The electric cord is shown broken away in FIGS. 2-6 for ease of illustration and is understood to represent indeterminate length.

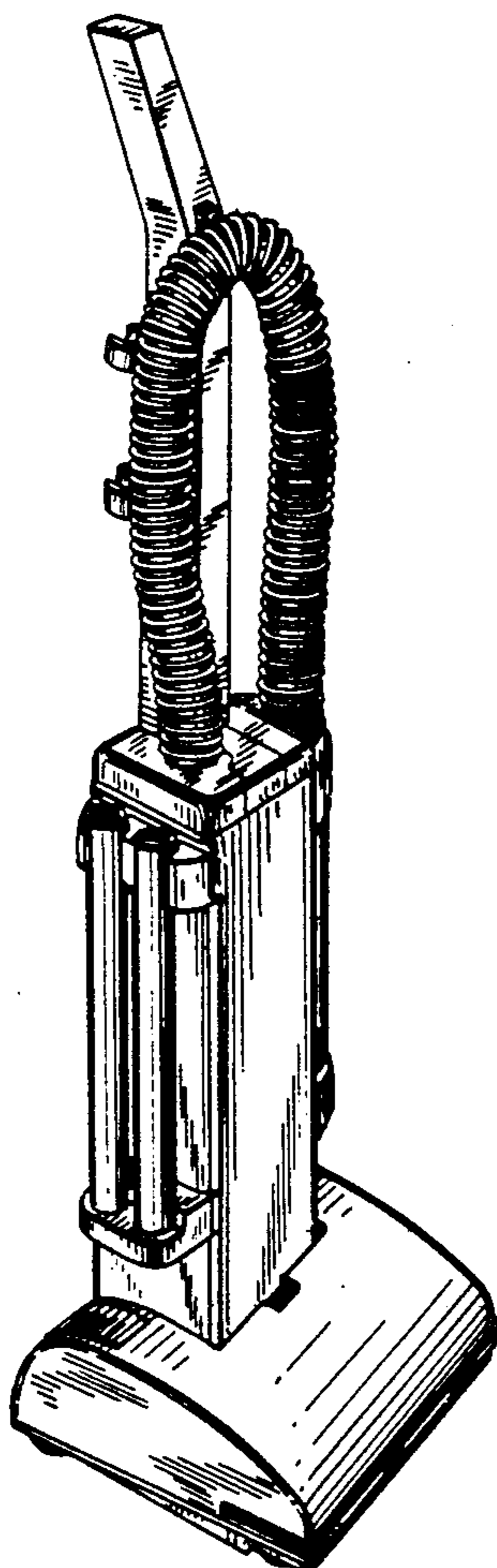

