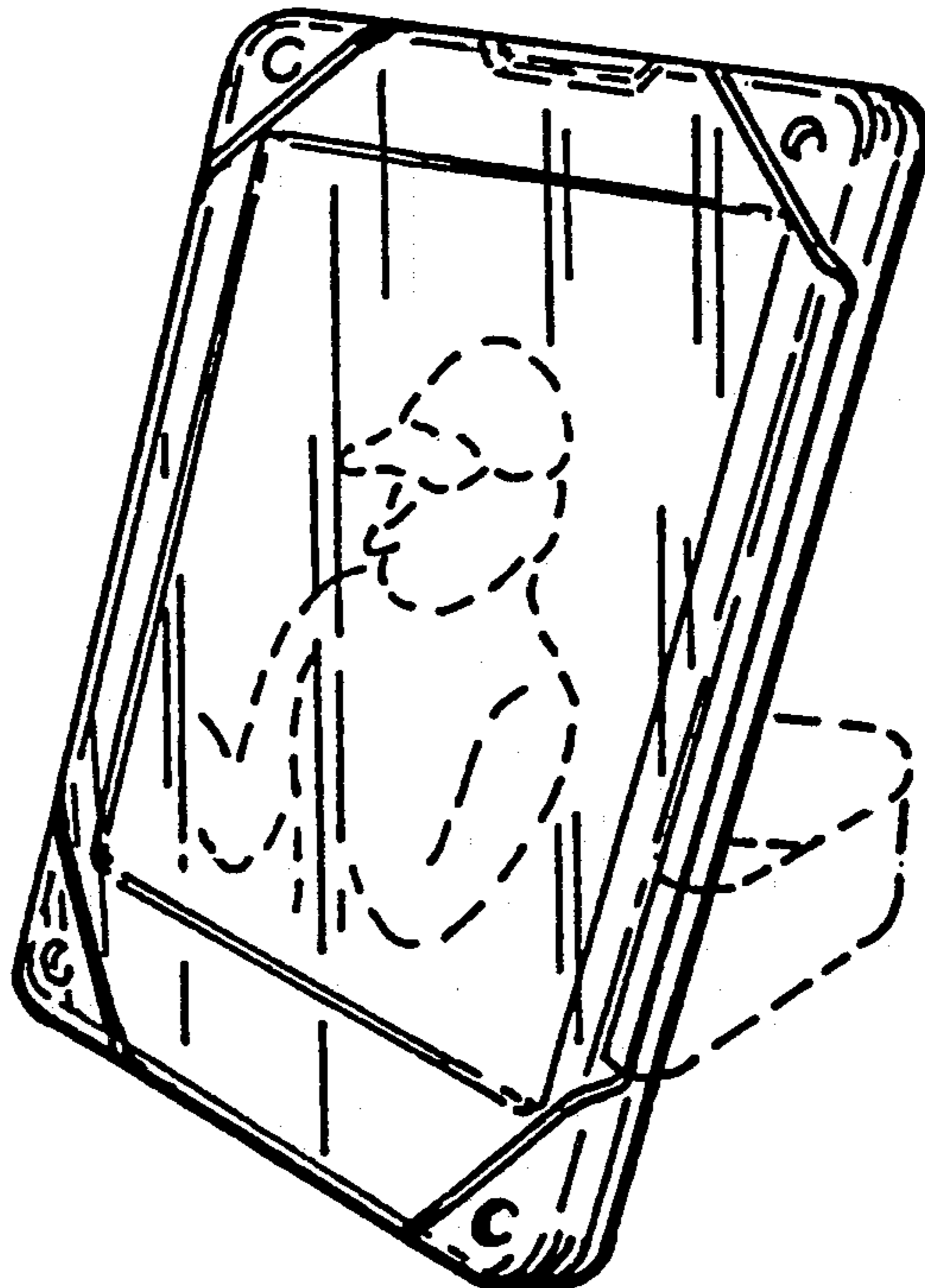

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a display unit or the like showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The support stand and person are shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.



