The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

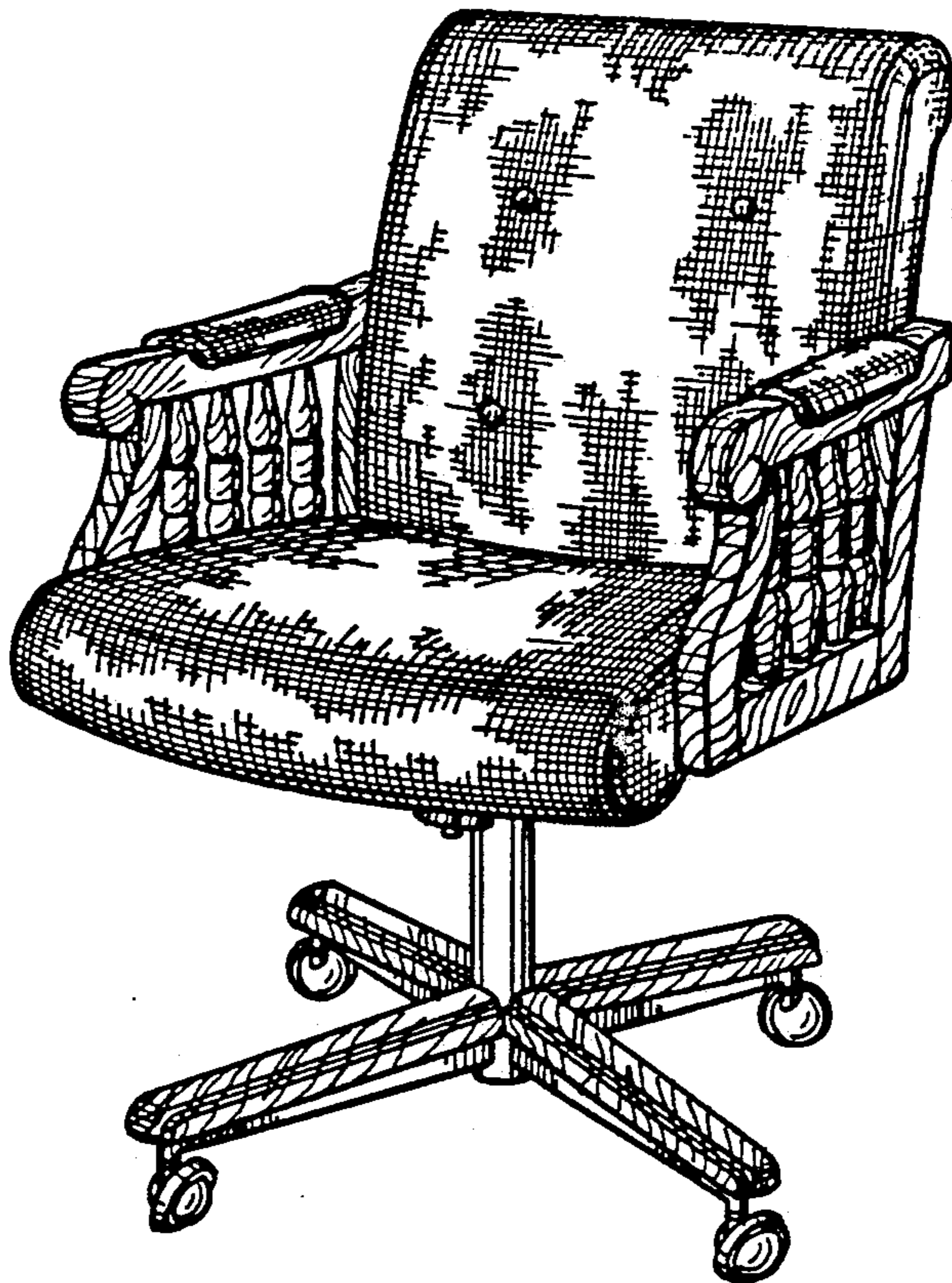
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof on an enlarged scale.



