The ornamental design for a support bracket for a vertical article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side, top and front perspective view of a support bracket for a vertical article showing my new design;

FIGS. 2 and 3 are respectively front and rear elevational views thereof;

FIGS. 4 and 5 are respectively top and bottom plan views thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image;

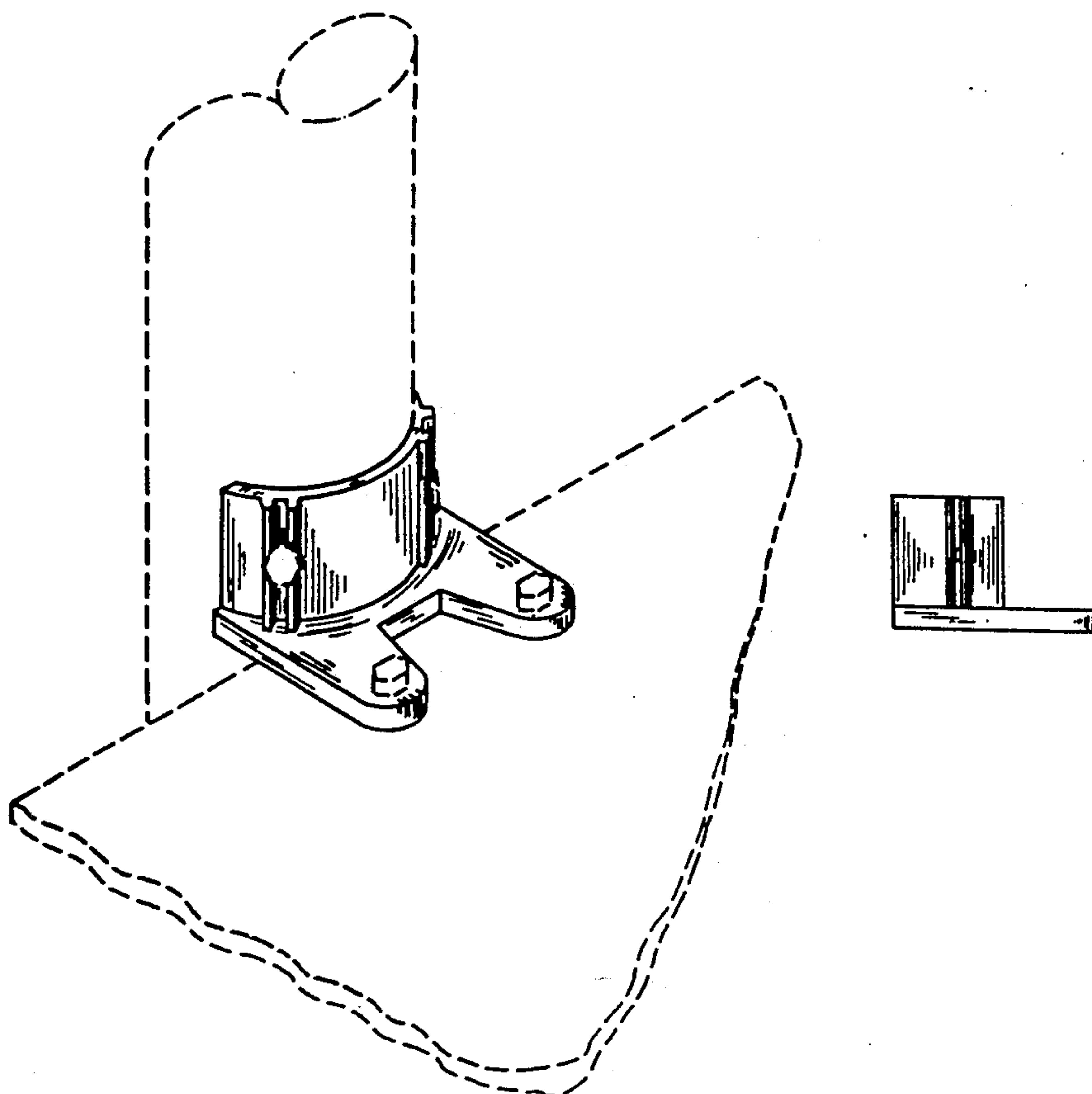