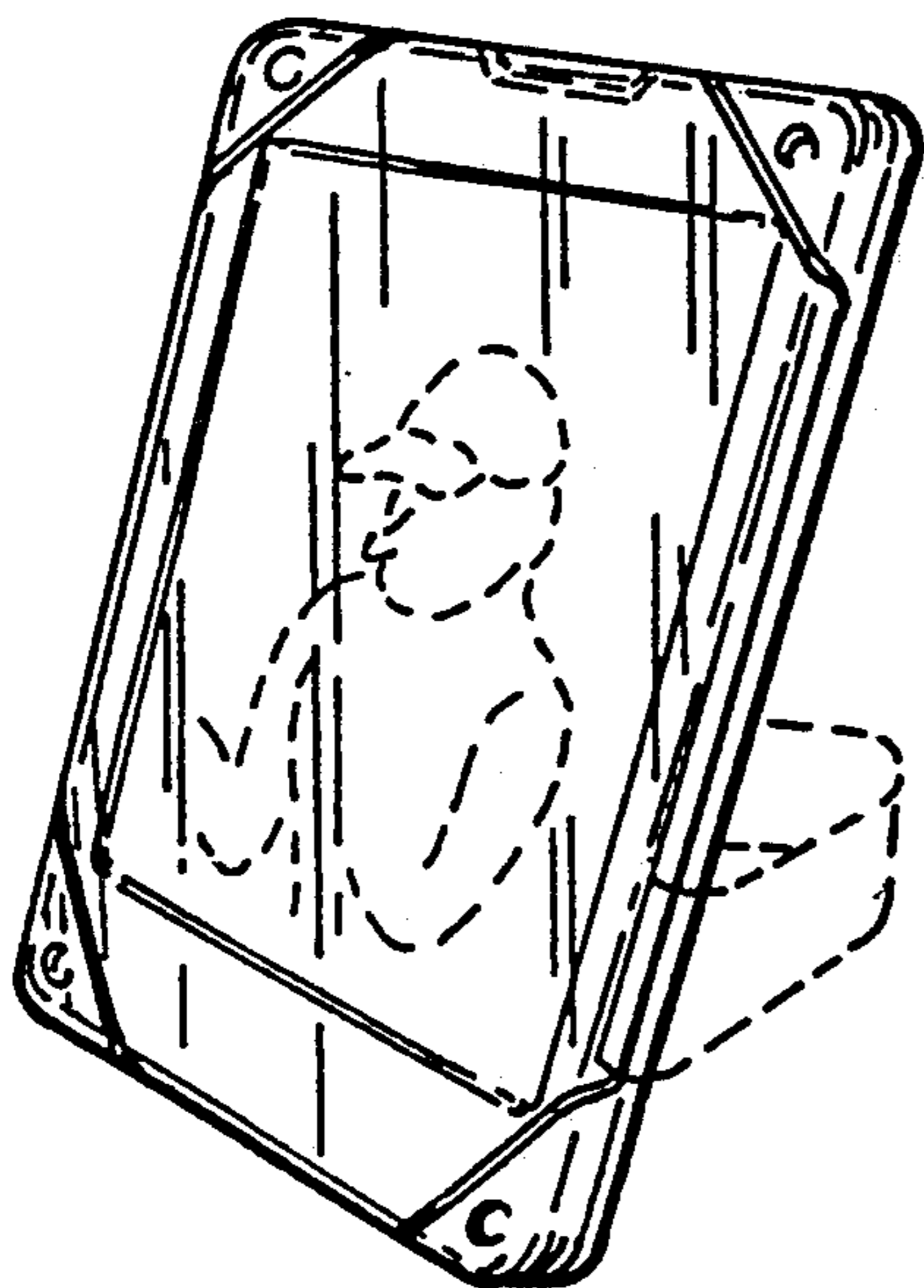

