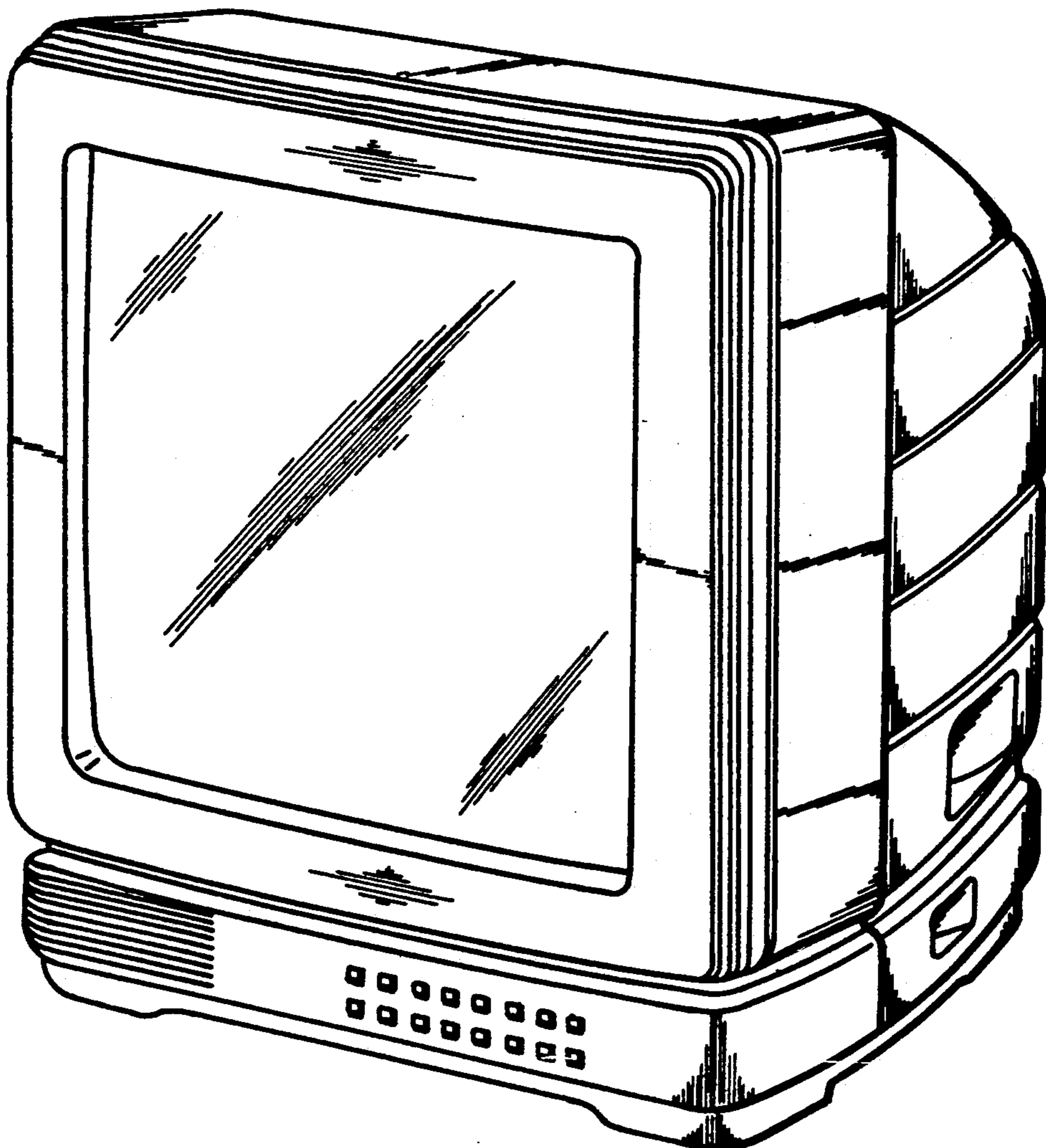

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a television receiver, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a television receiver showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top, rear and right side perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side perspective view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof. The bottom of the television receiver is plain and unornamented.