FIG. 7 is a left side, top and front perspective view of a second embodiment thereof;

FIGS. 8 and 9 are front and rear elevational views thereof;

FIGS. 10 and 11 top and bottom plan views thereof; and

The broken line showing of vertical and horizontal areas in FIGS. 1 and 7 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



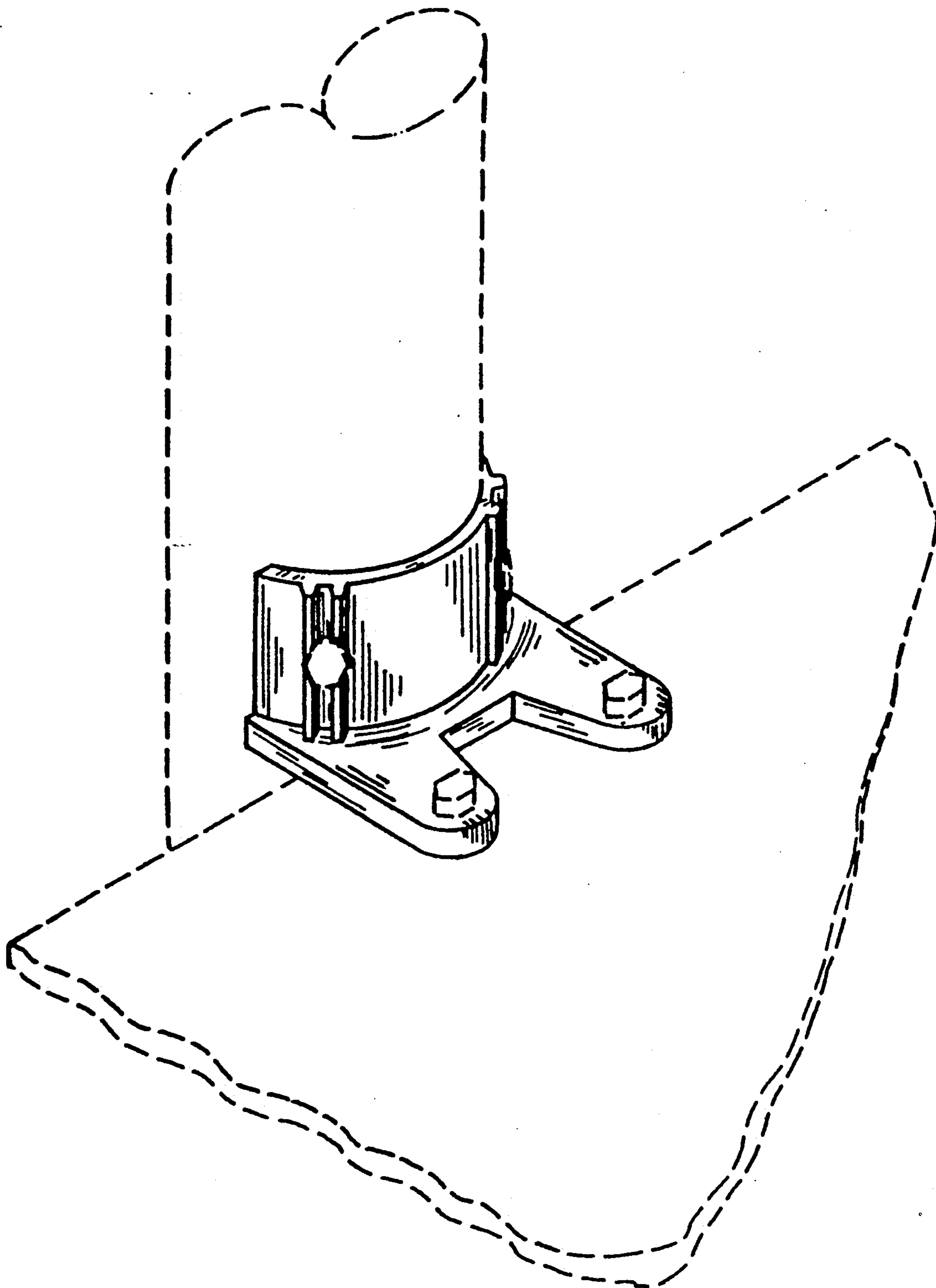

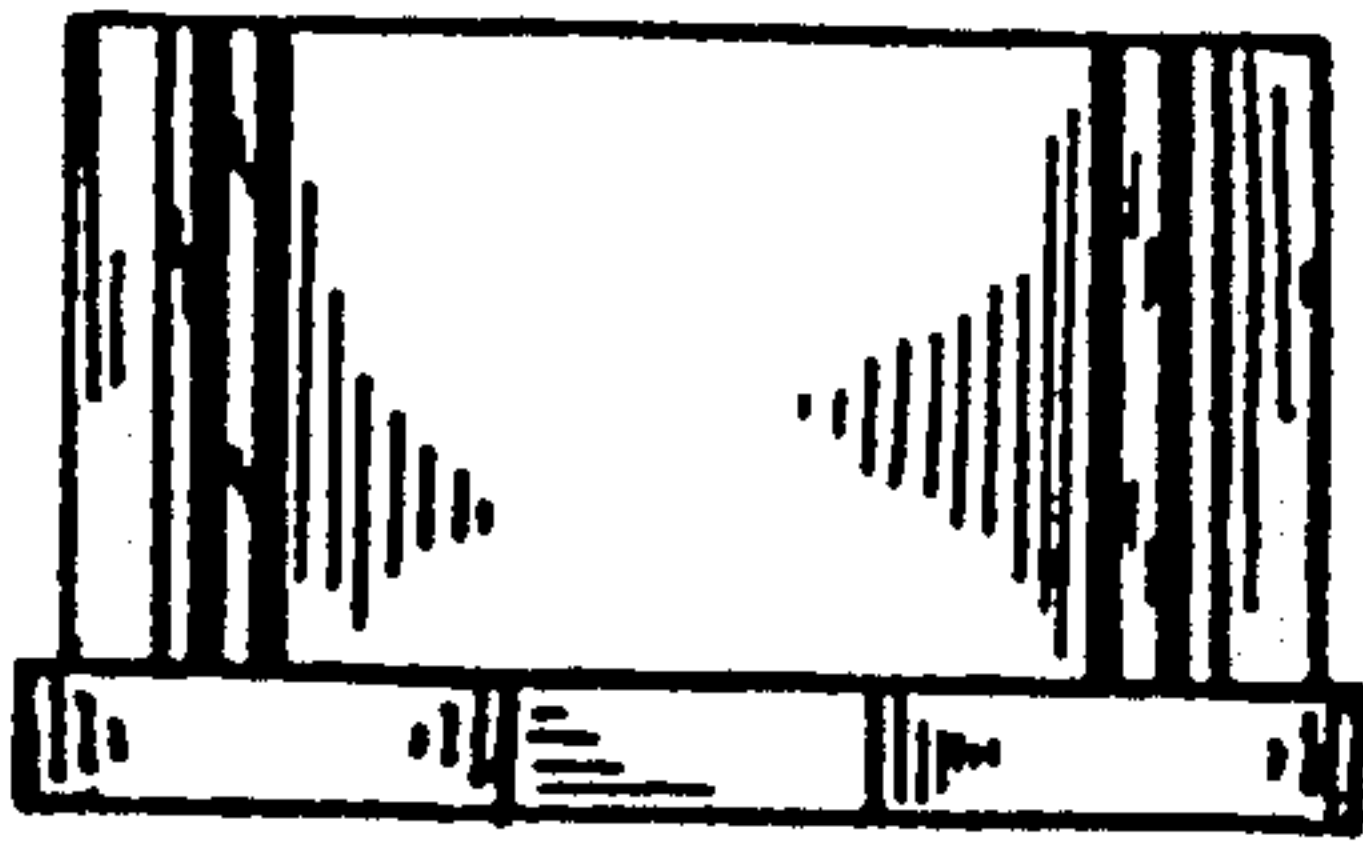

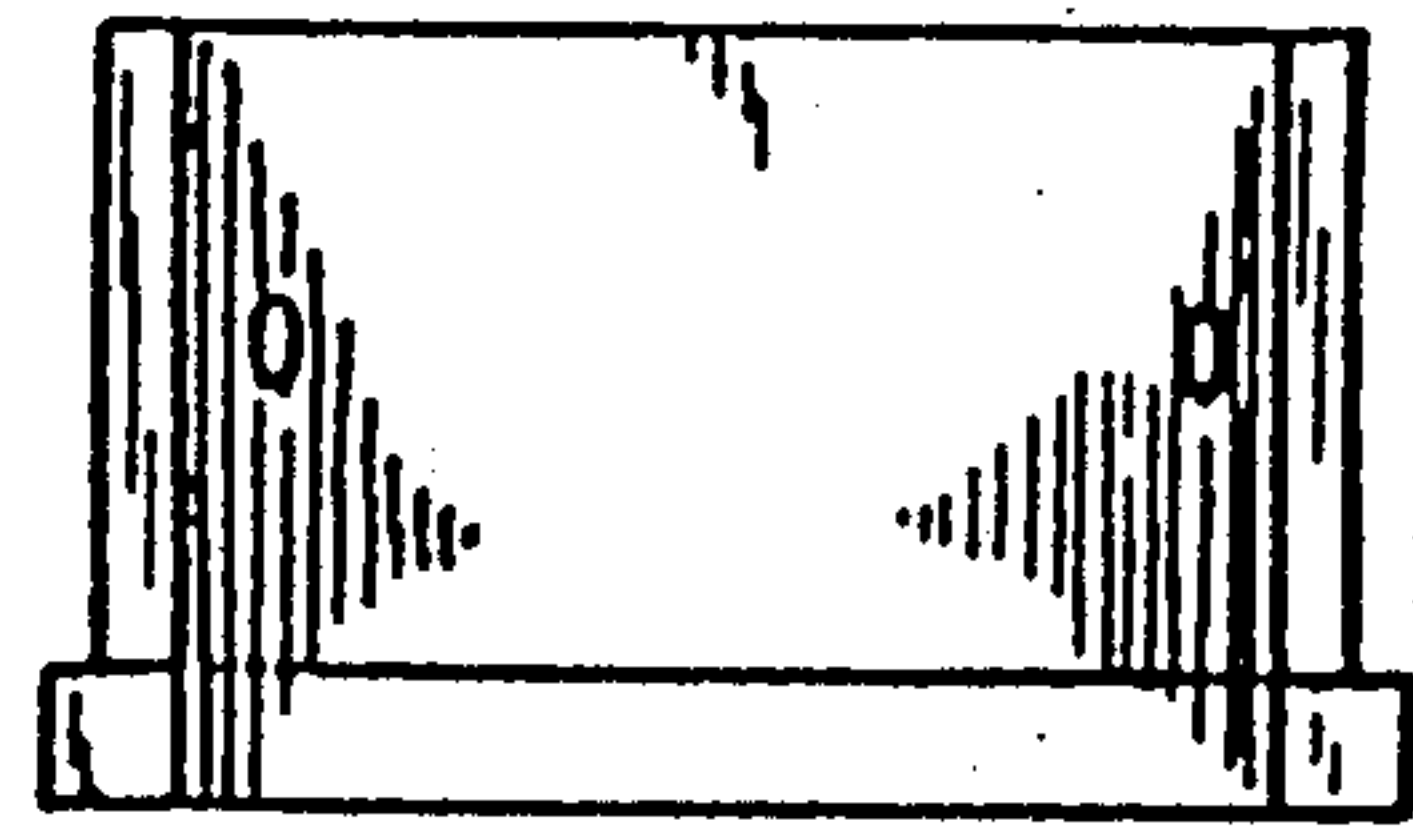