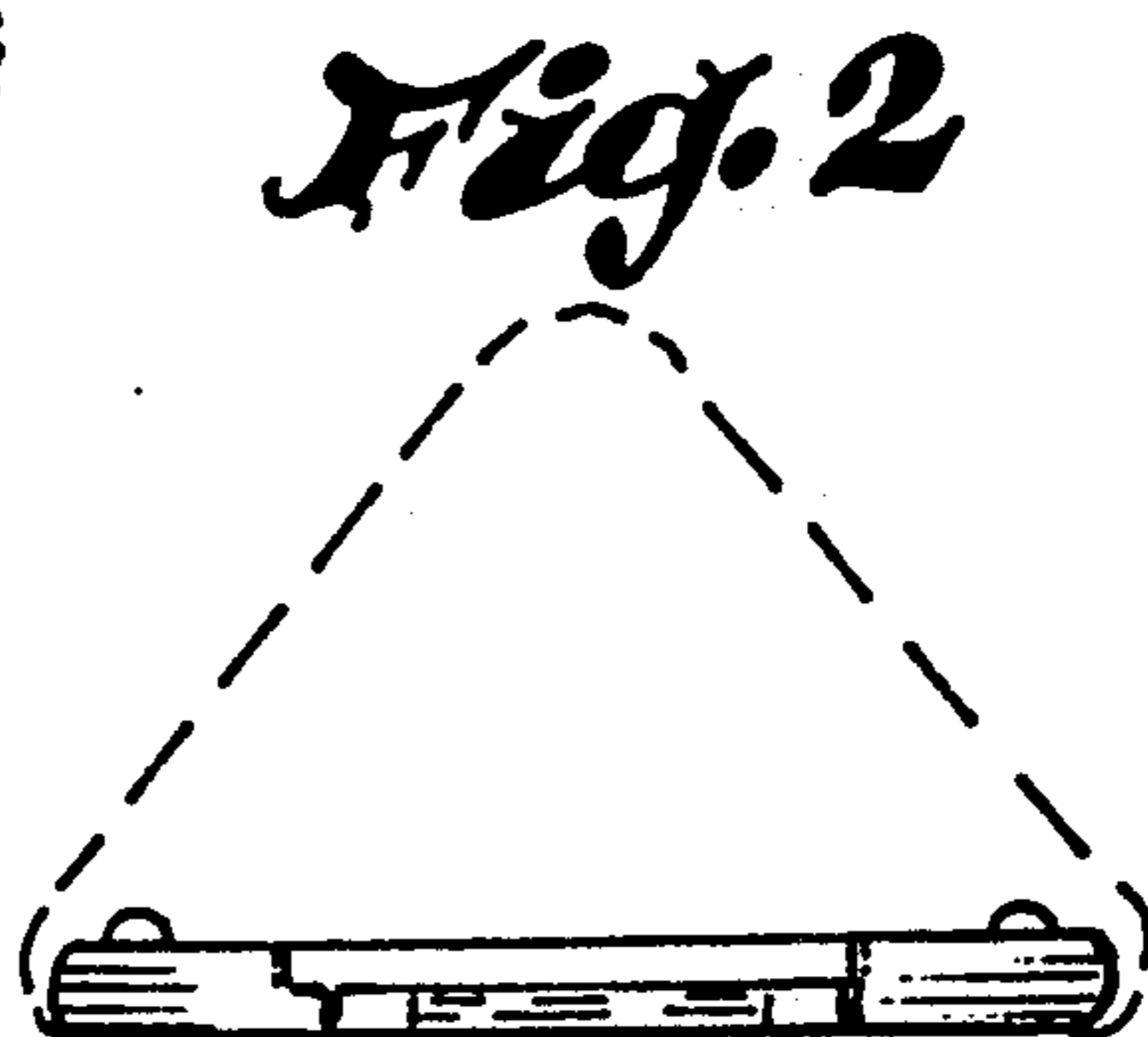