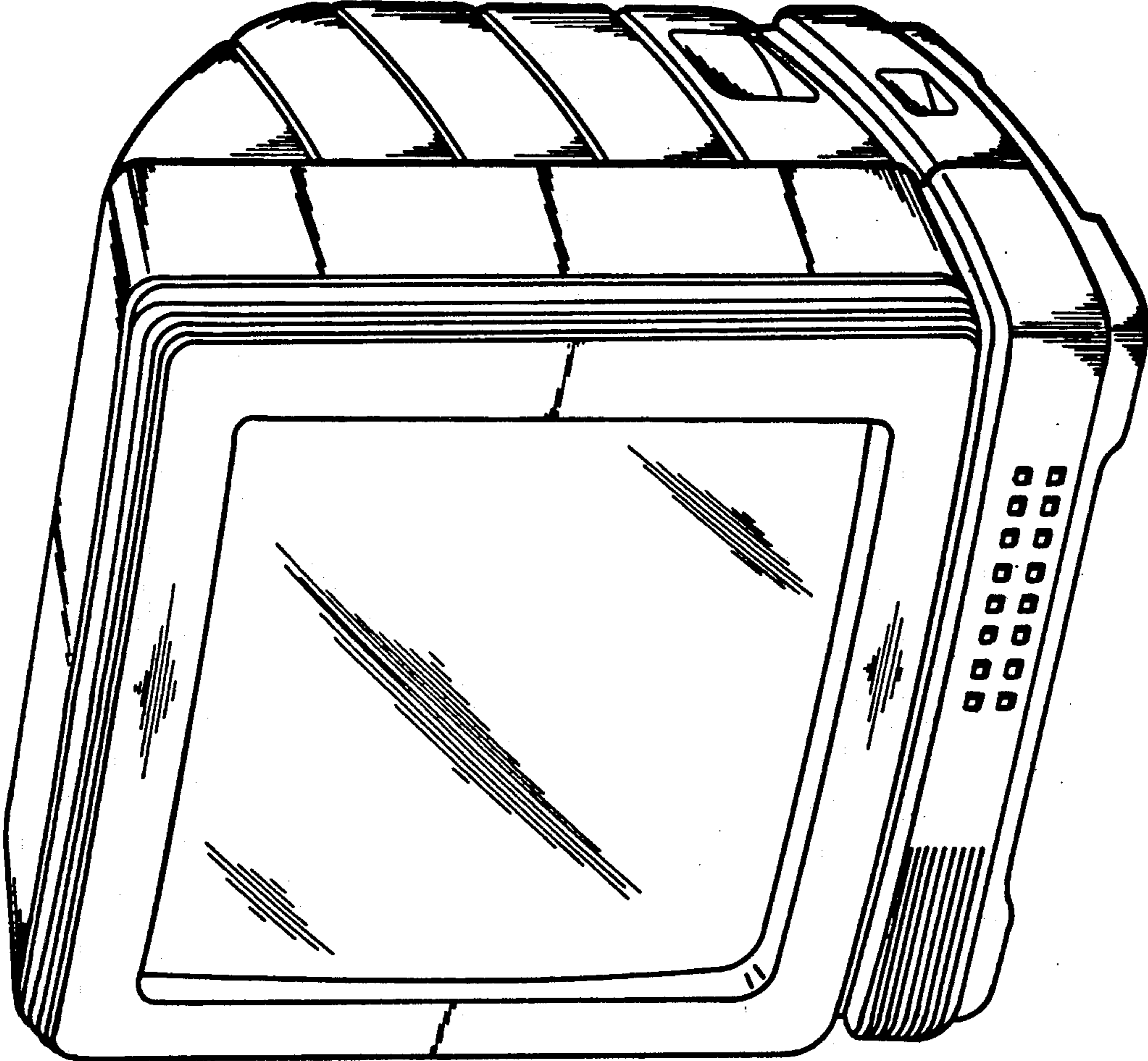

