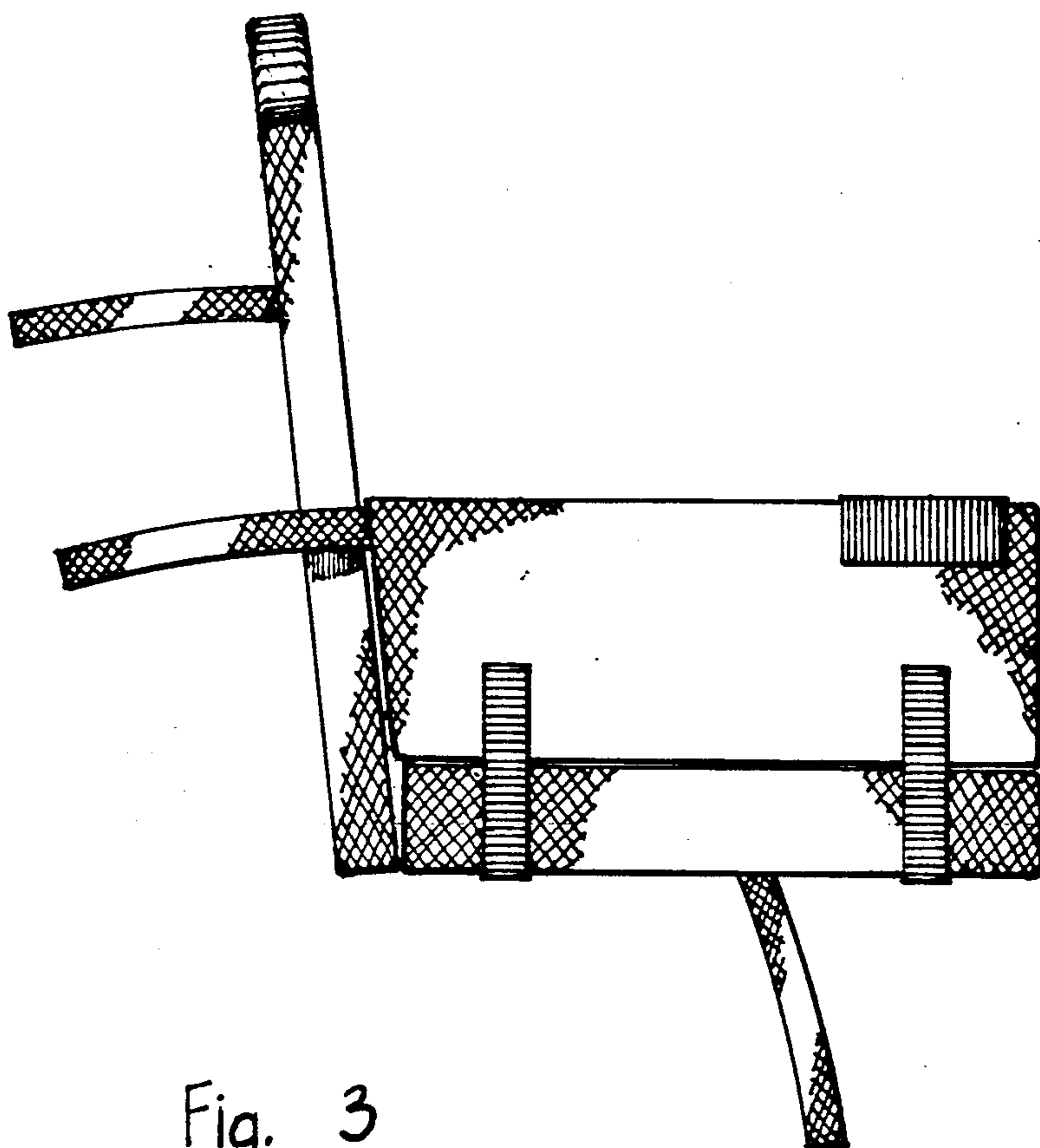

