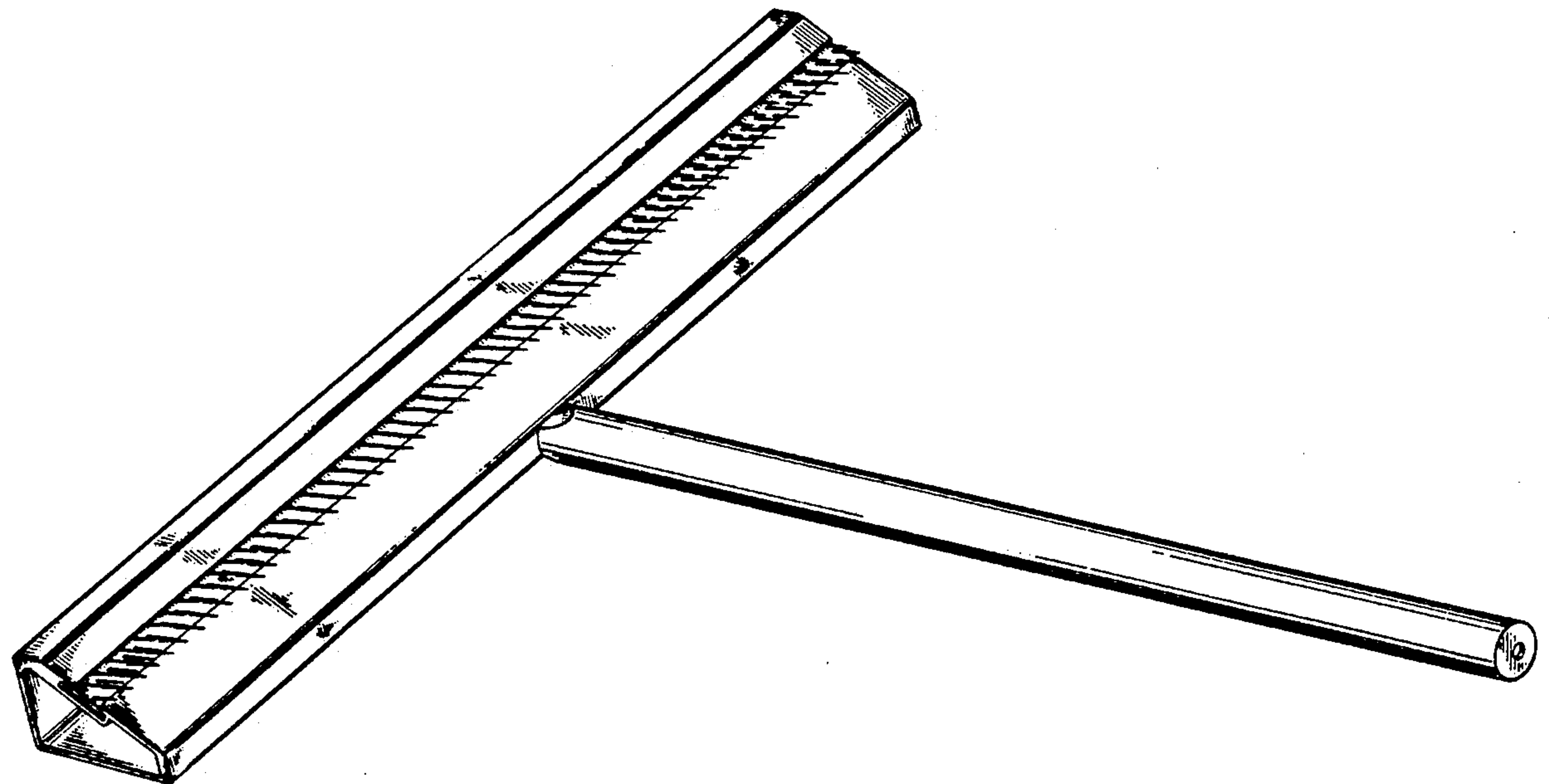

The ornamental design for a hand-held fabric stretcher, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a hand-held fabric stretcher showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; and FIG. 3 is a front perspective view thereof. The rear of the article is conventional in appearance.



