[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an animated horse figure for use with child's tricycle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an animated horse figure for use with child's tricycle showing my new design, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the side not shown being a mirror image of the side shown;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

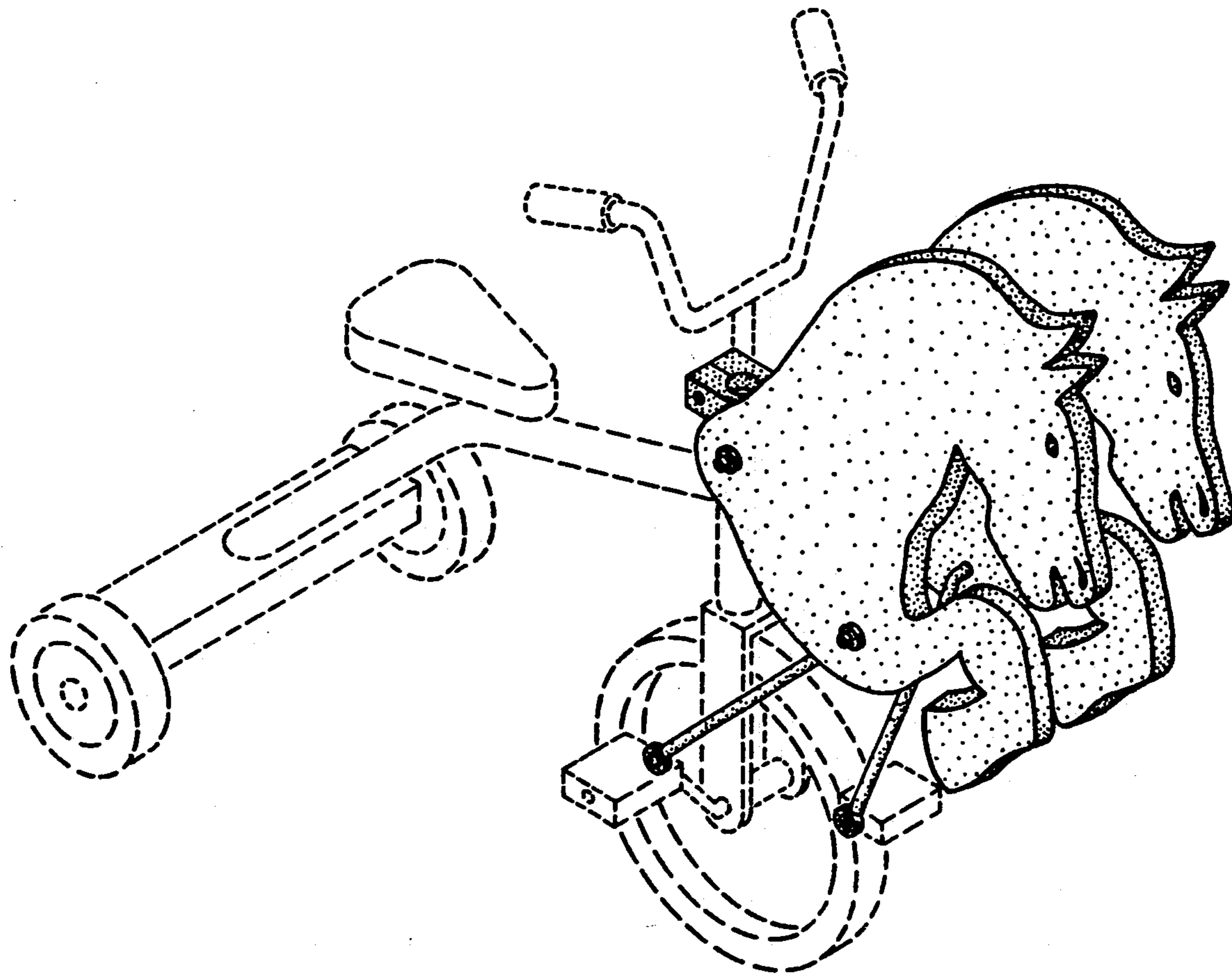

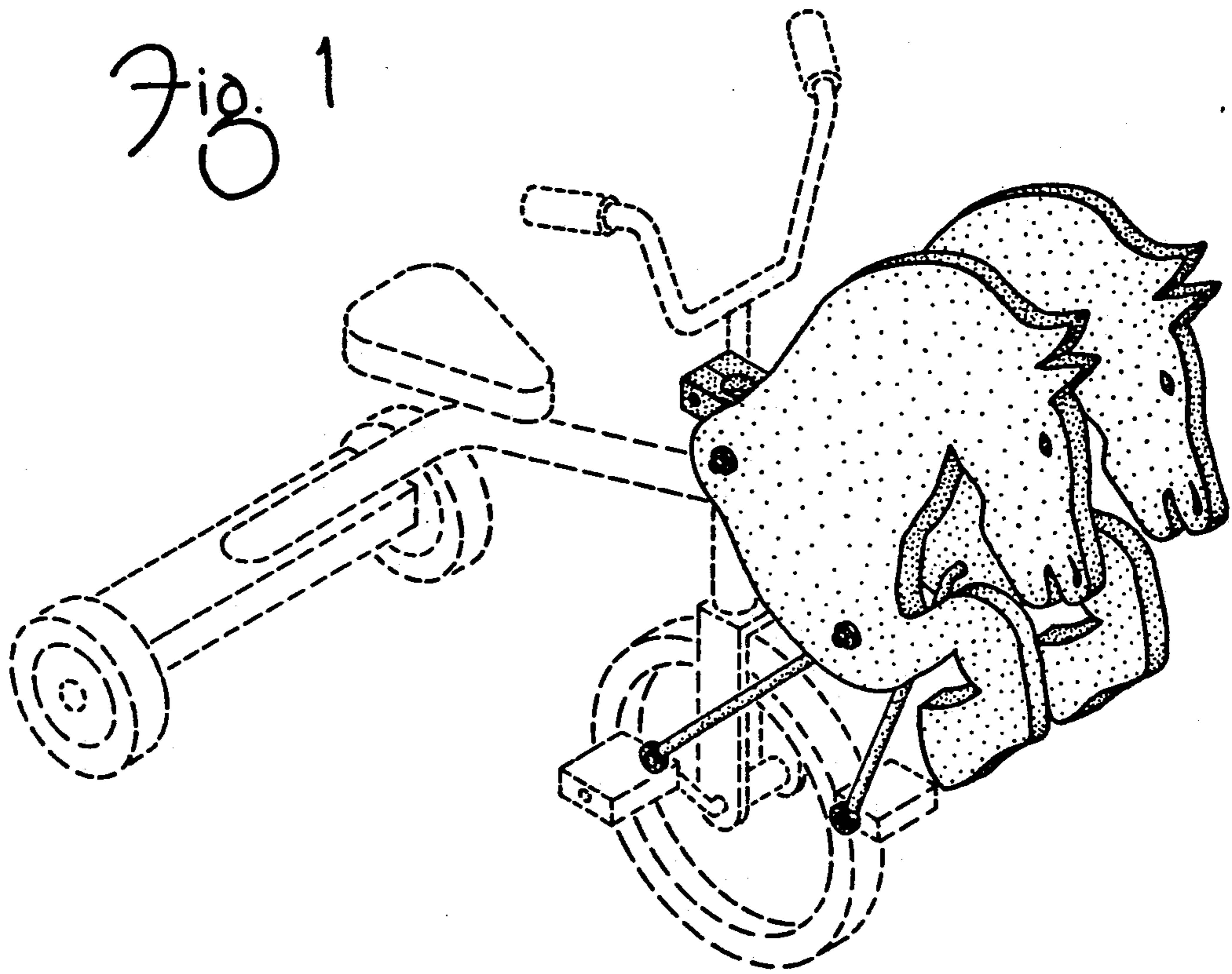

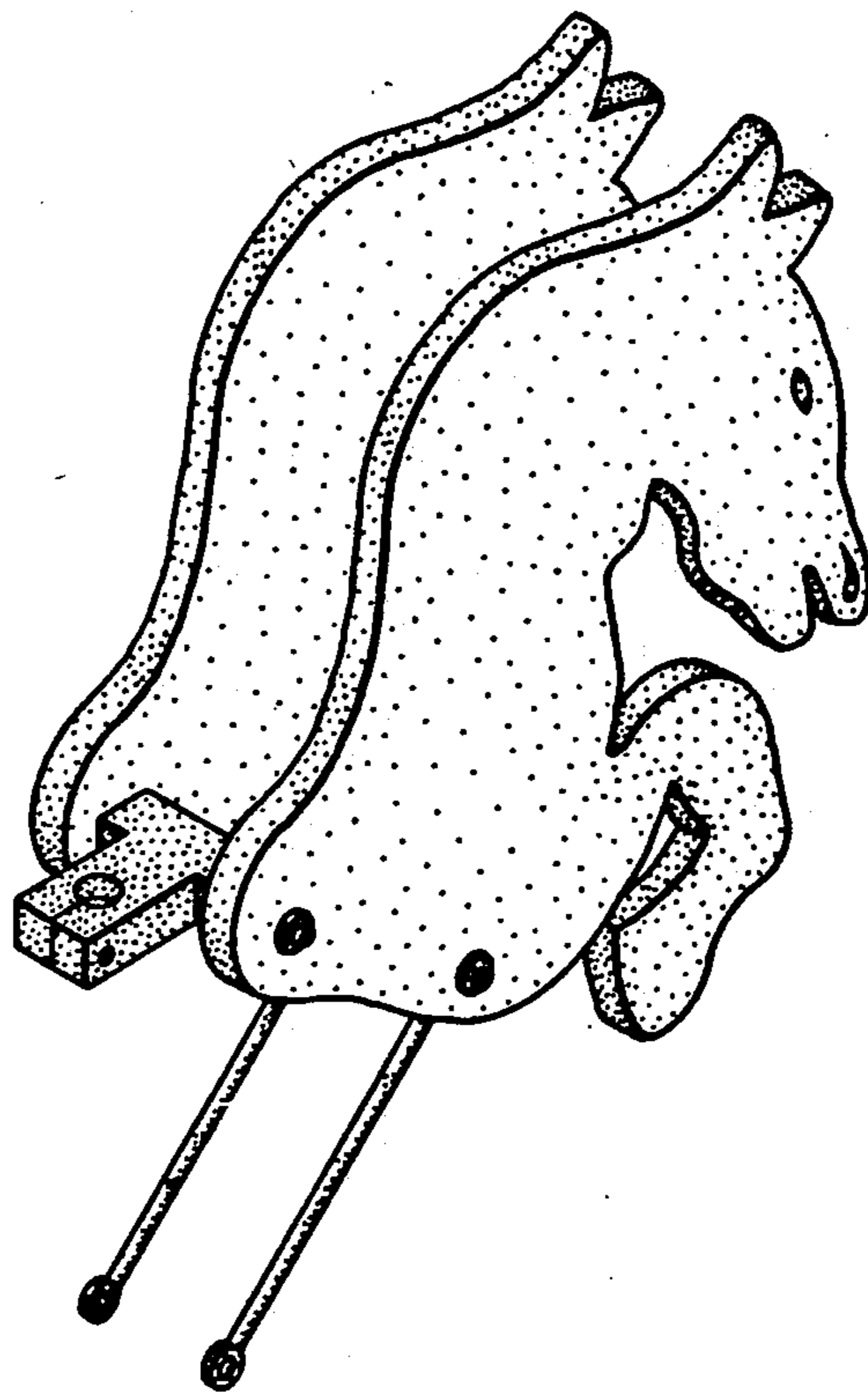

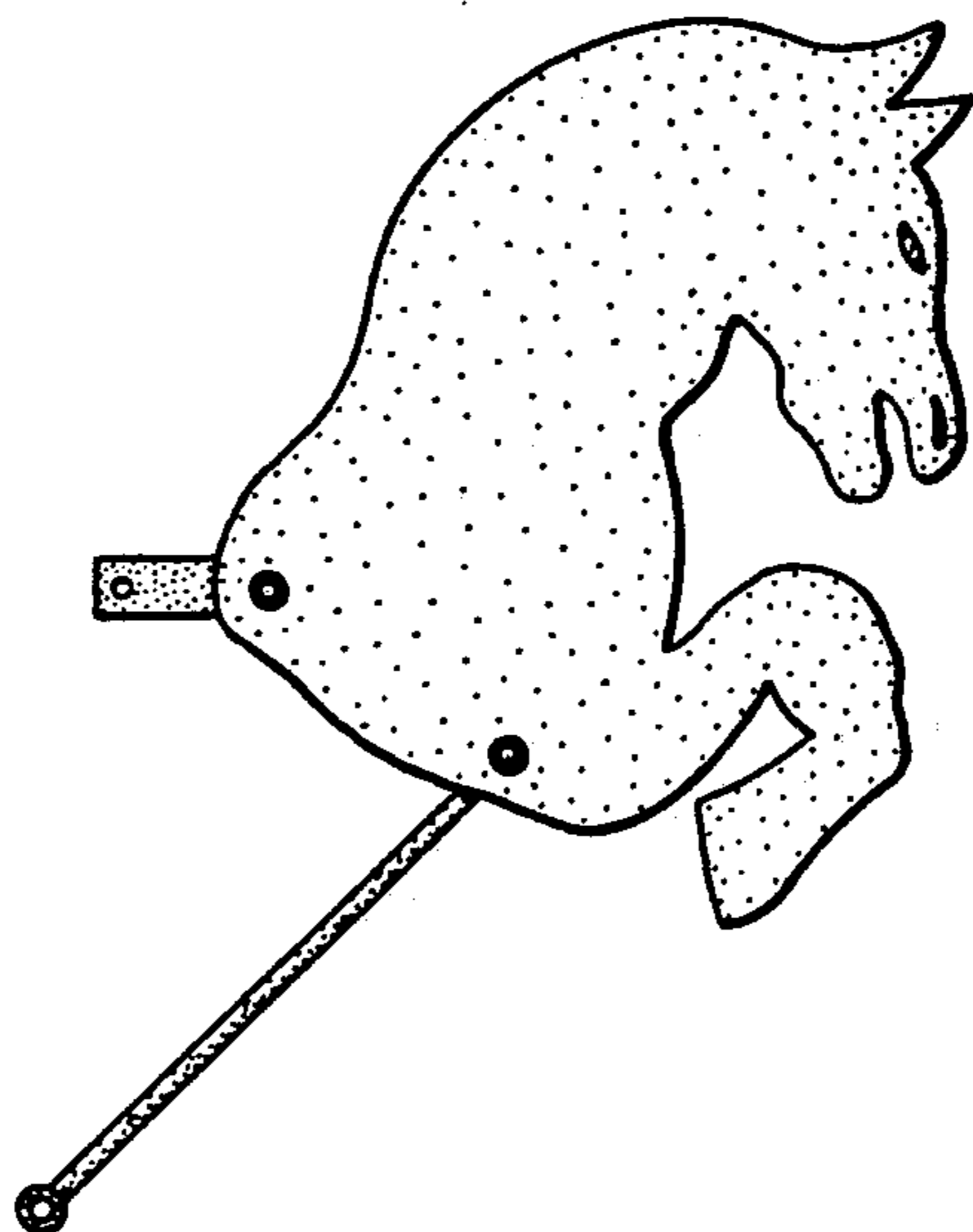