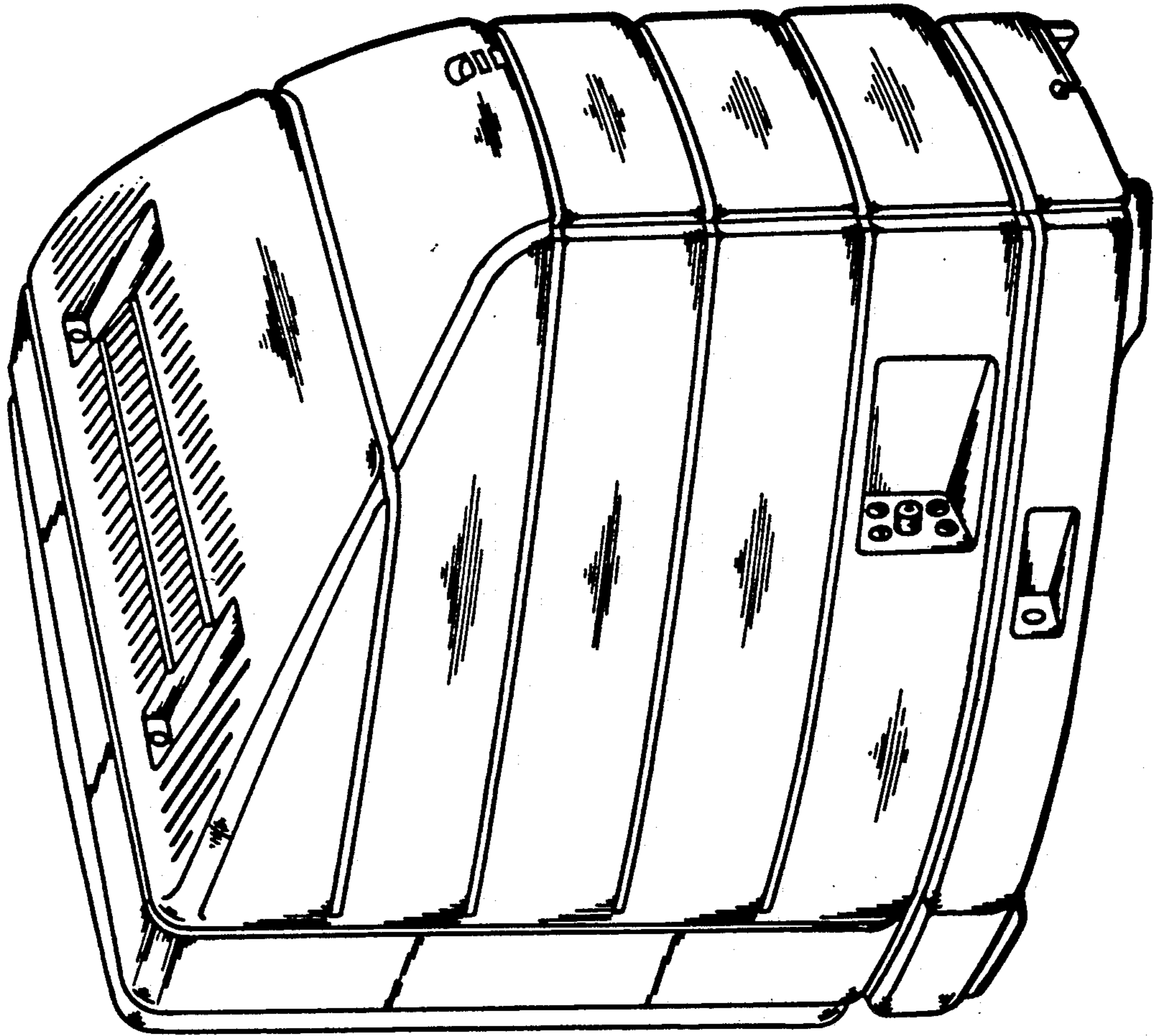