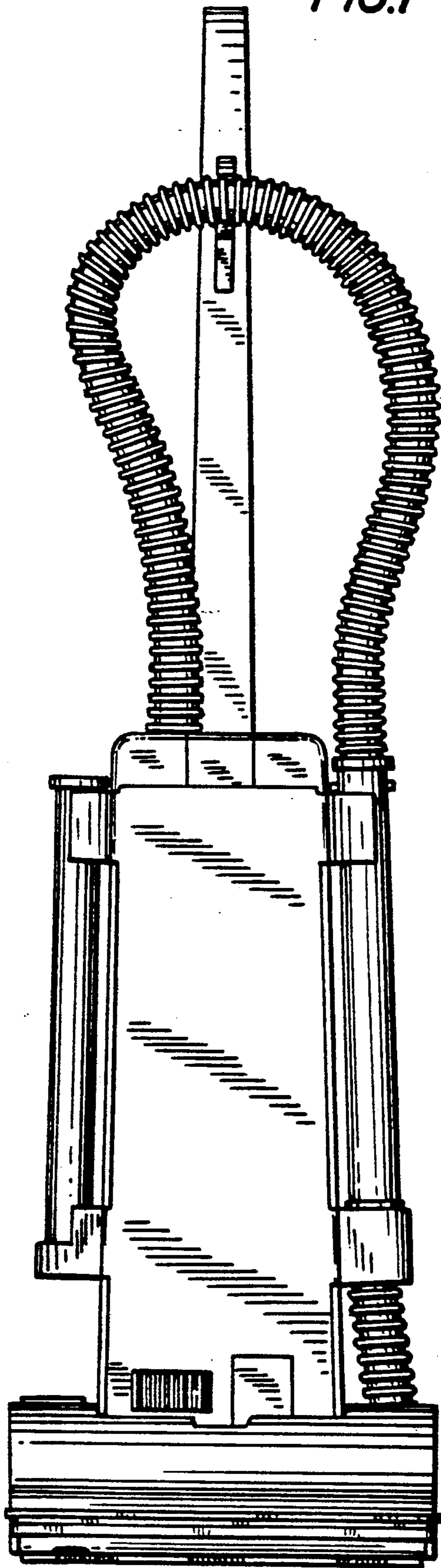
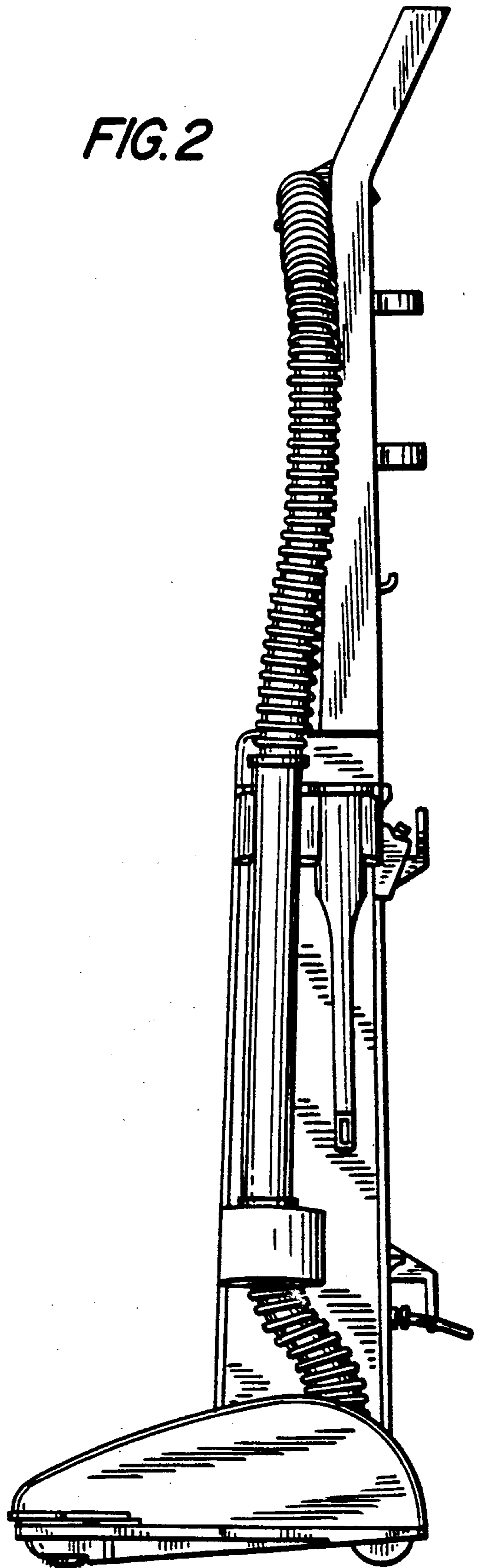
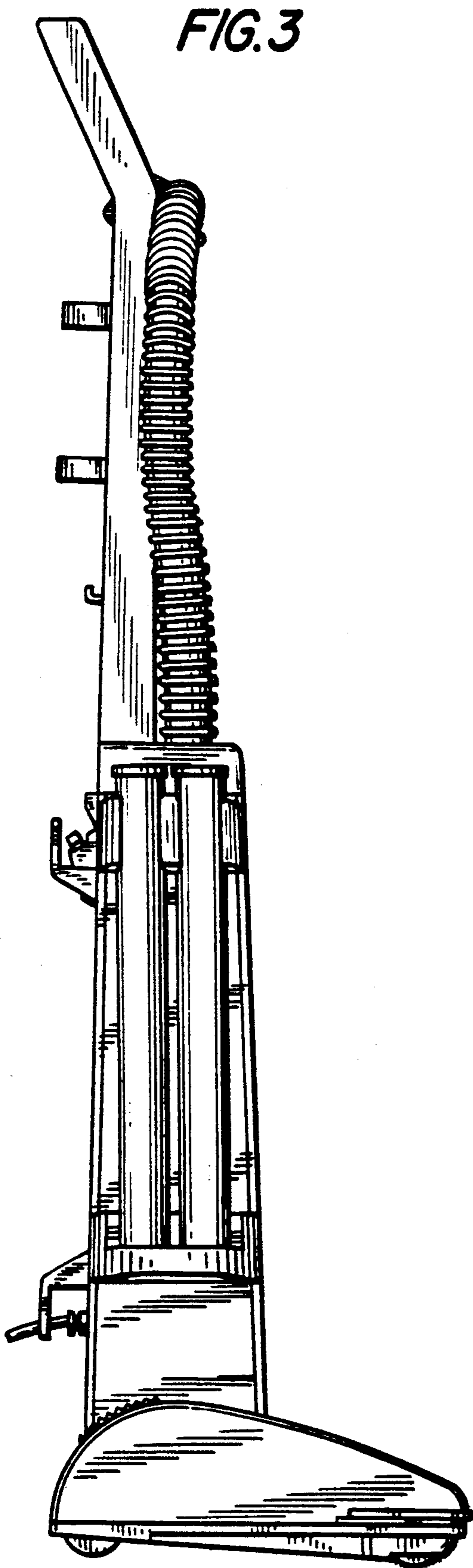