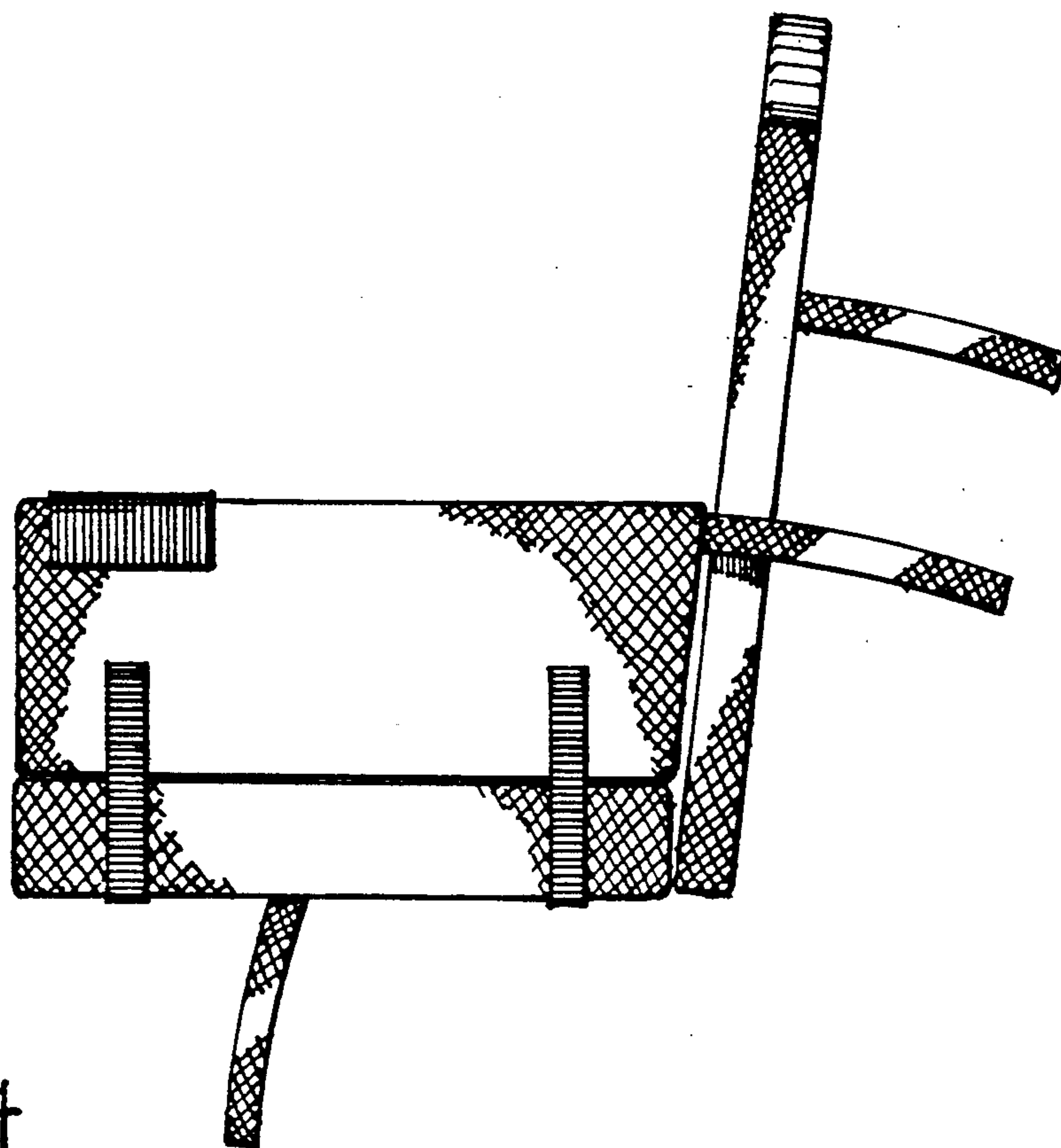