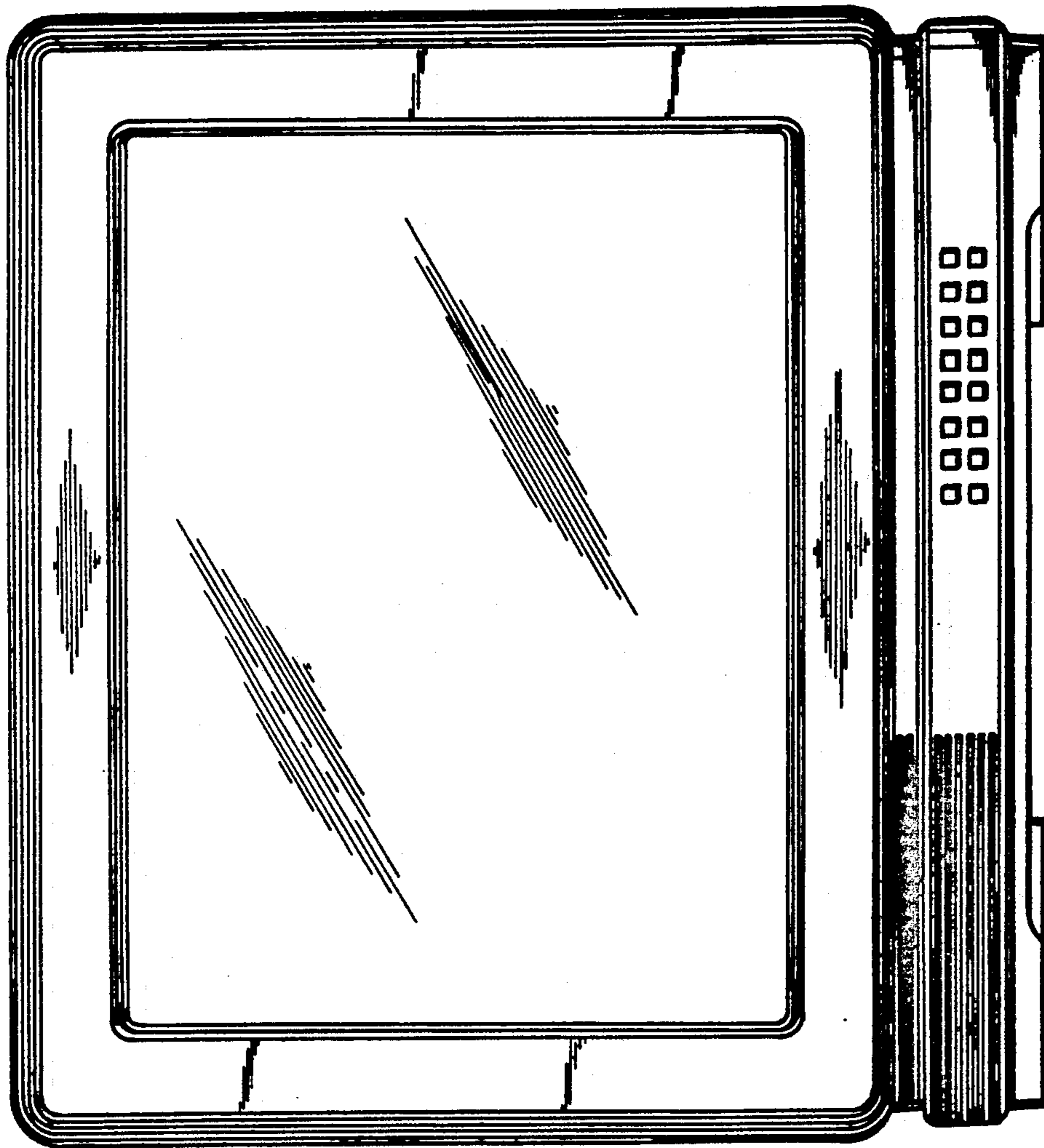