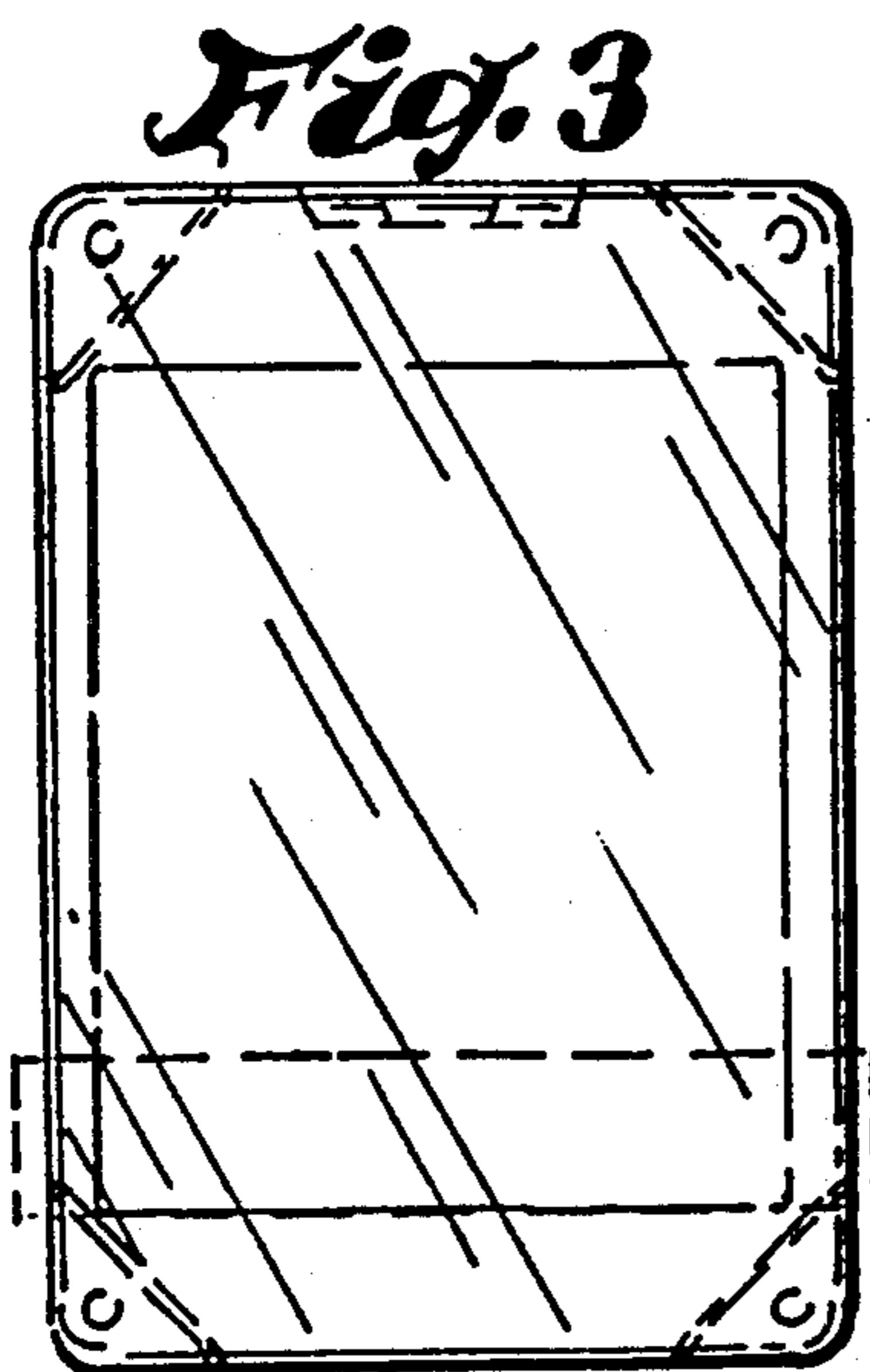

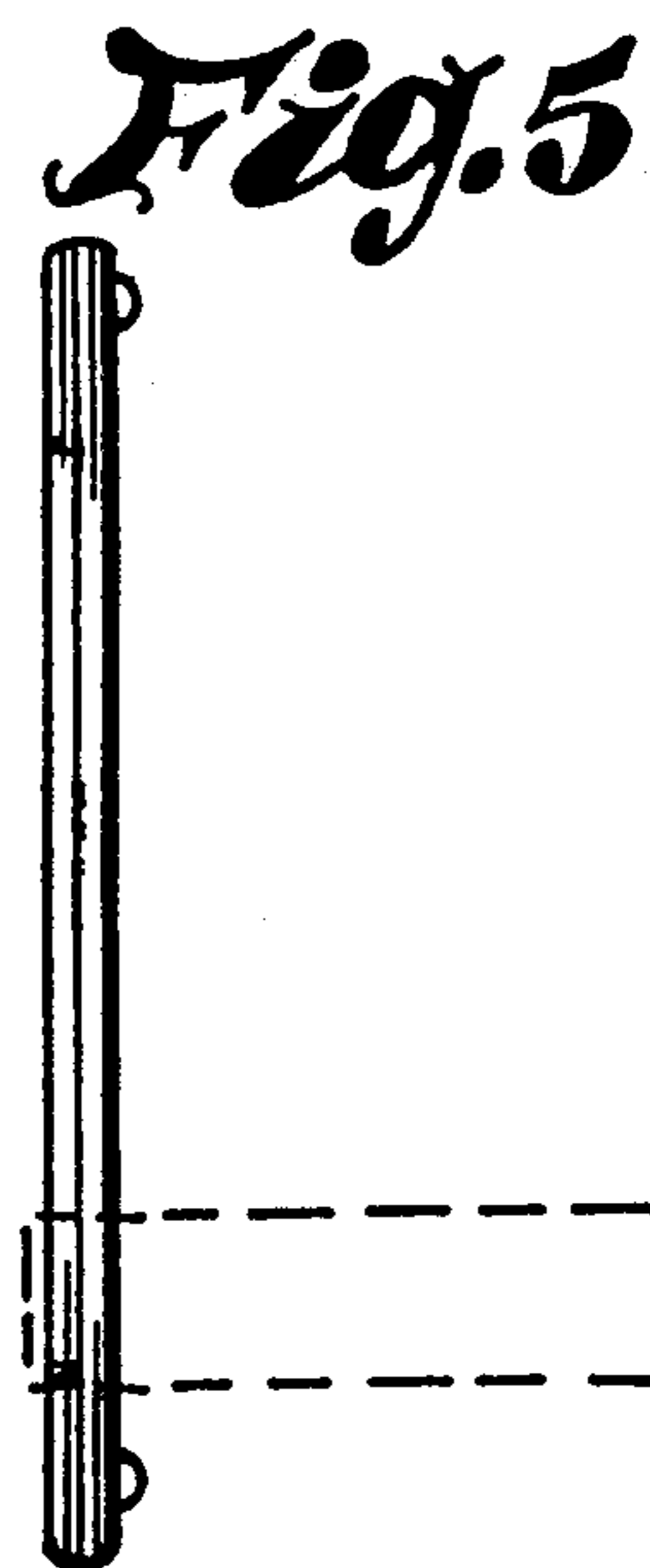