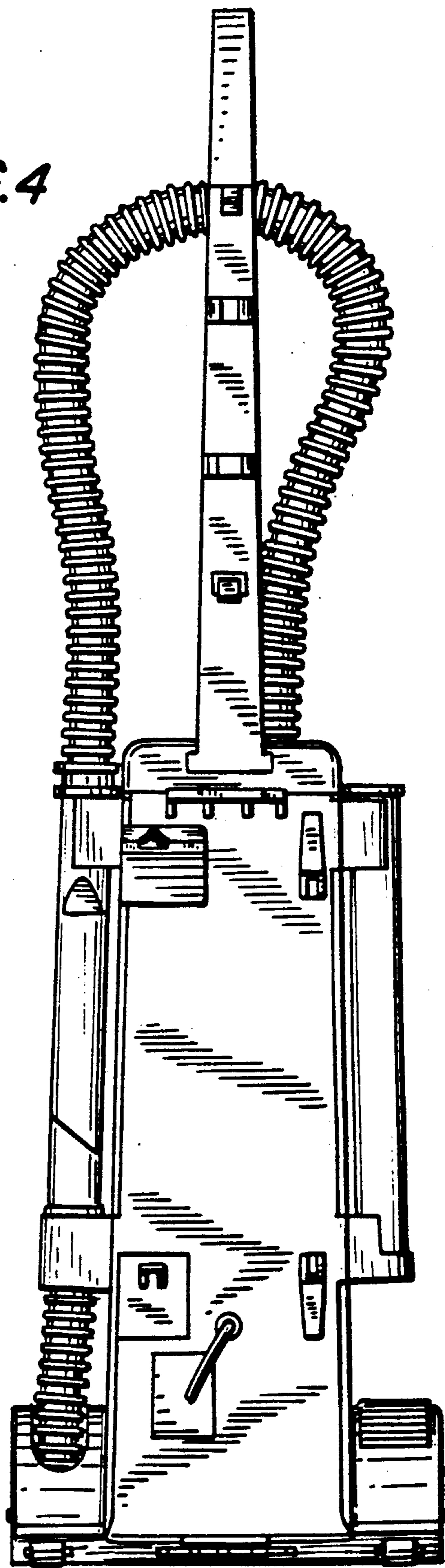

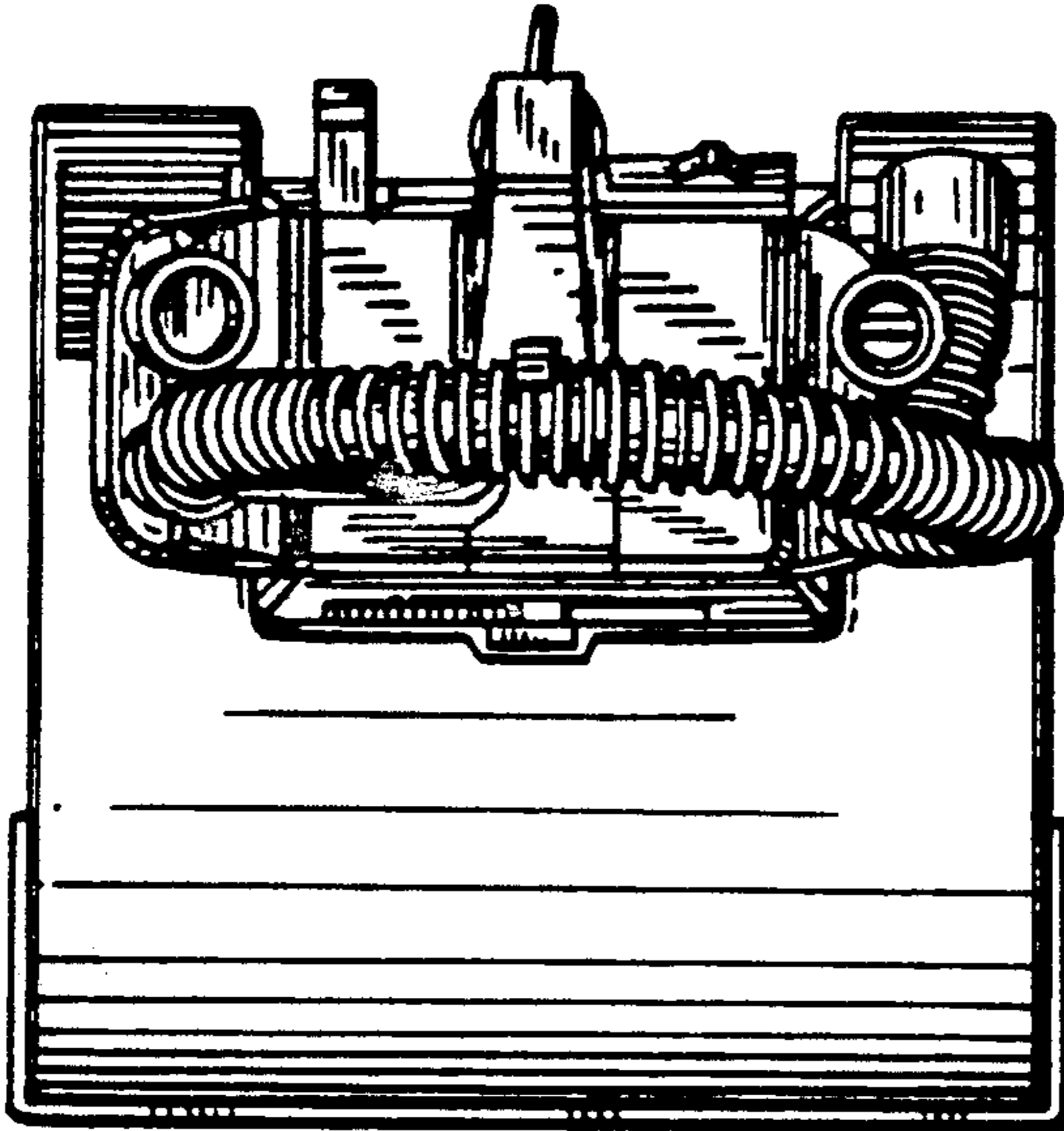