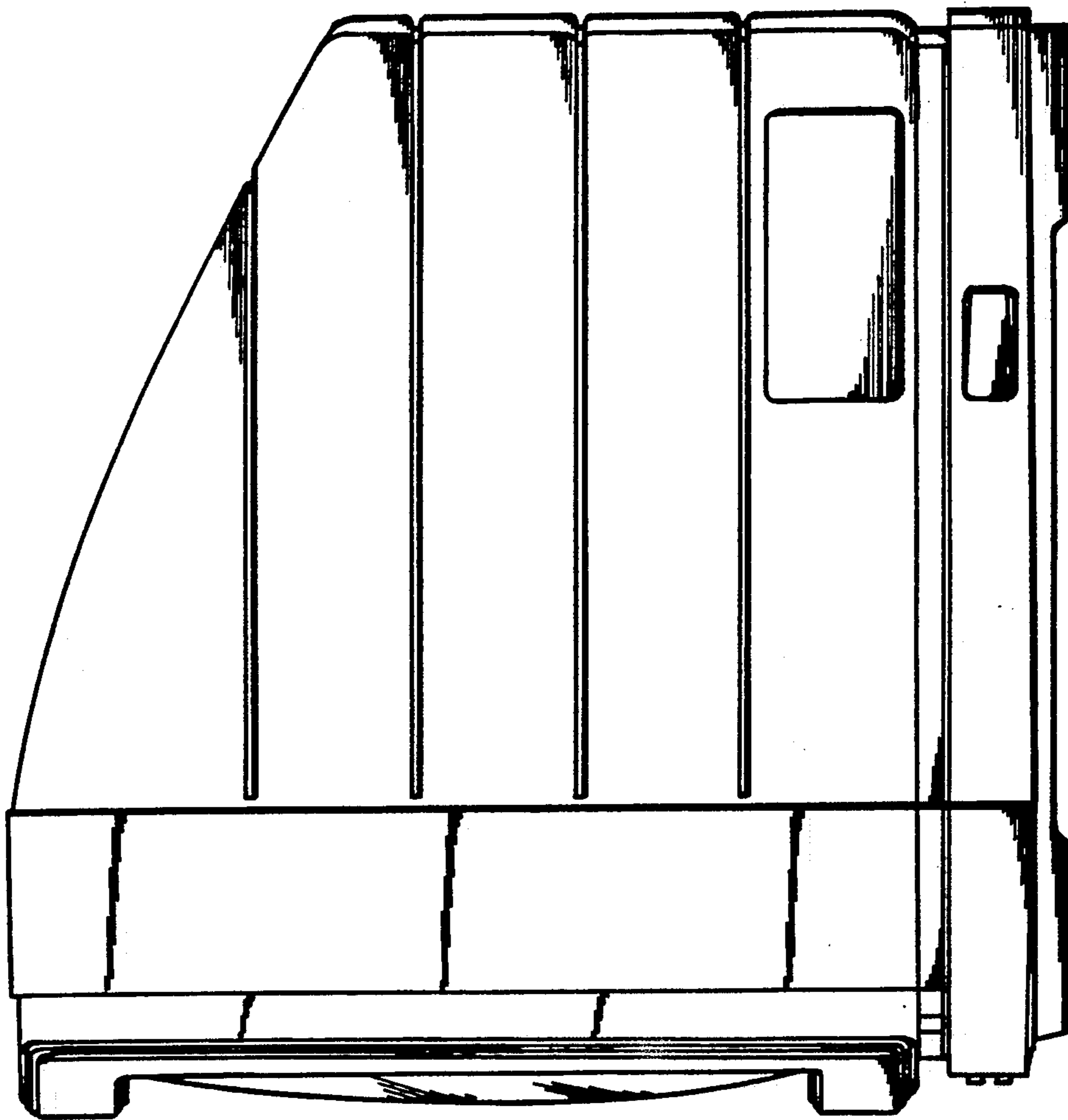