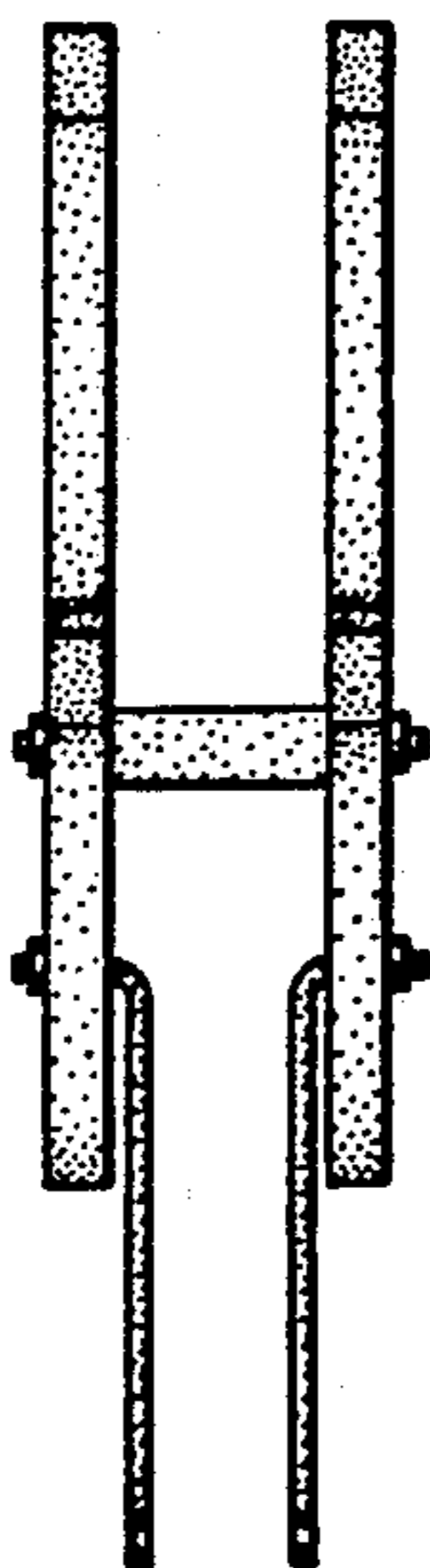

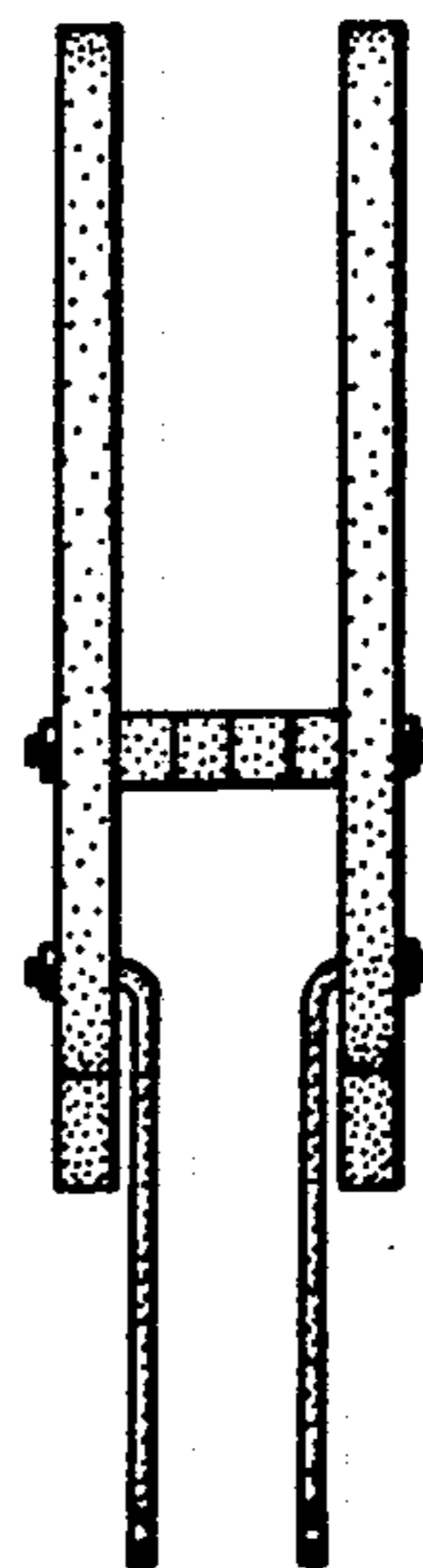

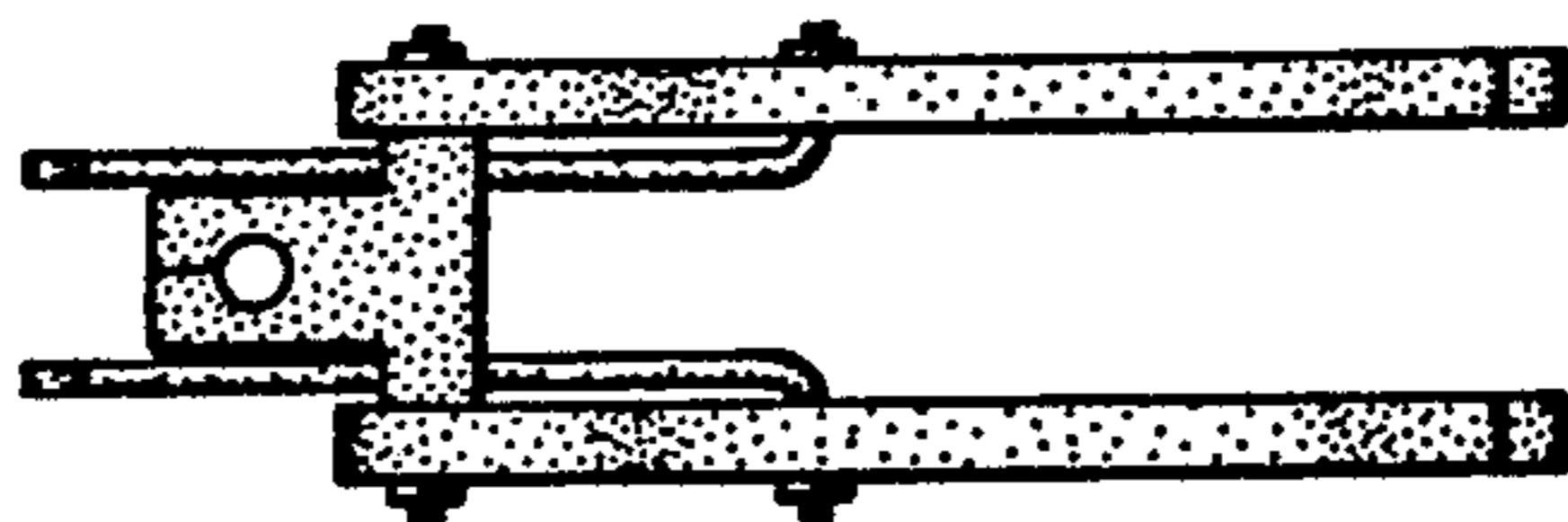