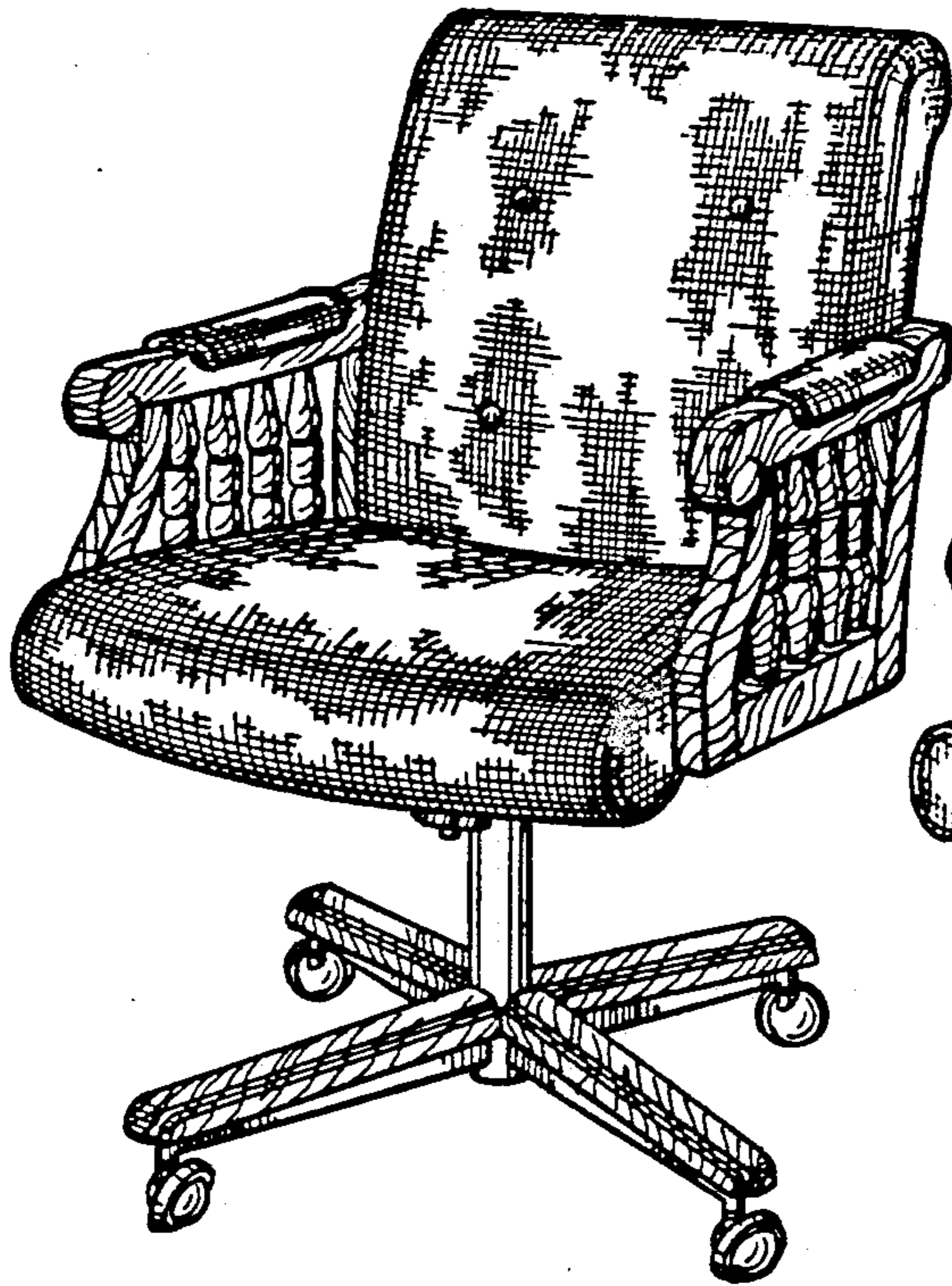