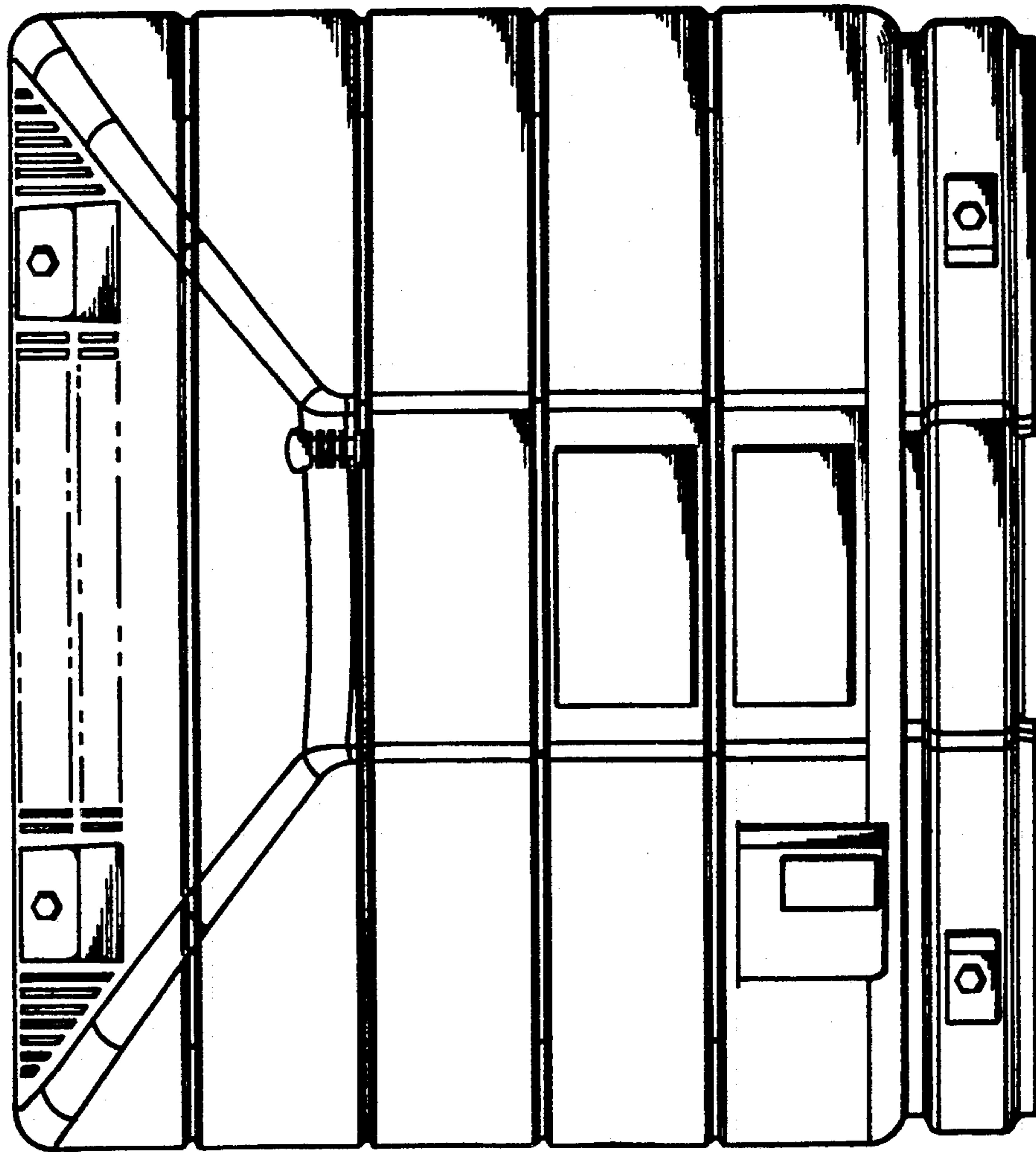