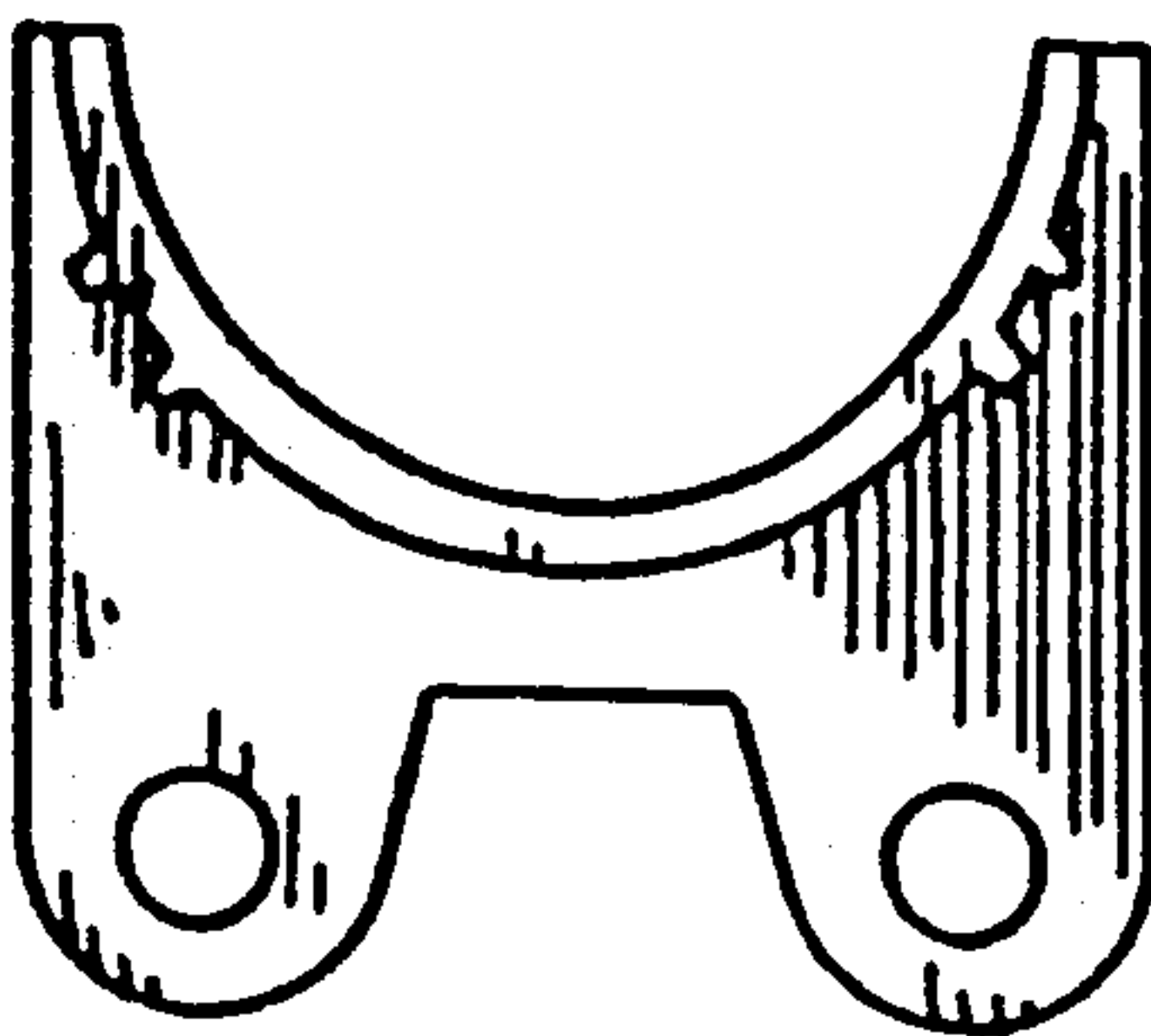

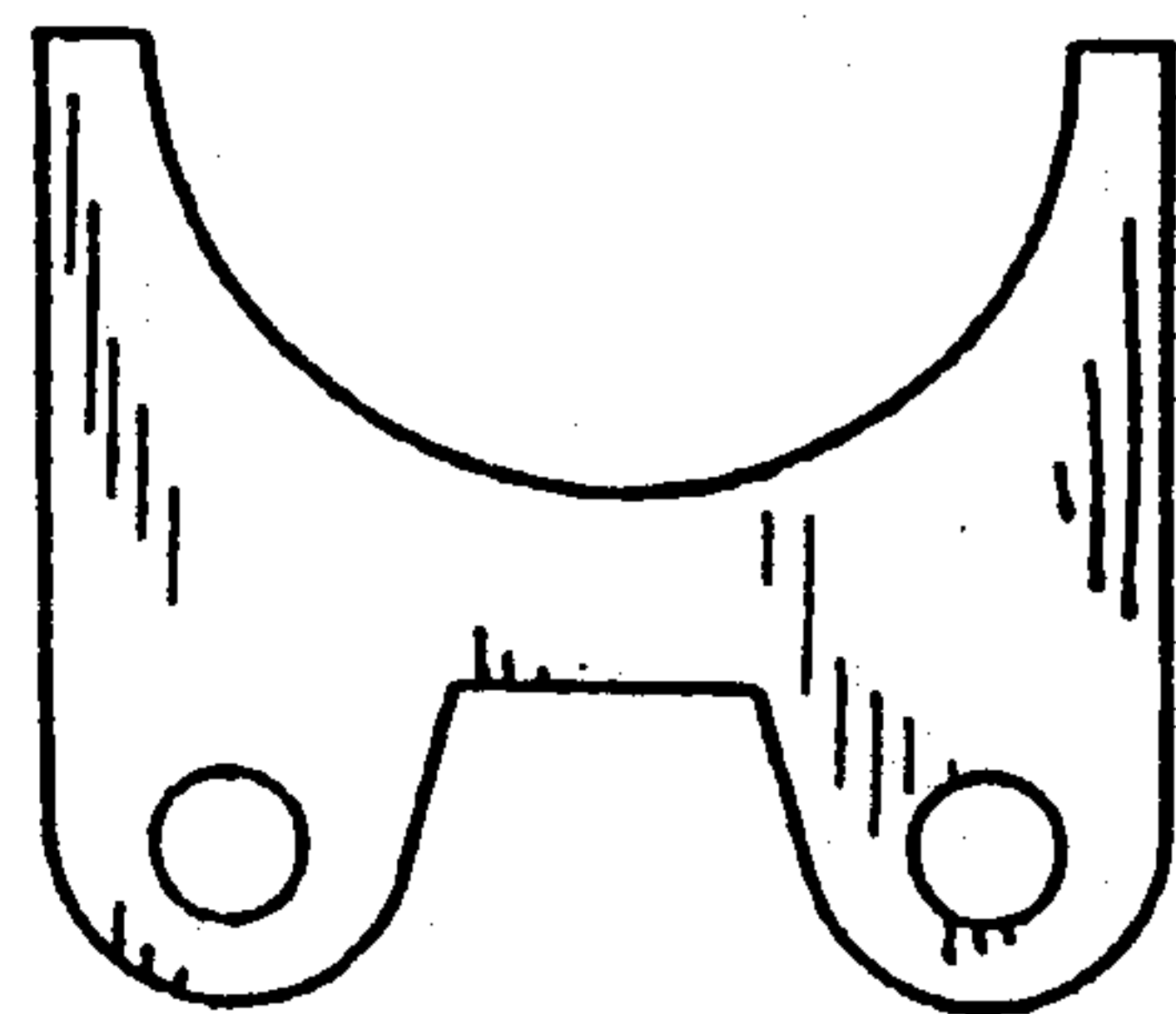

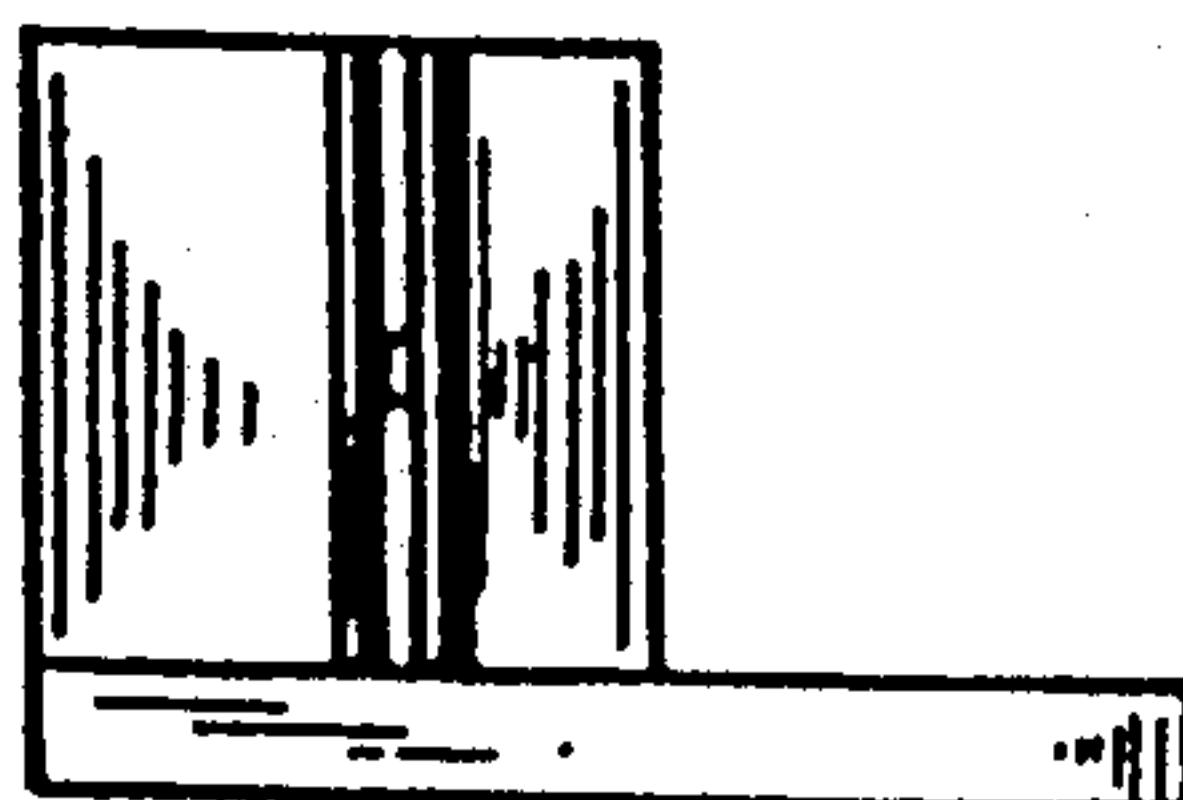

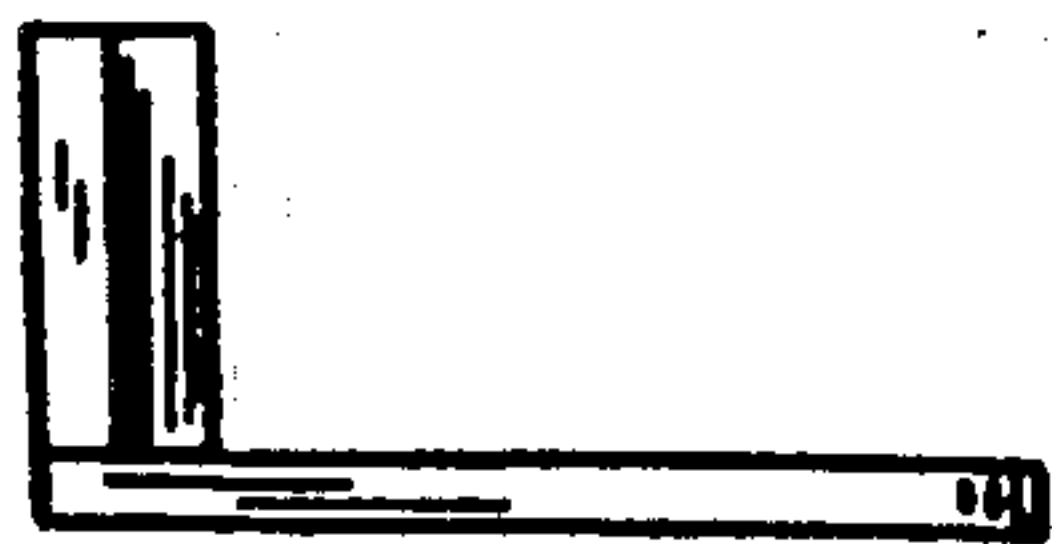