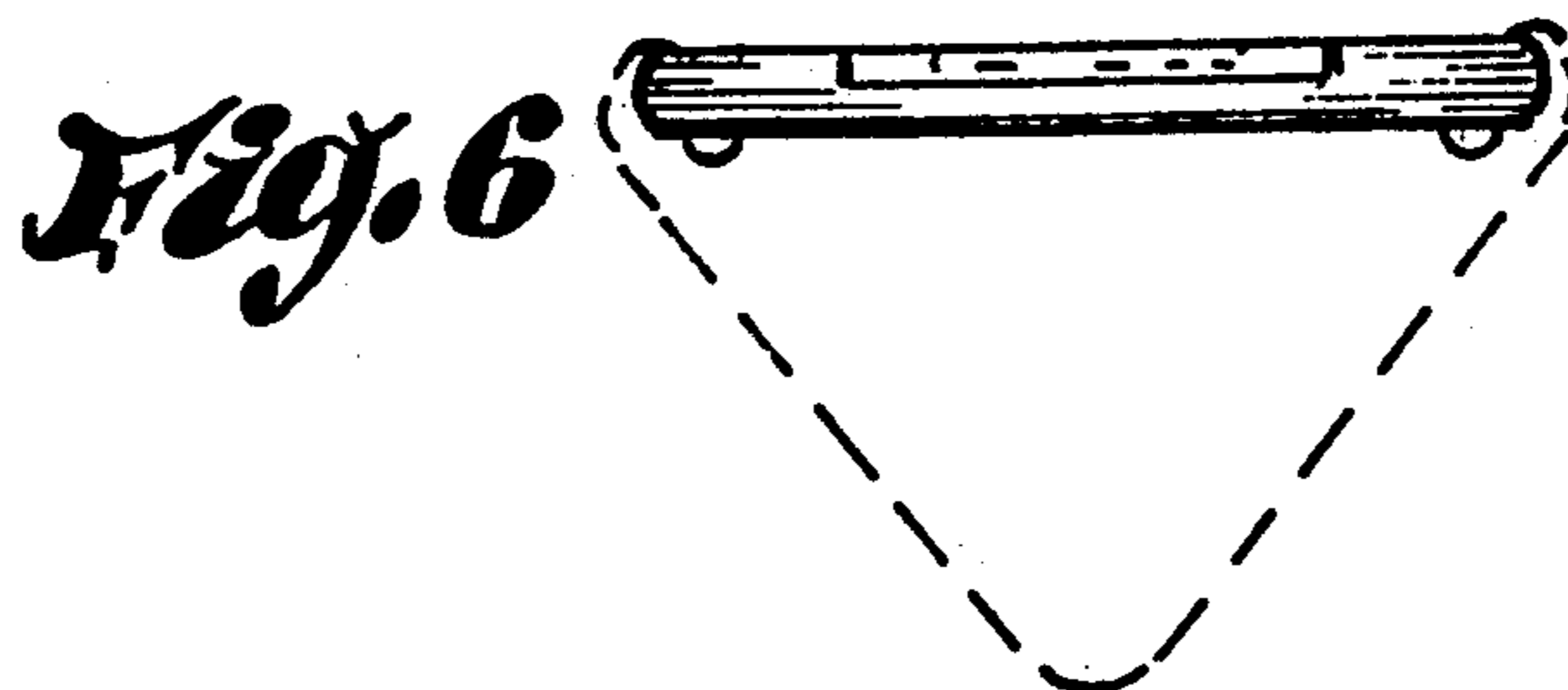