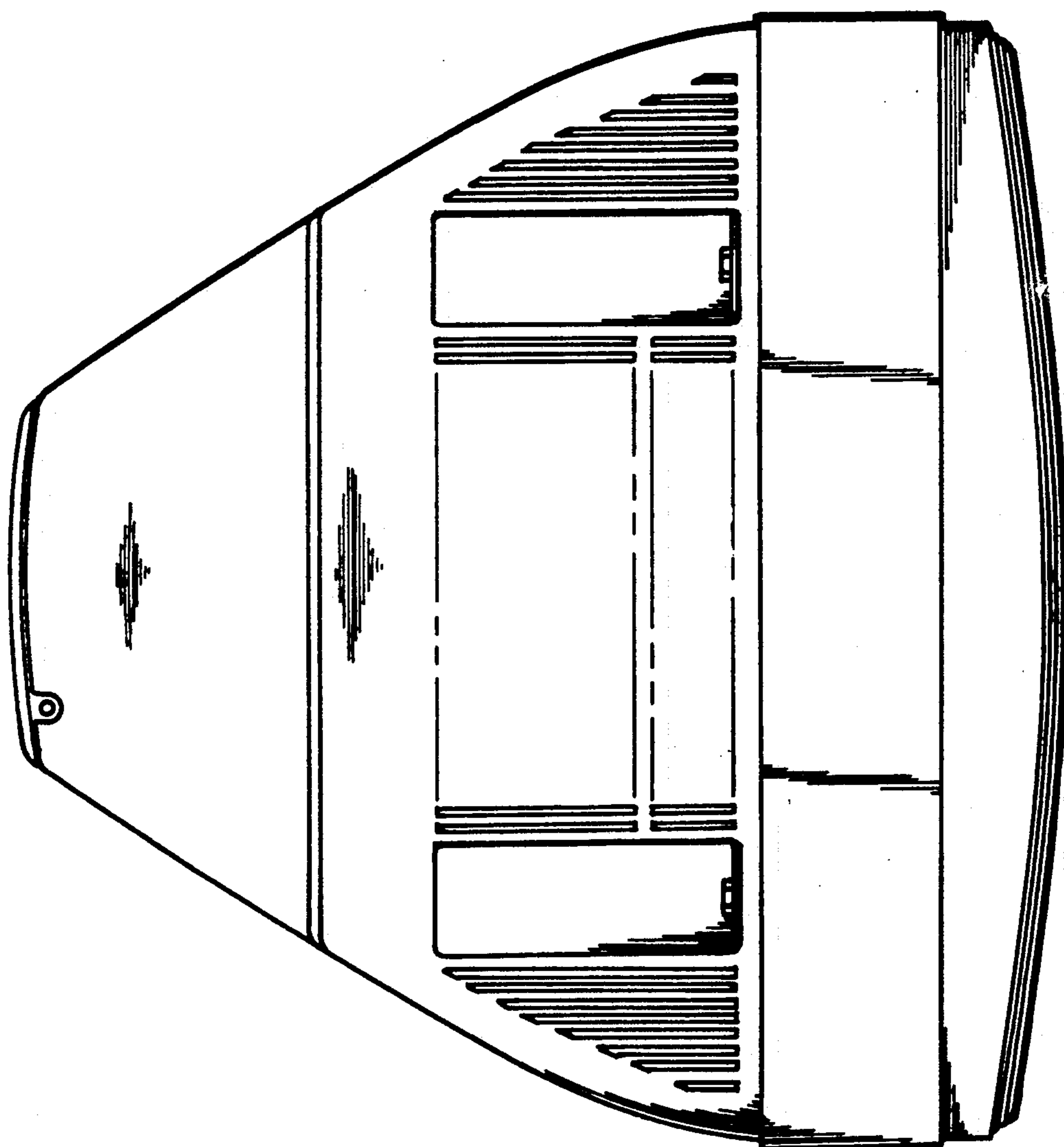