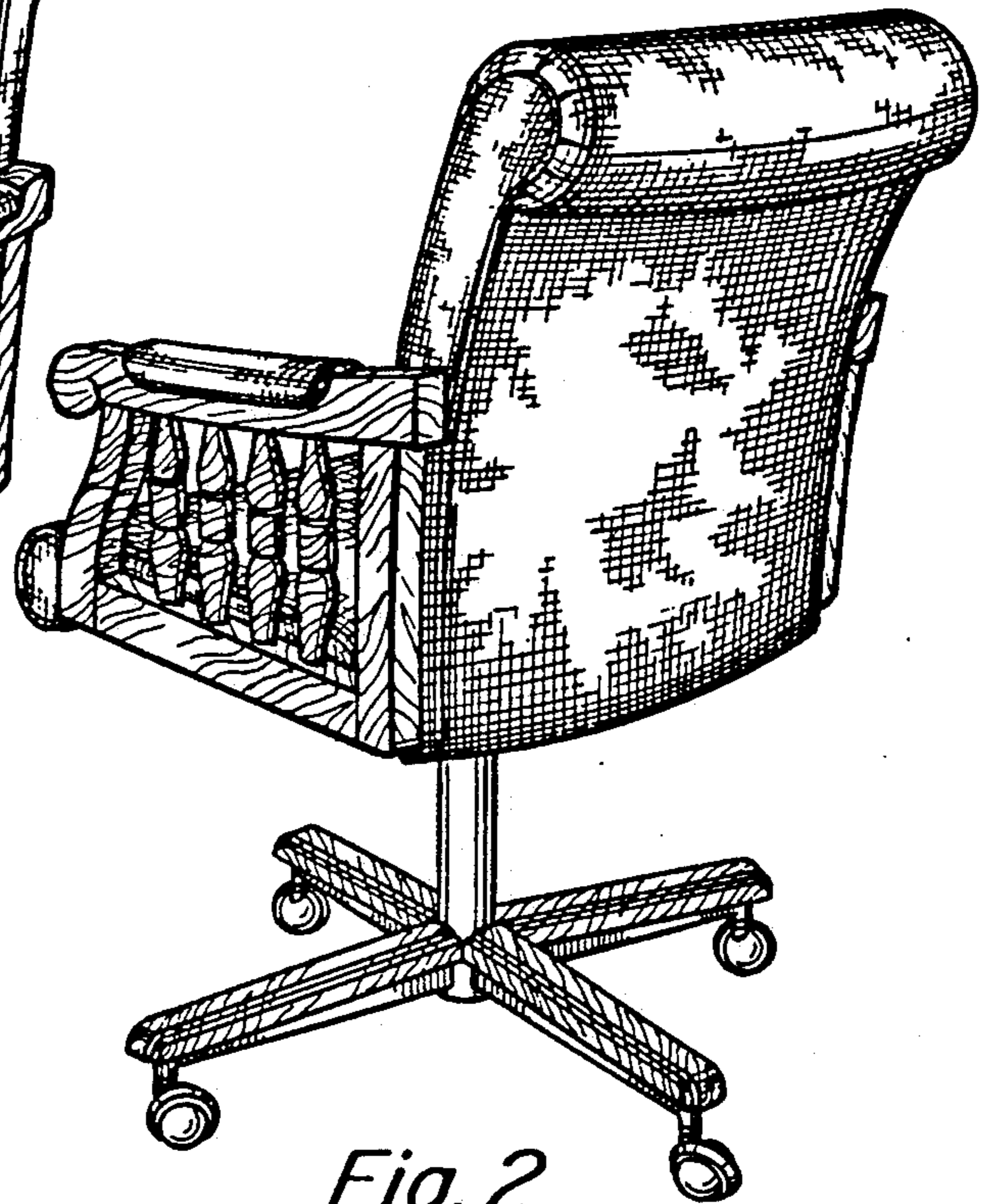