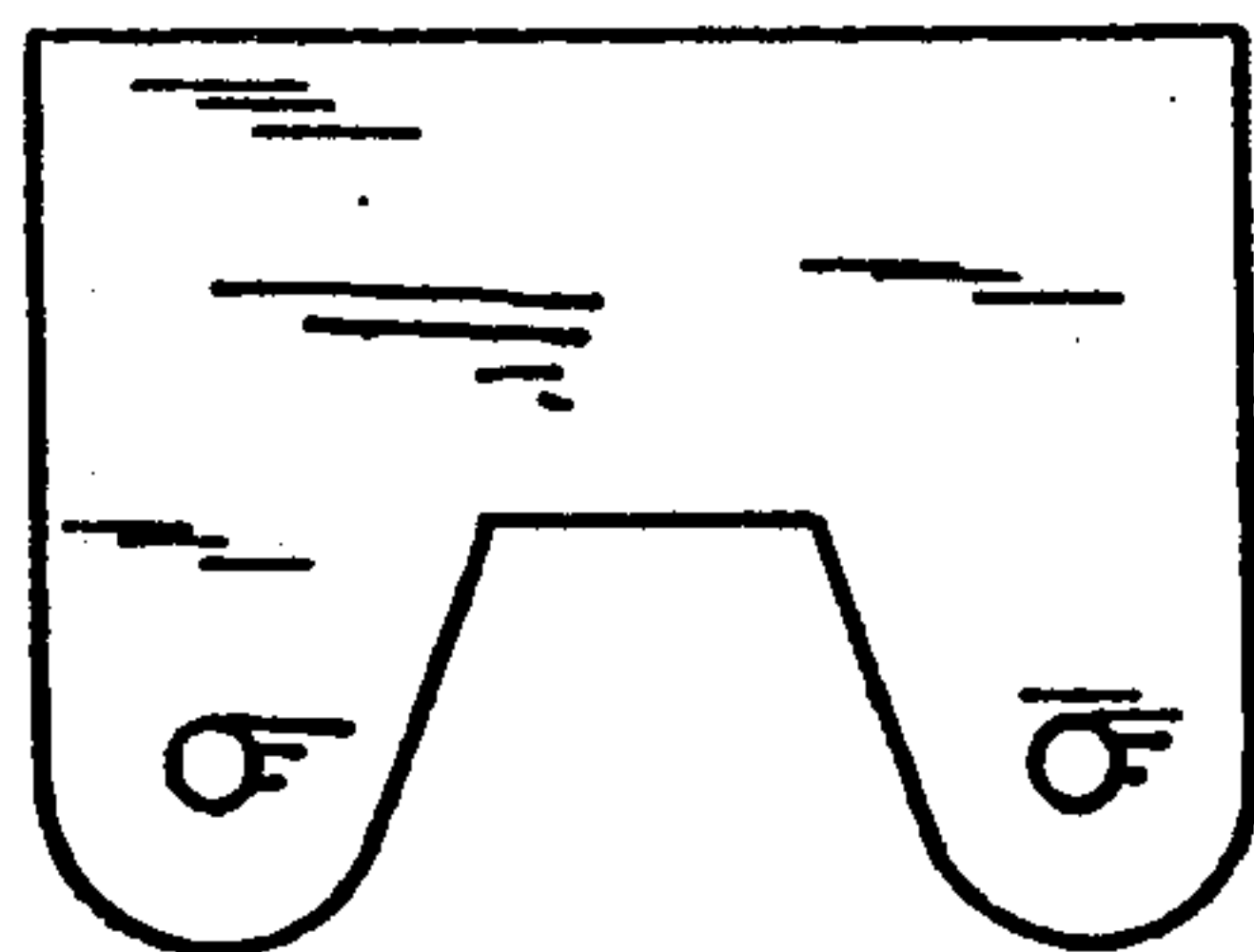
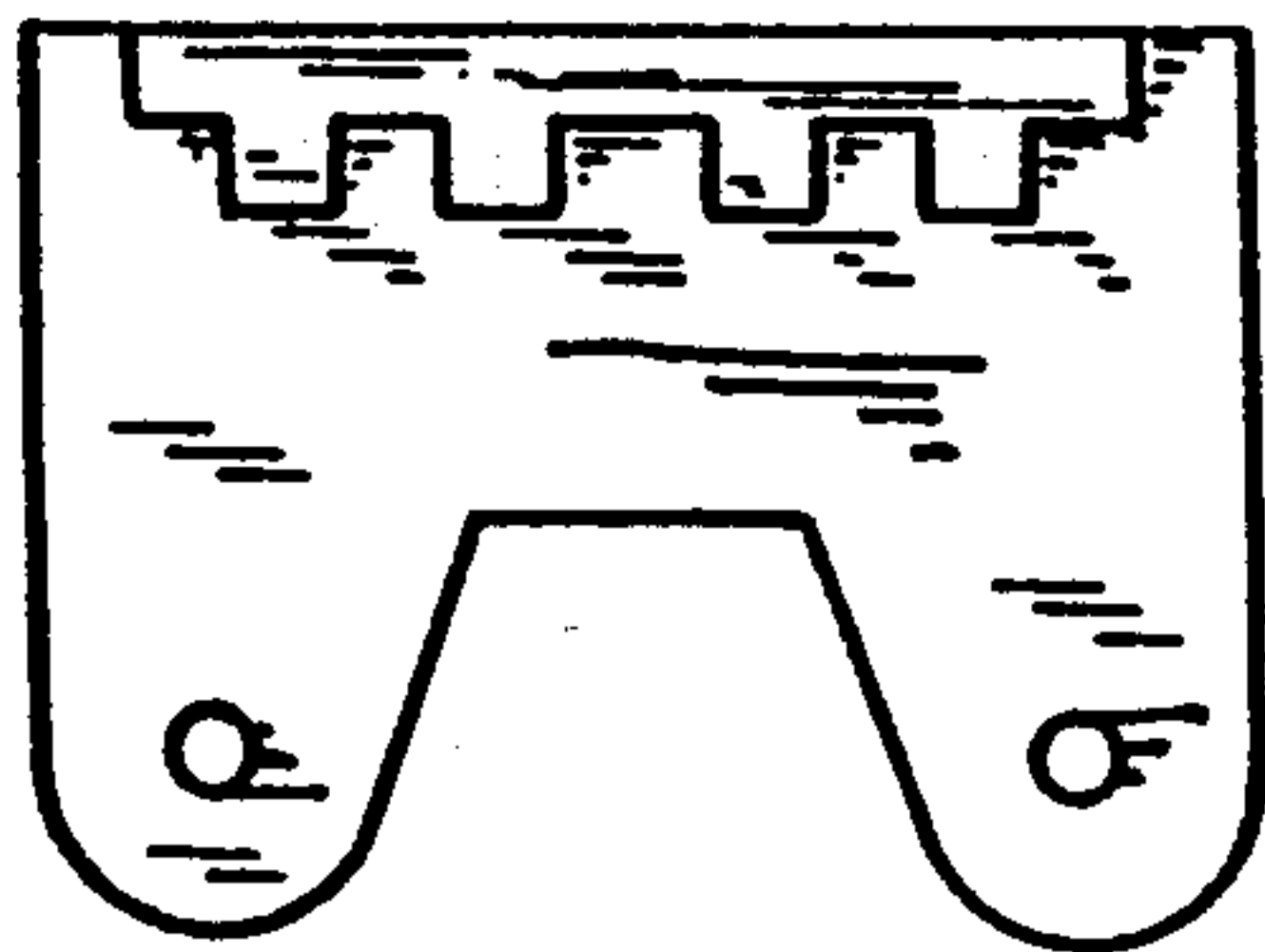
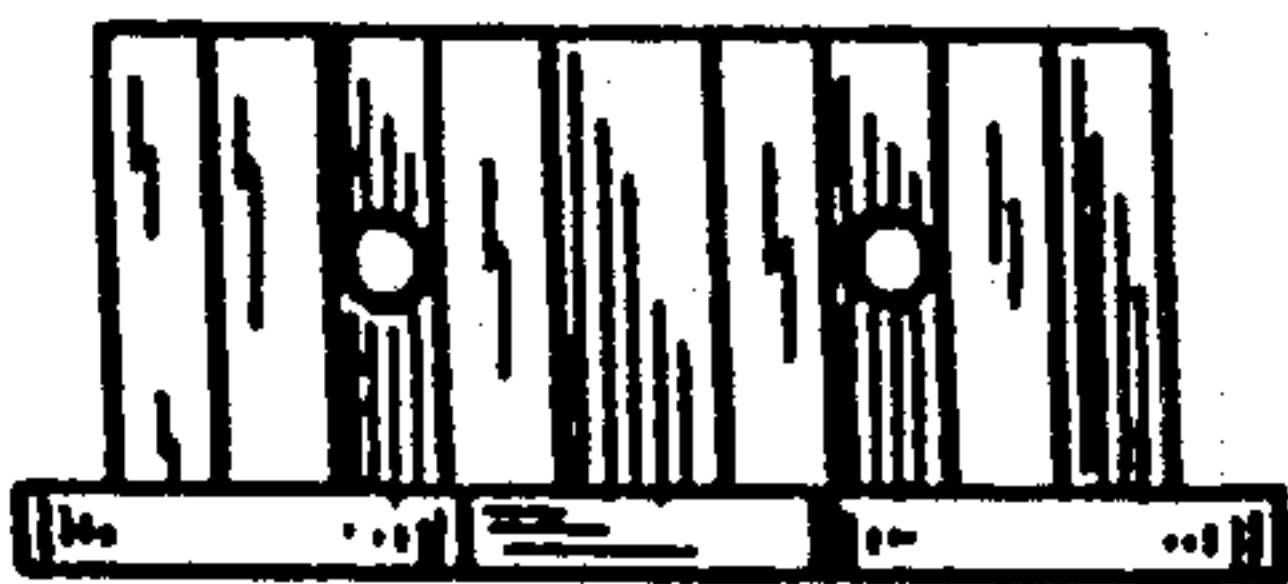
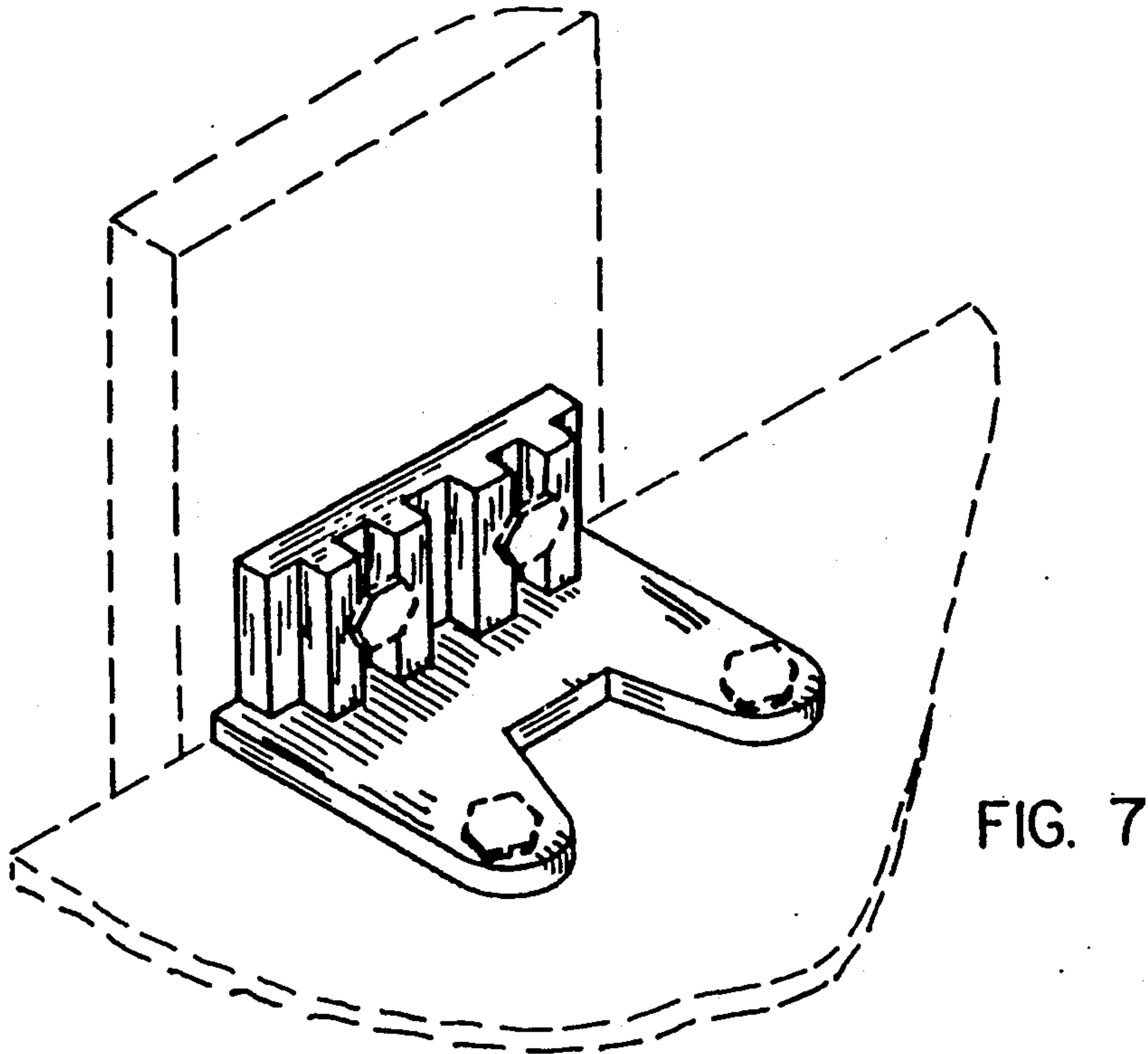