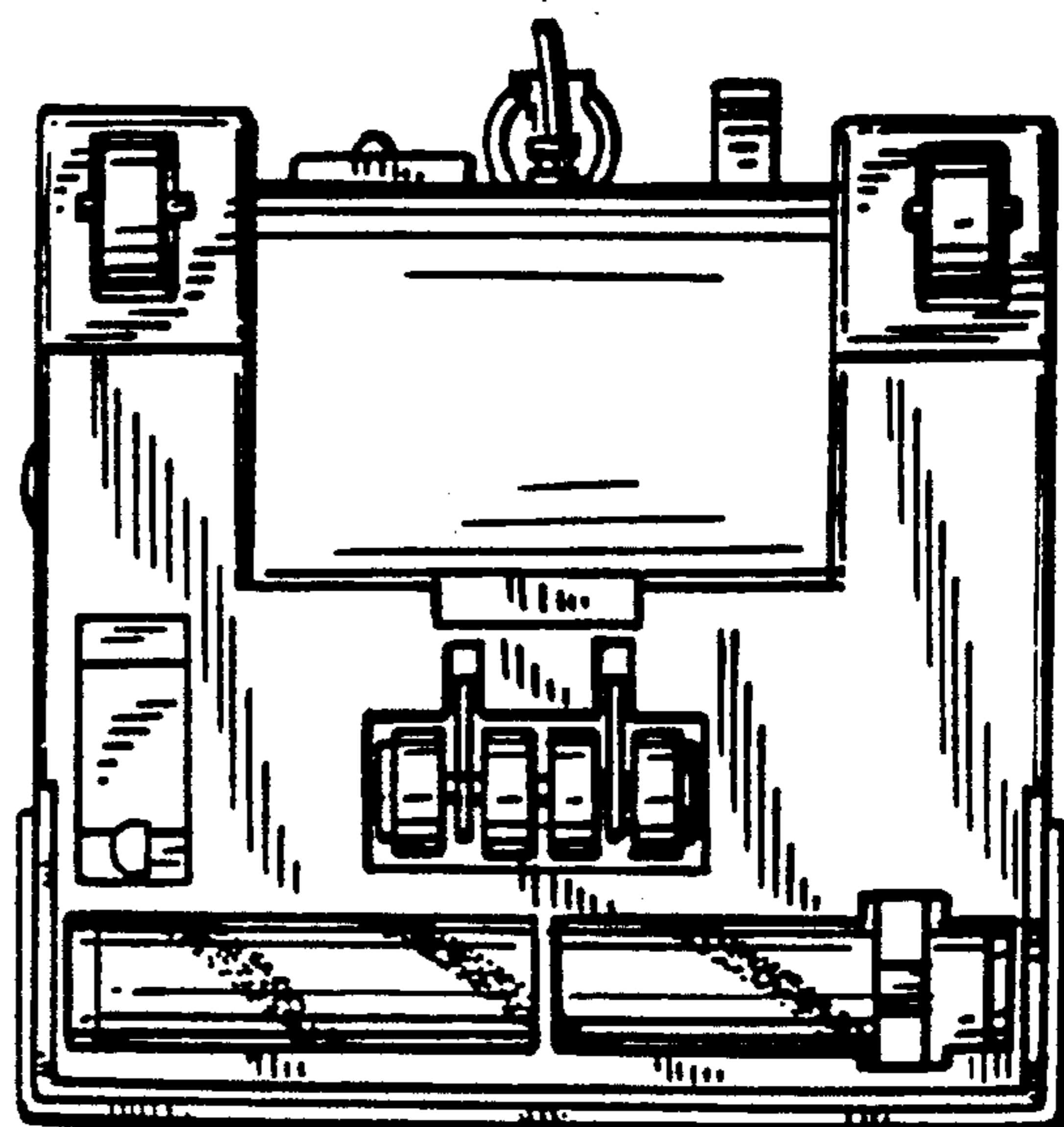

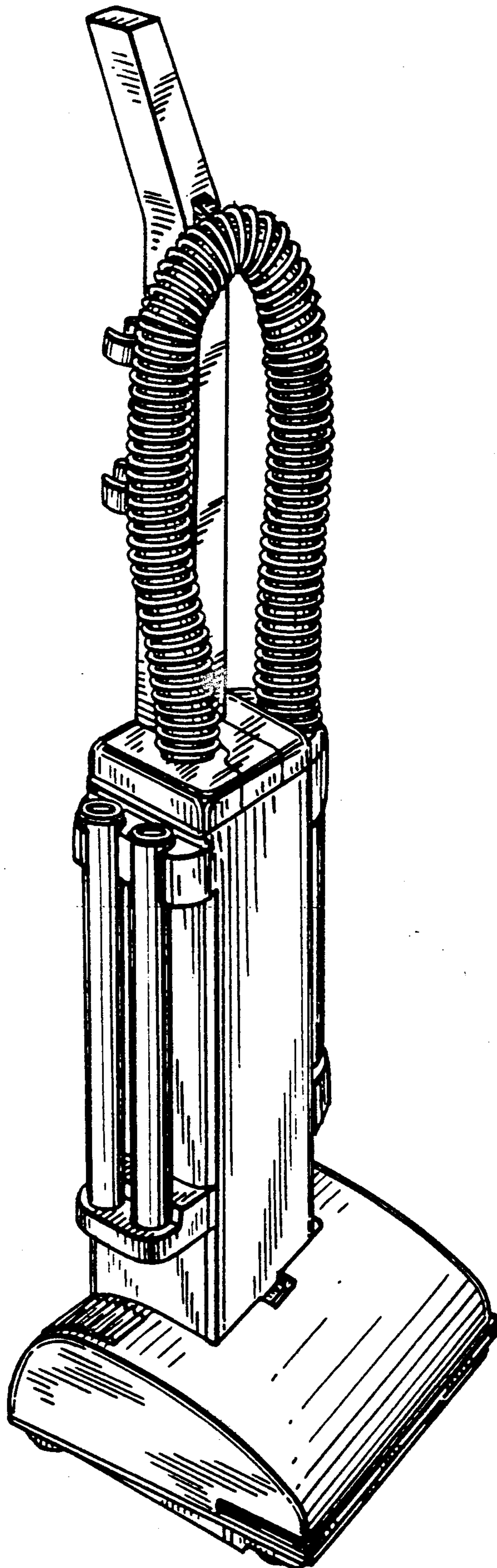