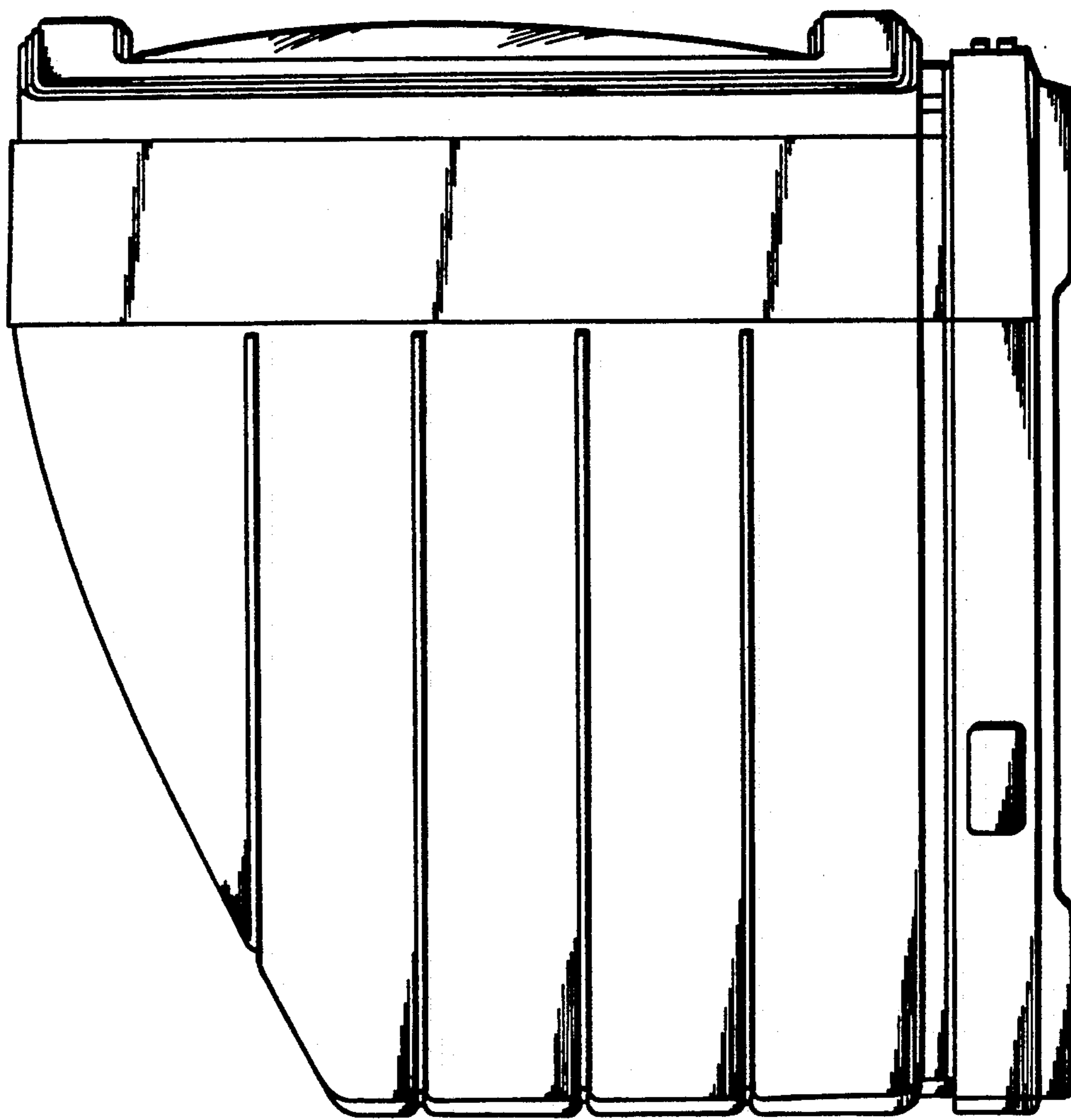