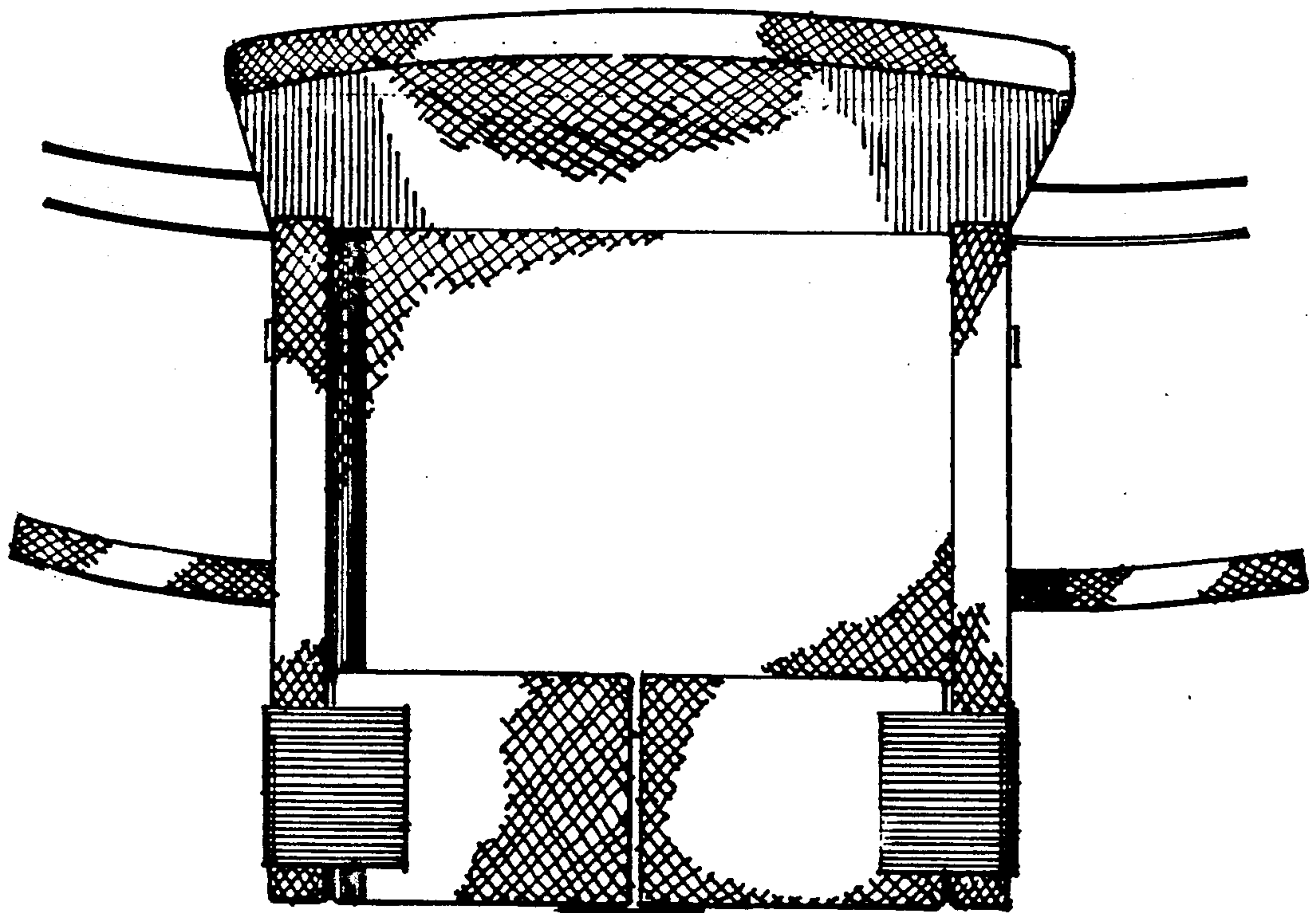