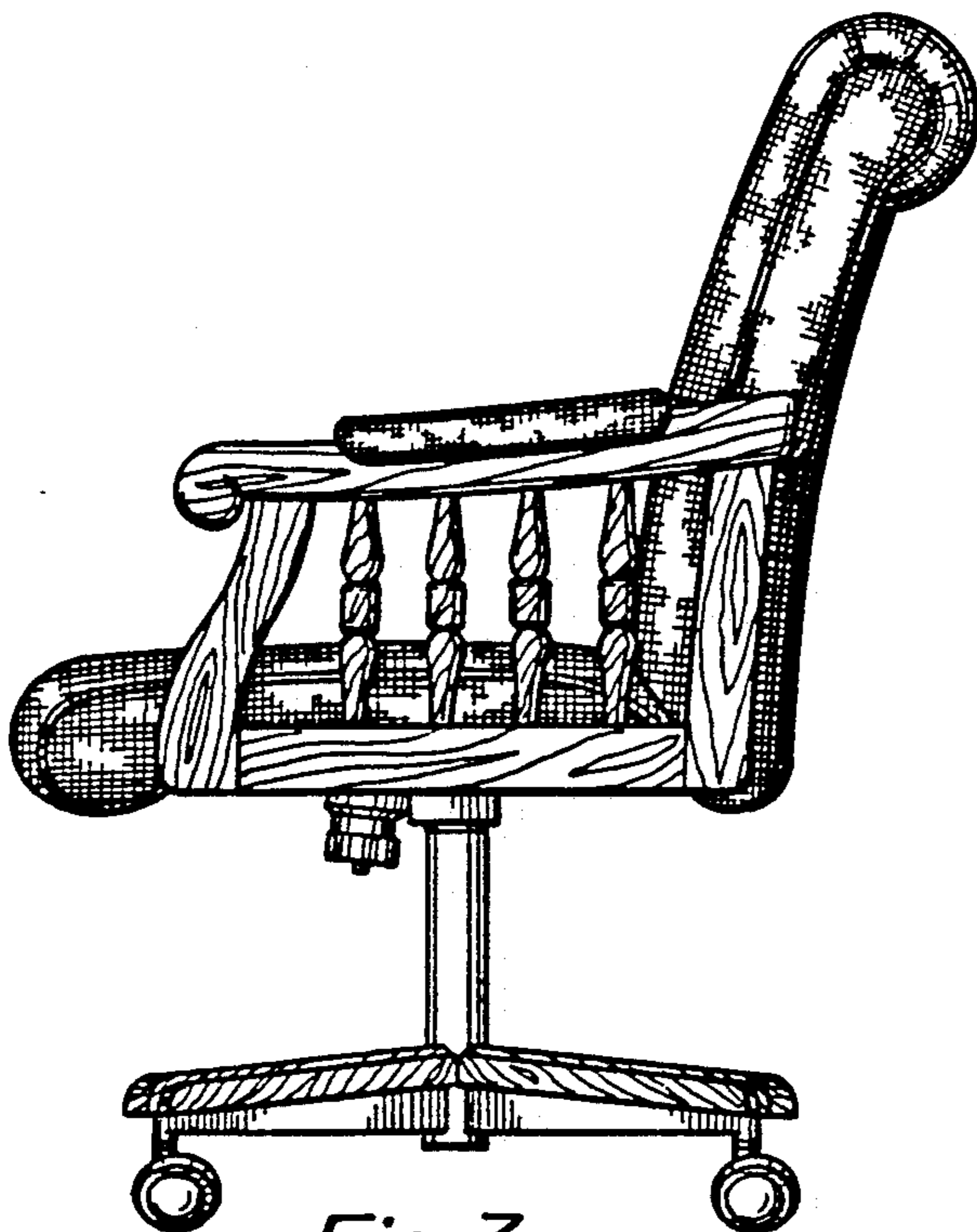