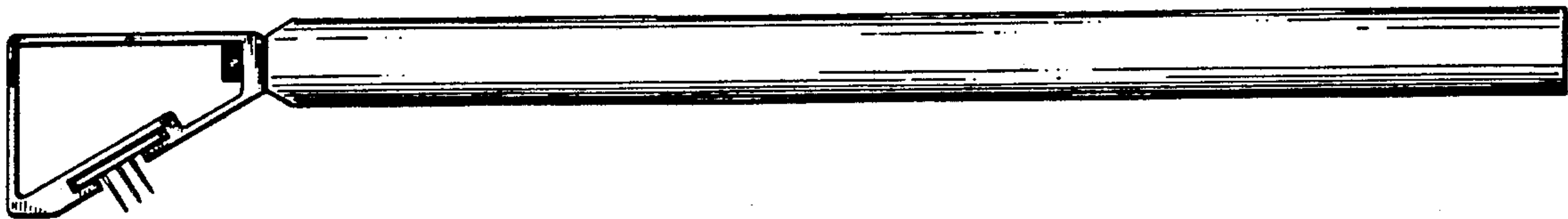

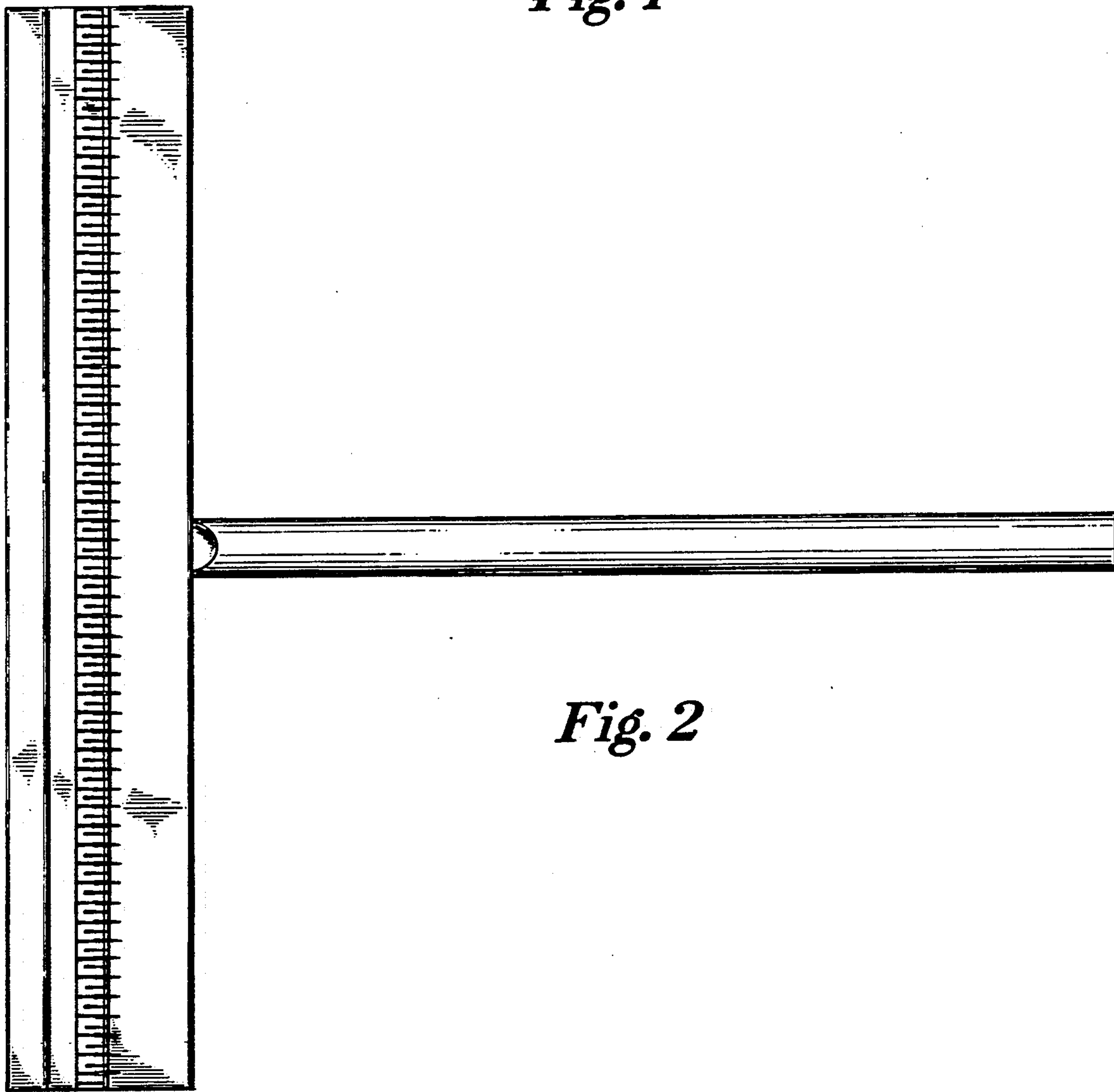

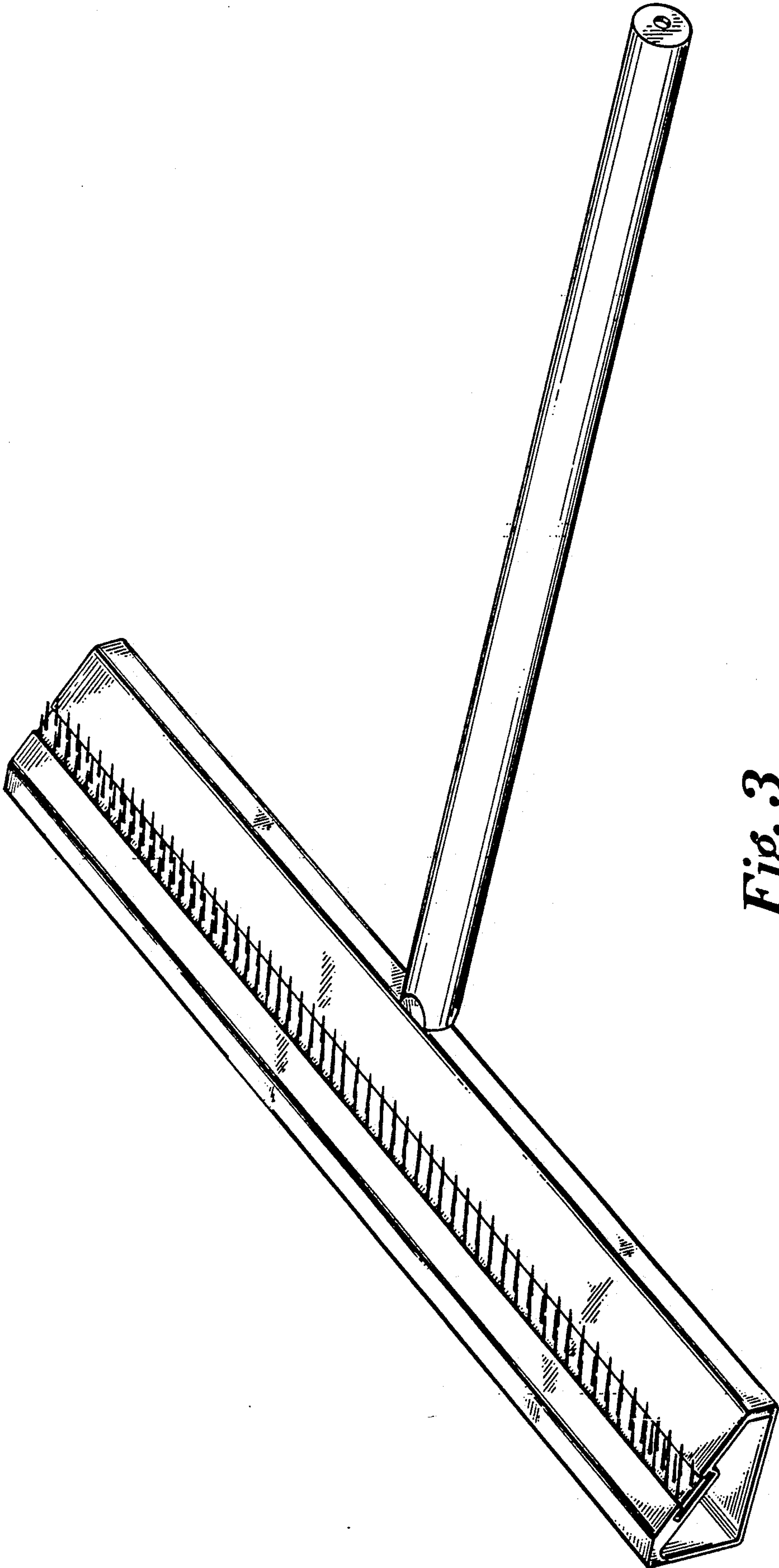