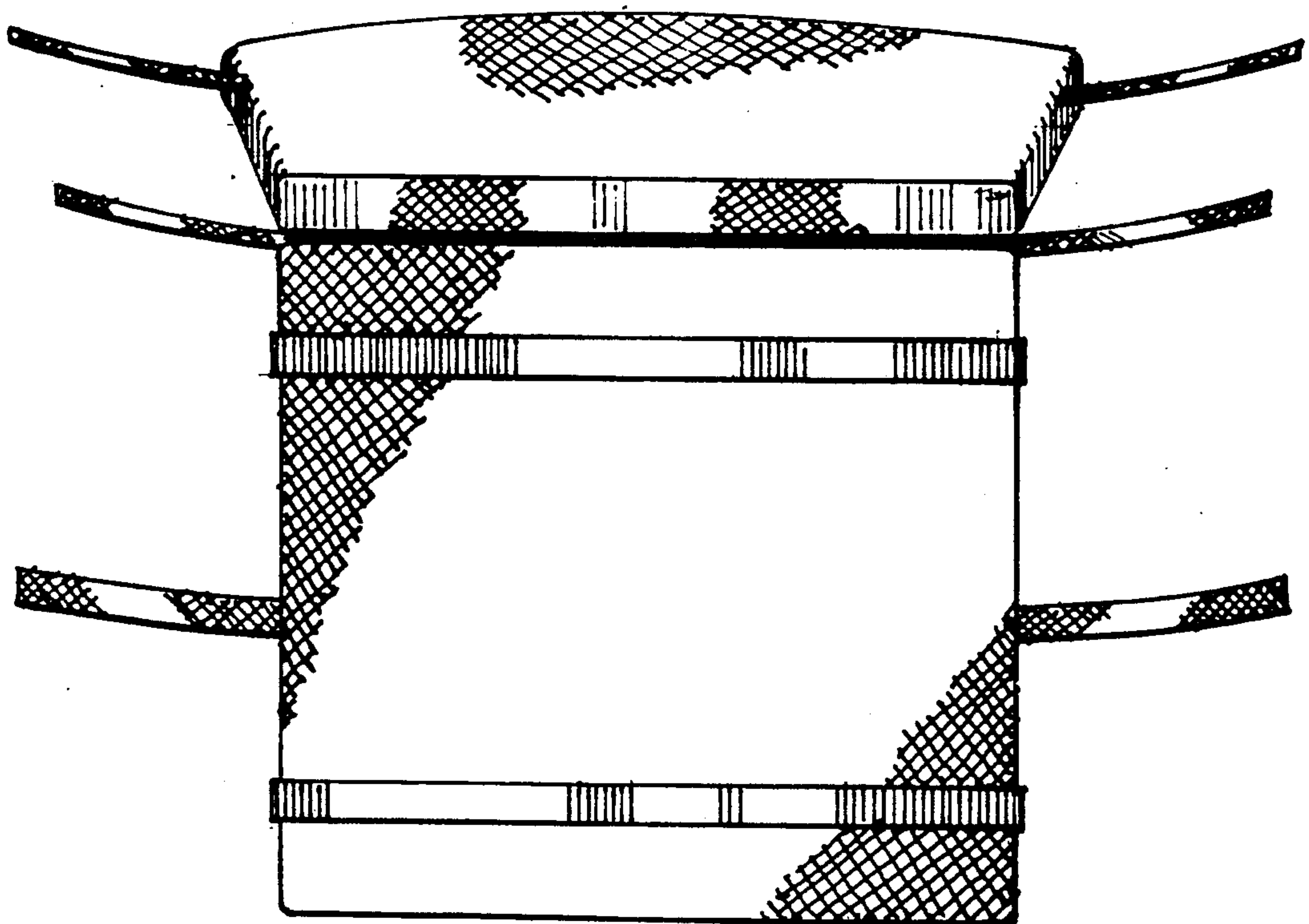