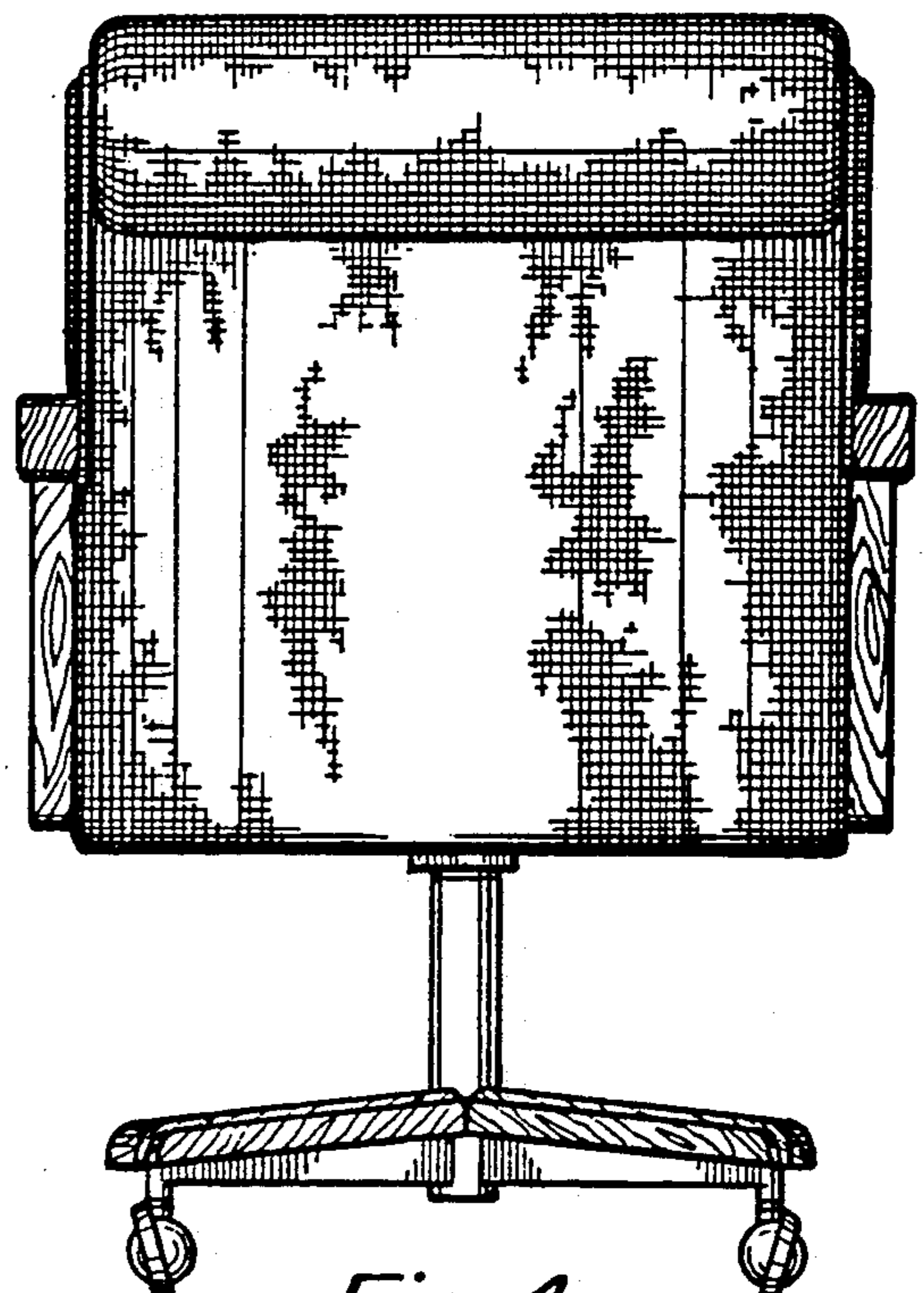
